FIG. 1;

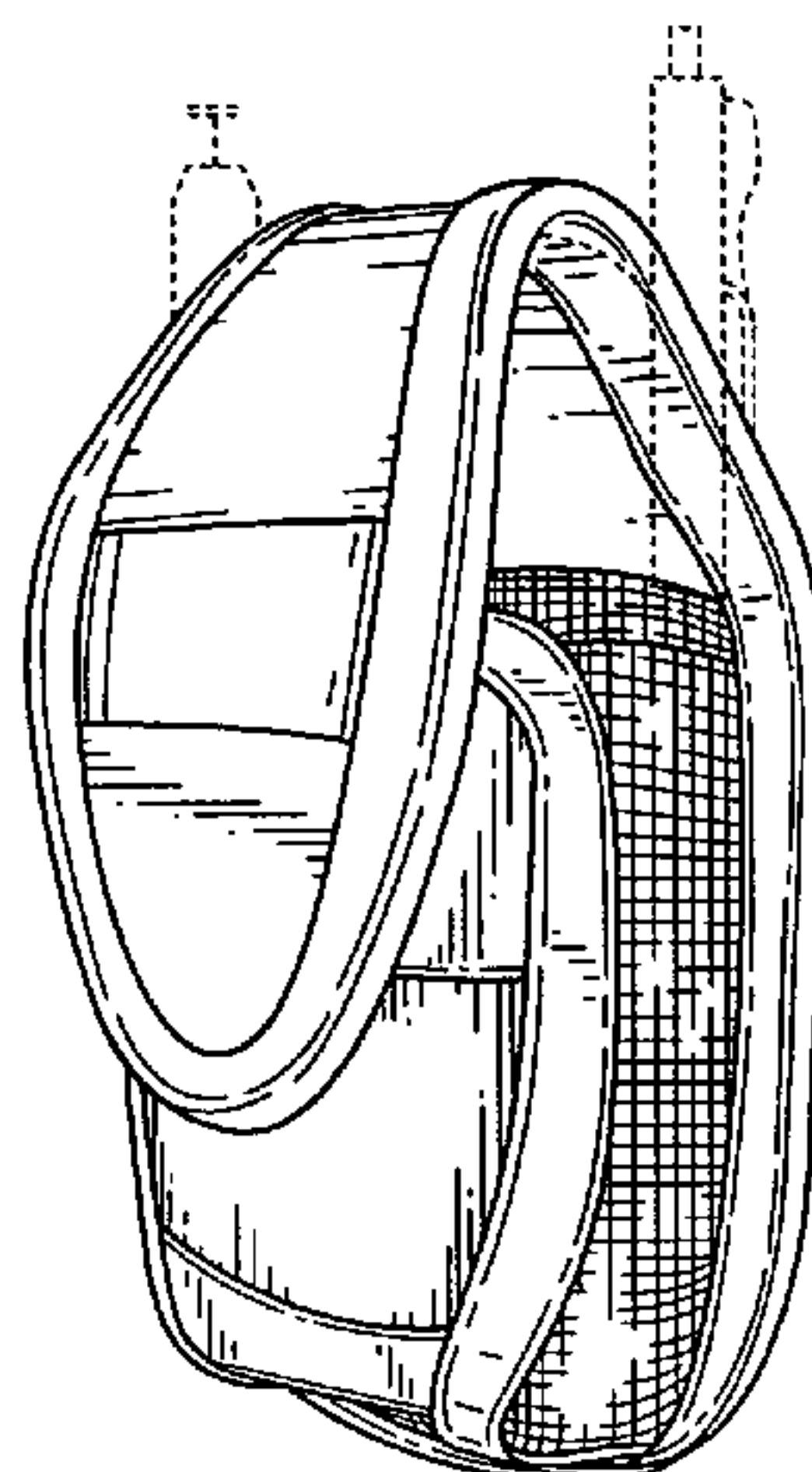


FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of the design shown in FIG. 1;

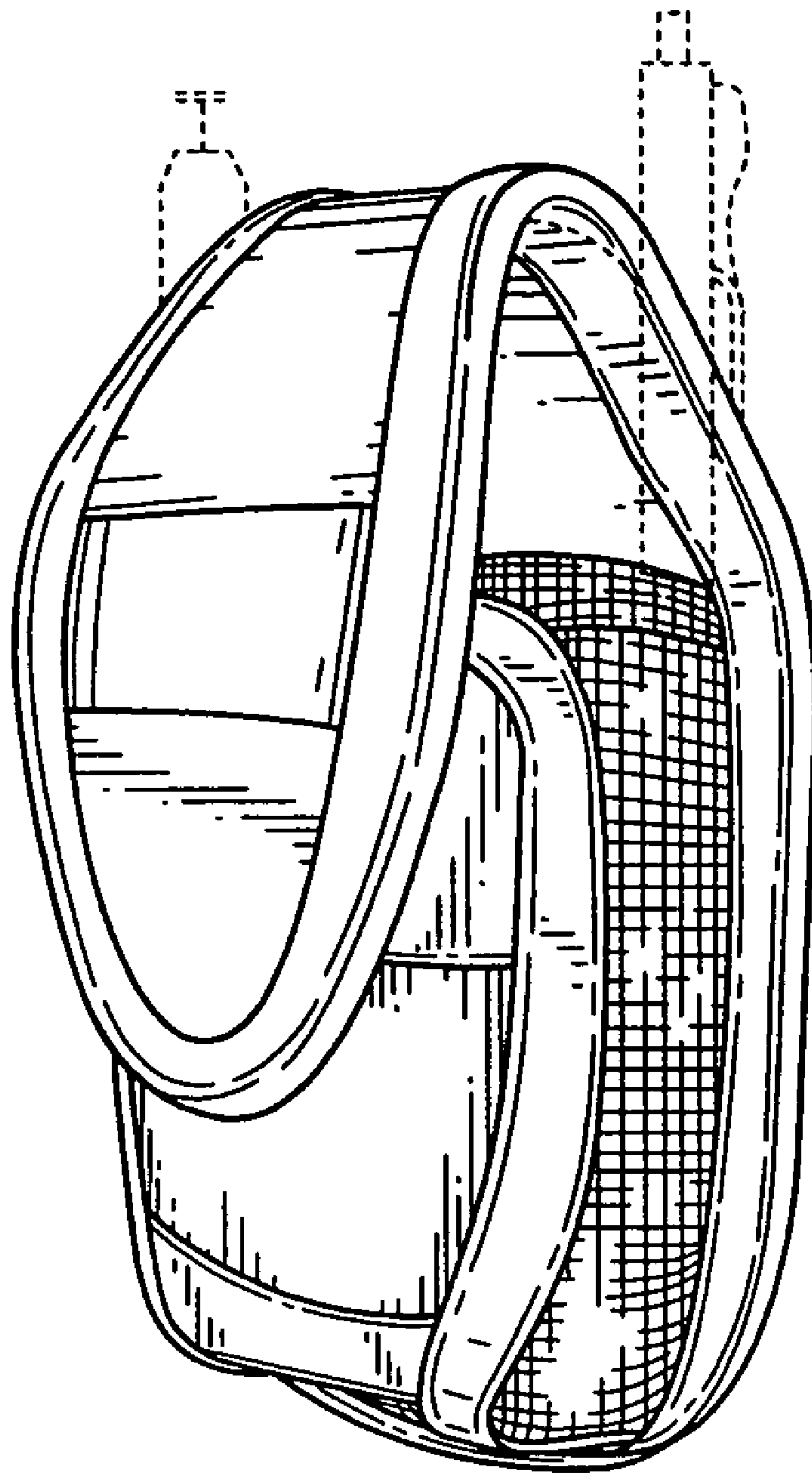

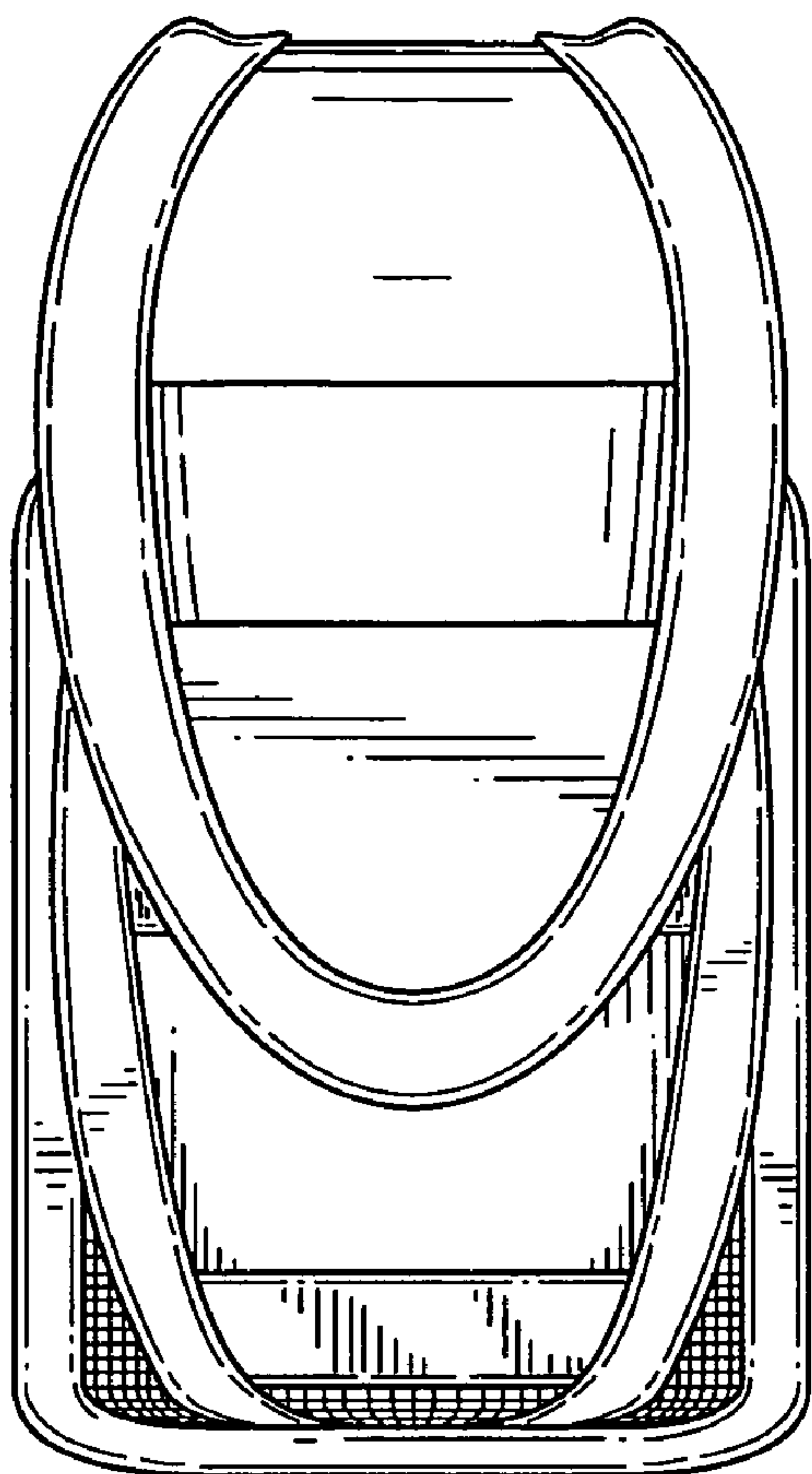

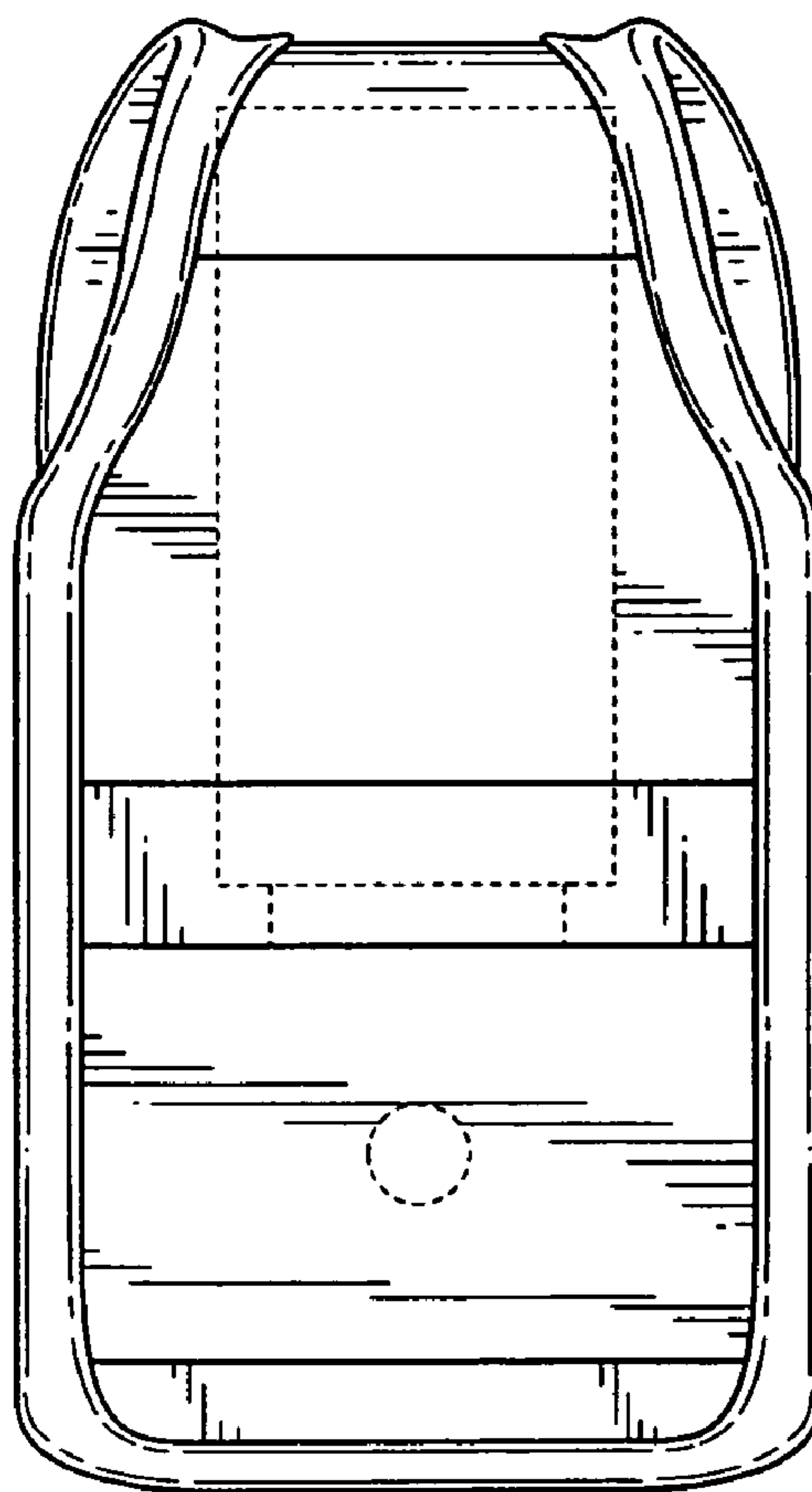

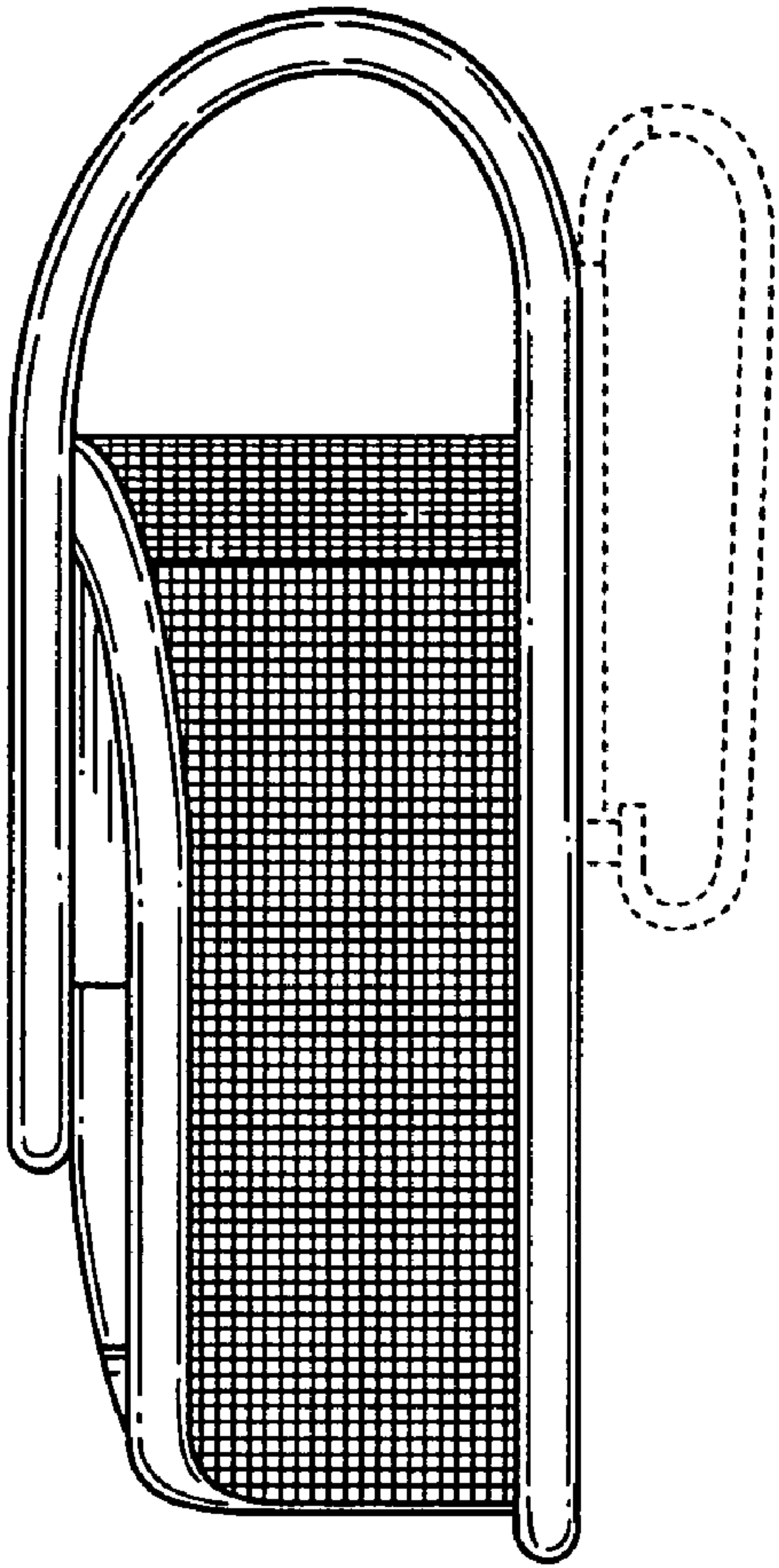

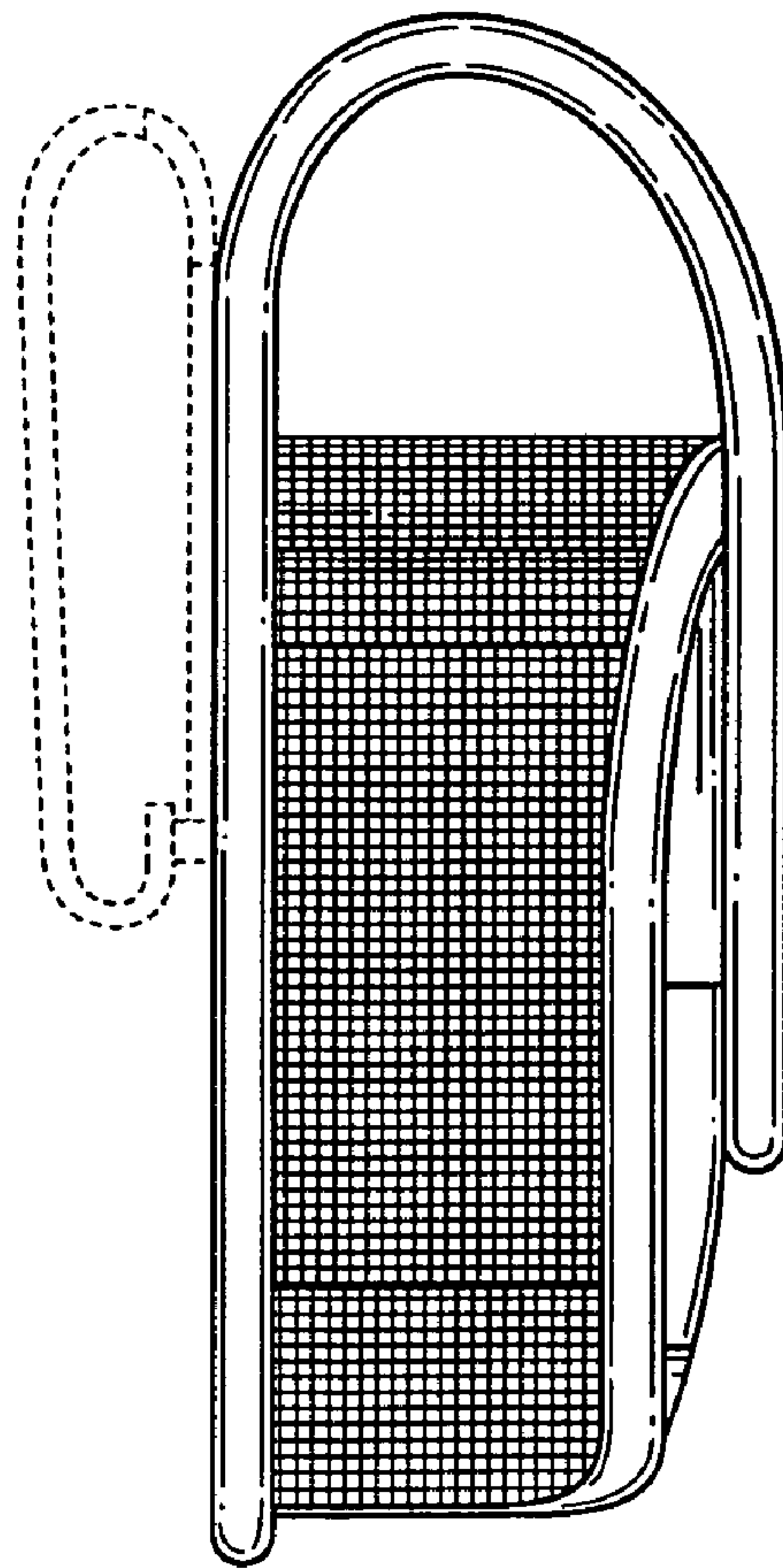

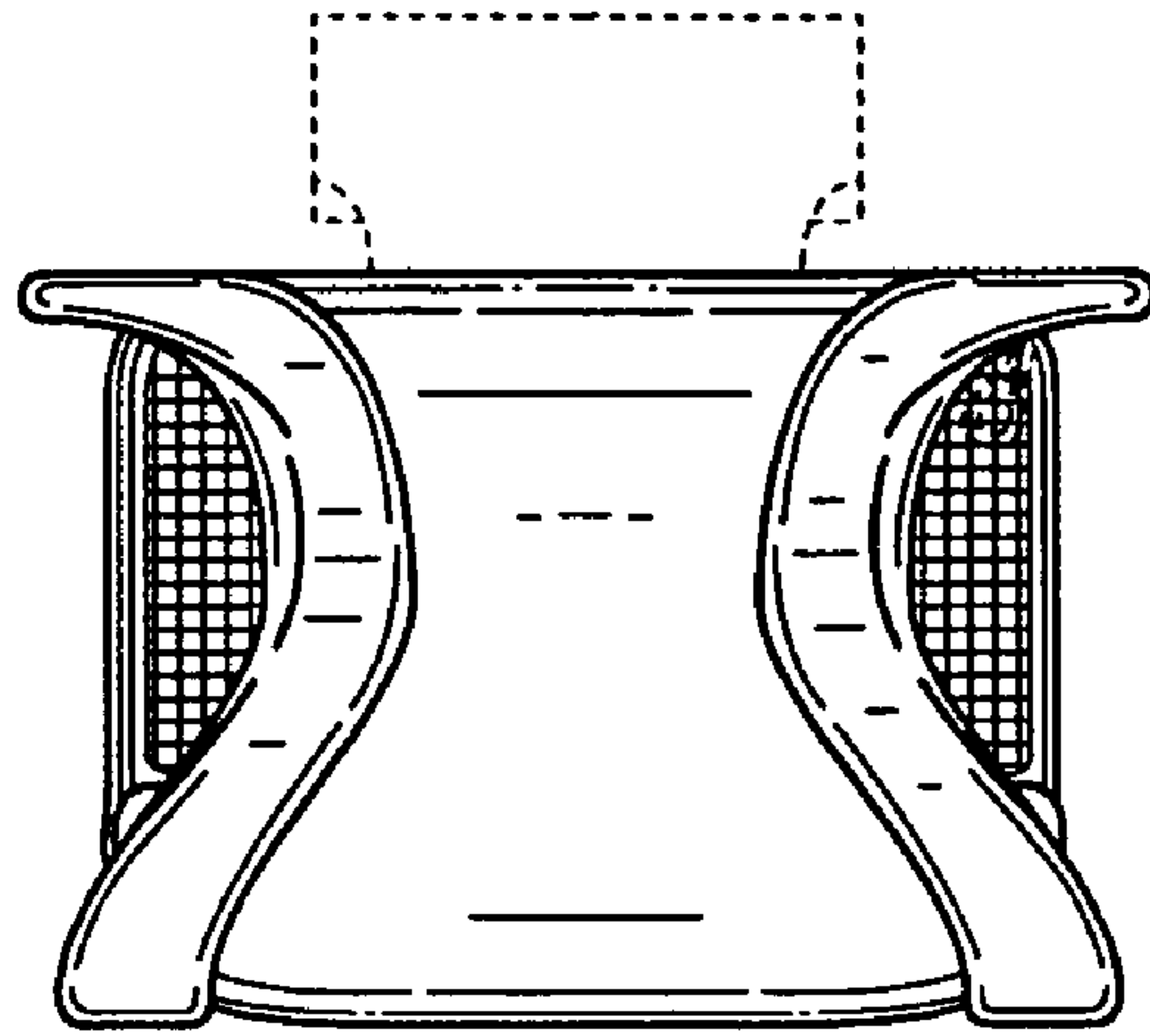

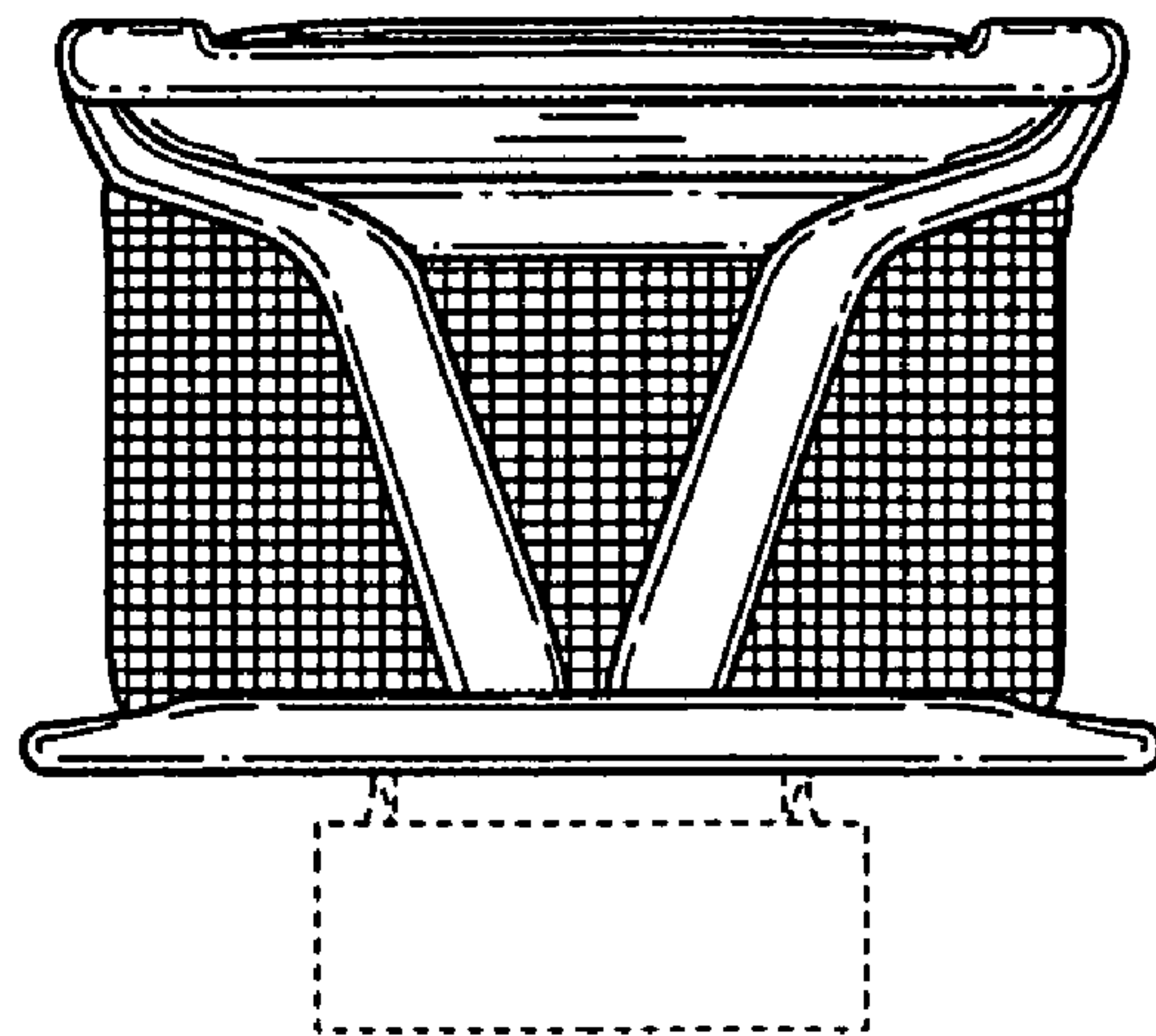

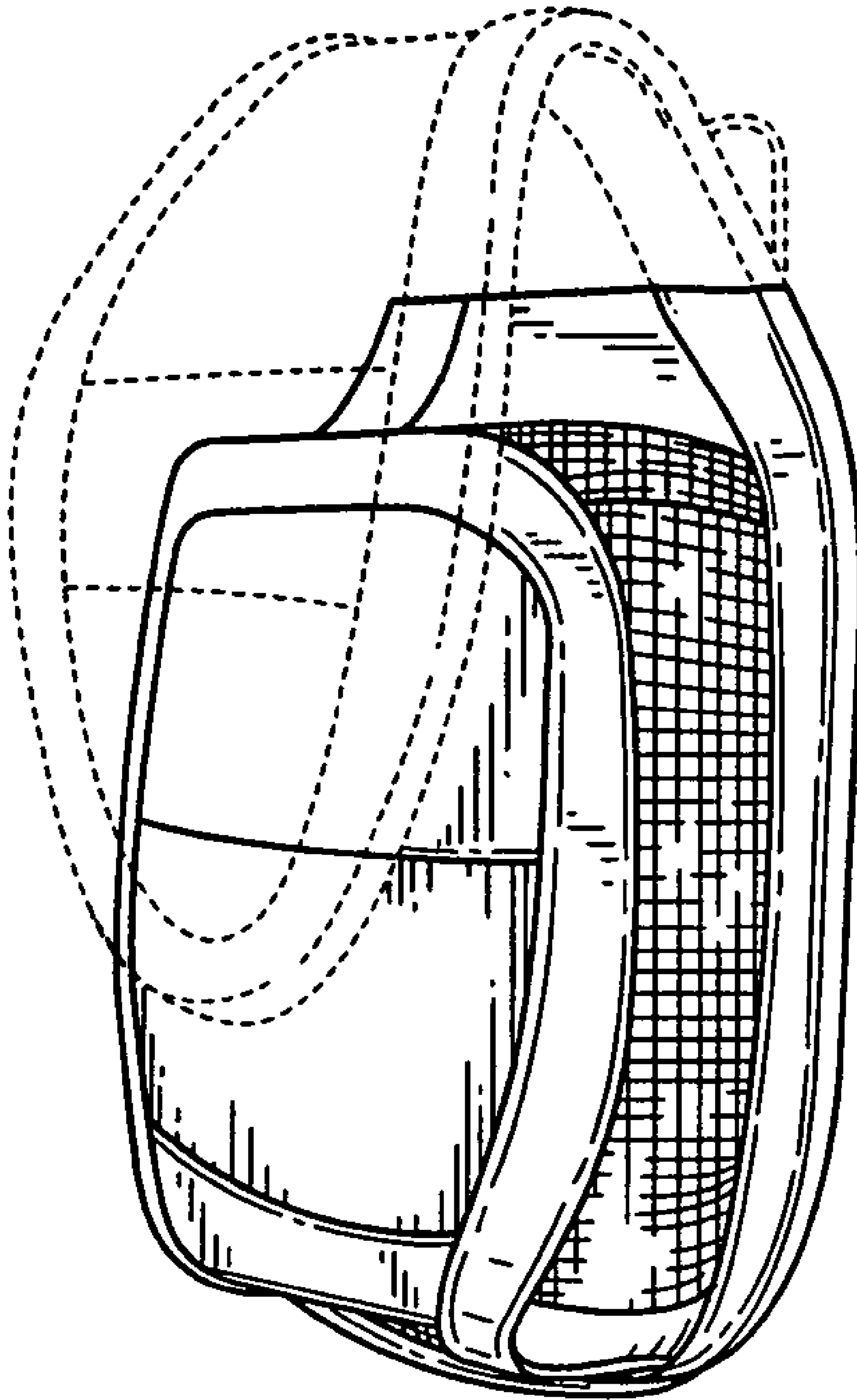

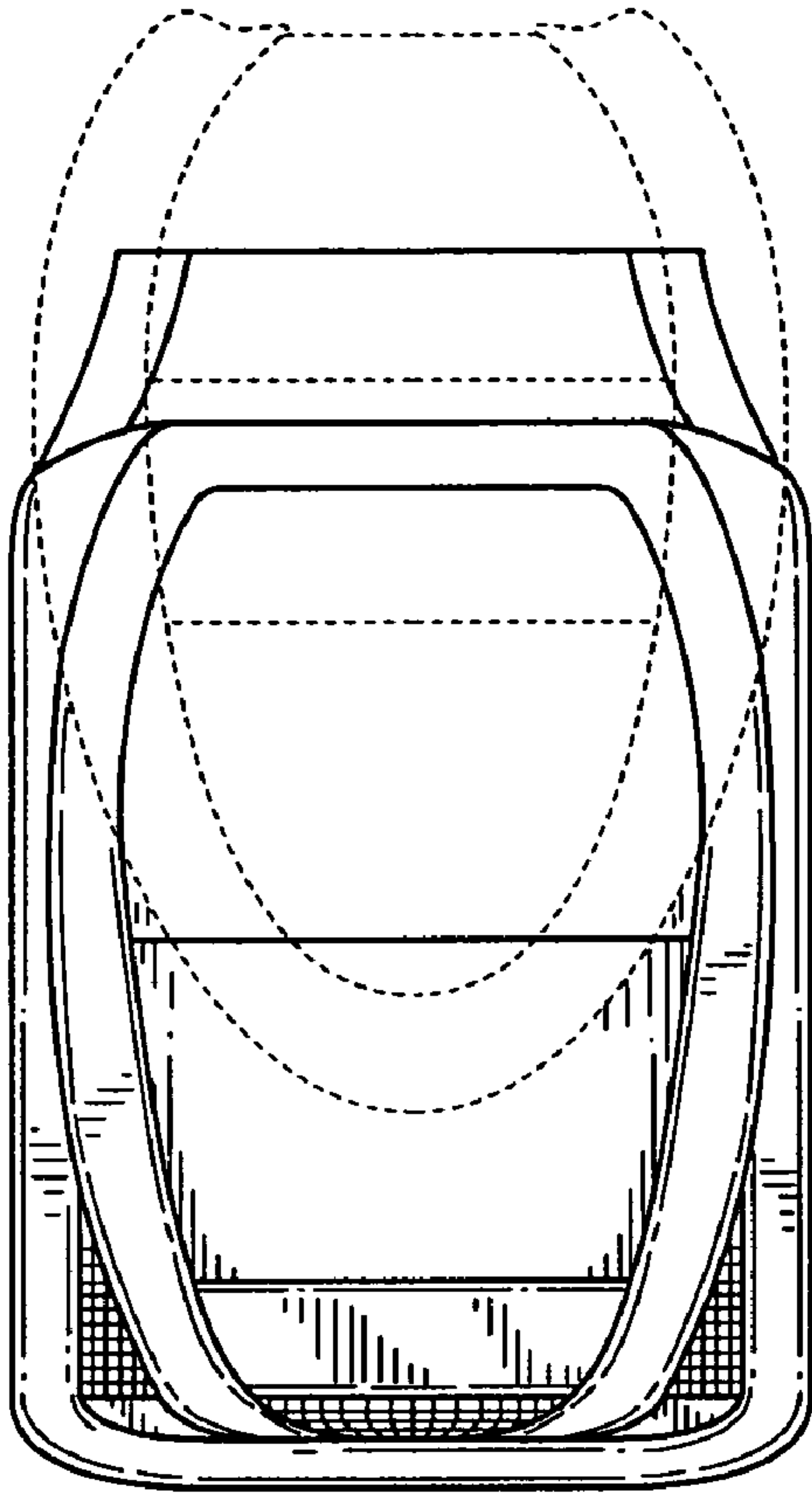

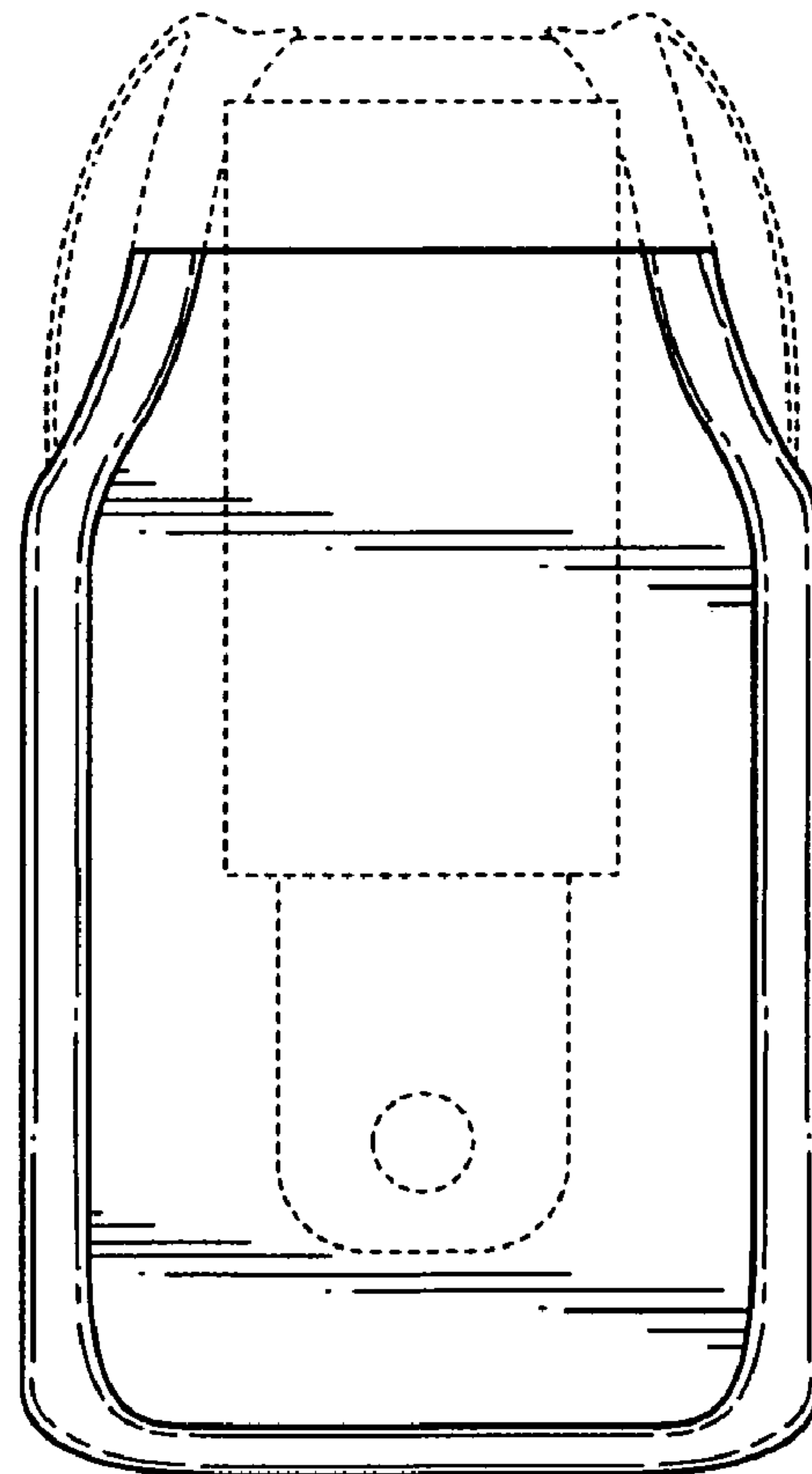

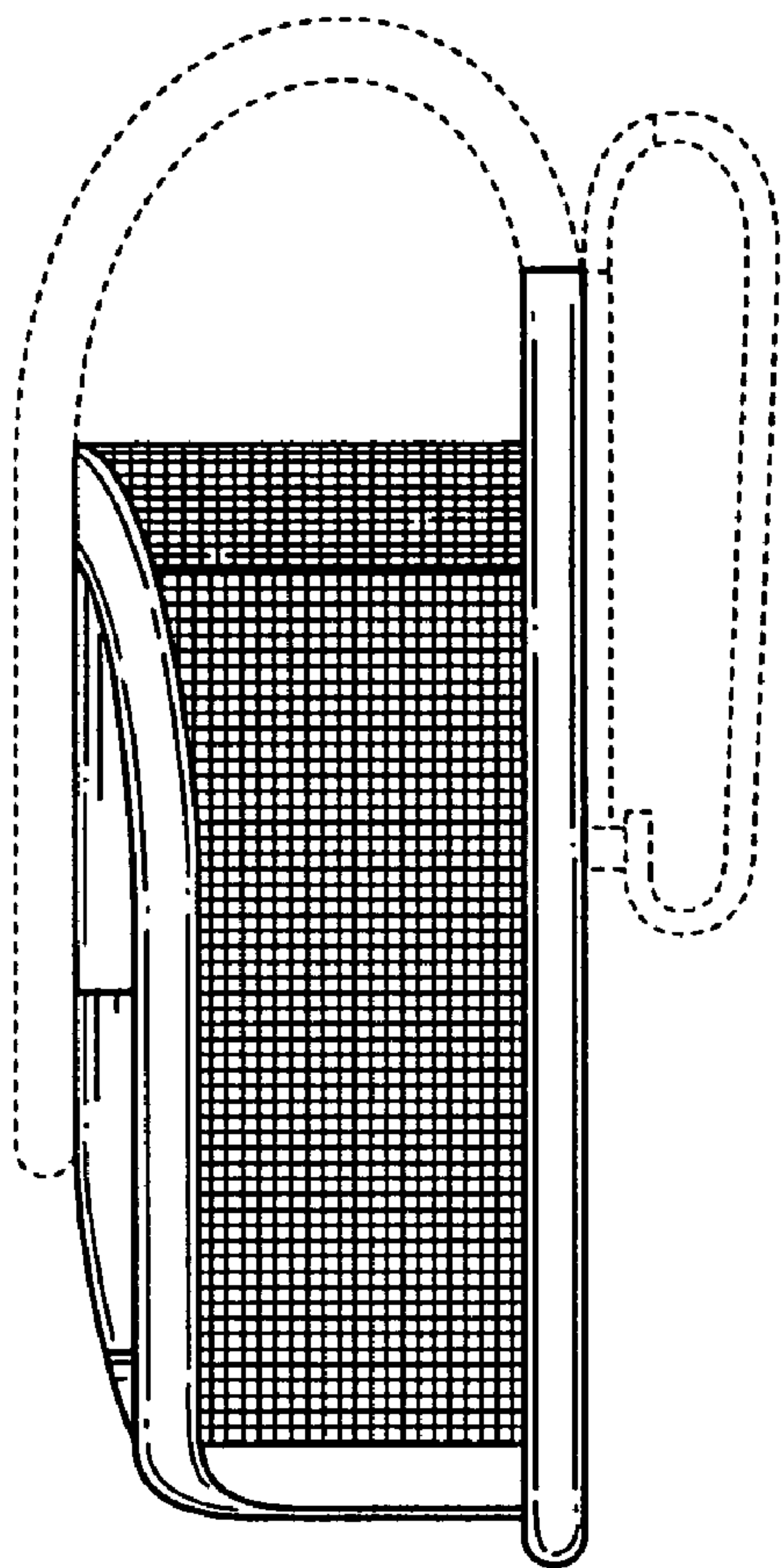

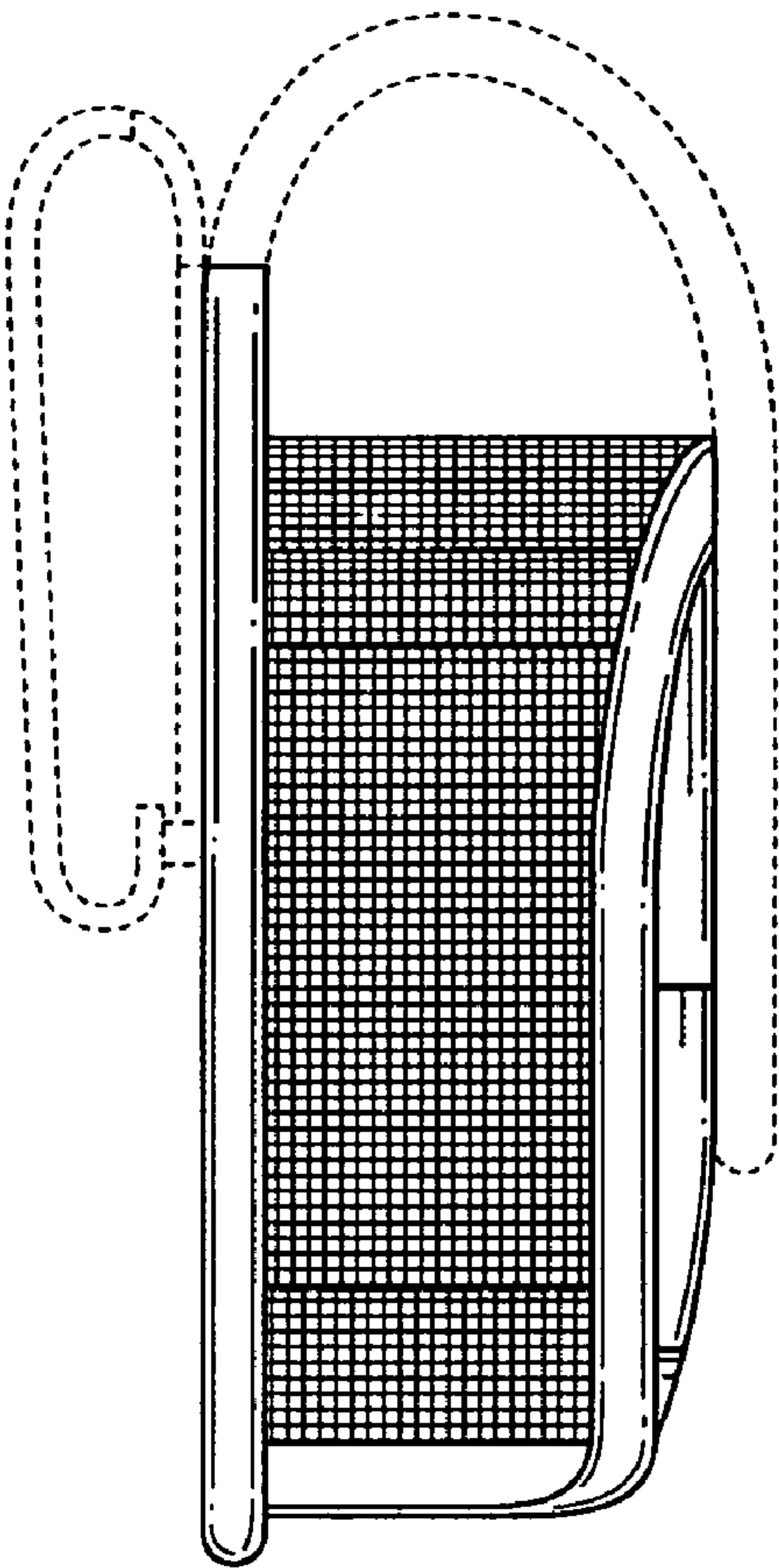

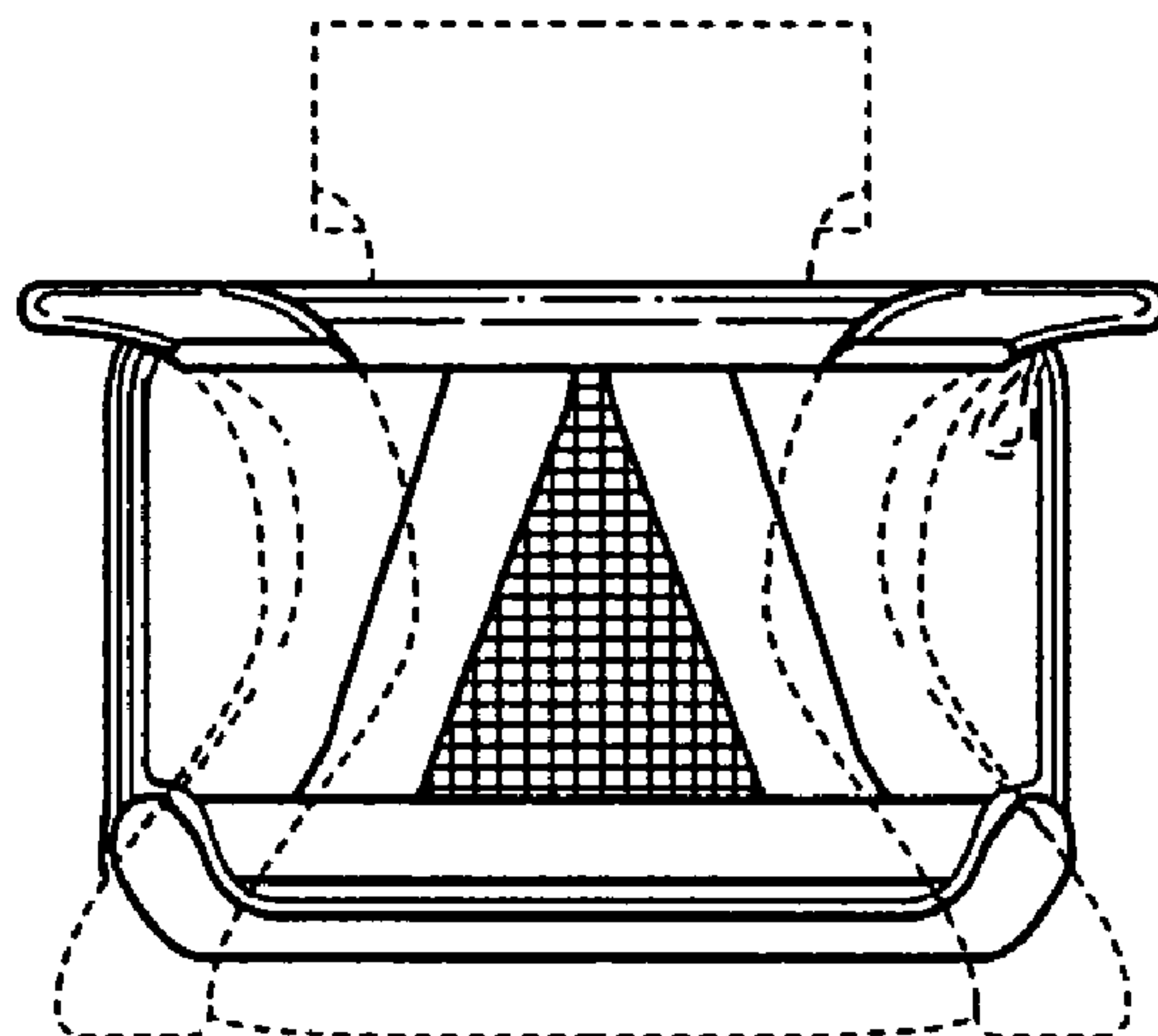

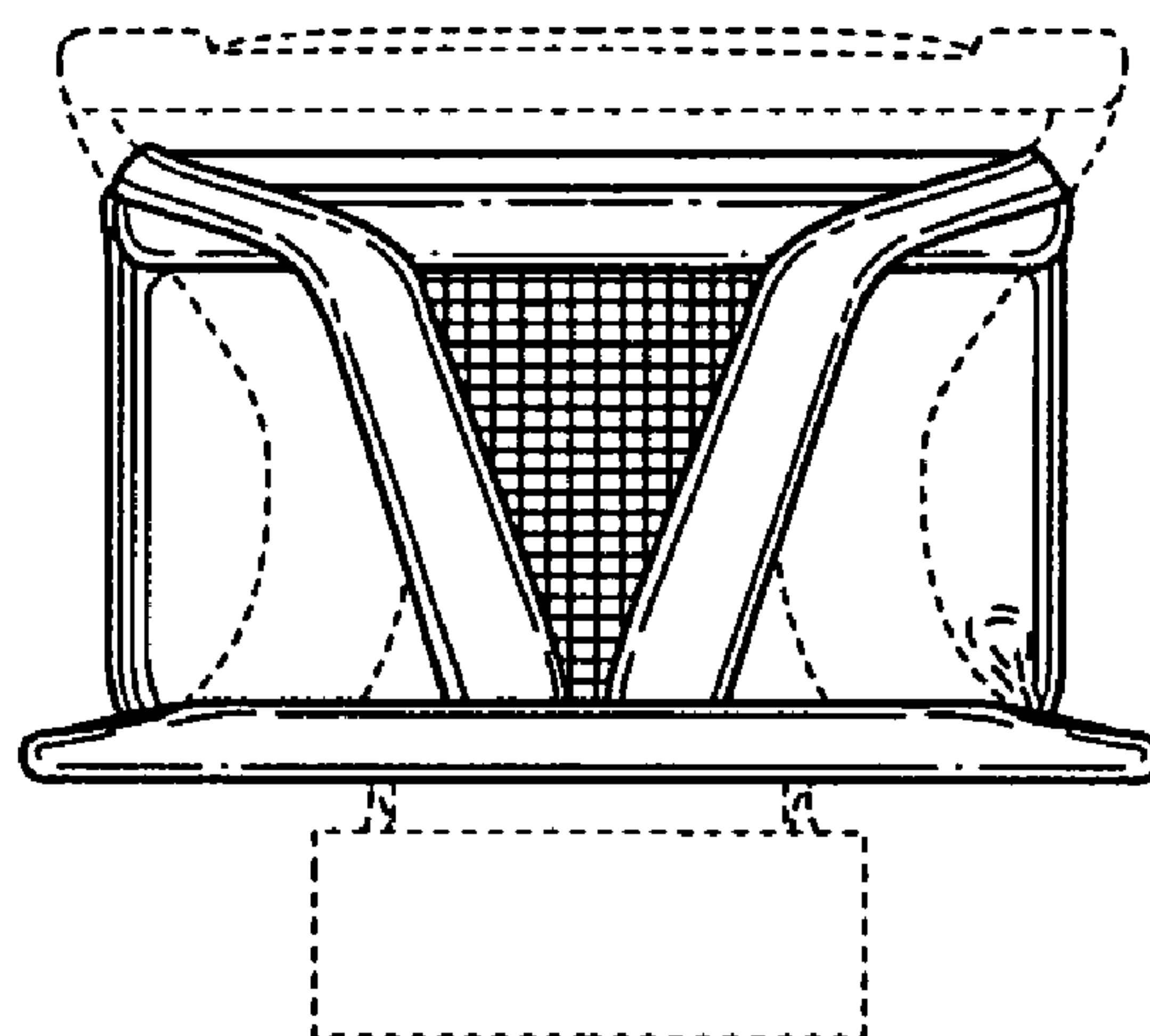

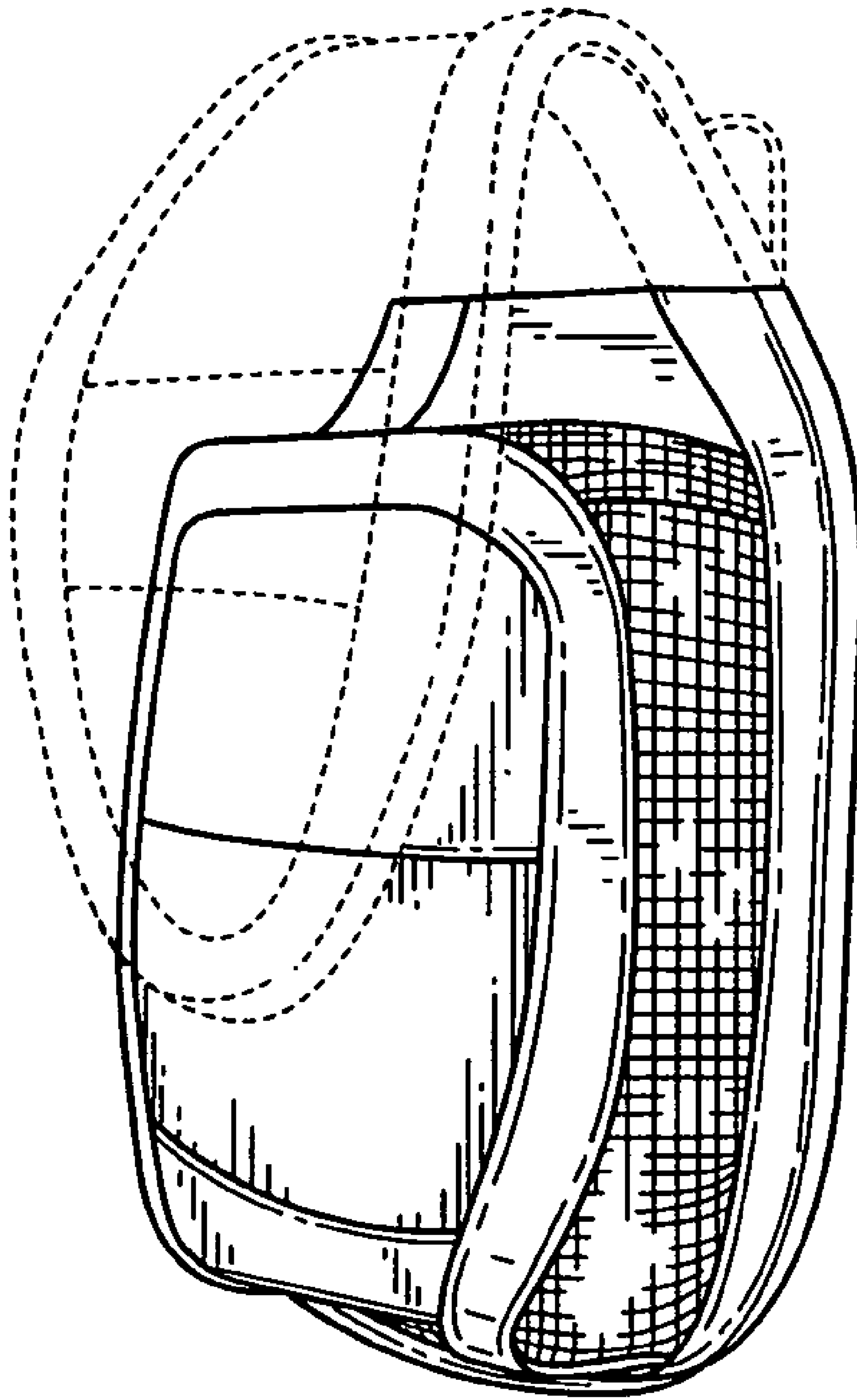

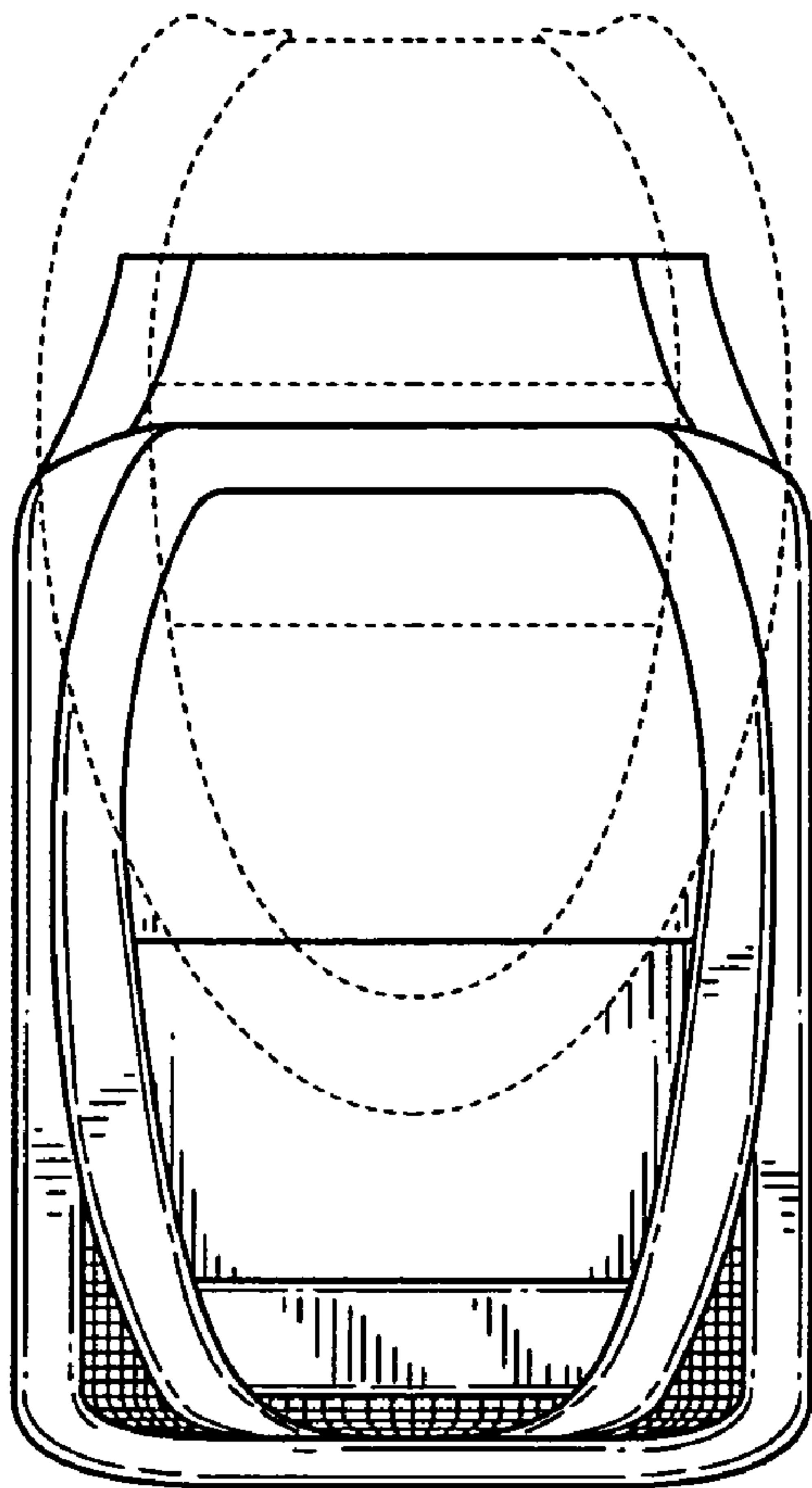

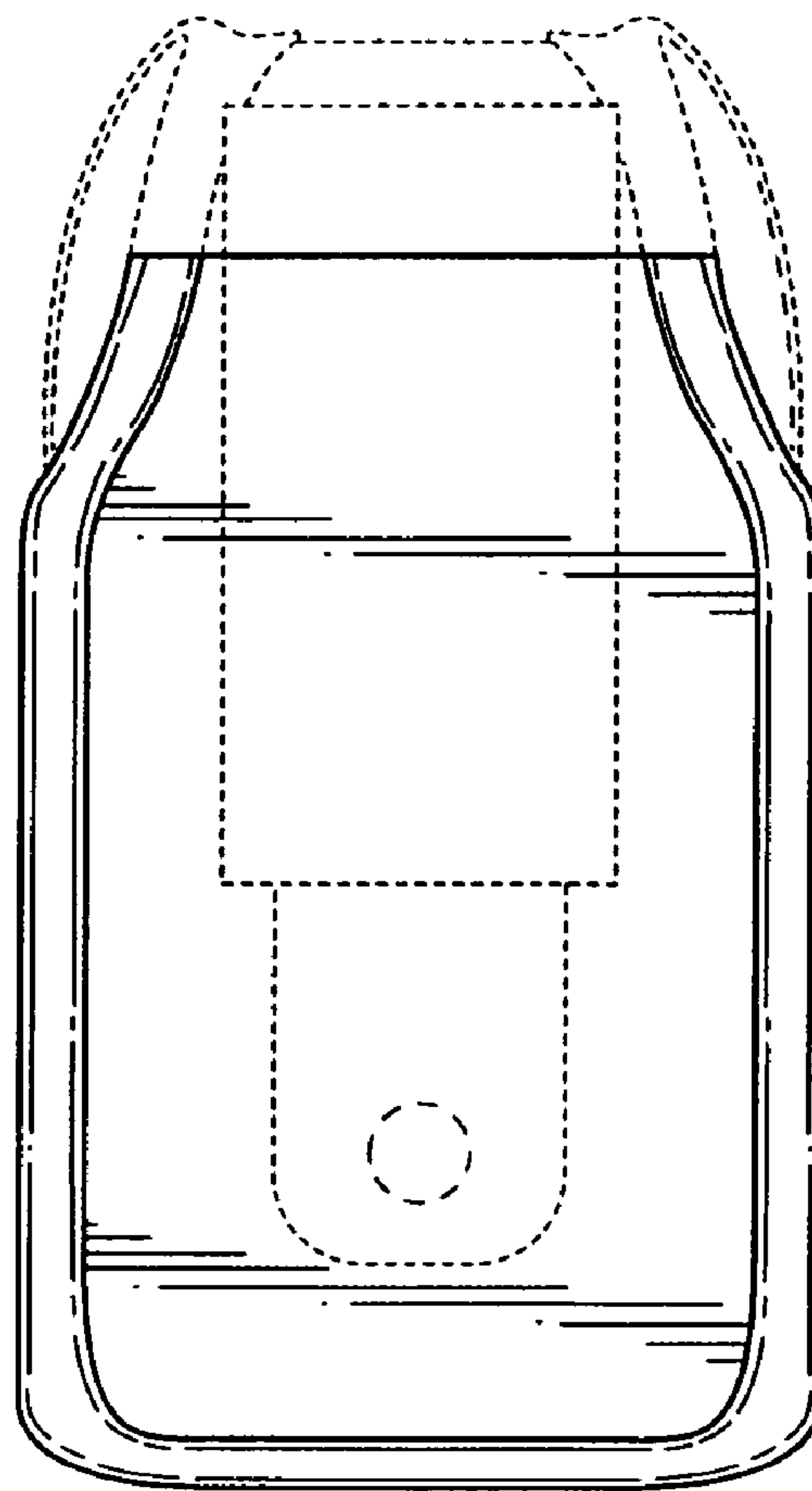

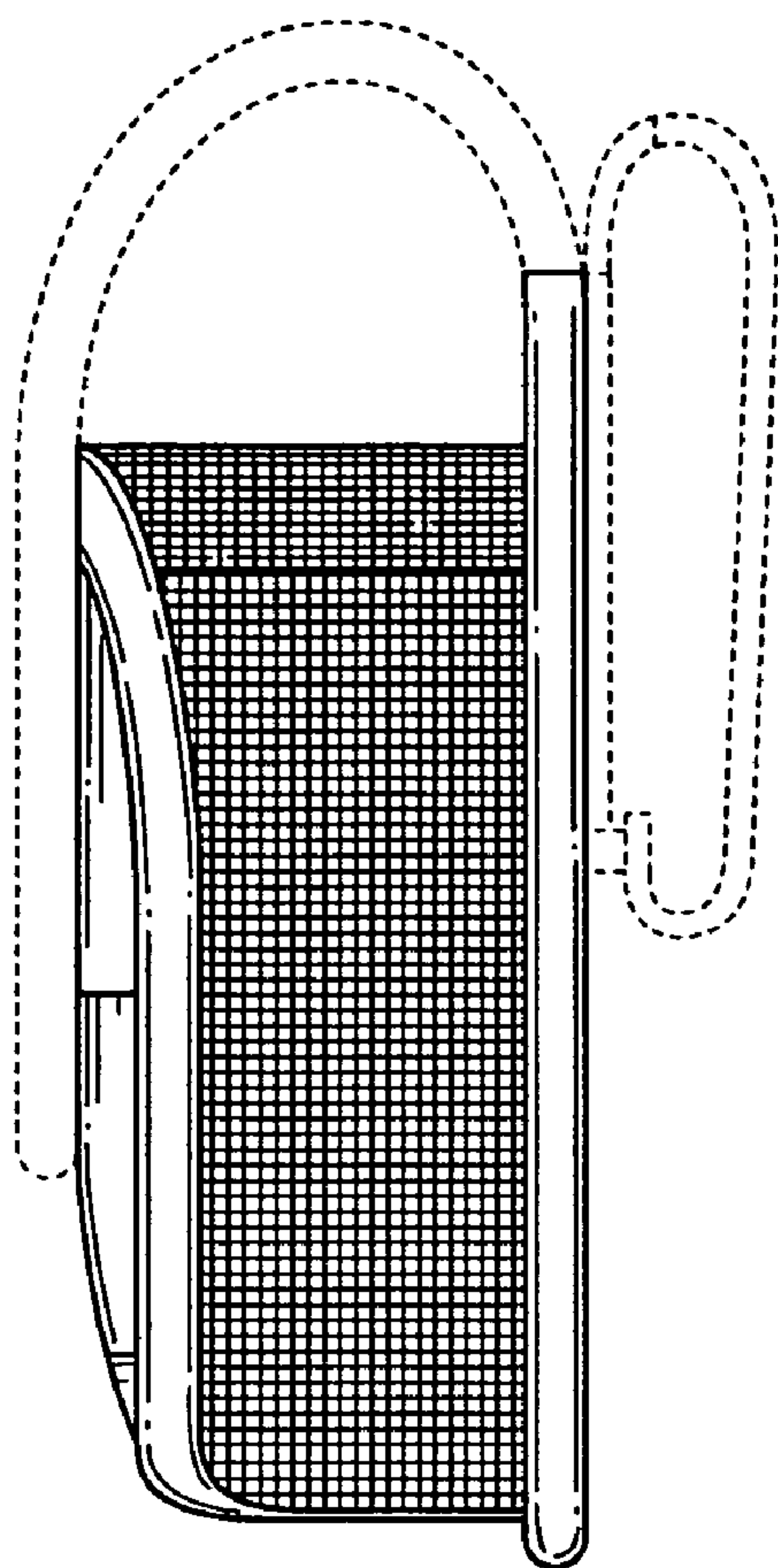

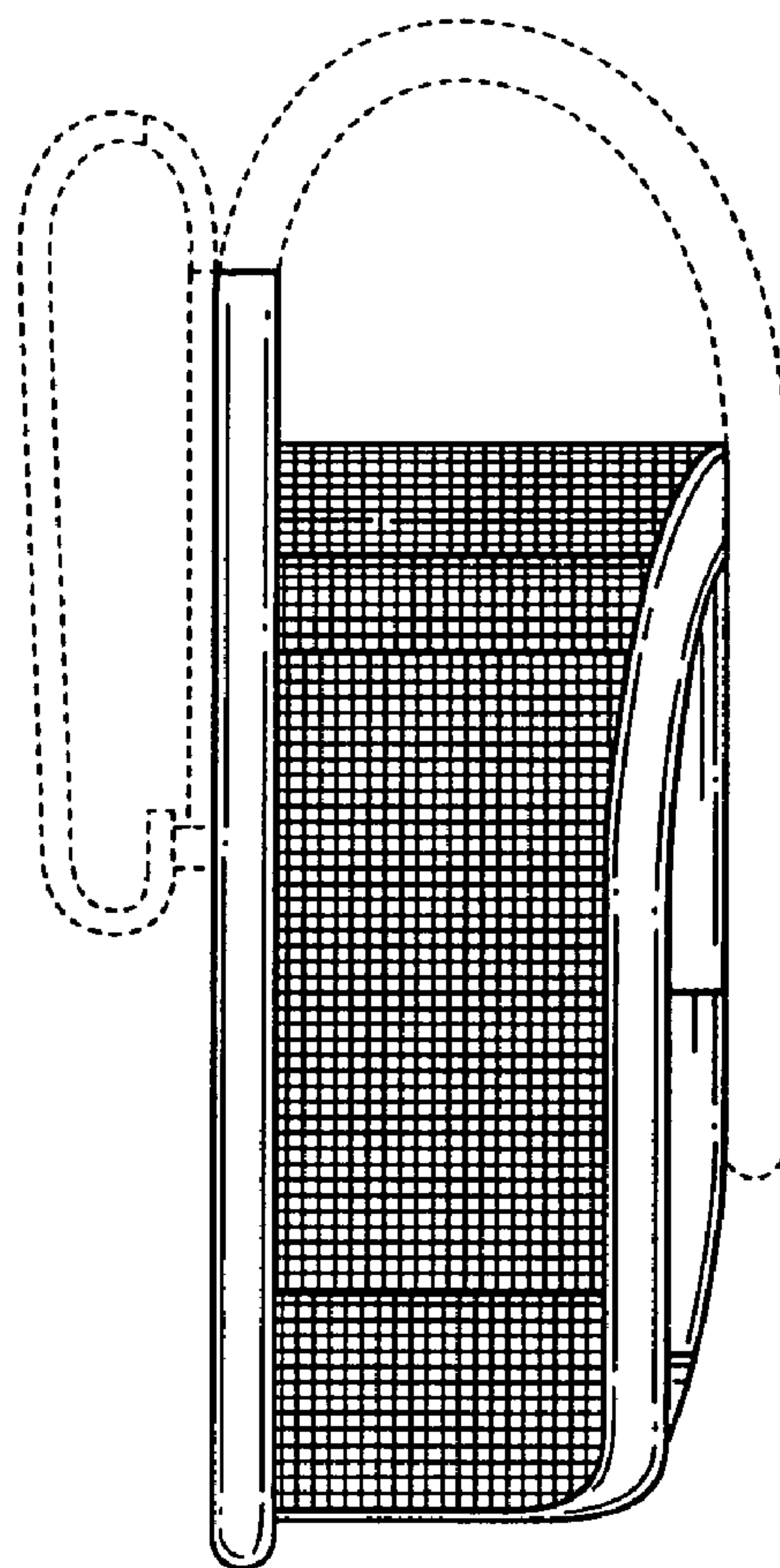

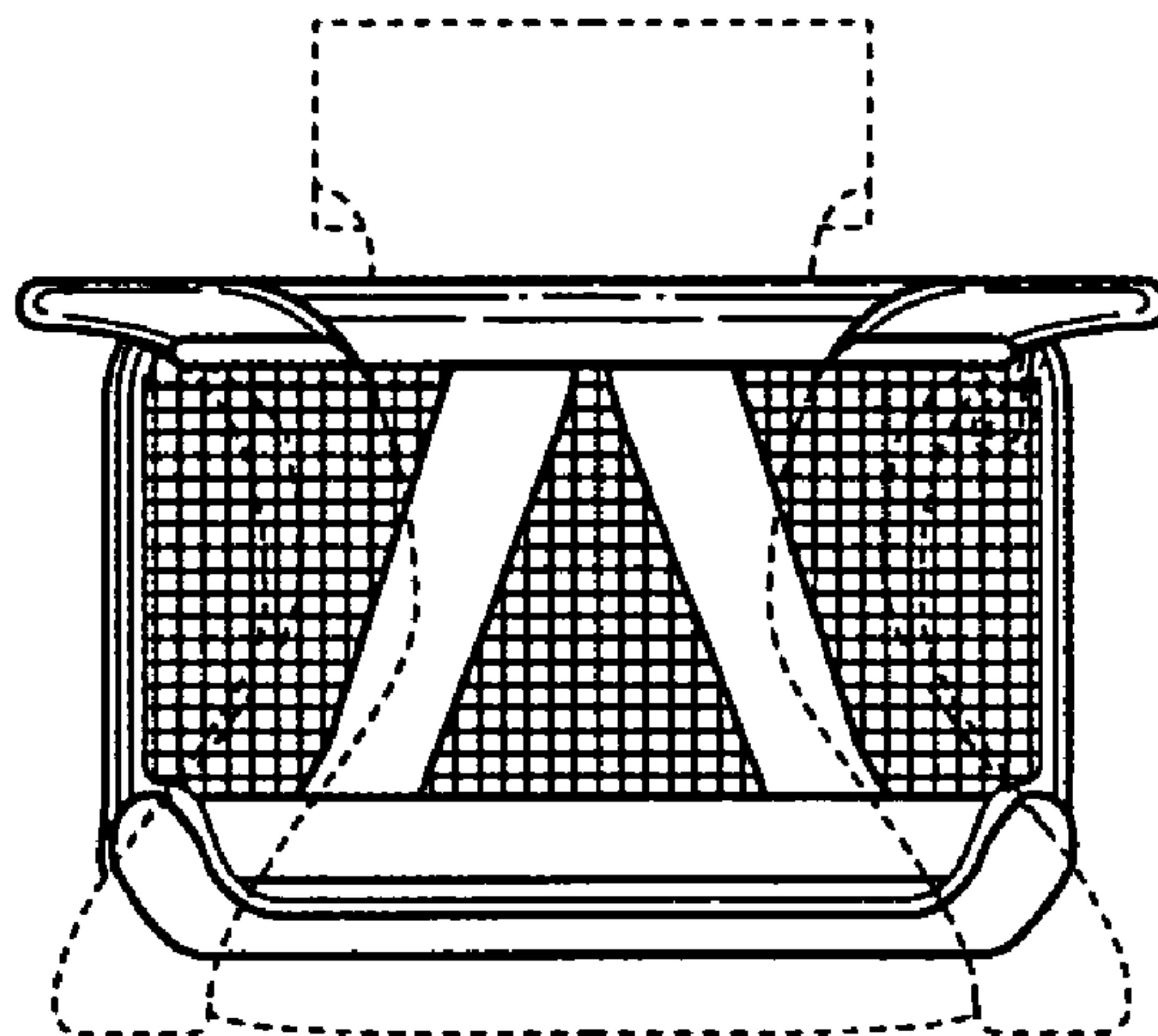

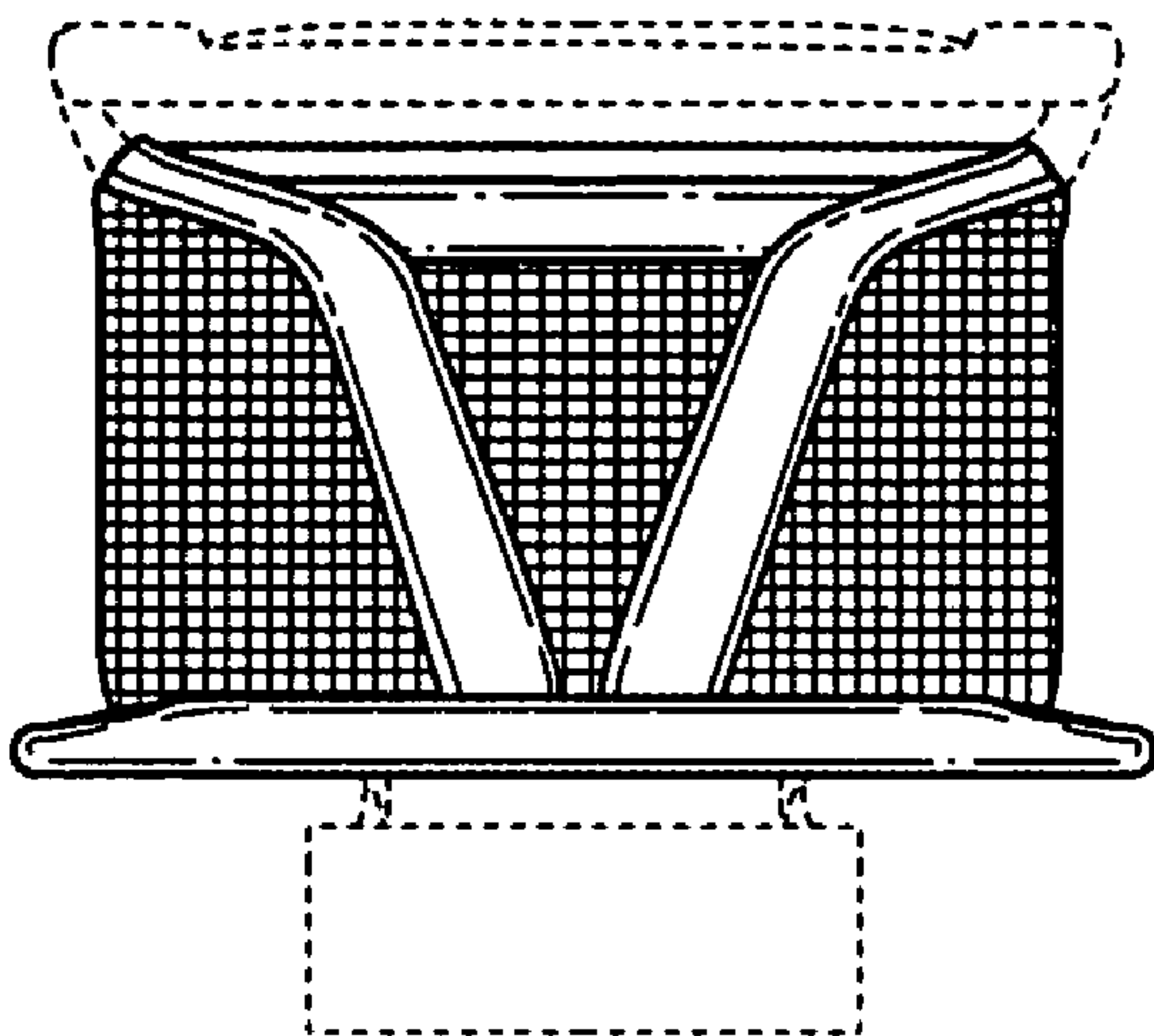
