FIG. 7 is a right-side view thereof; and,

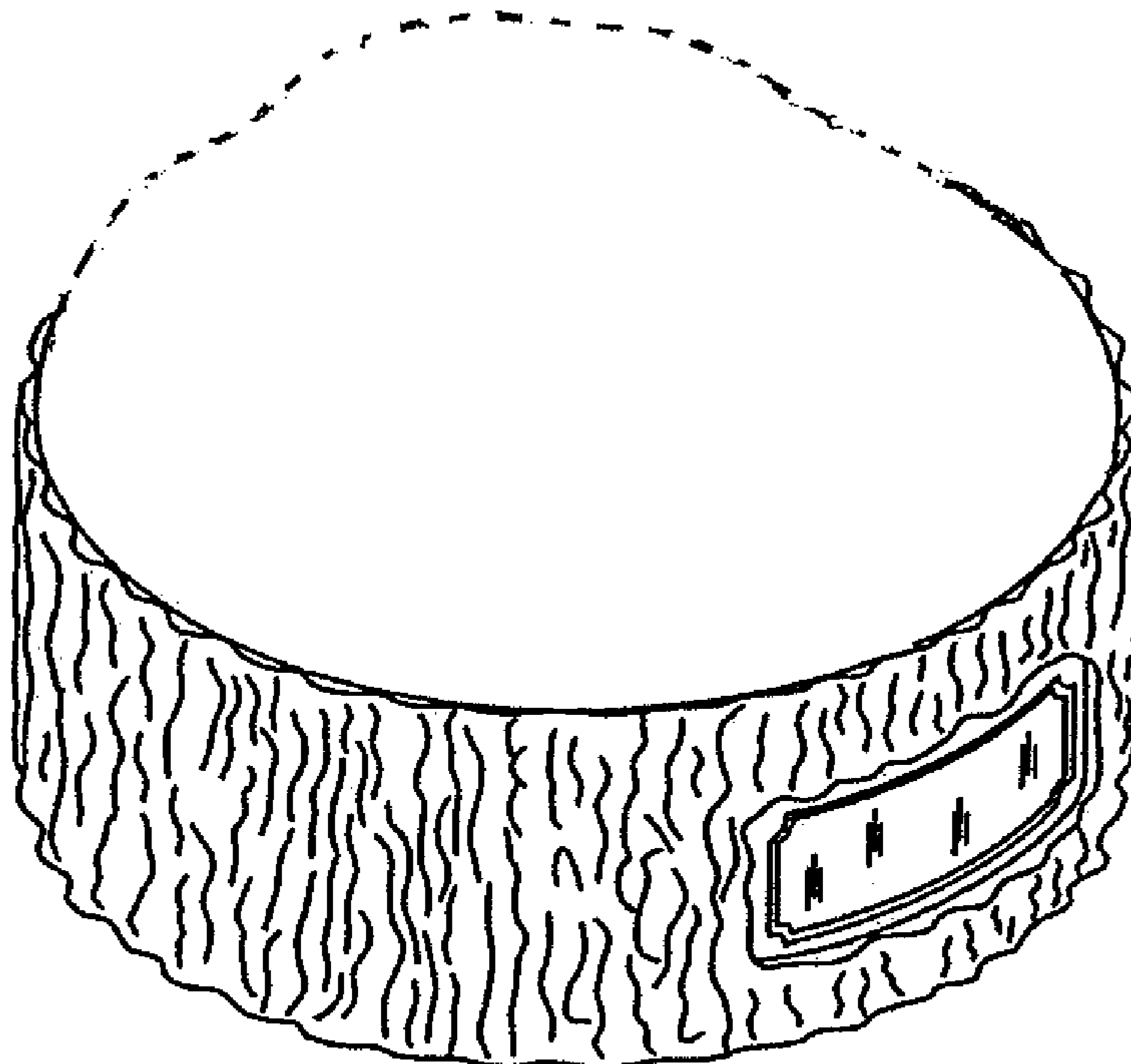
FIG. 8 is a front view thereof. The dotted line portion showing a pair of antlers is for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

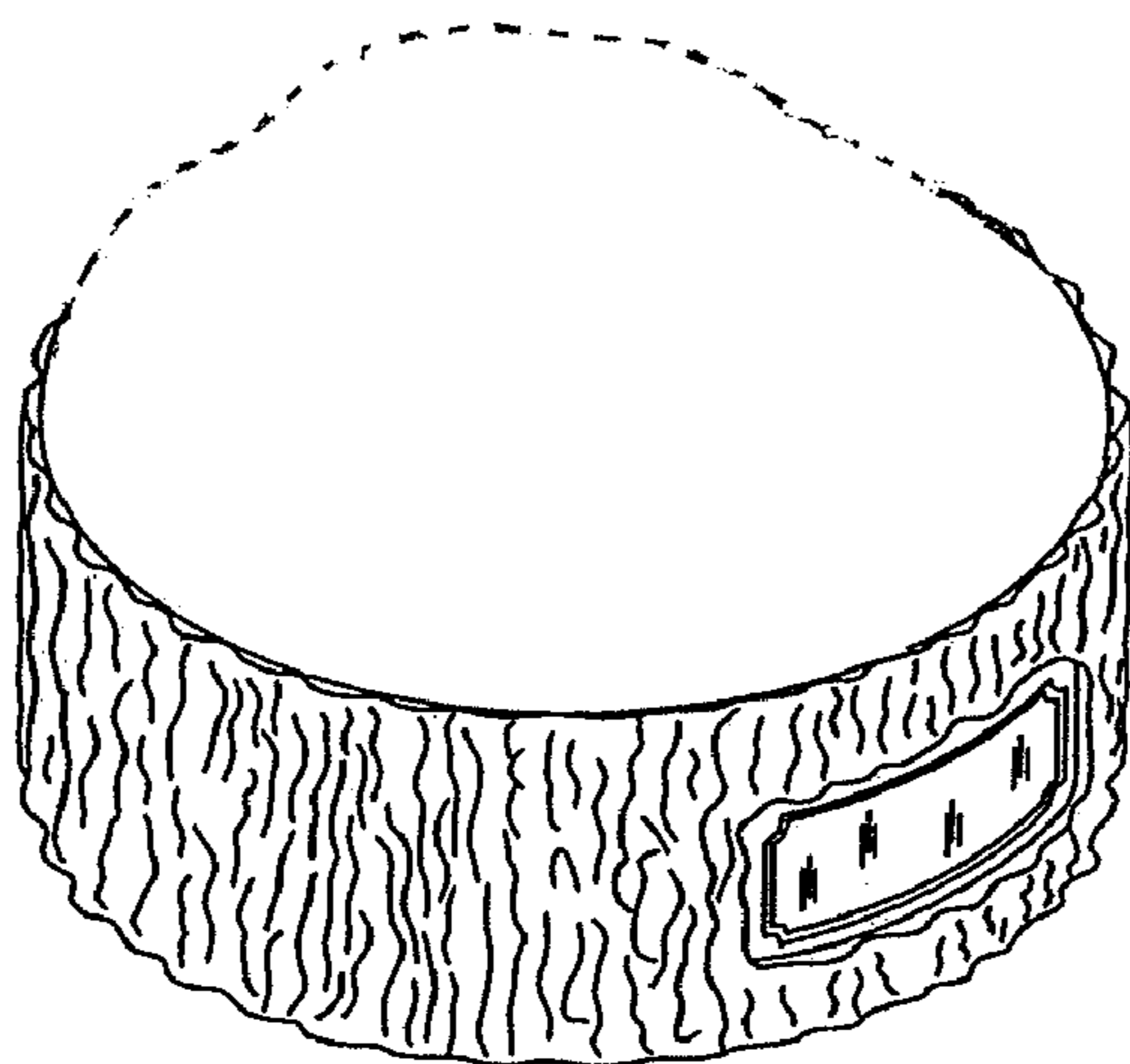

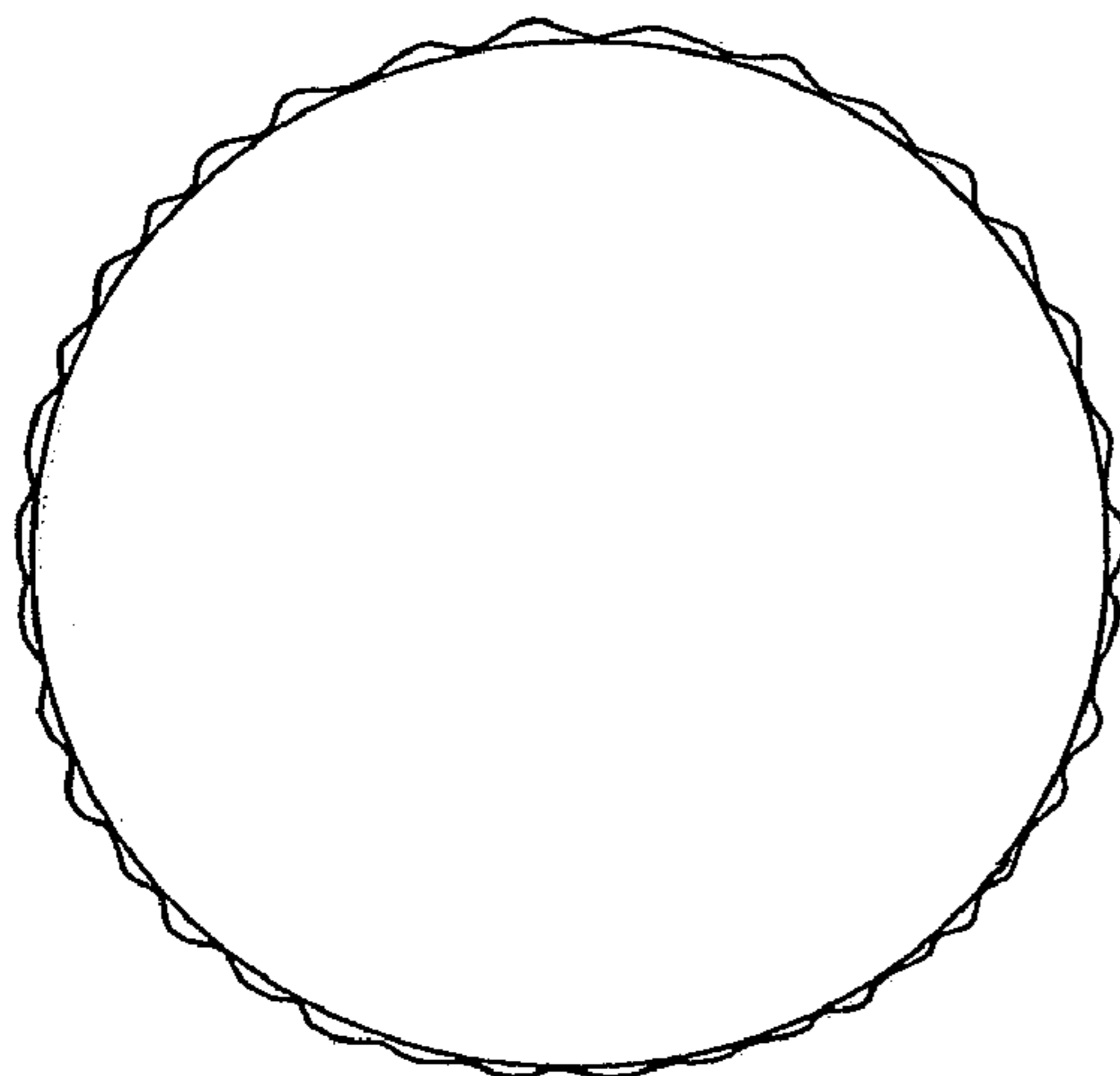

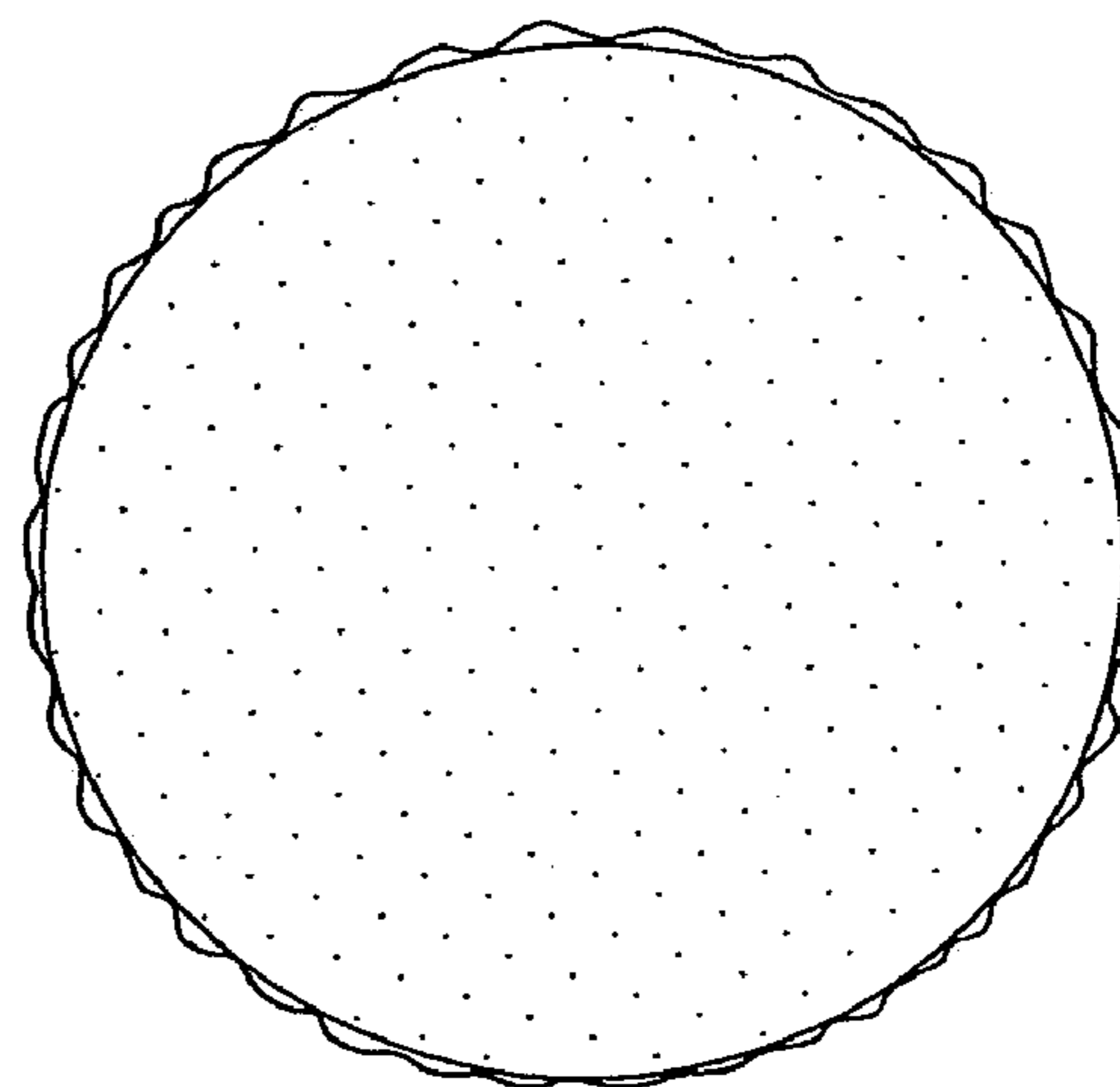

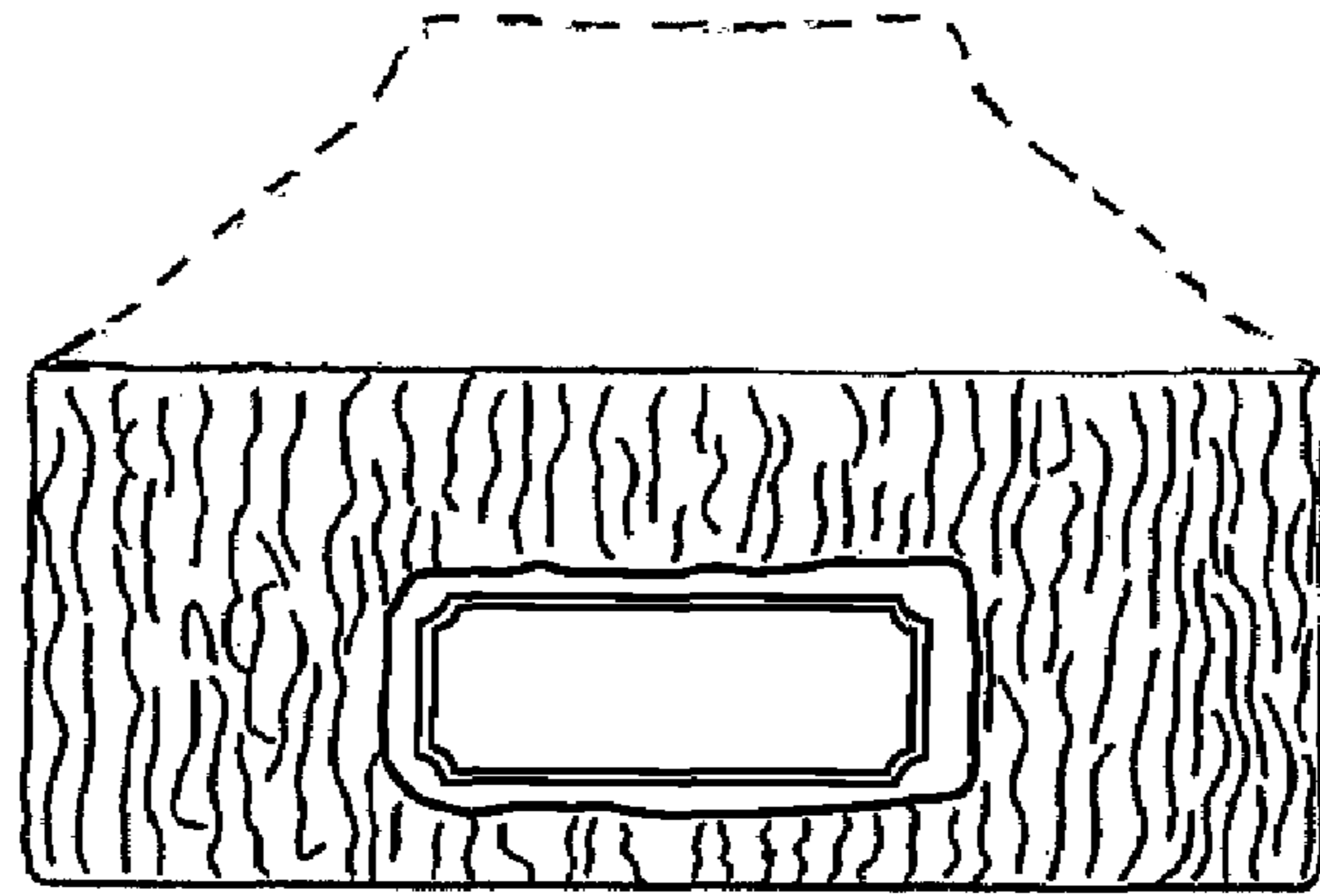

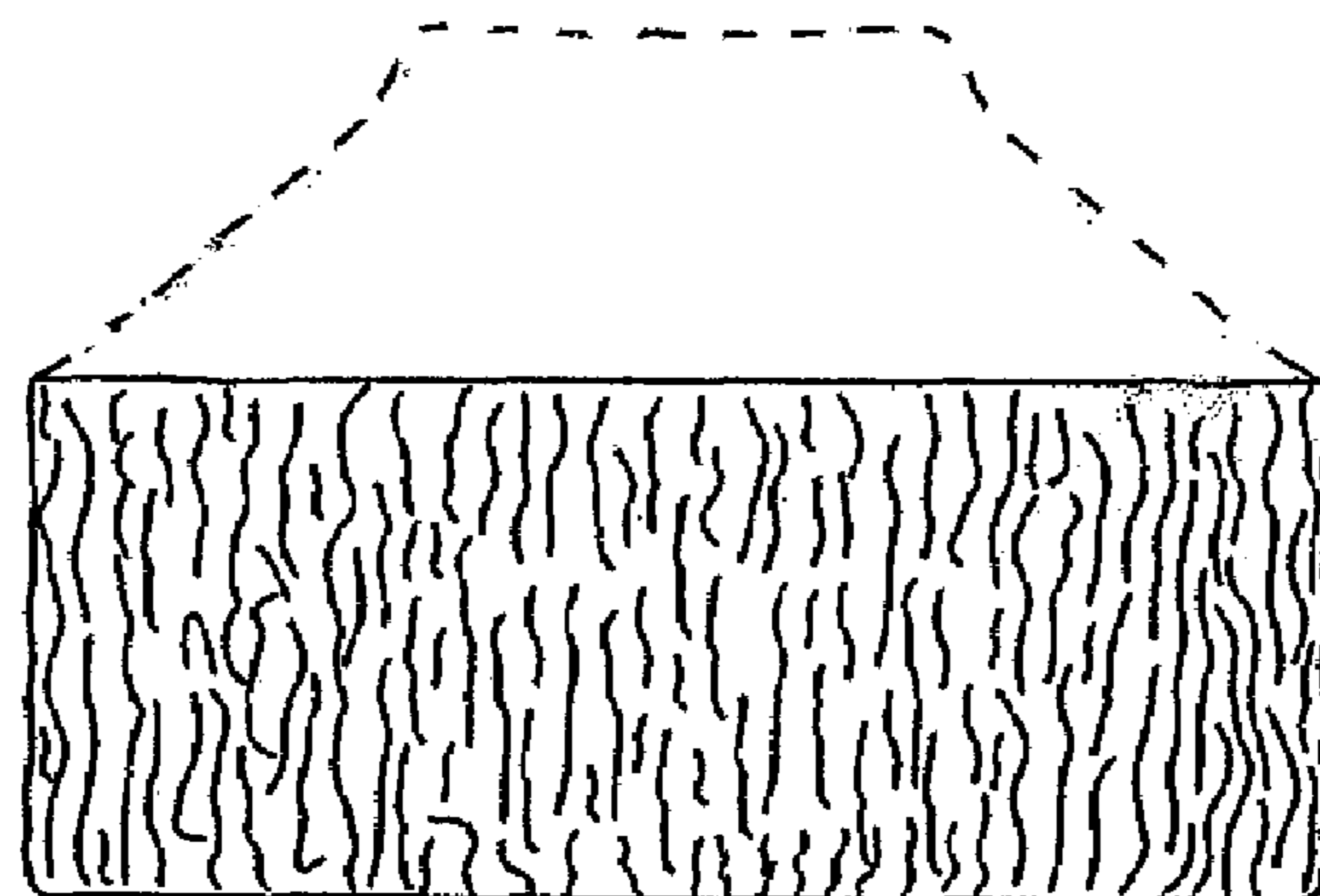

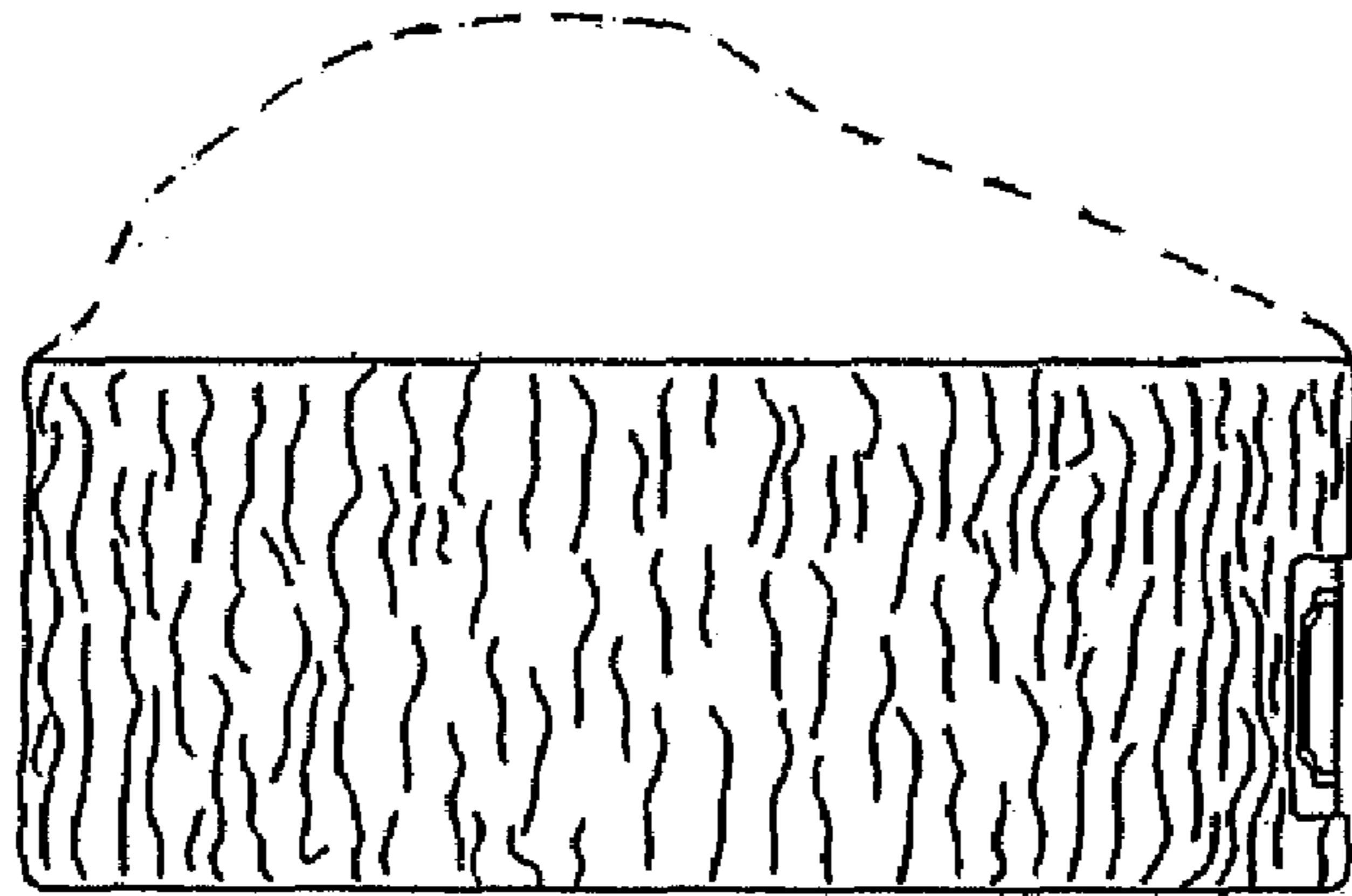

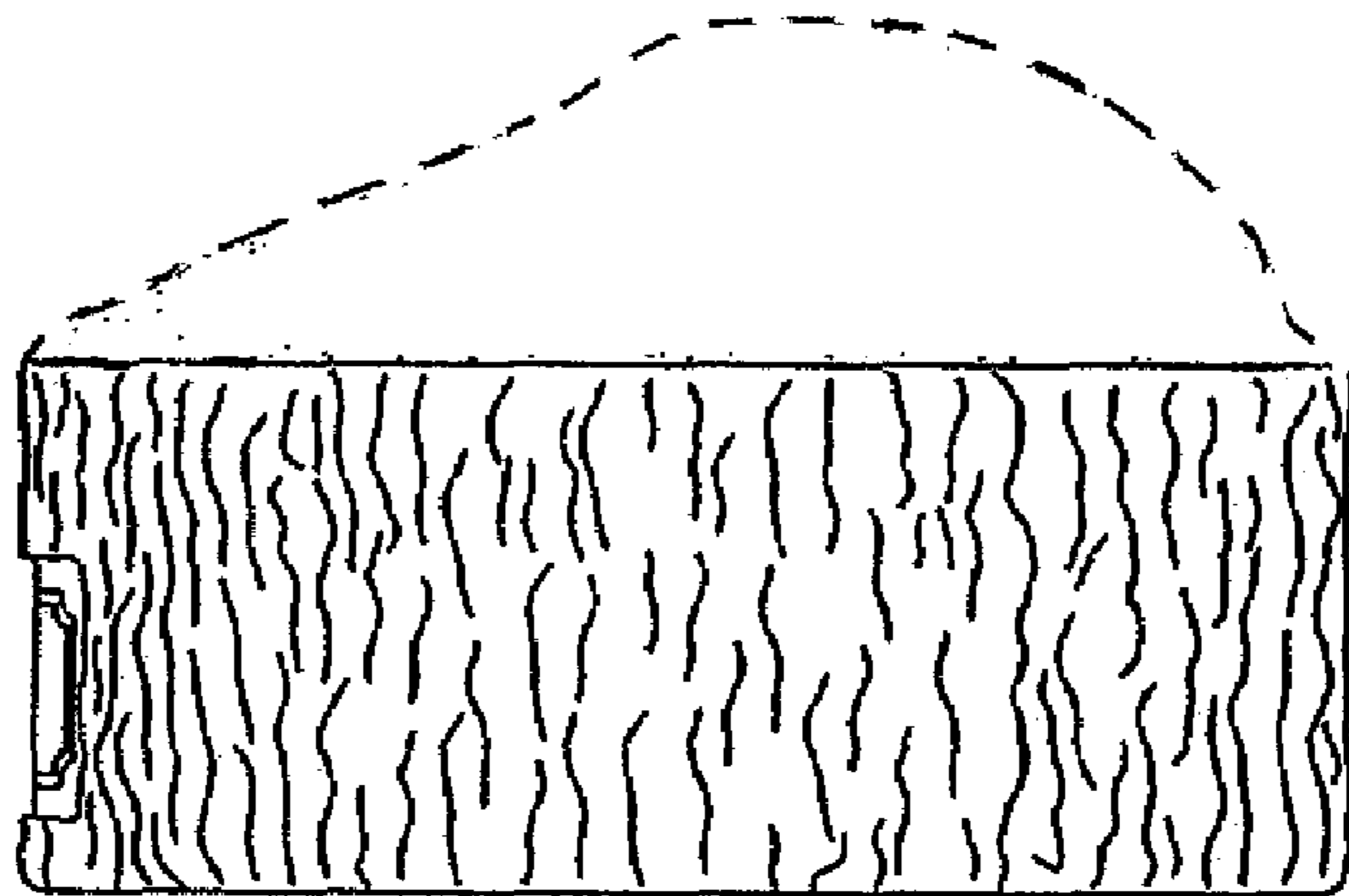

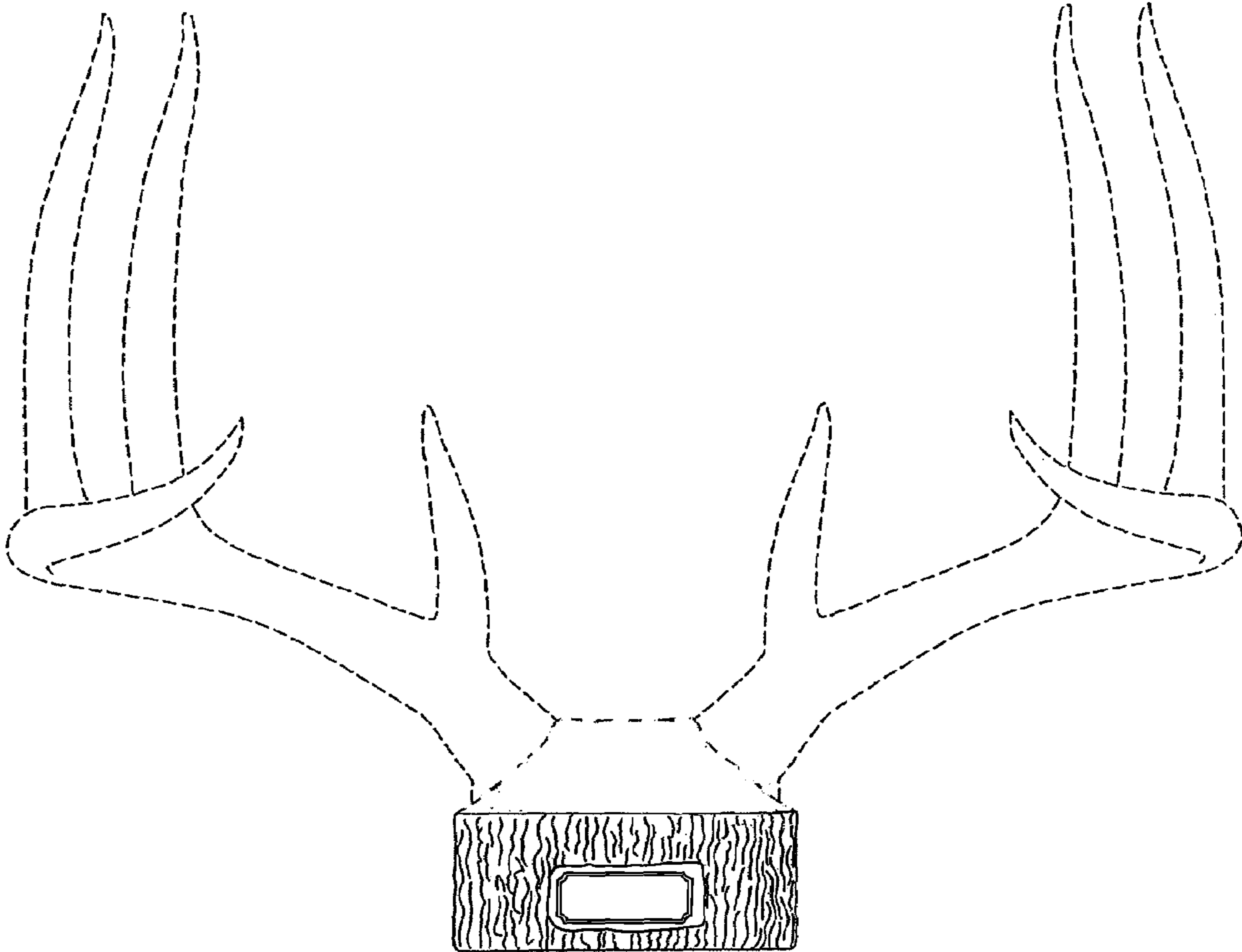
