DESCRIPTION

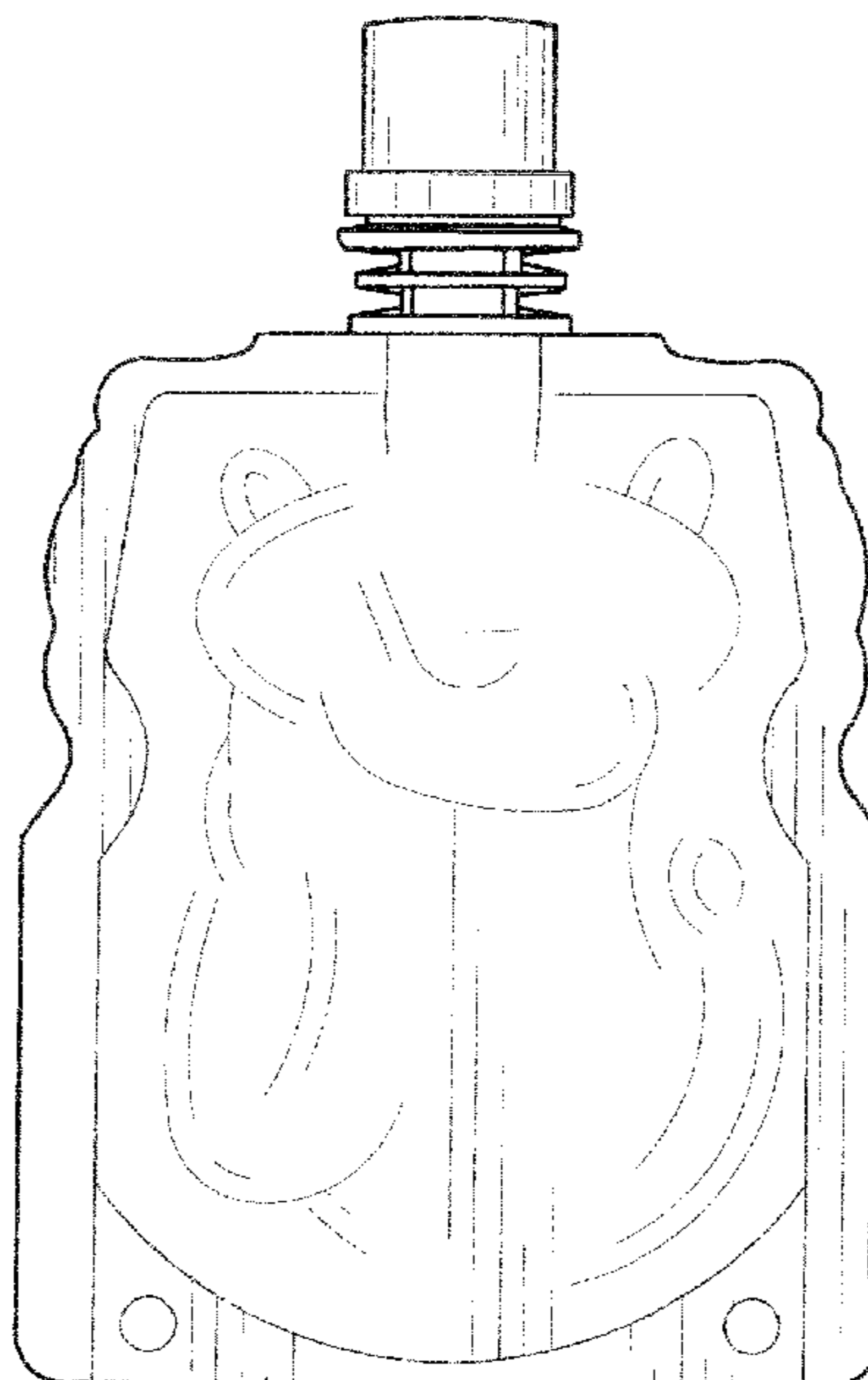
FIG. 1 is an elevational view of front side of a lion-shaped flexible pouch;

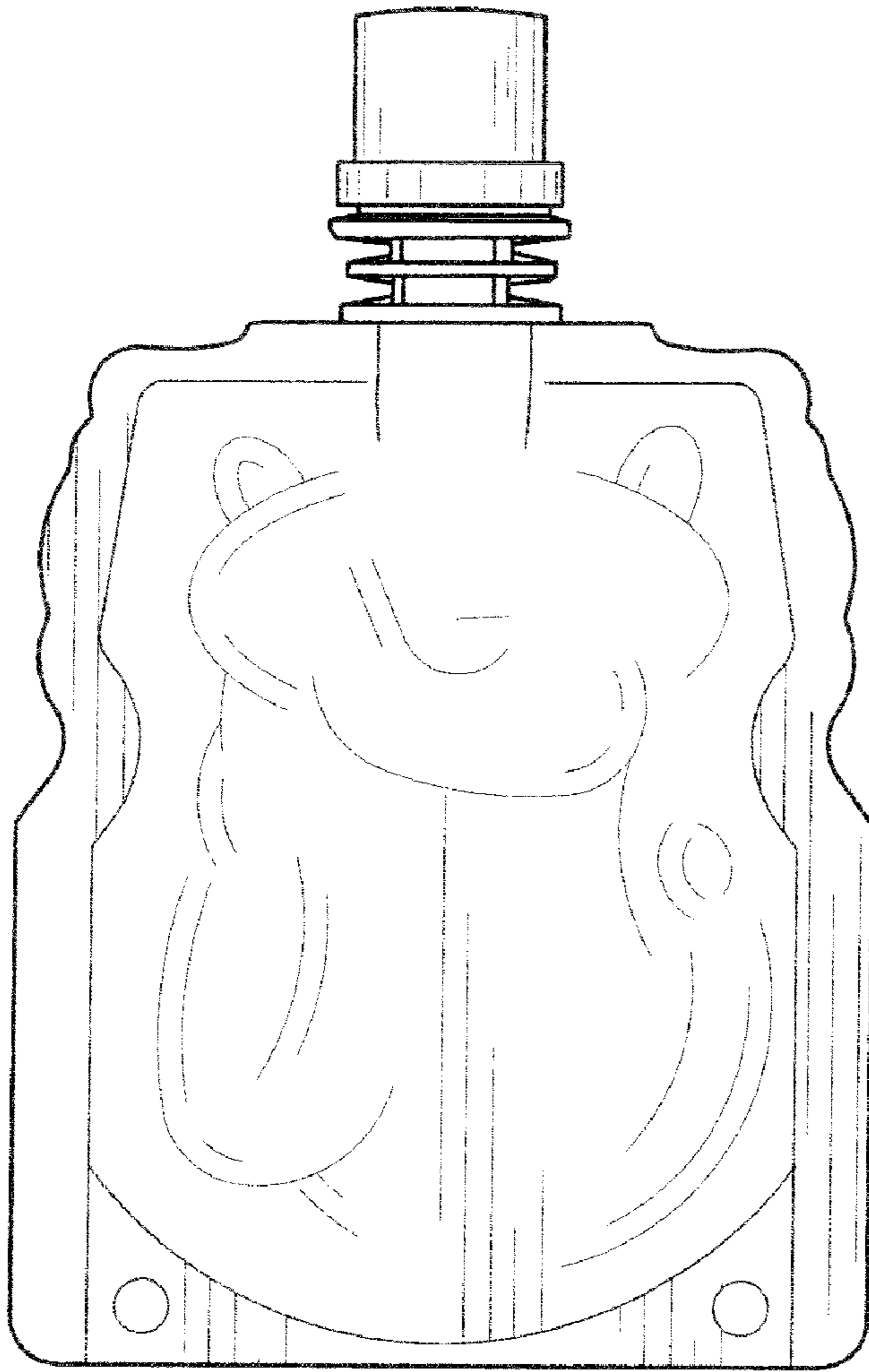

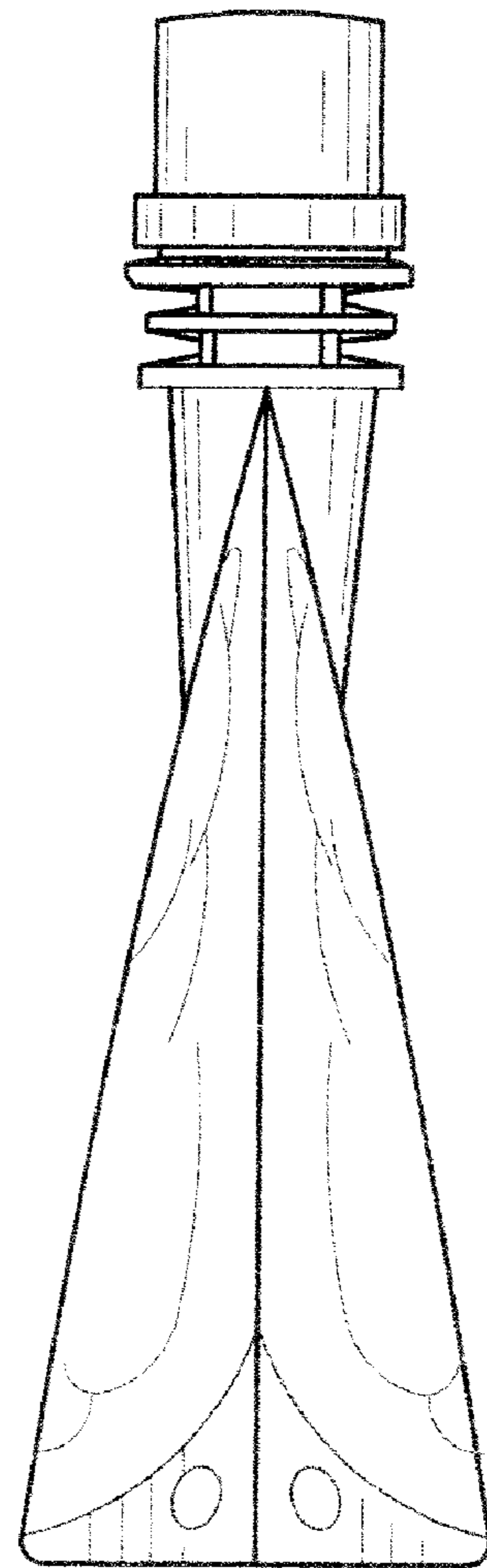

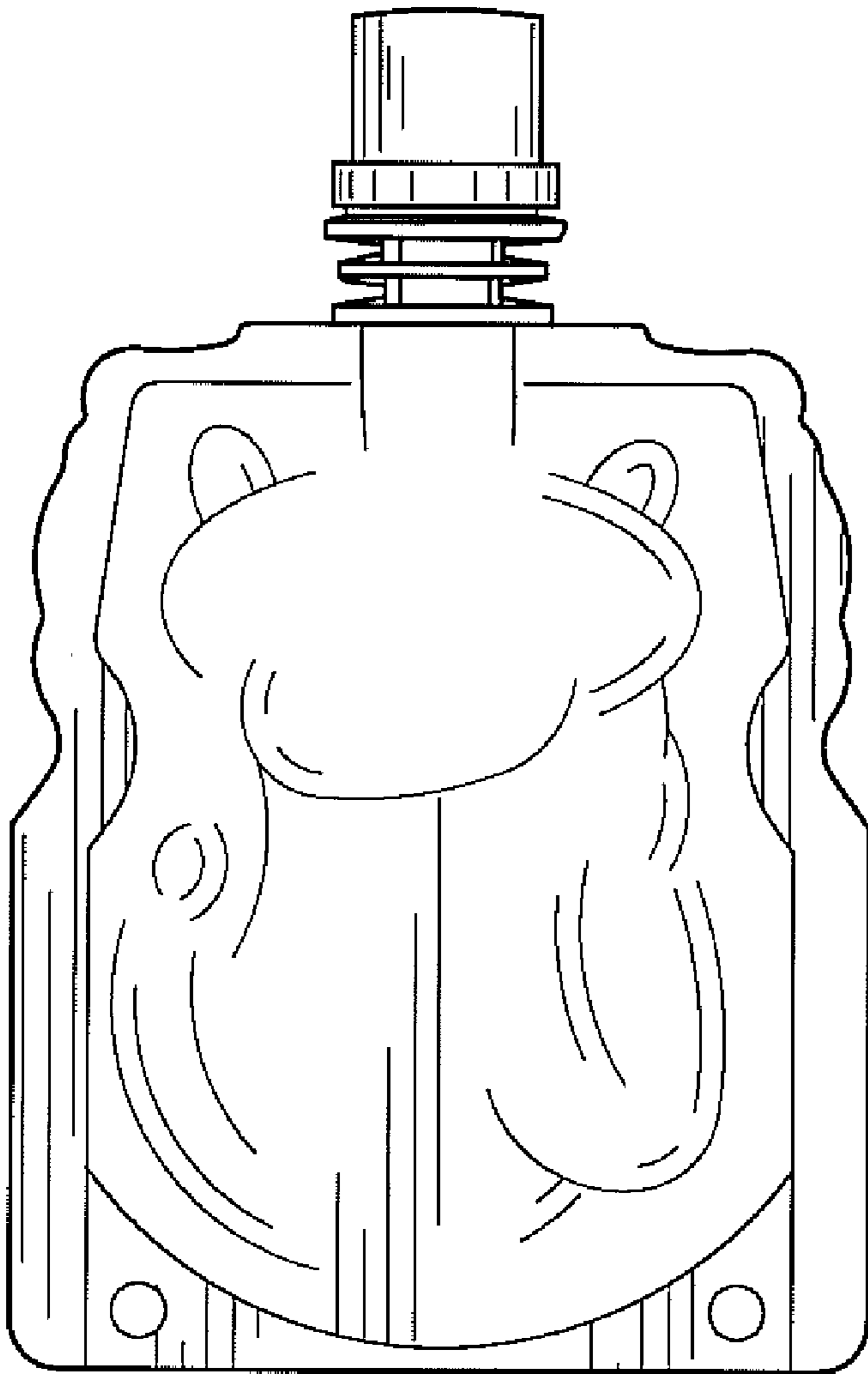
