The ornamental design for a beauty salon chair with extended curved arms, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a beauty salon chair with extended curved arms showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged front elevational view of the beauty salon chair with extended curved arms of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view of the beauty salon chair with extended curved arms of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged left side elevational view of the beauty salon chair with extended curved arms of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged right side elevational view of the beauty salon chair with extended curved arms of FIG. 1;

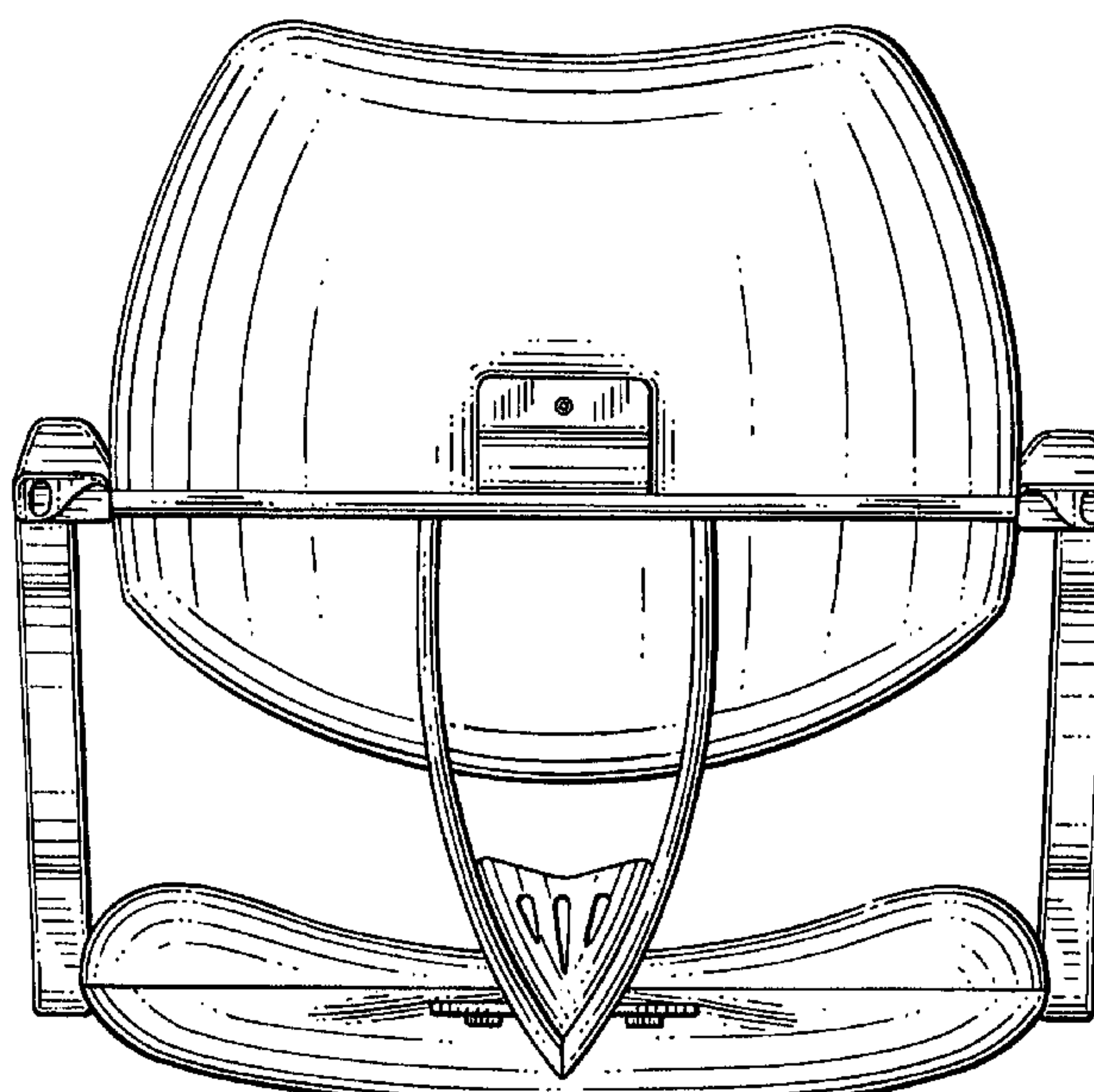
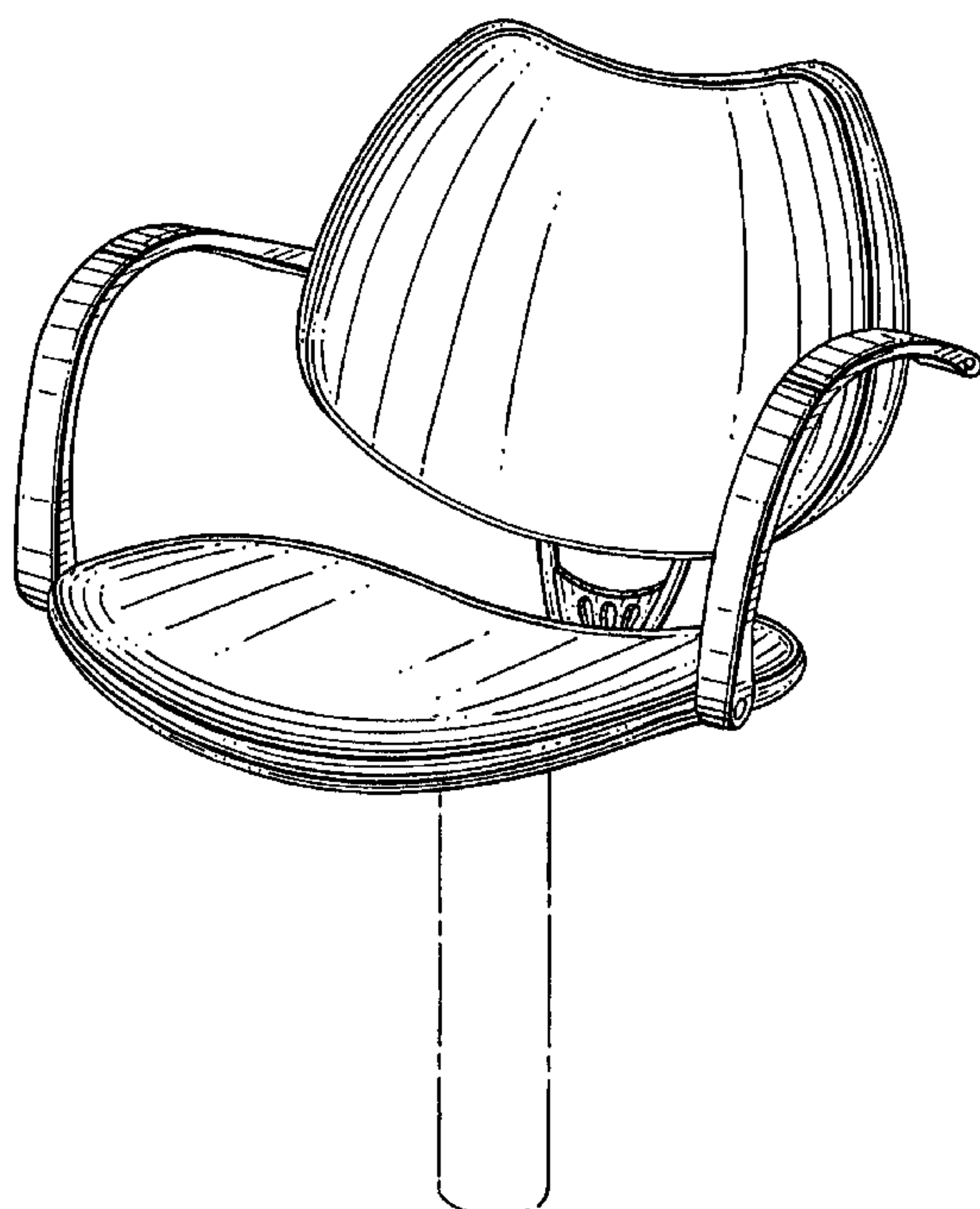
FIG. 6 is an enlarged back elevational view of the beauty salon chair with extended curved arms of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the beauty salon chair with extended curved arms of FIG. 1.

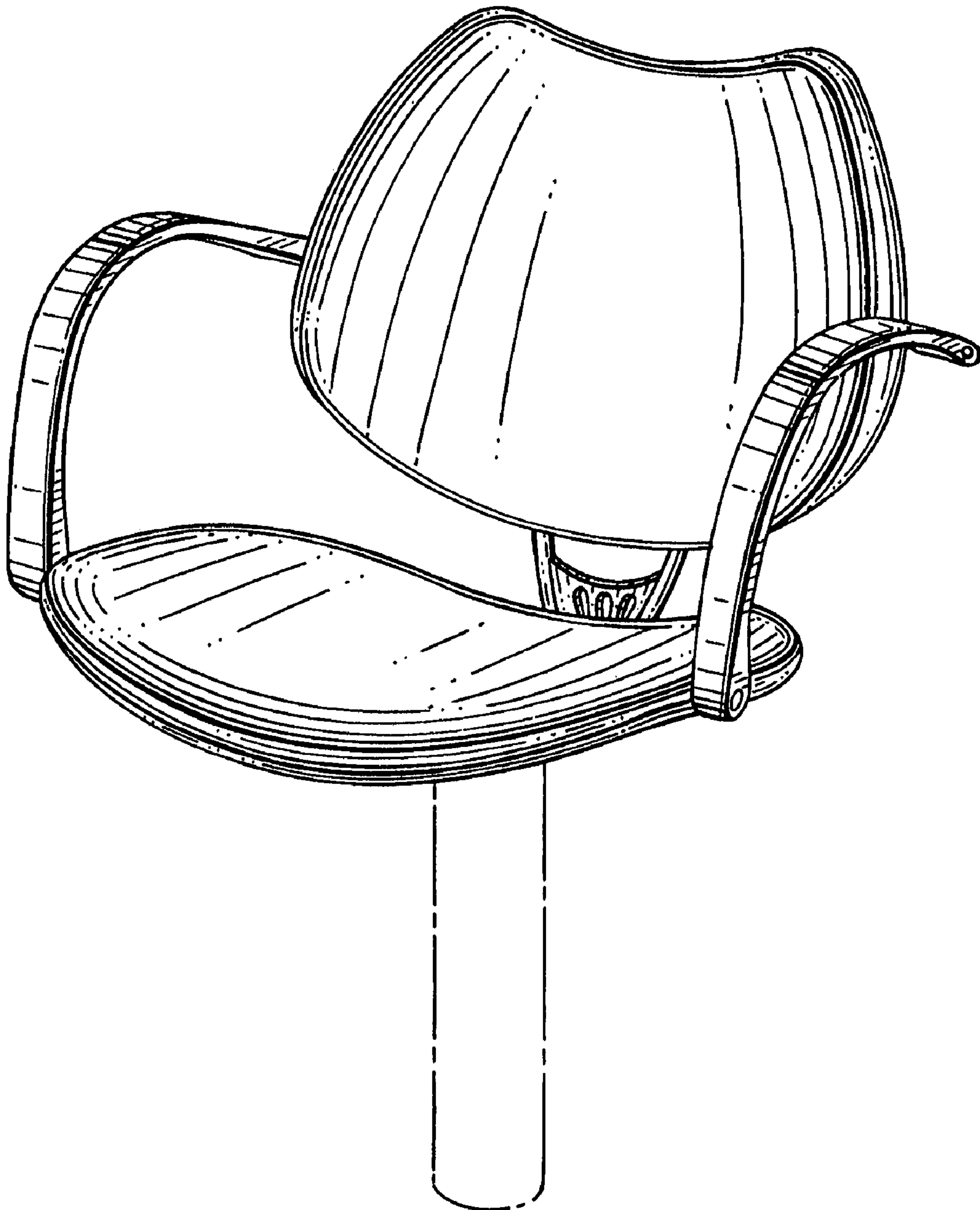

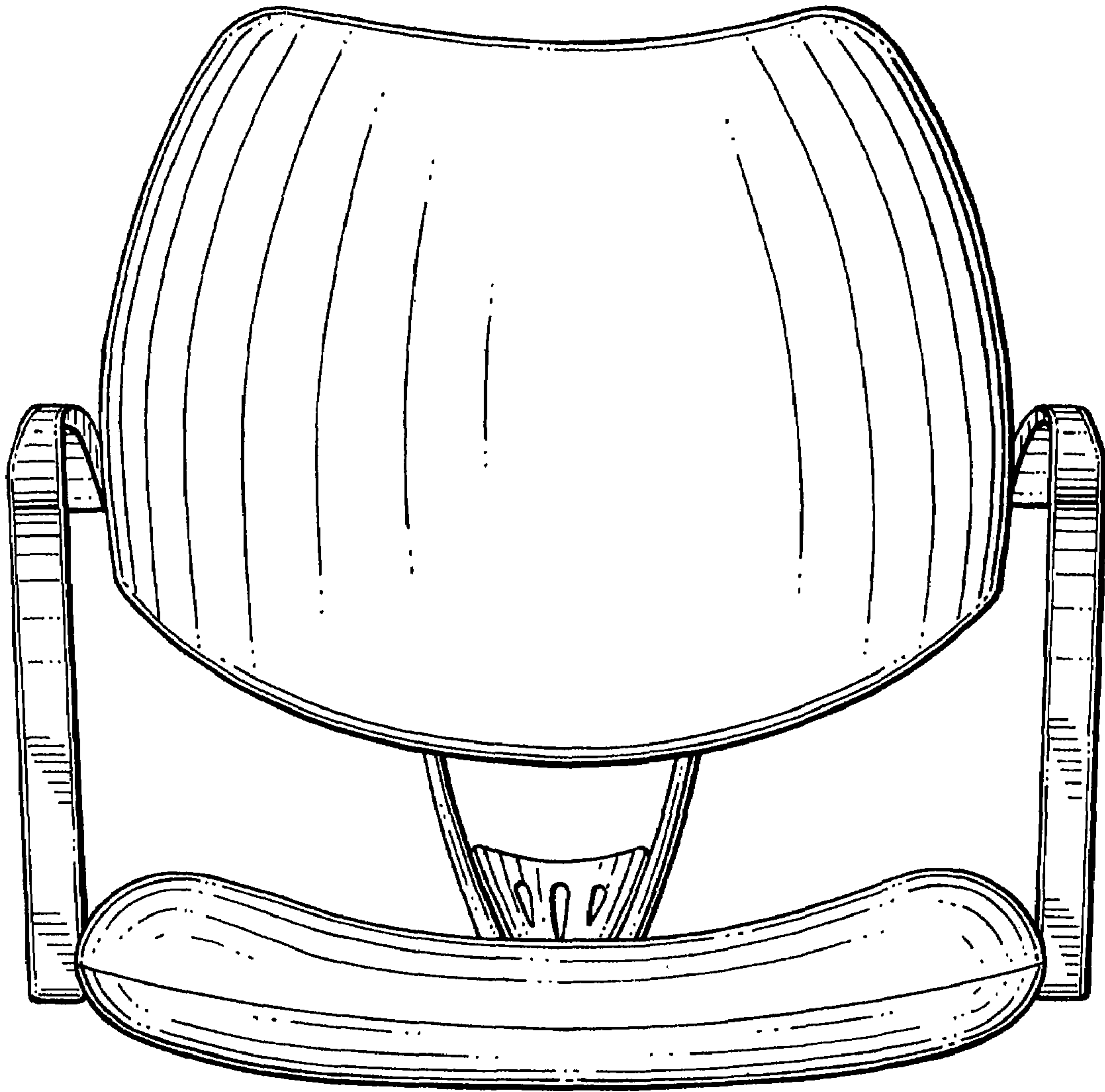

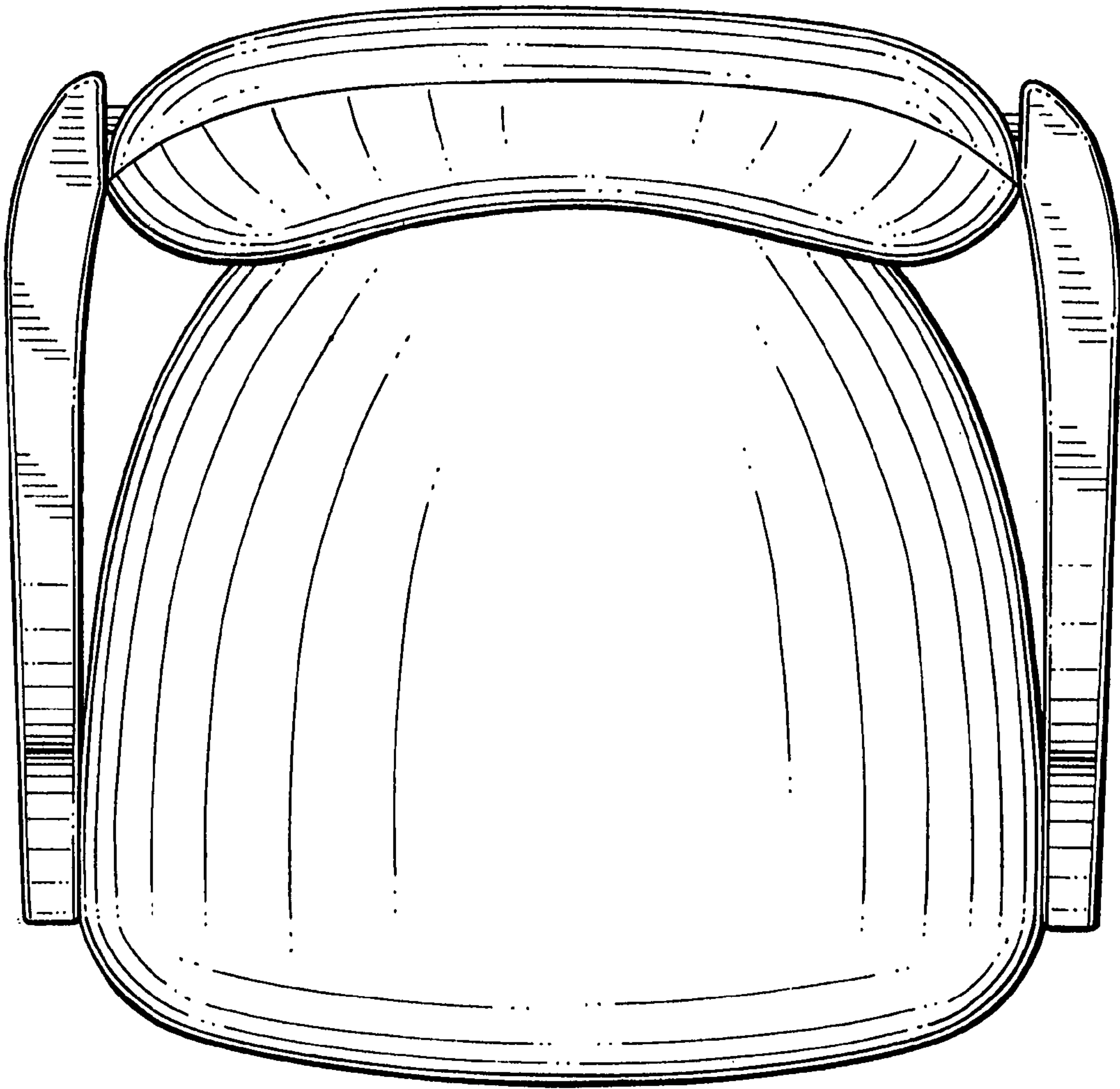

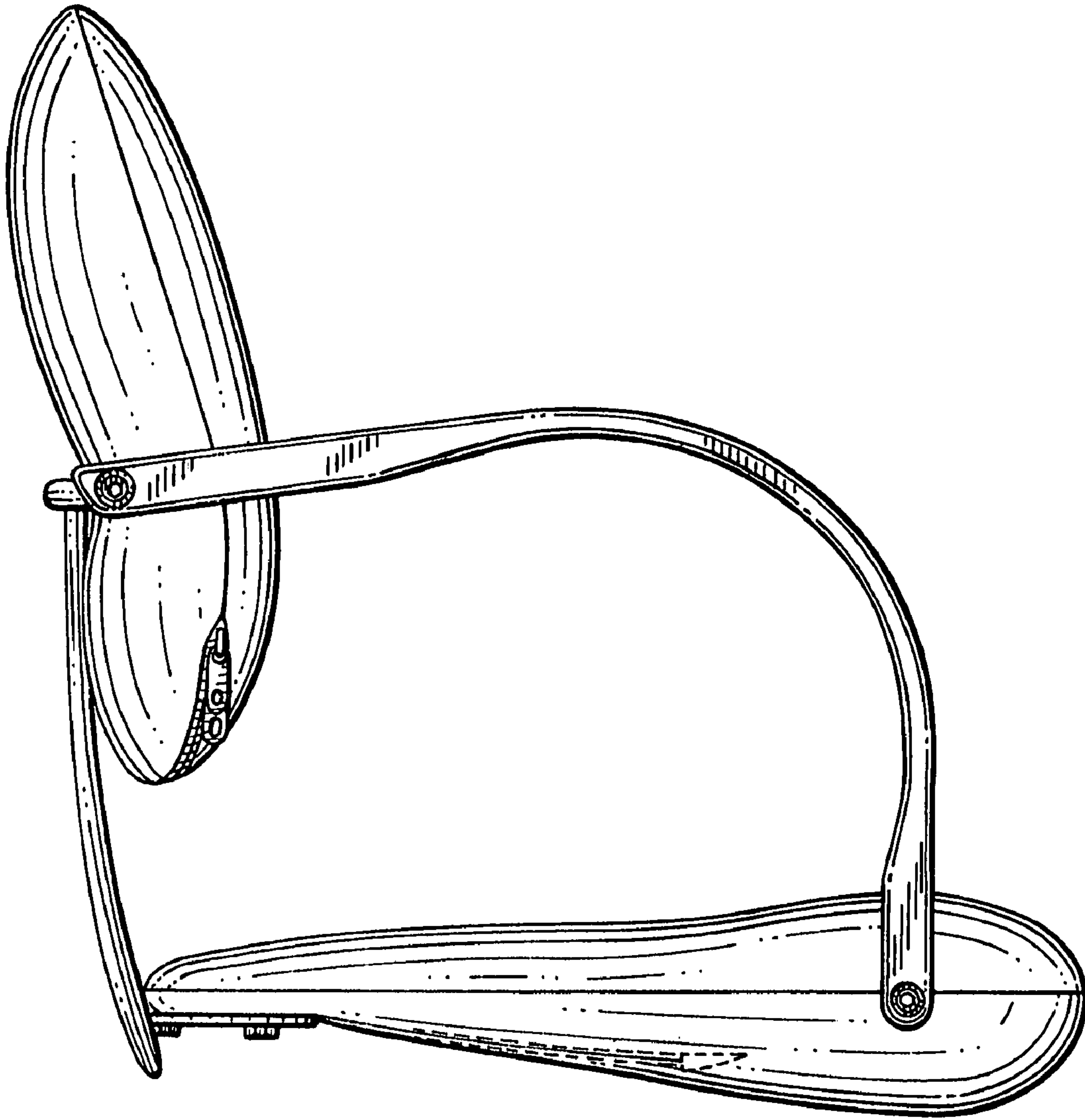

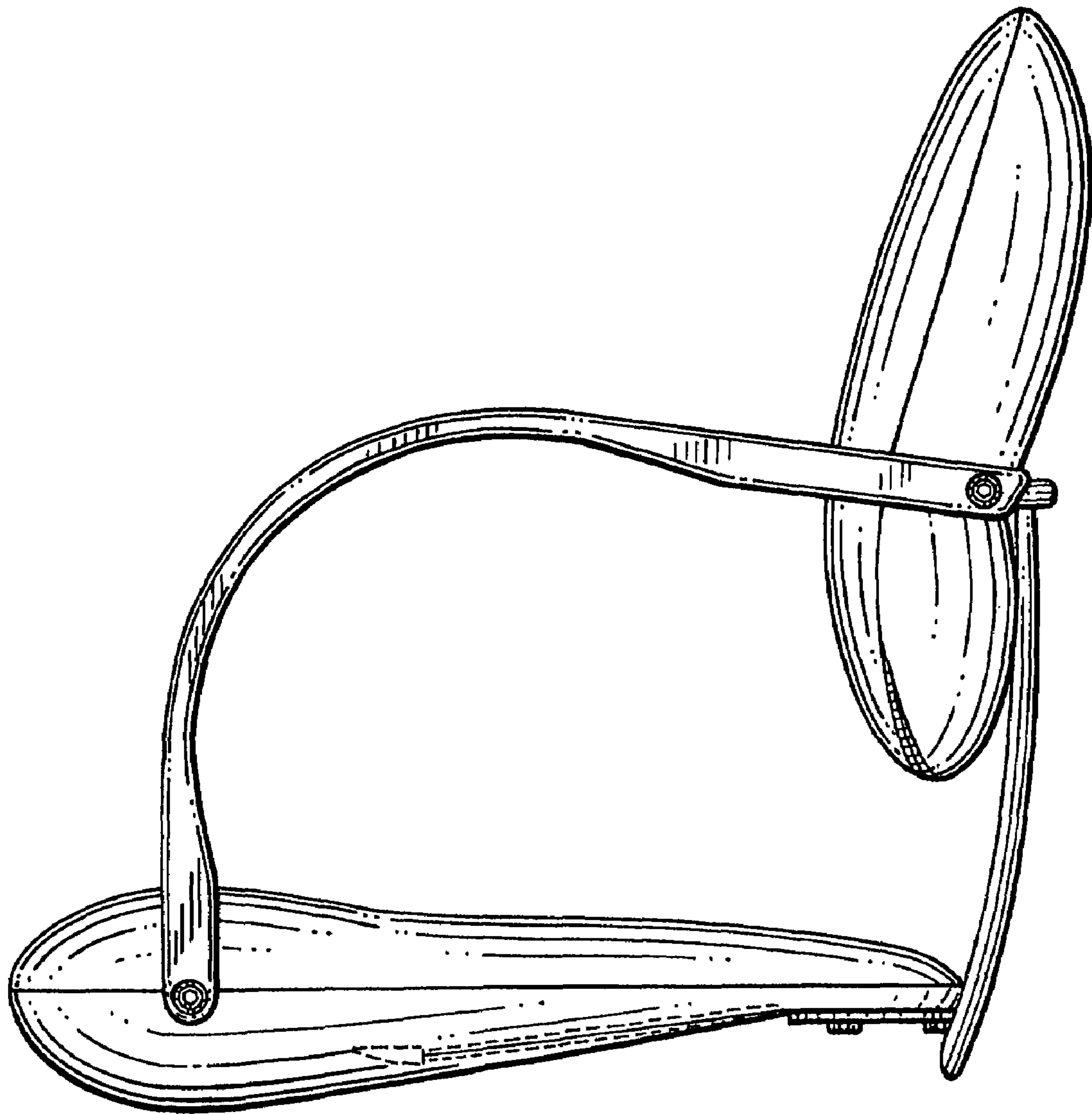

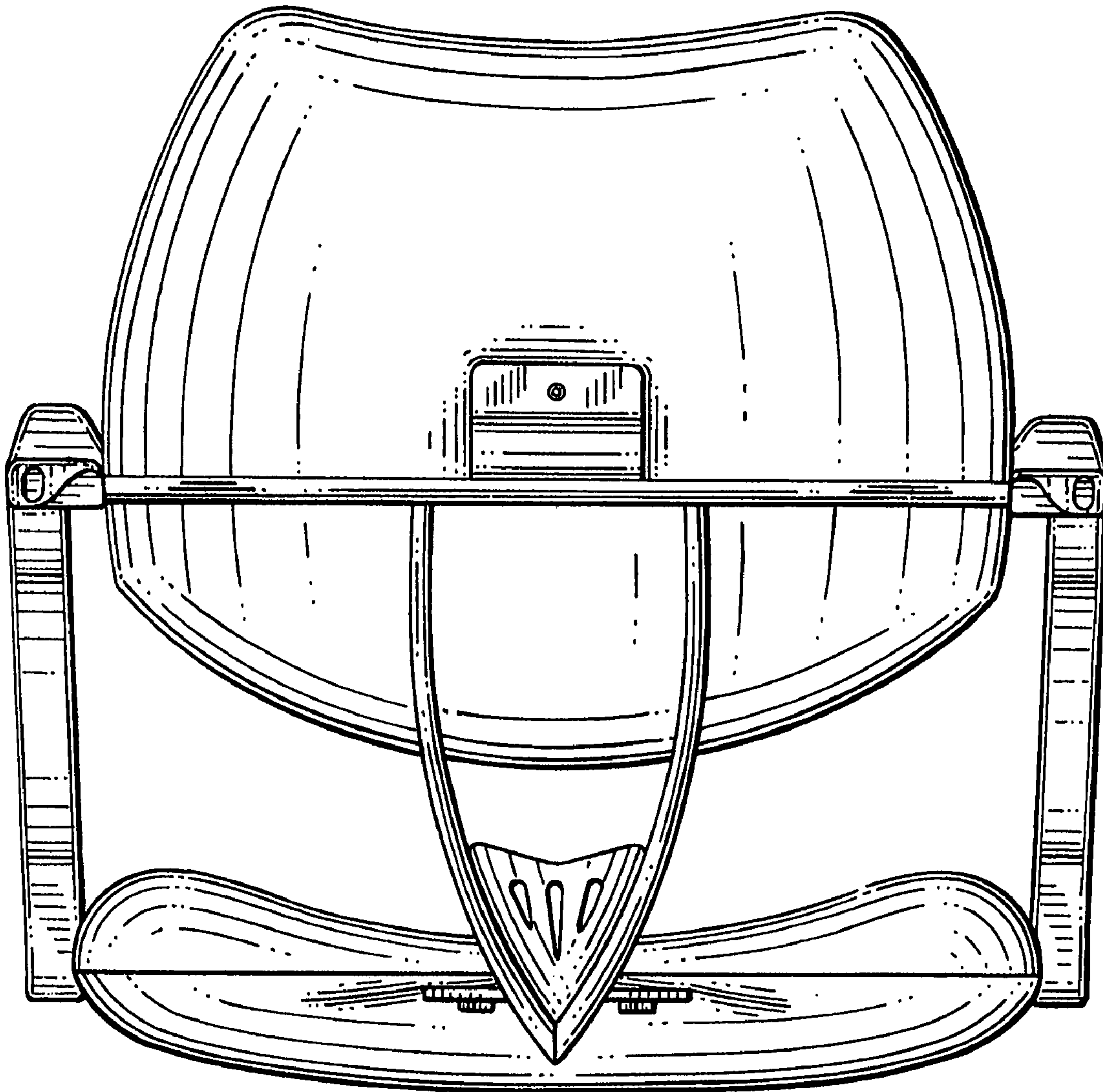

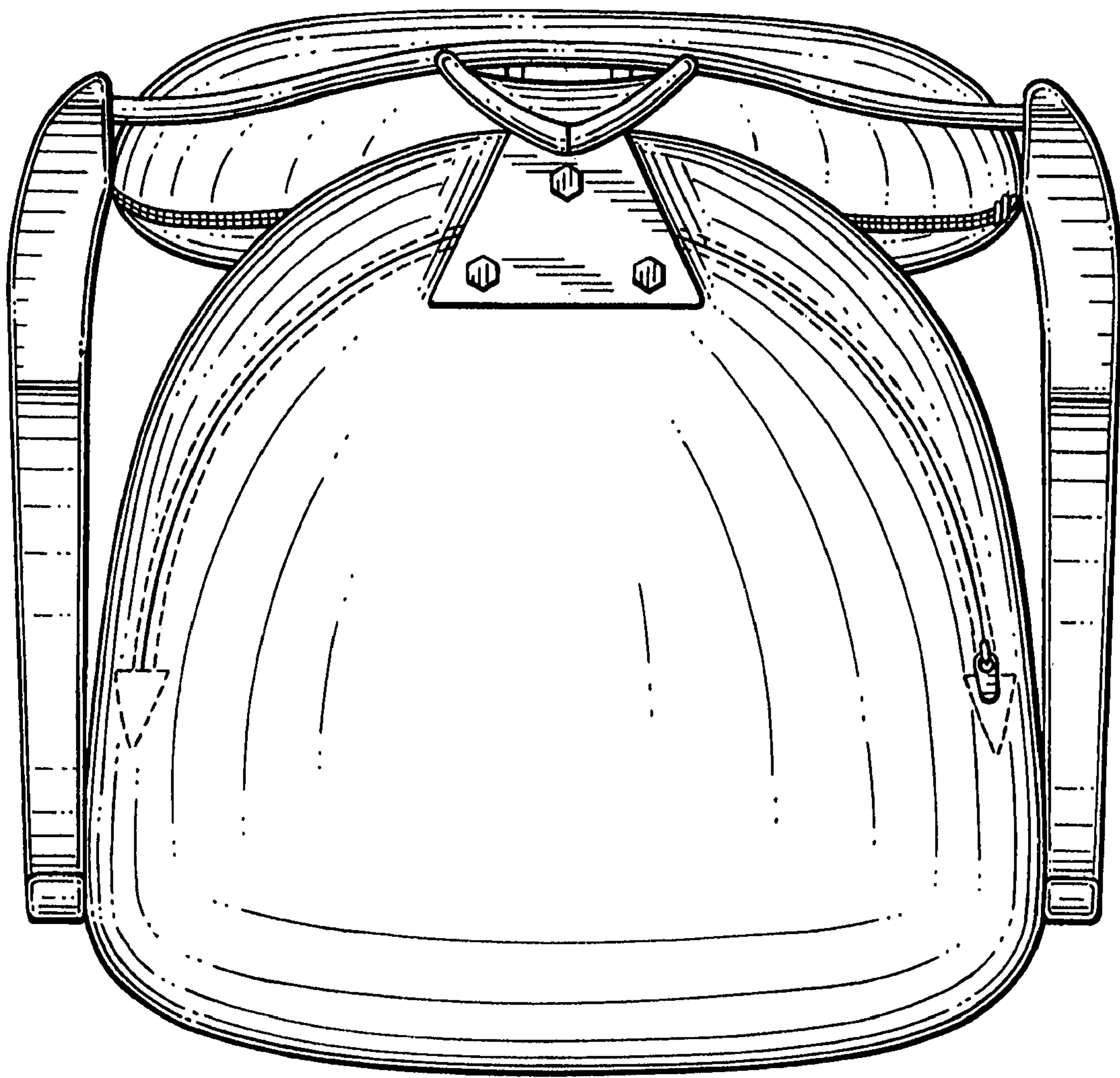
