**DESCRIPTION**


FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a deck chair showing my new design, the deck chair having the back portion in a folded position;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,


FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the deck chair of FIG. 1  
having the back chair in a reclined position.**1 Claim, 6 Drawing Sheets**




