DESCRIPTION

FIG. 10 shows a plan view of the protective panel shown in FIG. 8;

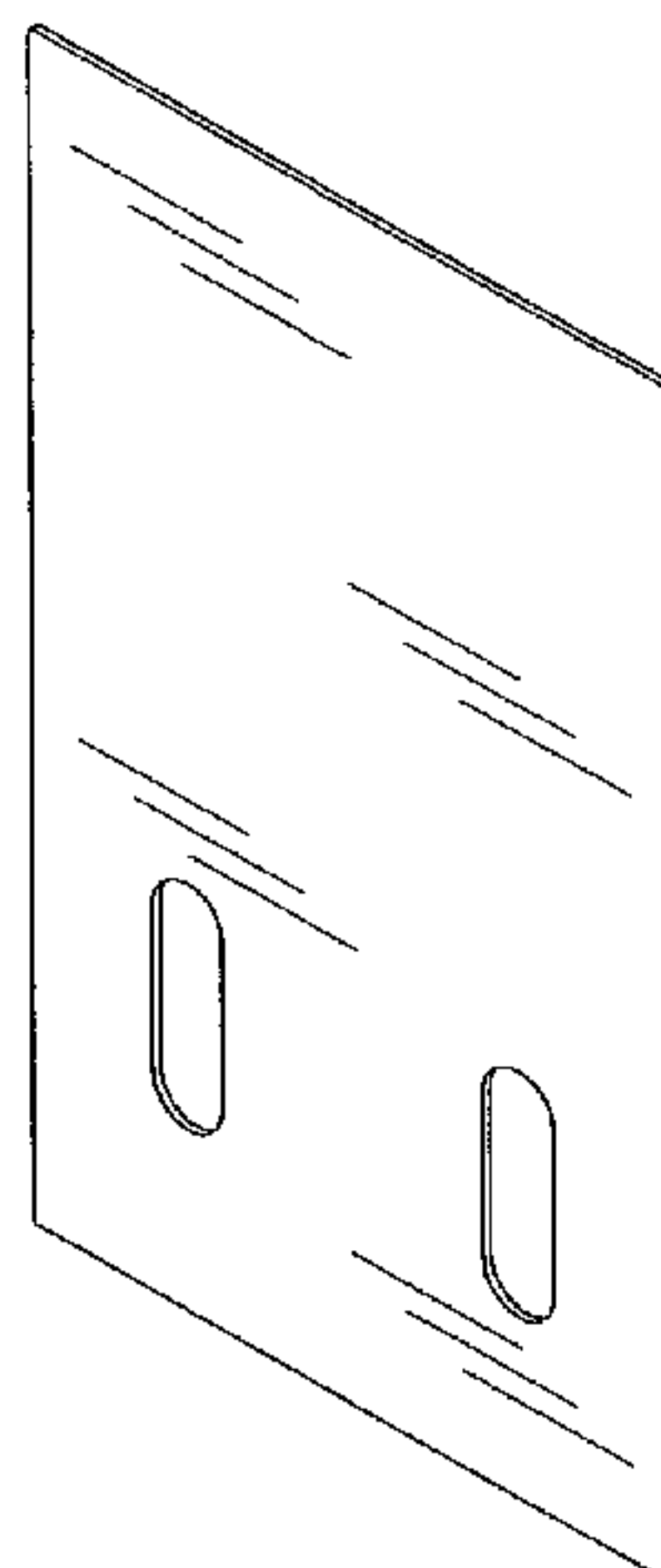
FIG. 11 shows a right-hand side view of the protective panel shown in FIG. 8;

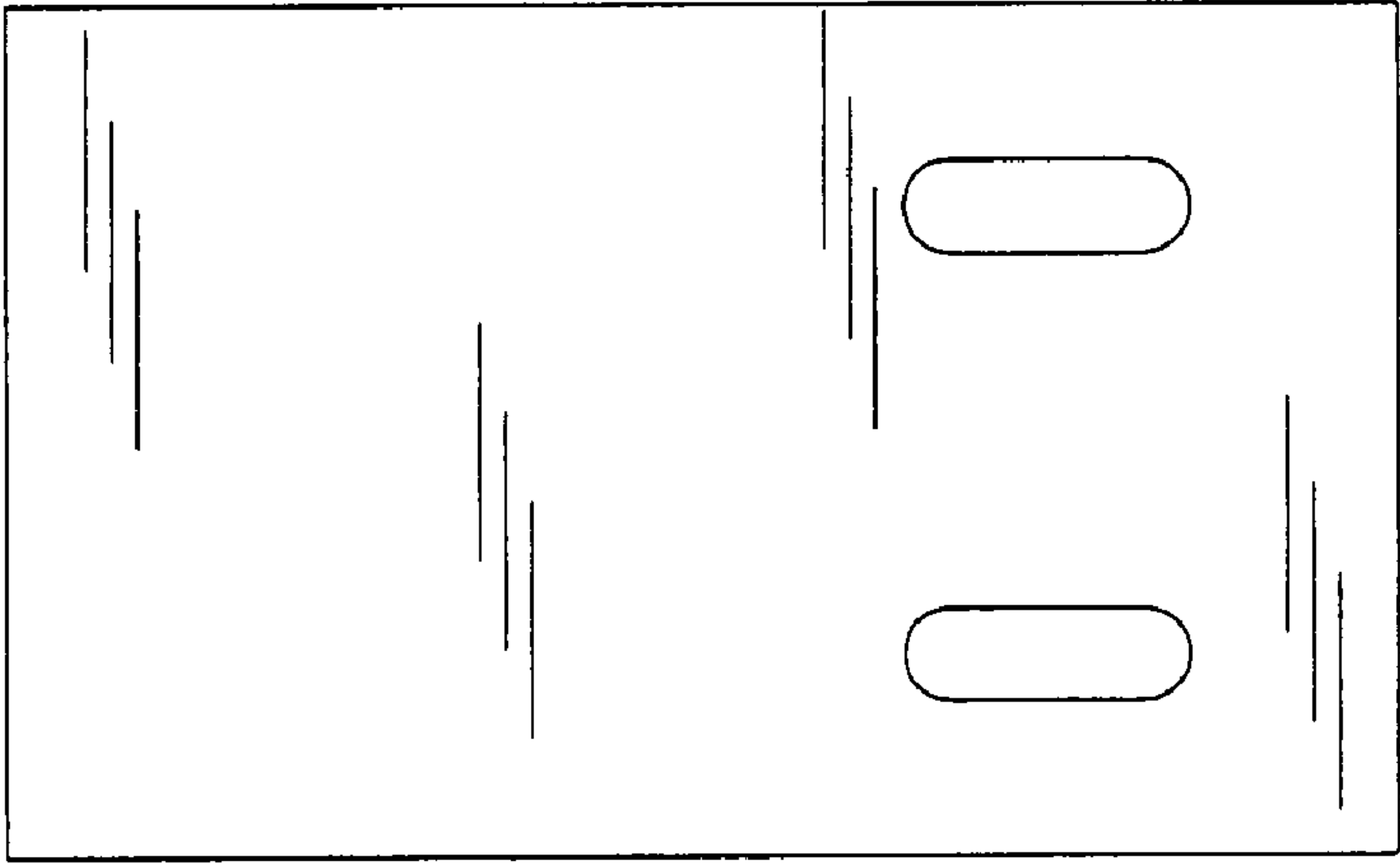

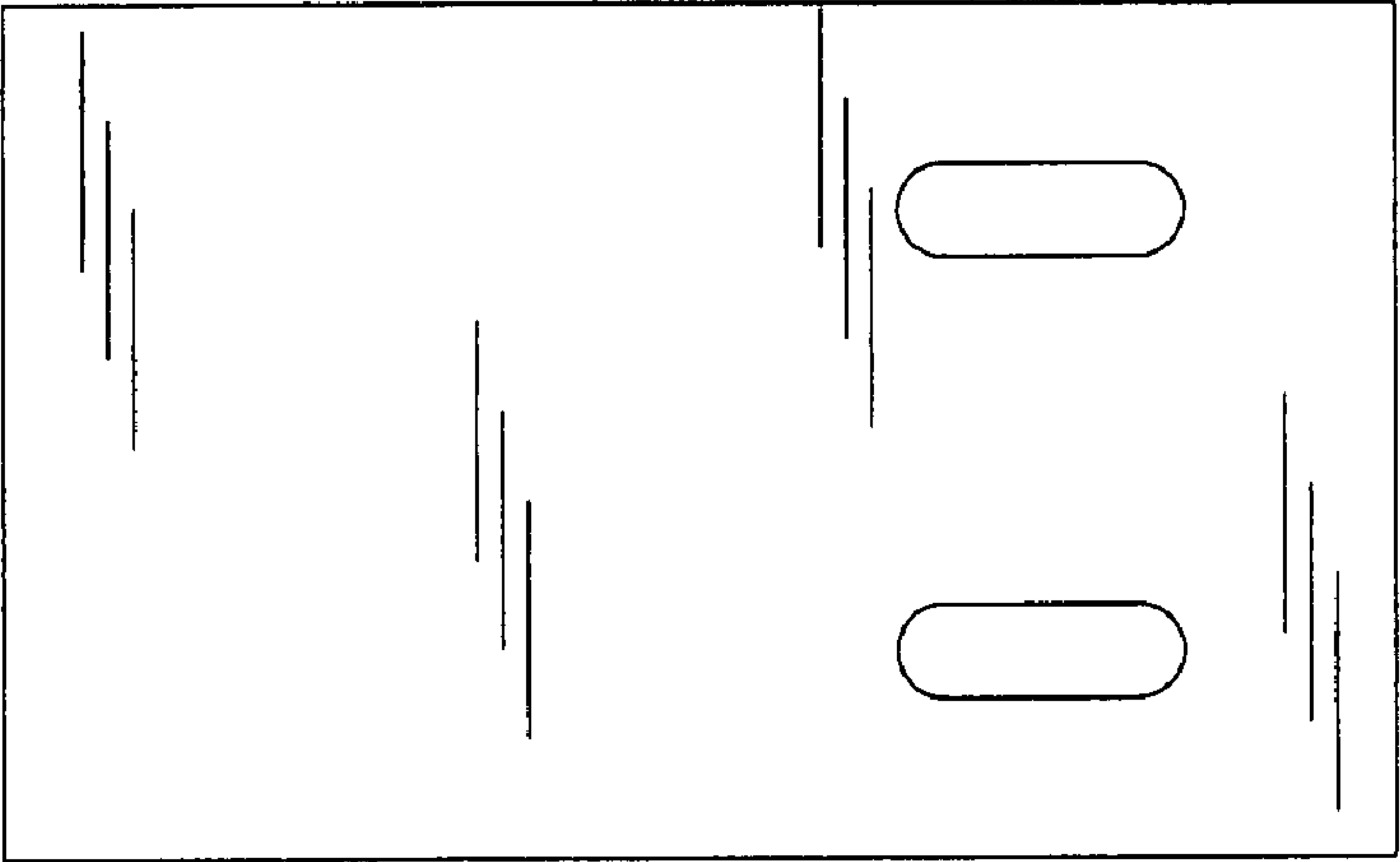

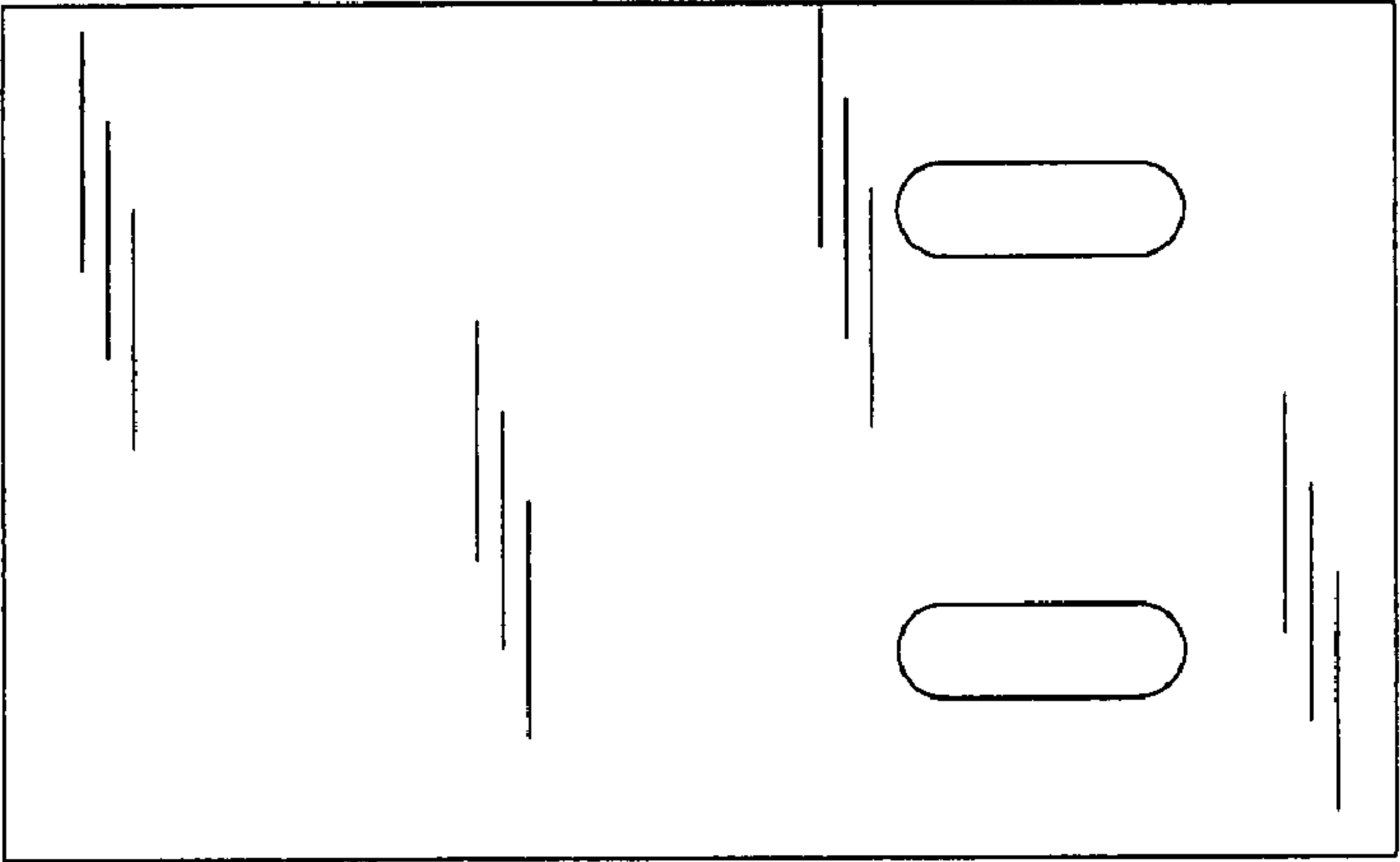

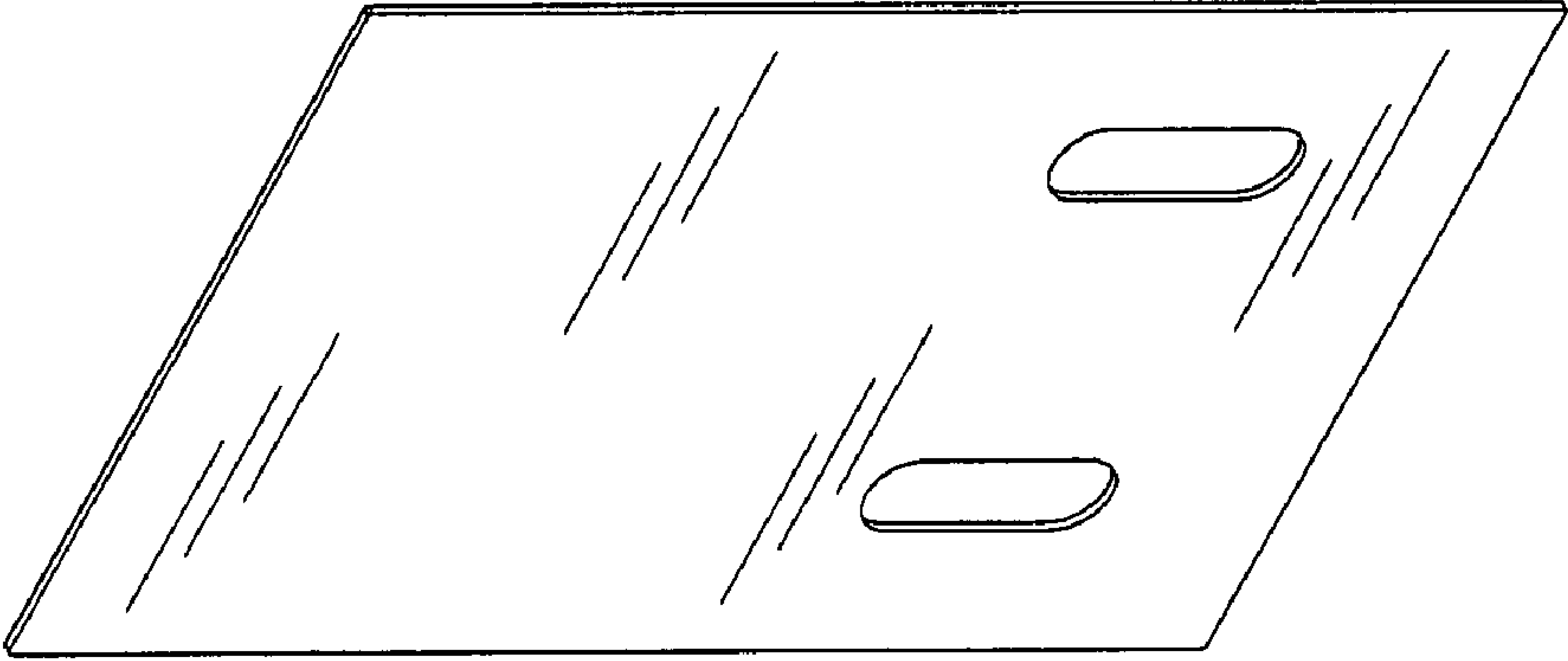

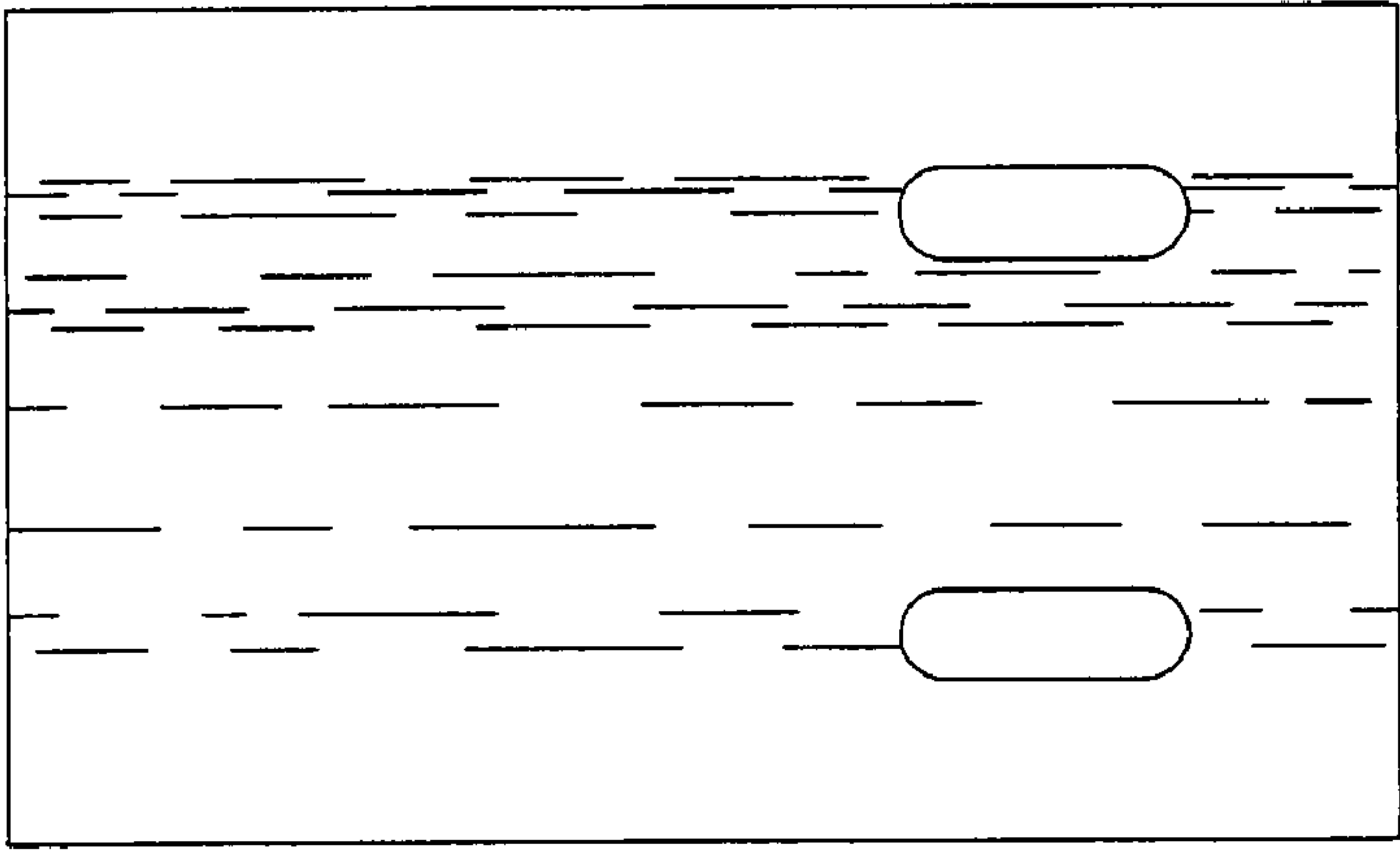

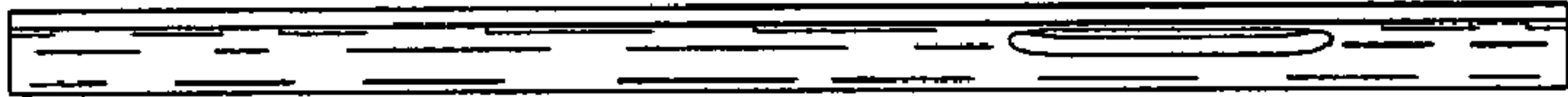

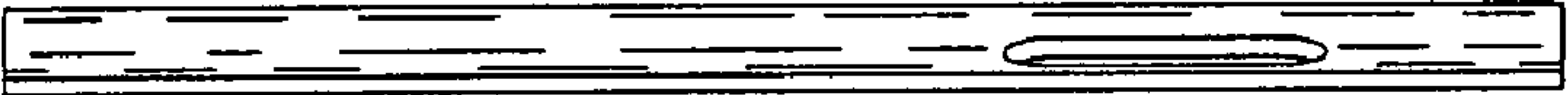

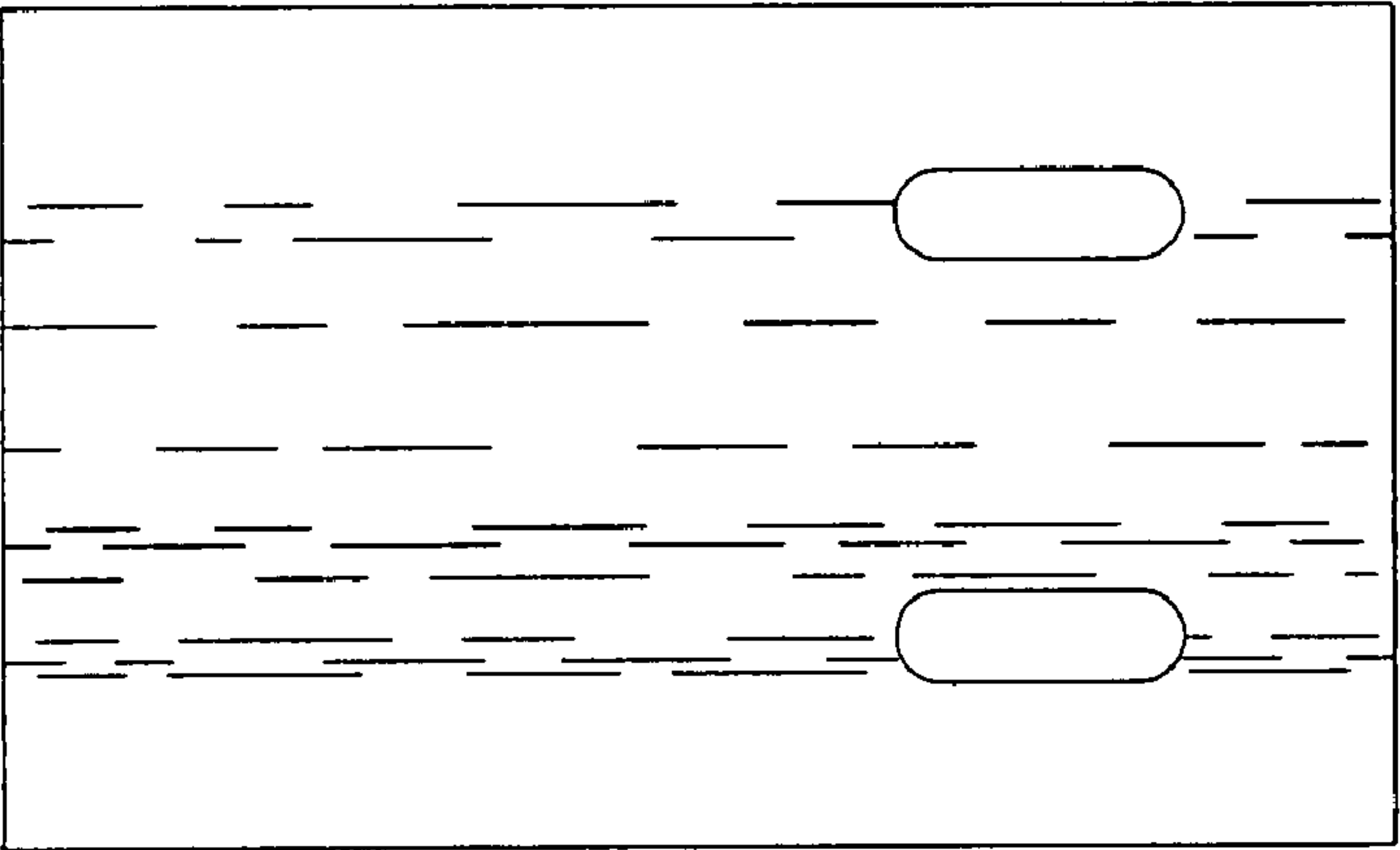

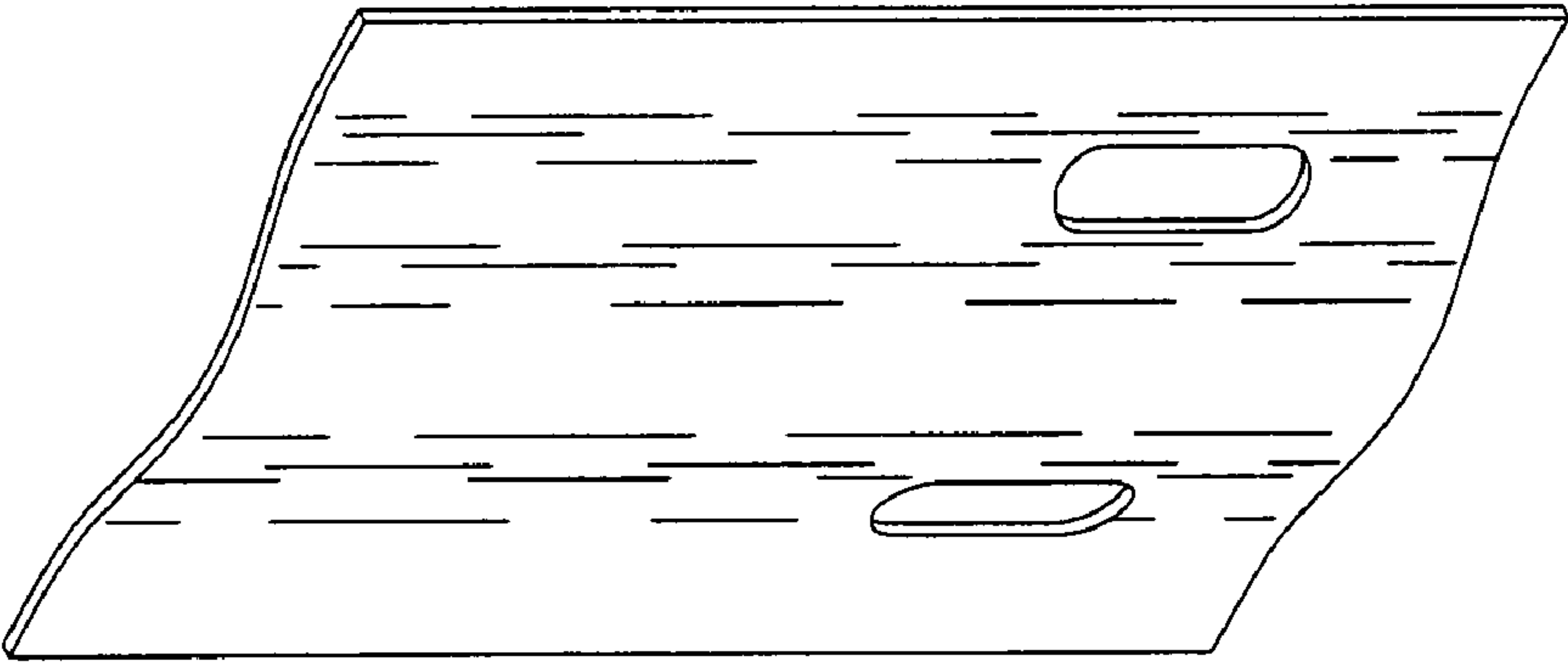
