The ornamental design for a outsole for a golf shoe, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a outsole for a golf shoe showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

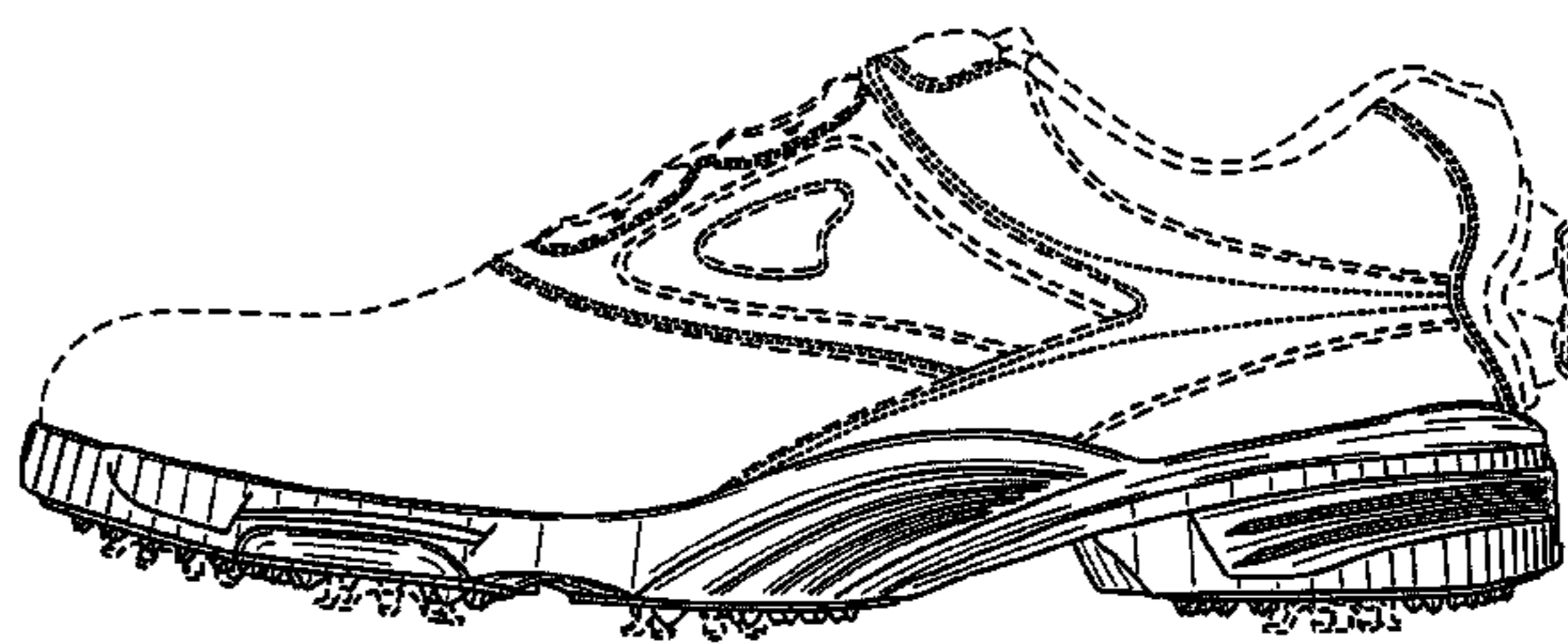
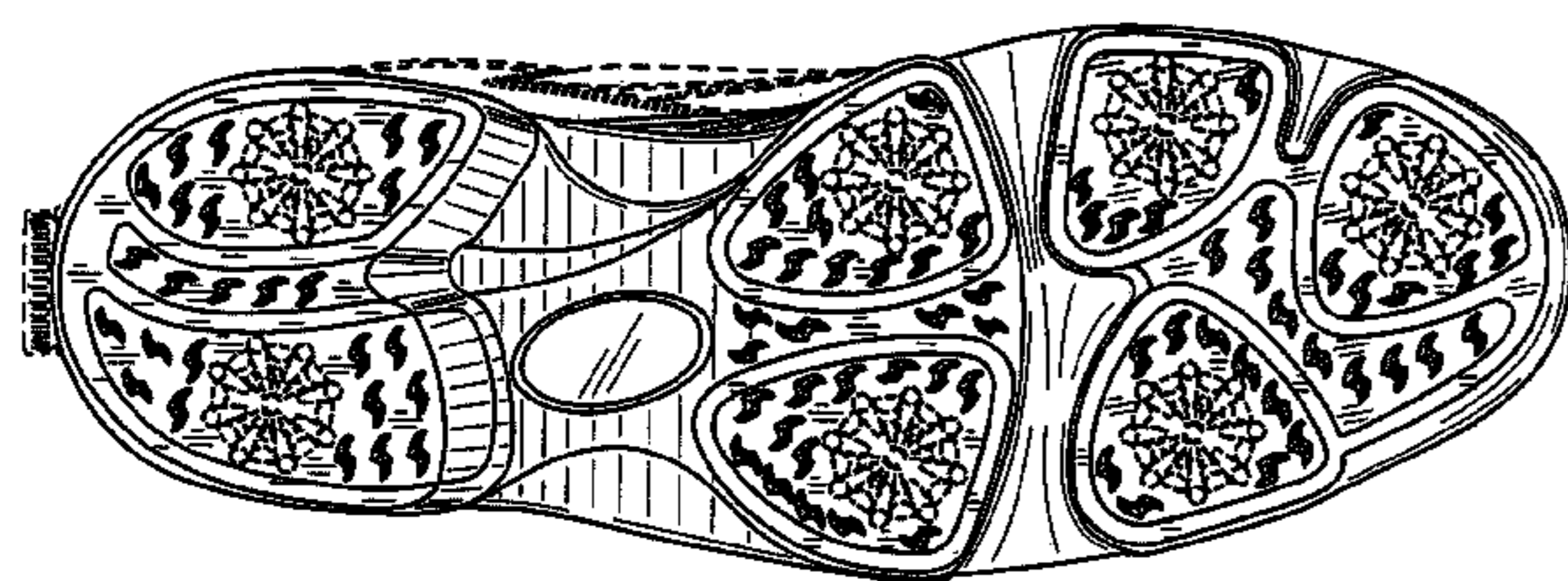
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

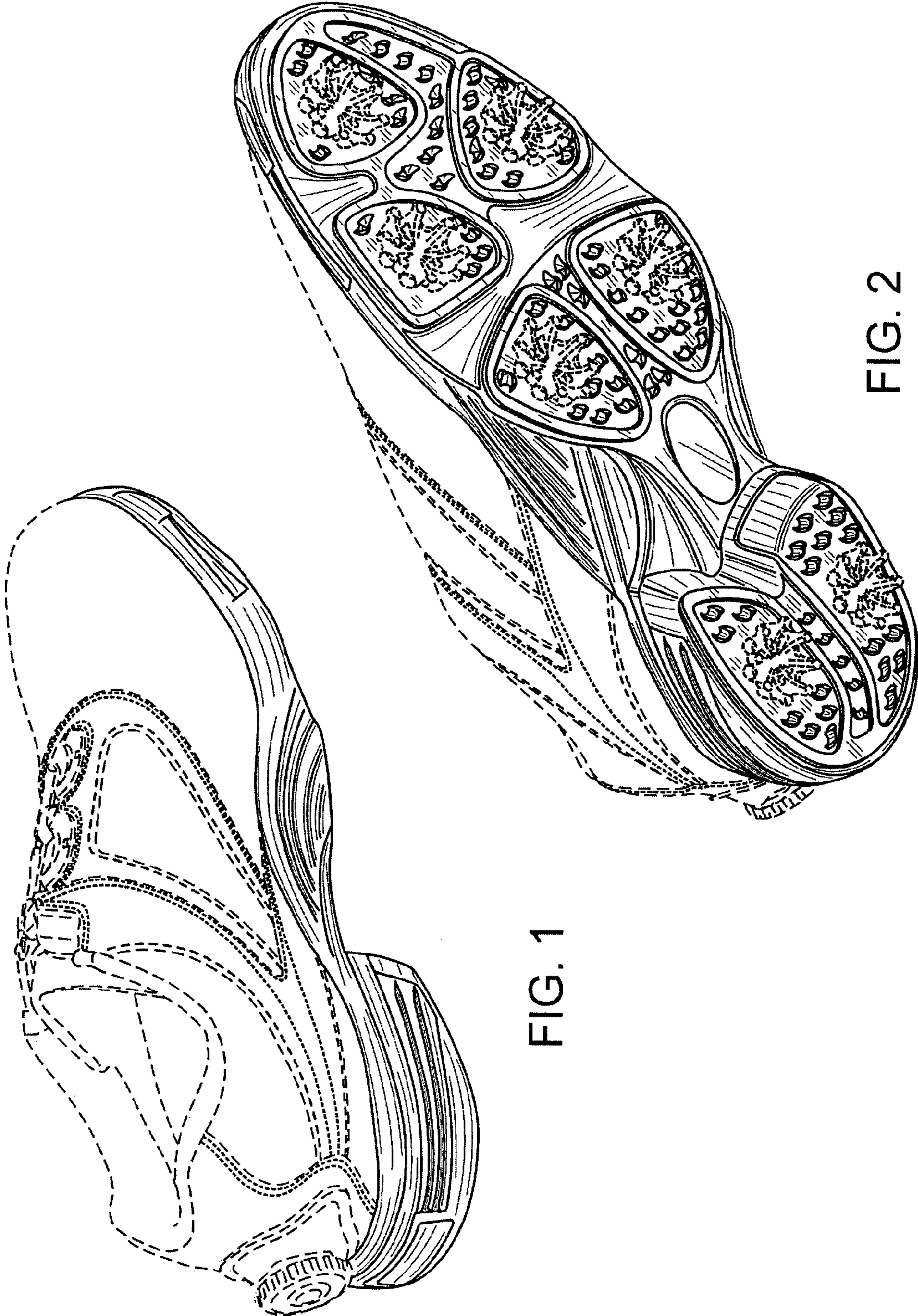

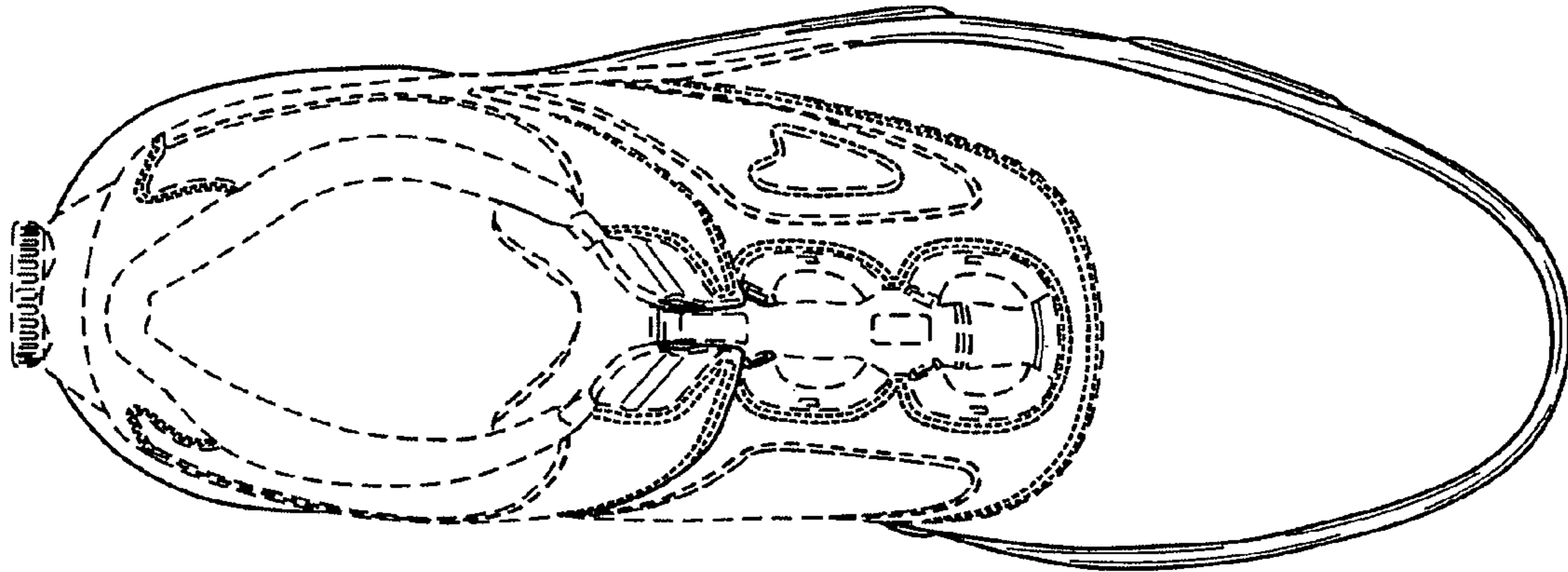

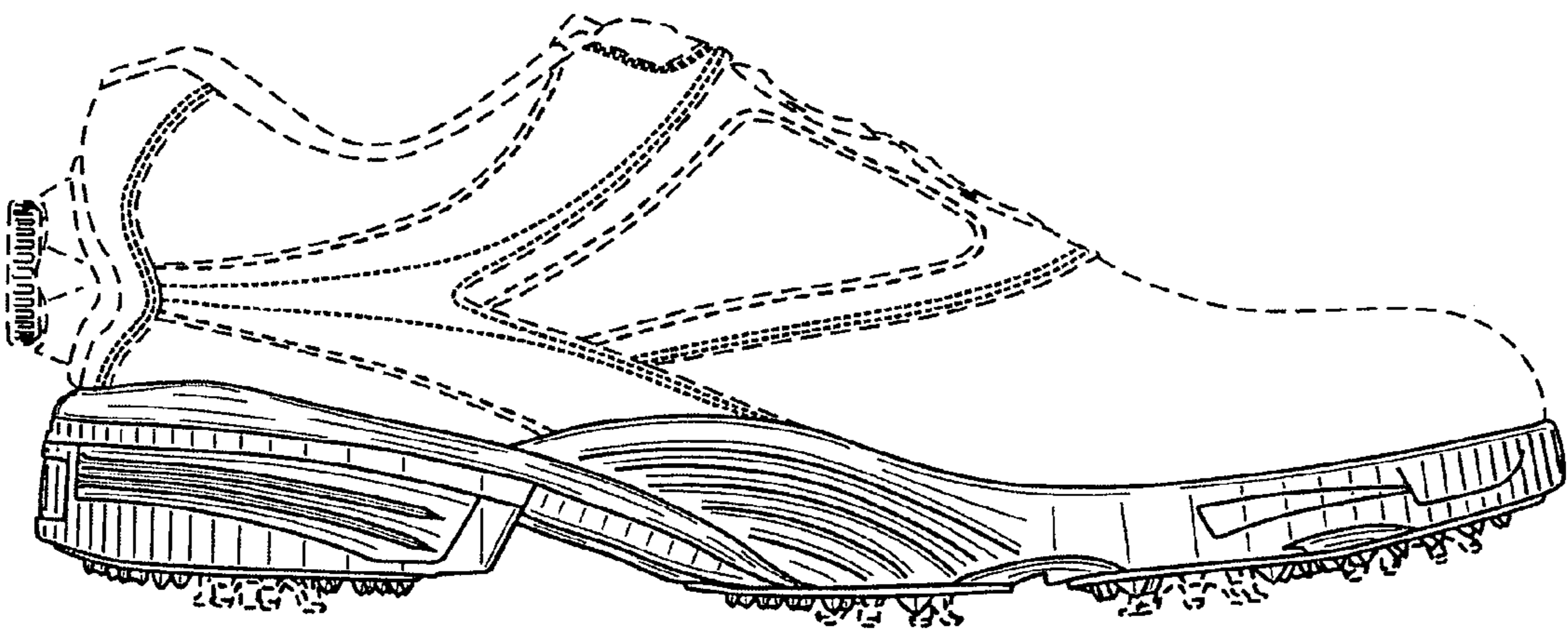

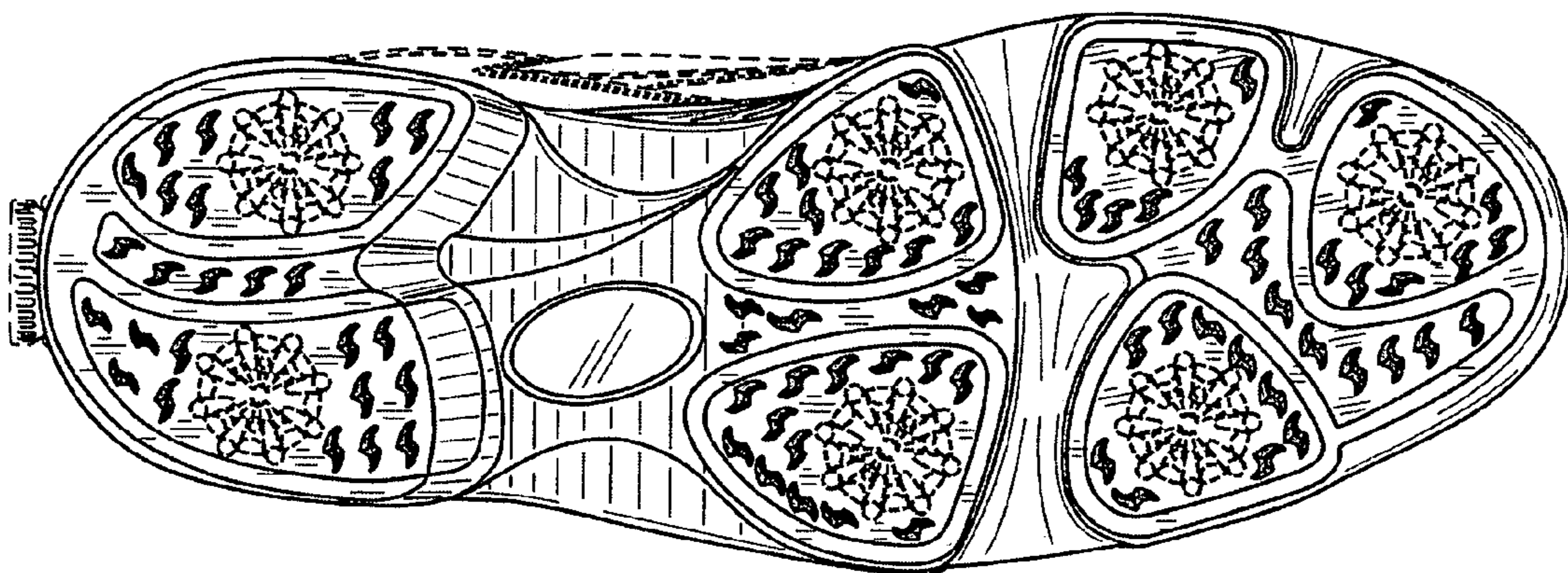

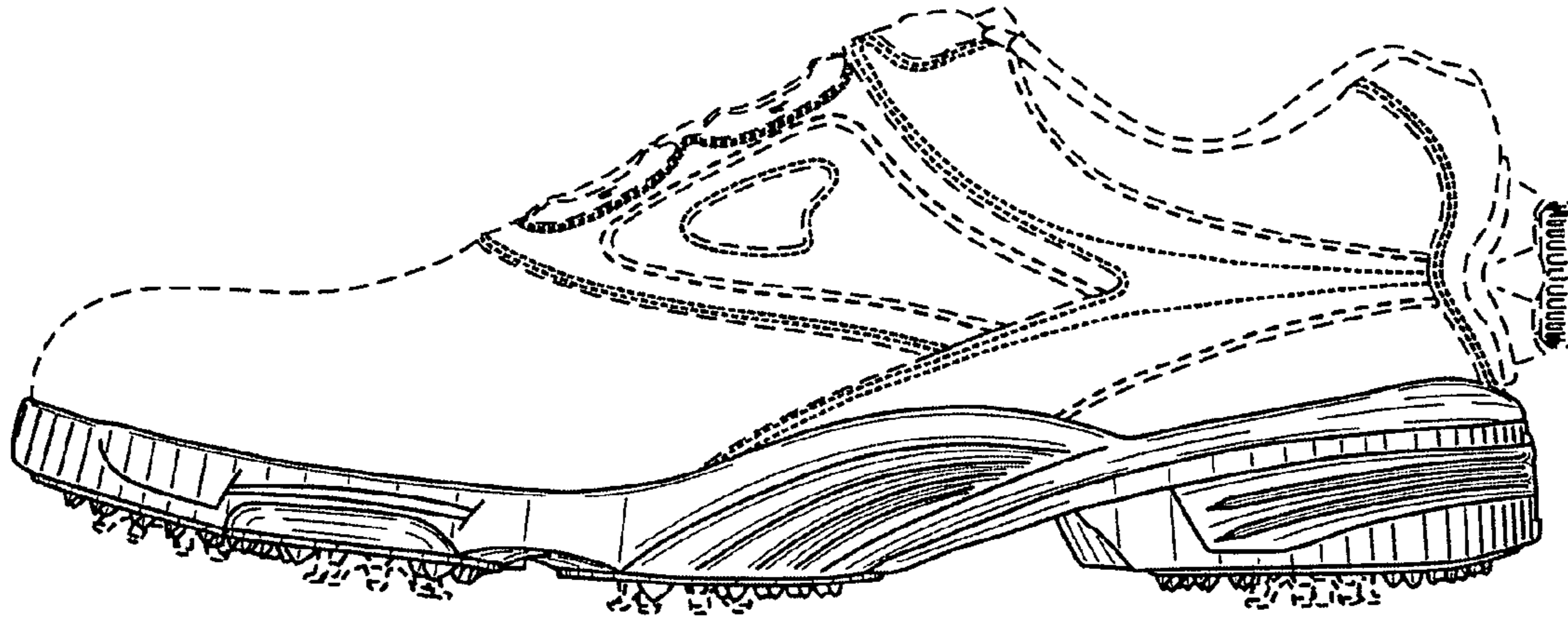

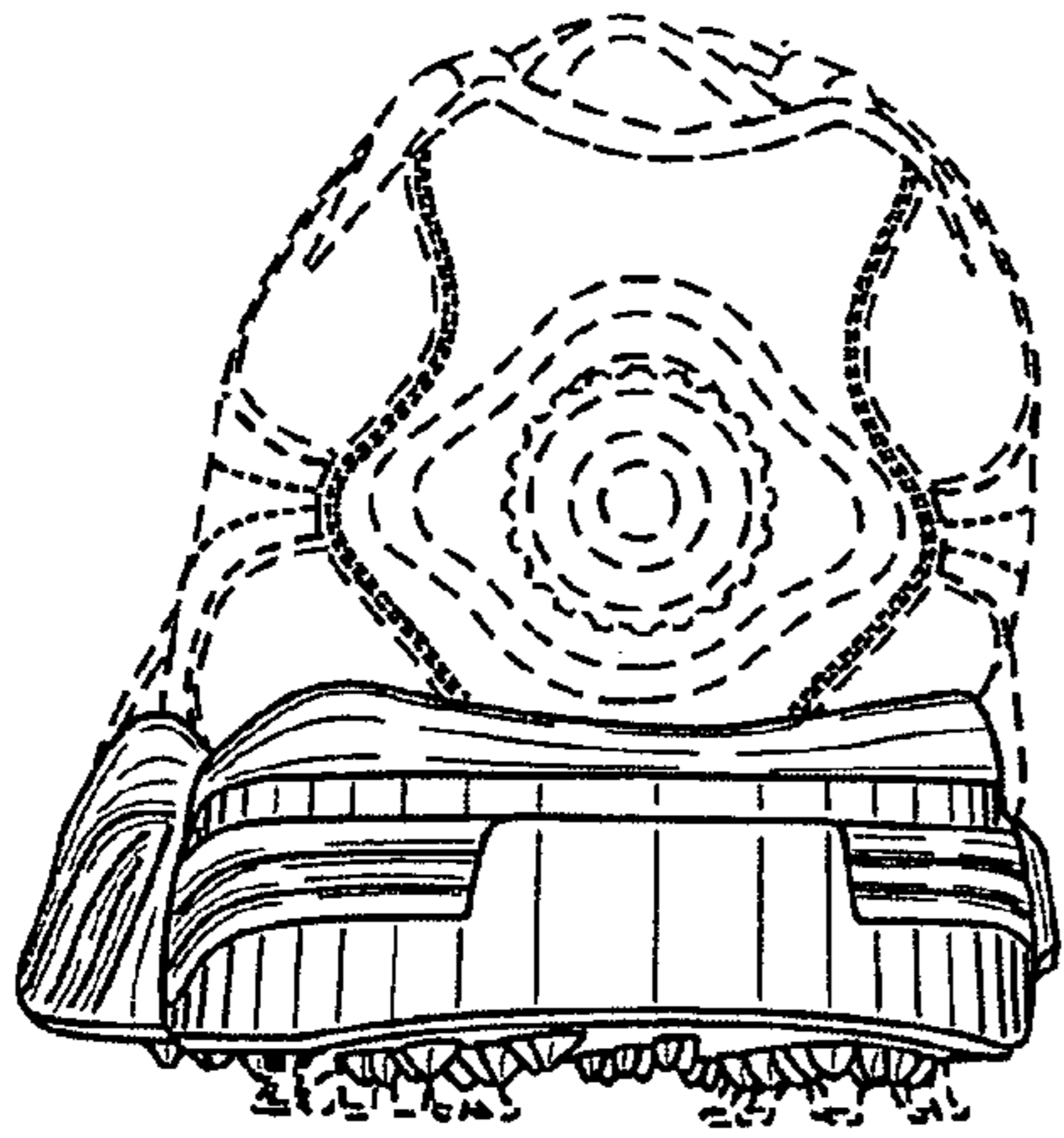

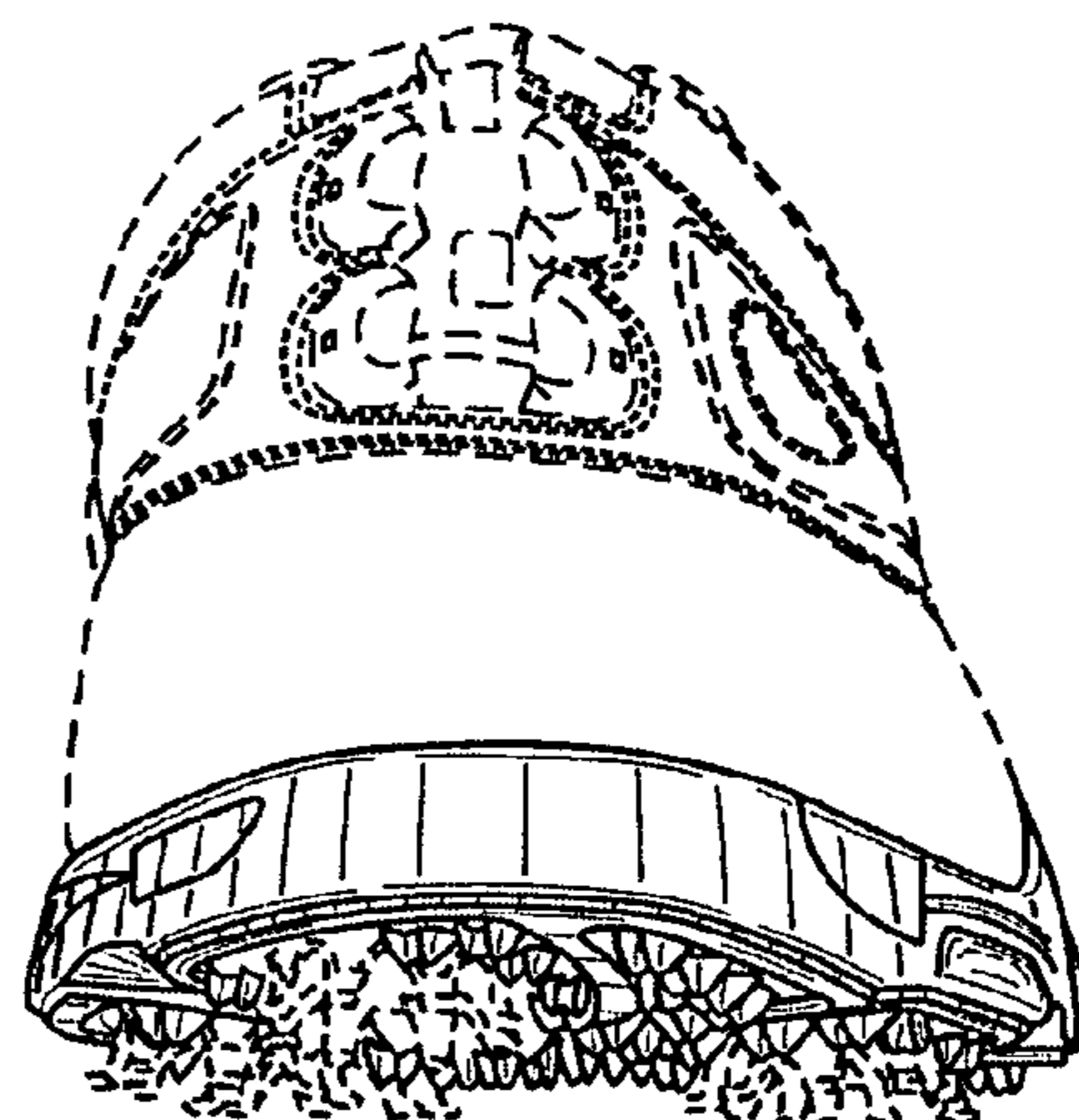
