FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the water craft with see-through bottom showing my new design;

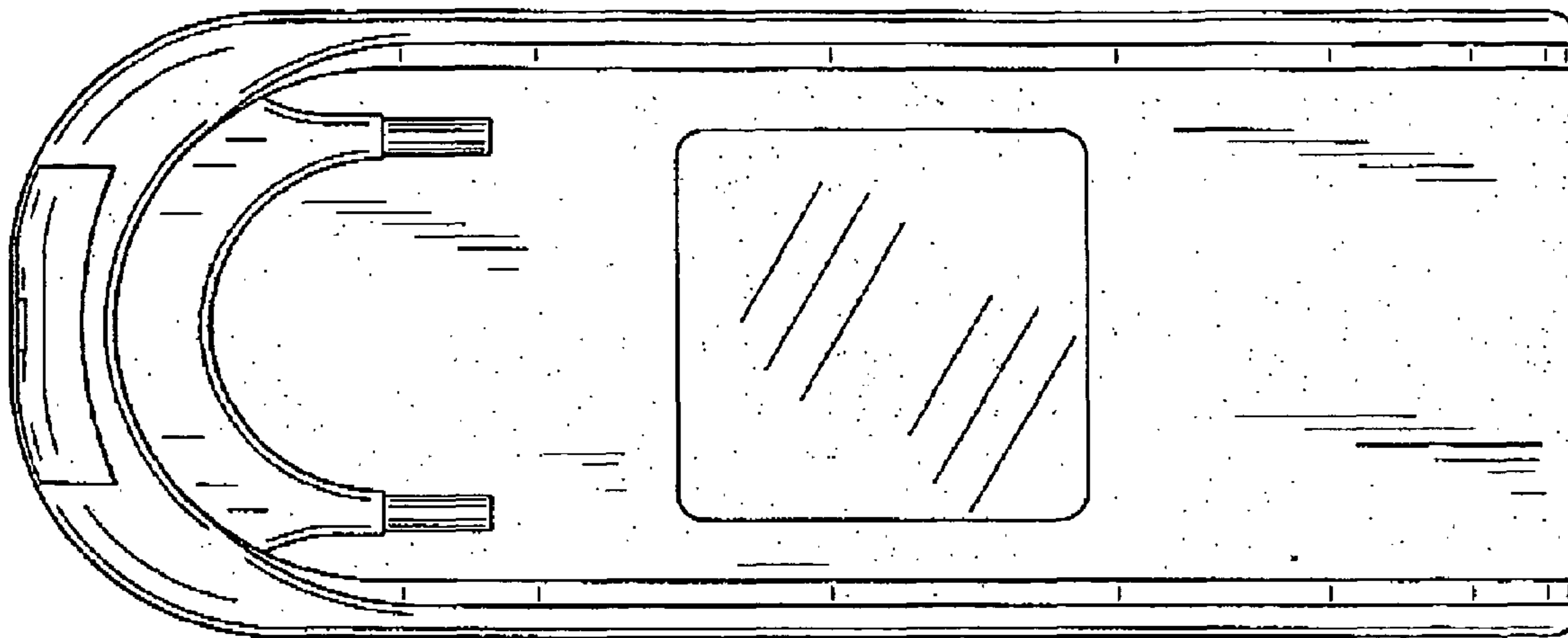
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

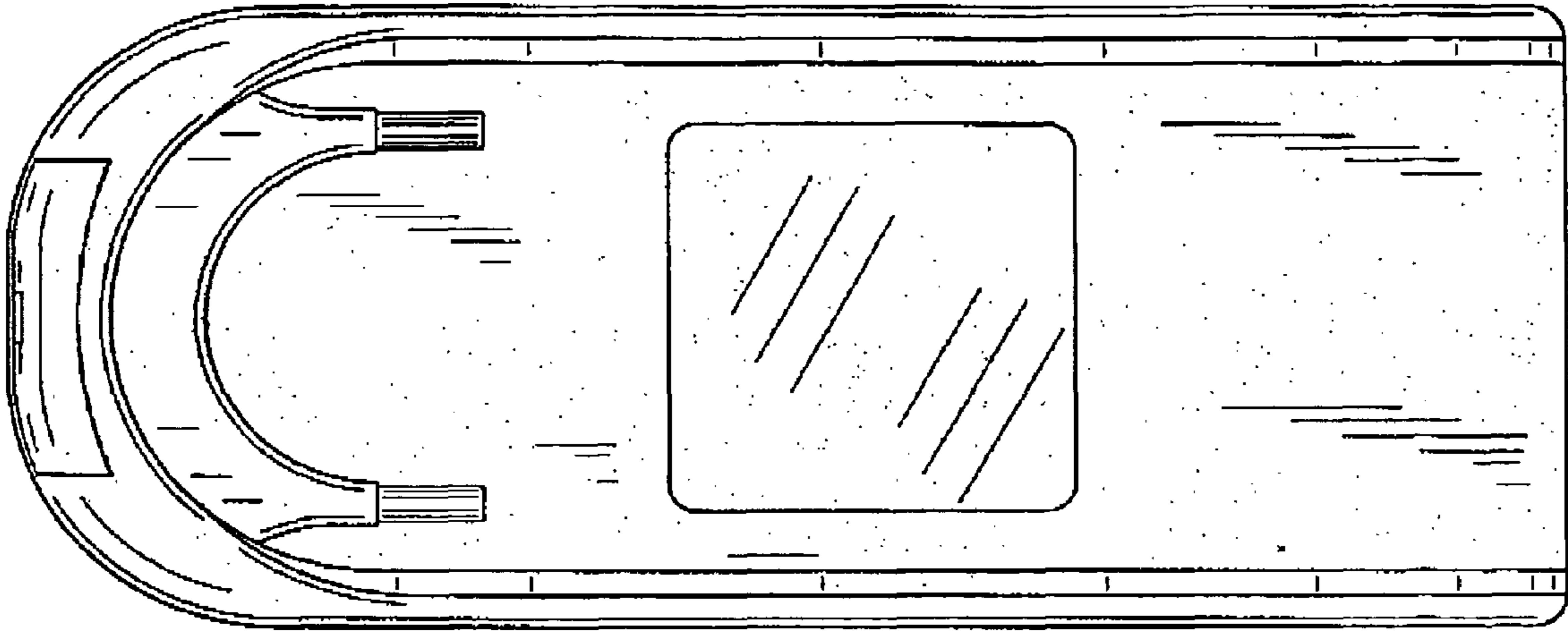

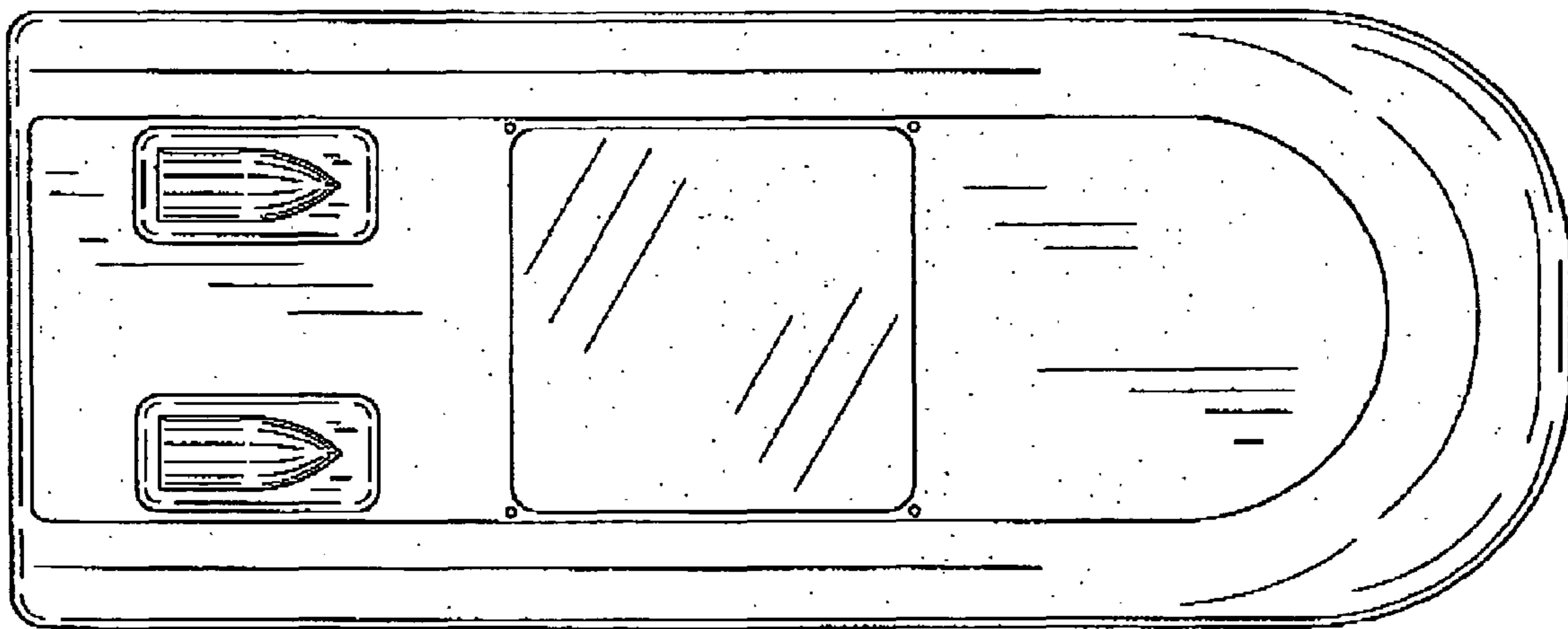

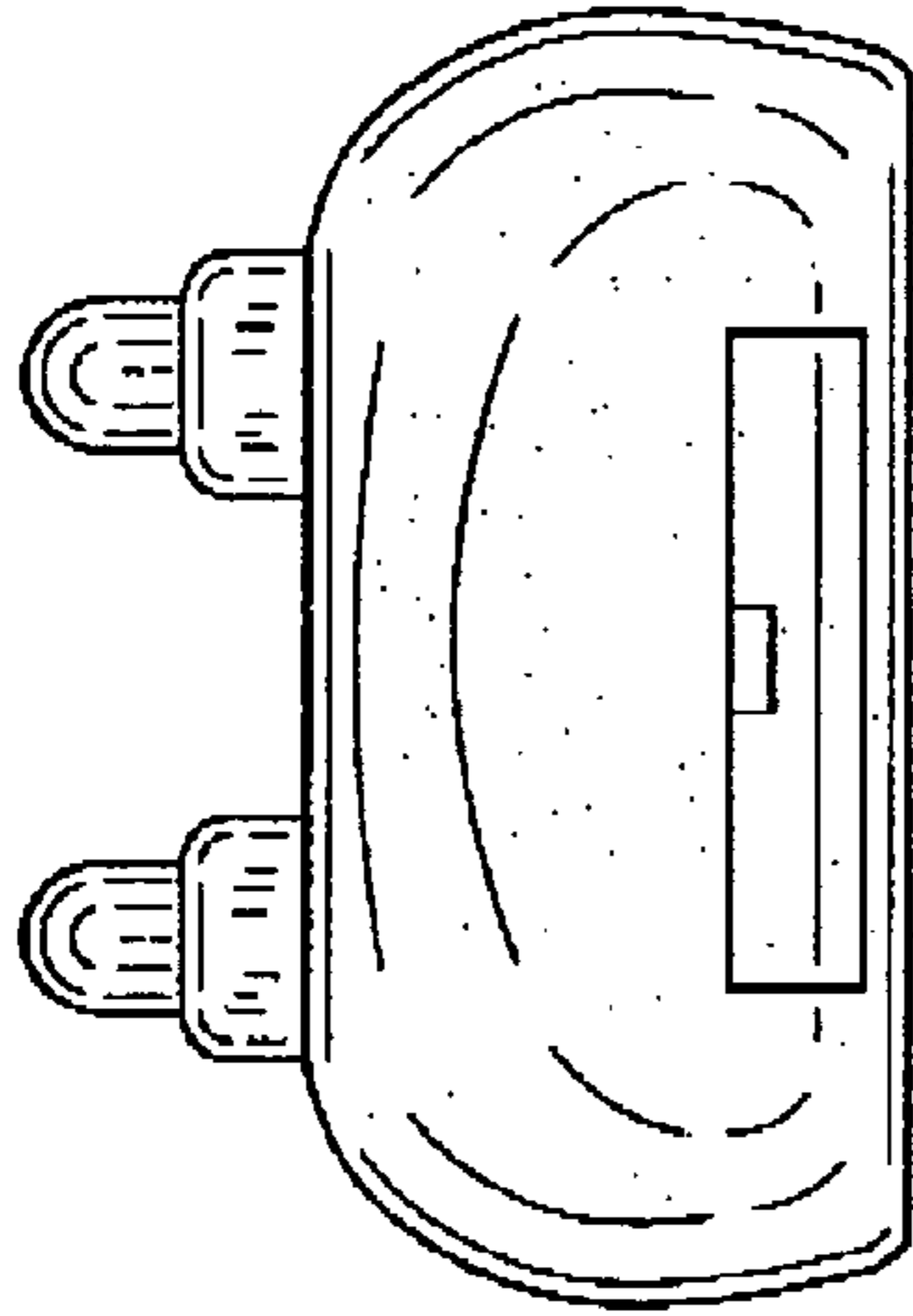

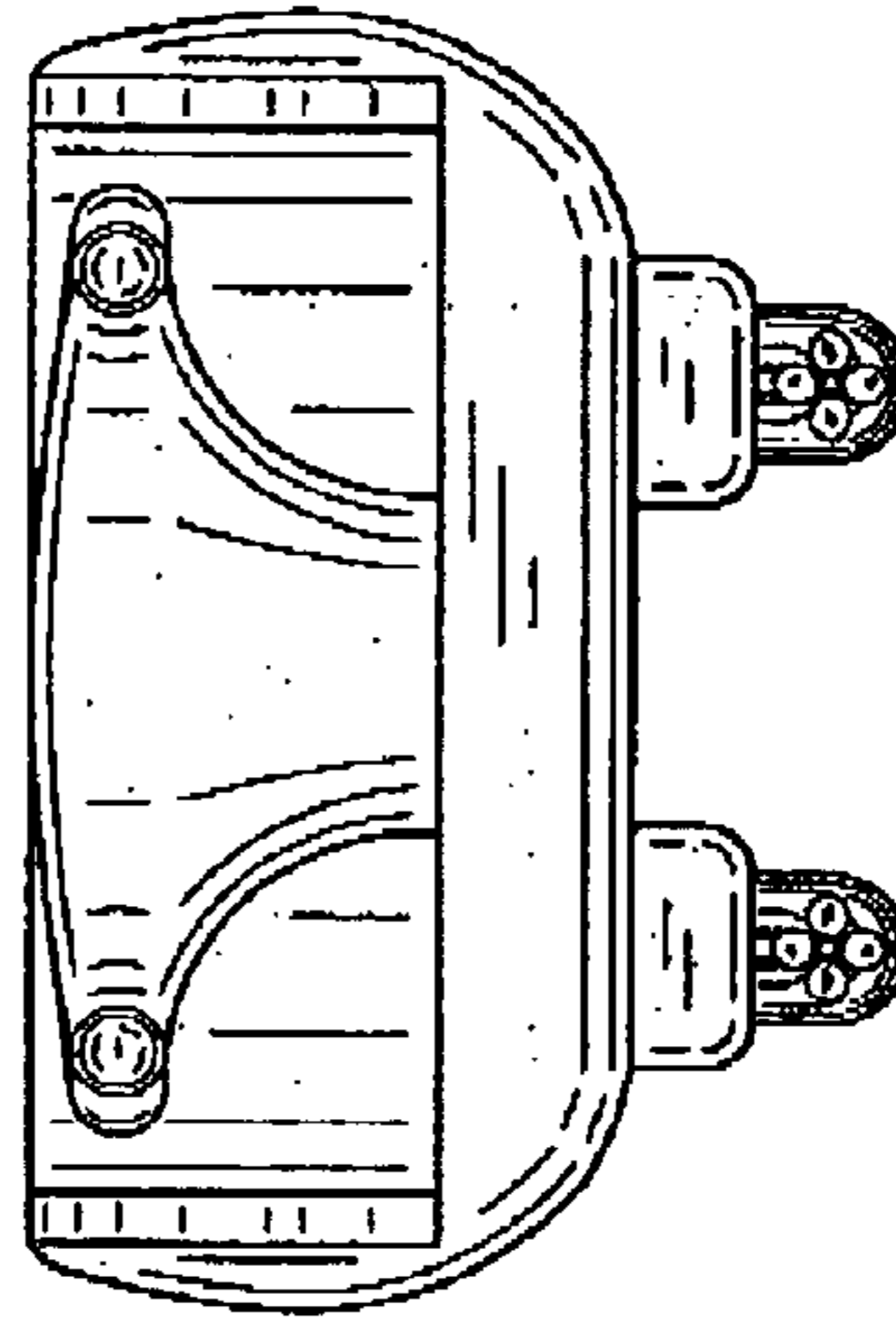

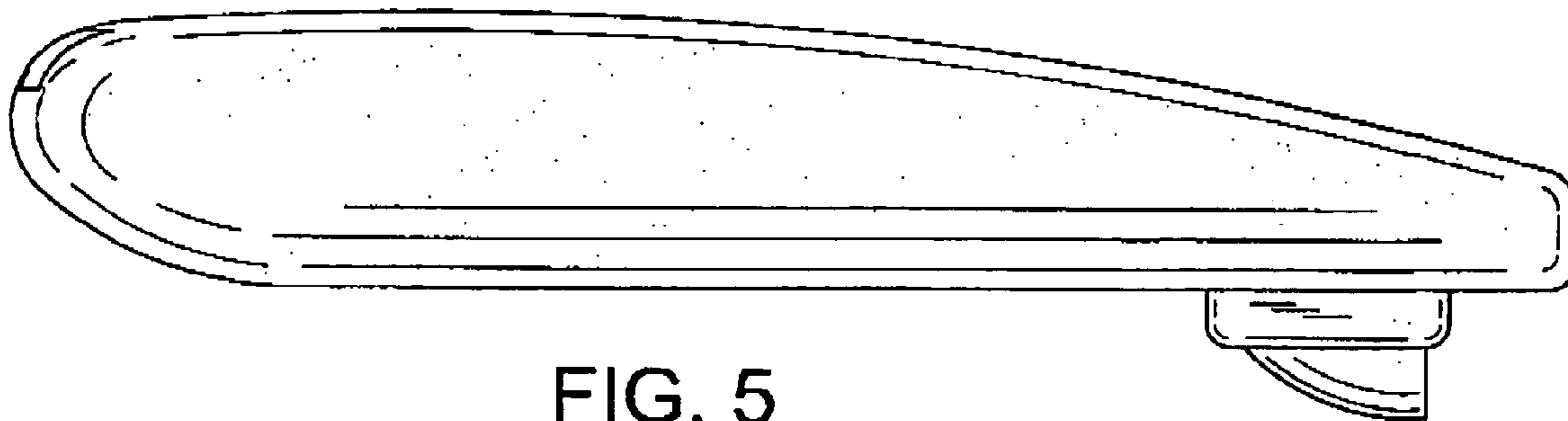
