FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; and,

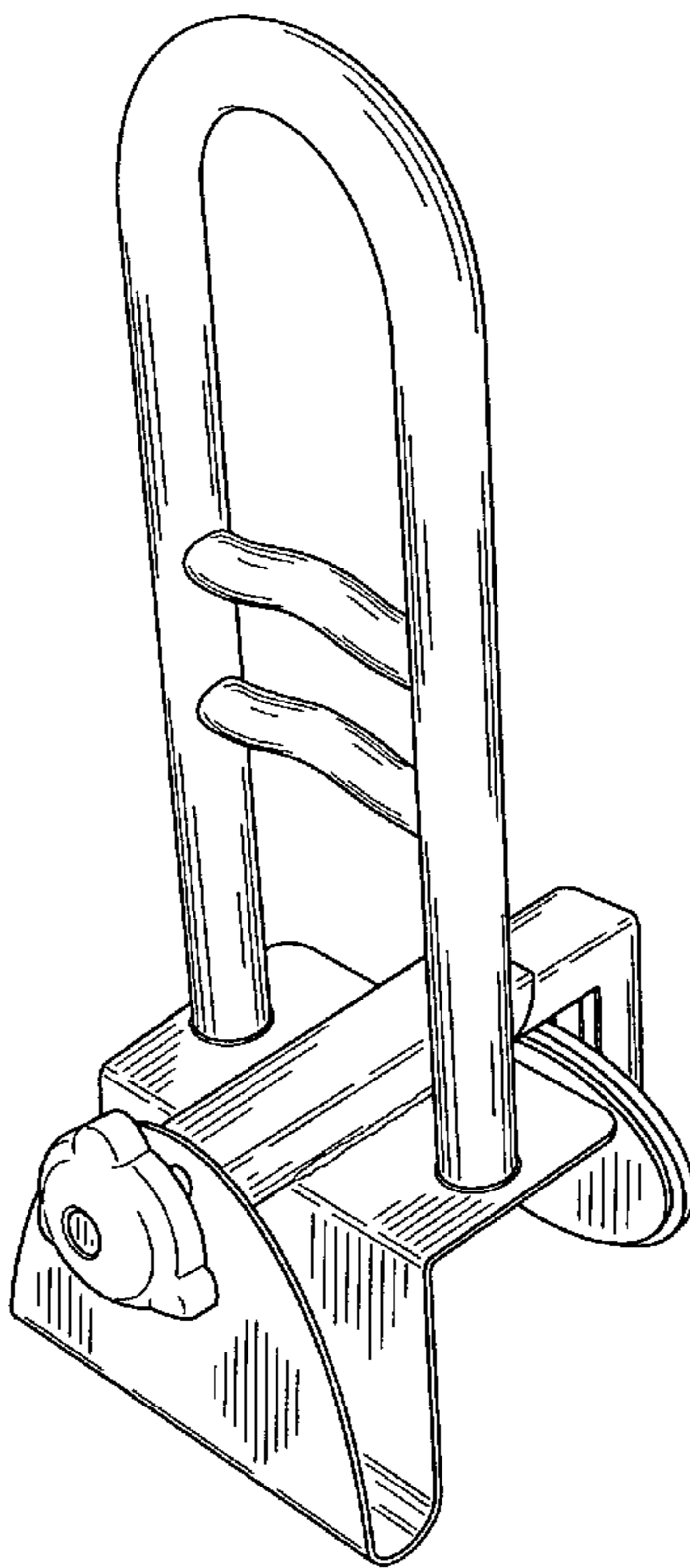
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof.

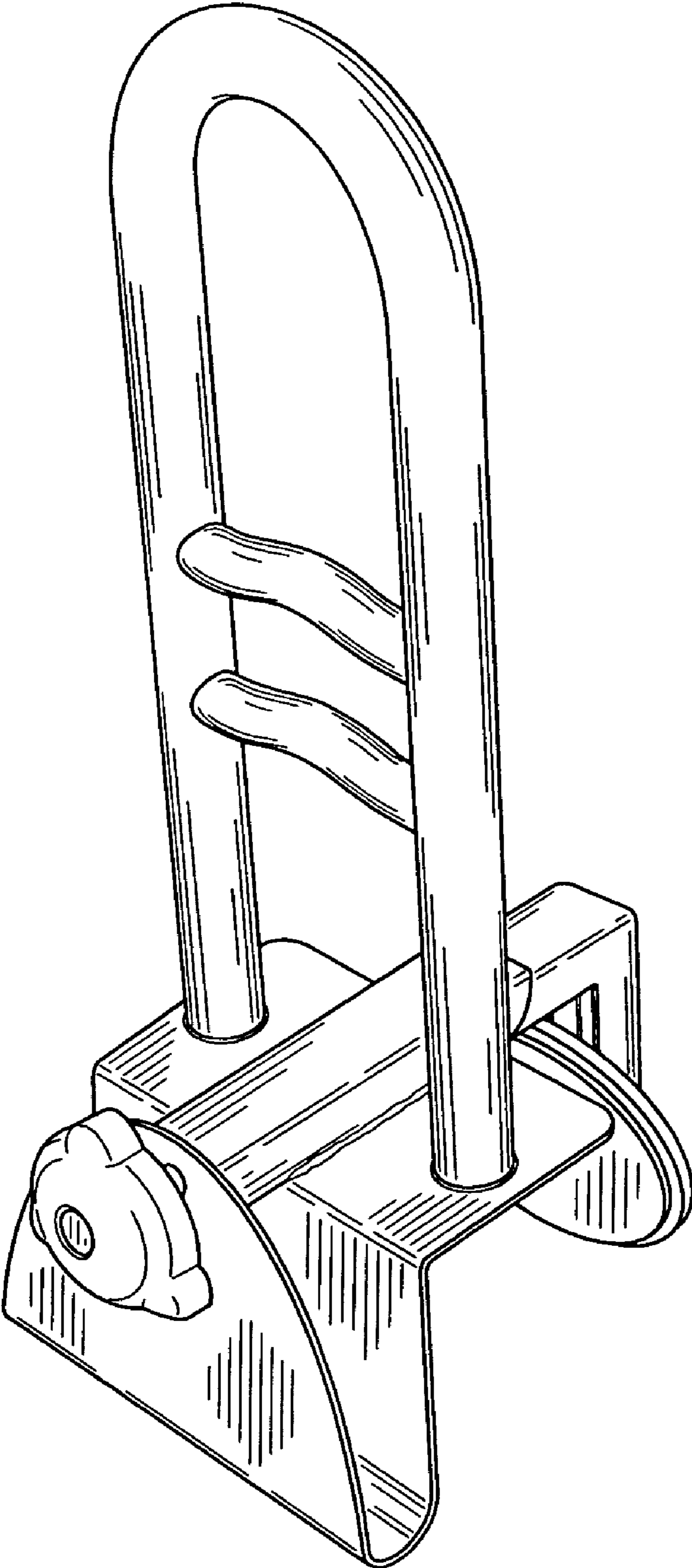

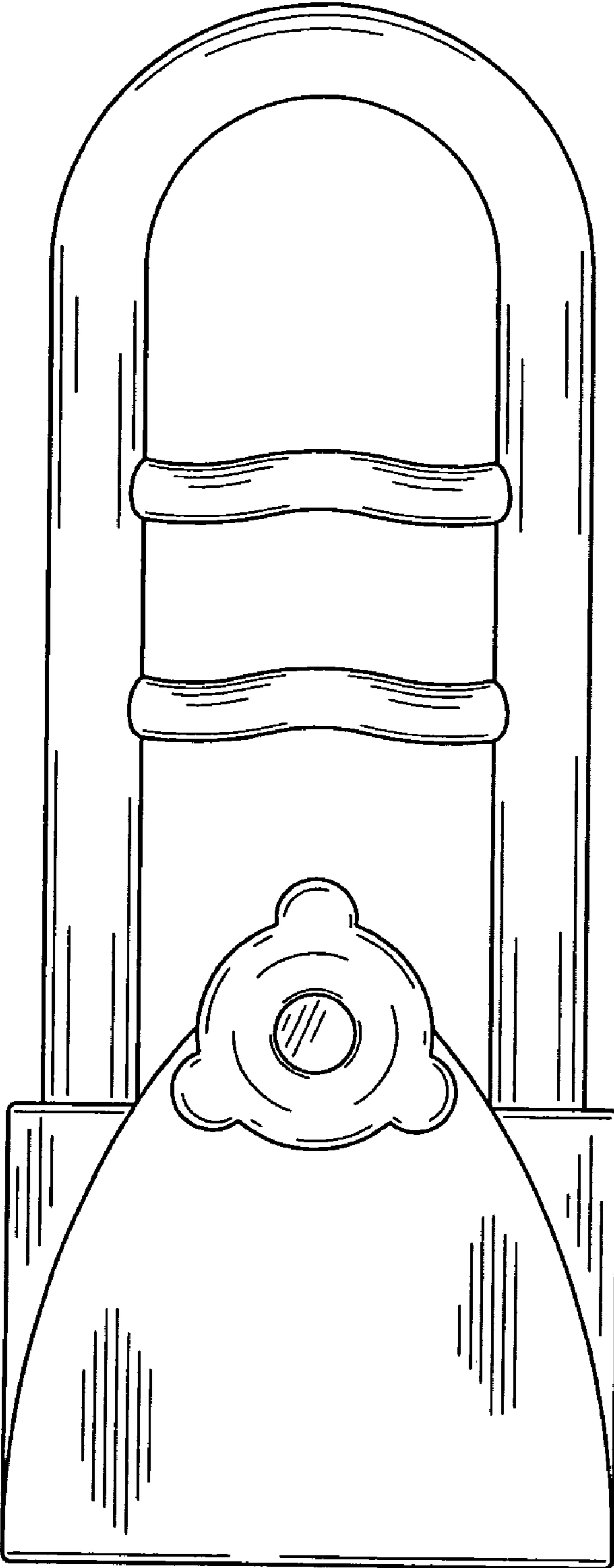

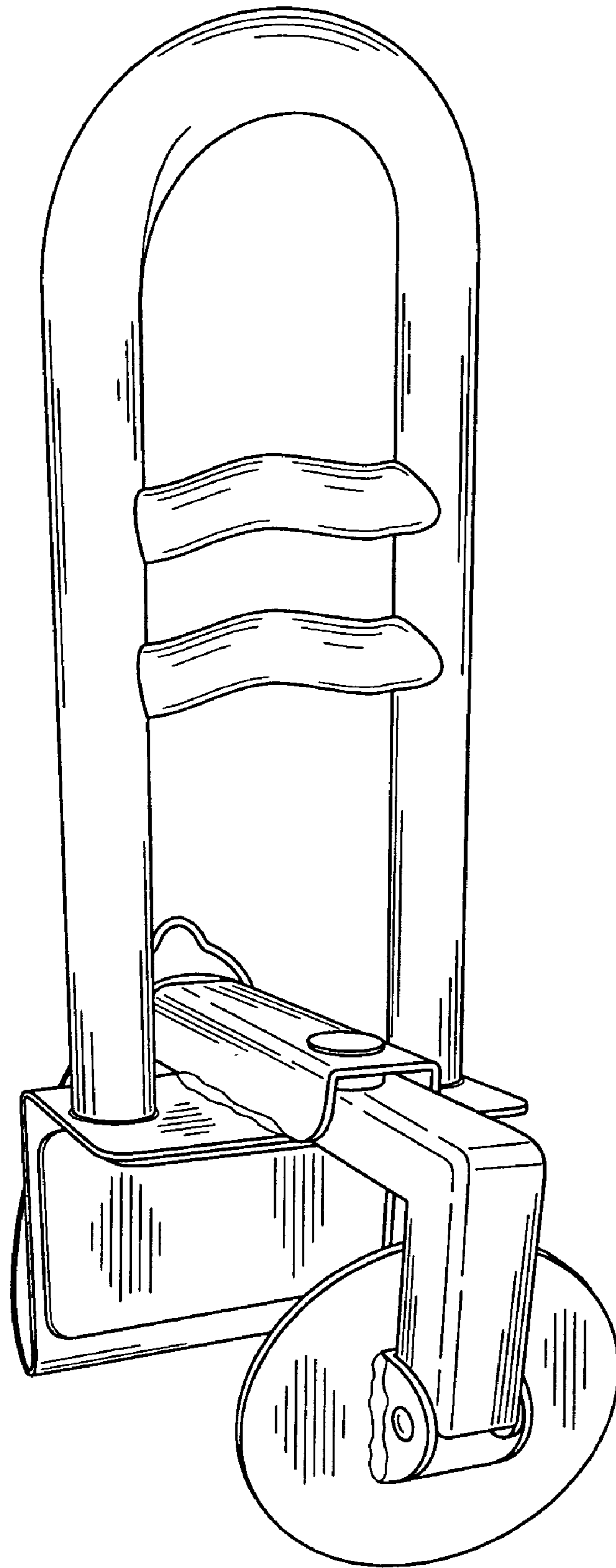
