FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a pet dish;

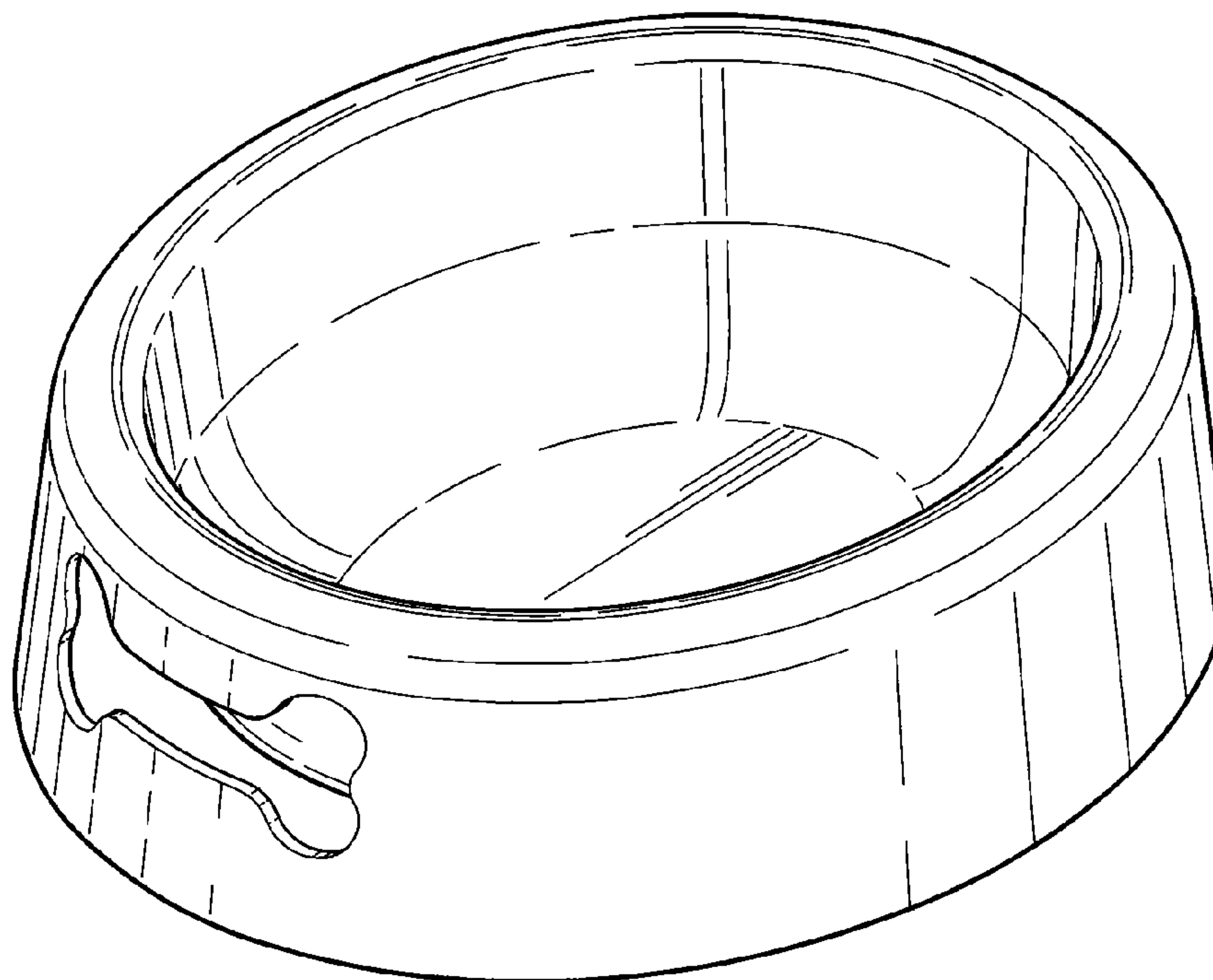
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational

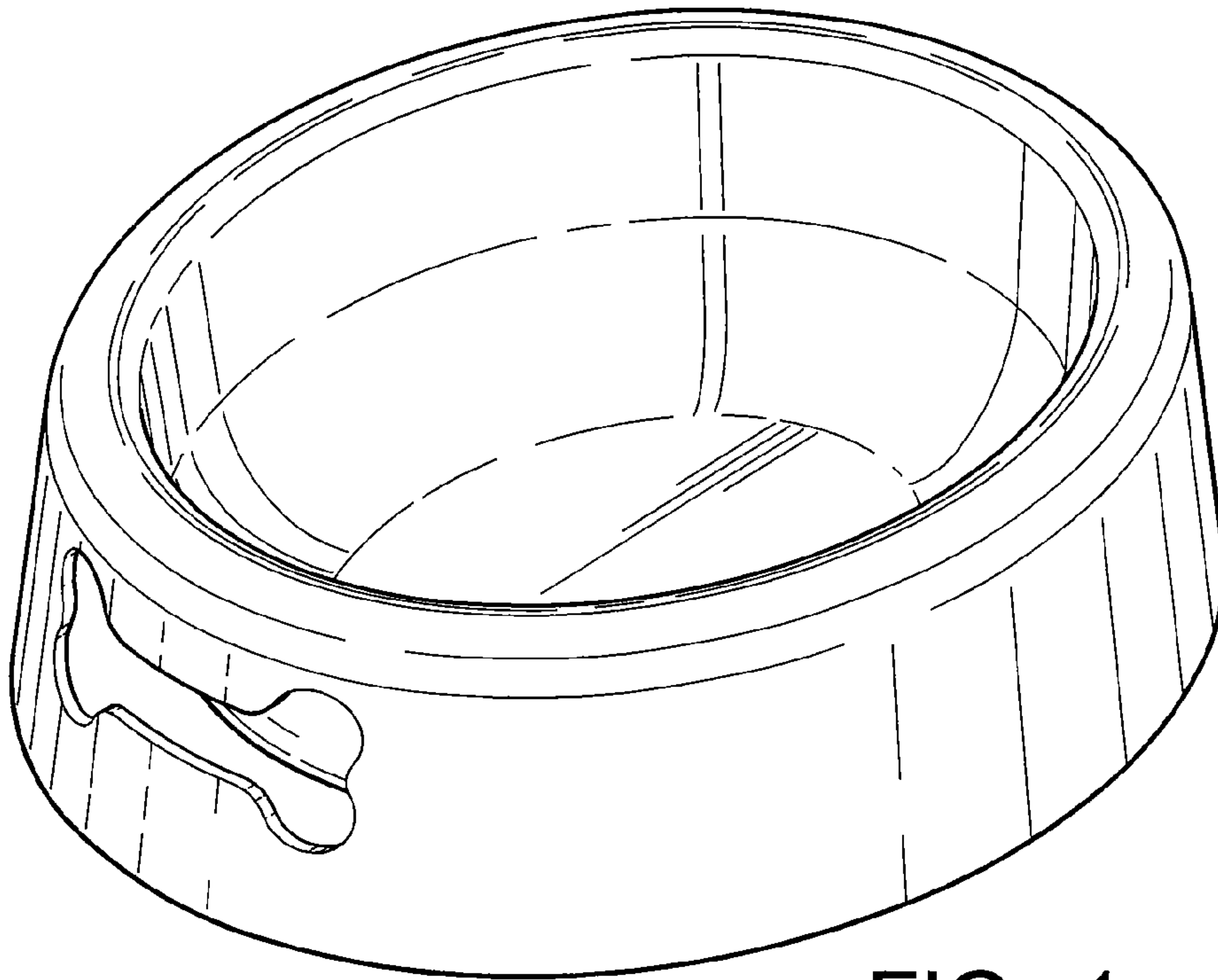

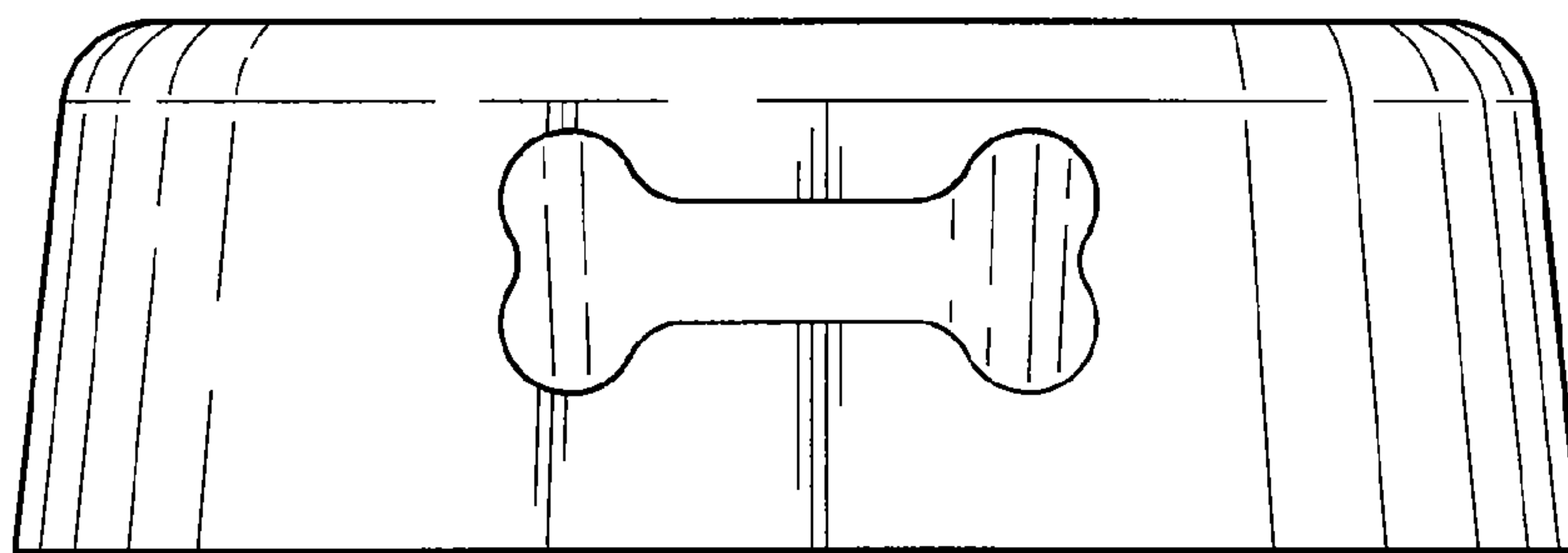

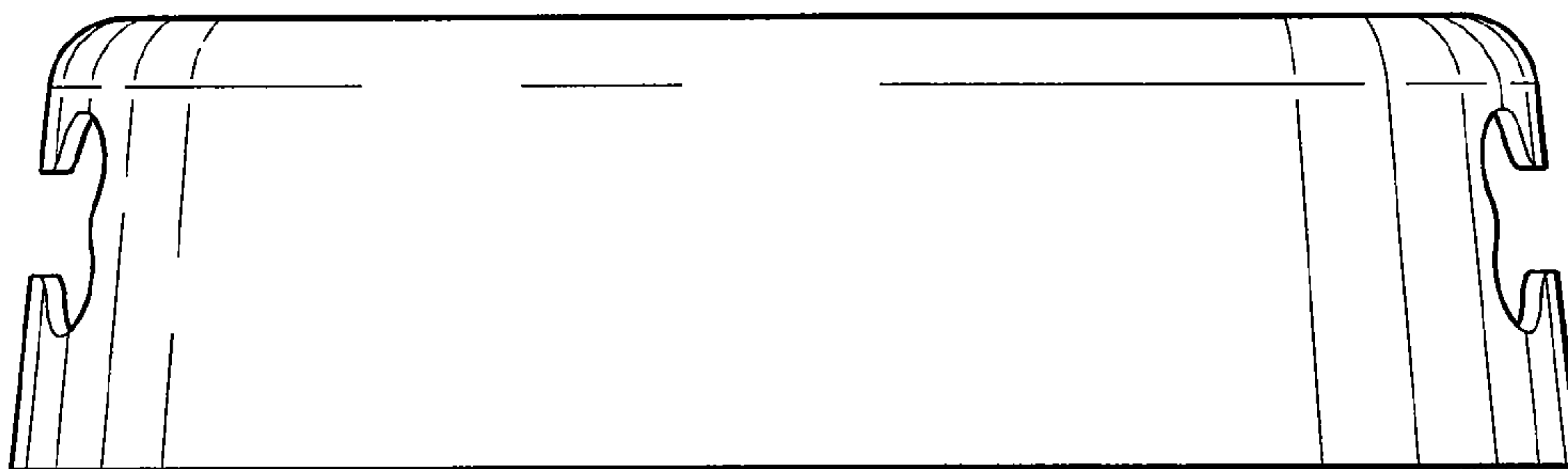

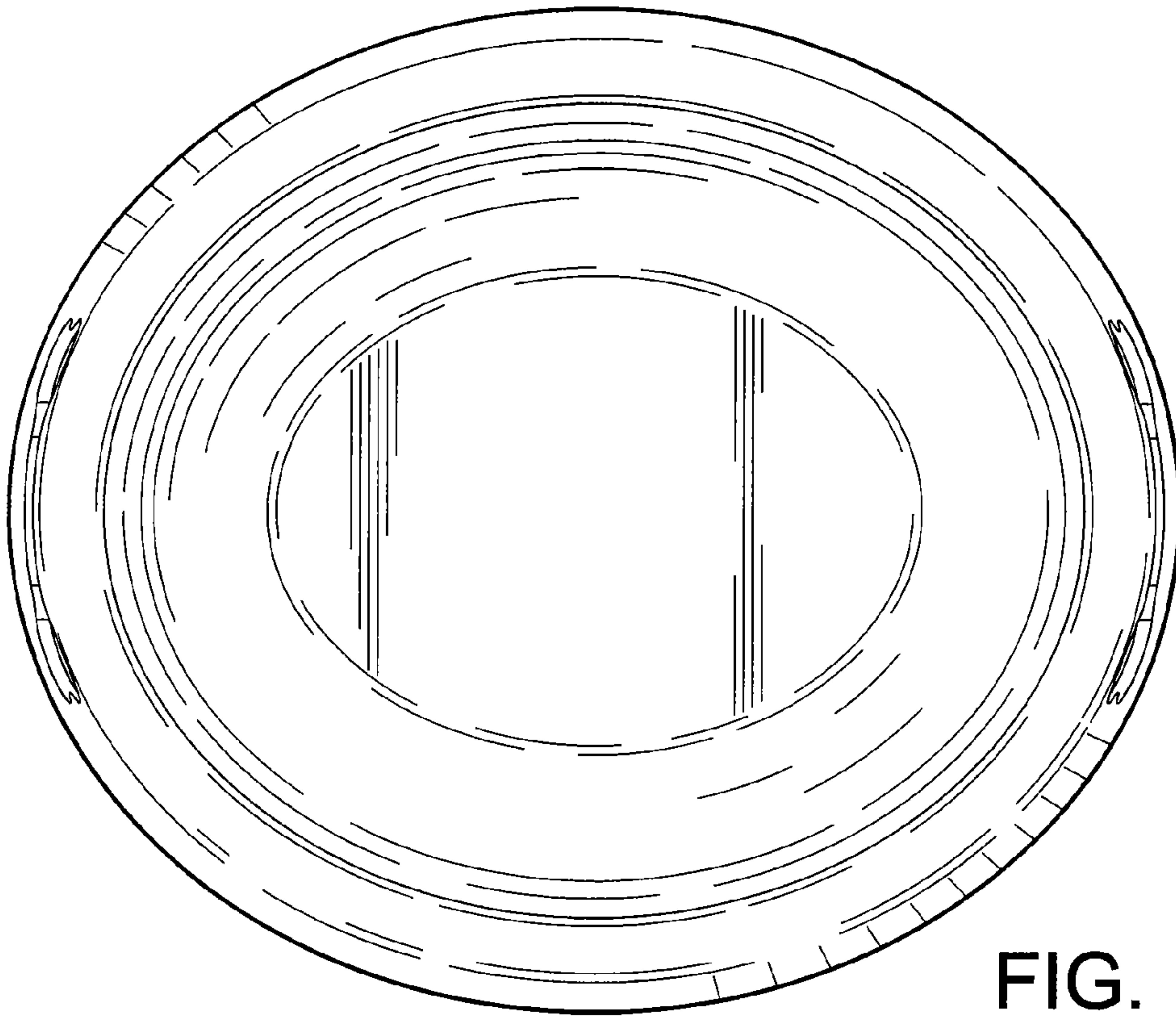

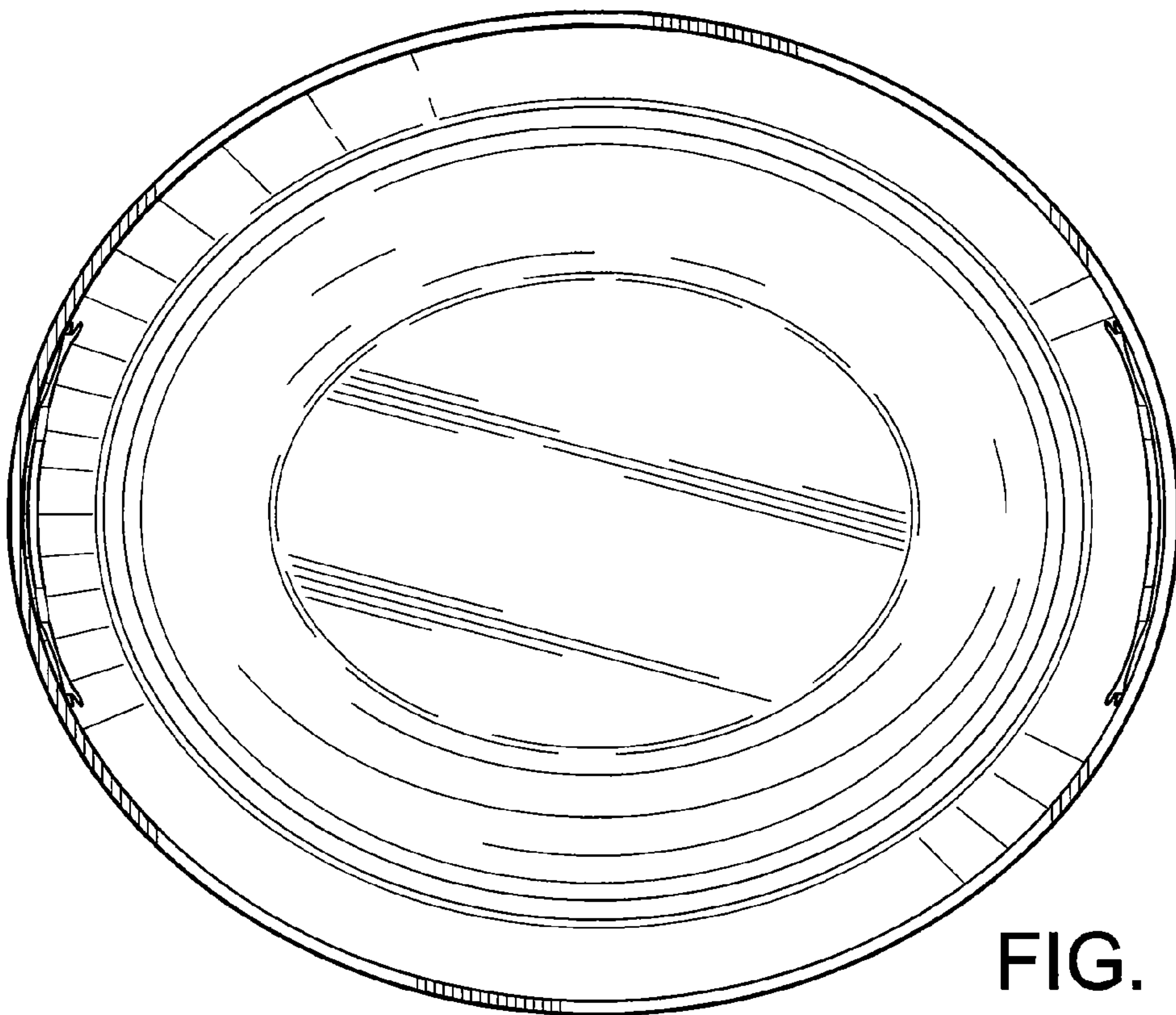
