I claim the ornamental design for tactical knife, as shown and described.

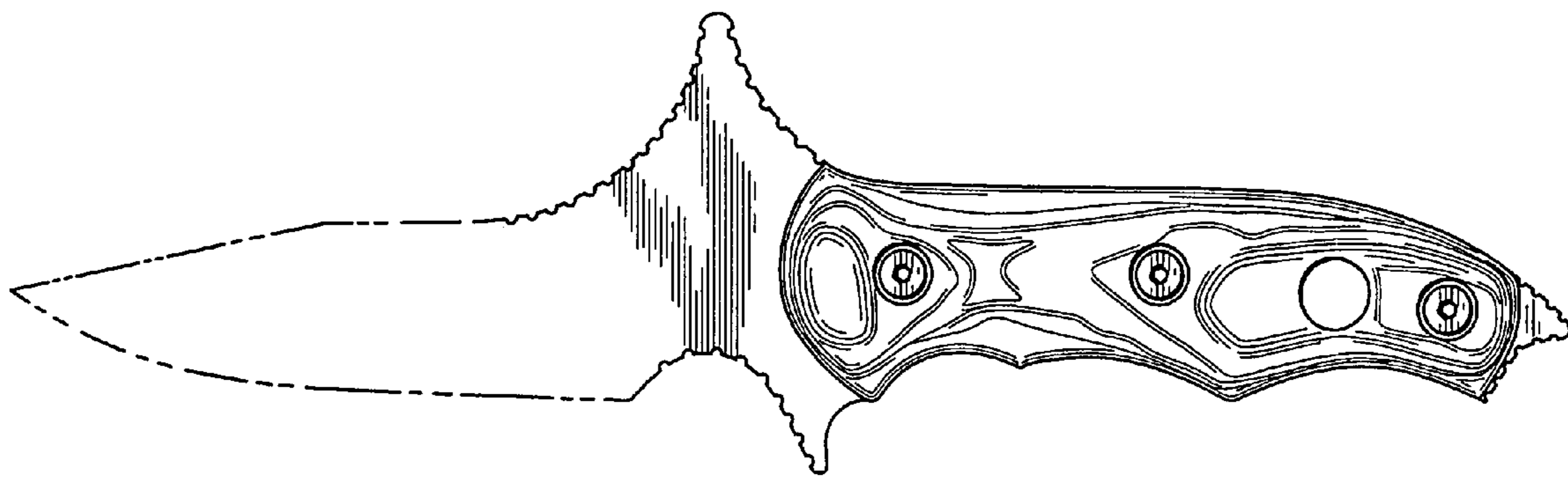
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a first embodiment of the invention; FIG. 2 is a rear view of the invention of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a top view of the invention of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the invention of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a left side view of the invention of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a right side view of the invention of FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is a front view of a second embodiment of the invention; FIG. 8 is a rear view of the invention of FIG. 7; FIG. 9 is a top view of the invention of FIG. 7; FIG. 10 is a bottom view of the invention of FIG. 7; FIG. 11 is a left side view of the invention of FIG. 7; and, FIG. 12 is a right side view of the invention of FIG. 7.

In FIGS. 1-6, the design of the blade end of the knife portion shown by the phantom lines is disclaimed. The handle portion depicted in FIGS. 1-2 depicts a cut grain pattern typical of handles made from wood material or reinforced fiberglass linen mircarta material.

The handle portion depicted in FIGS. 7-12 depicts a cut grain pattern typical of handles made from wood material or reinforced fiberglass linen mircarta material.

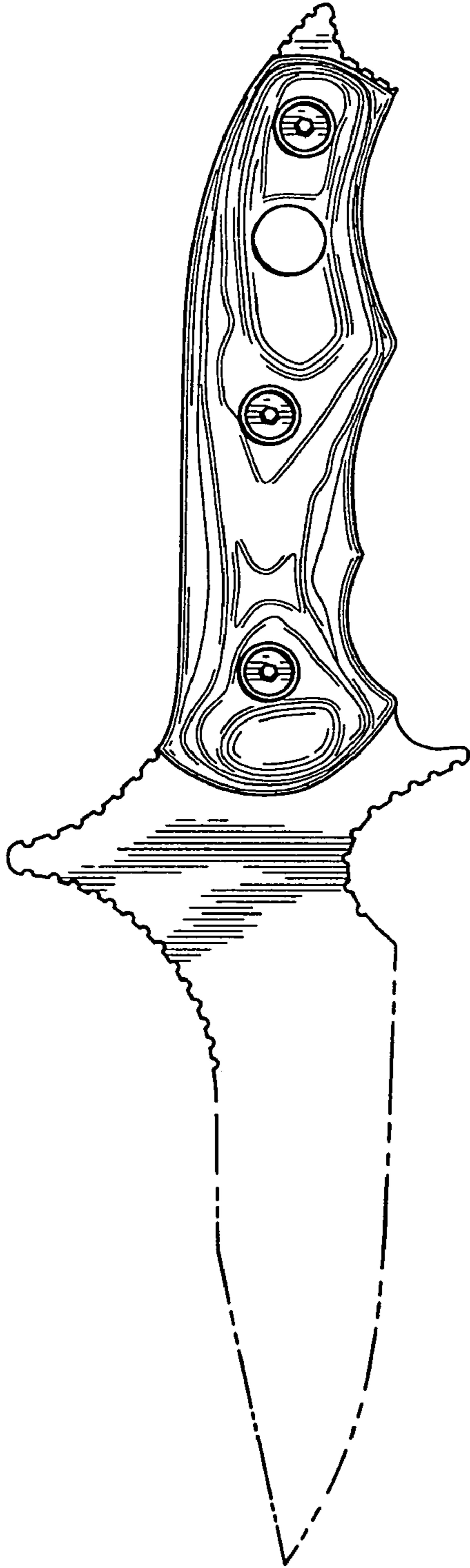

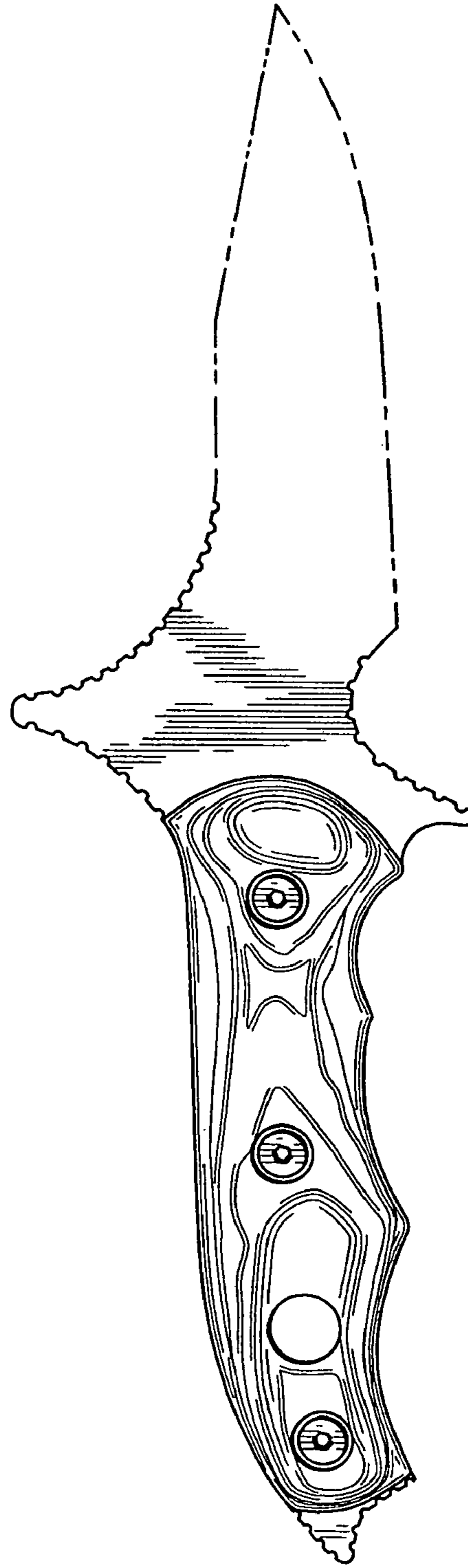

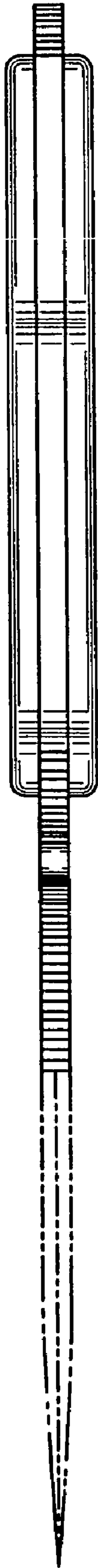

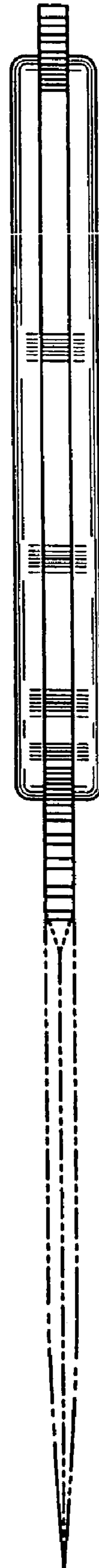

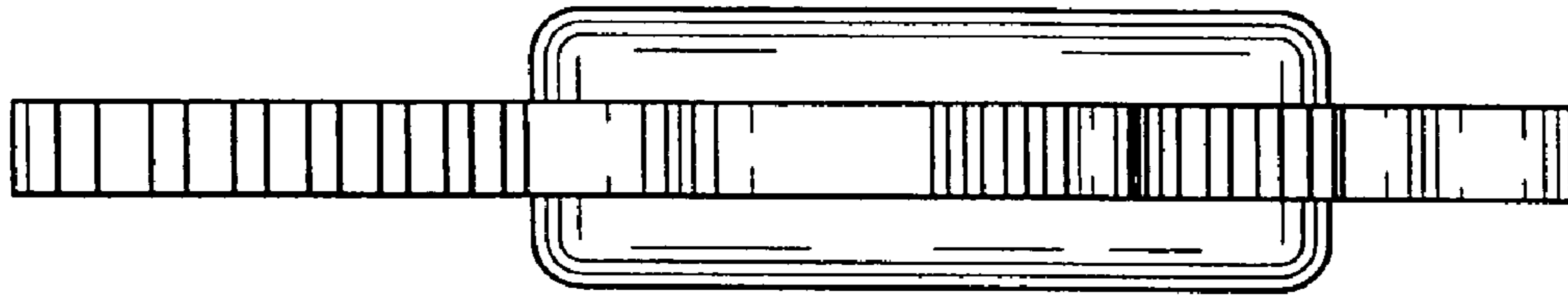

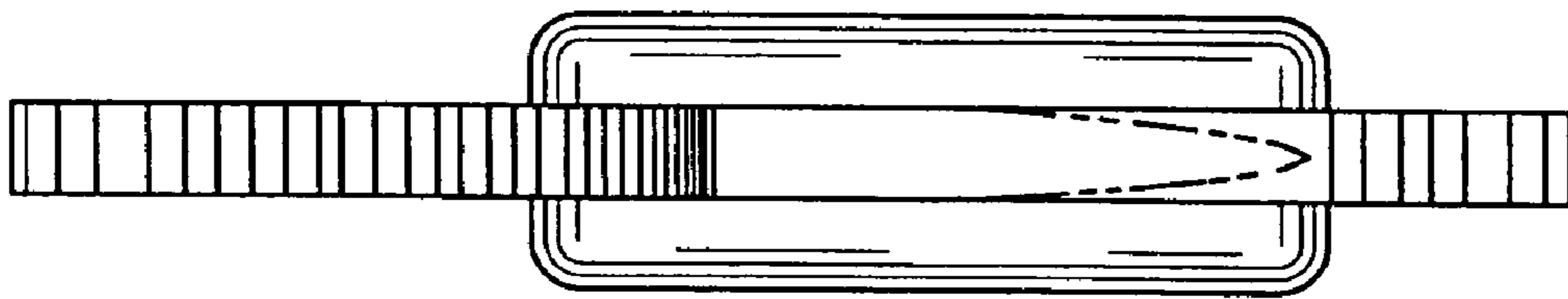

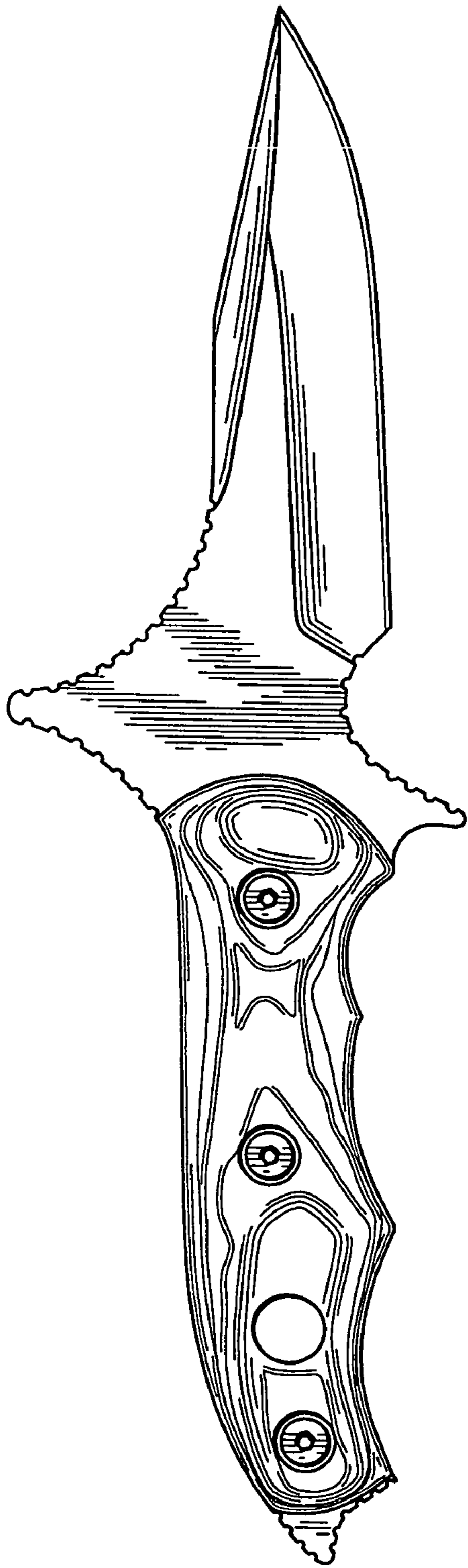

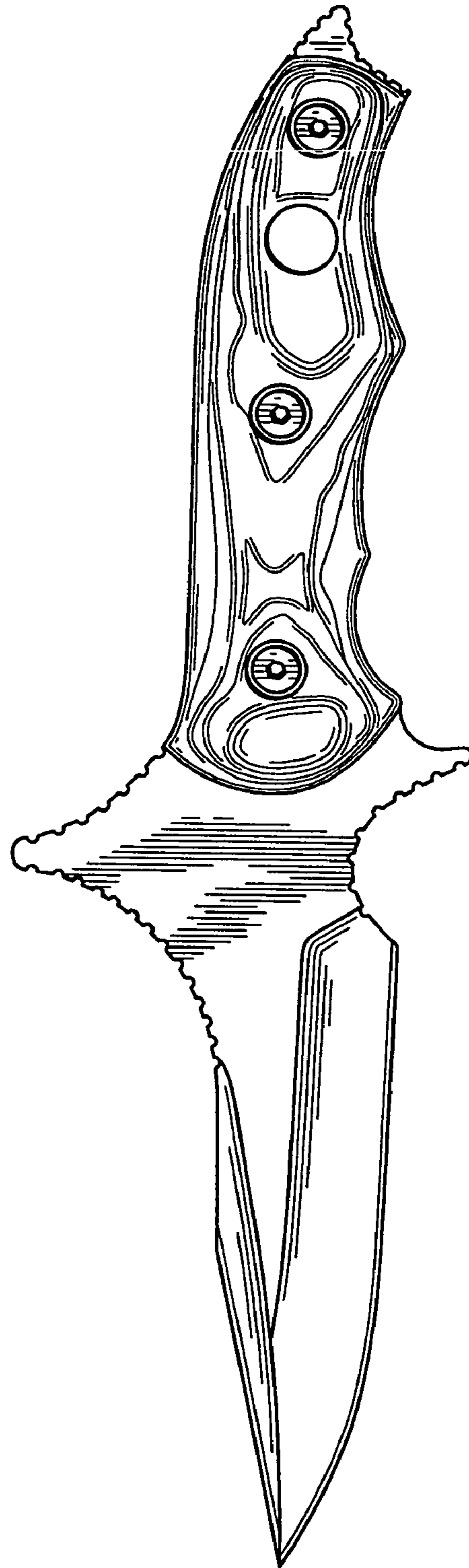

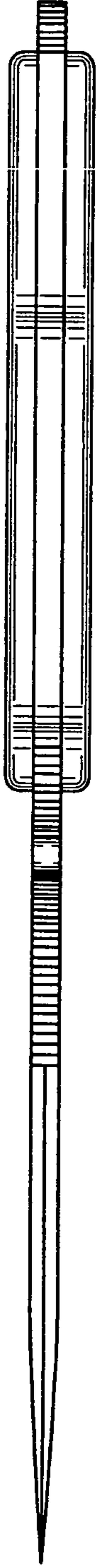

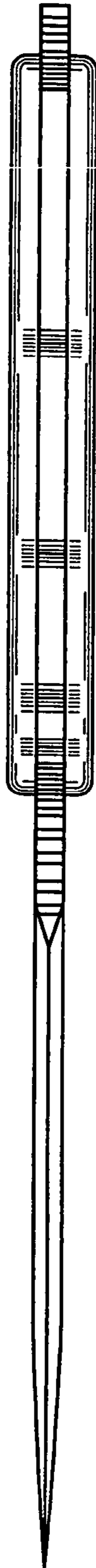

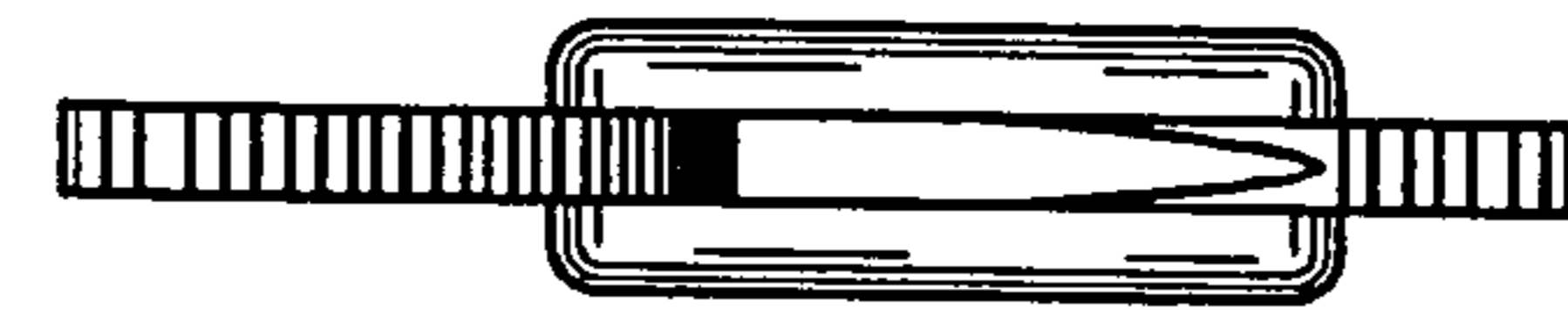

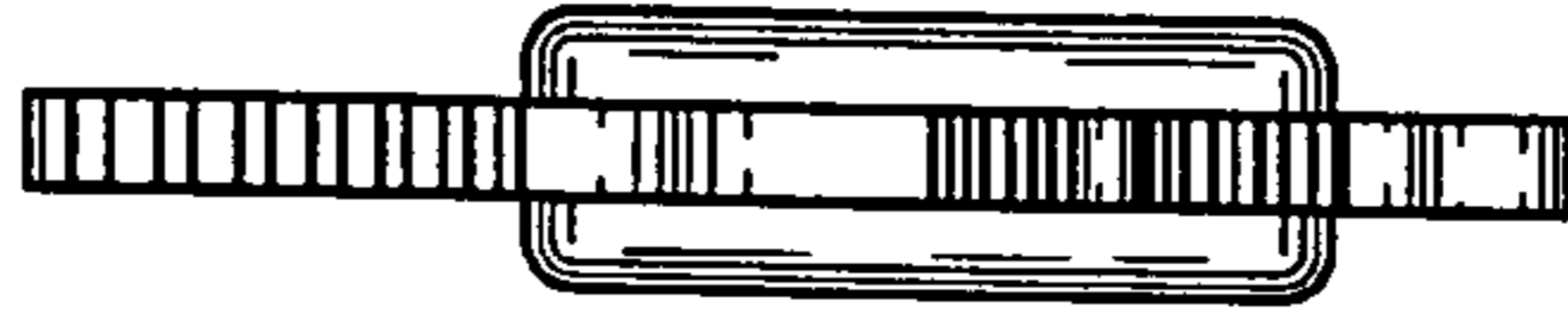
