(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a pair of shoe outsoles, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the left odd of a pair of shoe outsoles showing our new design; the broken lines showing the shoe upper illustrating the portion of the design that forms no part of the claim.

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the pair of shoe outsoles of this invention;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the pair of shoe outsoles of this invention;

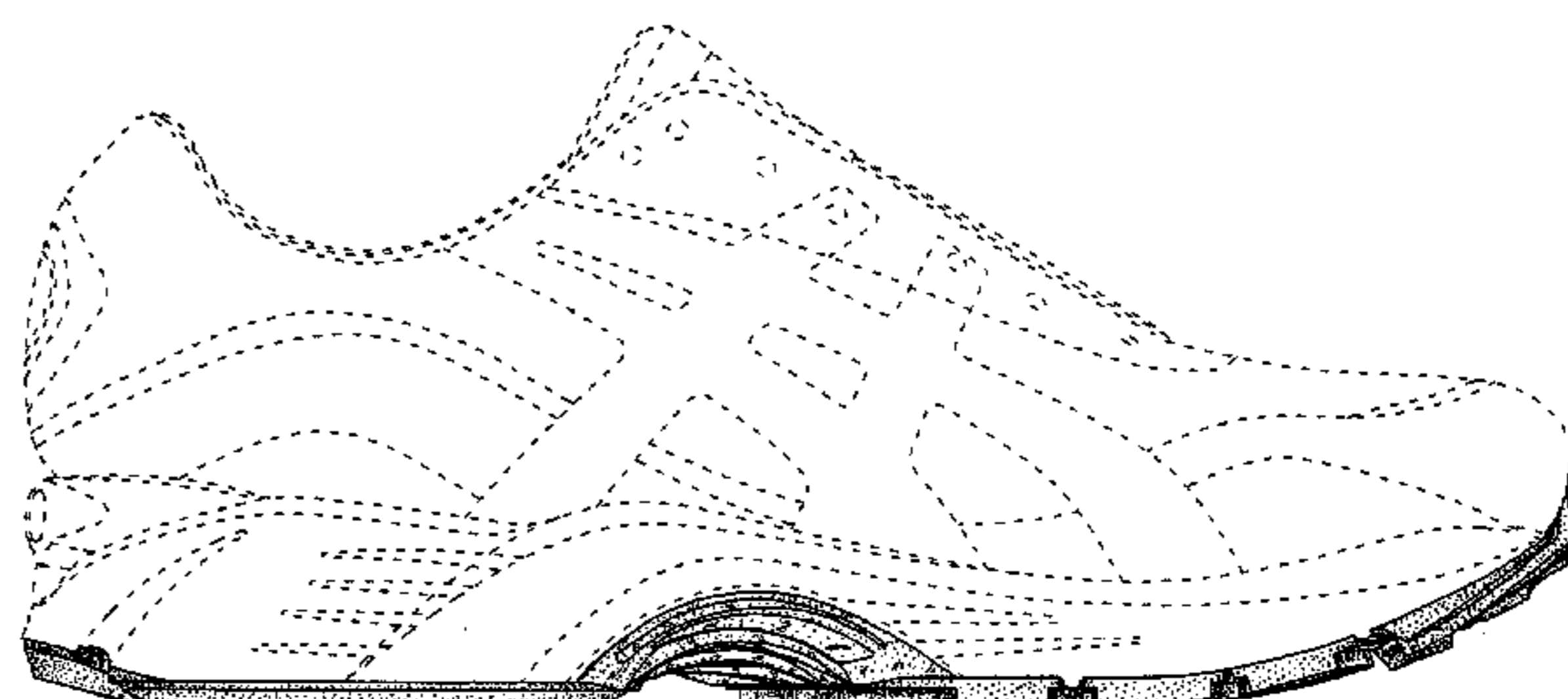
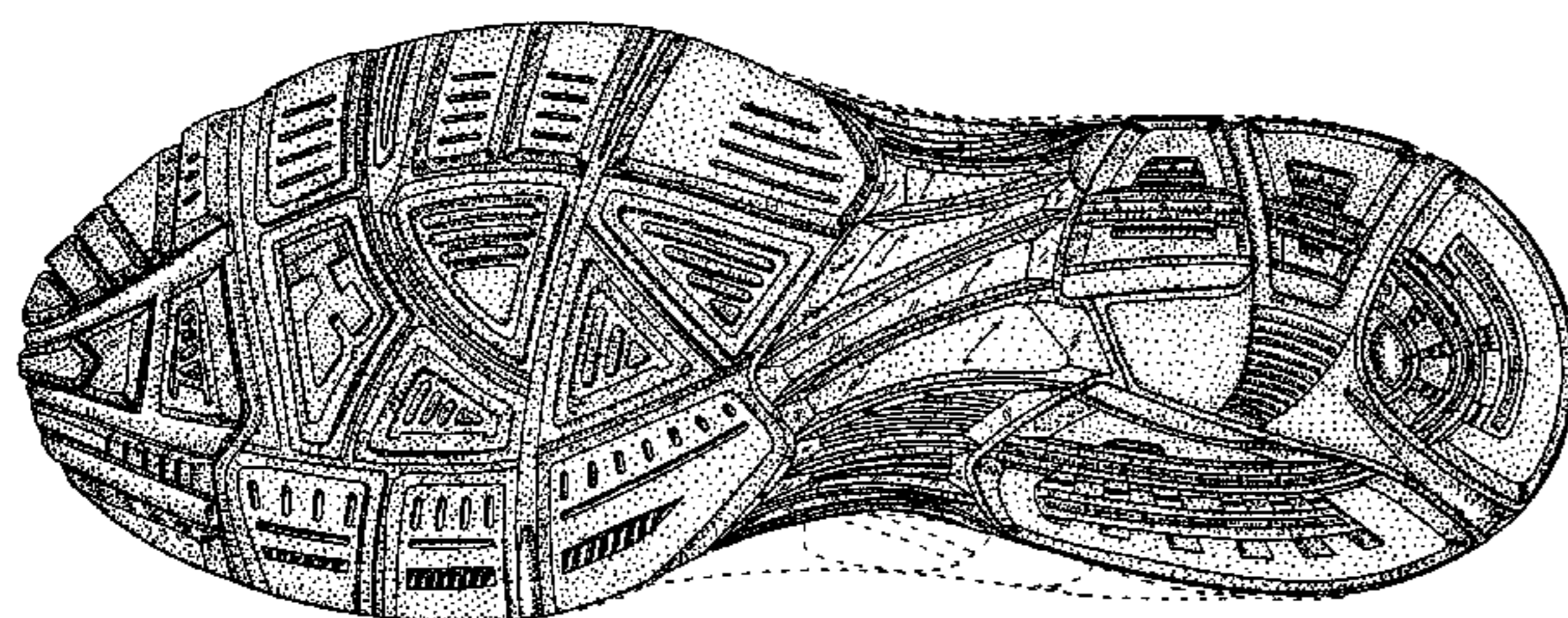
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the pair of shoe outsoles of this invention;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the pair of shoe outsoles of this invention; and,

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the pair of shoe outsoles of this invention.

The right odd of the pair of shoe outsoles is a mirror image.

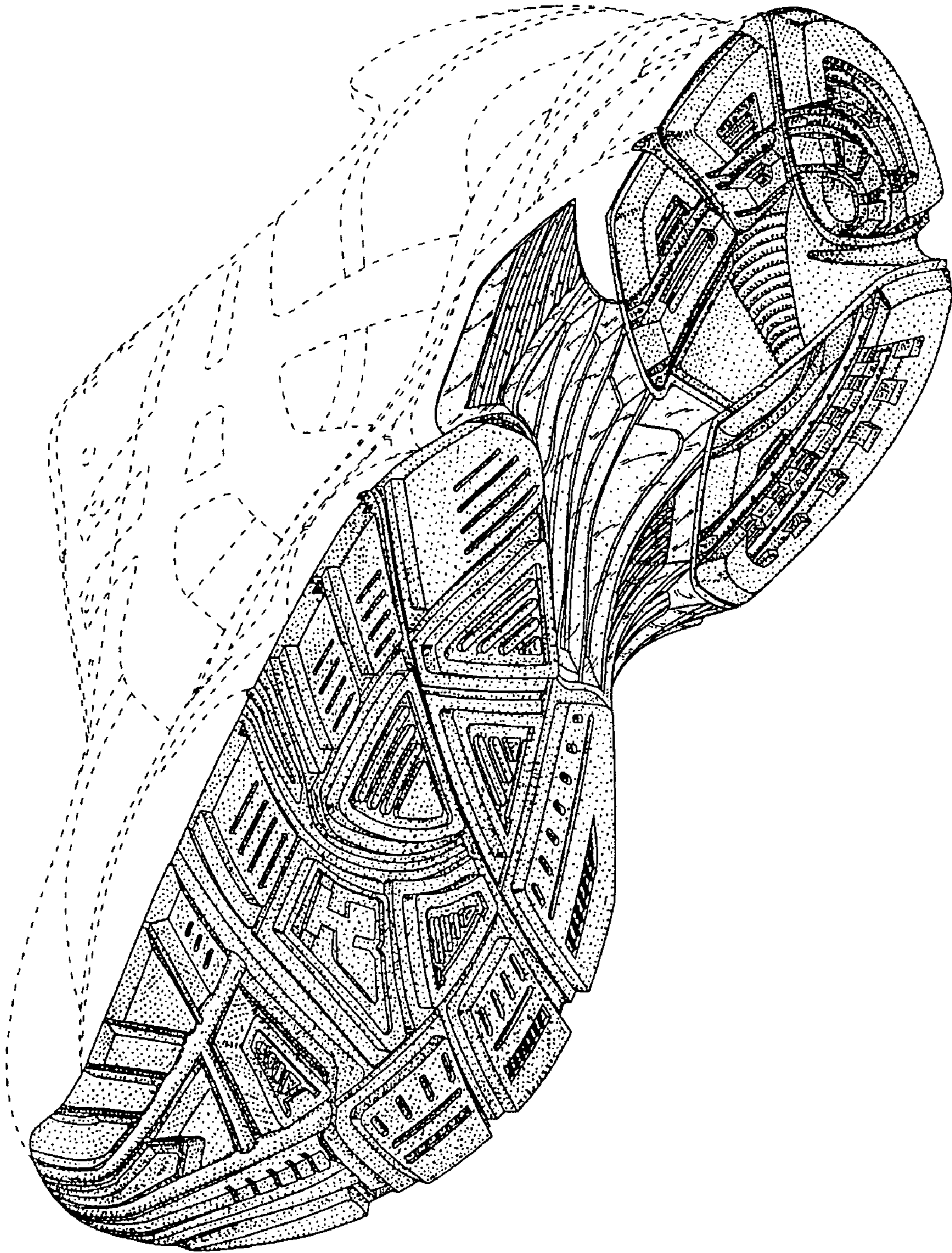

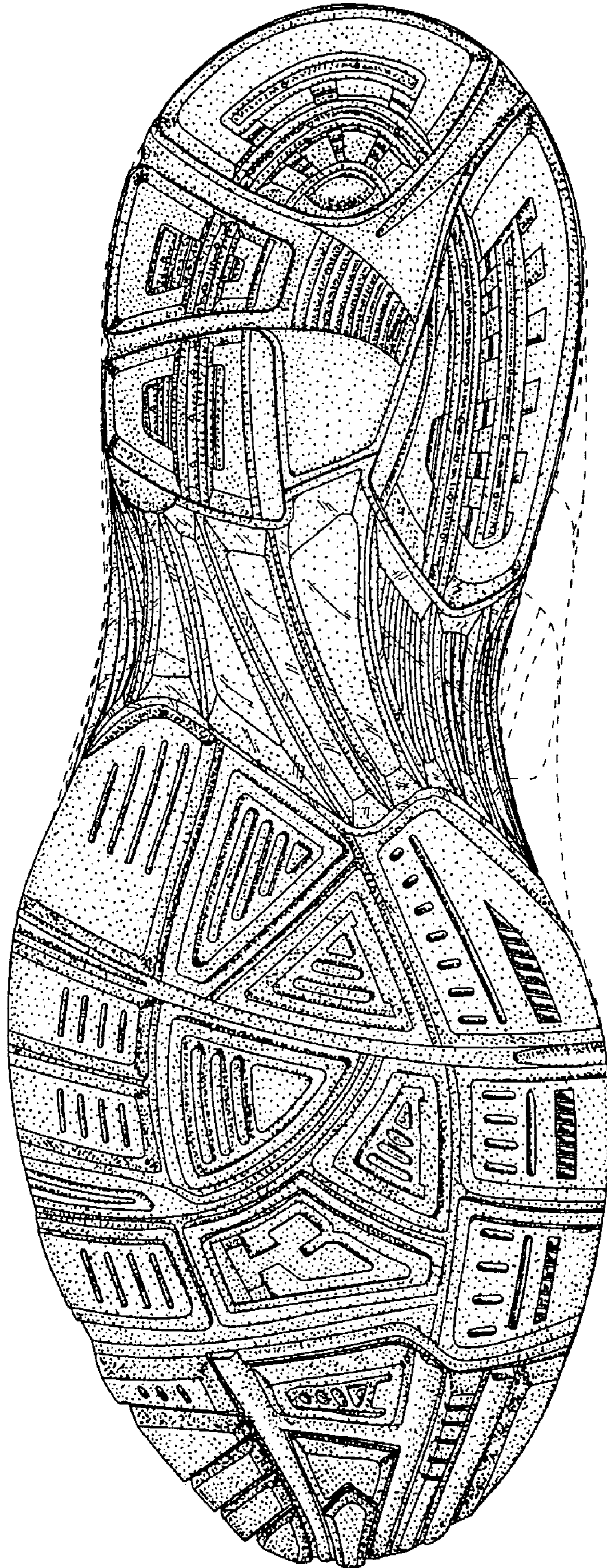

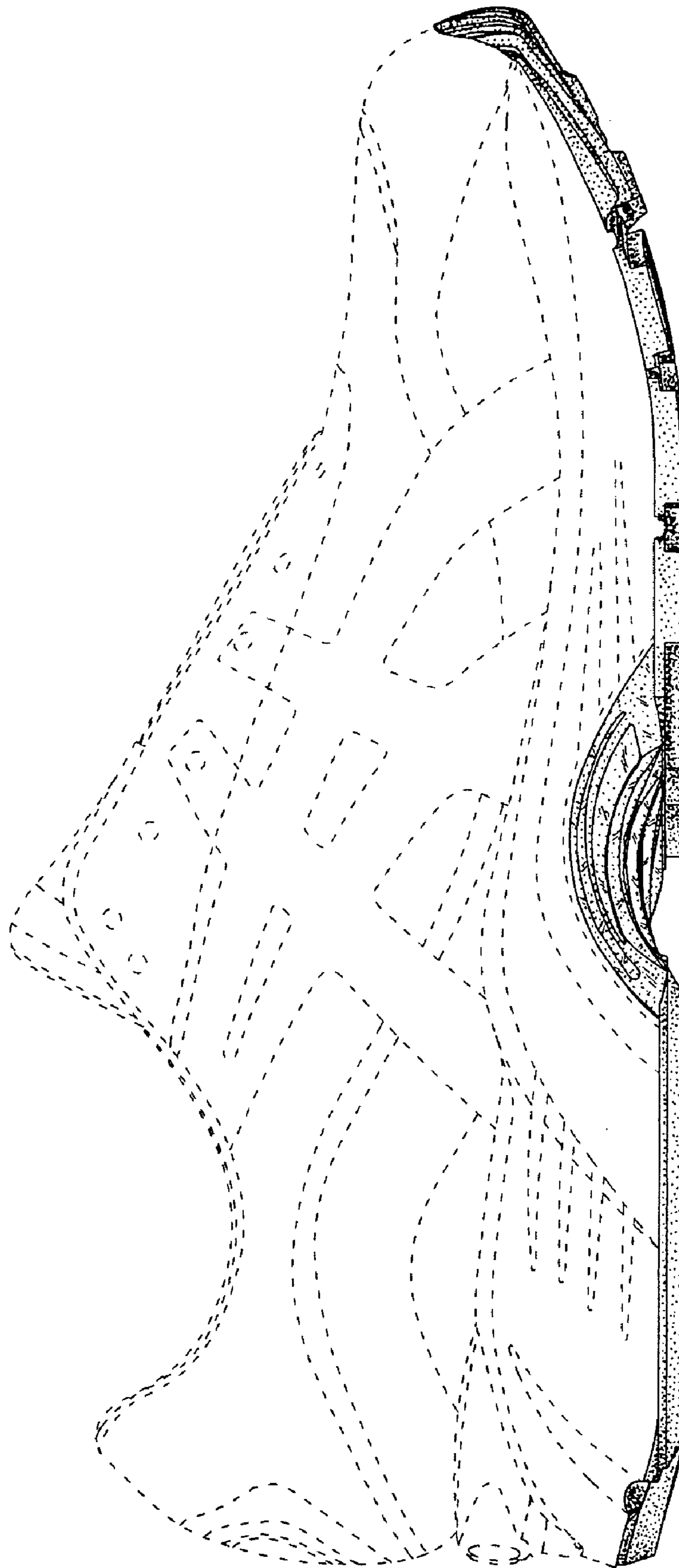

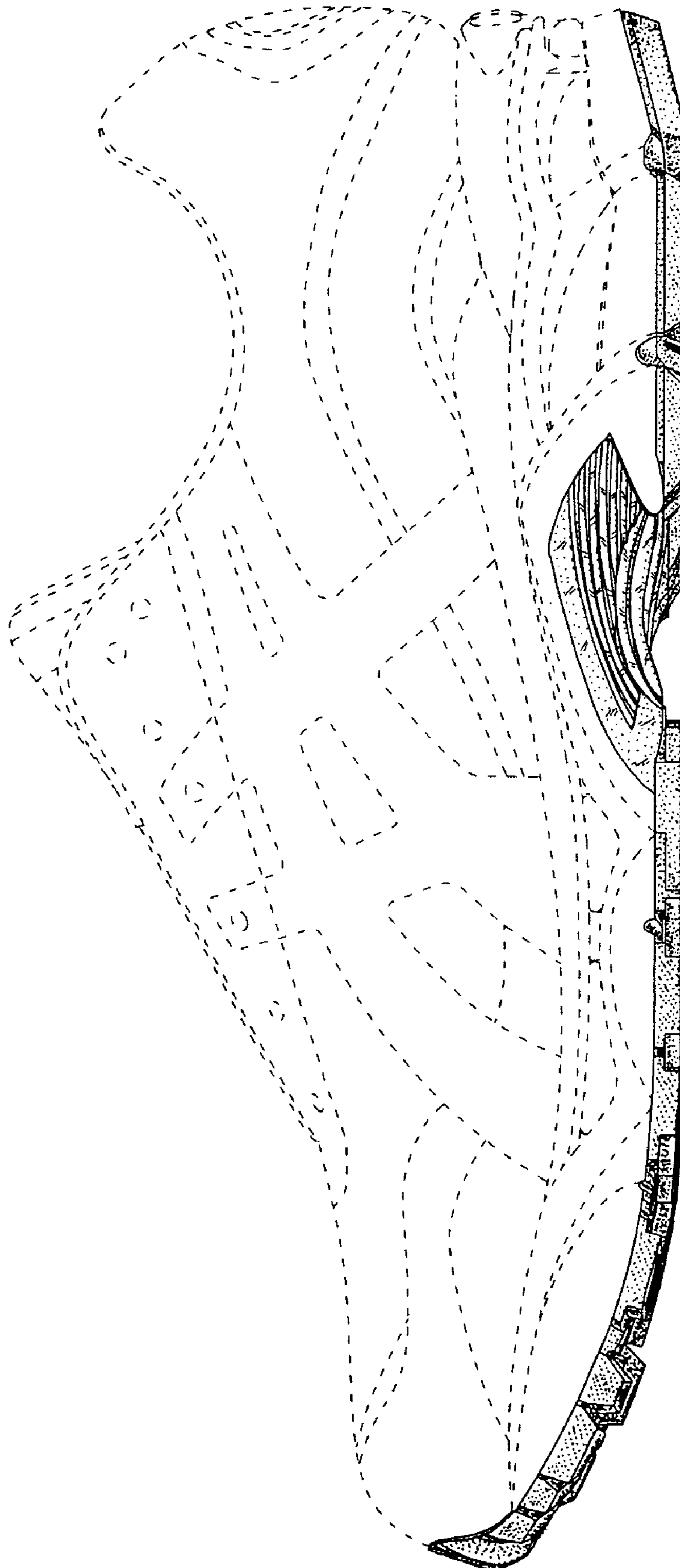

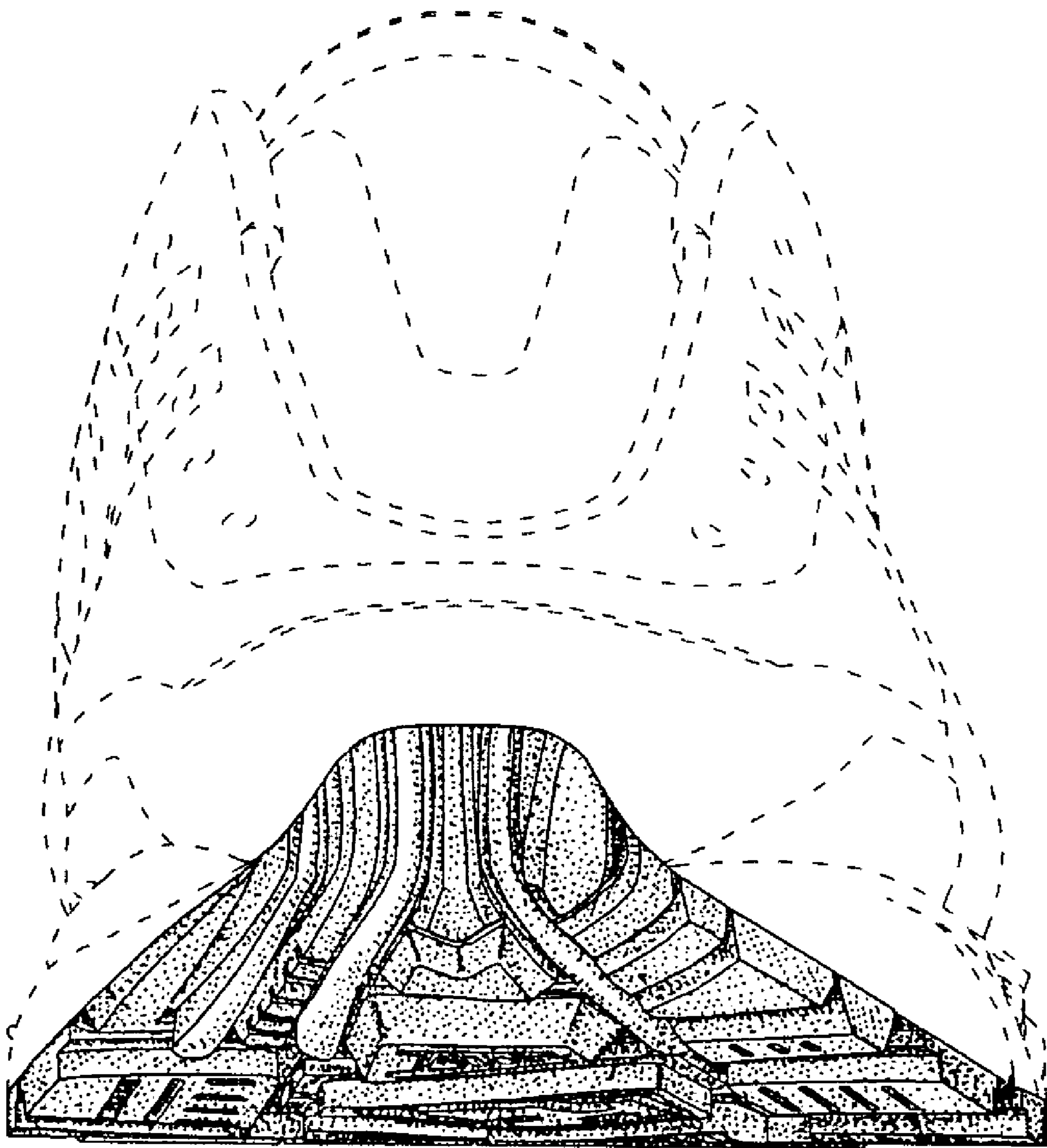
