FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the flat-top combination dresser according to my claimed design; the drawers, door, drawer pulls and door pulls are not part of the claimed design and are shown in phantom;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

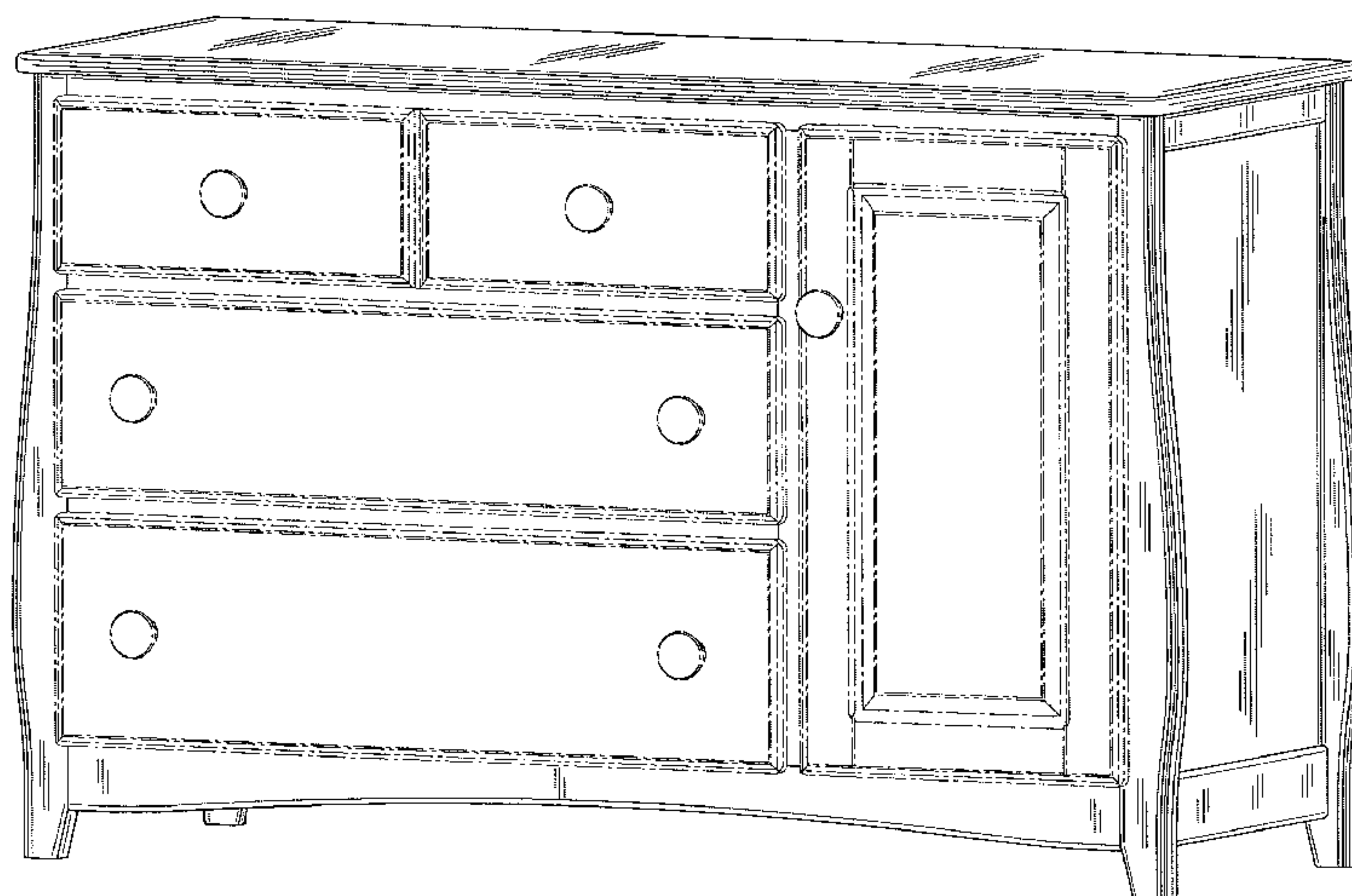
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;

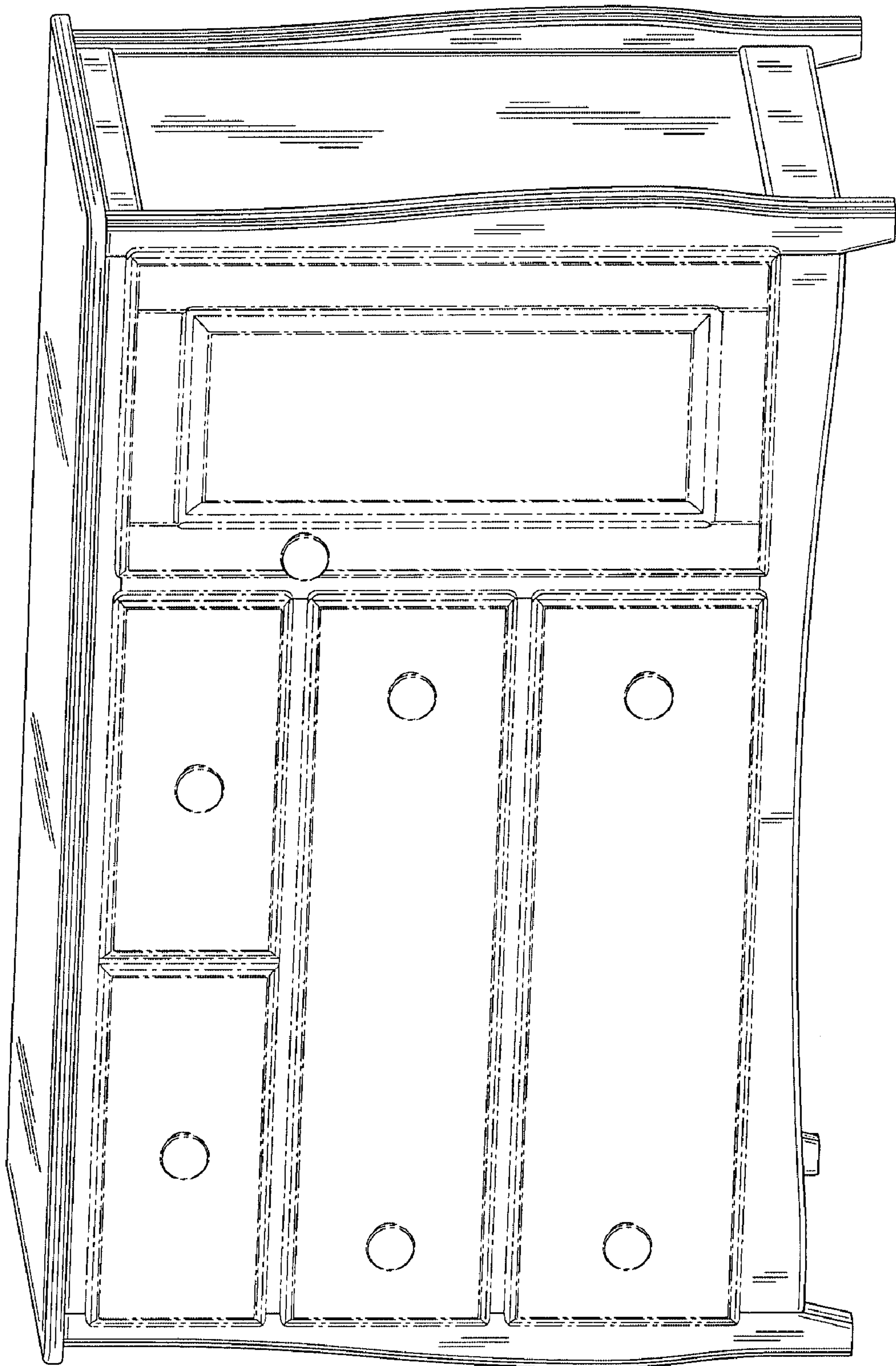

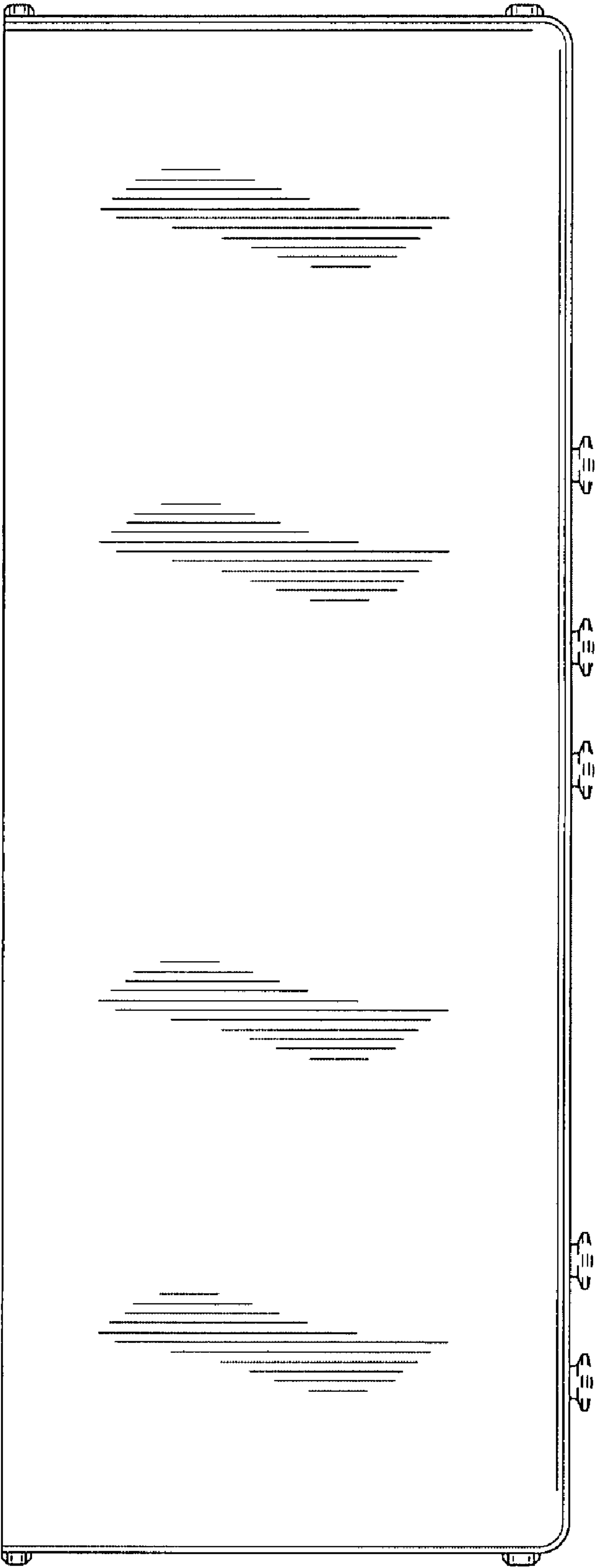

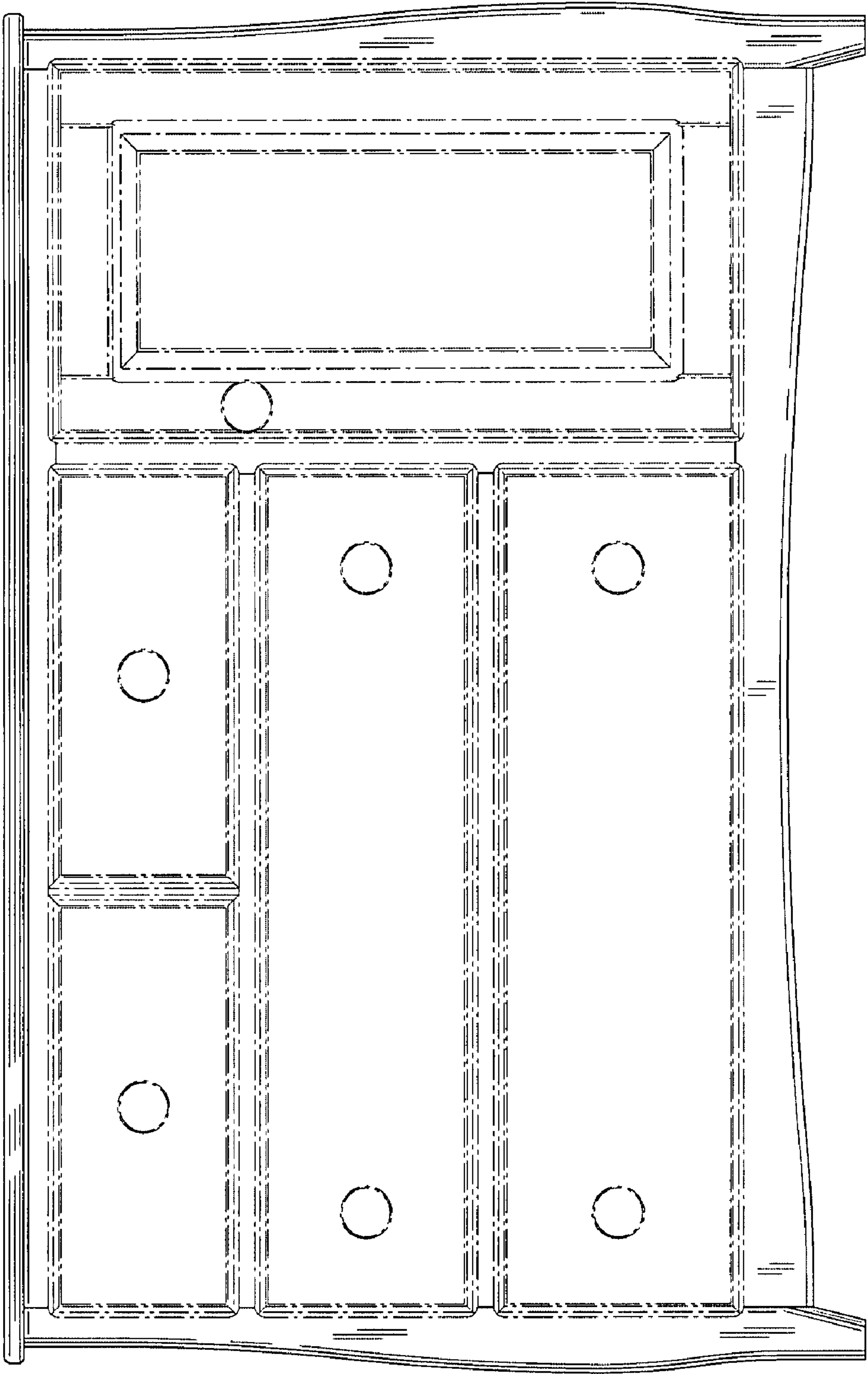

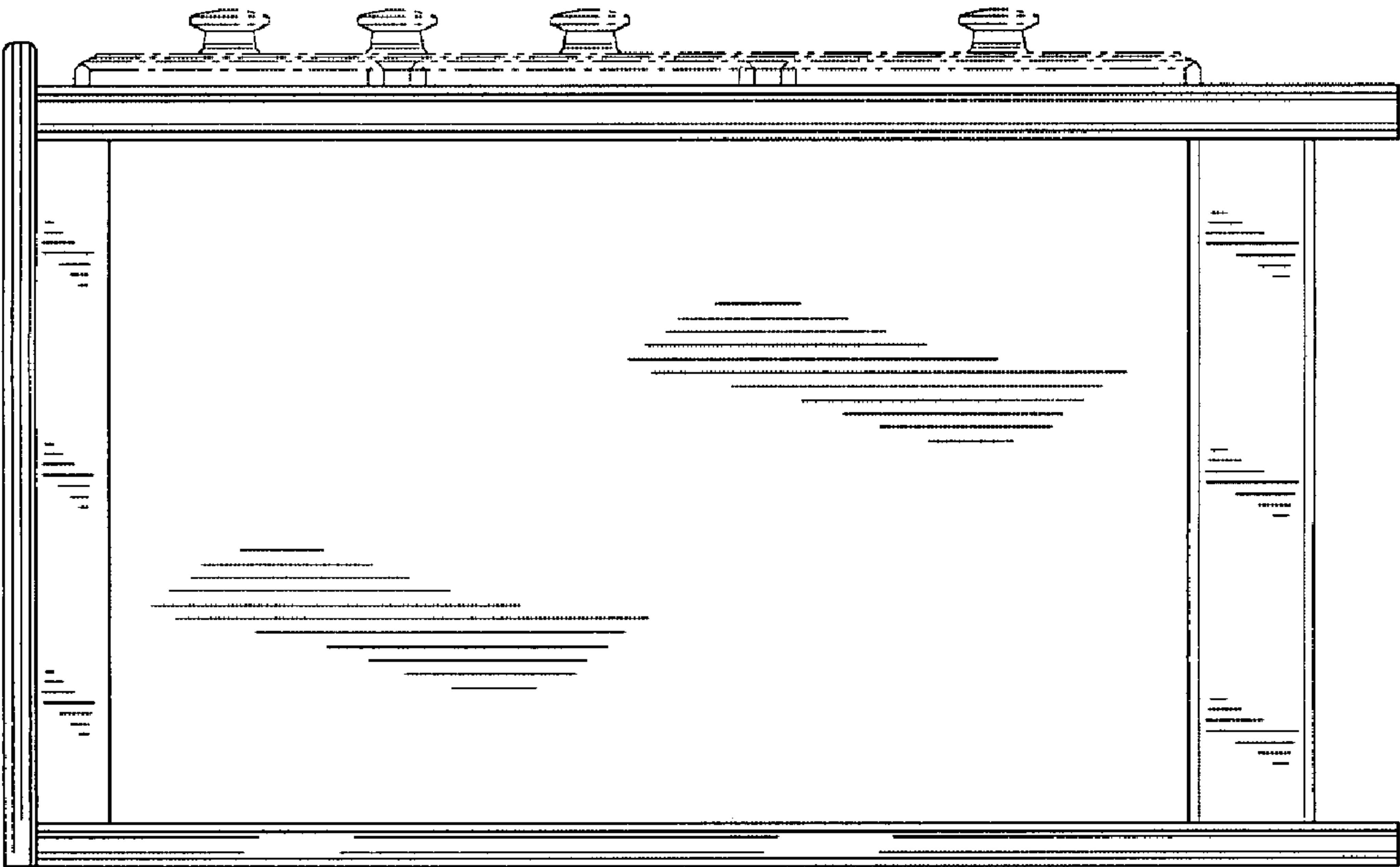
