FIG. 8 is a bottom view of said light assembly for a cane.

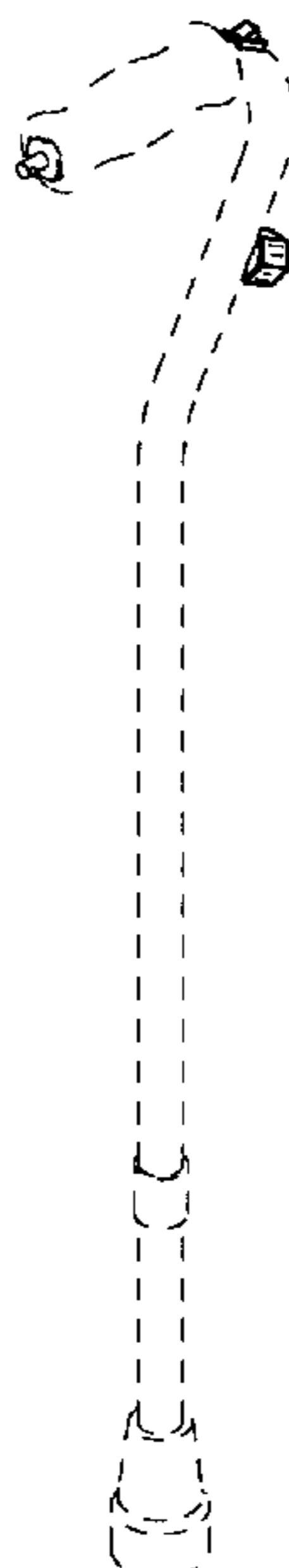

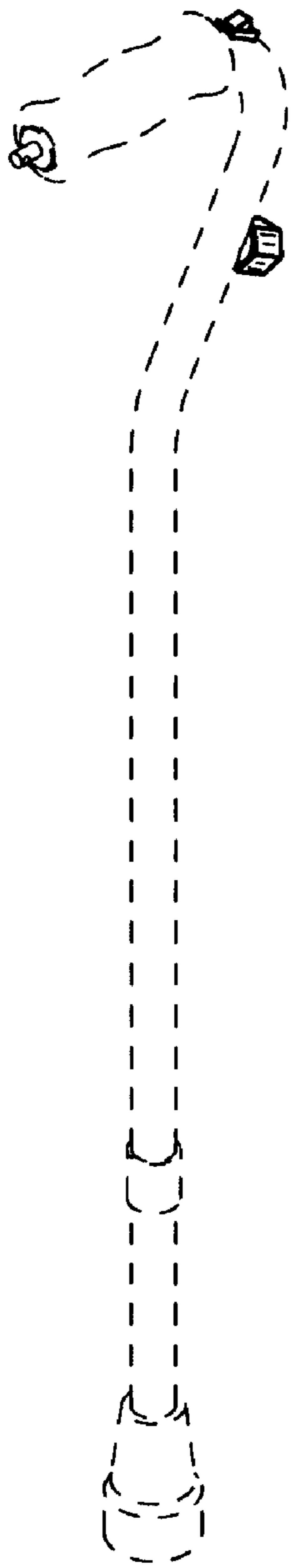

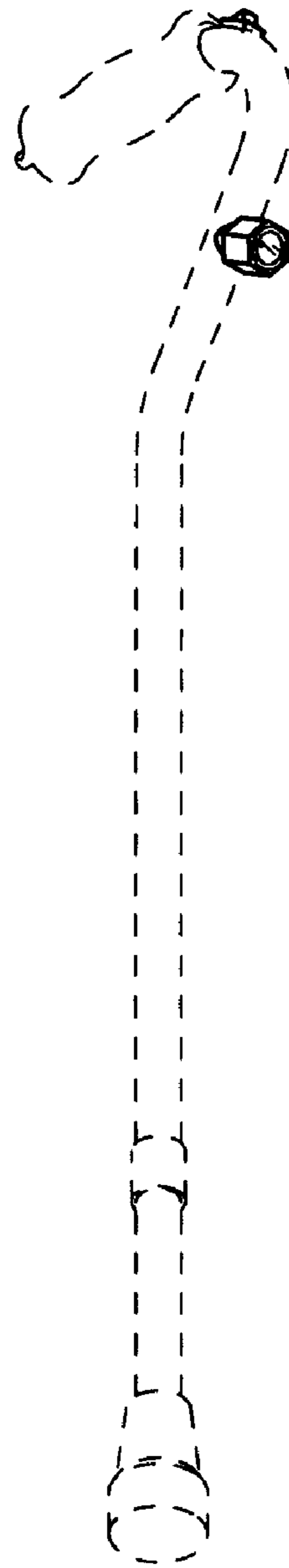

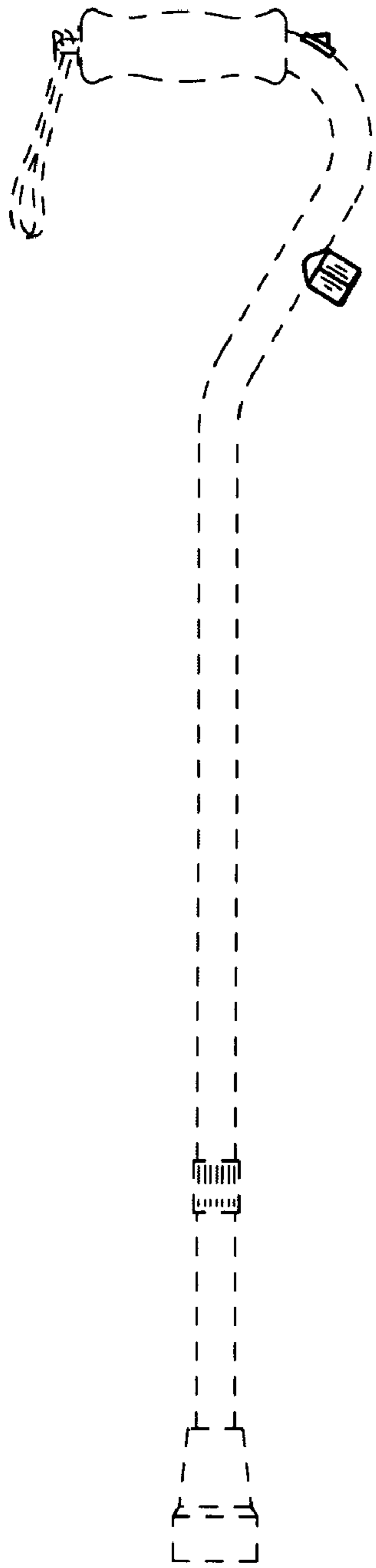

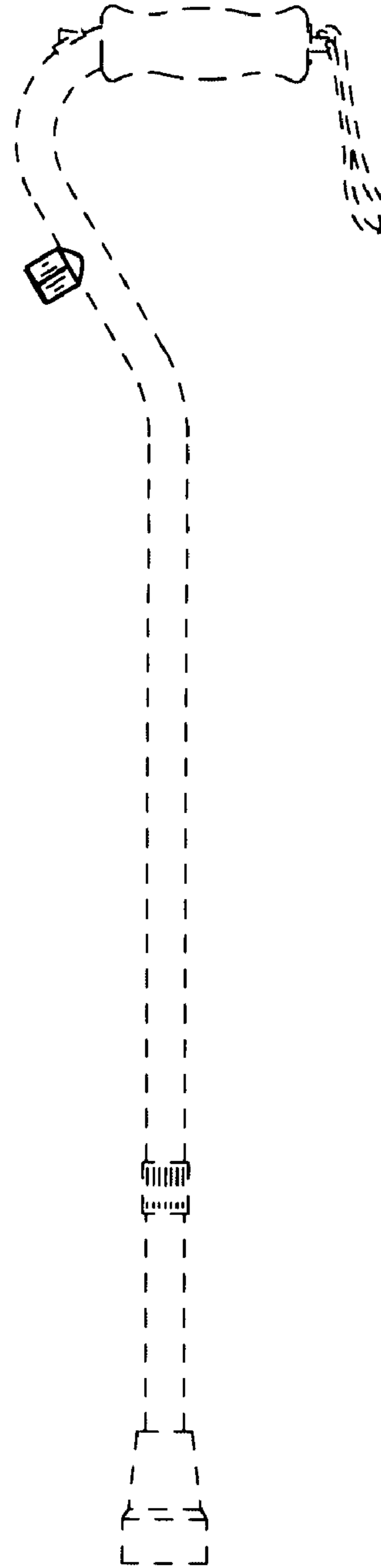

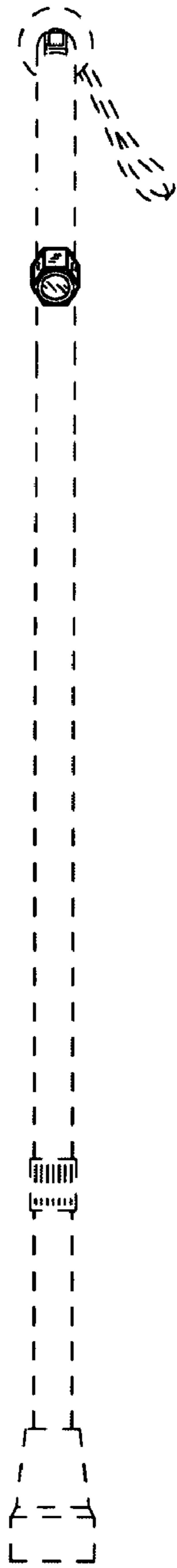

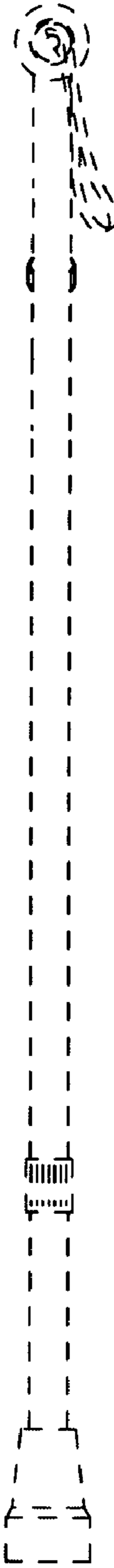

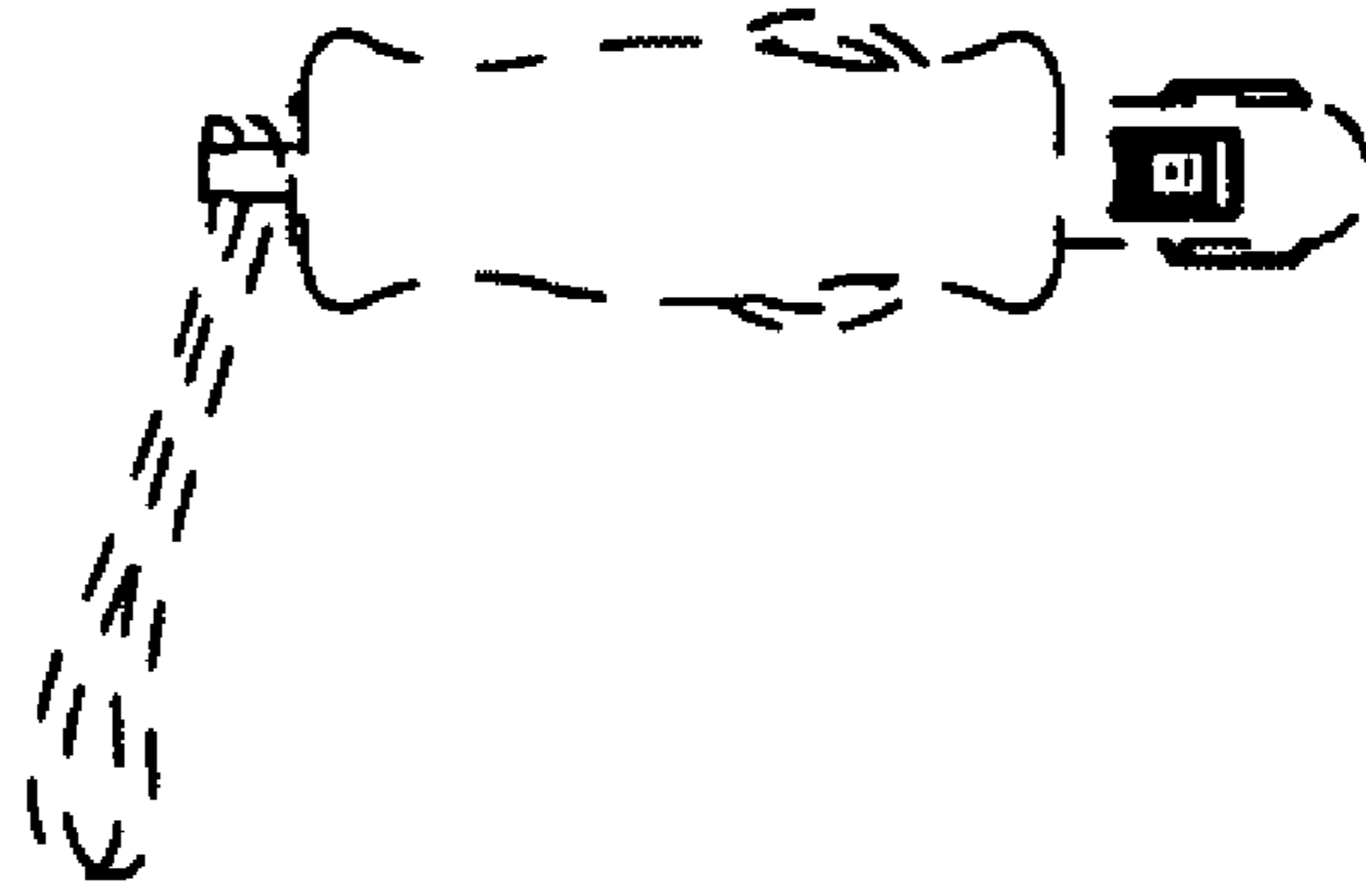

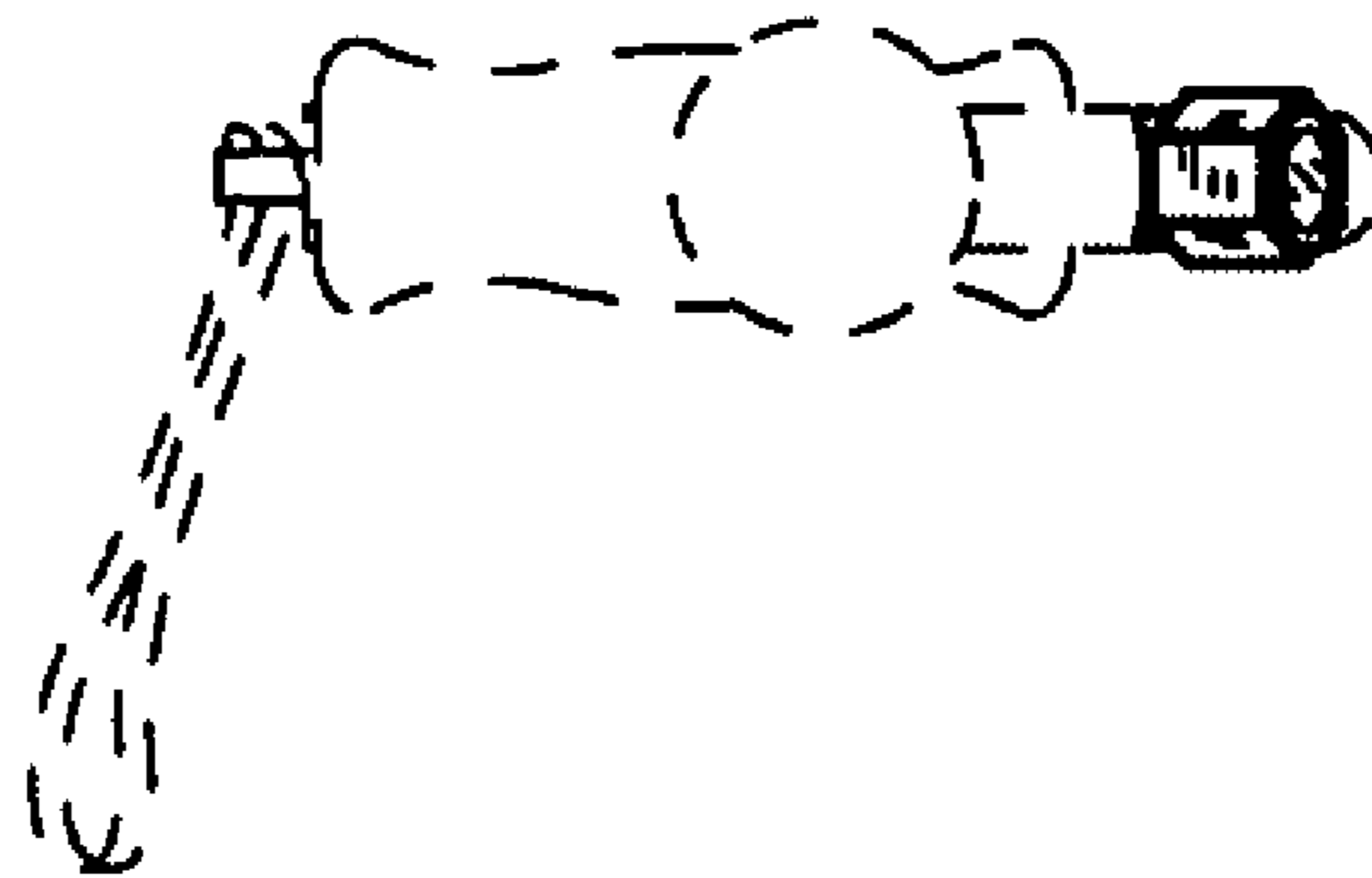
