FIG. 4 is a left side view of the design of FIG. 1;

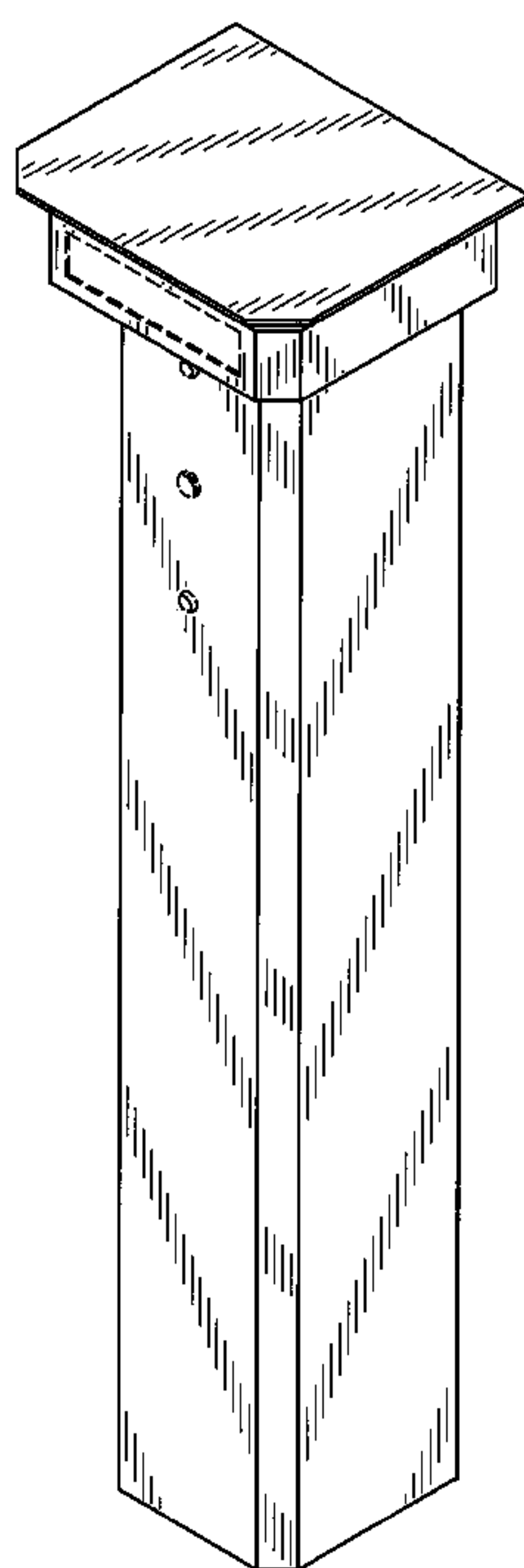
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the design of FIG. 1;

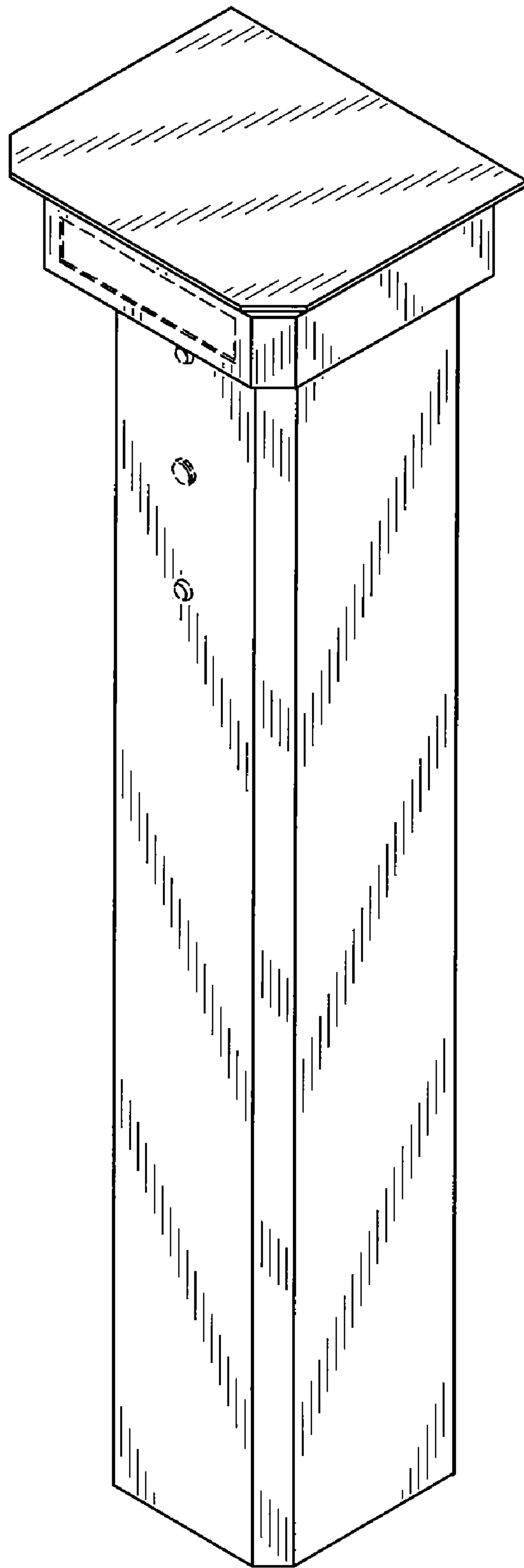

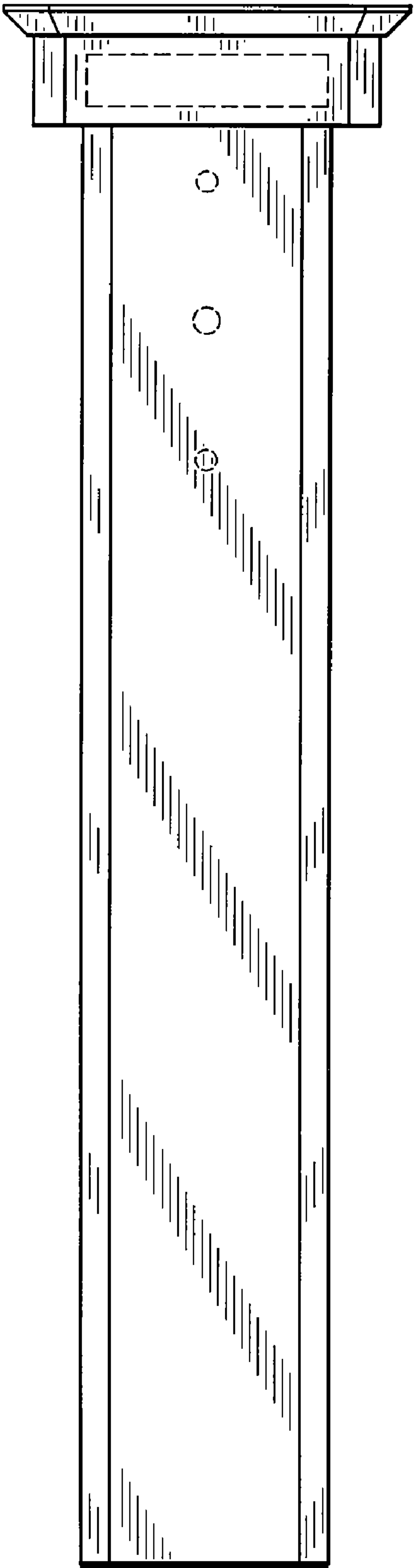

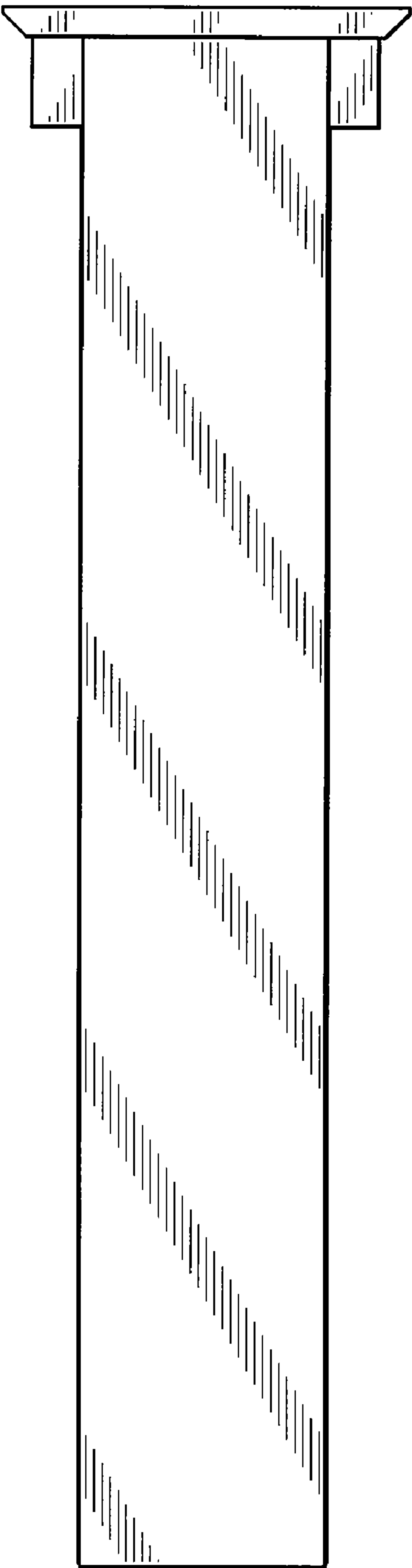

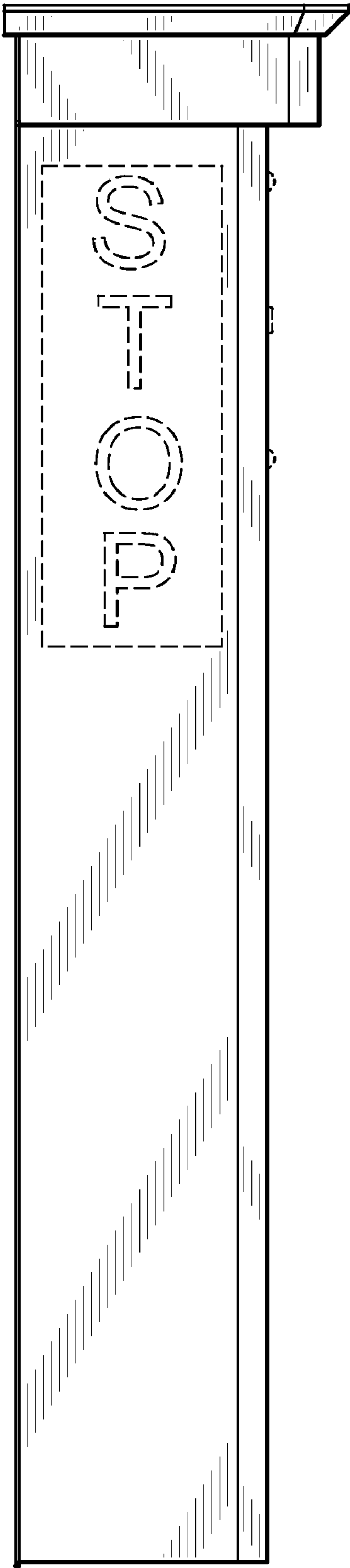

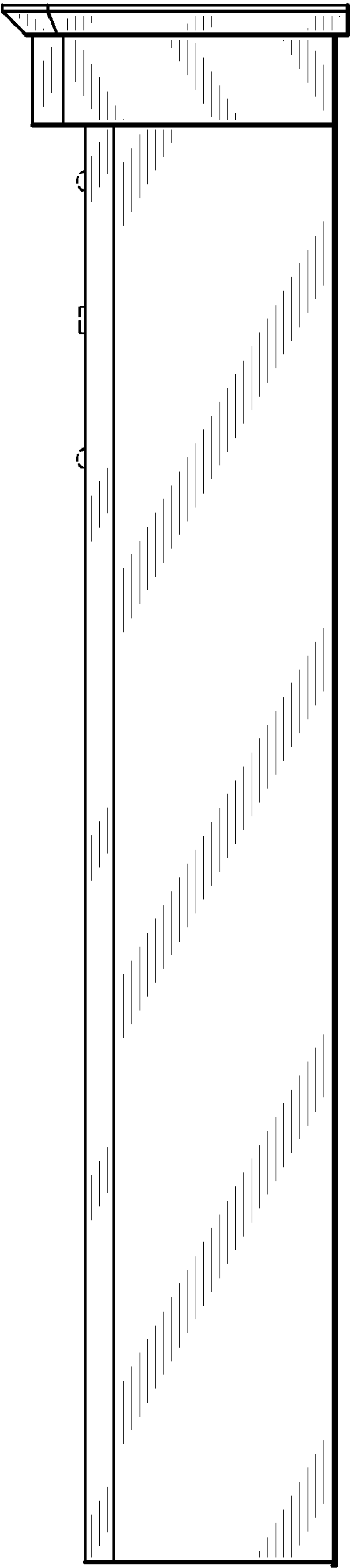

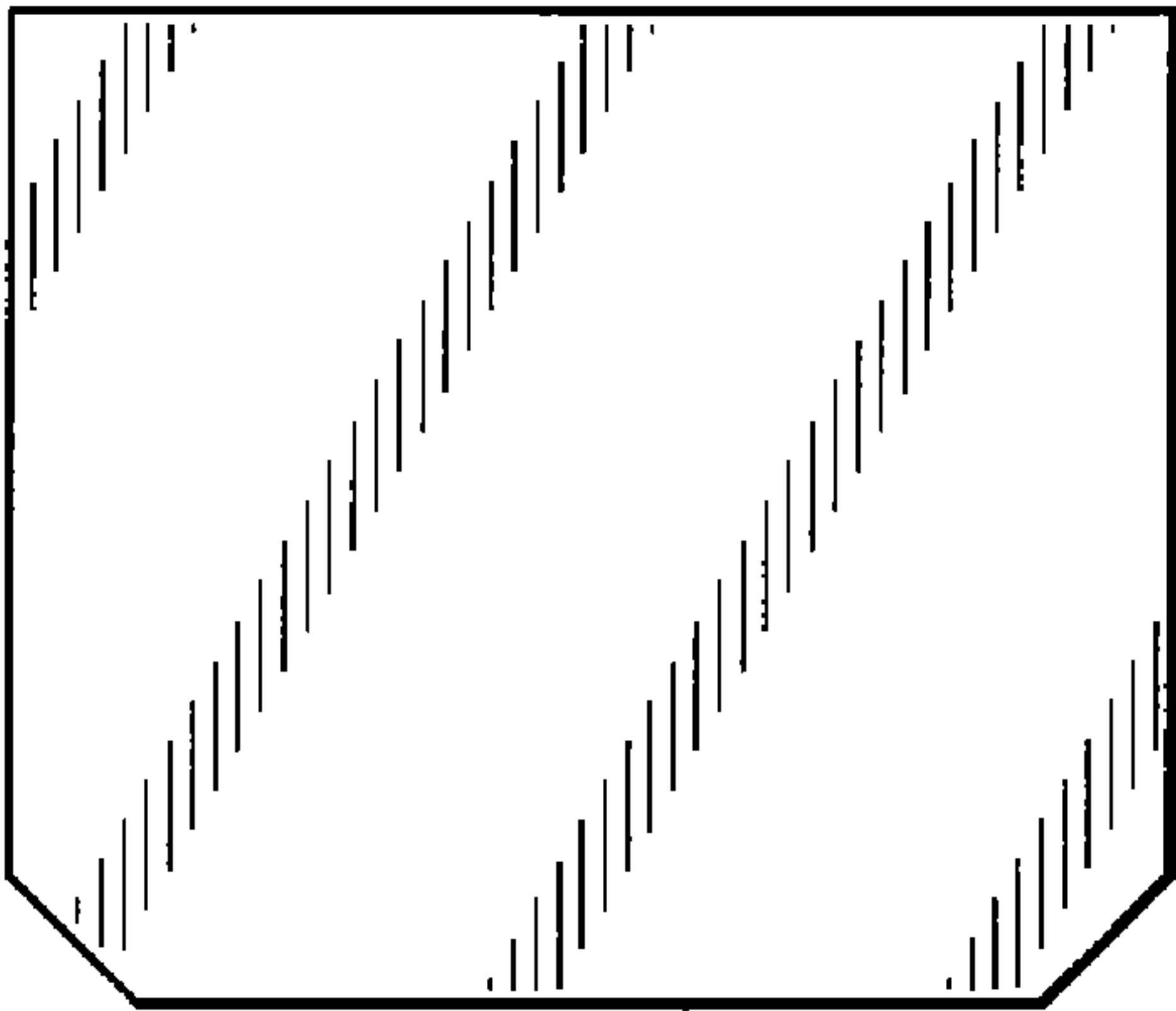

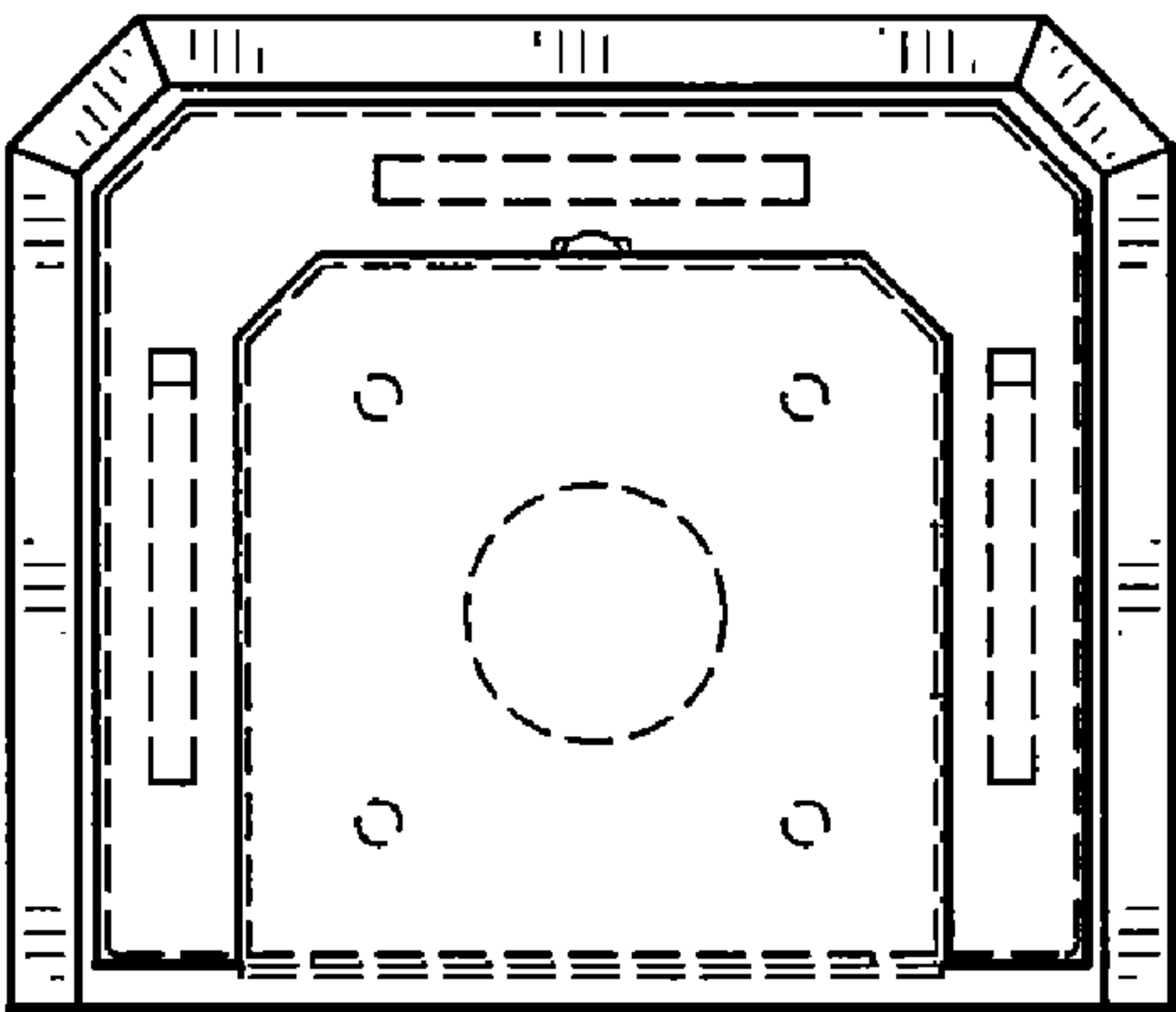
