FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.

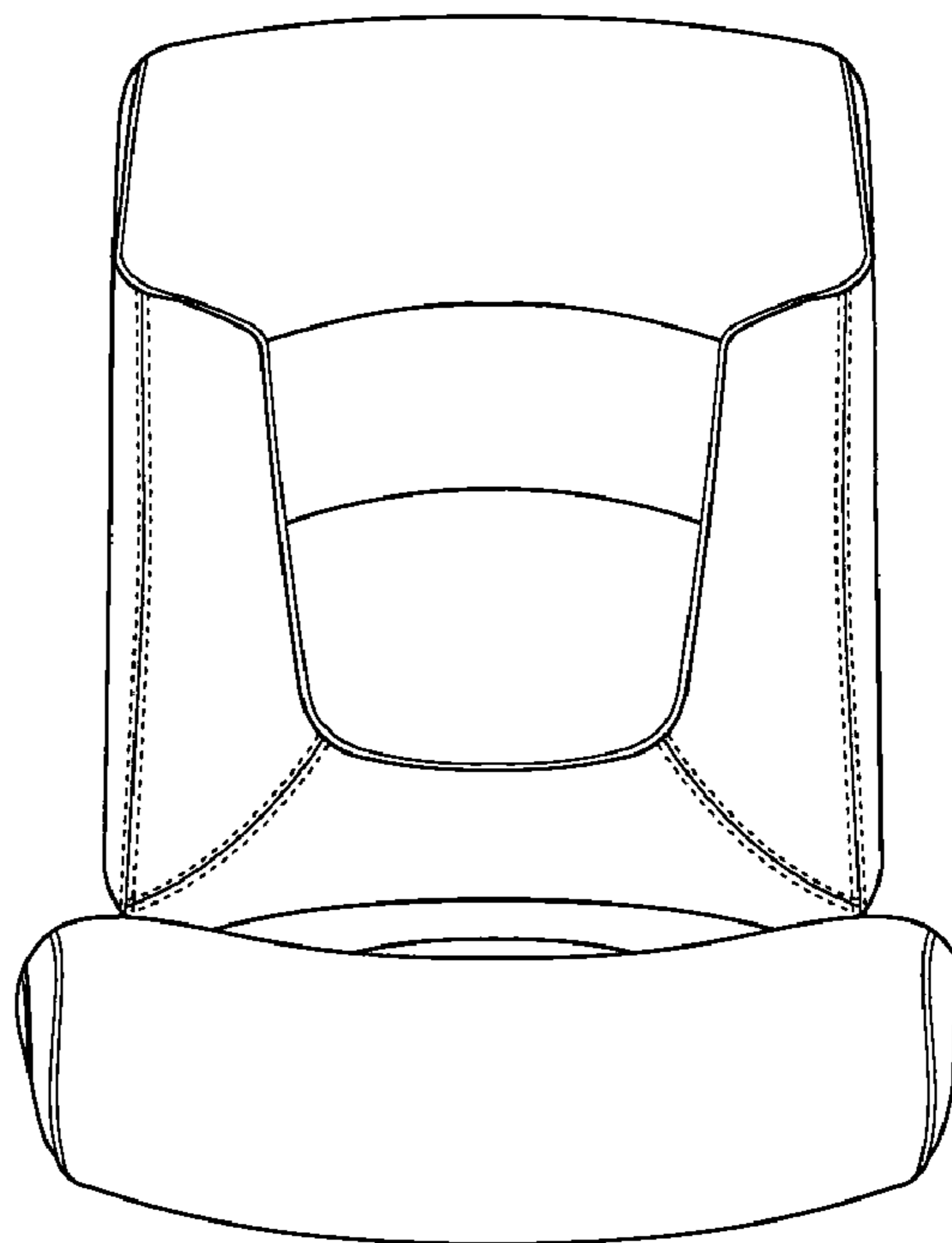
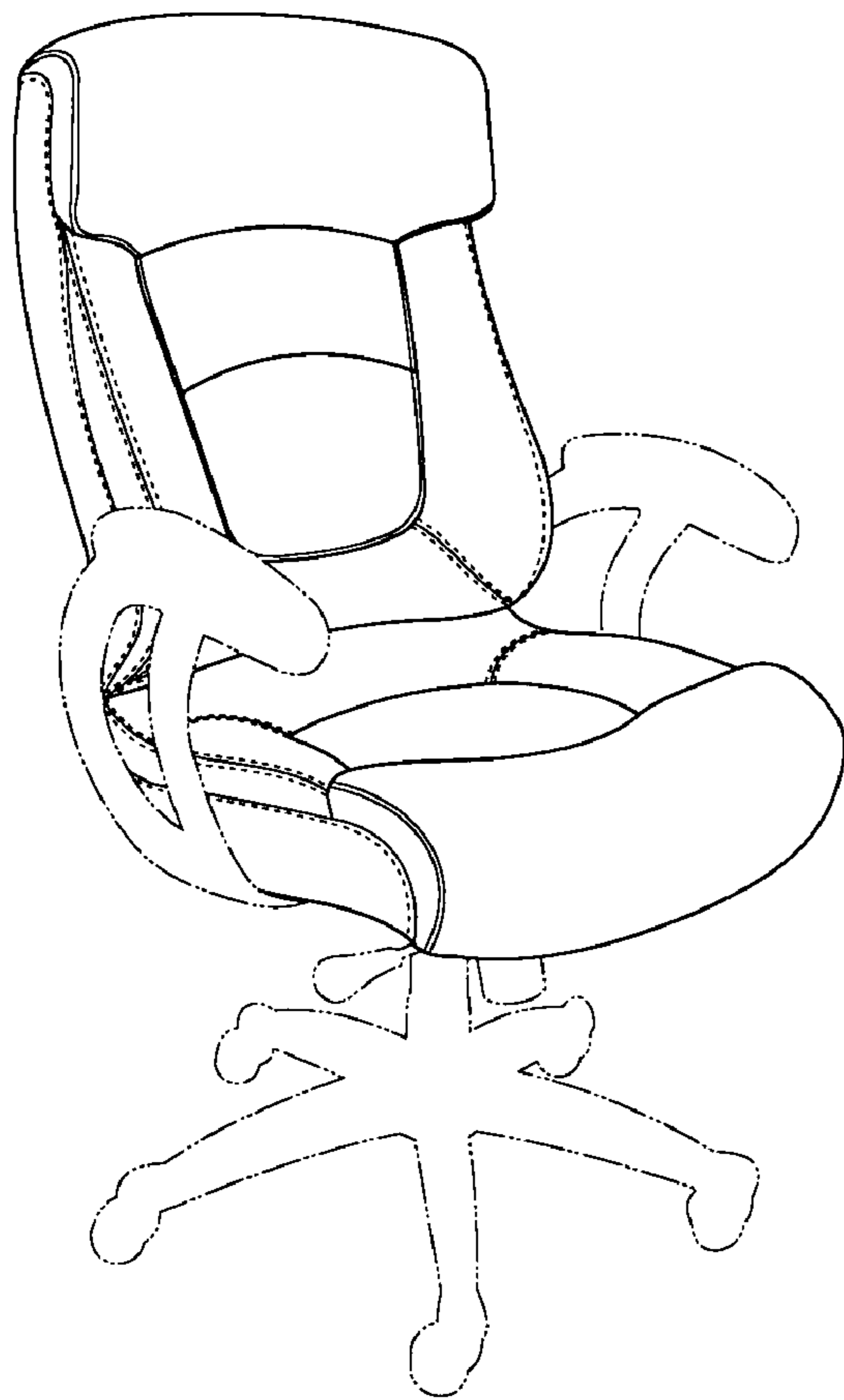
The short, broken lines on the chair in FIGS. 1-5 are

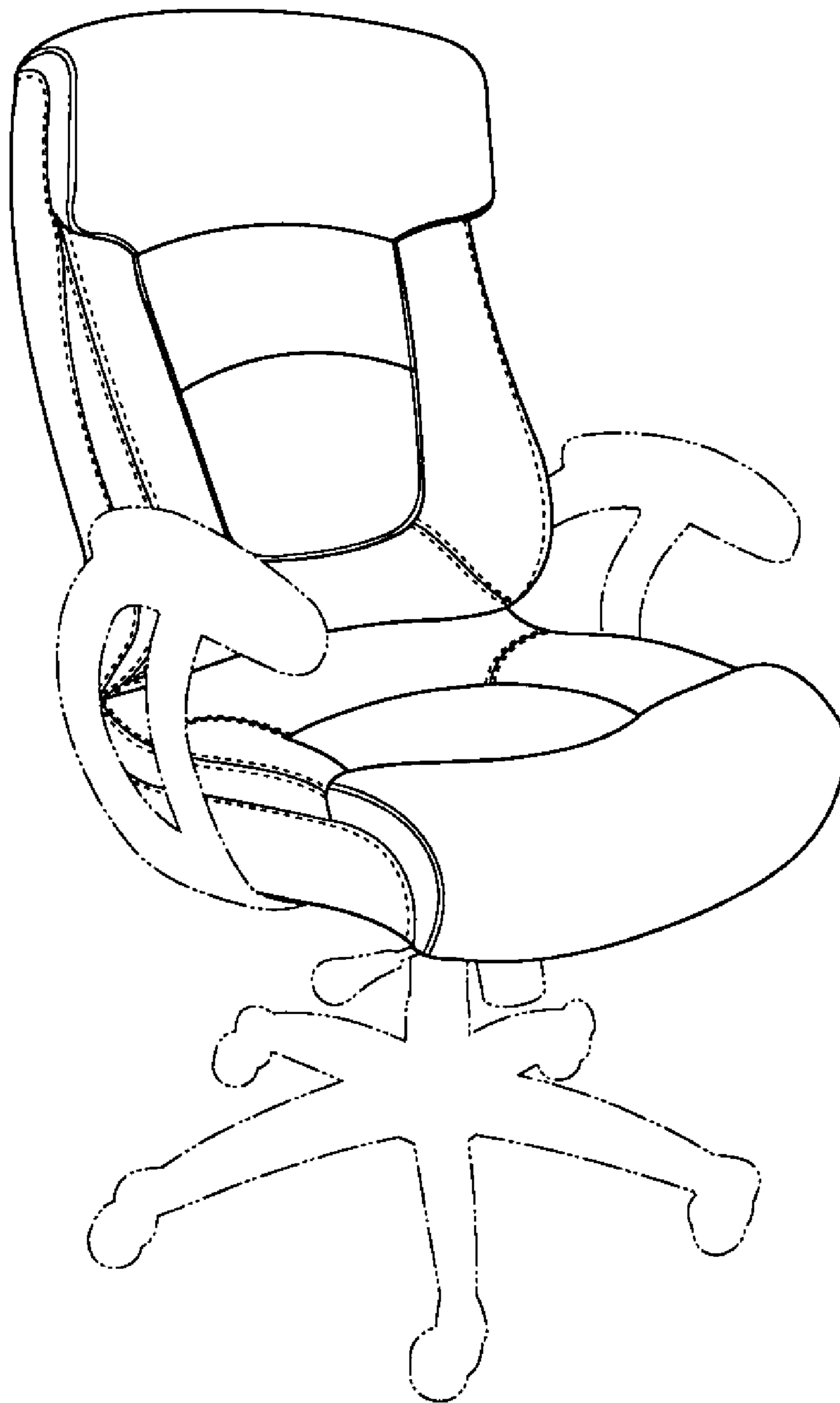

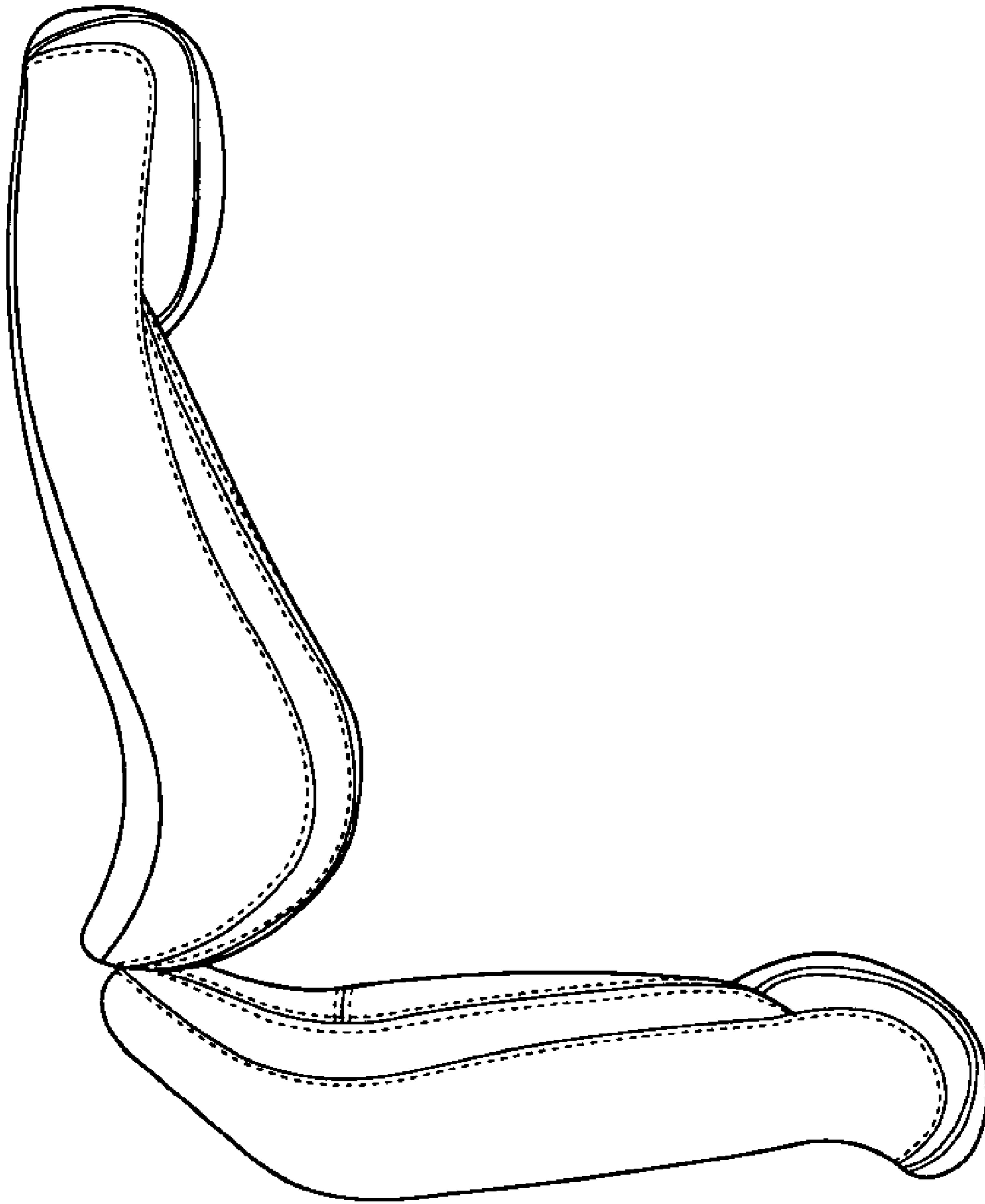

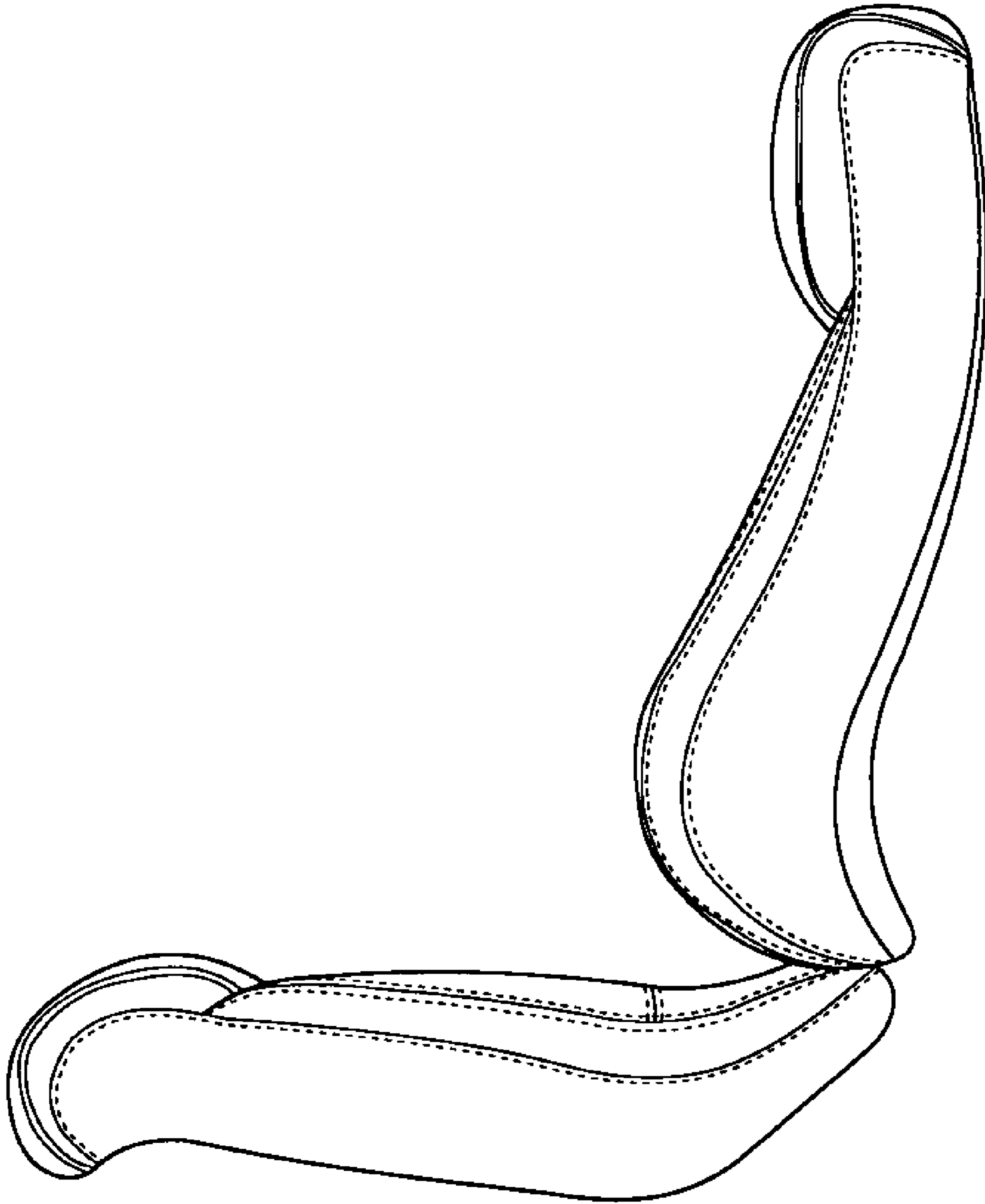

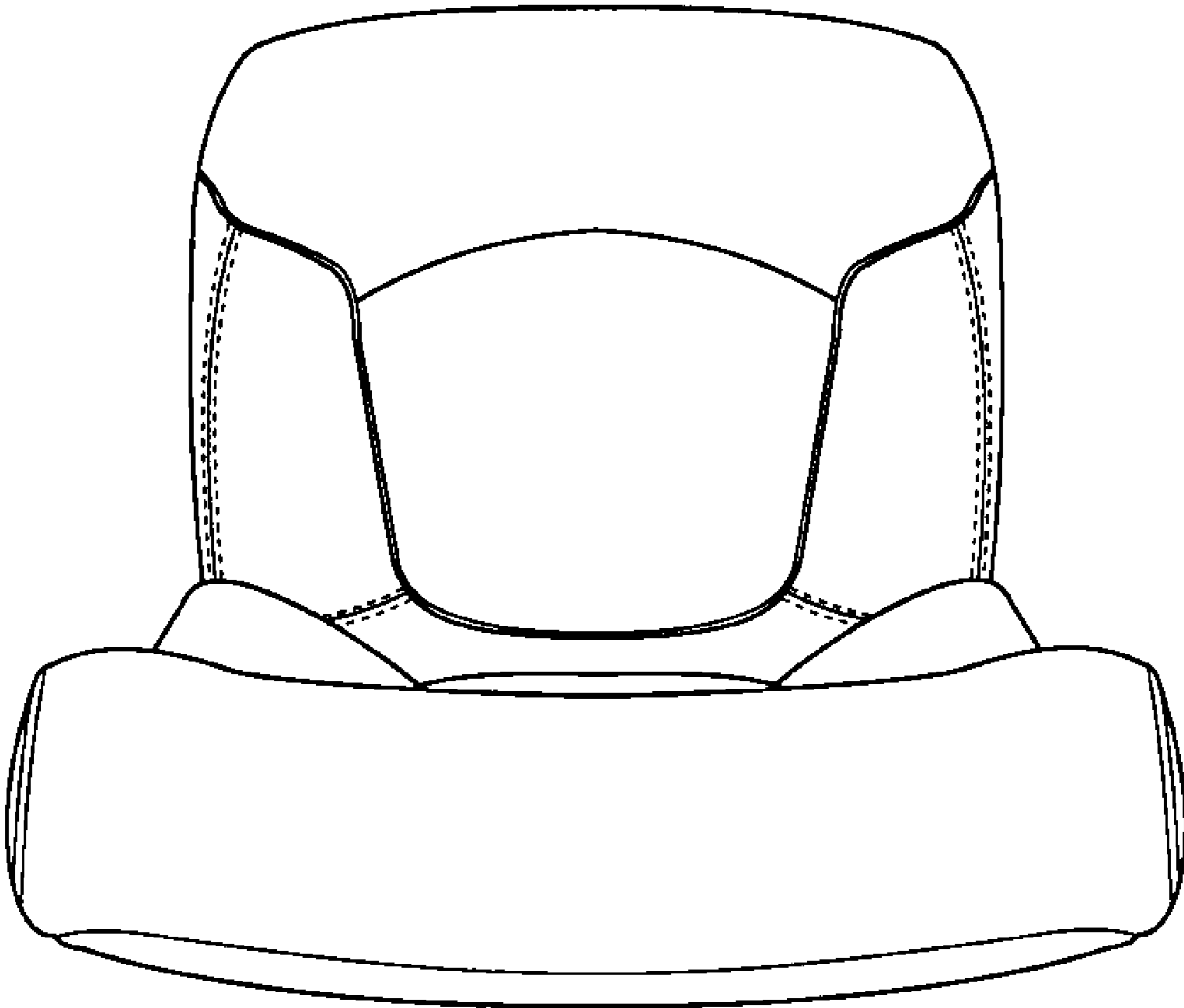

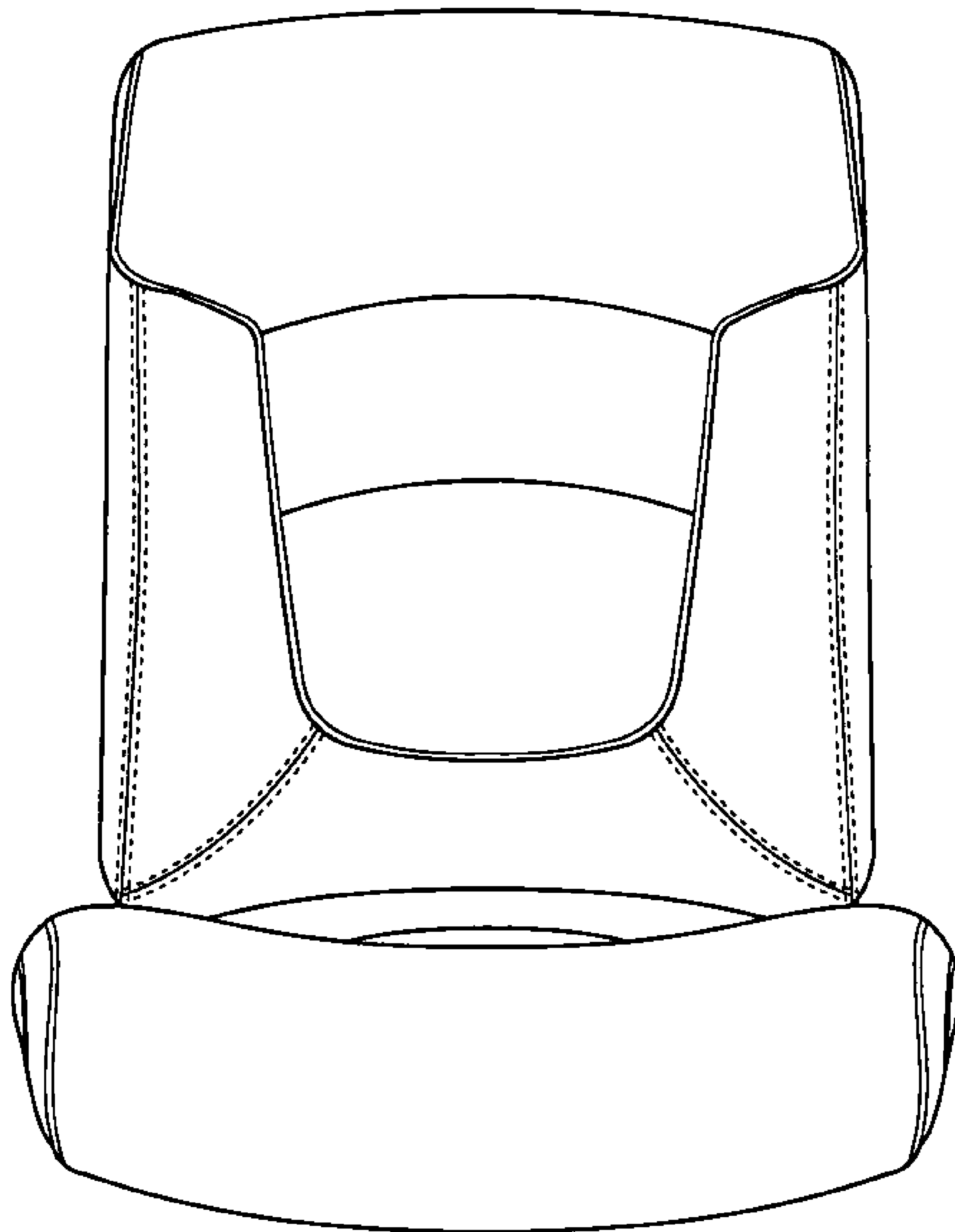
