wall panels;

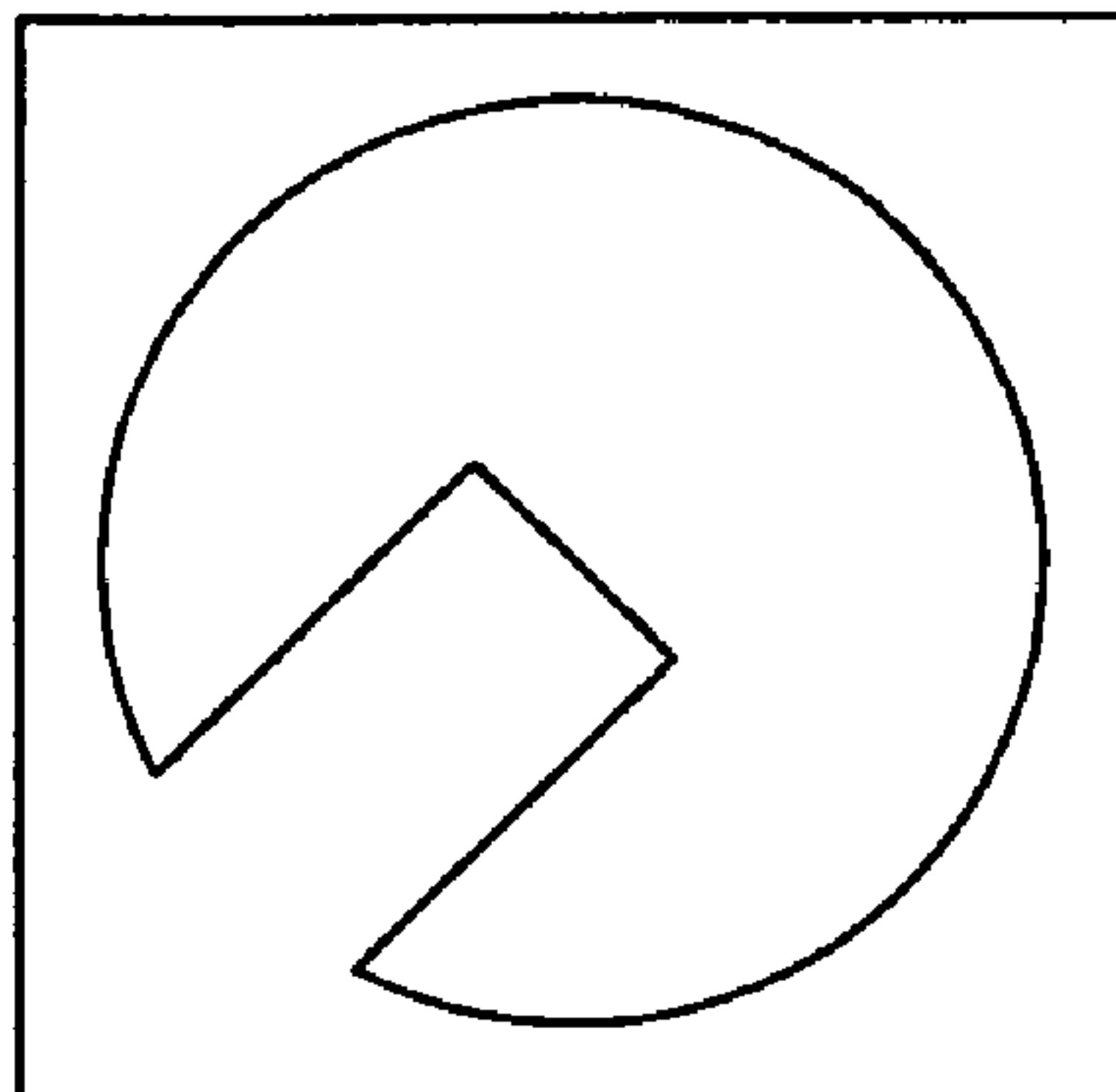
FIG. 9 is a reduced scale top view of the embodiment of FIG.

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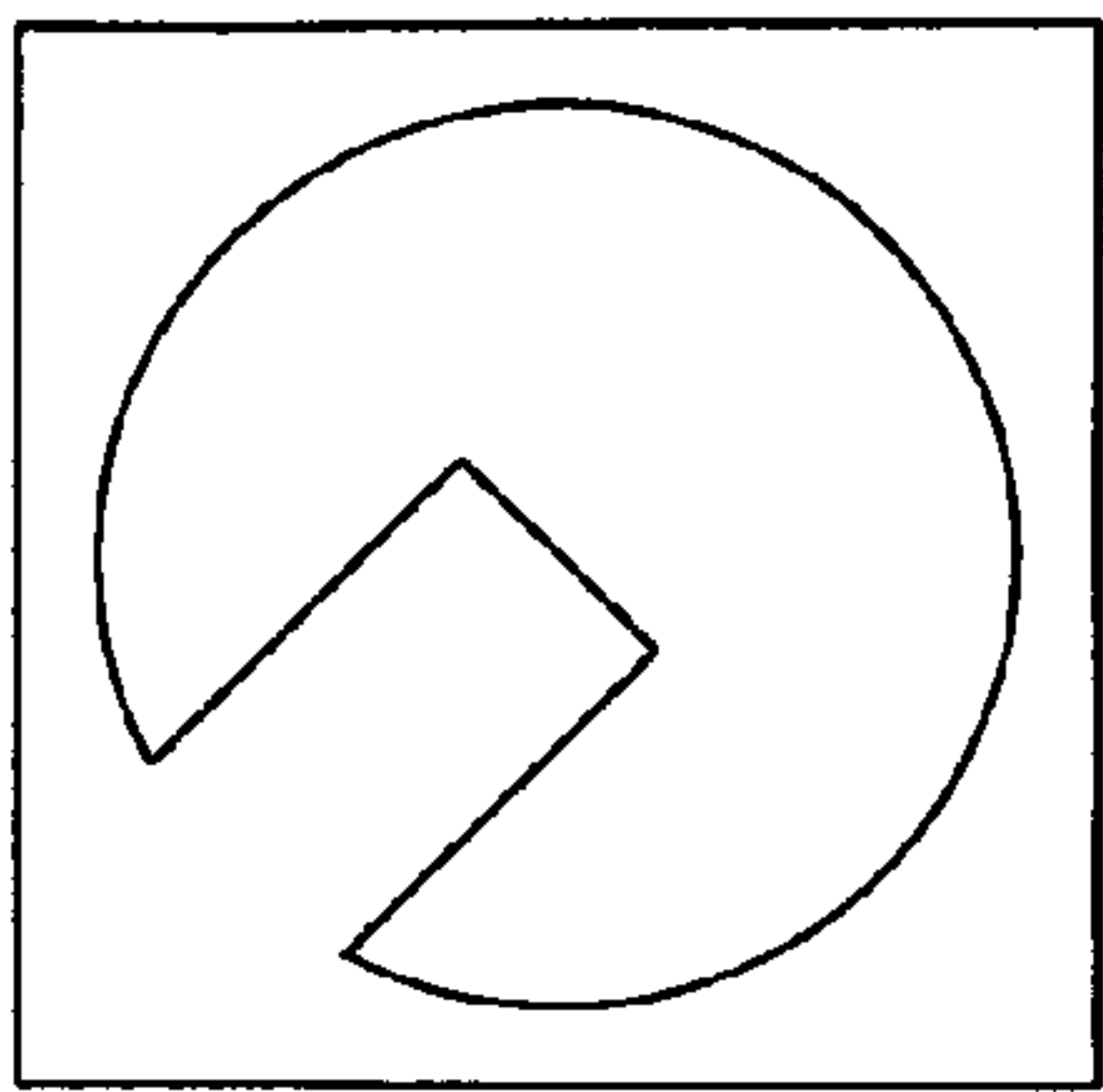

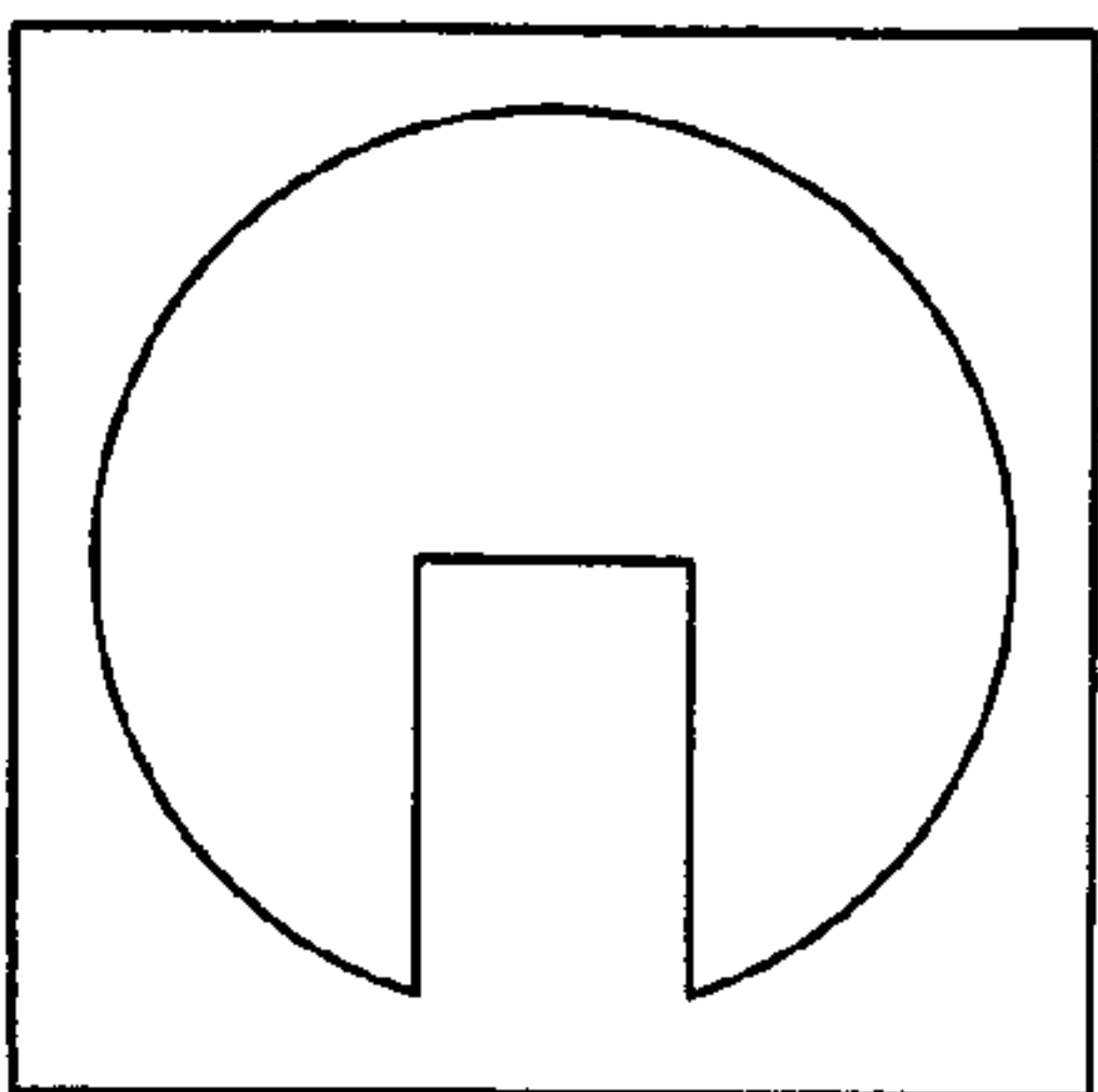

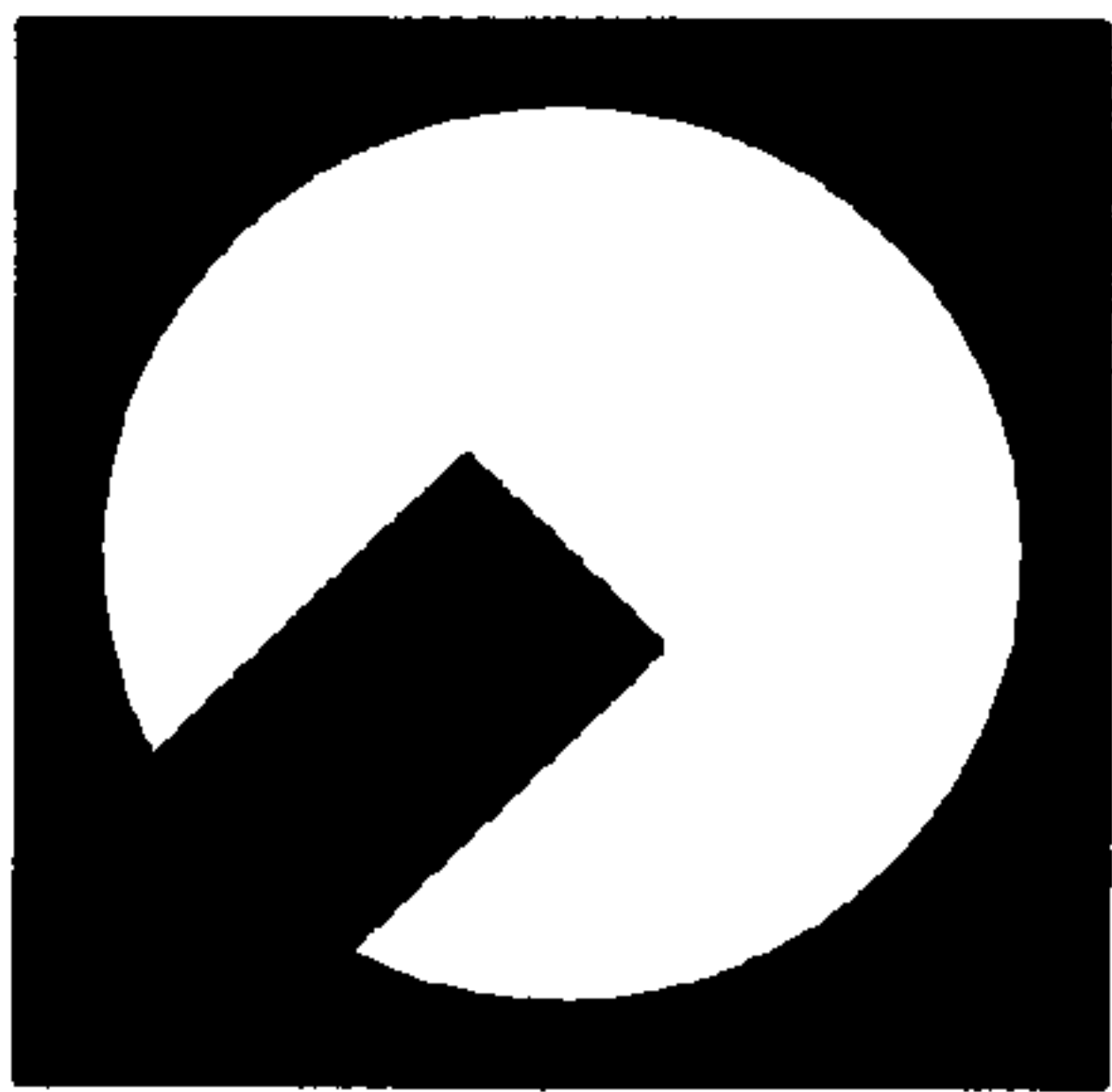

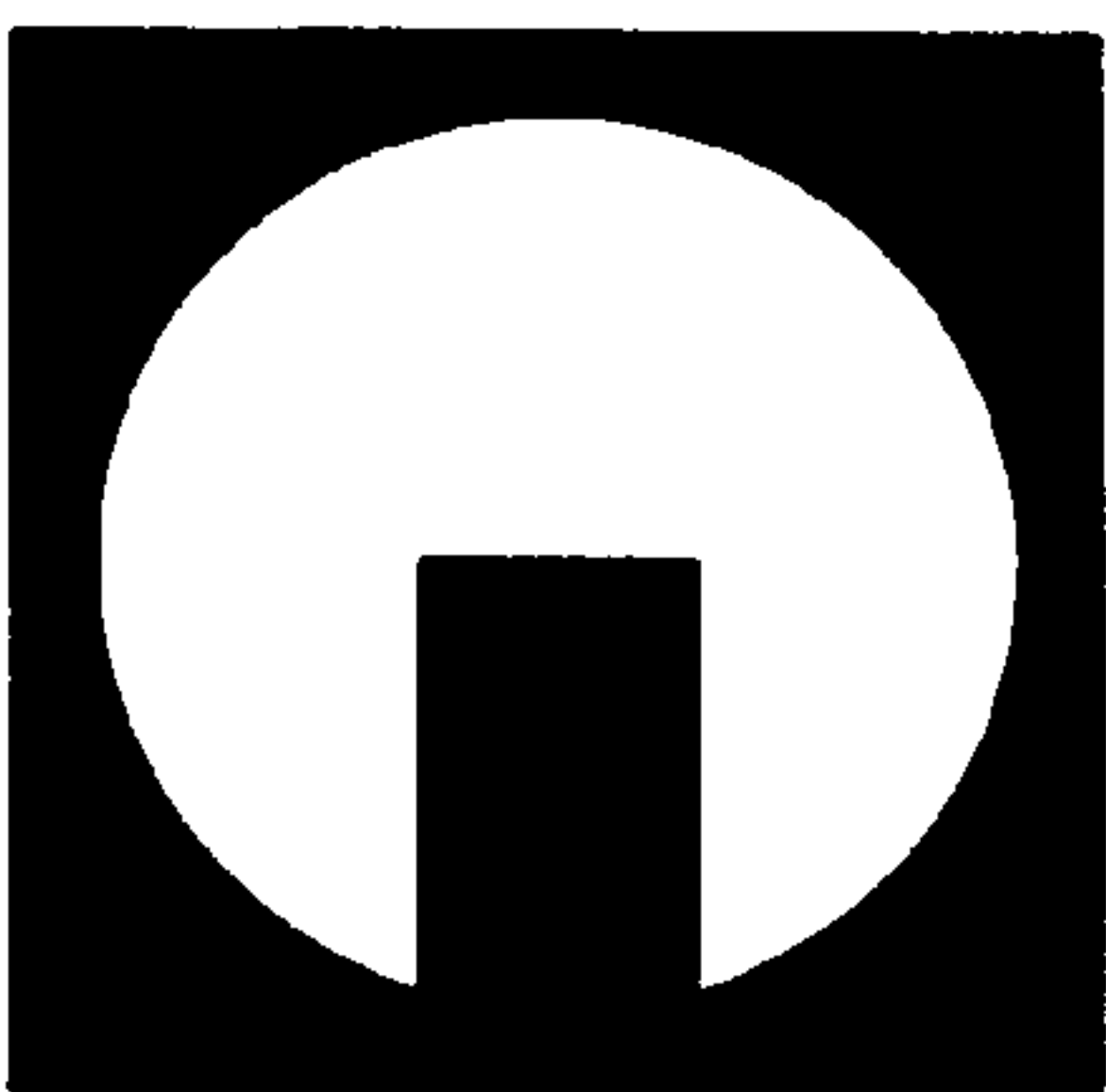

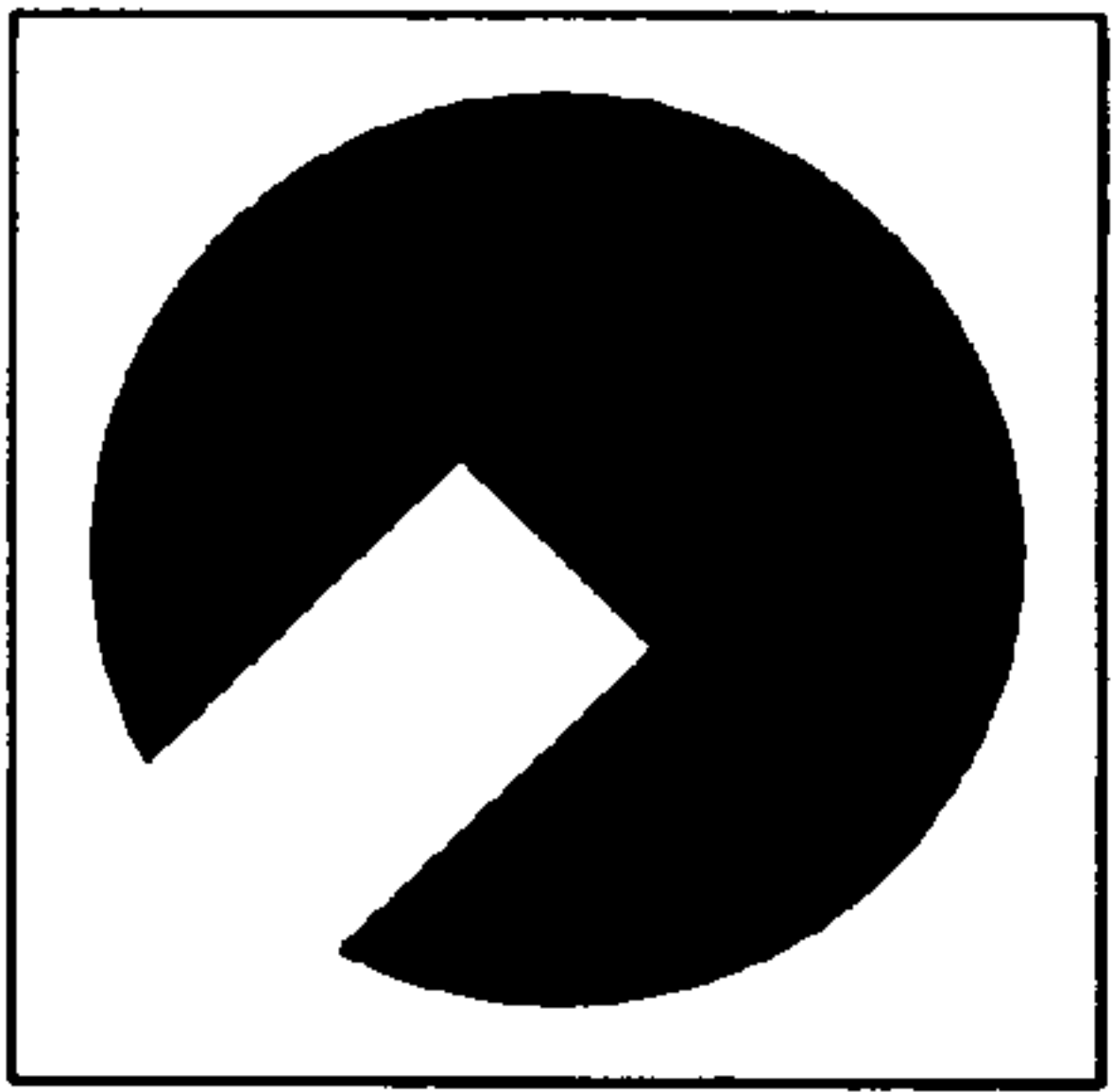

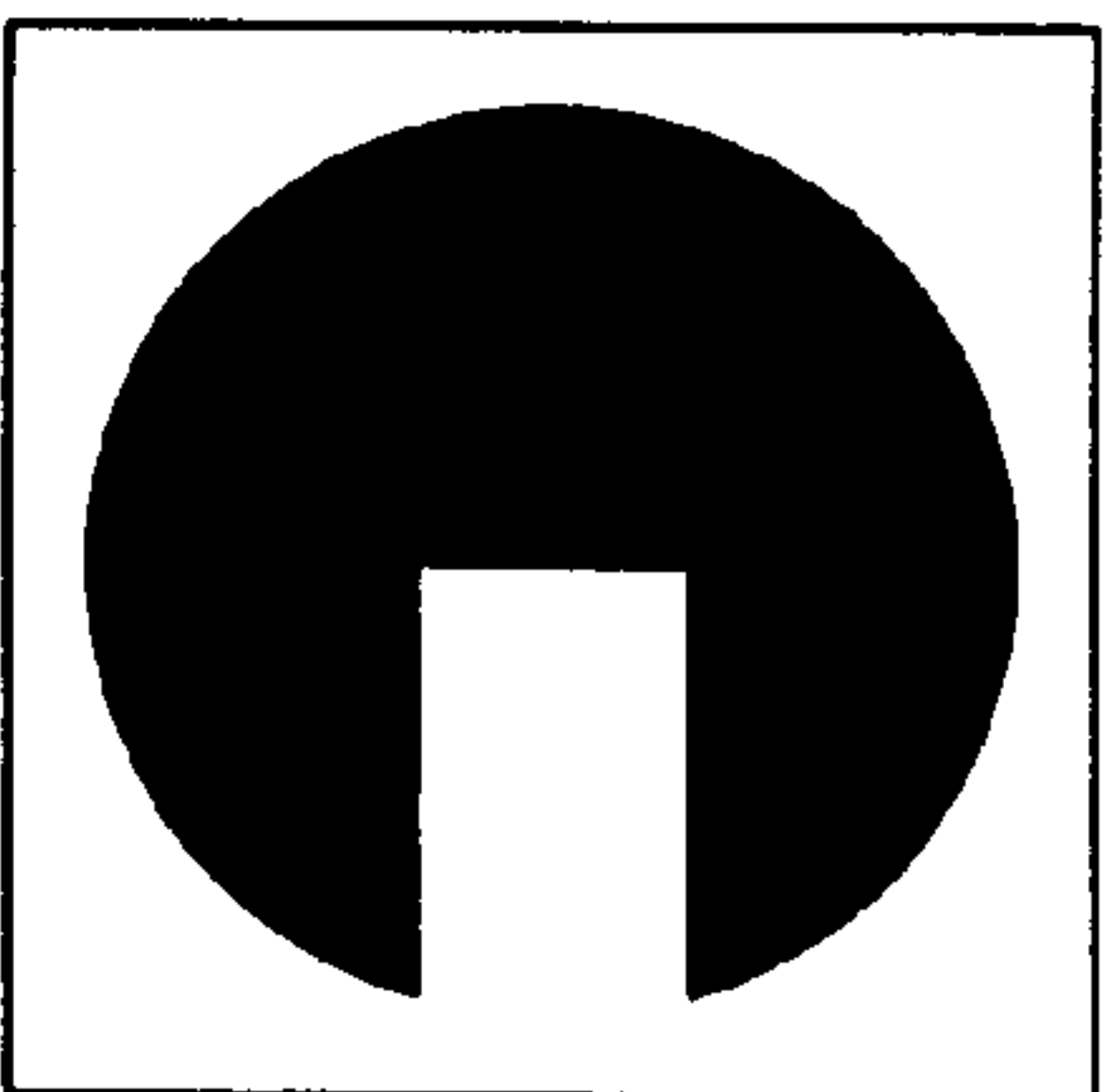

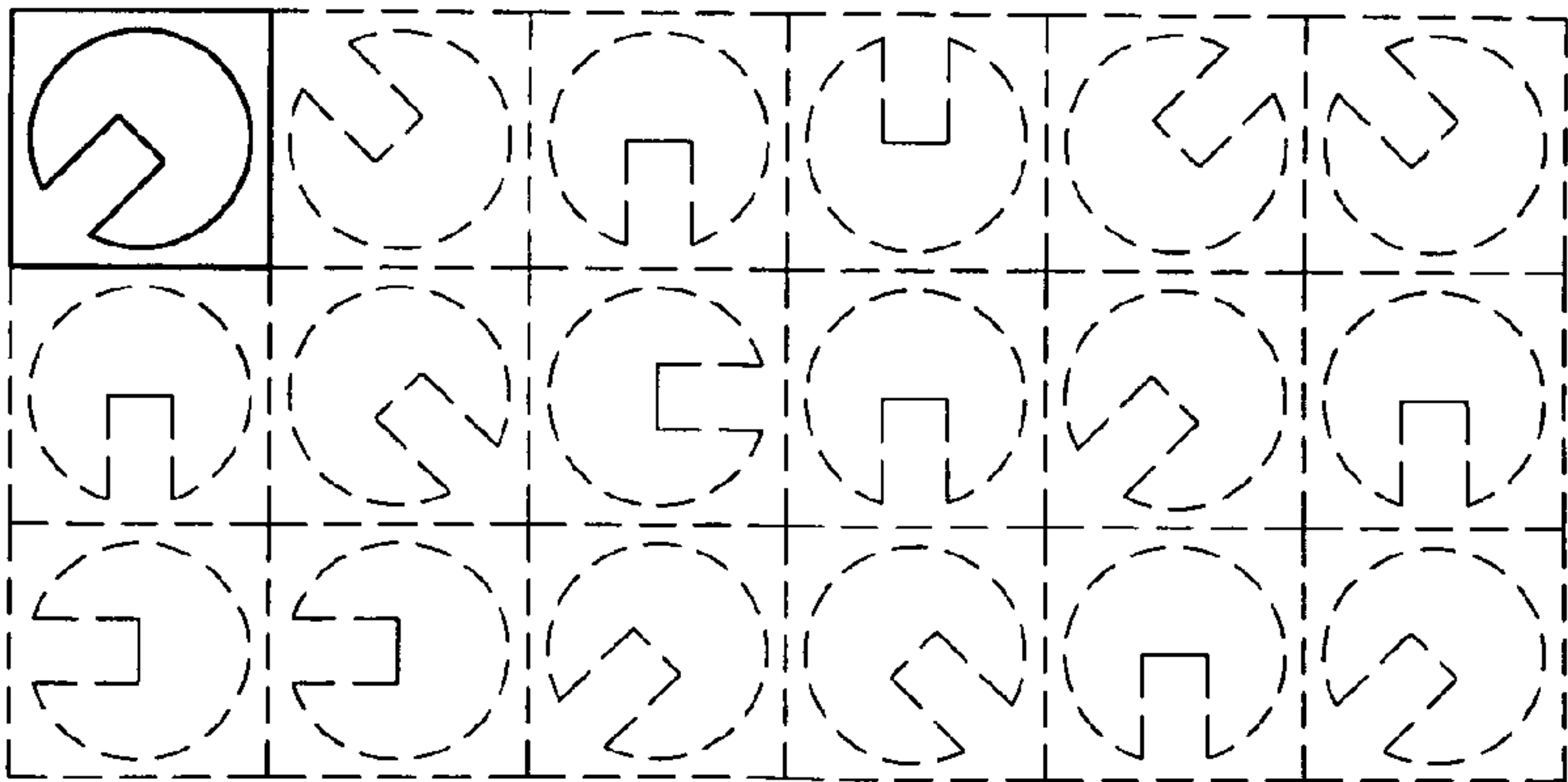

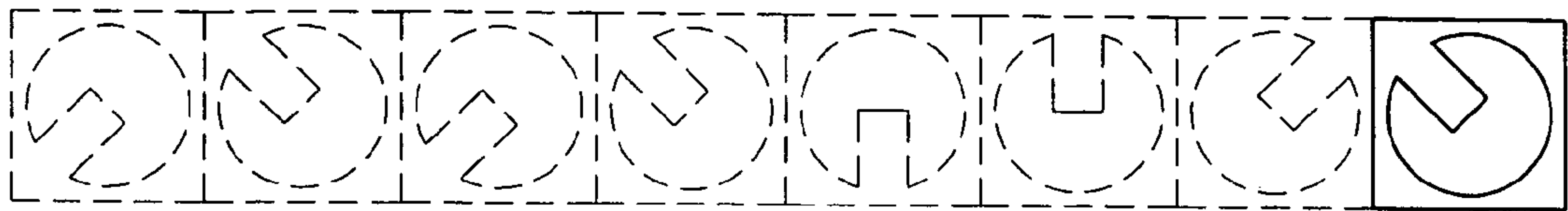

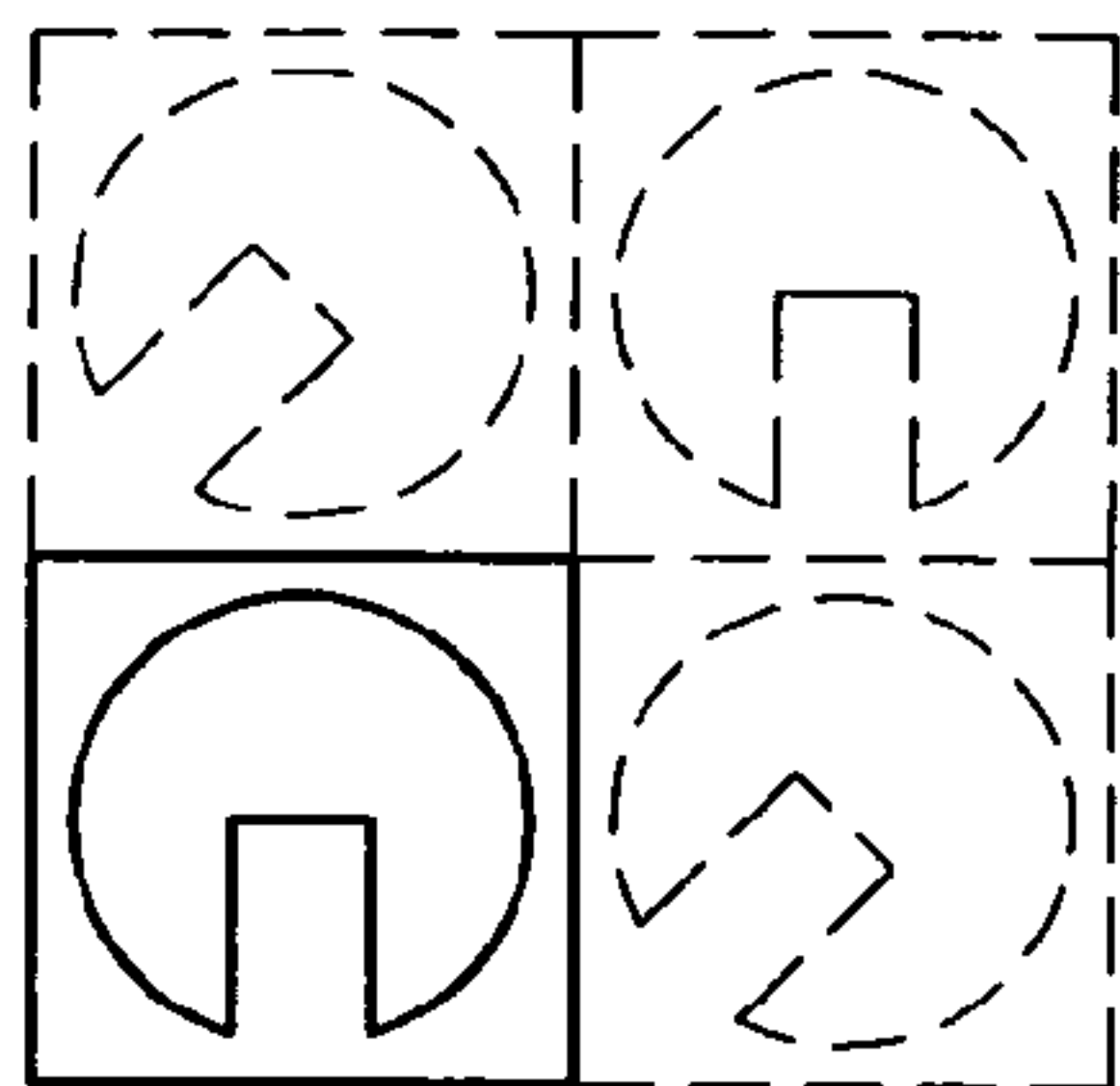

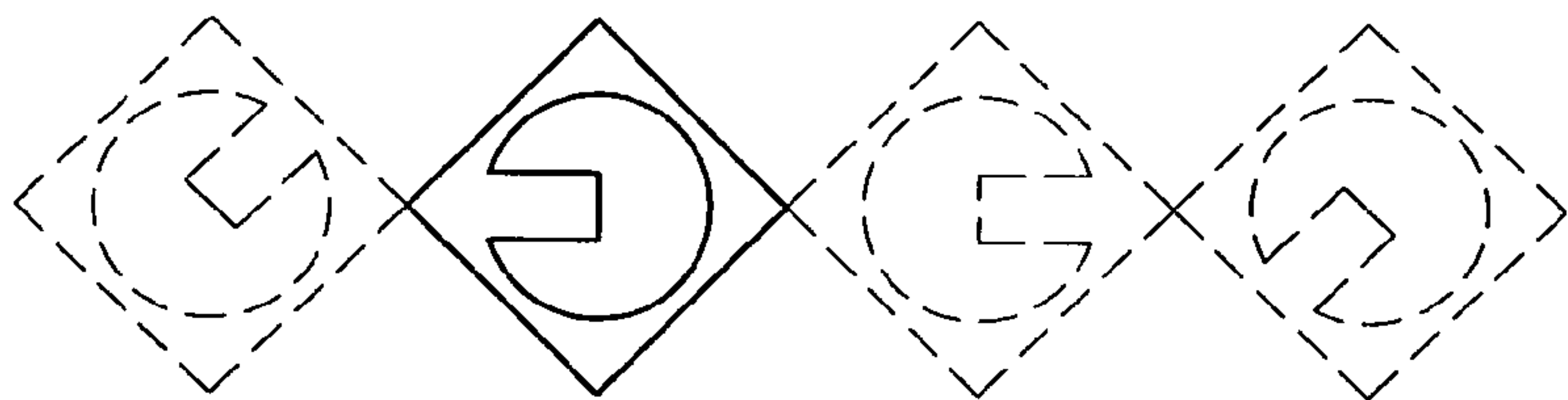

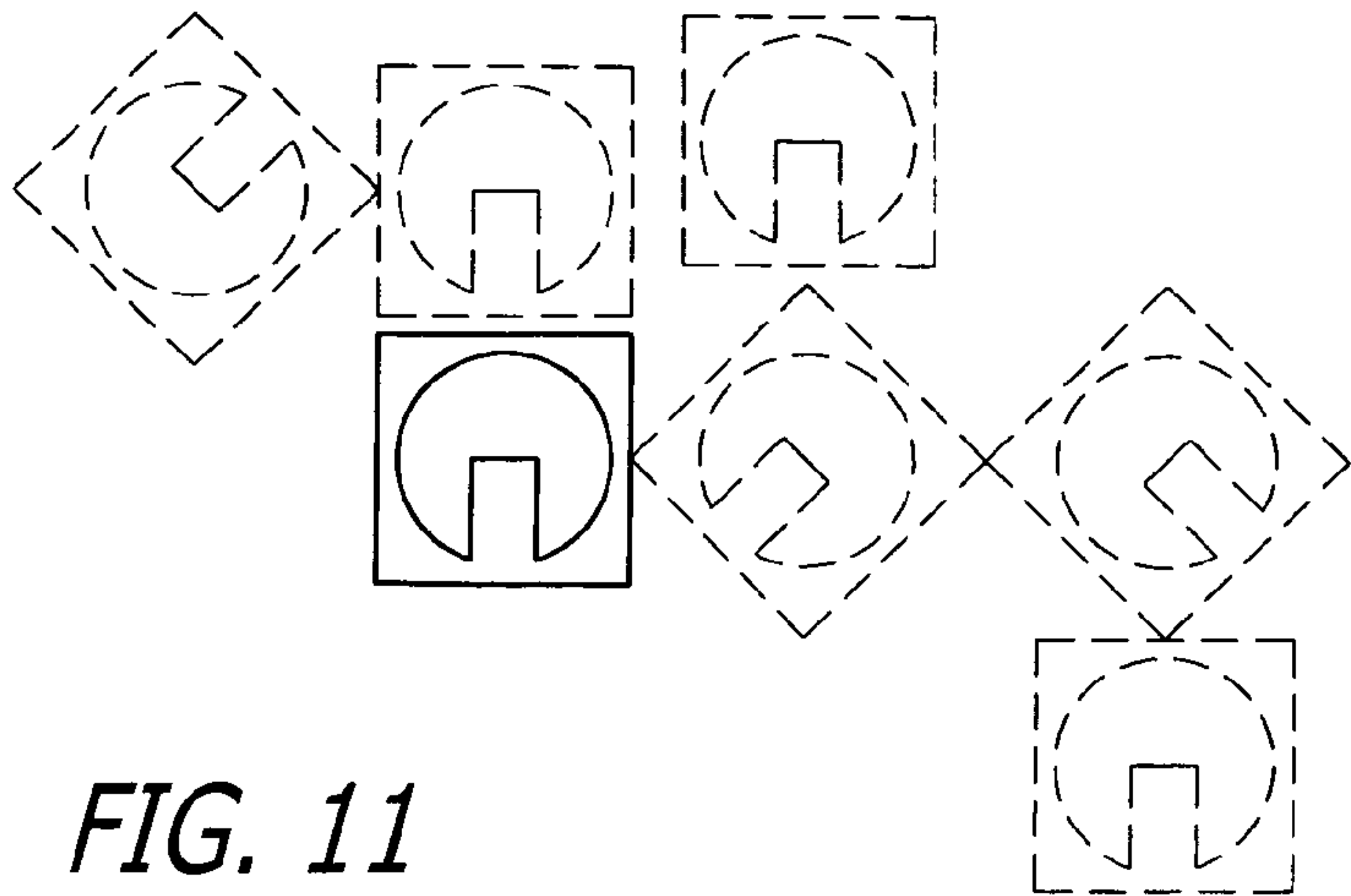
