(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an artificial gemstone, natural gemstone, ornamental object made of glass, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom view of the artificial gemstone, natural gemstone, ornamental object made of glass according to the first embodiment;

FIG. 2 is a right end view of the artificial gemstone, natural gemstone, ornamental object made of glass according to the first embodiment;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the artificial gemstone, natural gemstone, ornamental object made of glass according to the first embodiment;

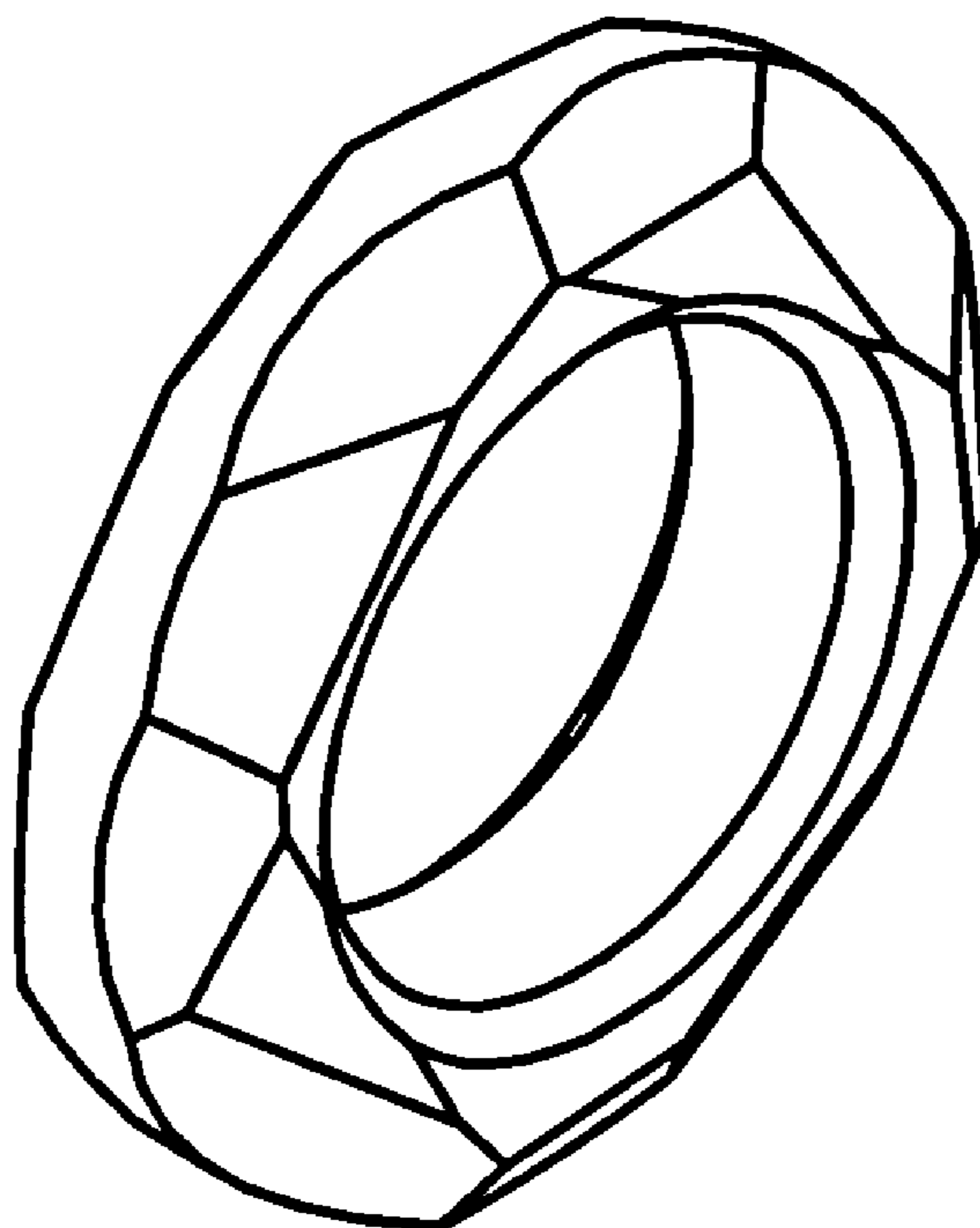
FIG. 4 is a left end view of the artificial gemstone, natural gemstone, ornamental object made of glass according to the first embodiment;

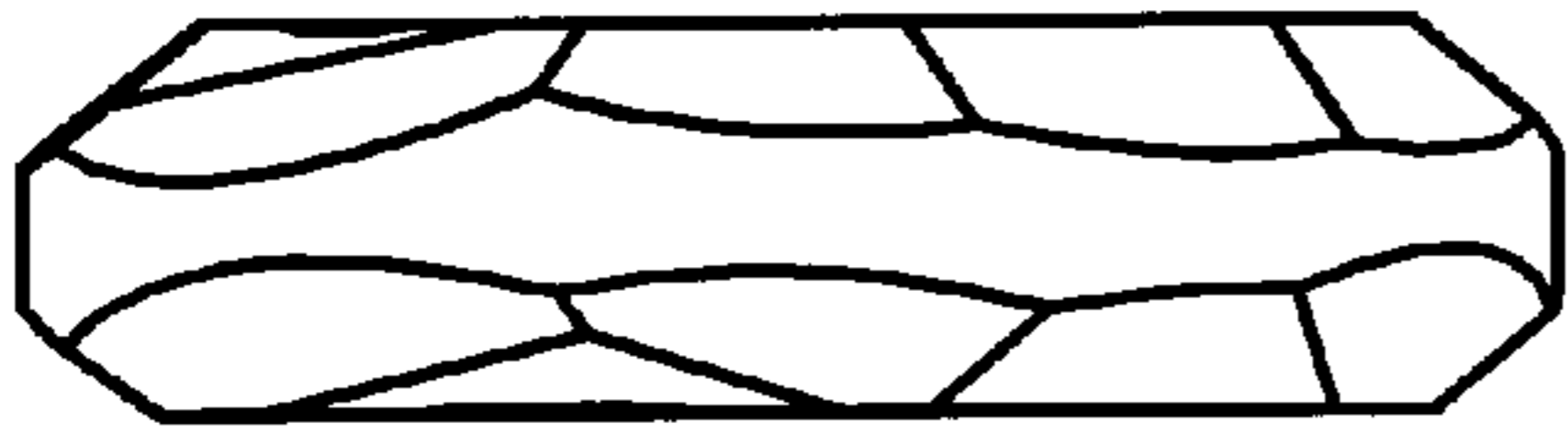

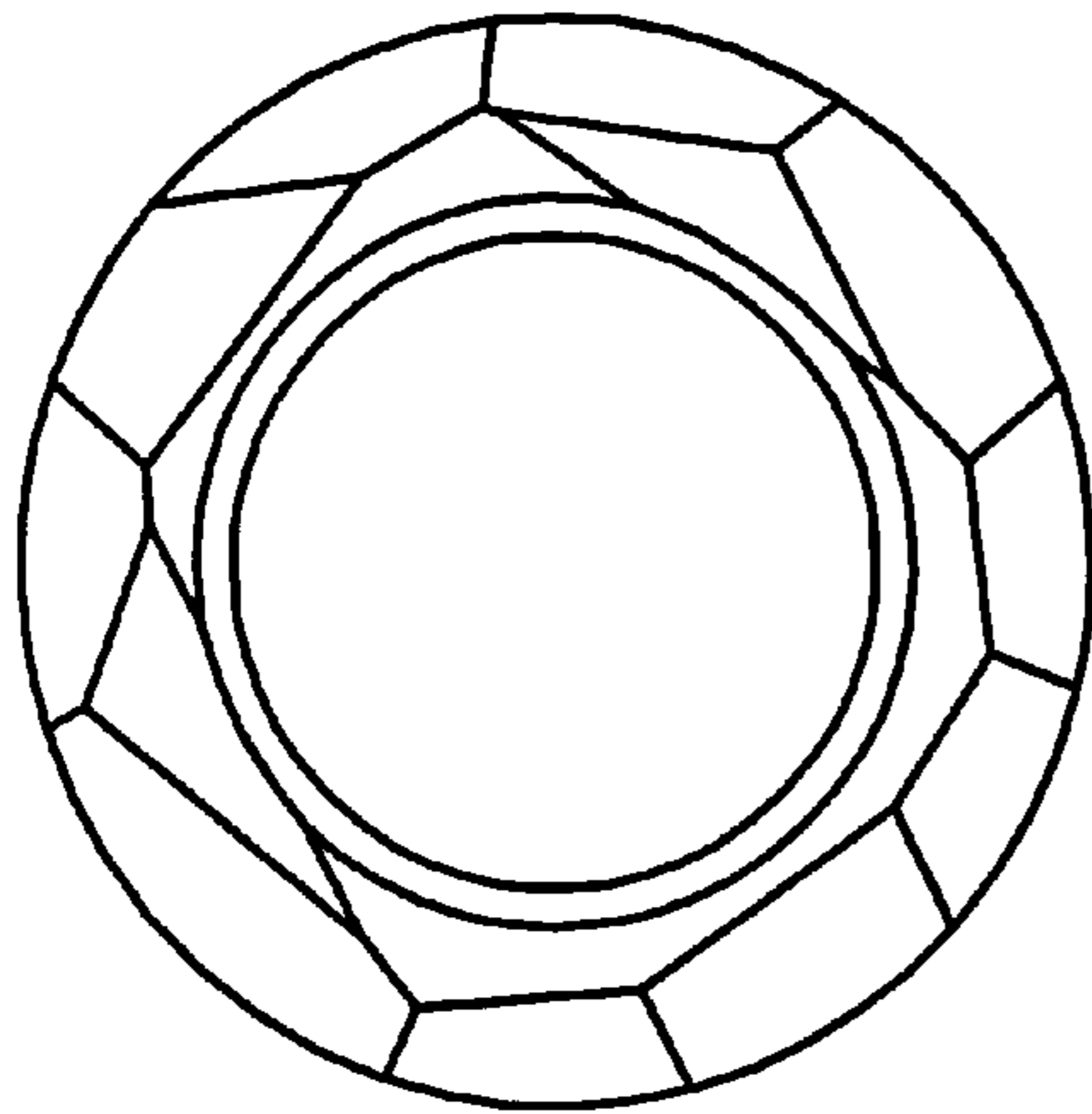

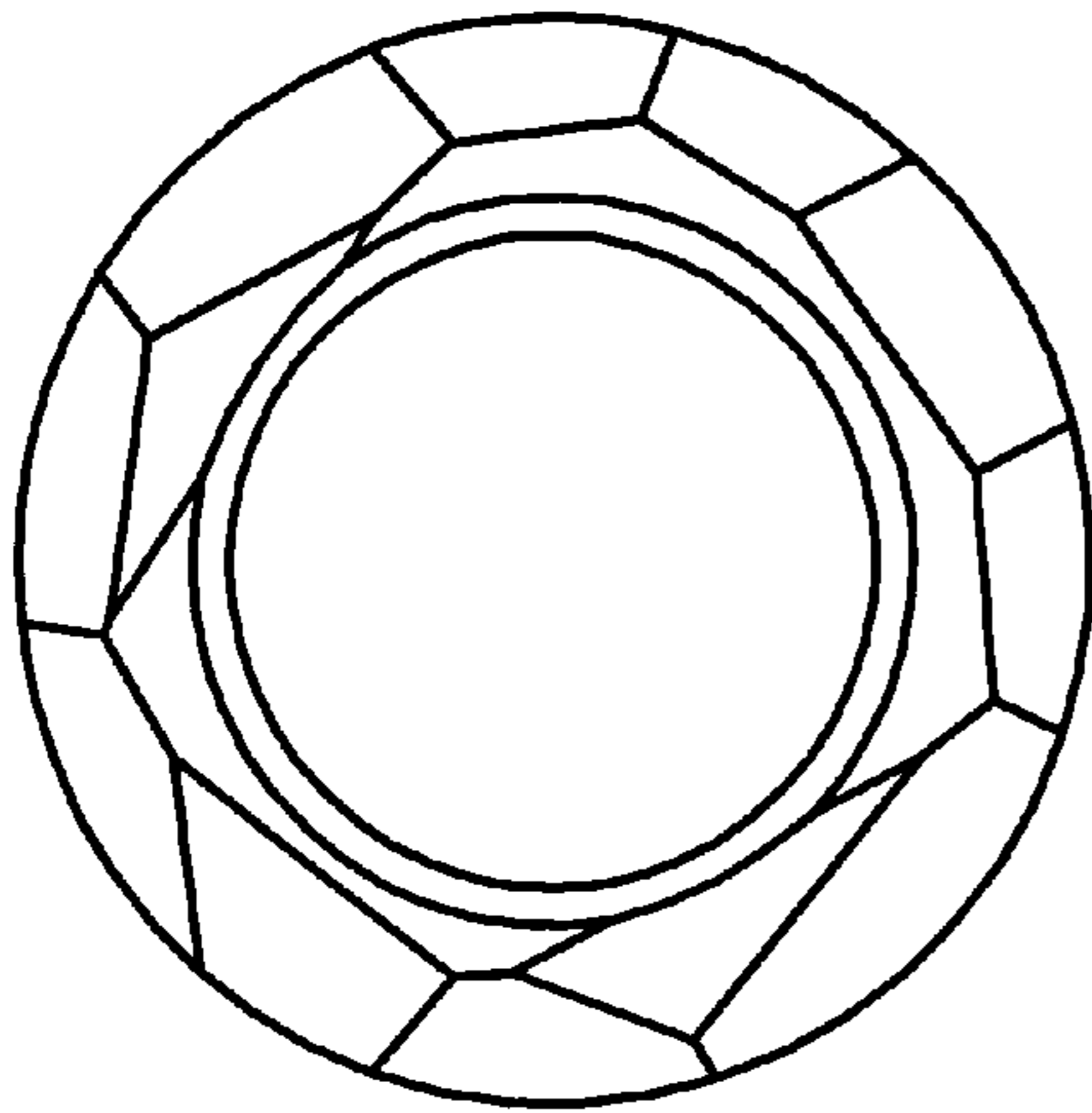

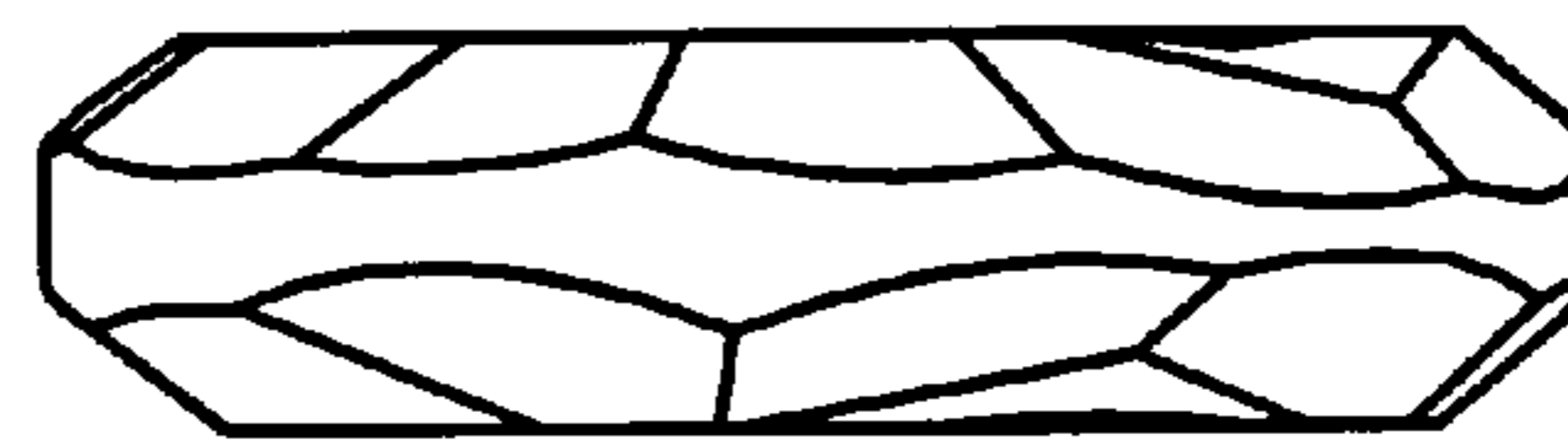

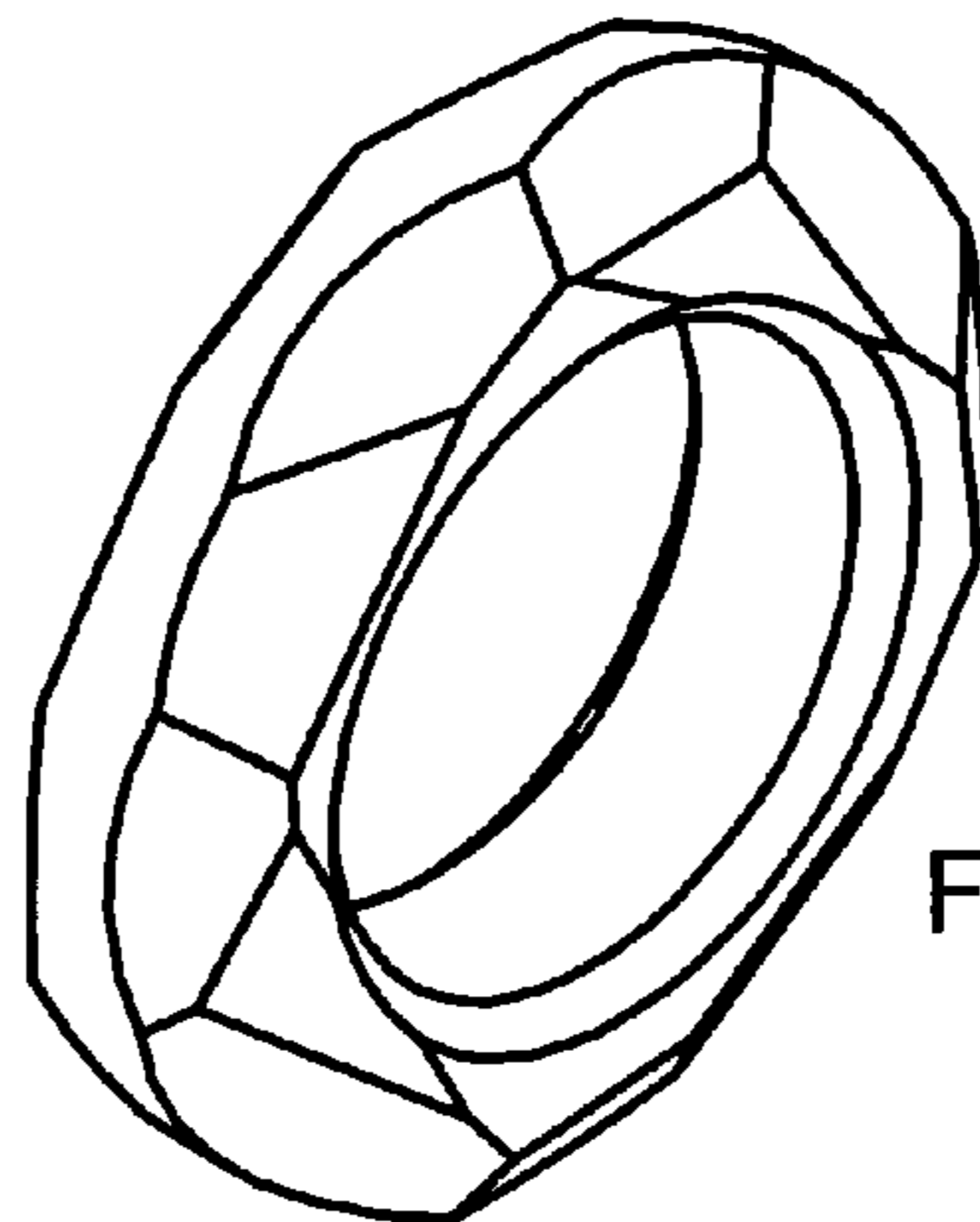
