FIG. 2 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;

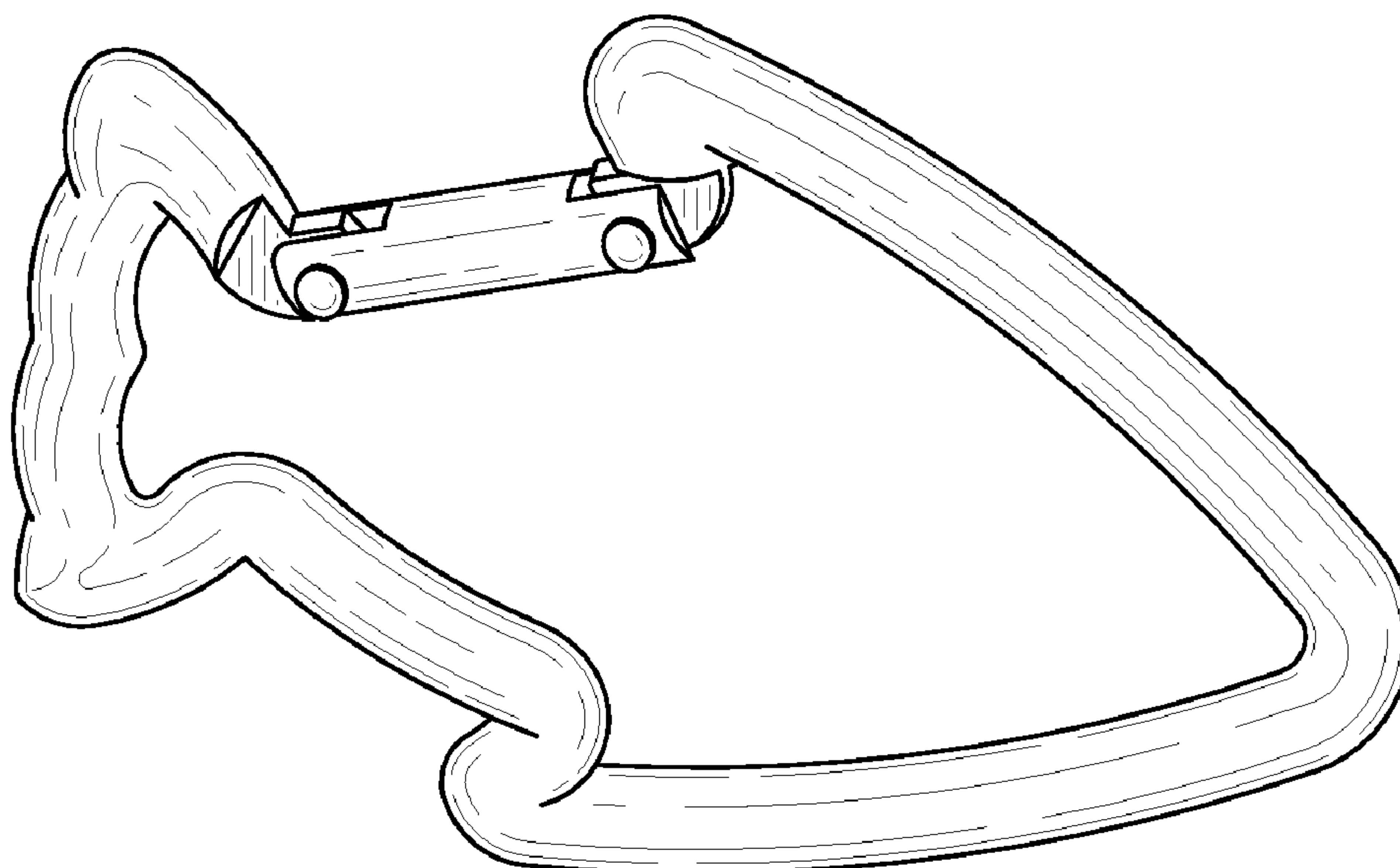
FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view of FIG. 1;

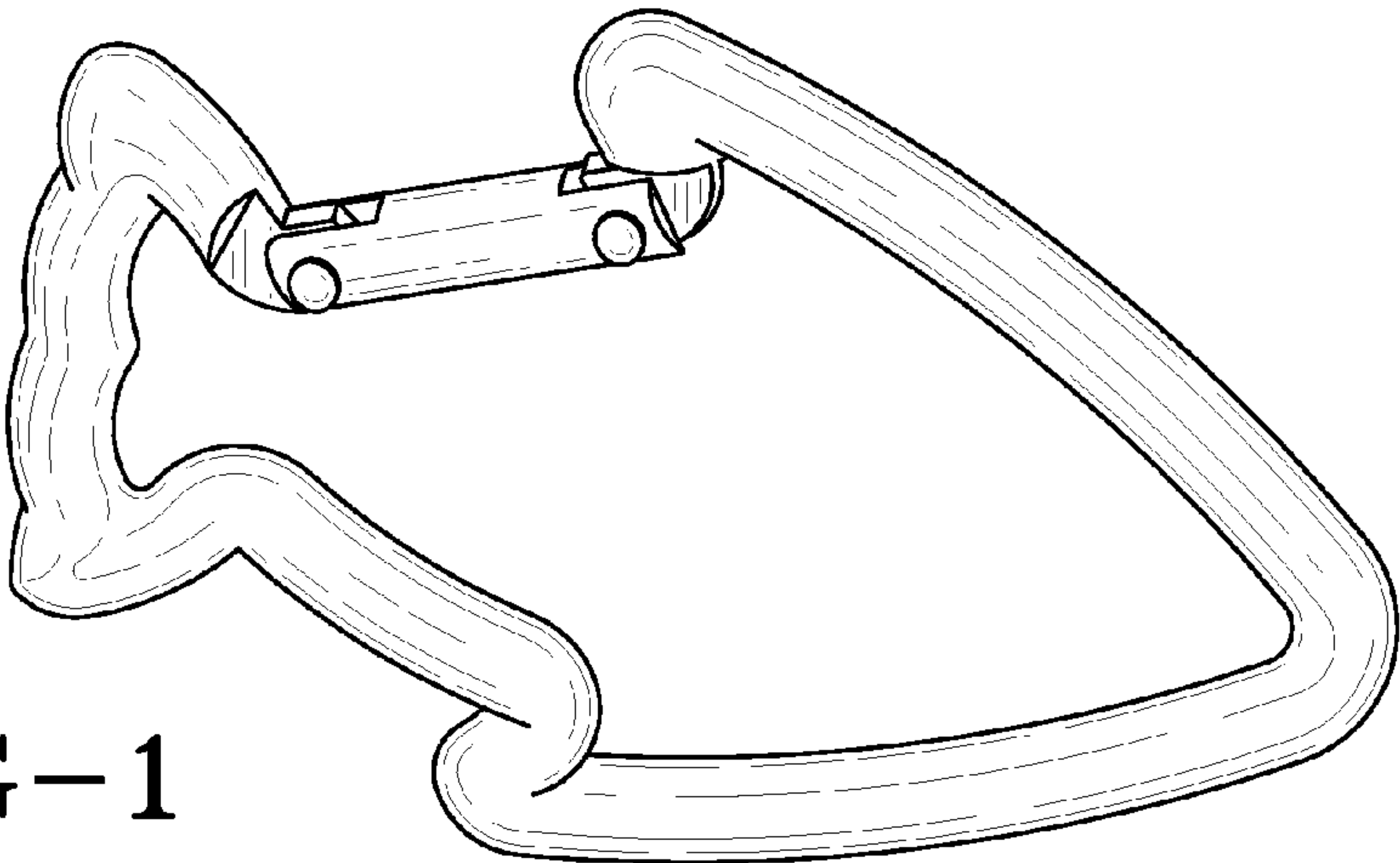

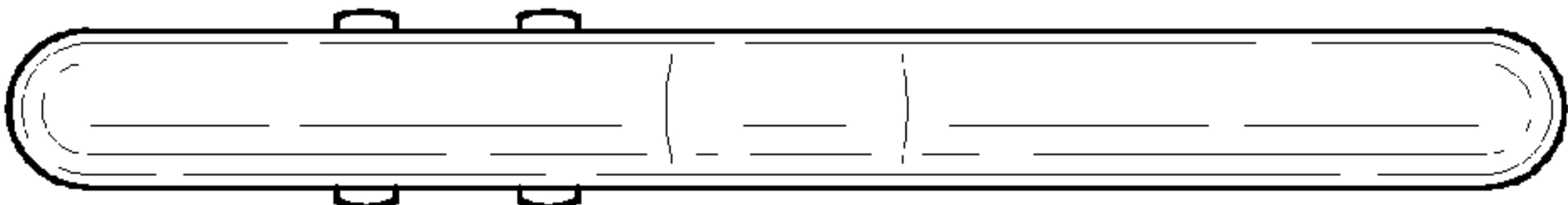

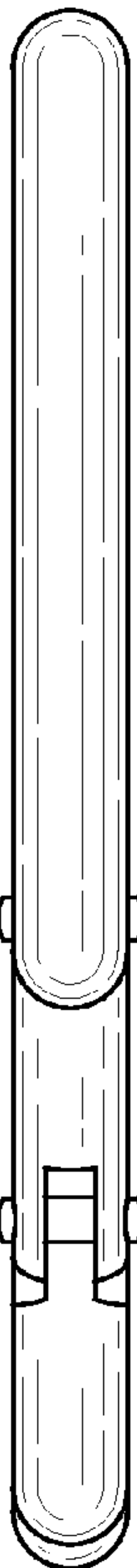

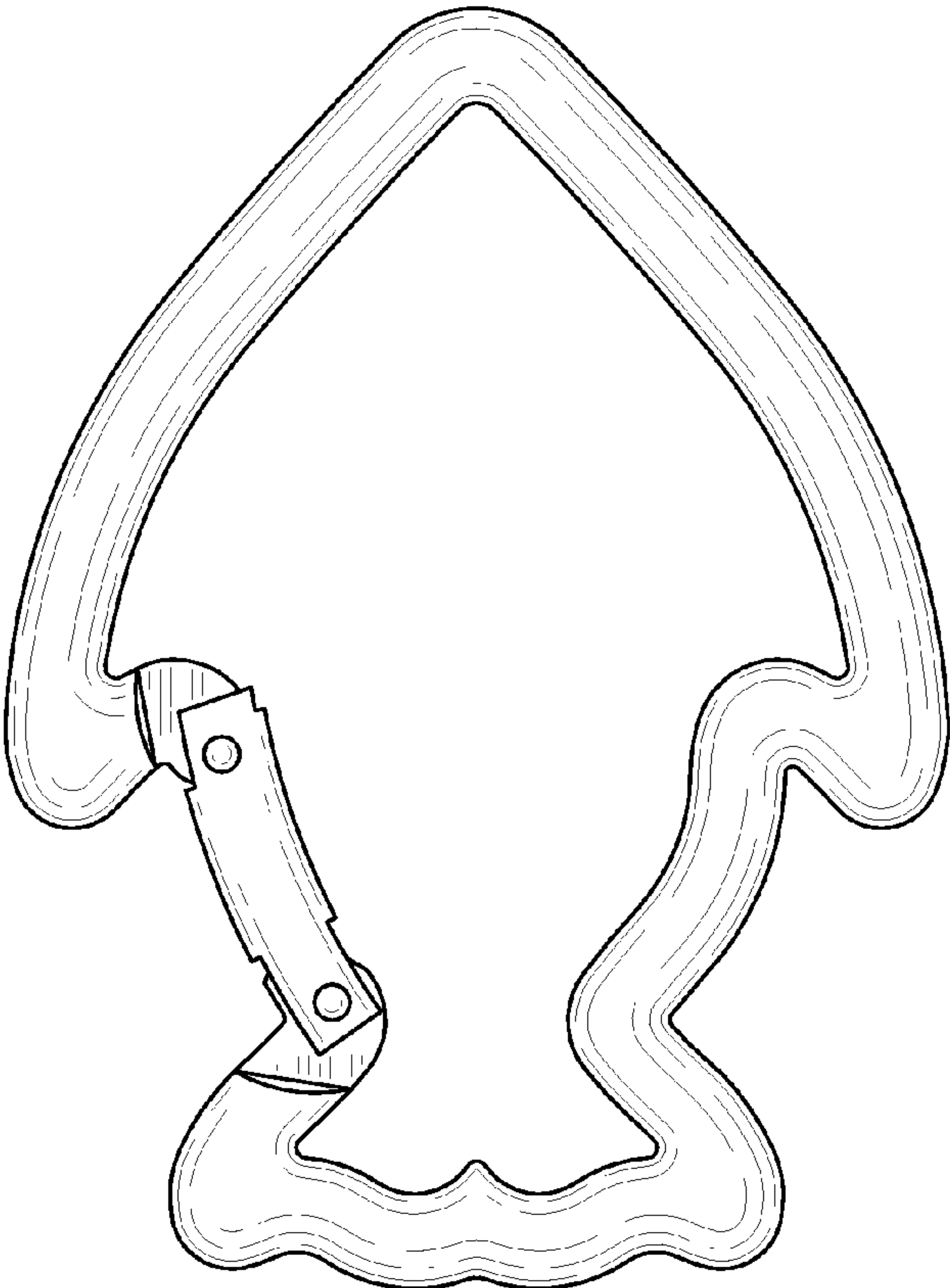

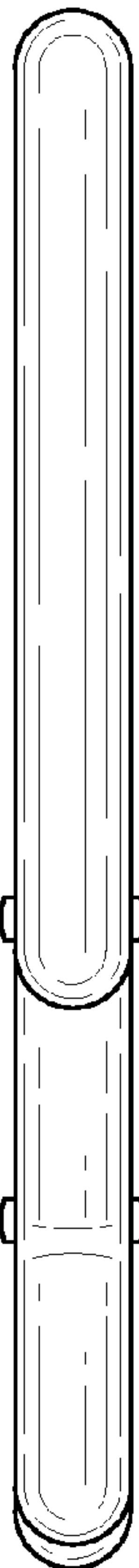

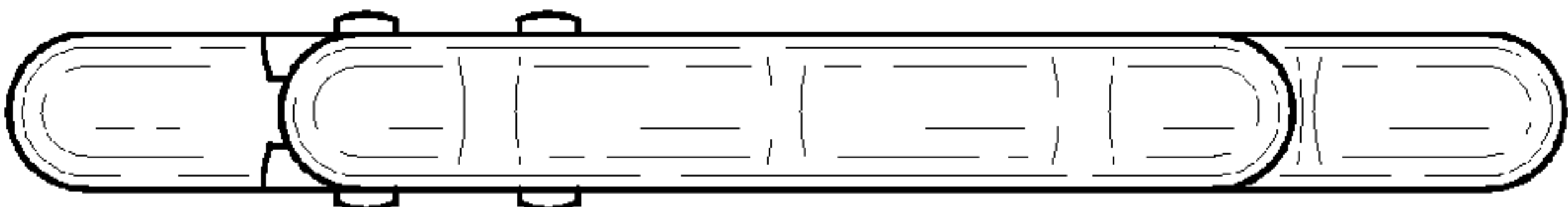
