FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.

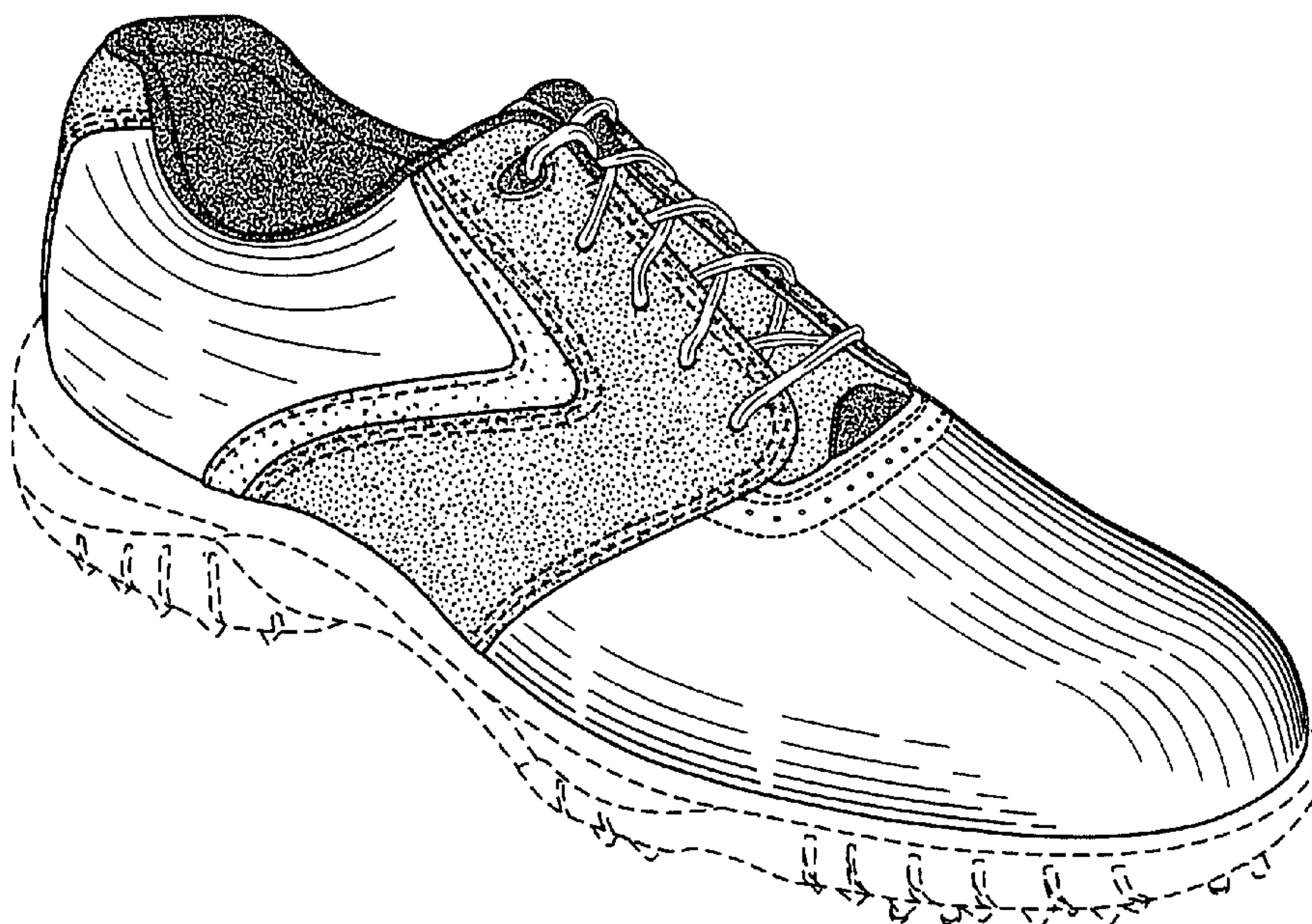
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

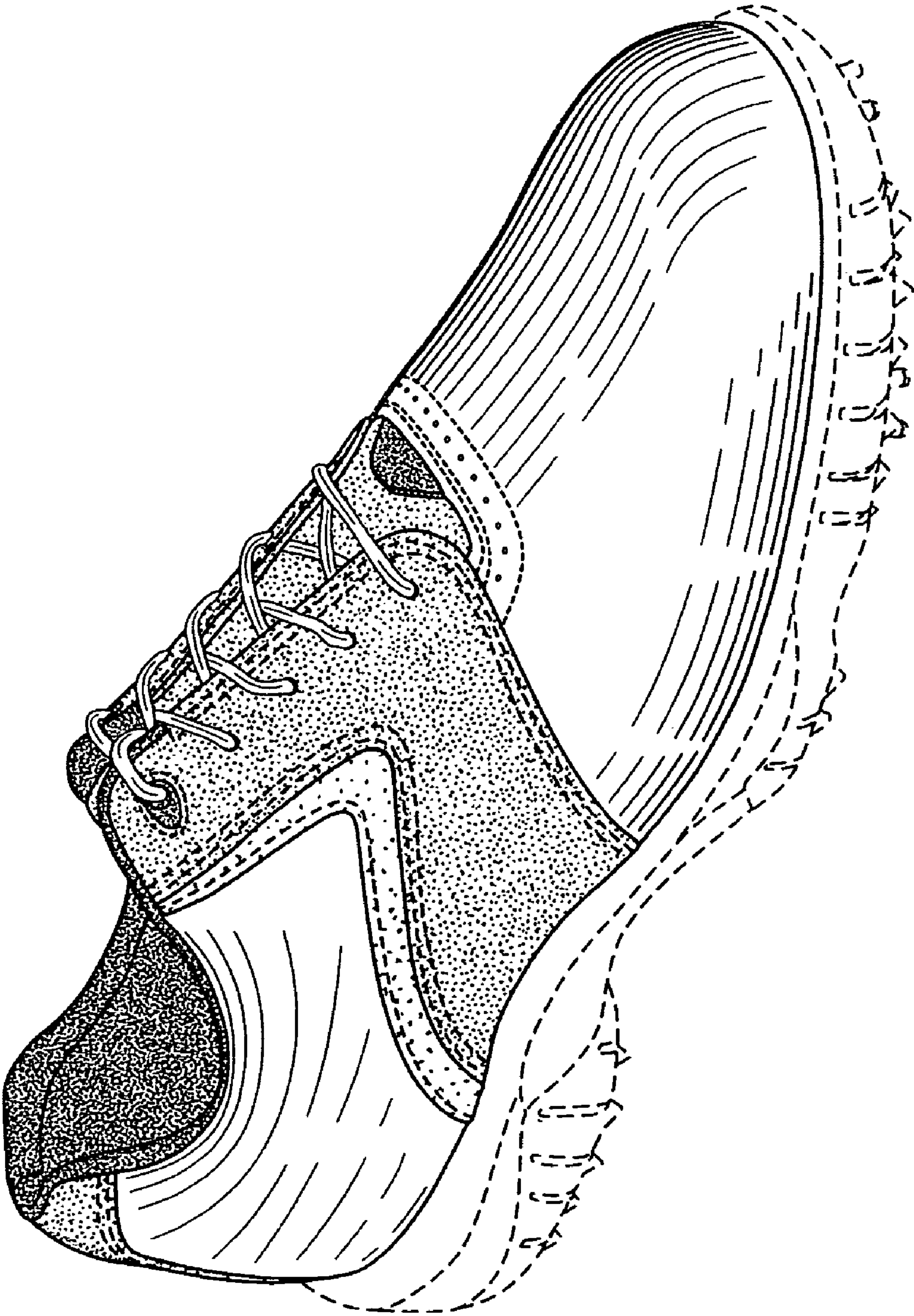

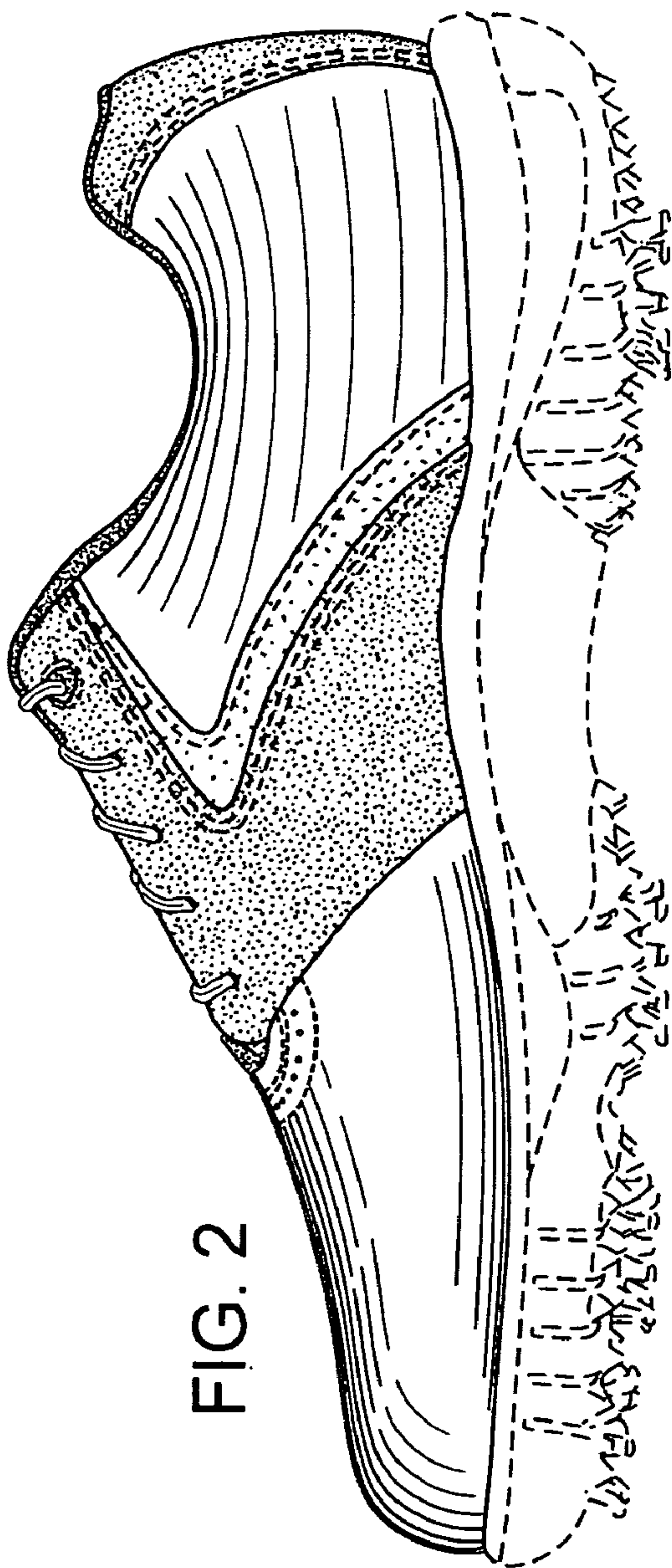

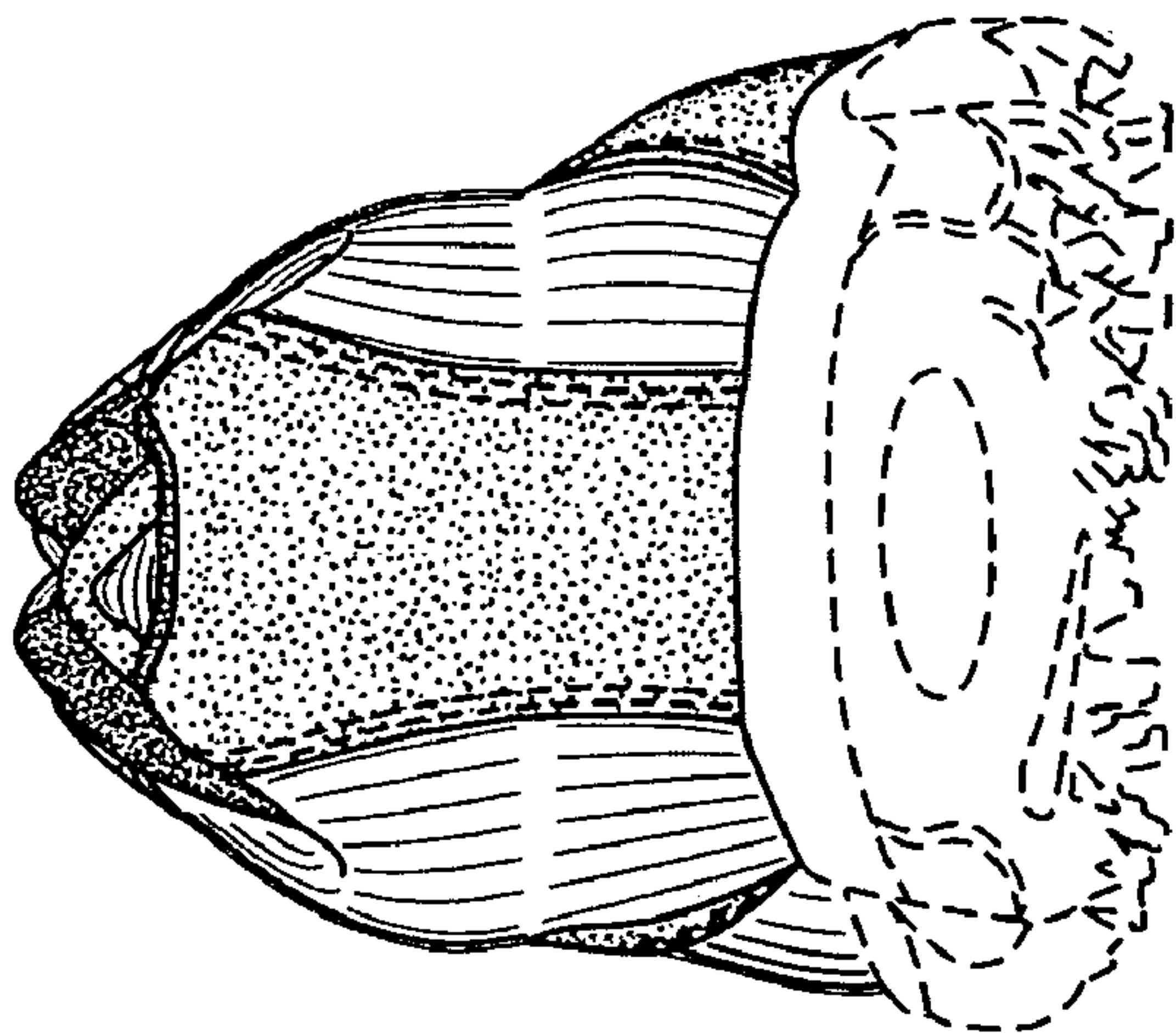

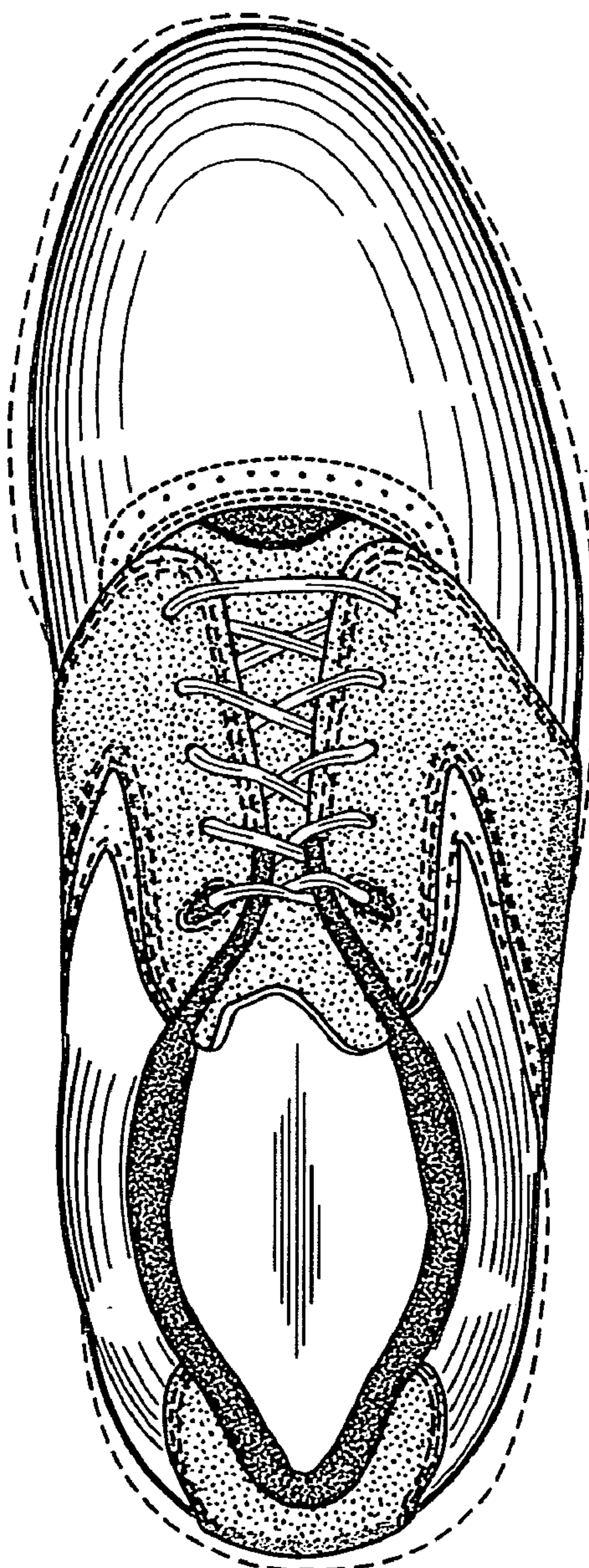

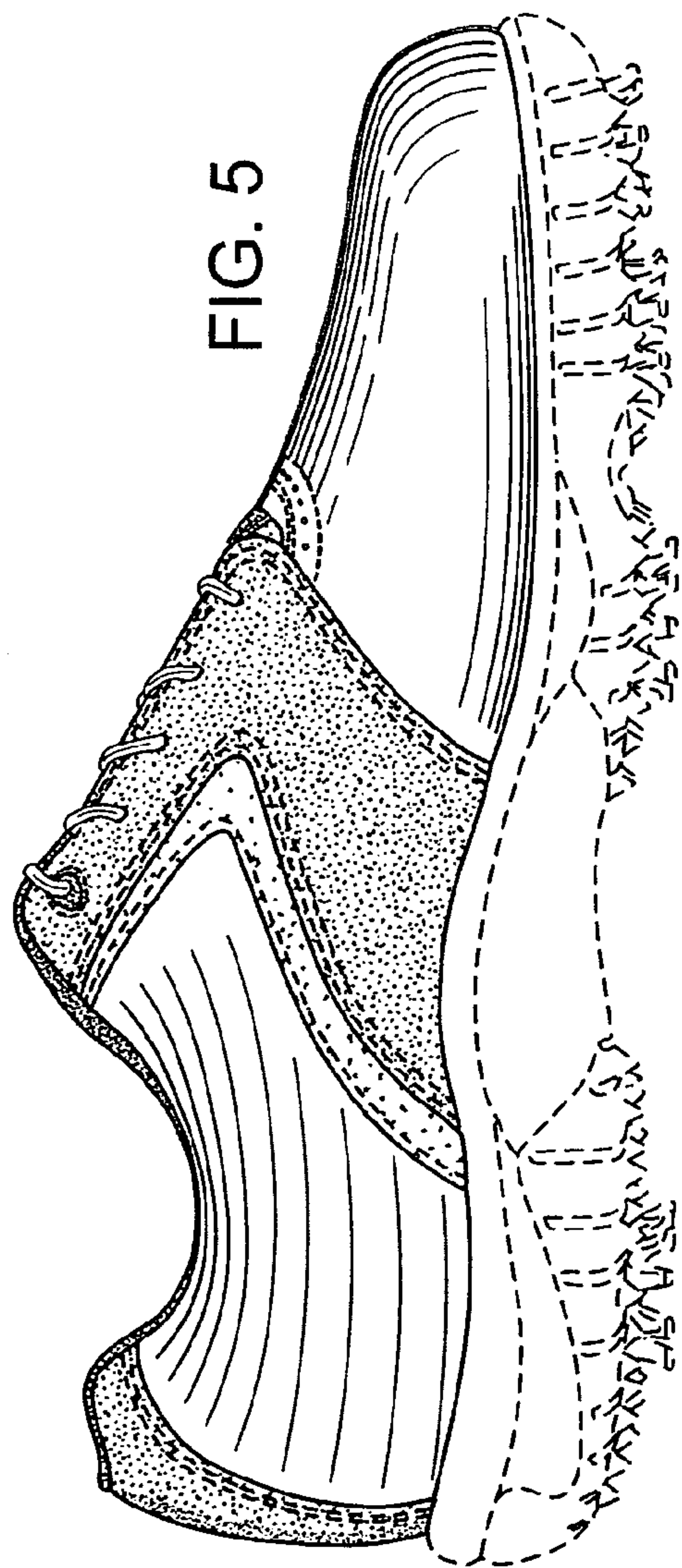

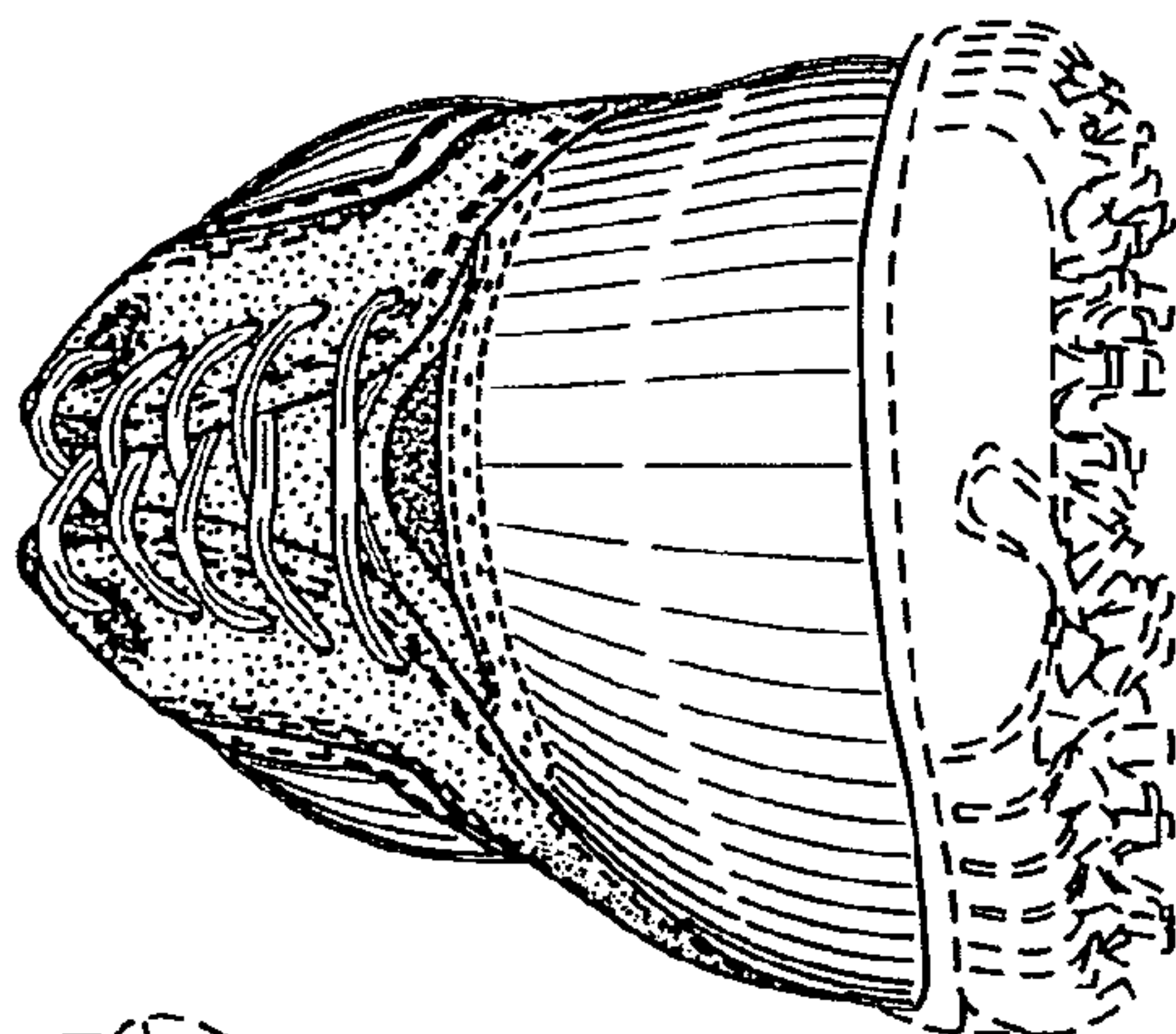

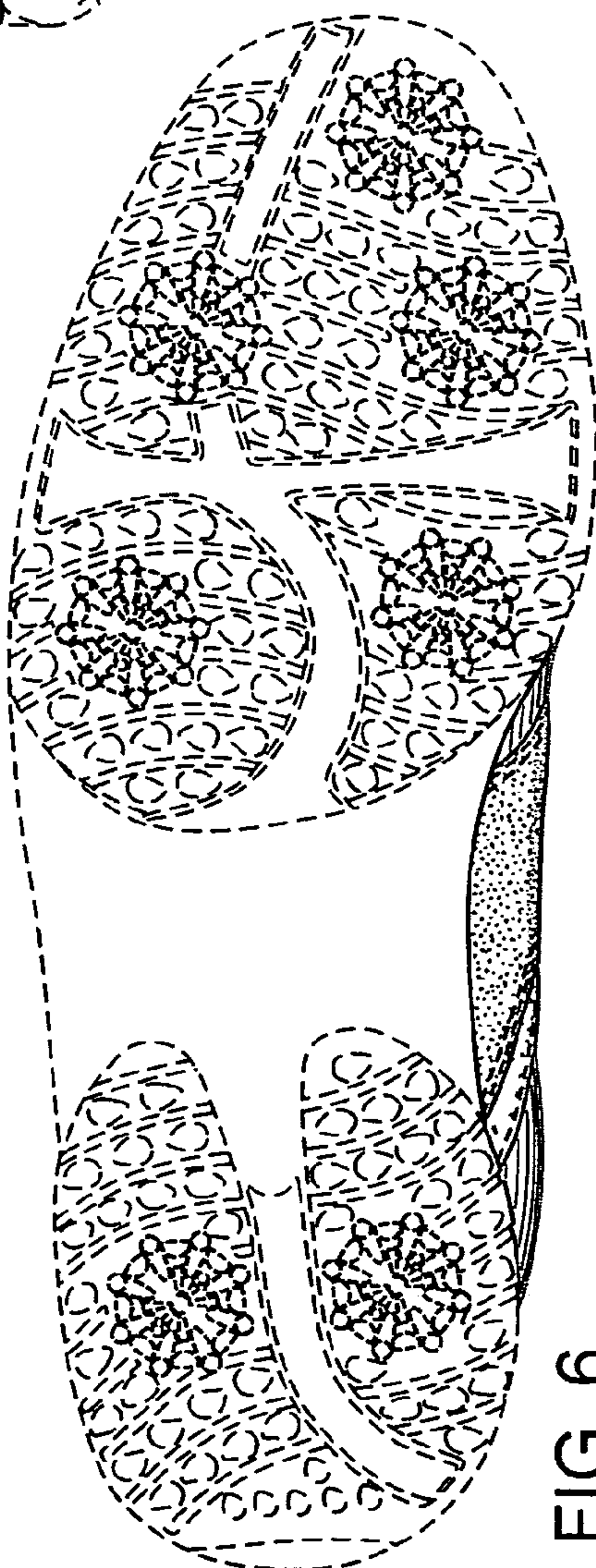
