FIG. 4 is an end elevational view of the first embodiment;

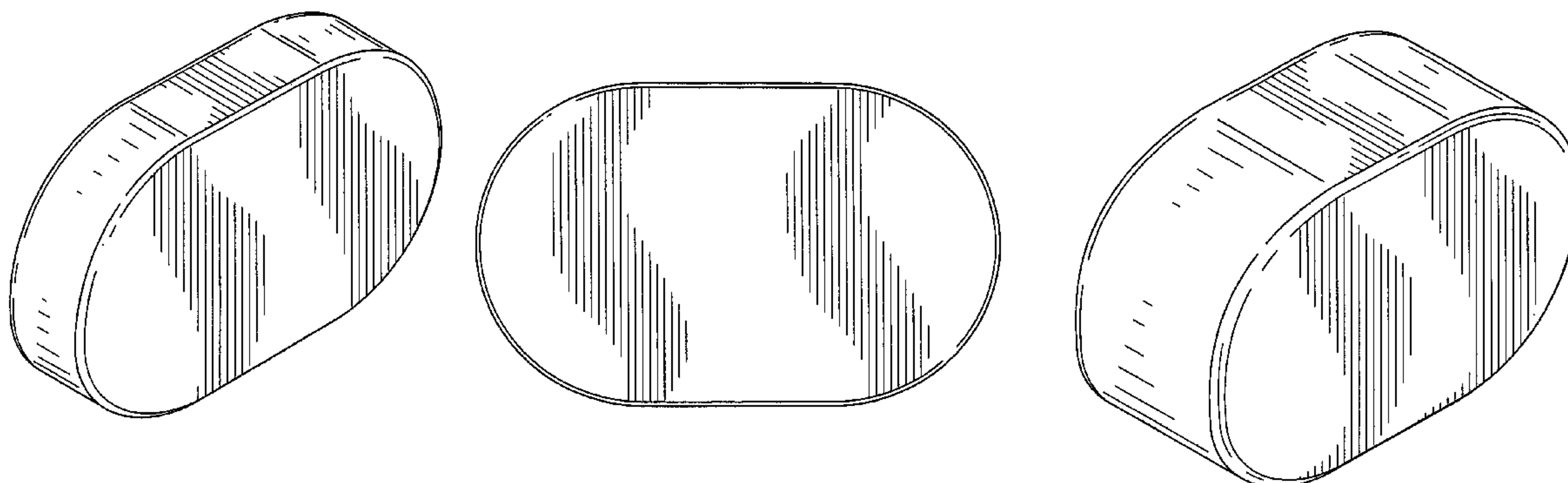
FIG. 5 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment;

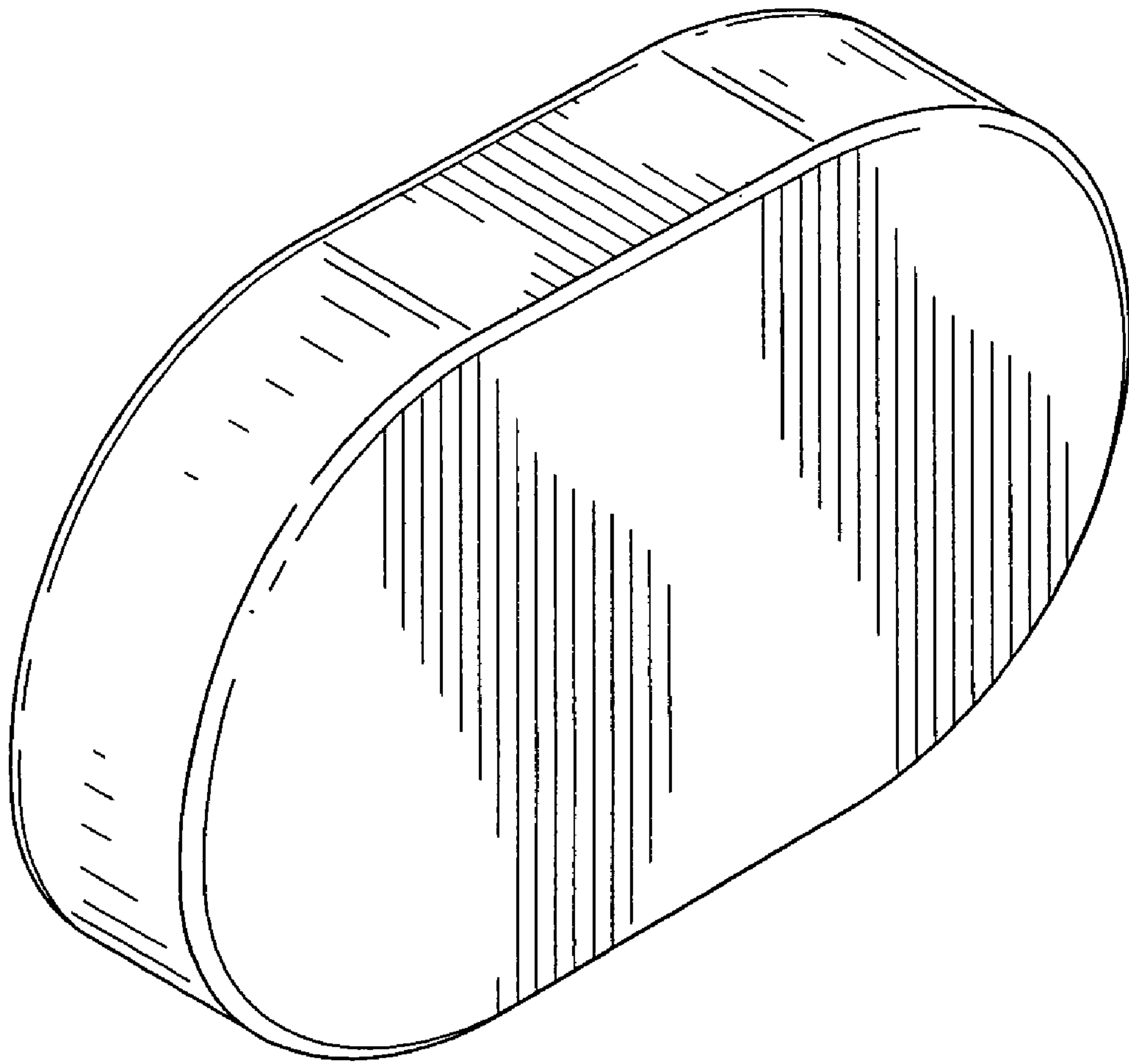

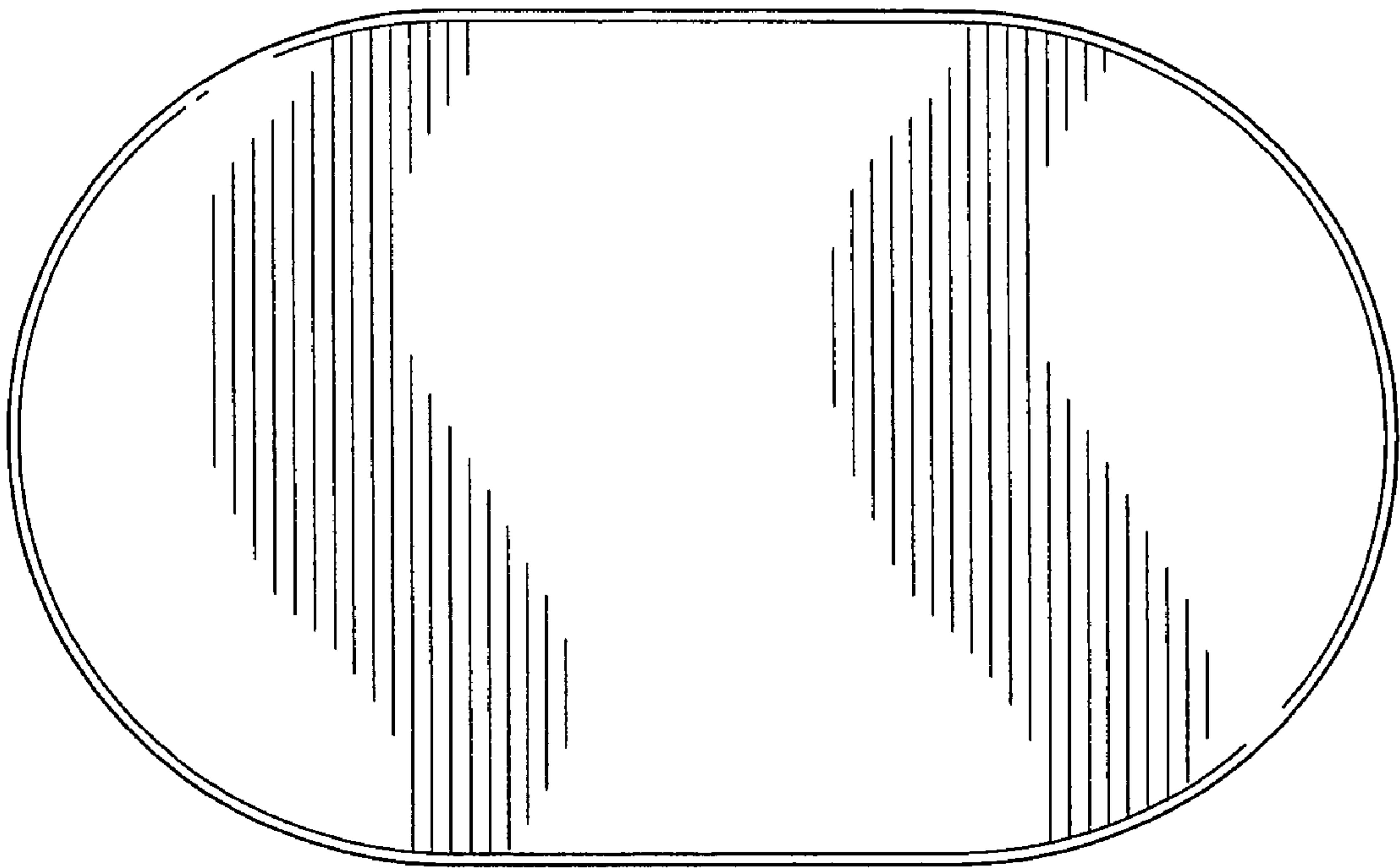

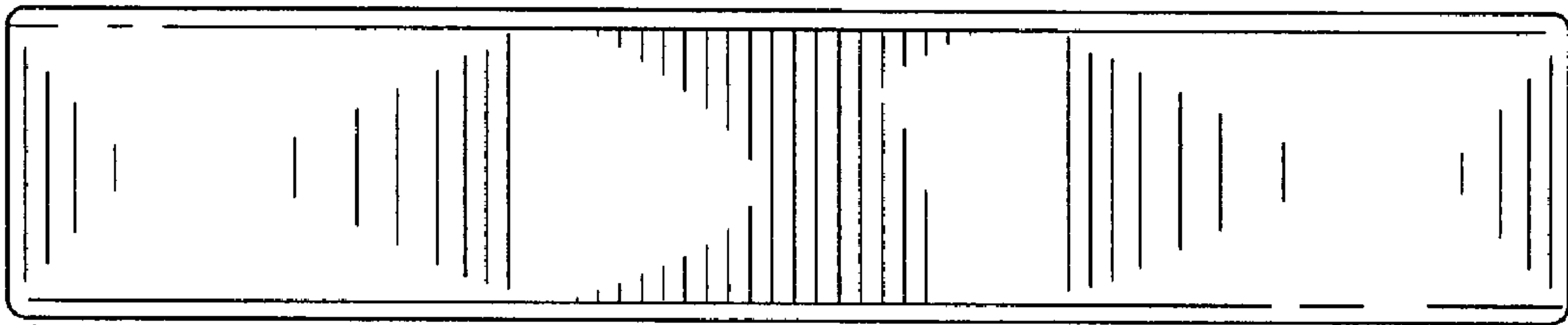

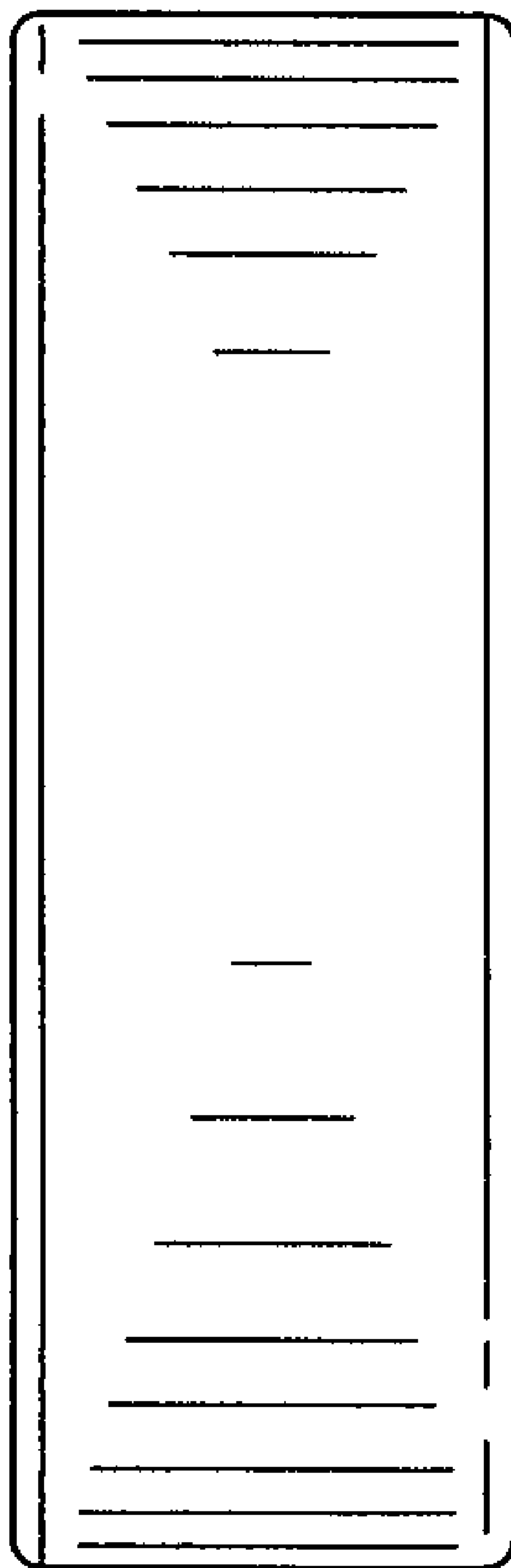

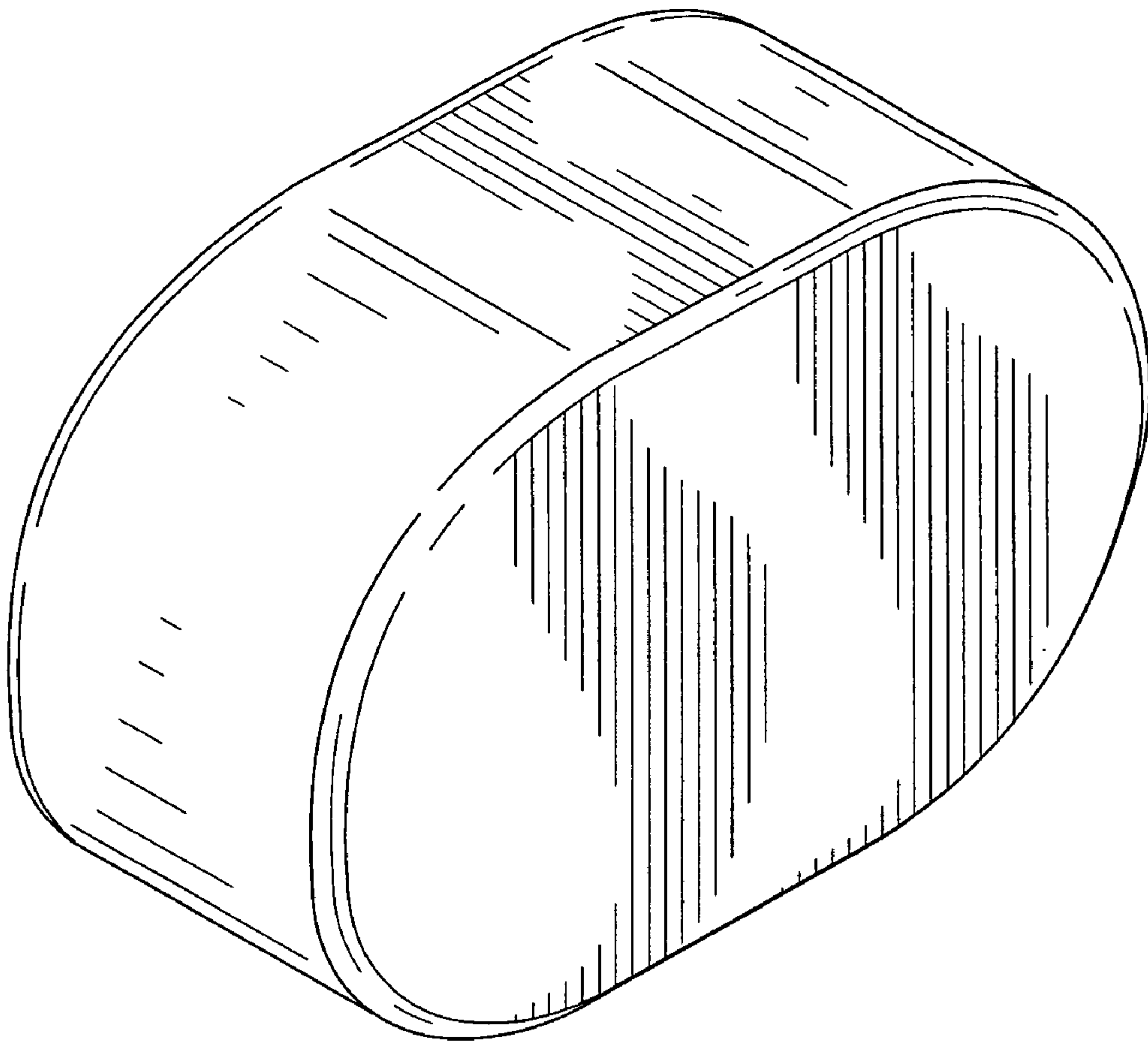

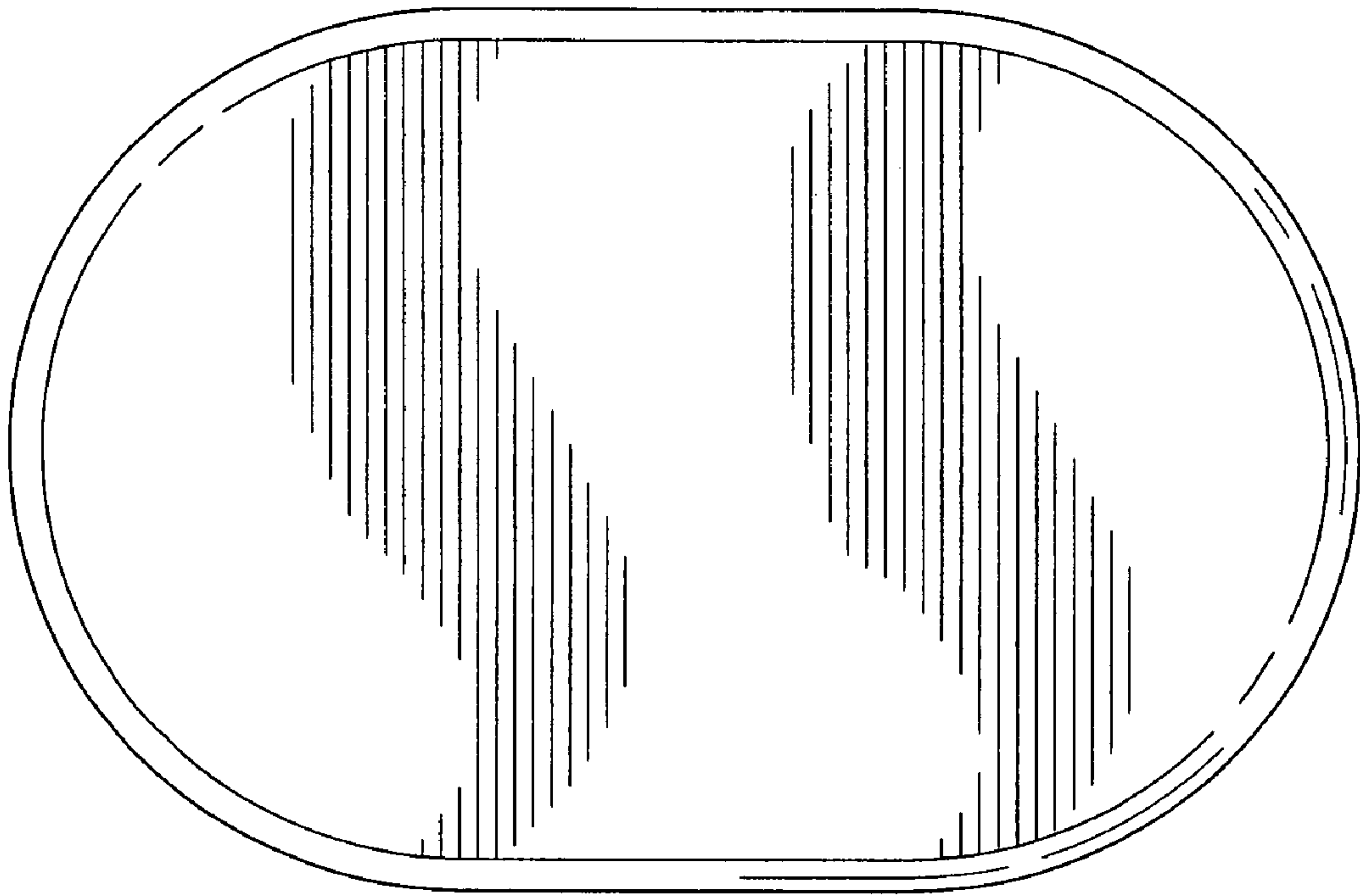

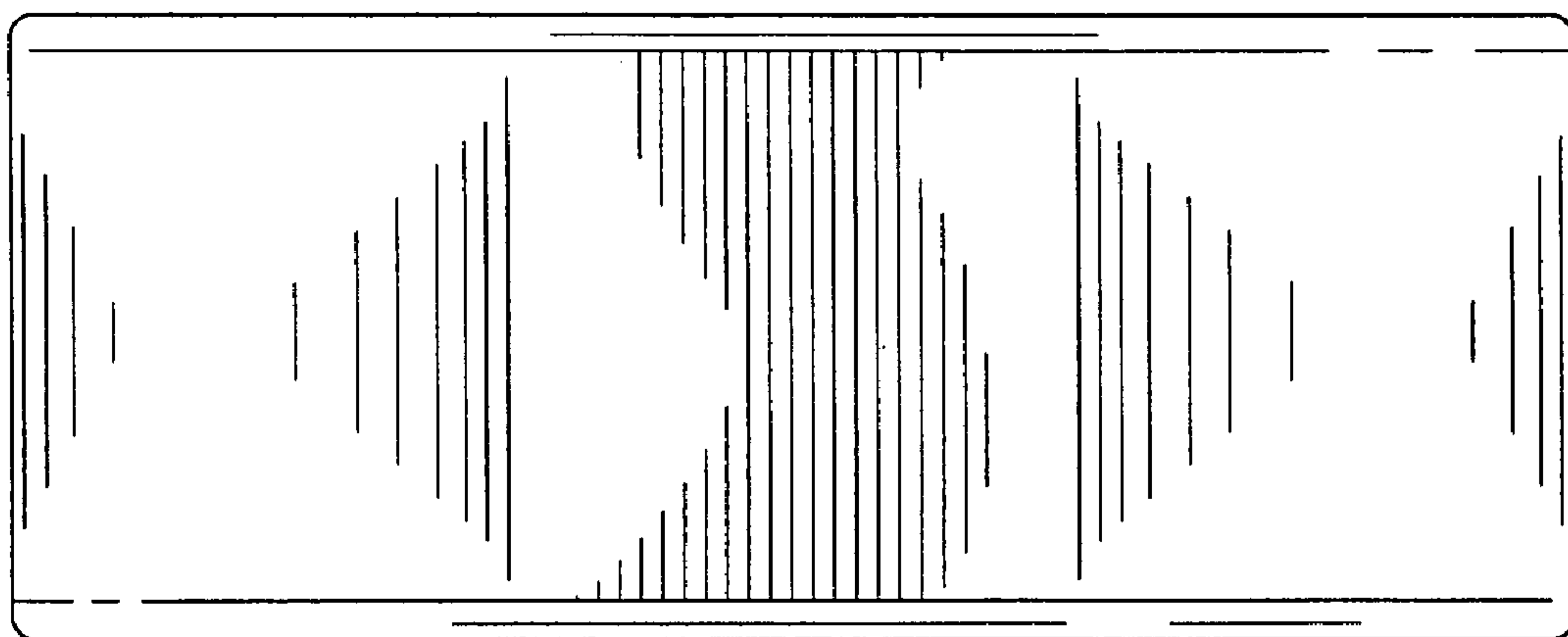

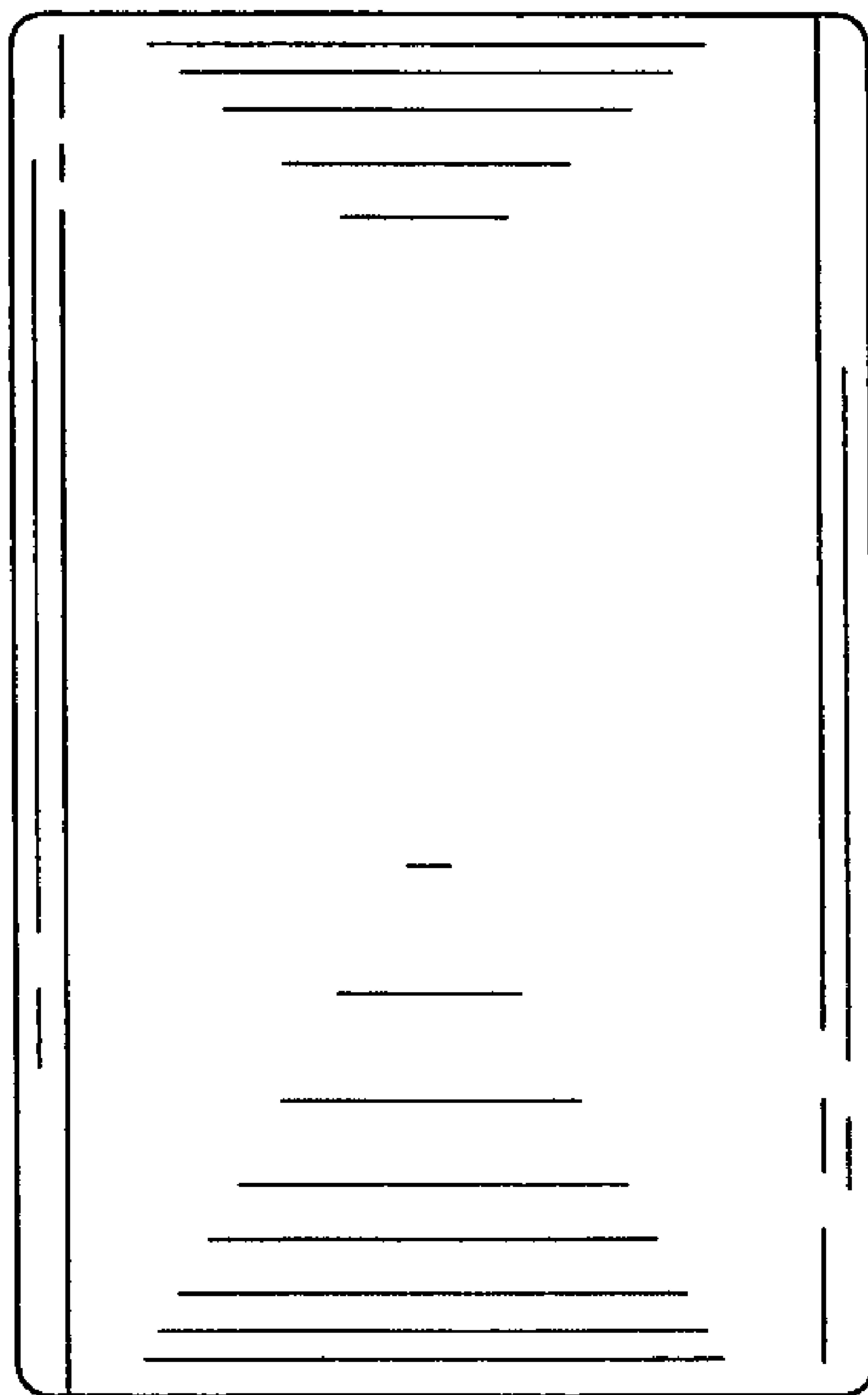
