FIG. 12 is a front elevational view thereof;

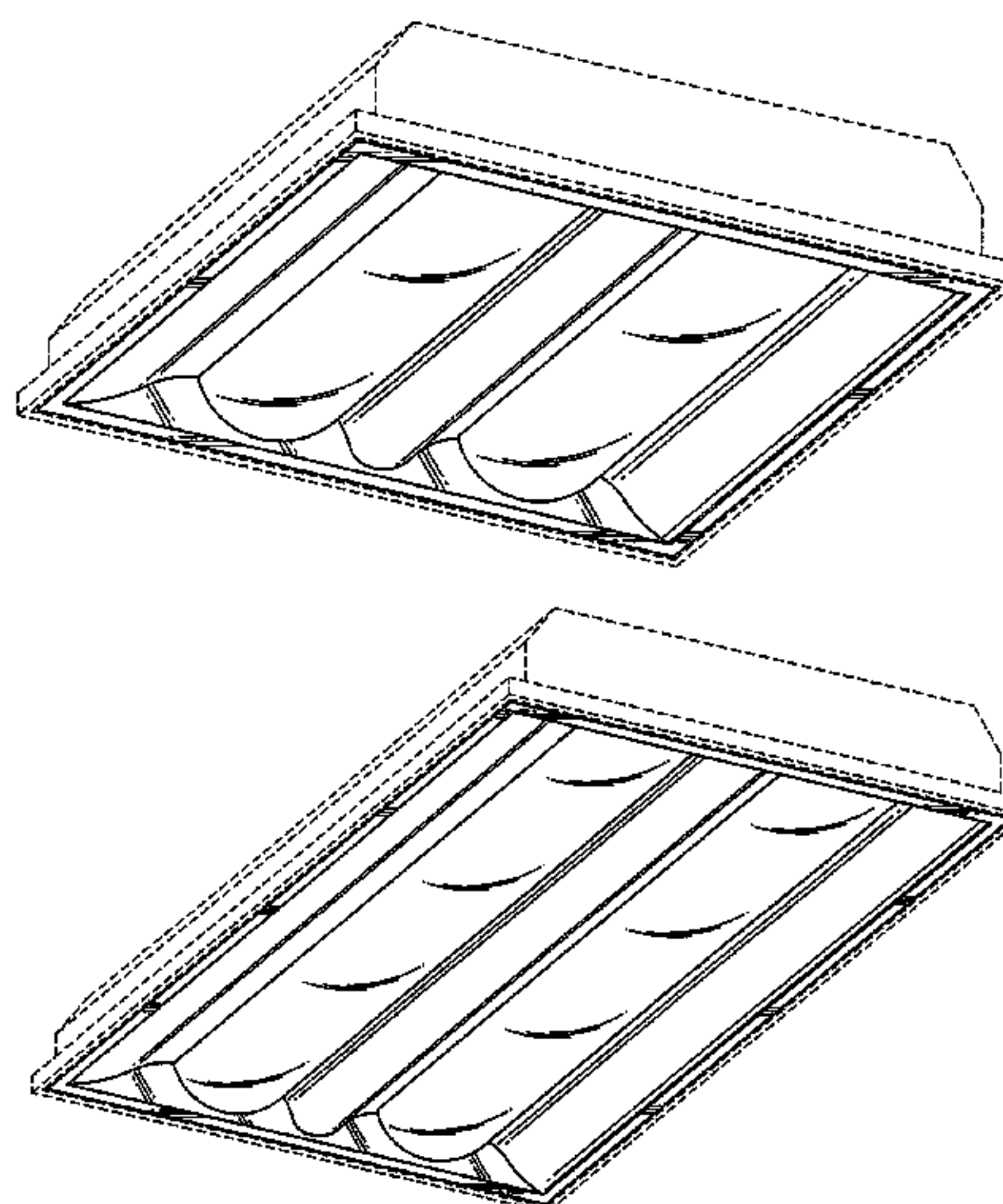
FIG. 13 is a side elevational view thereof; and,

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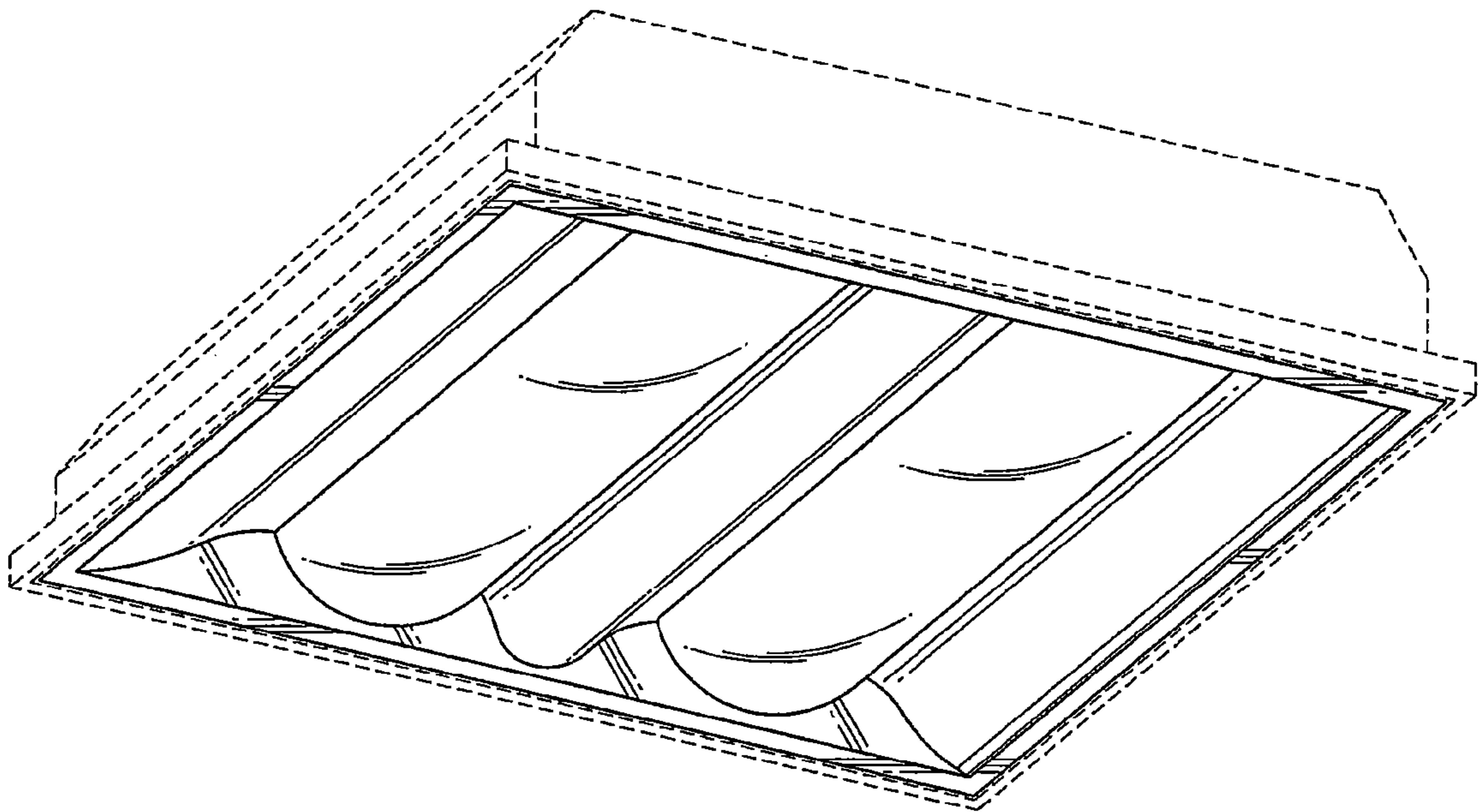

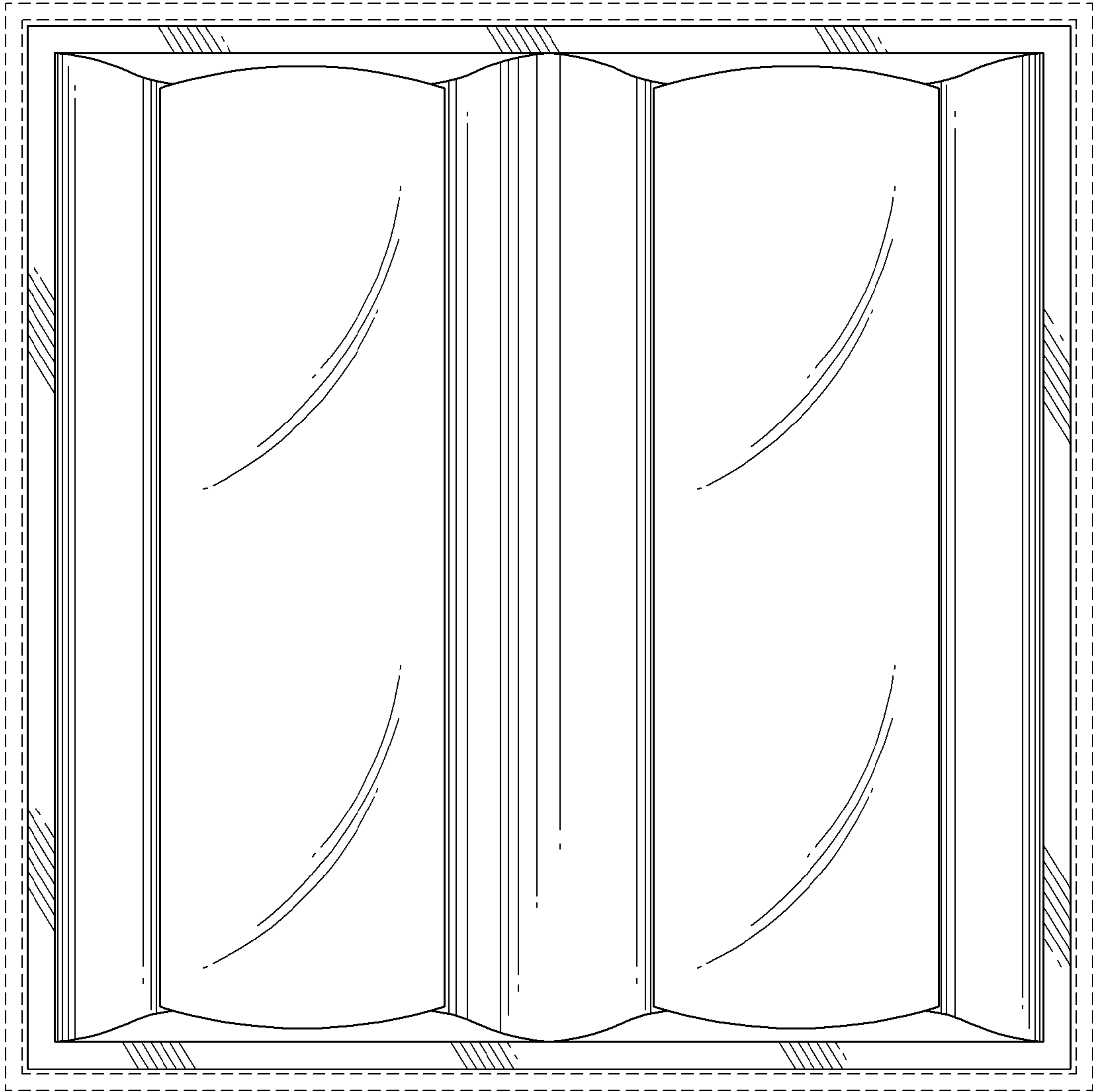

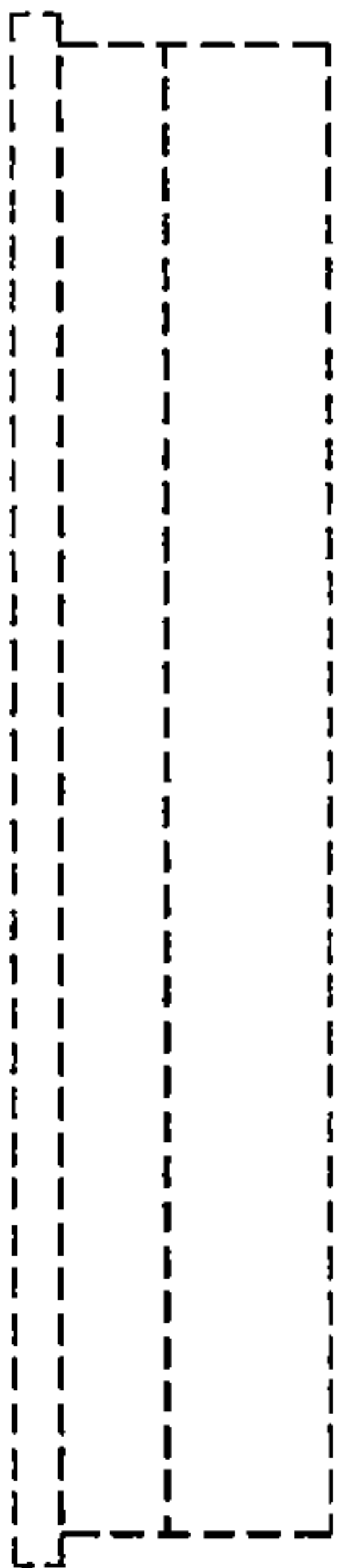

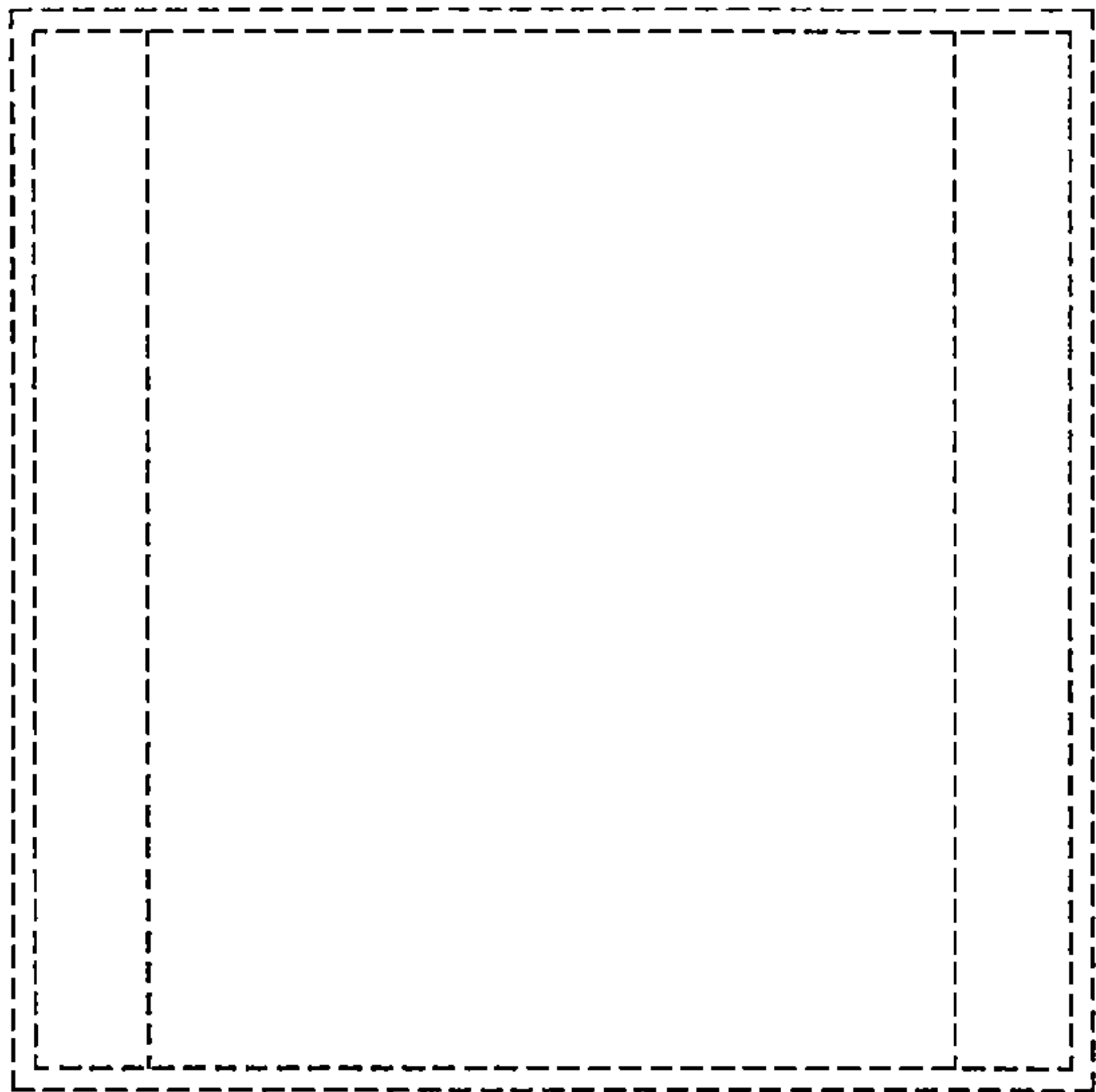

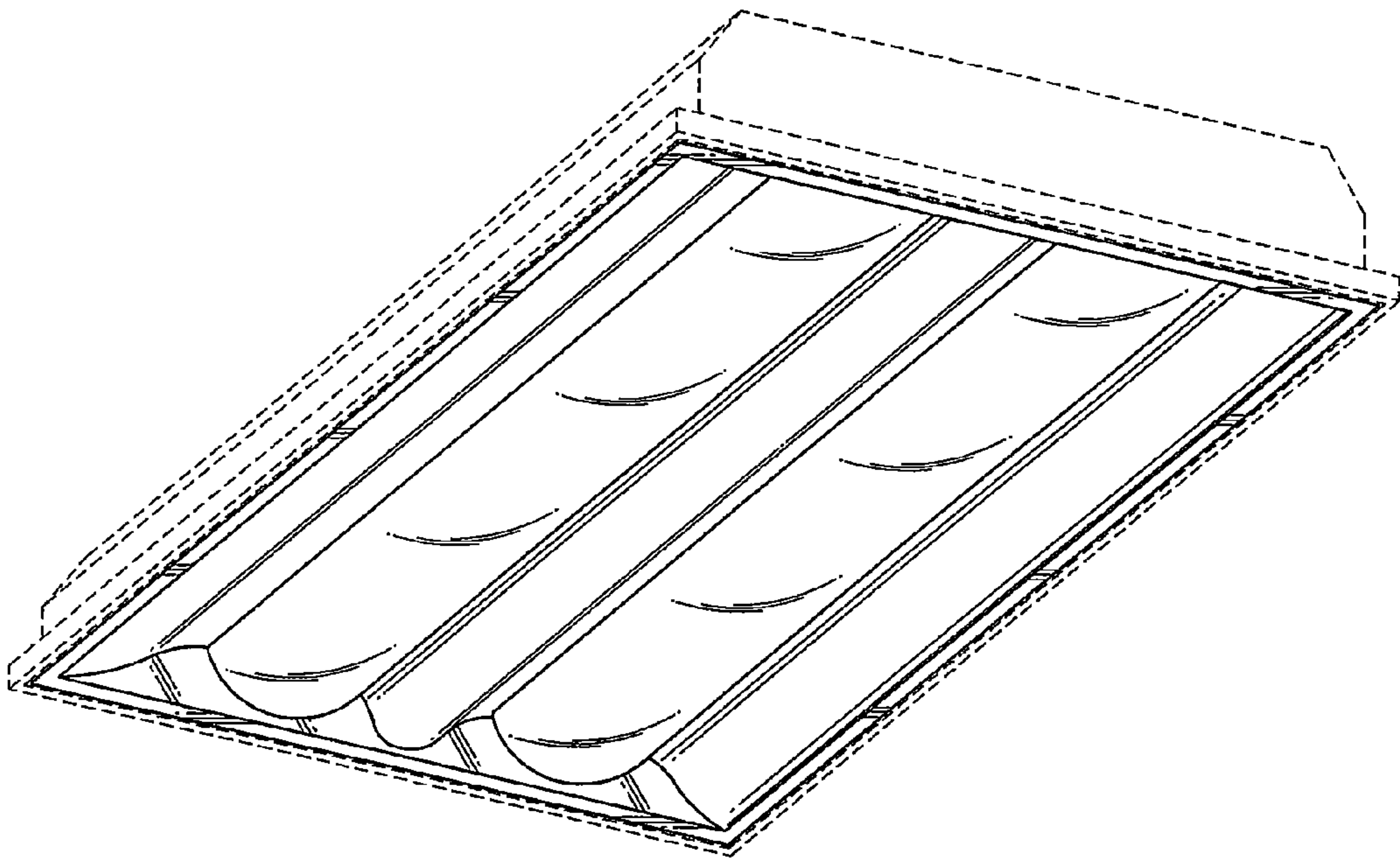

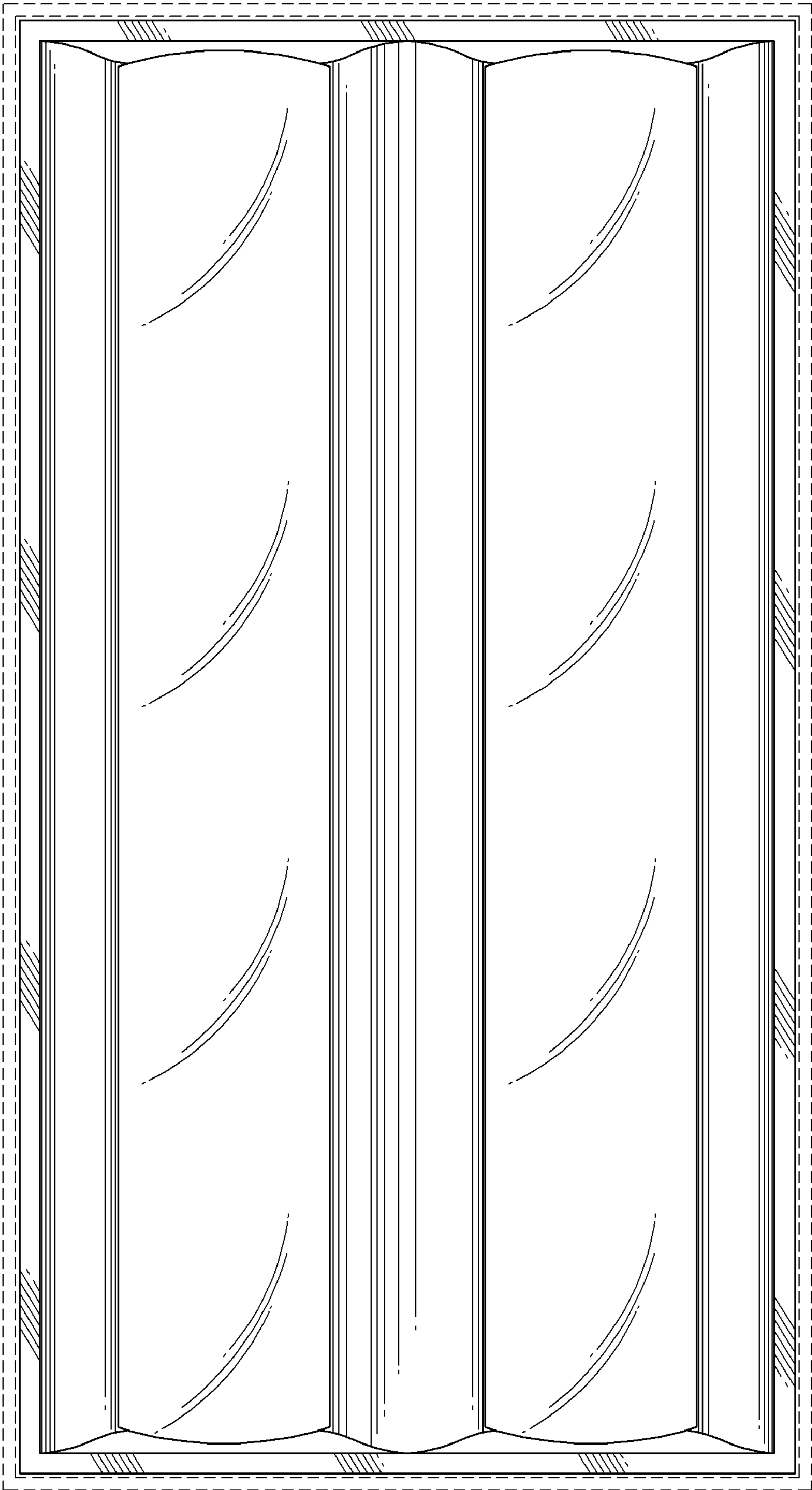

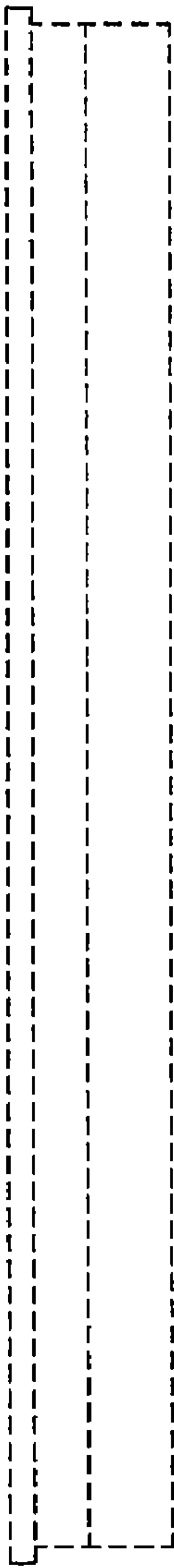

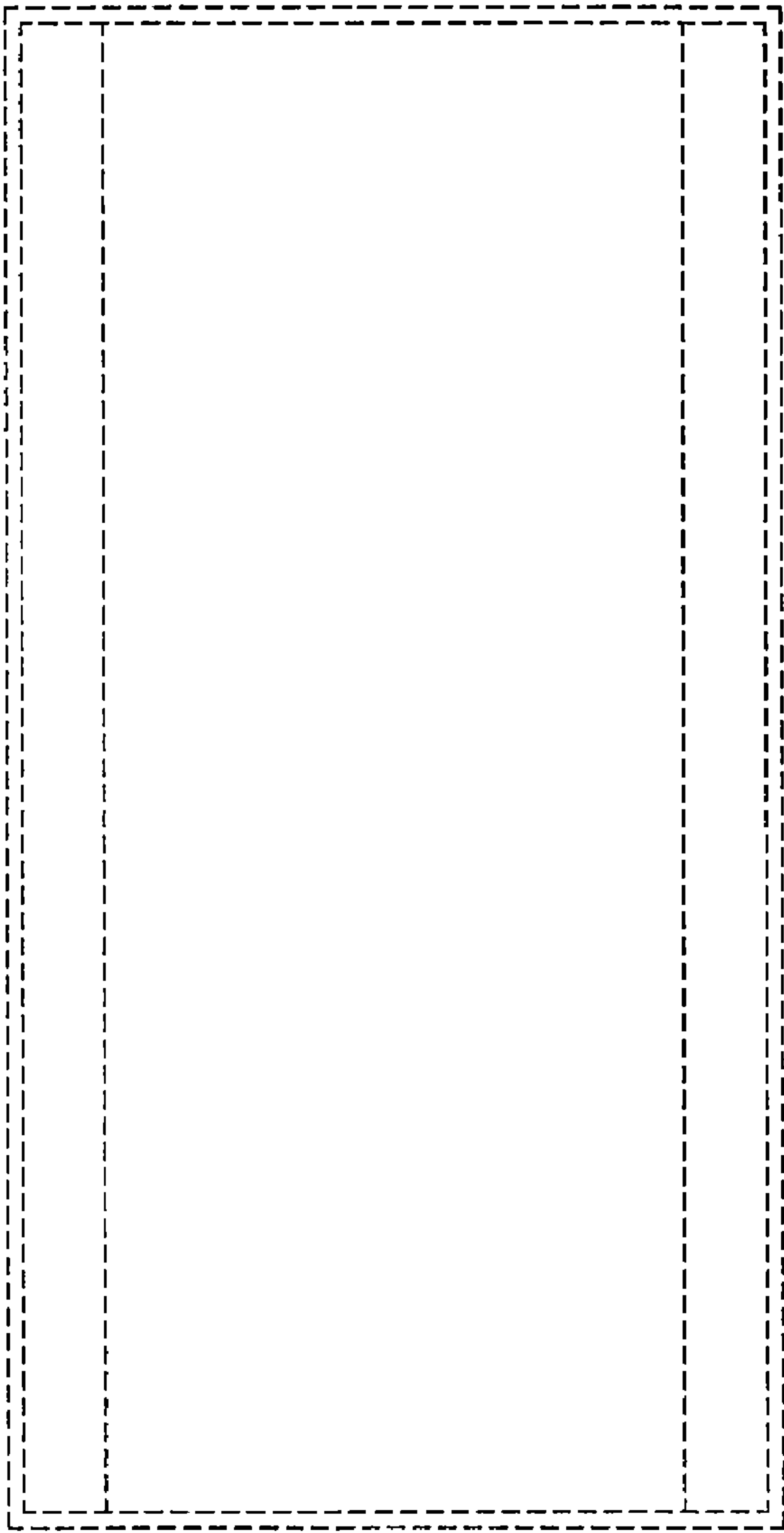

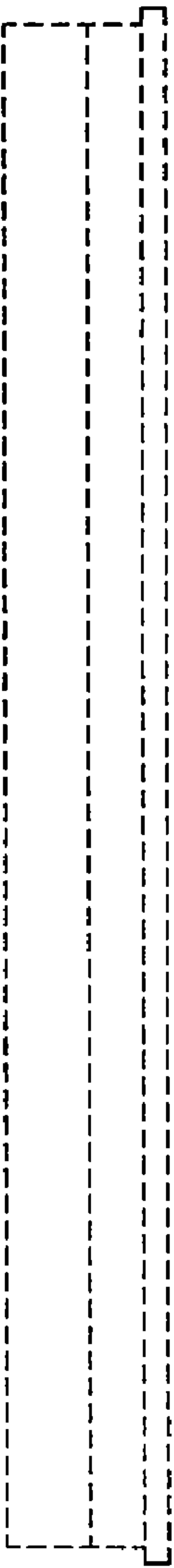
