The ornamental design for a wine charm, as shown and described.

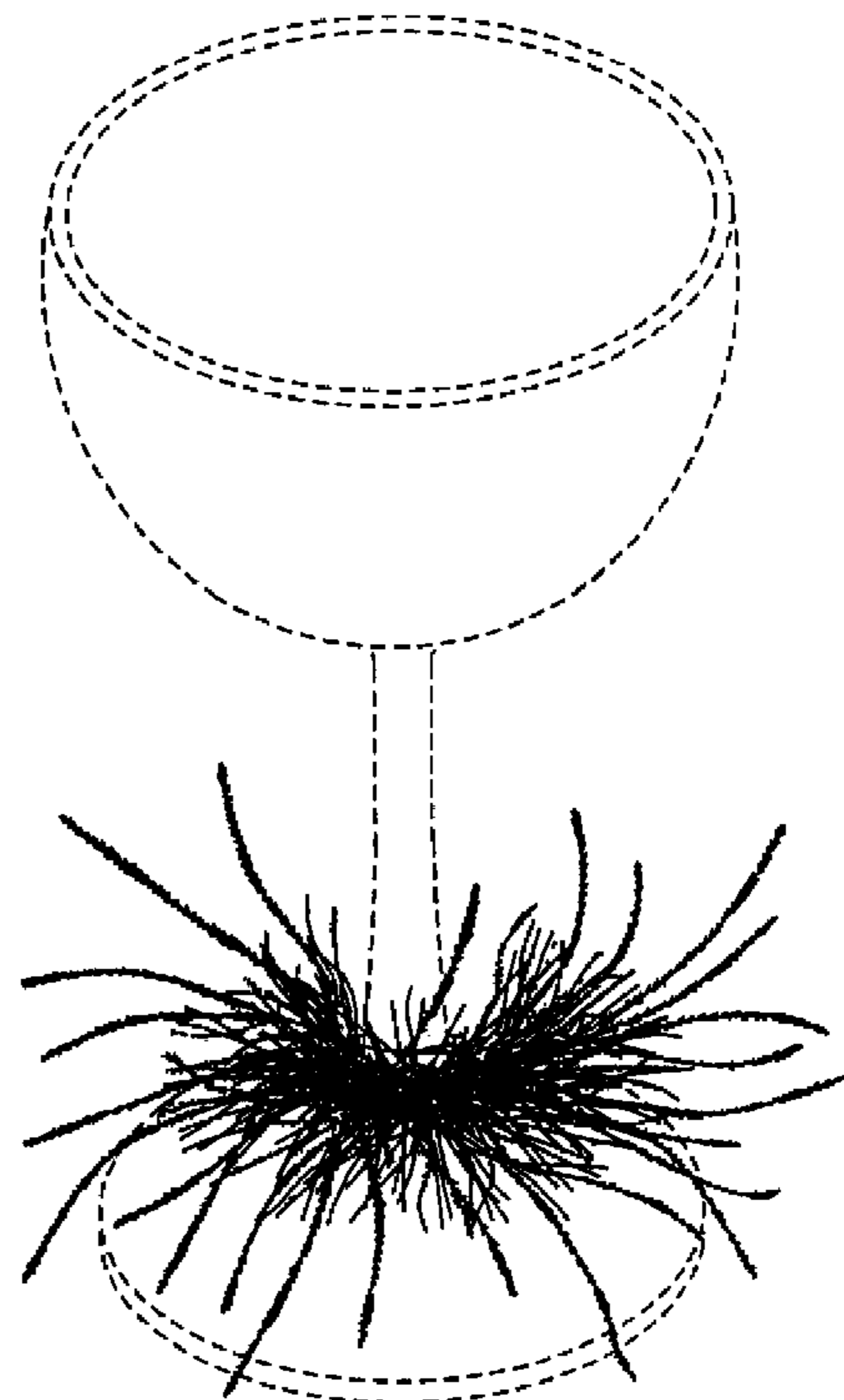
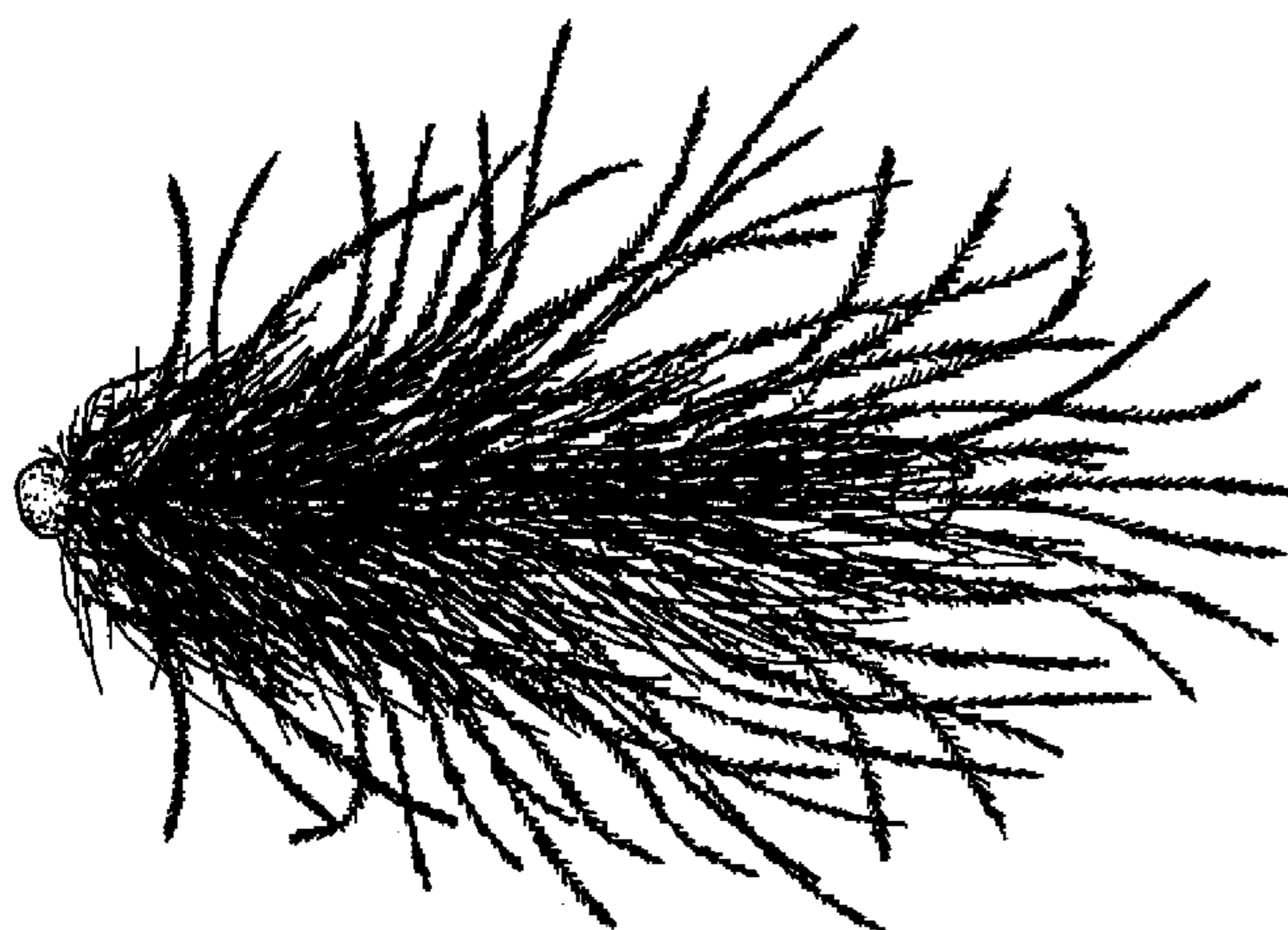
DESCRIPTION

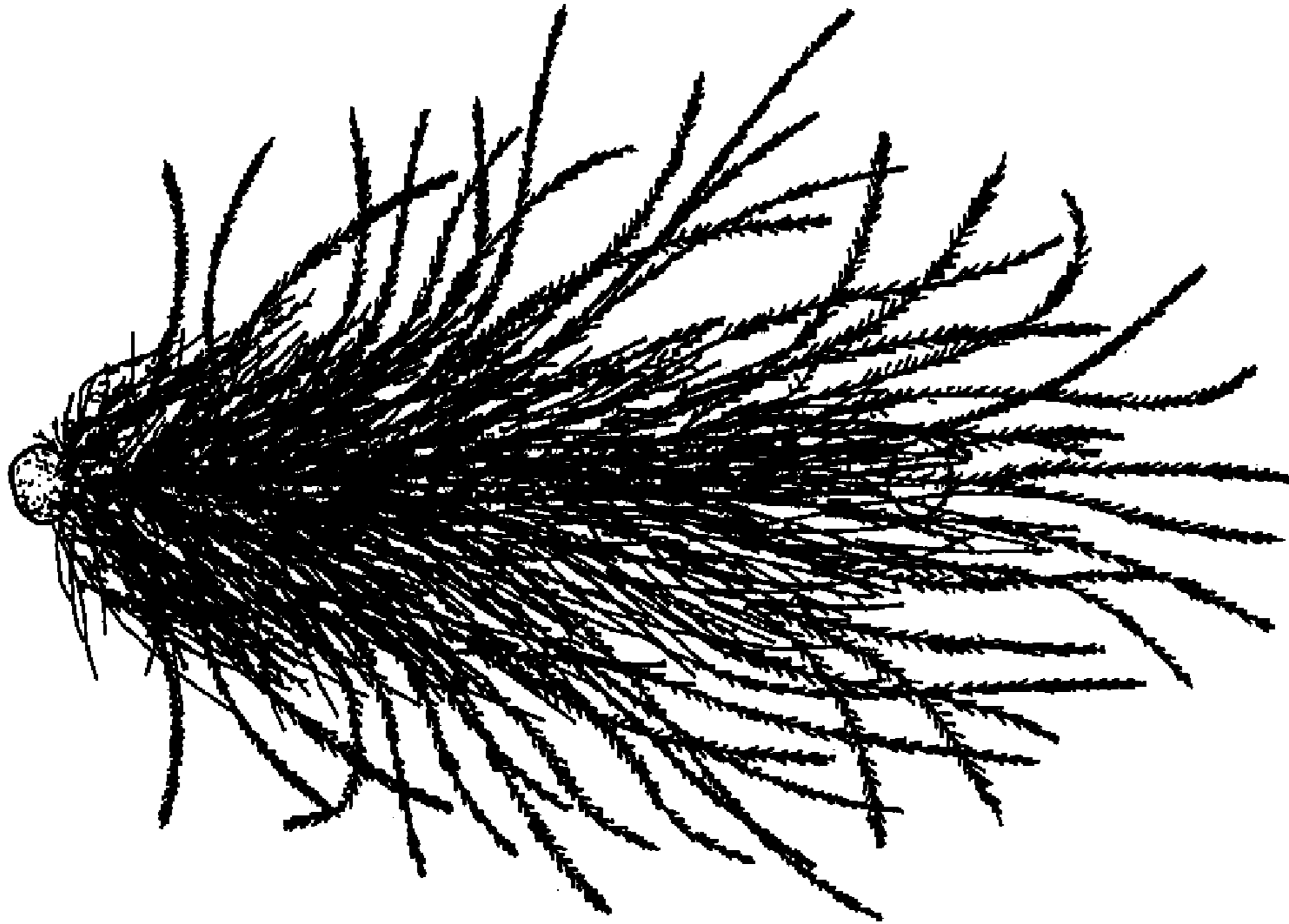

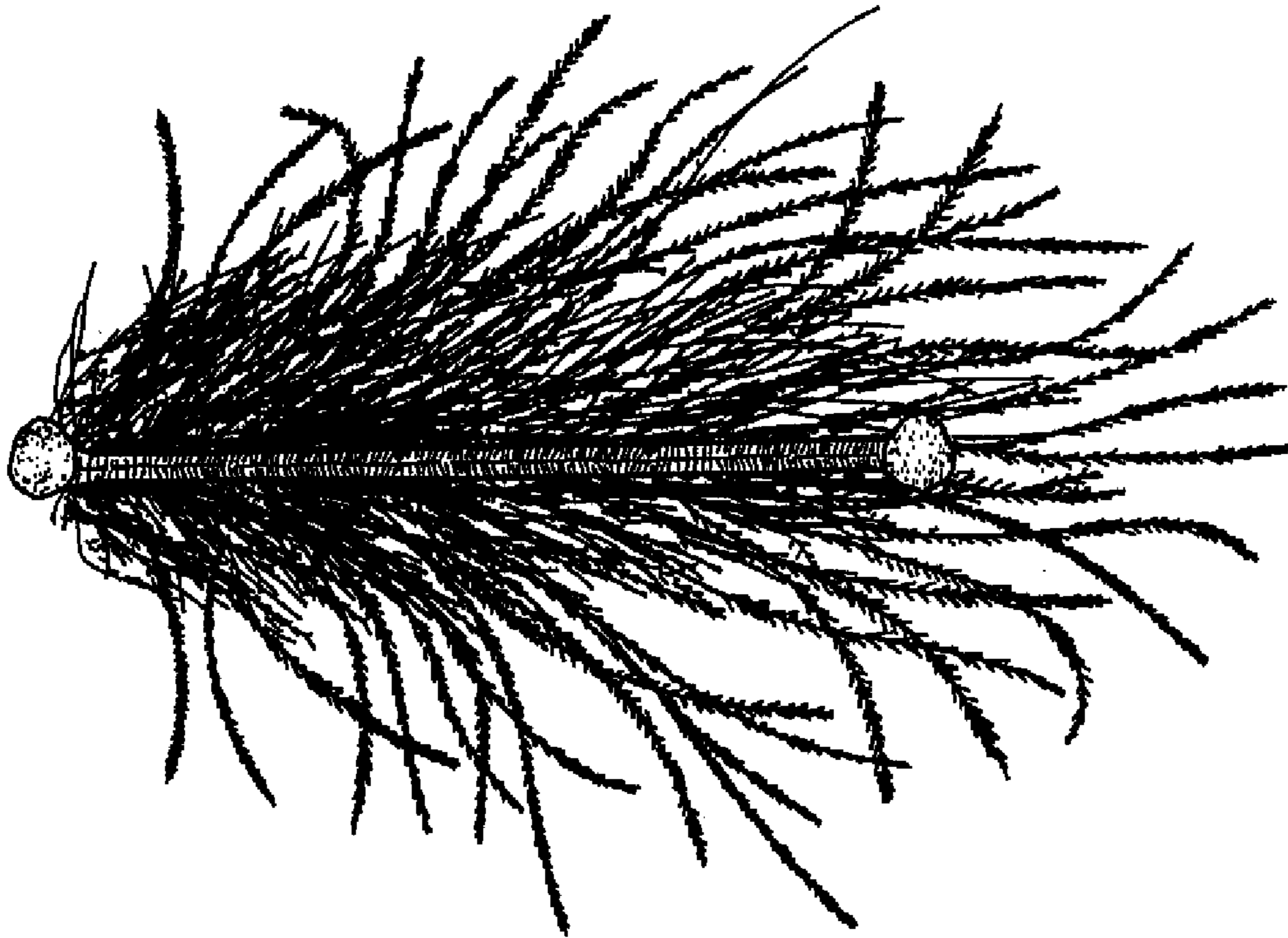
