(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for an outsole for a shoe, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of an outsole for a shoe
showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front side view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a detail view of the area referenced as 7 in FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a cross sectional view taken along line 8—8 shown
in FIG. 2;

FIG. 9 is a cross sectional view taken along line 9—9 shown
in FIG. 2;

FIG. 10 is a detail view of the area referenced as 10 in FIG.
4;

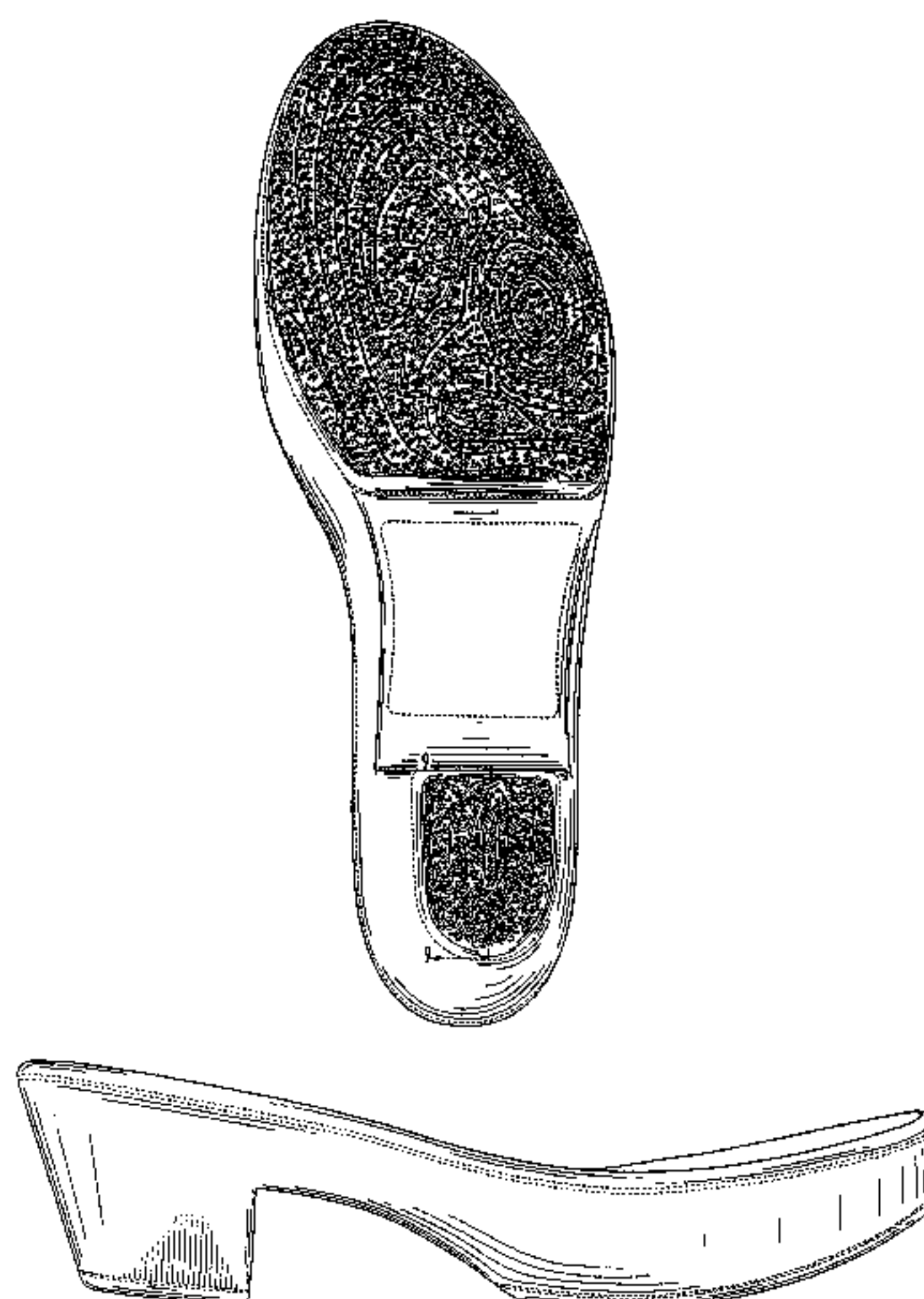
FIG. 11 is a detail view of the area referenced as 11 in FIG.
5;

FIG. 12 is a detail view of the area referenced as 12 in FIG.
6; and,

FIG. 13 is a detail view of the area referenced as 13 in FIG.
1.

The broken line showing a rectangular shape in the arch
areas of FIGS. 1 & 2, along with the parallel broken lines
around the periphery, forefoot and heel in FIGS. 1-5,
represent the boundaries of the design with neither the lines
themselves nor the areas within forming any part of the
claim. The broken lines showing the interior surfaces in
FIGS. 8 & 9 represent the portions of the design that form
no part of the claim.

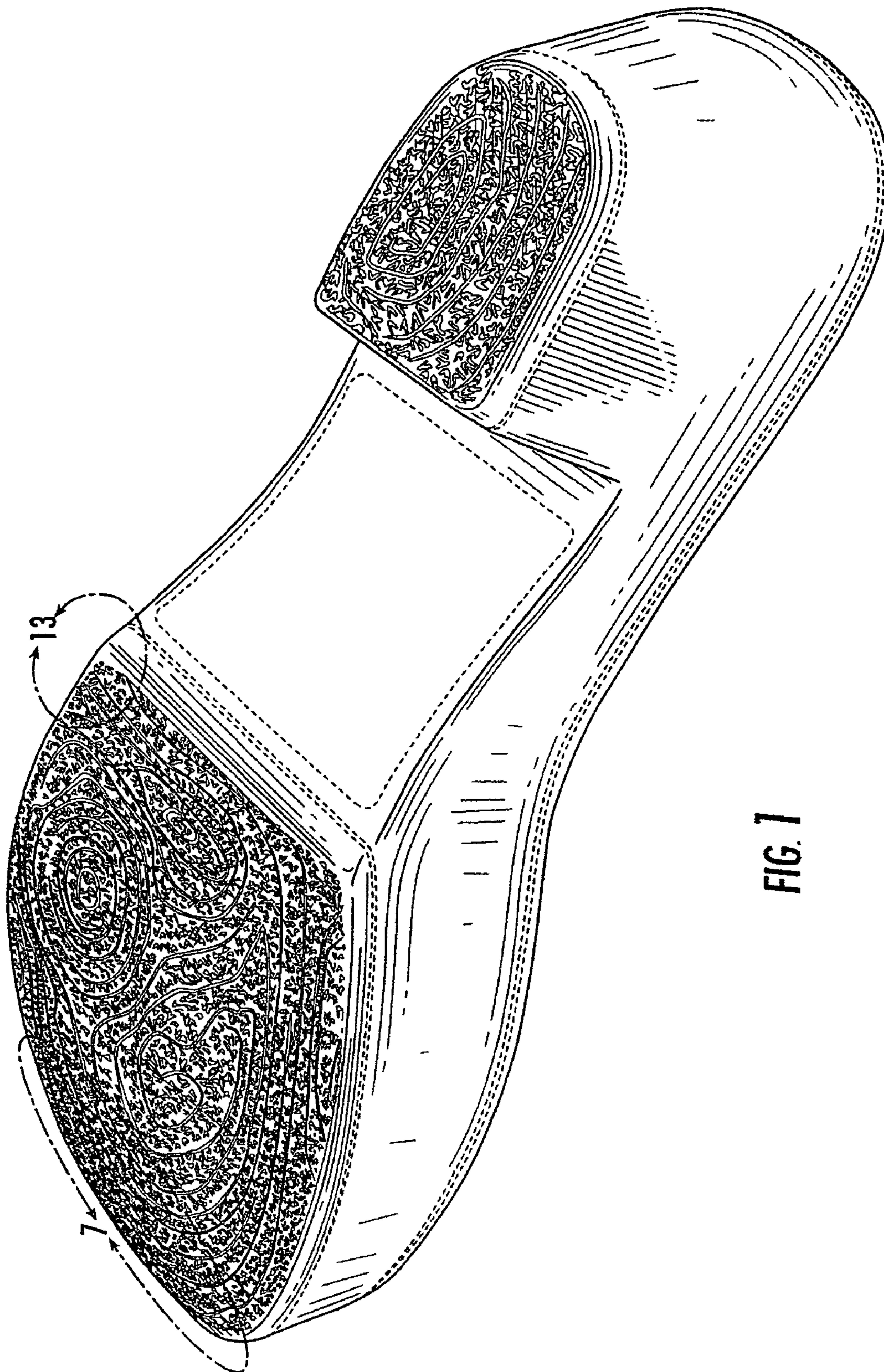

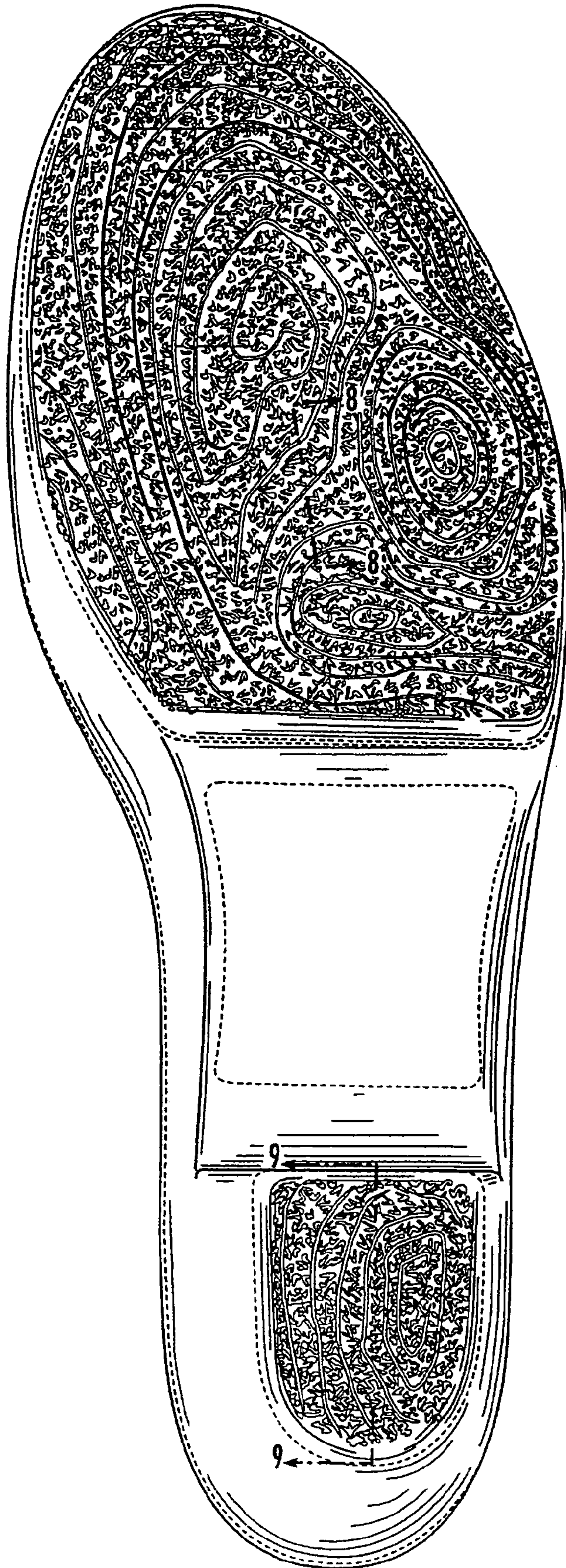

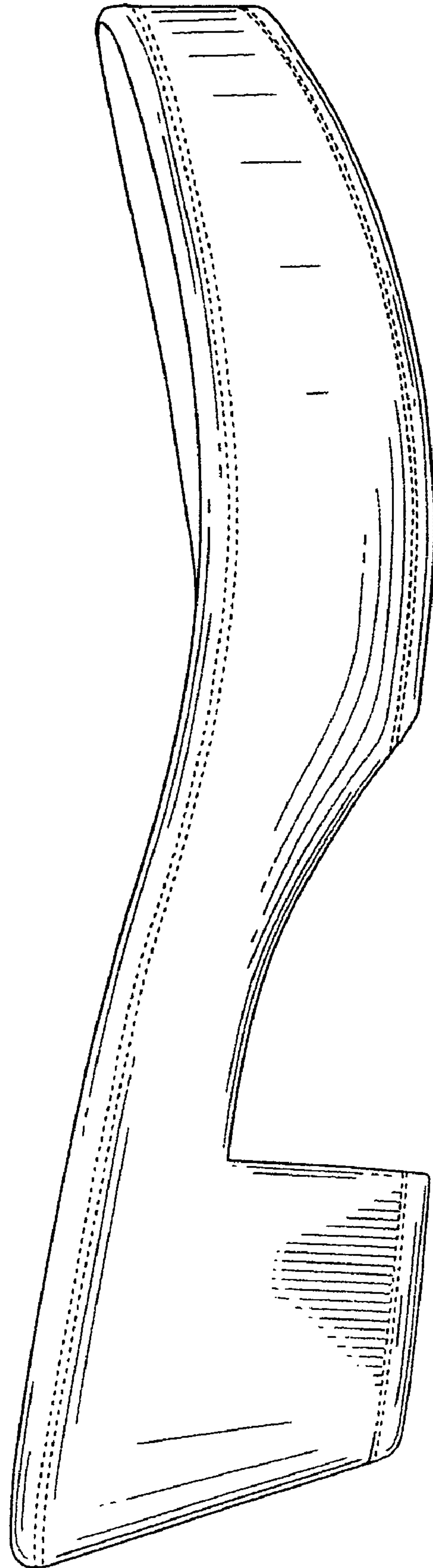

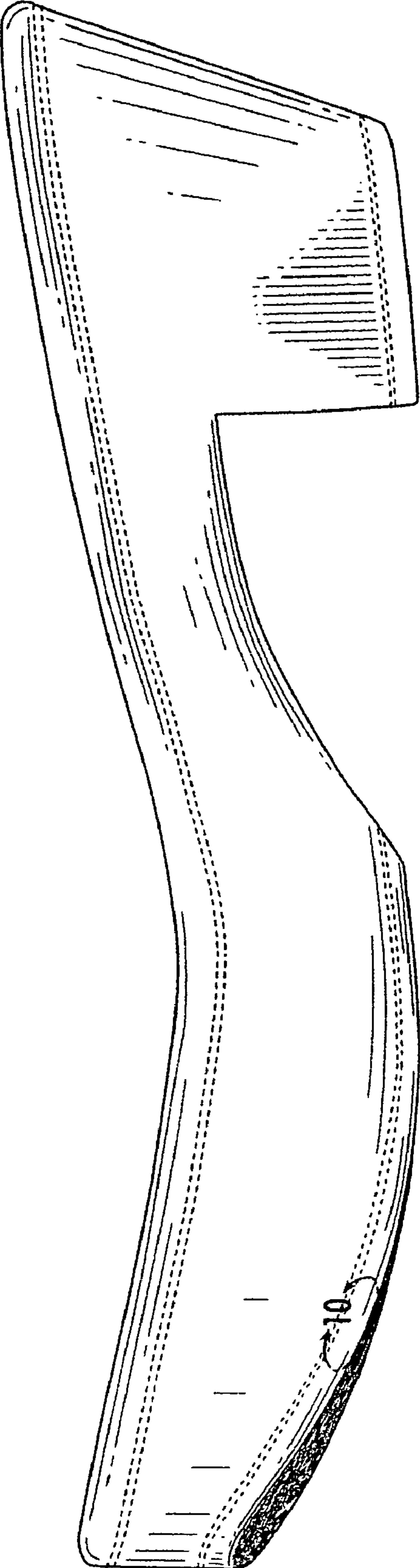

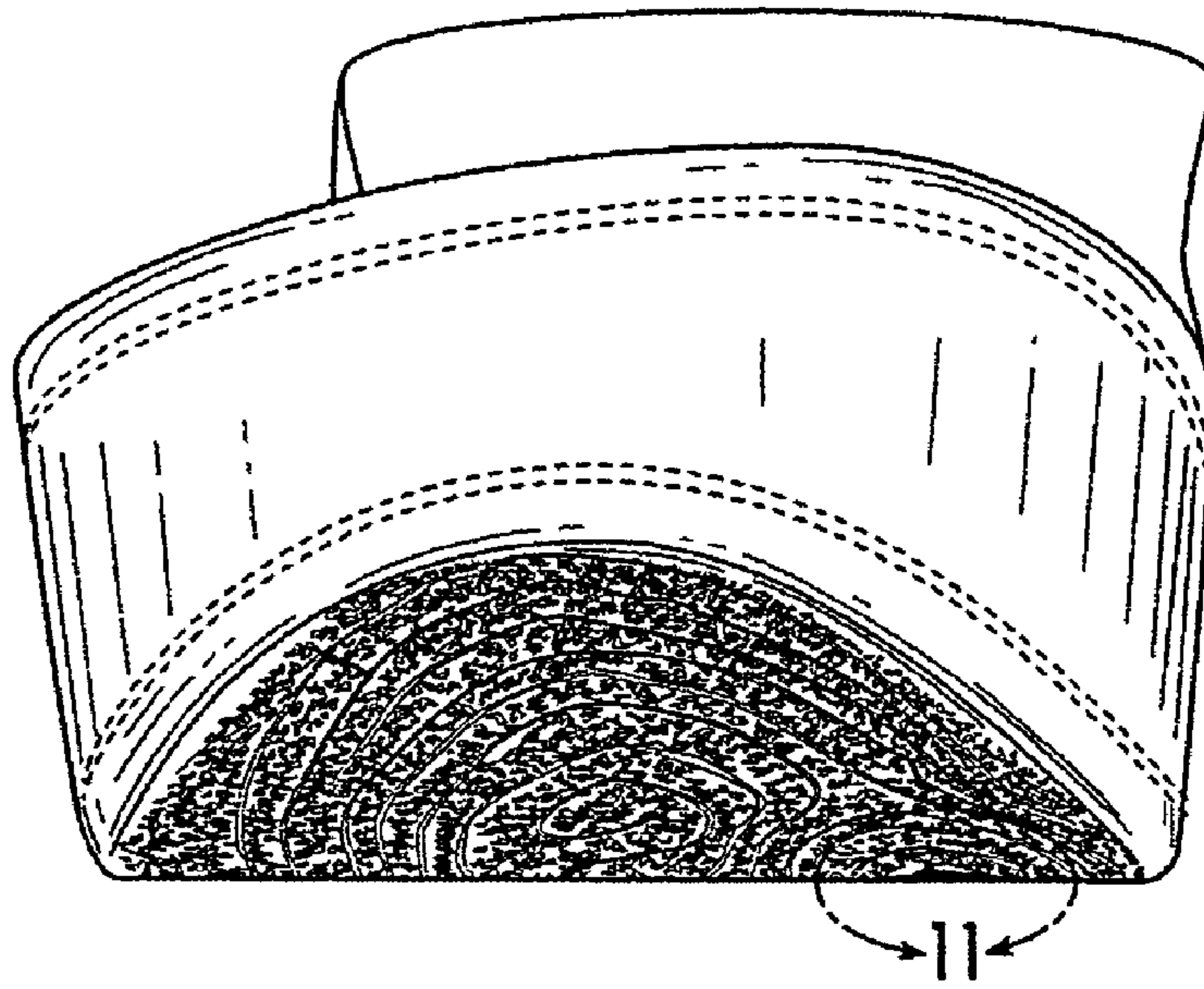

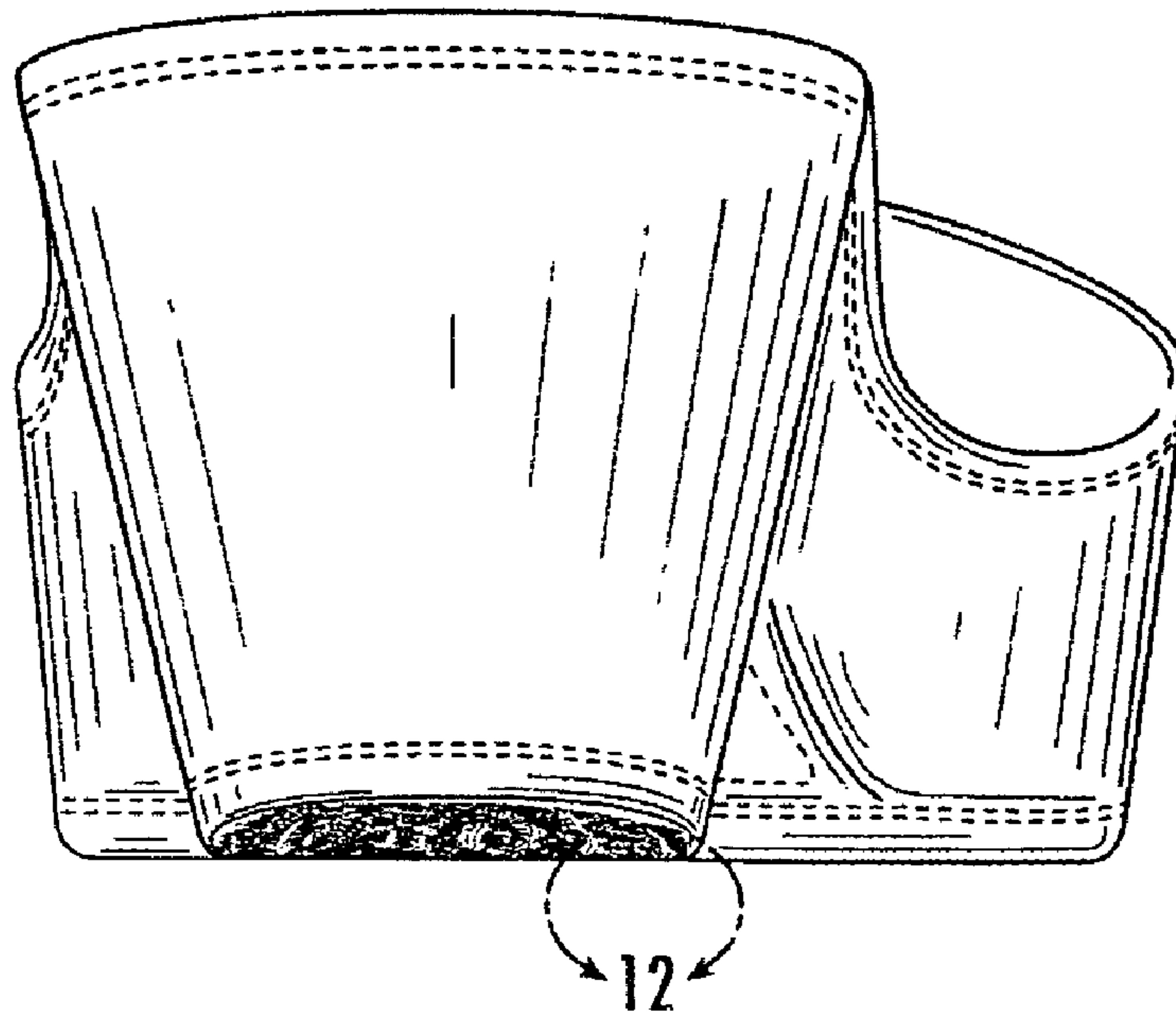

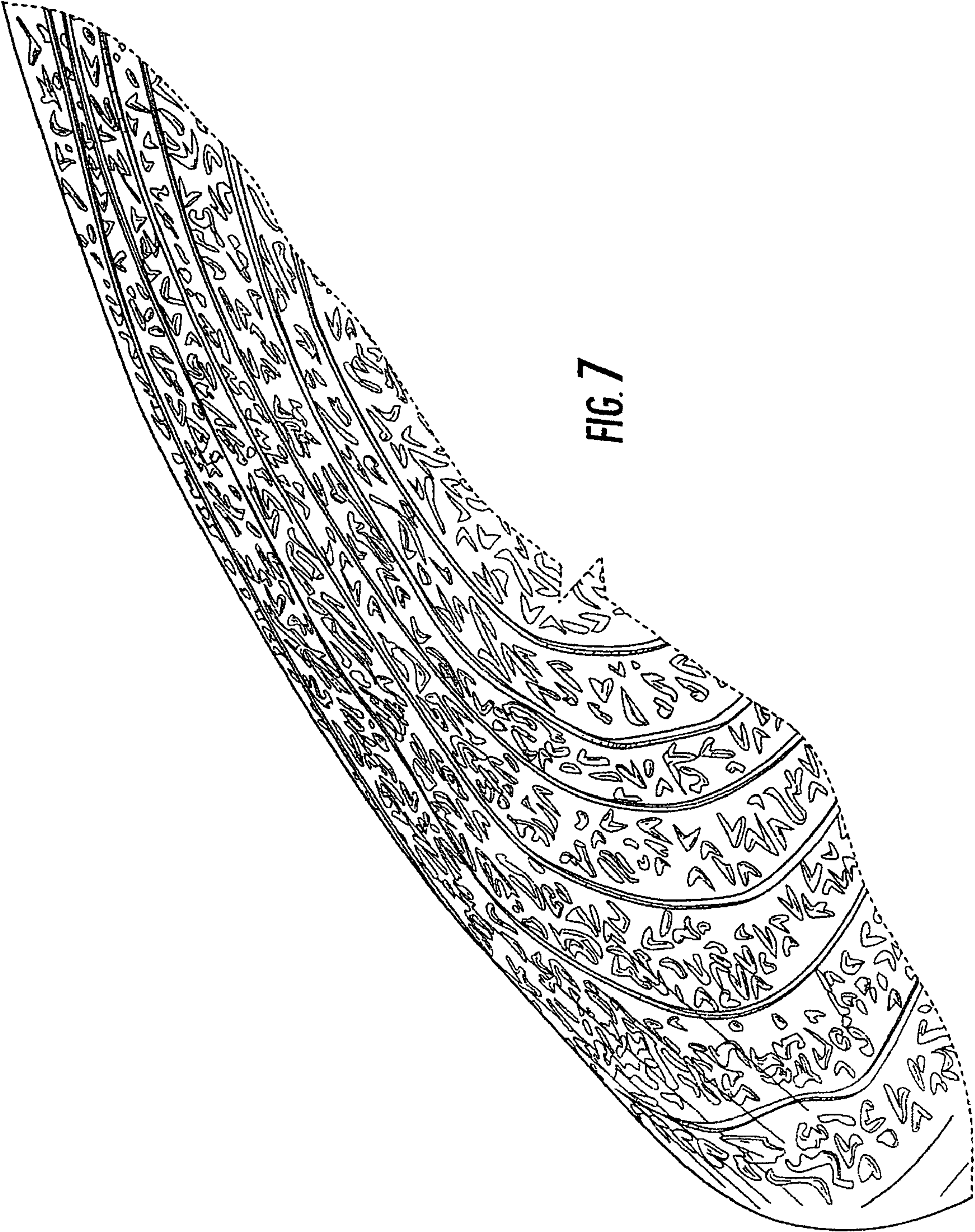

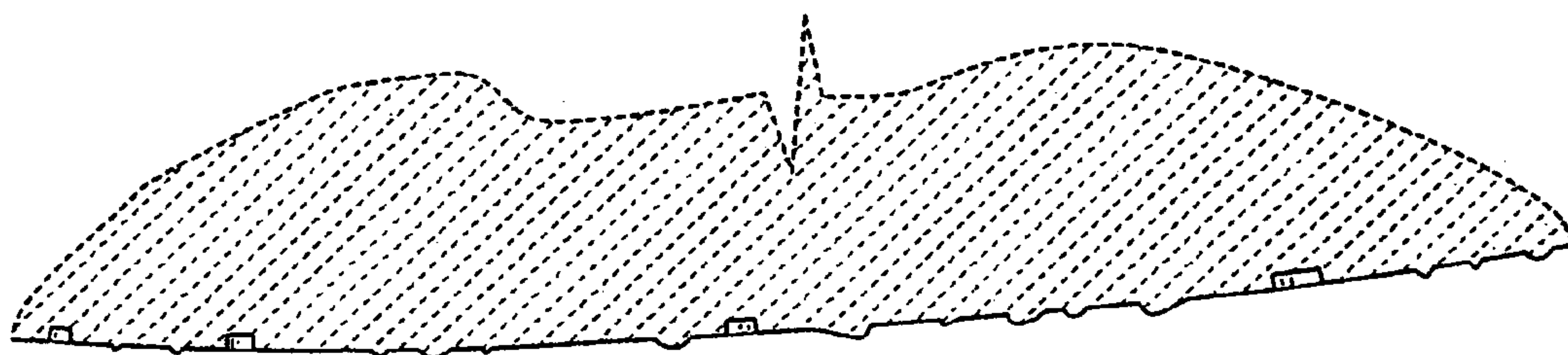

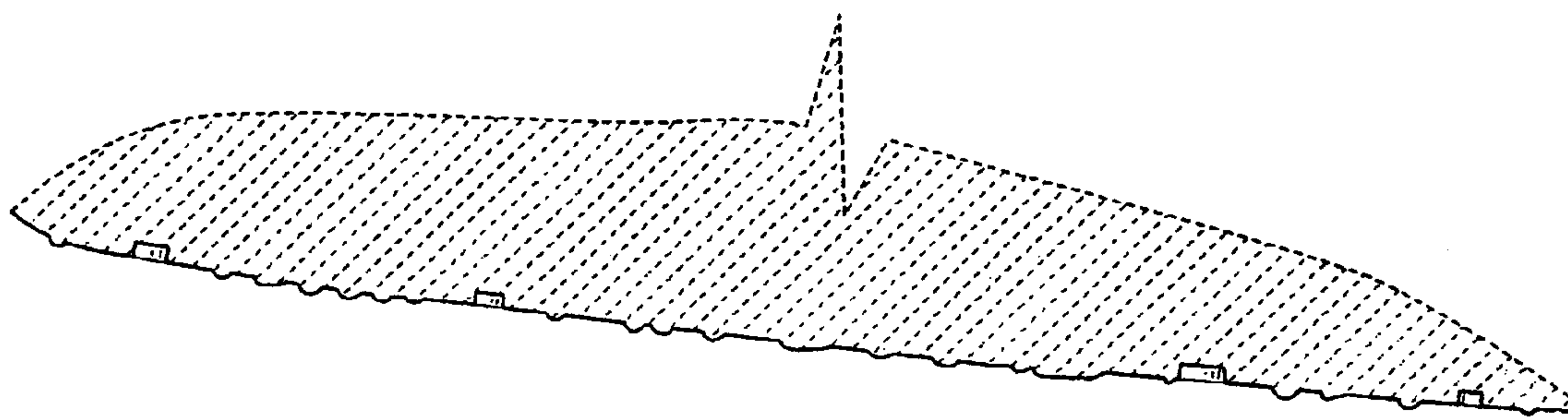

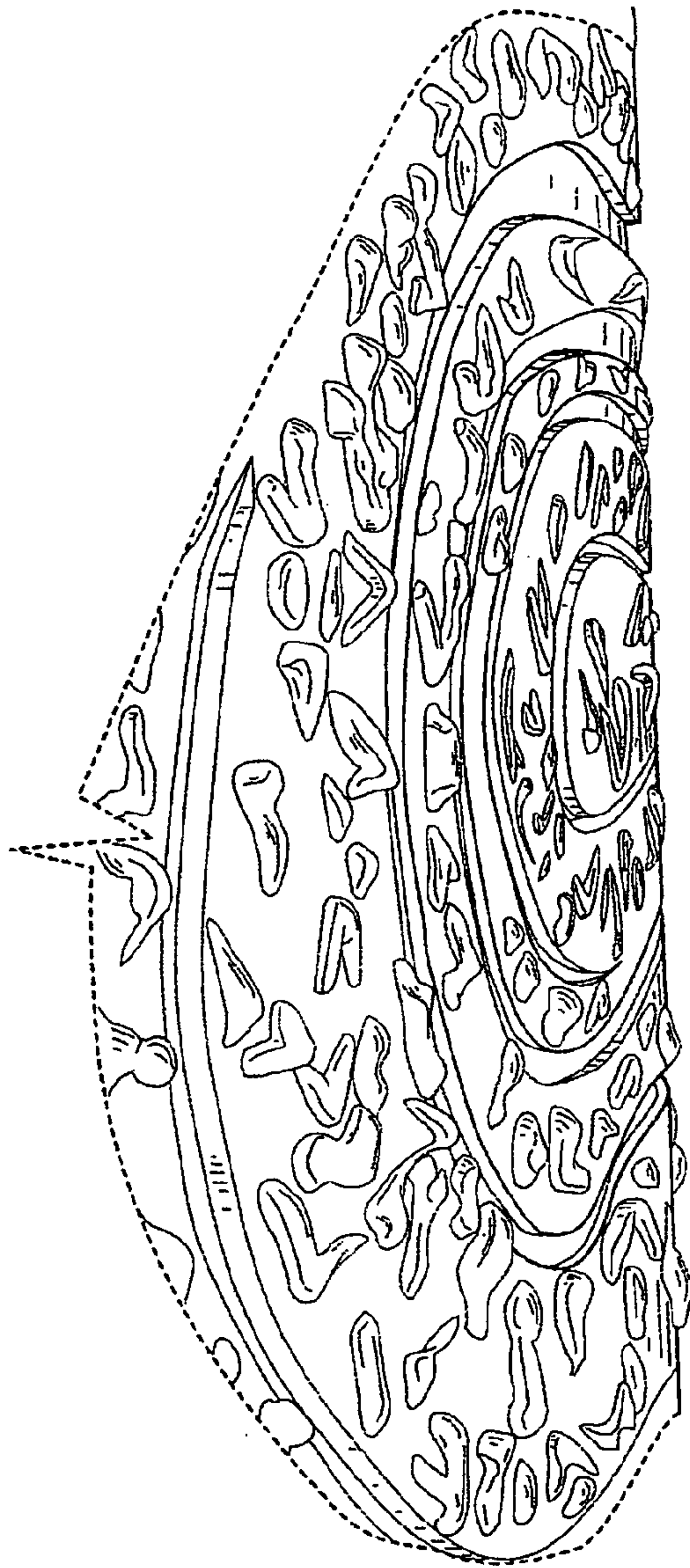

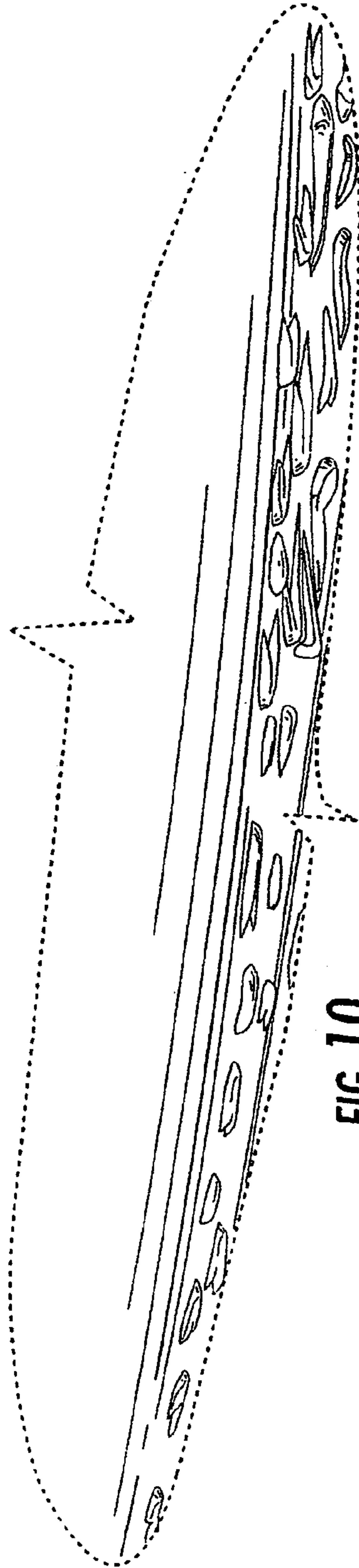

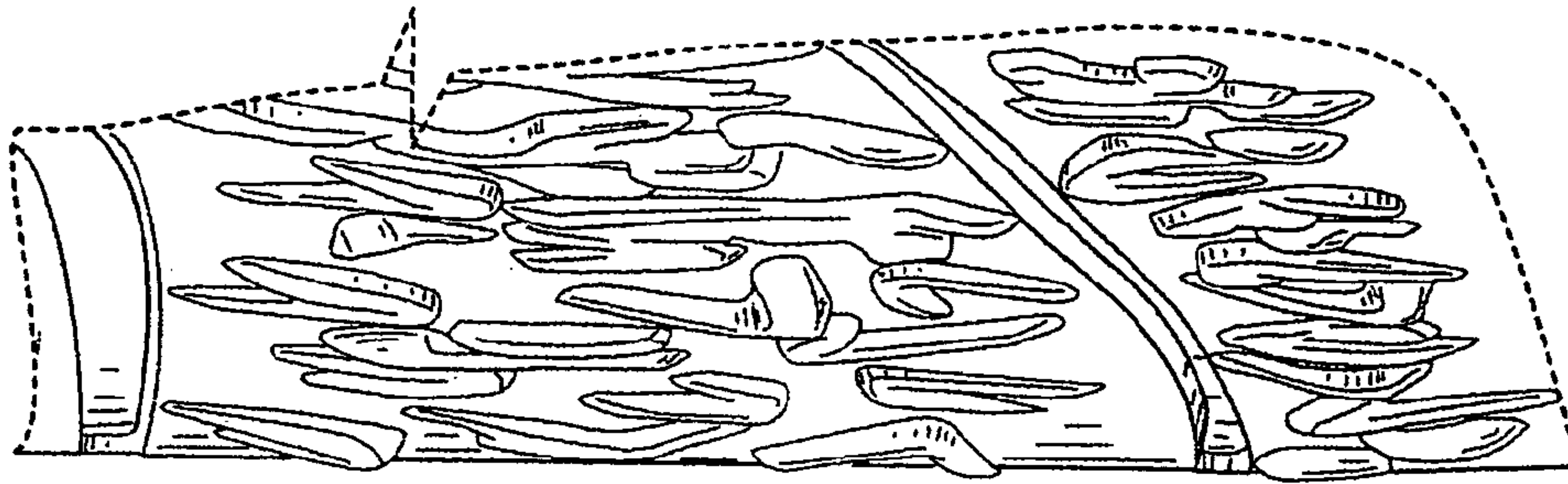

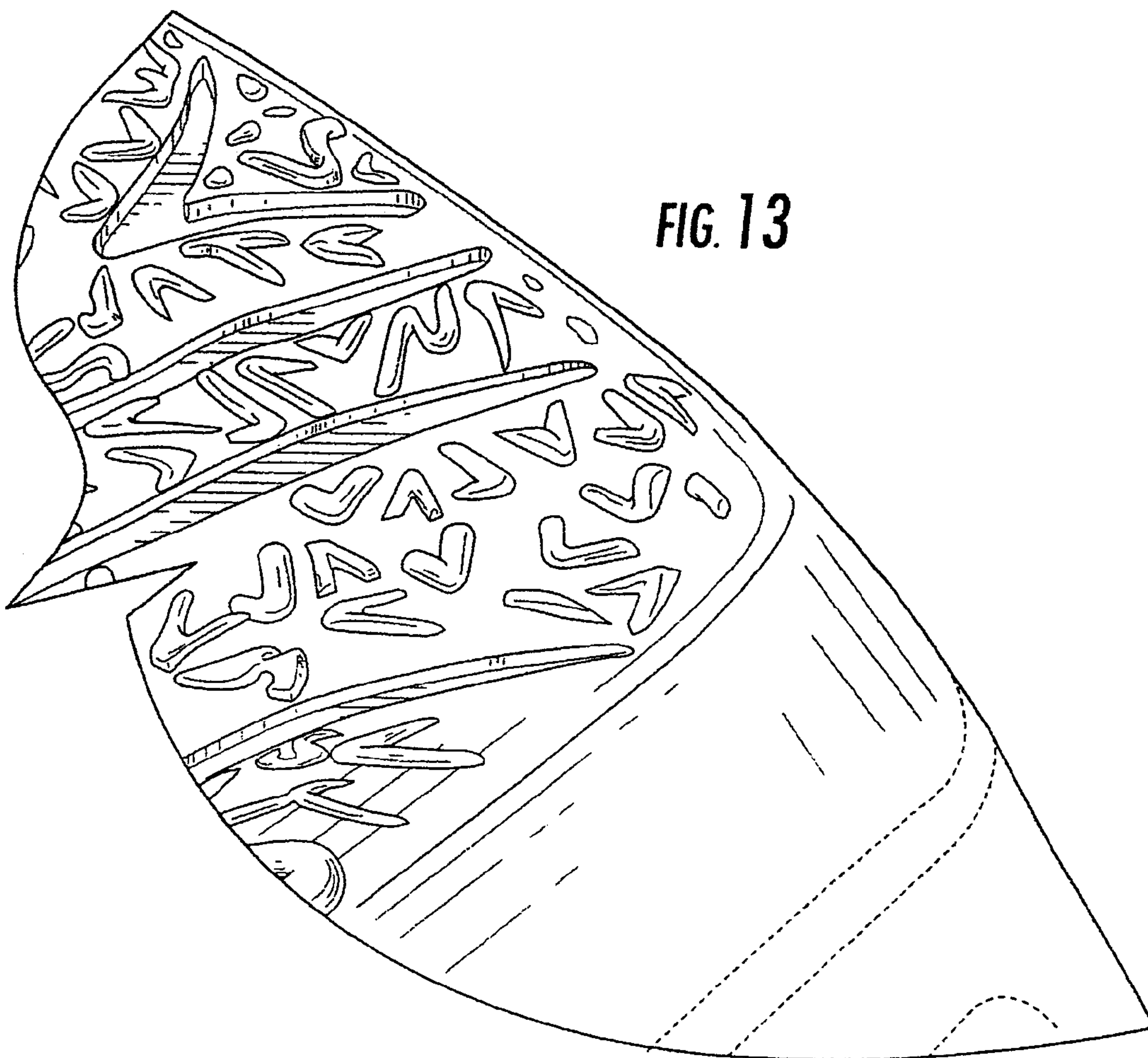
