FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;

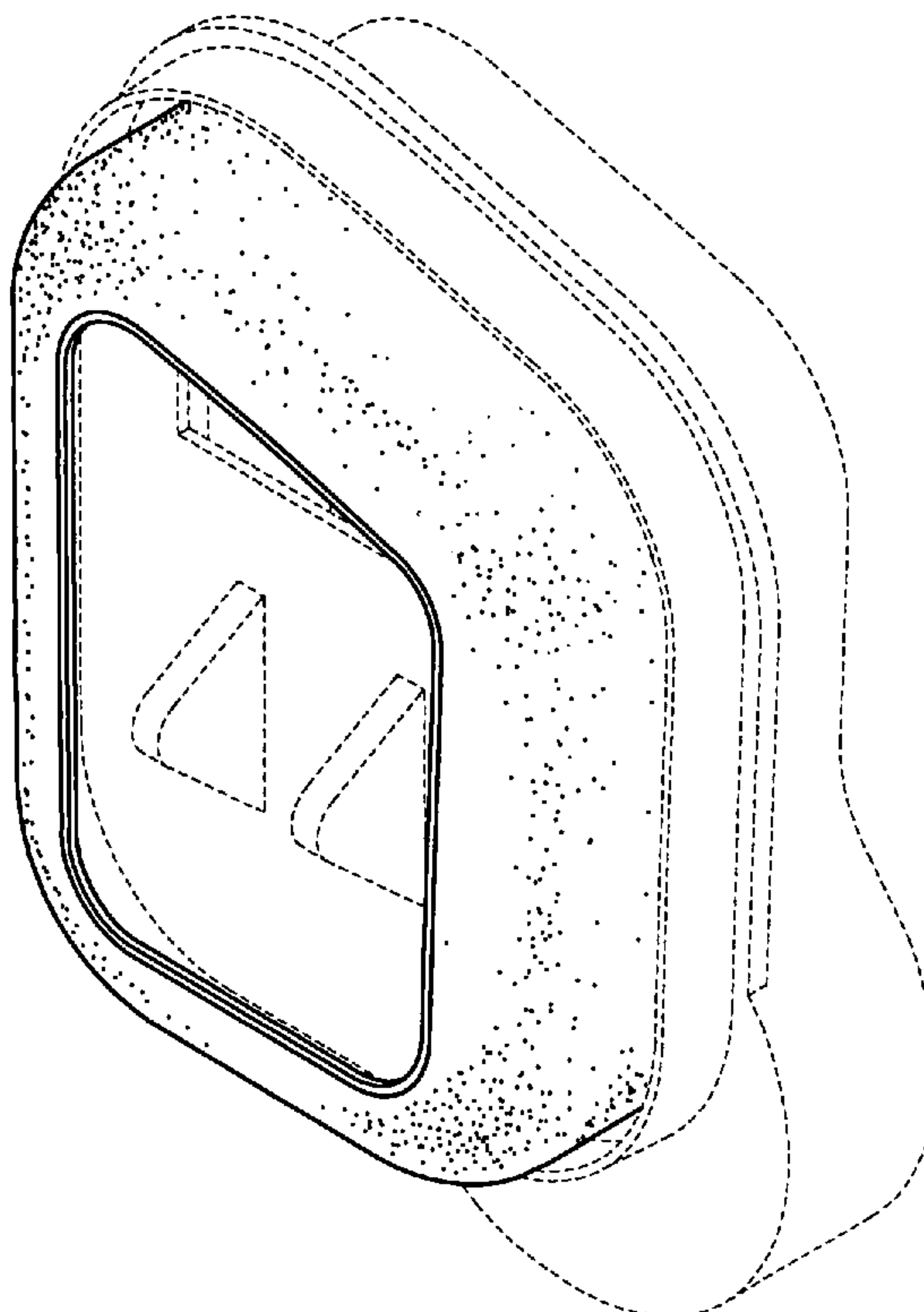
FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof; and,

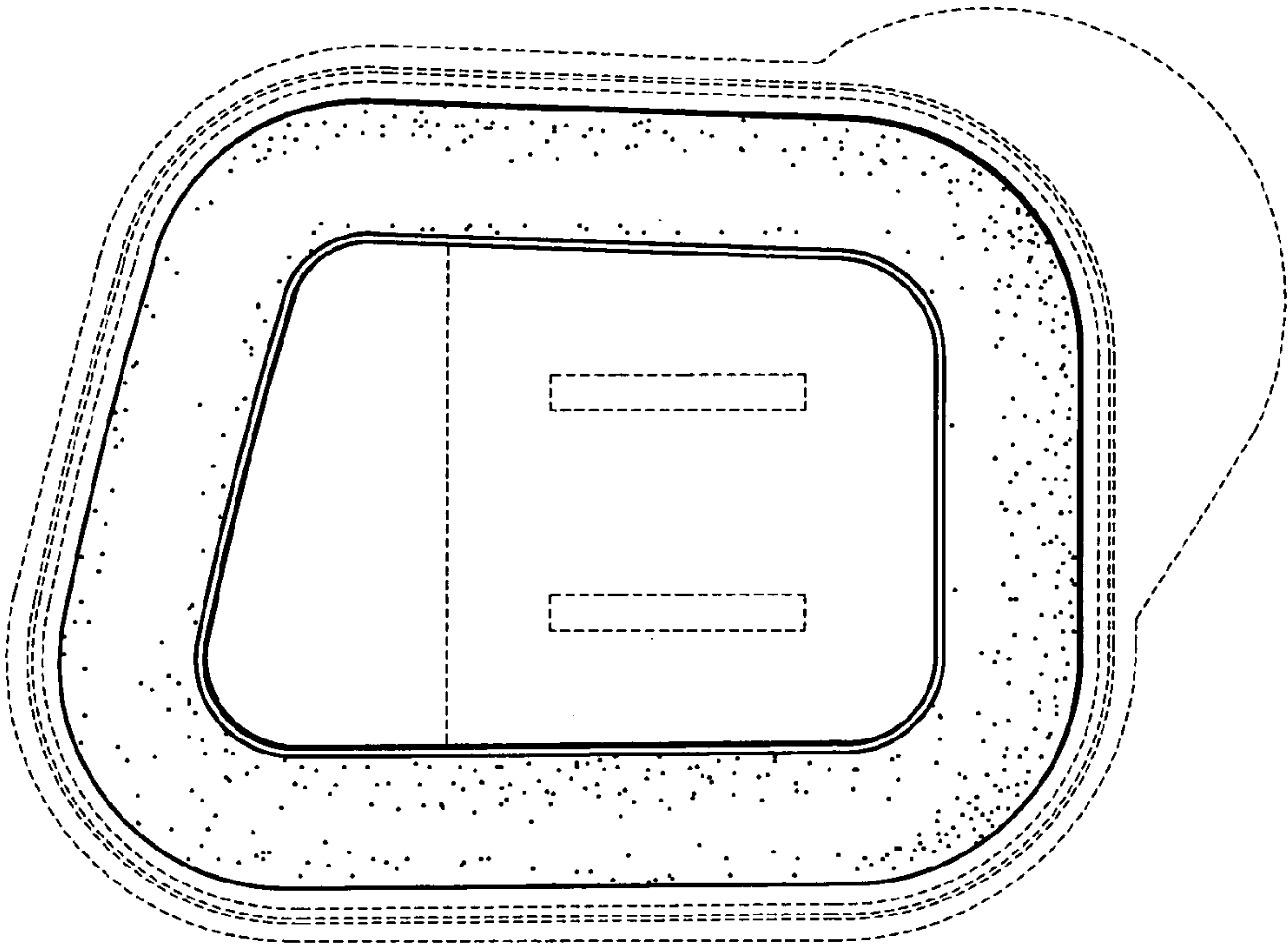

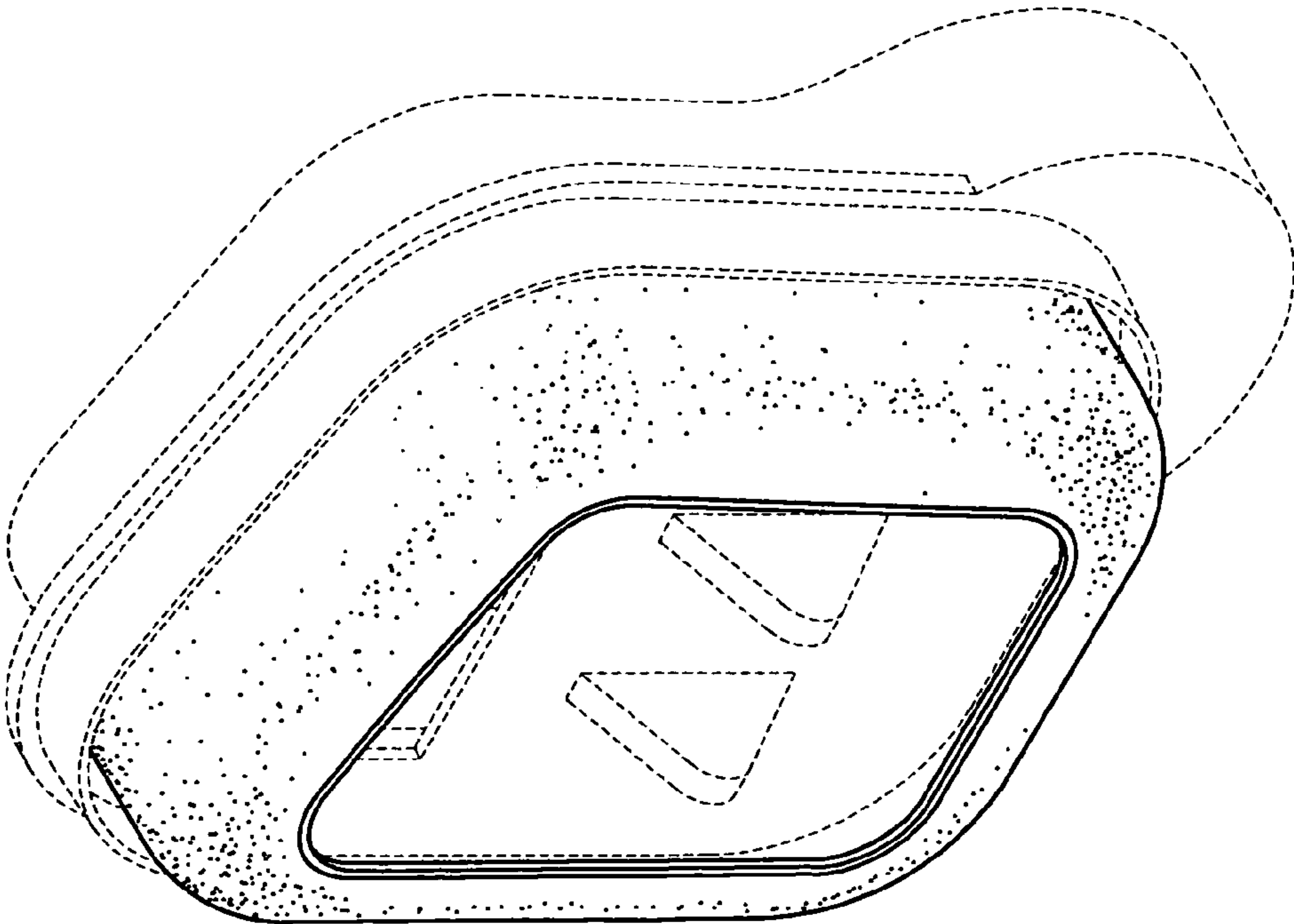

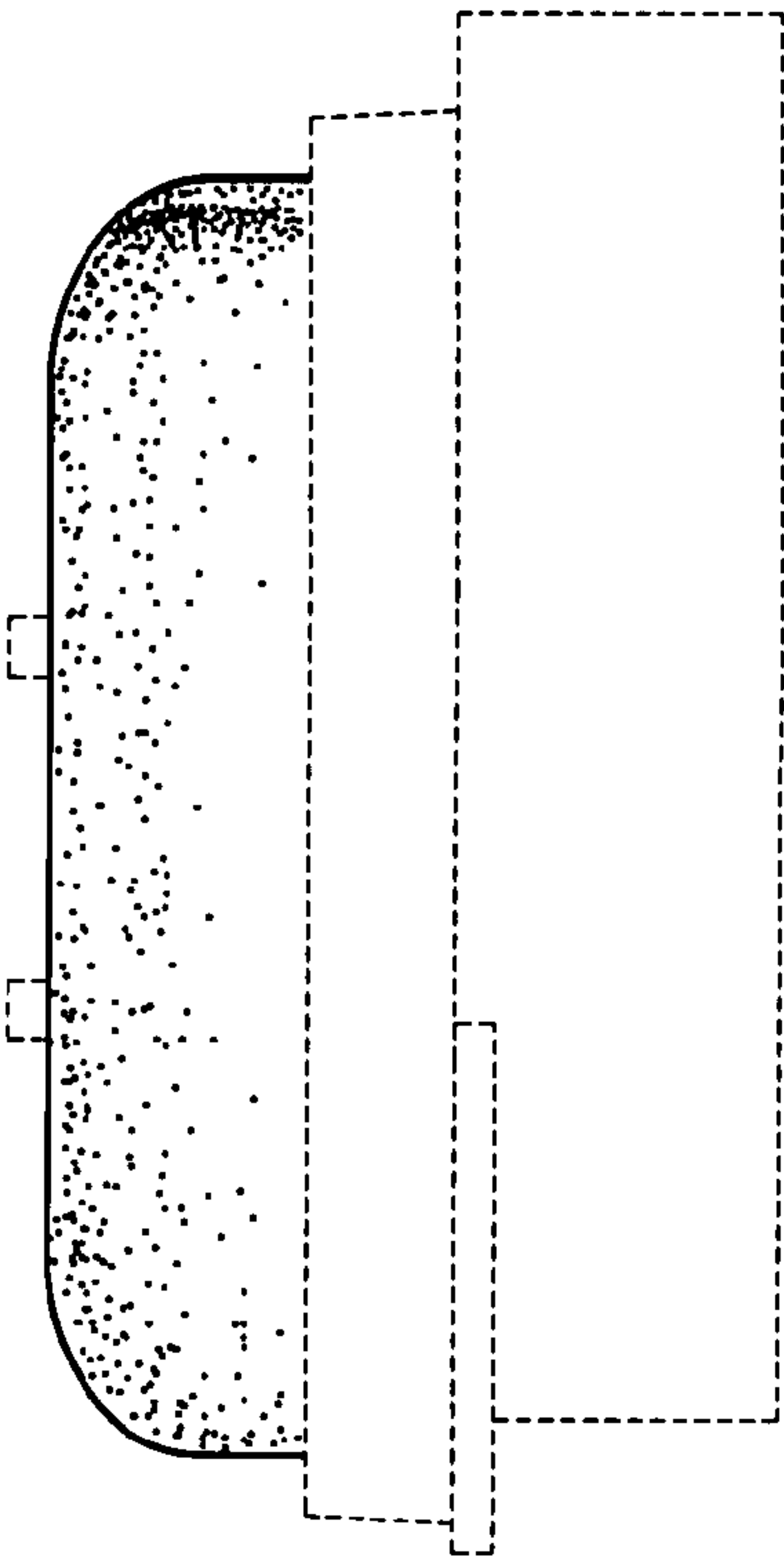

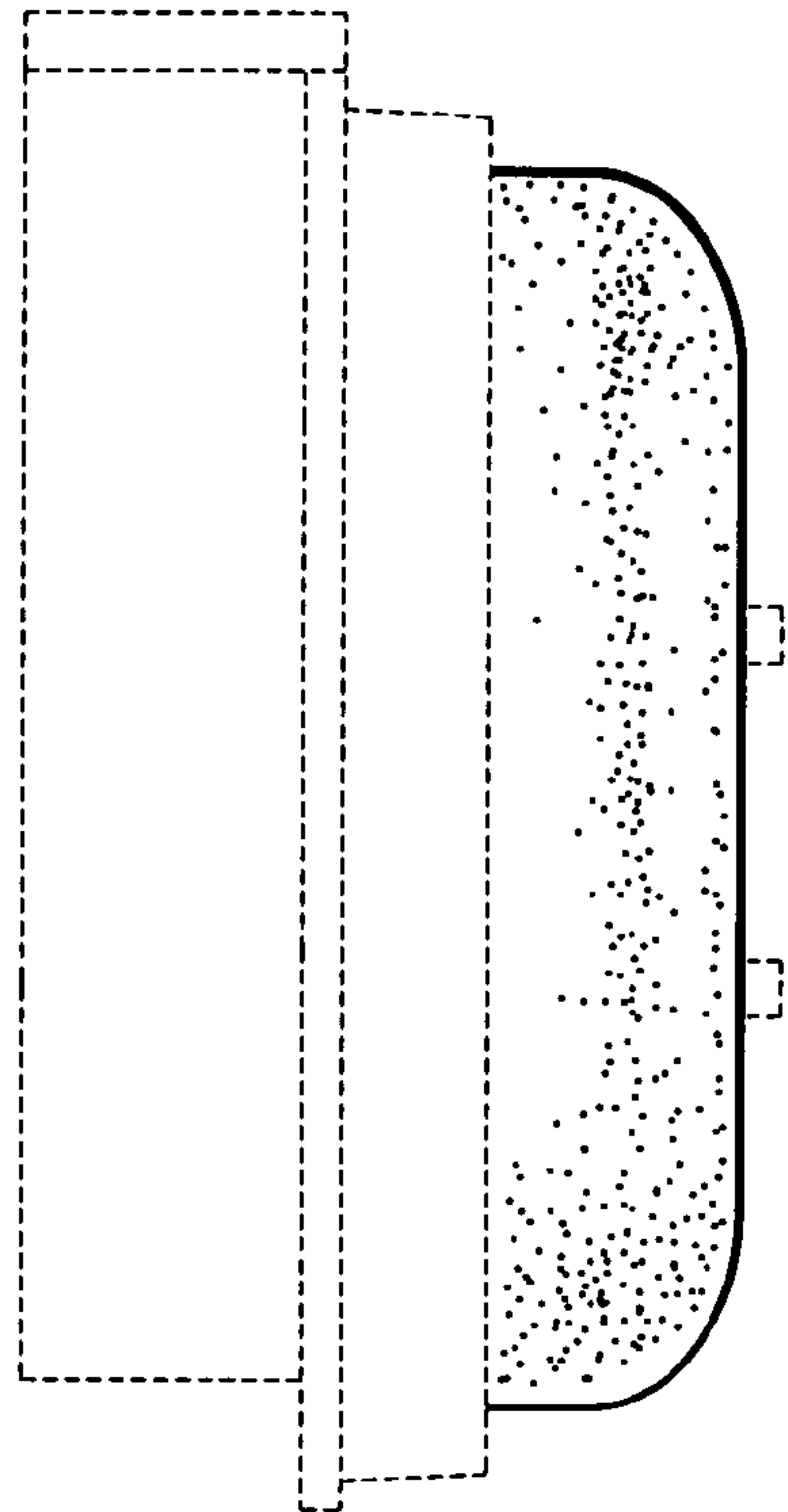

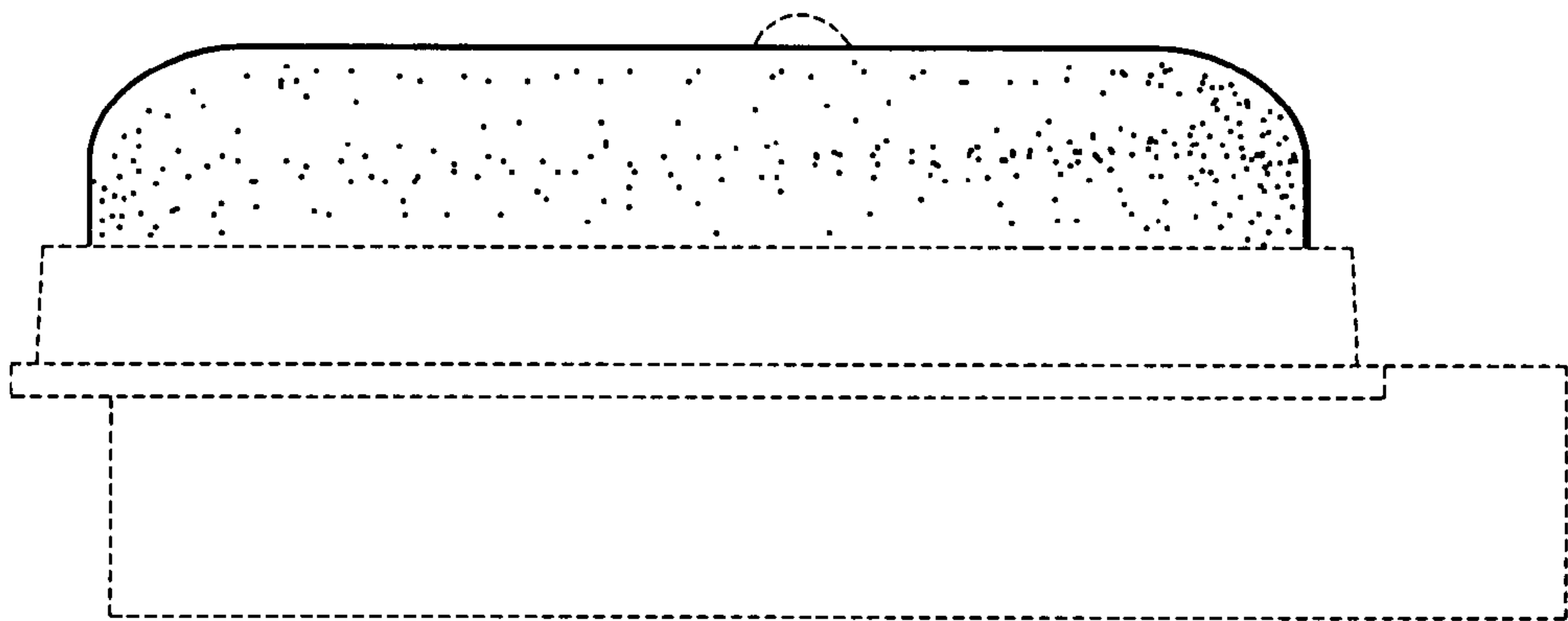

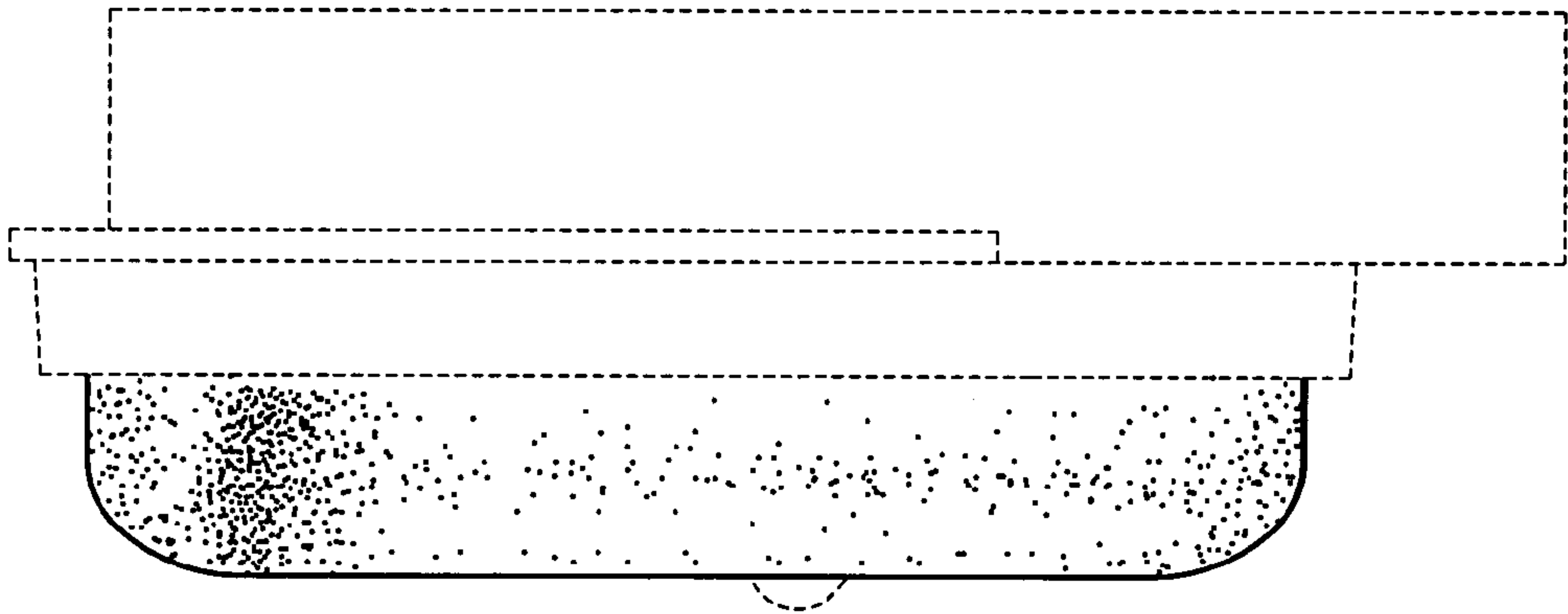

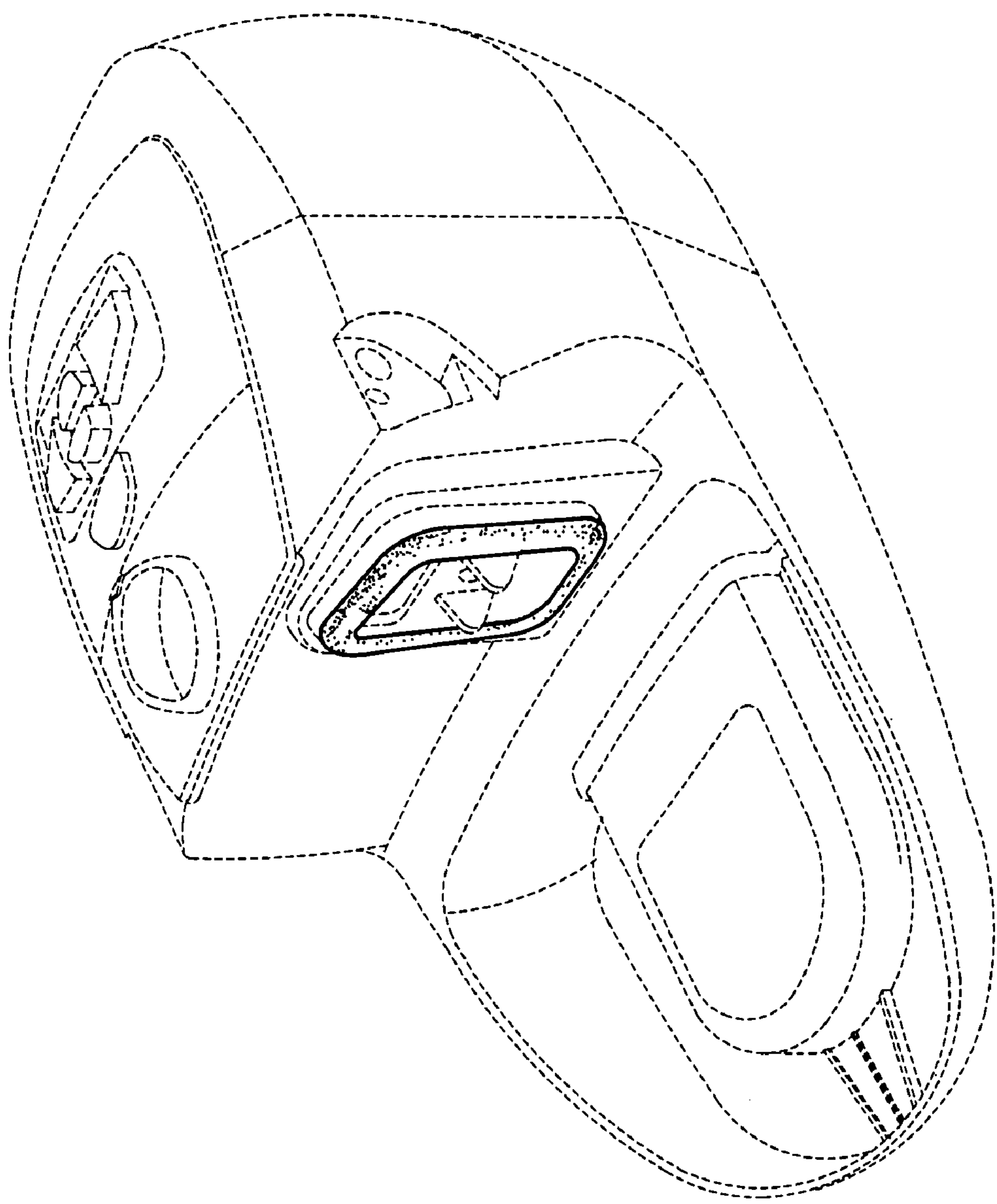
