FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

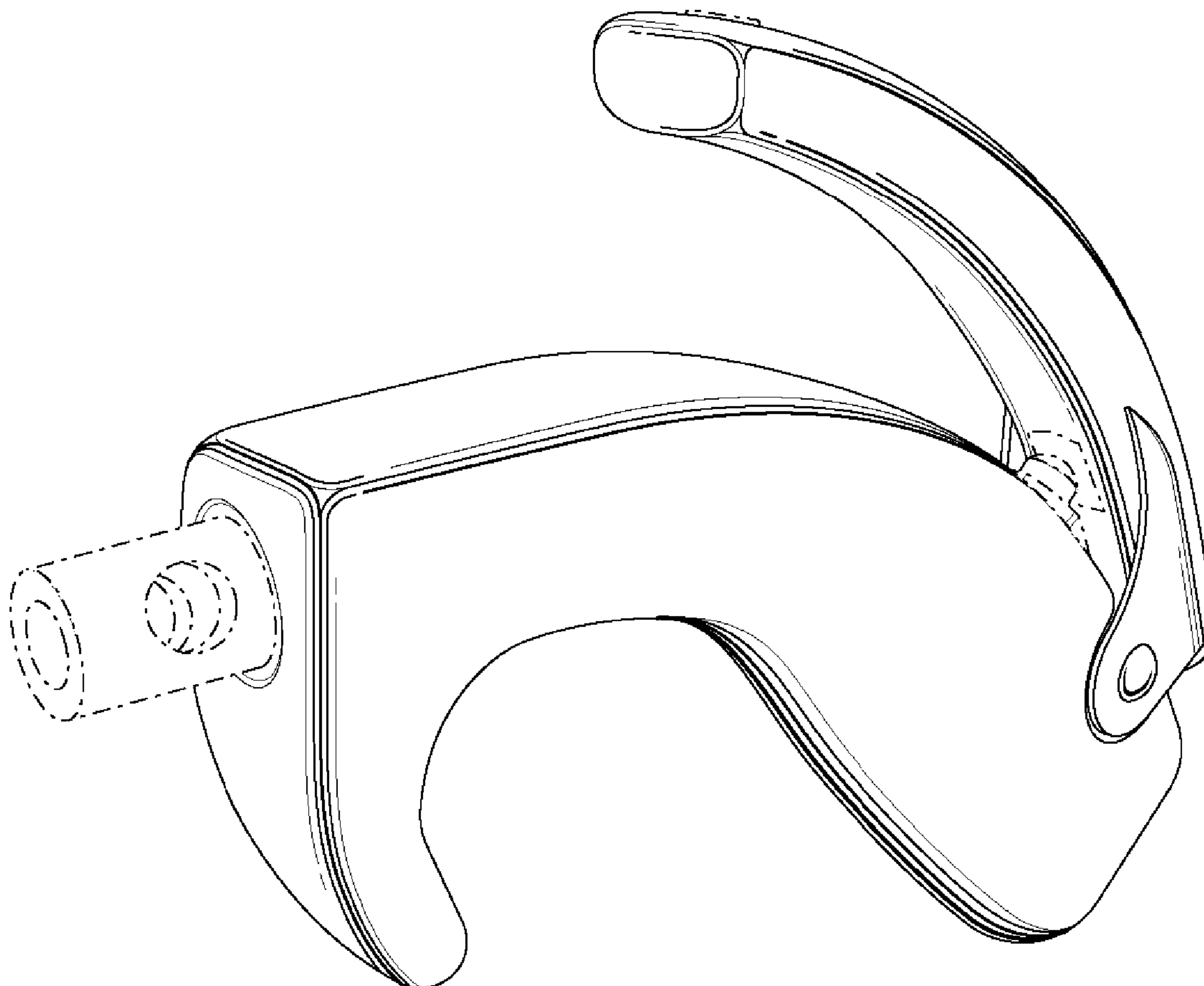
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side

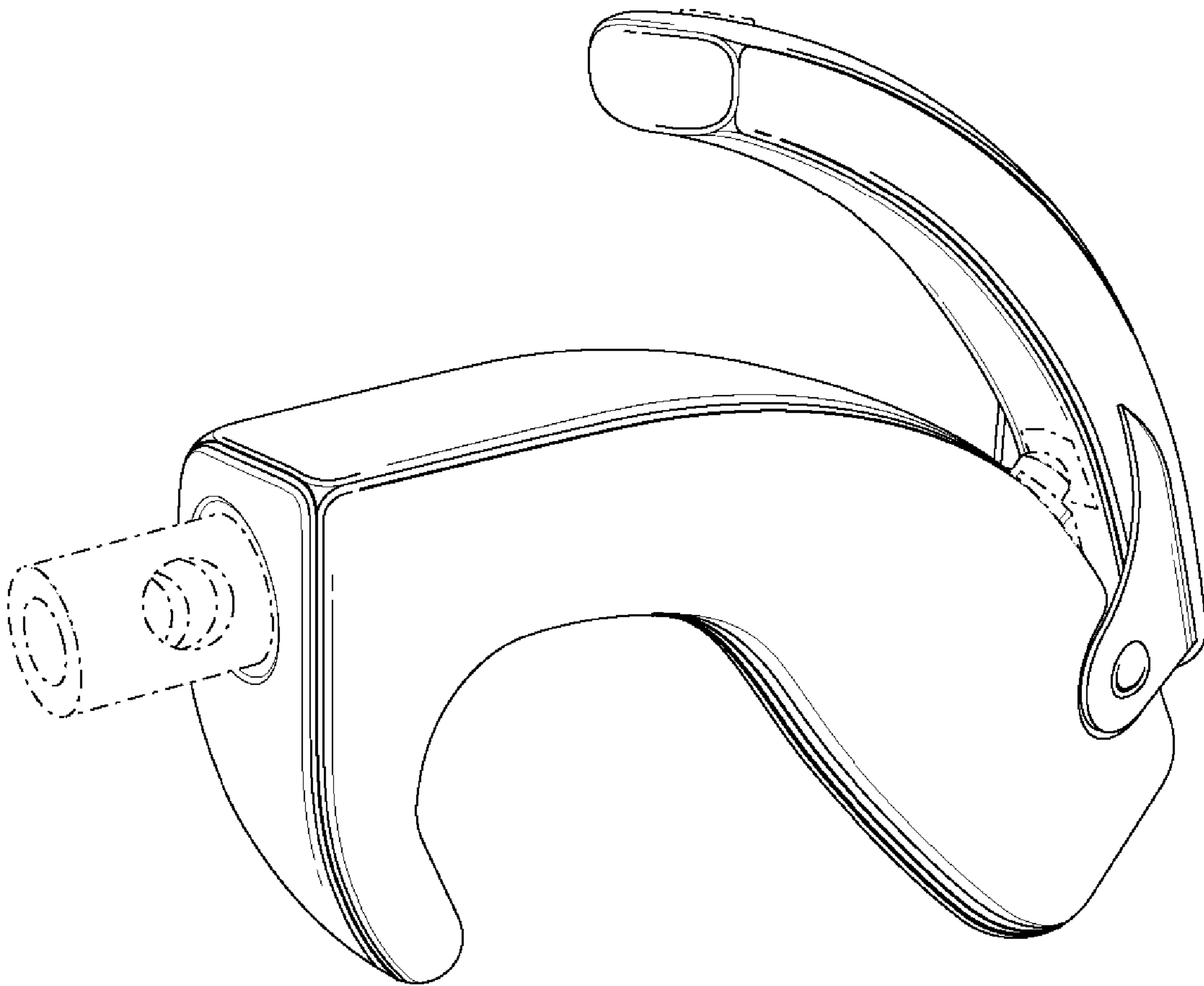

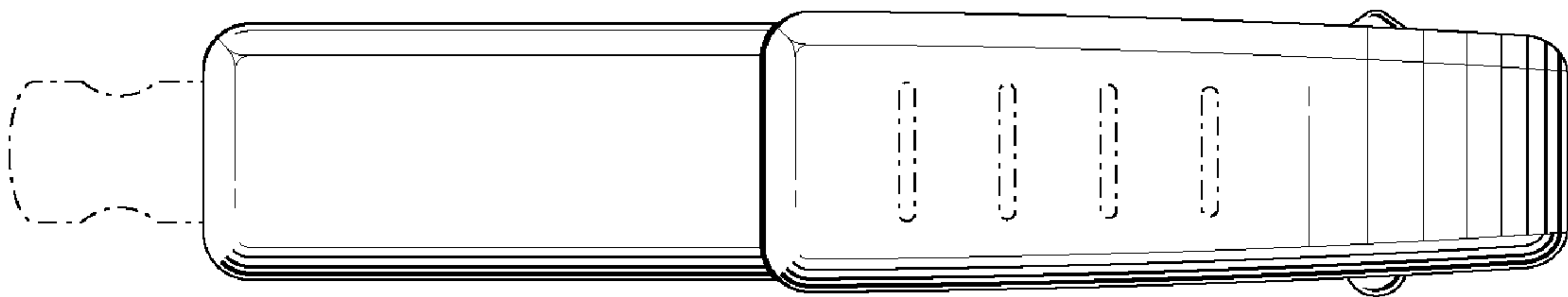

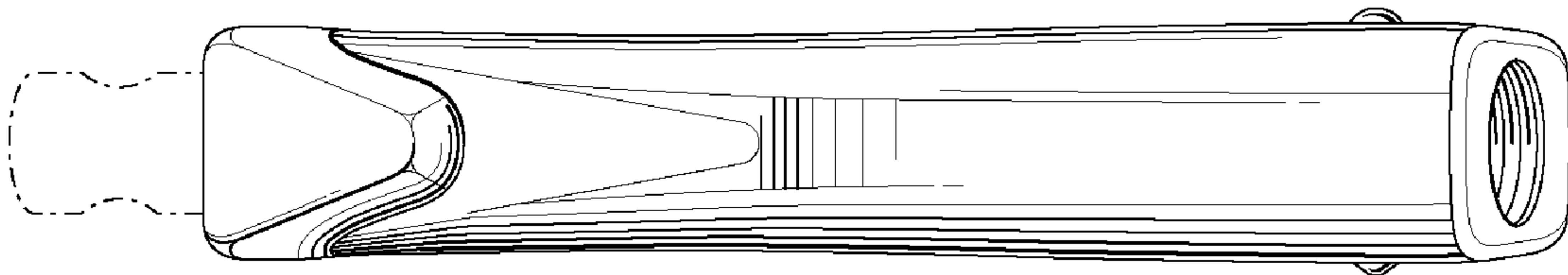

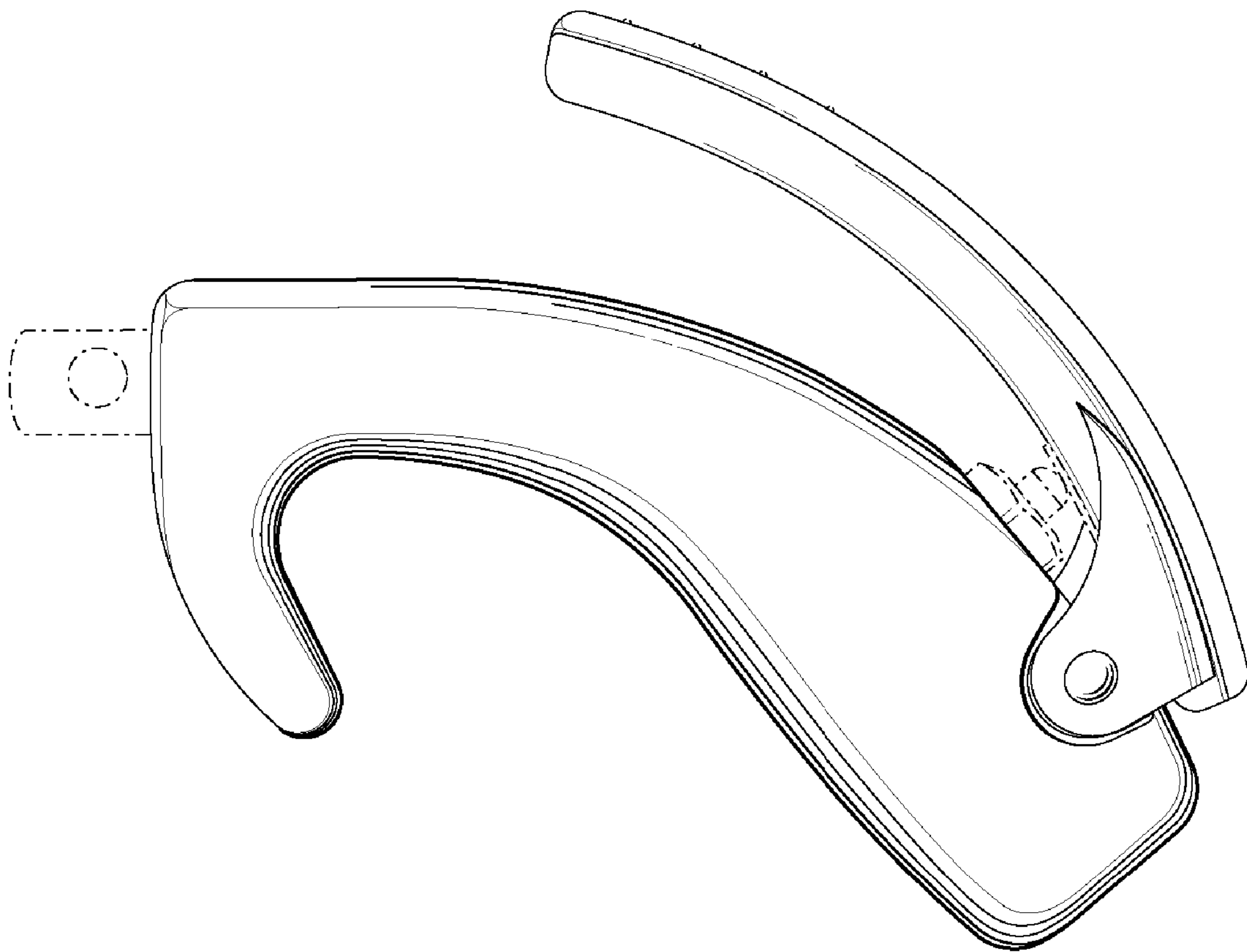

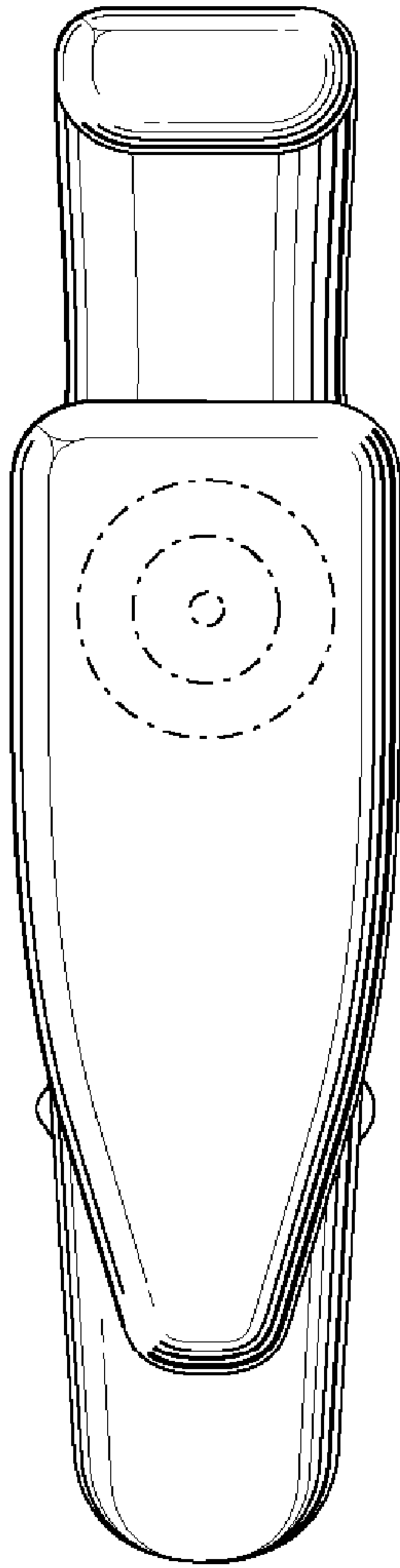

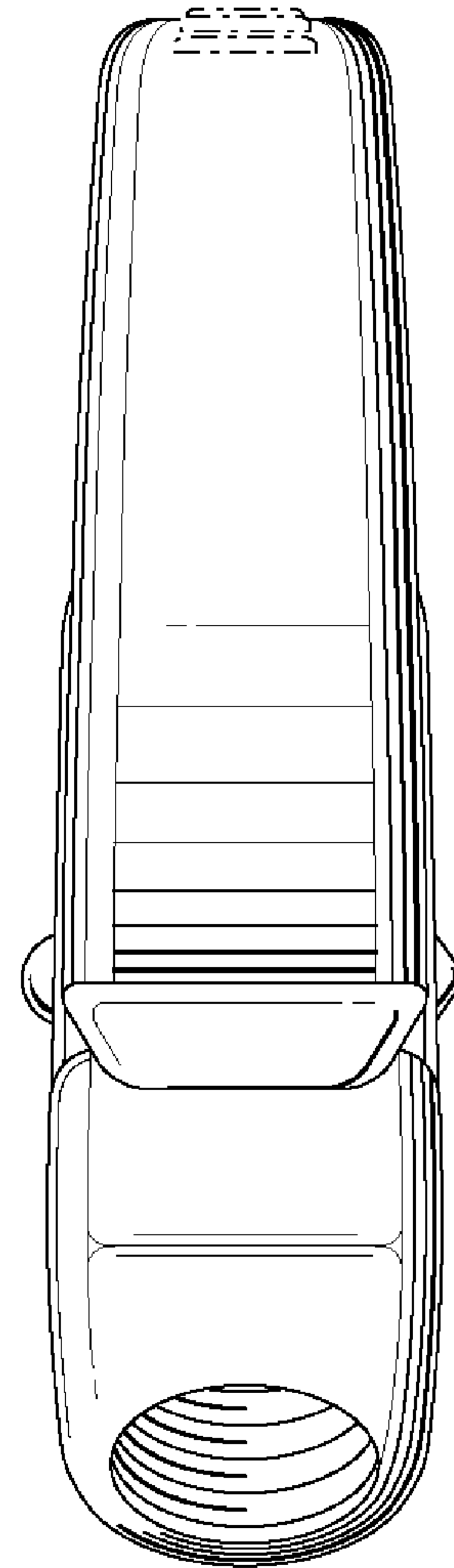
