The ornamental design for a sports themed shirt, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of my design of a sports themed shirt, showing a football on the central chest;

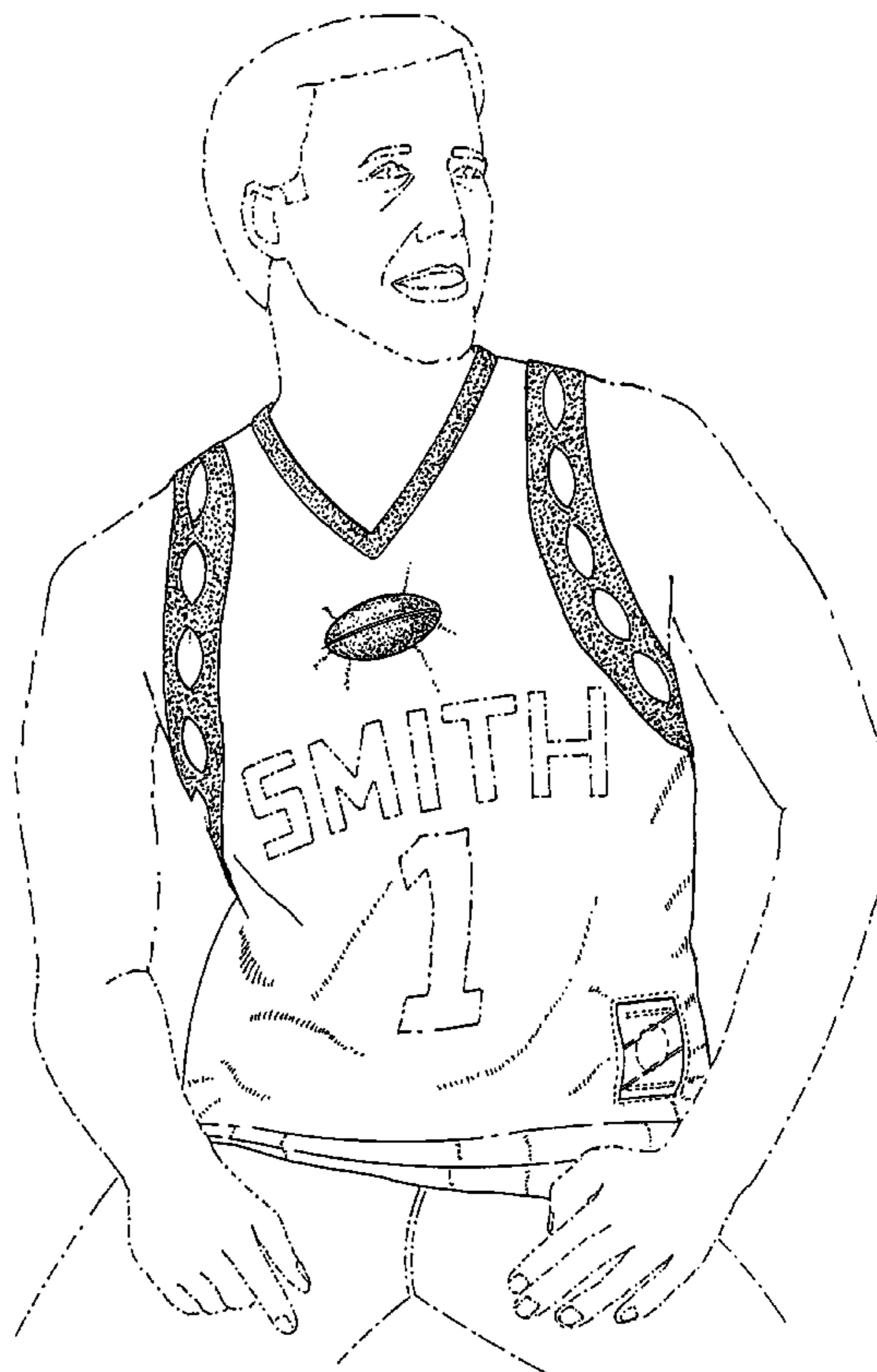
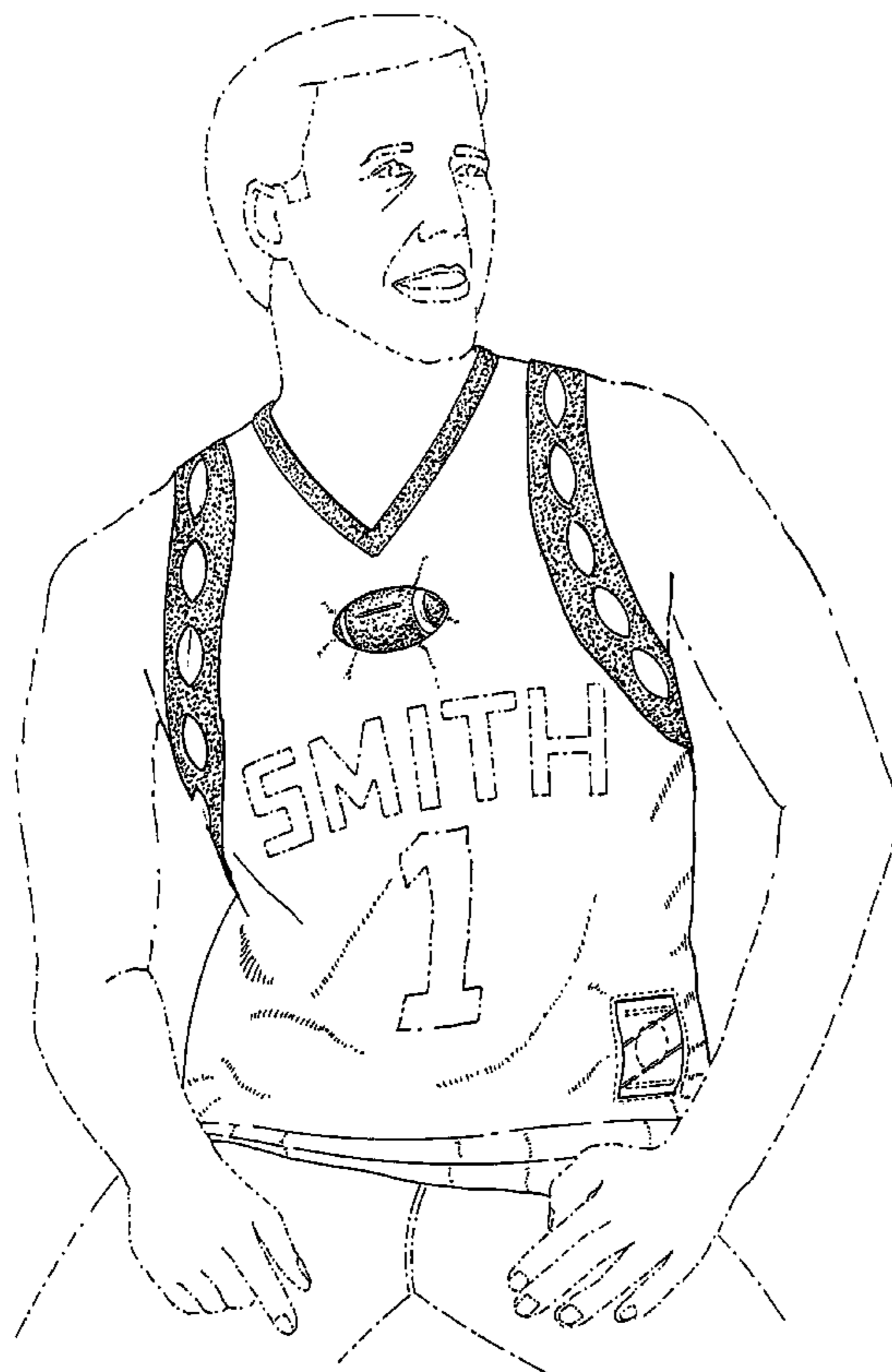
FIG. 2 is a back elevational view thereof;

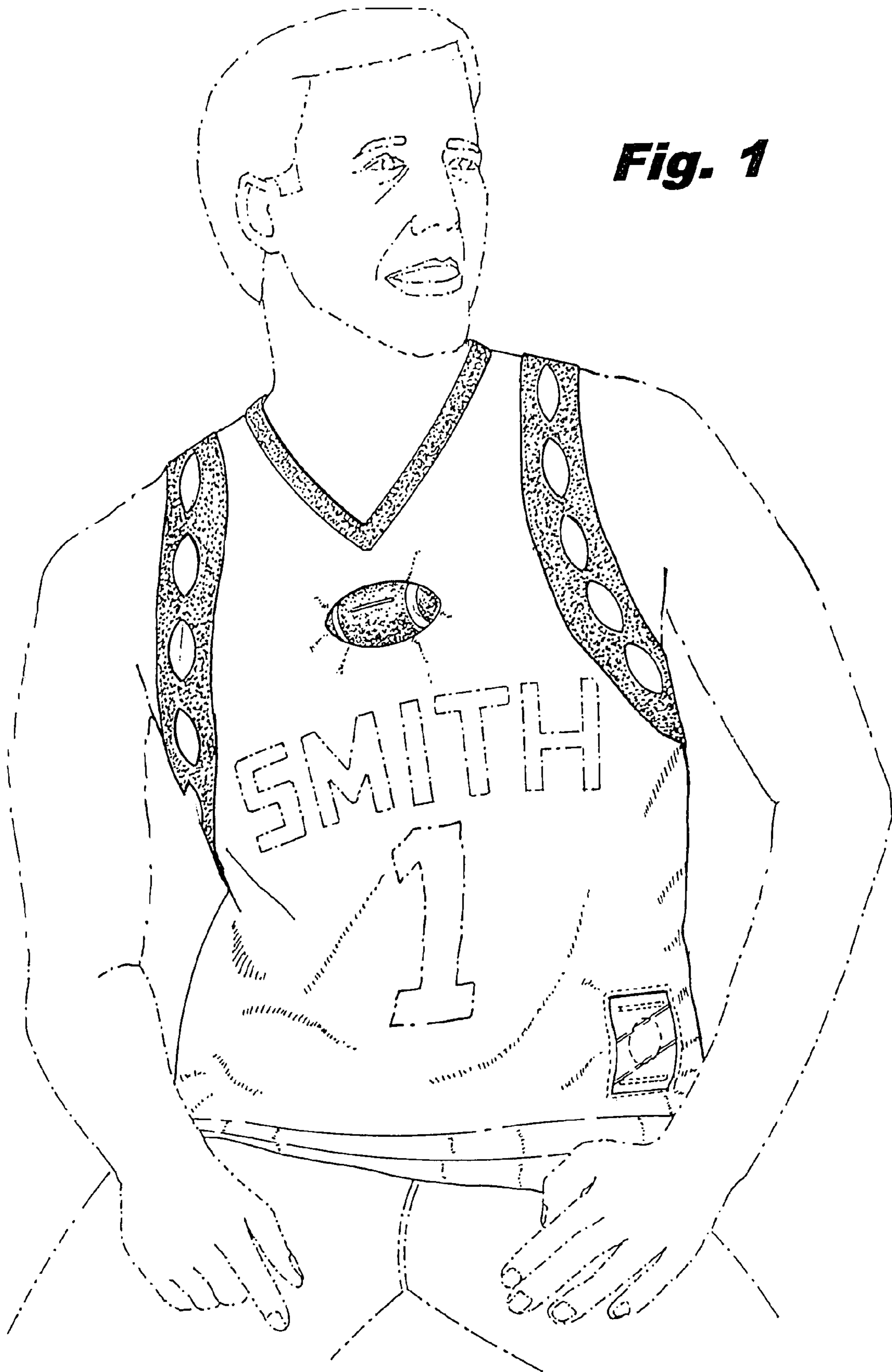

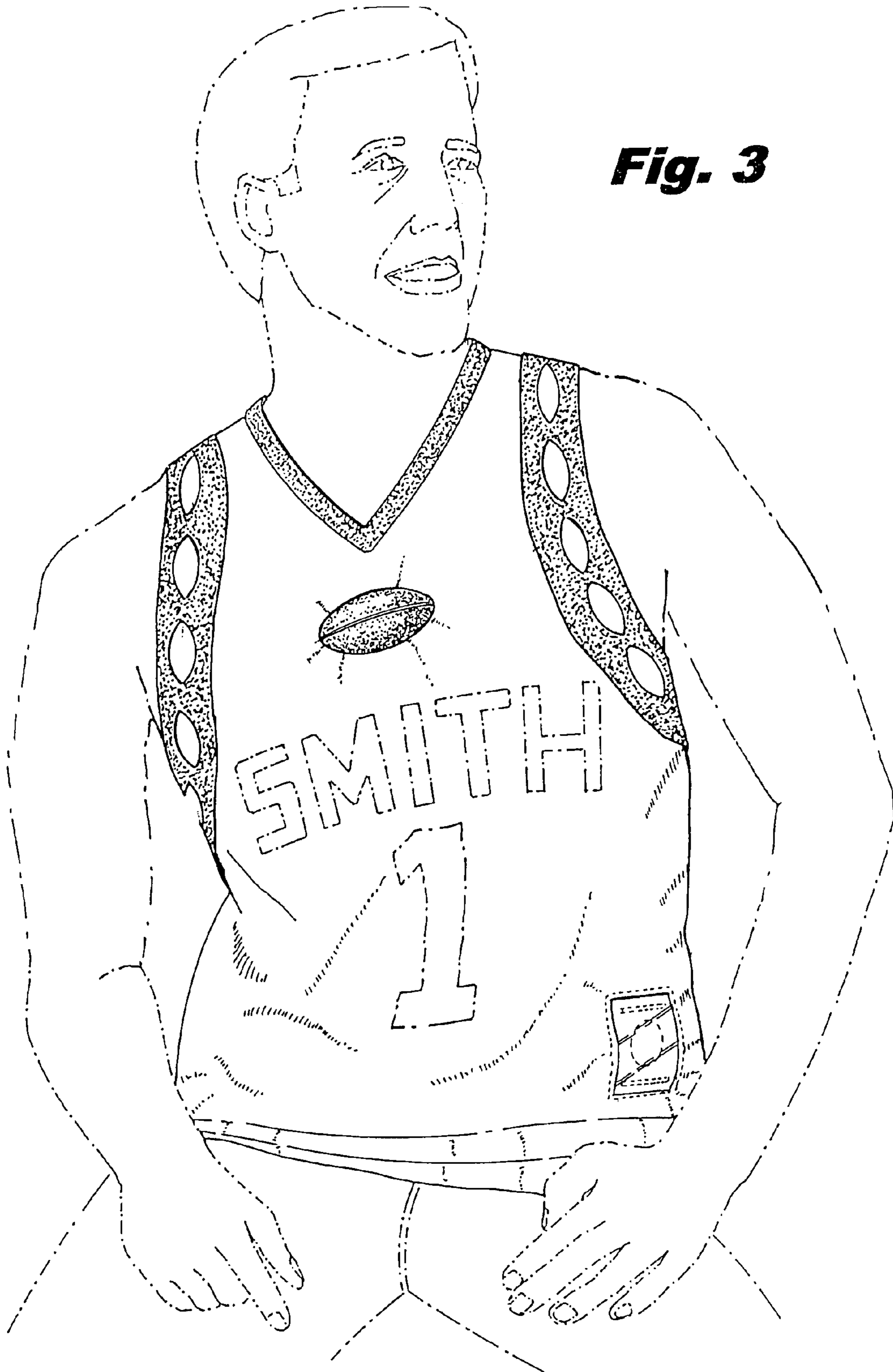
