FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof;

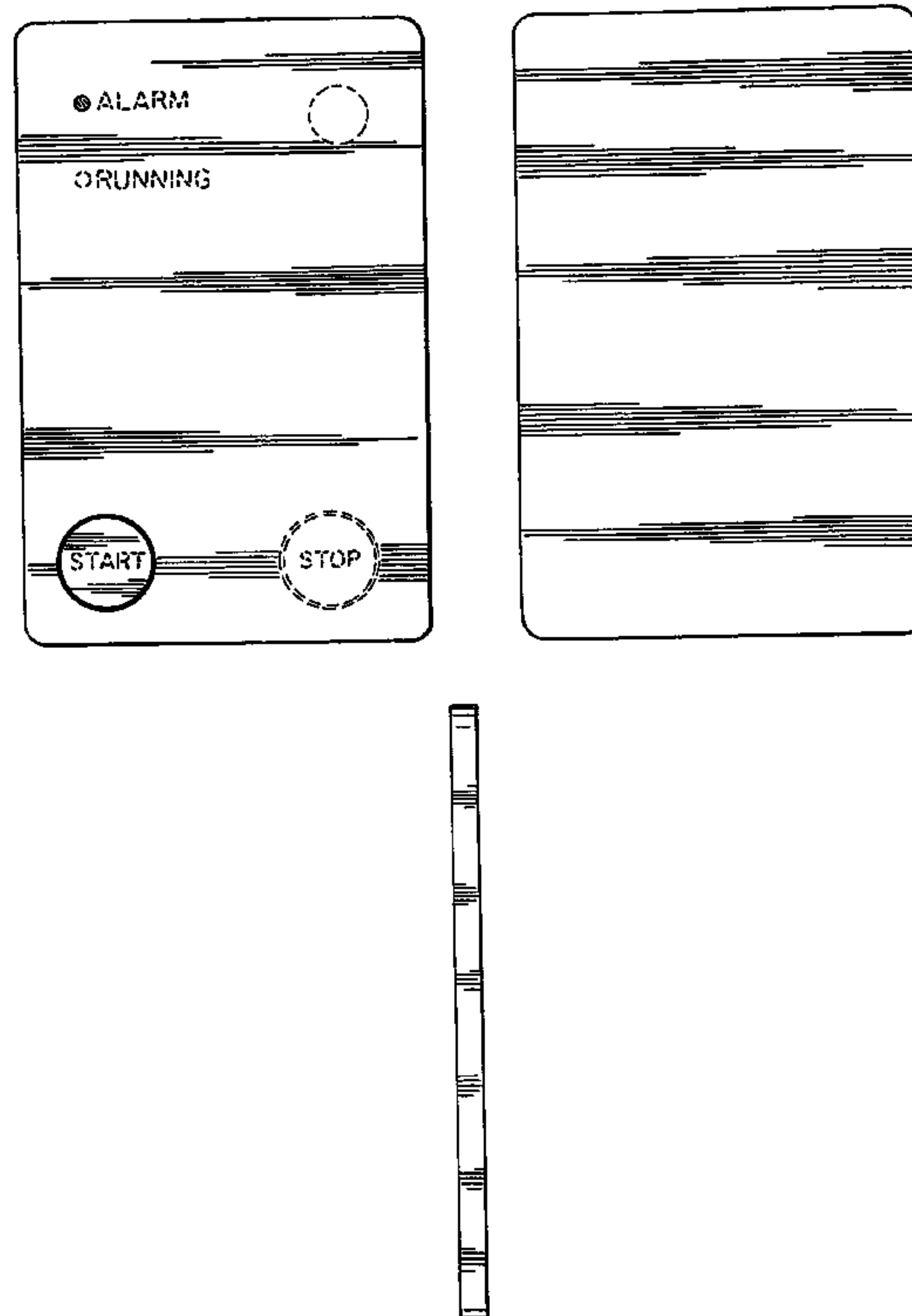
FIG. 3 is a left view thereof, the right side view being a

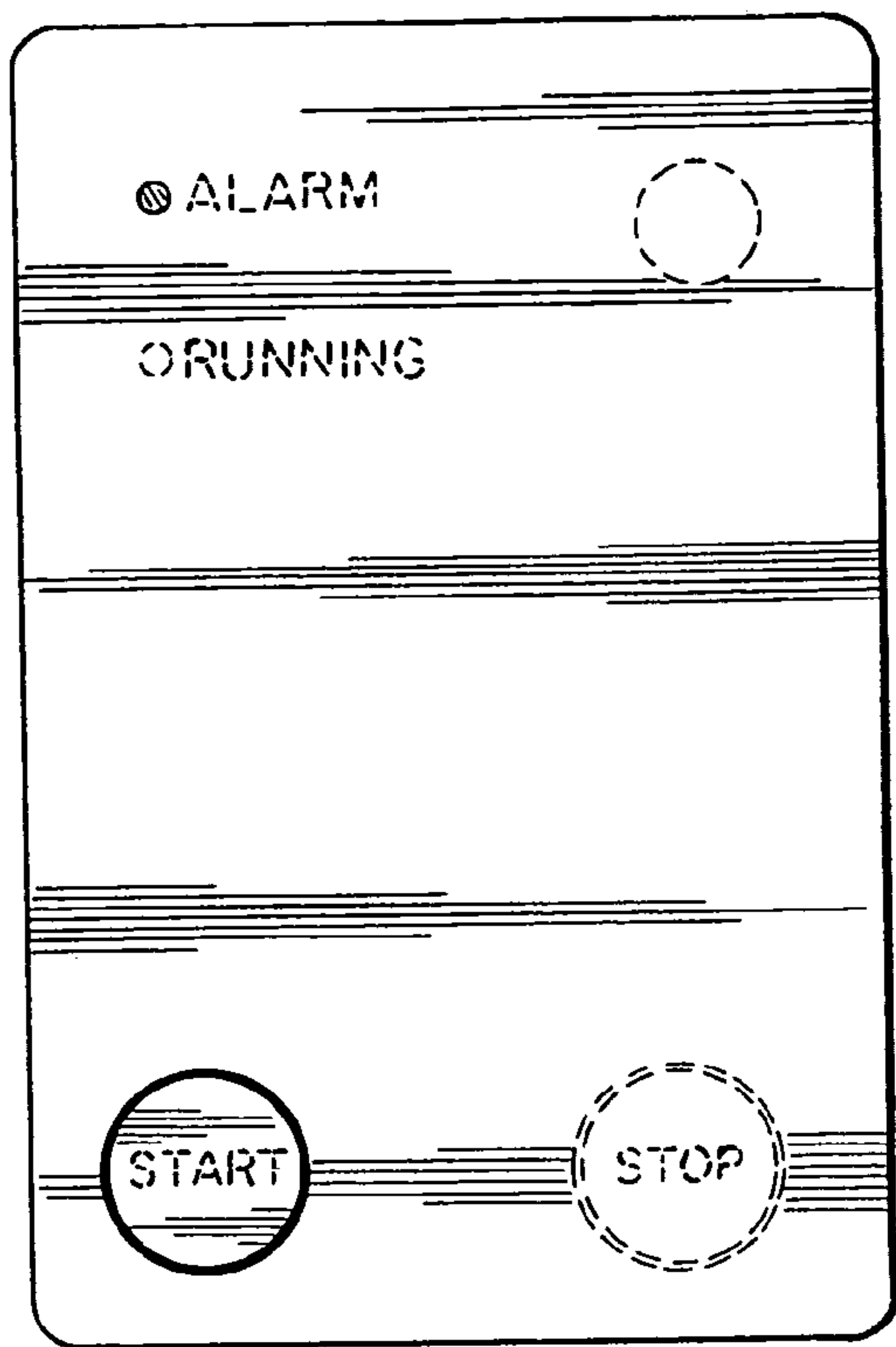

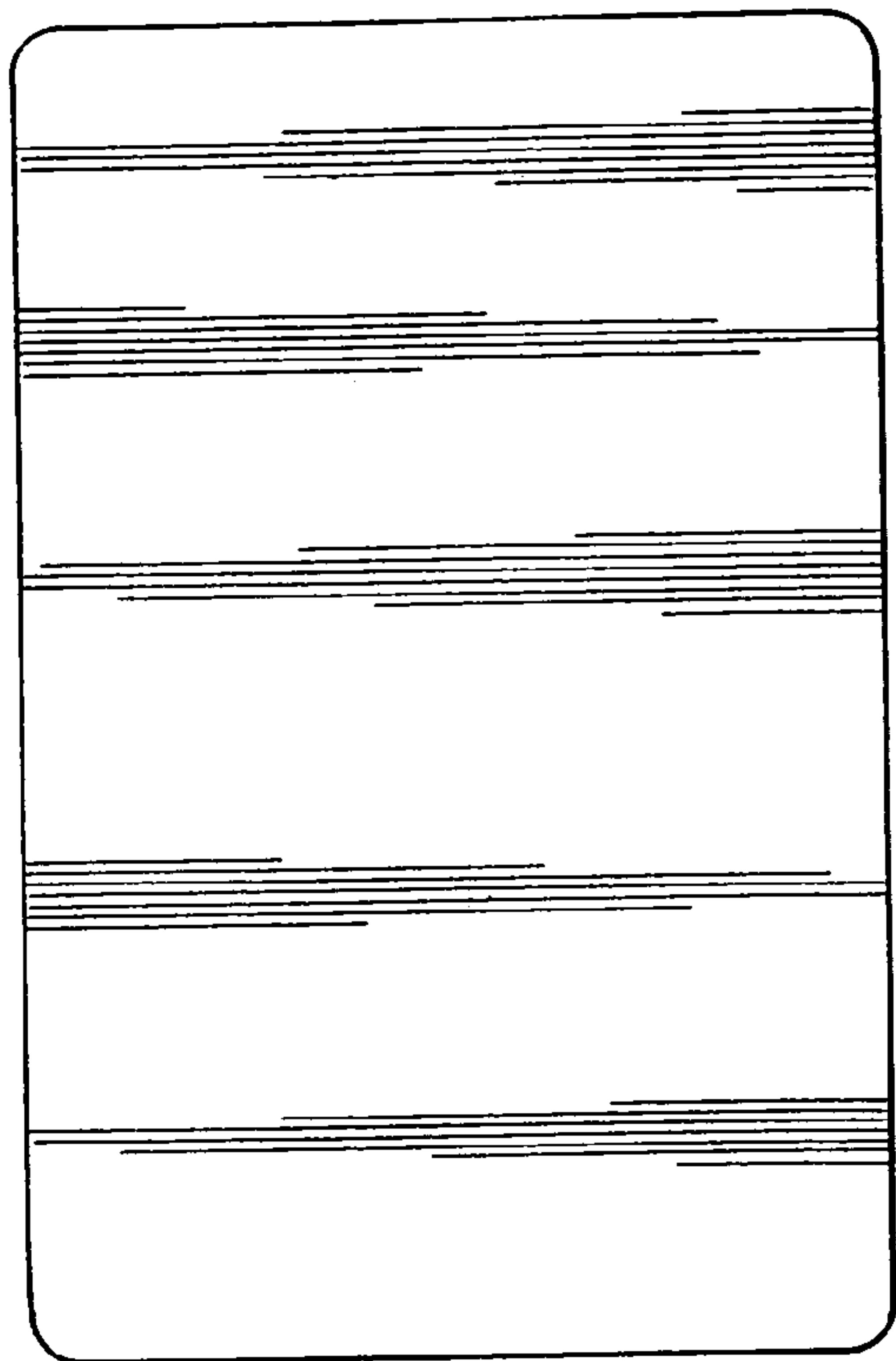
