FIG. 4 is an exploded bottom view thereof;

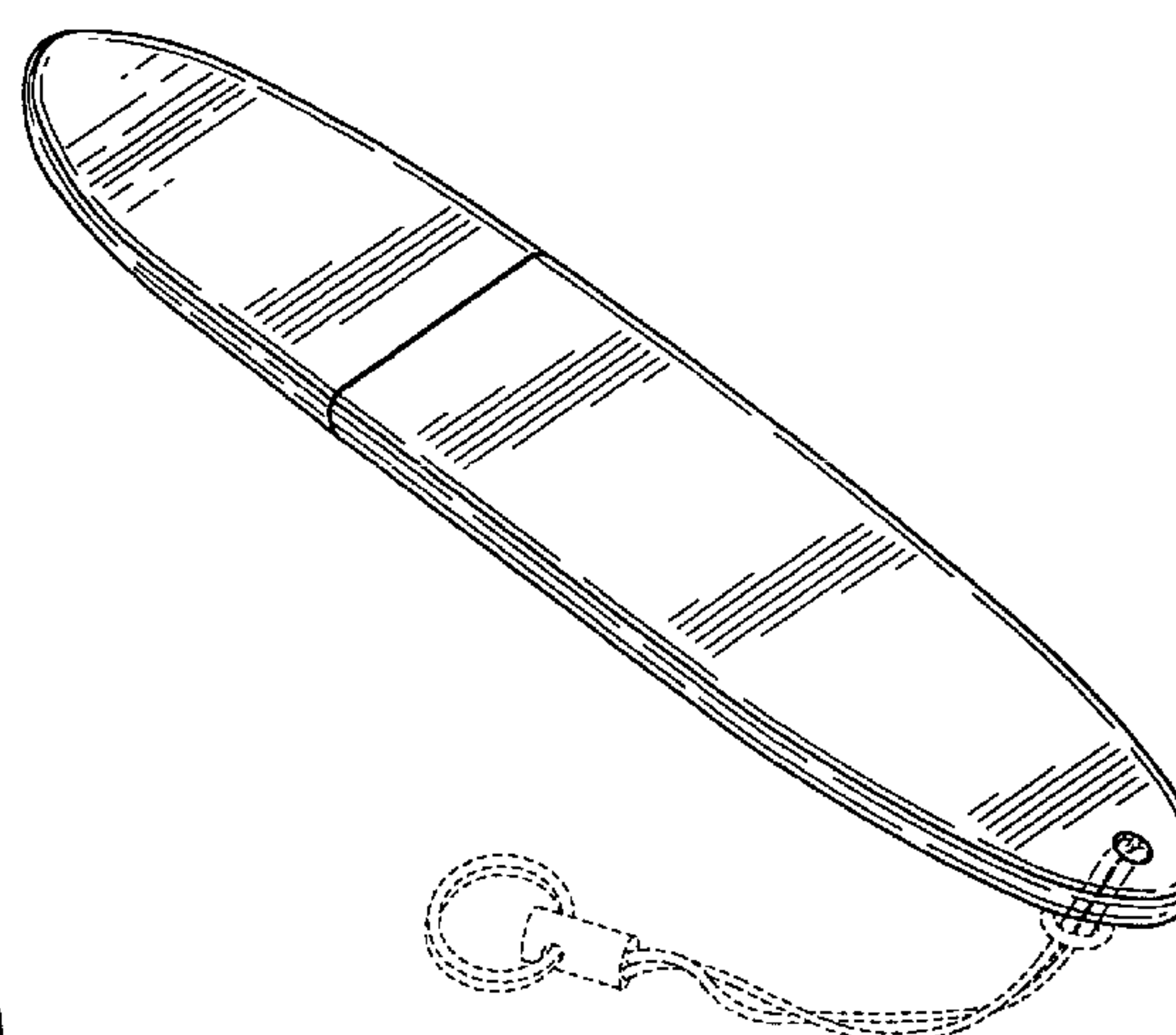
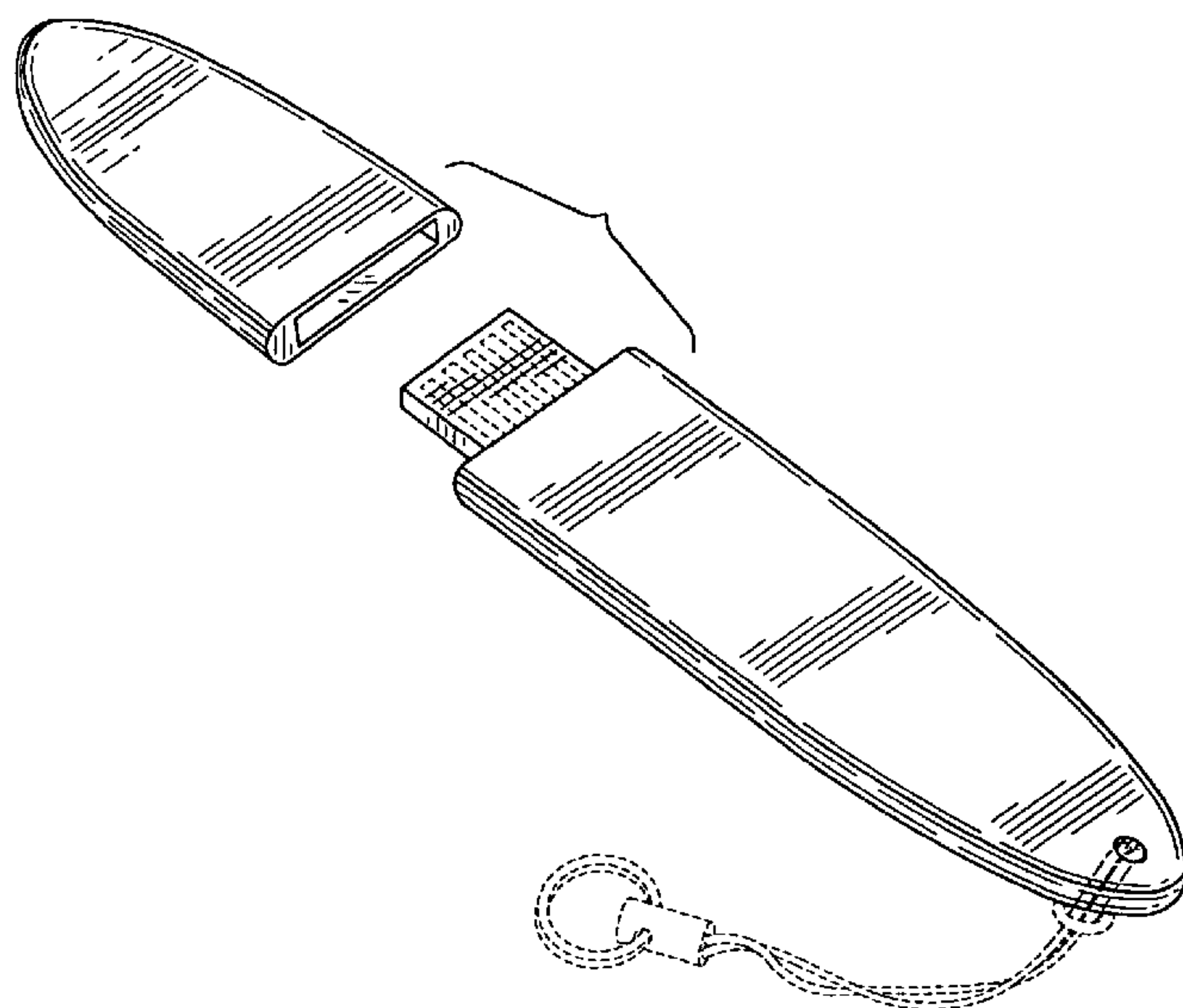
FIG. 5 is as front view thereof;

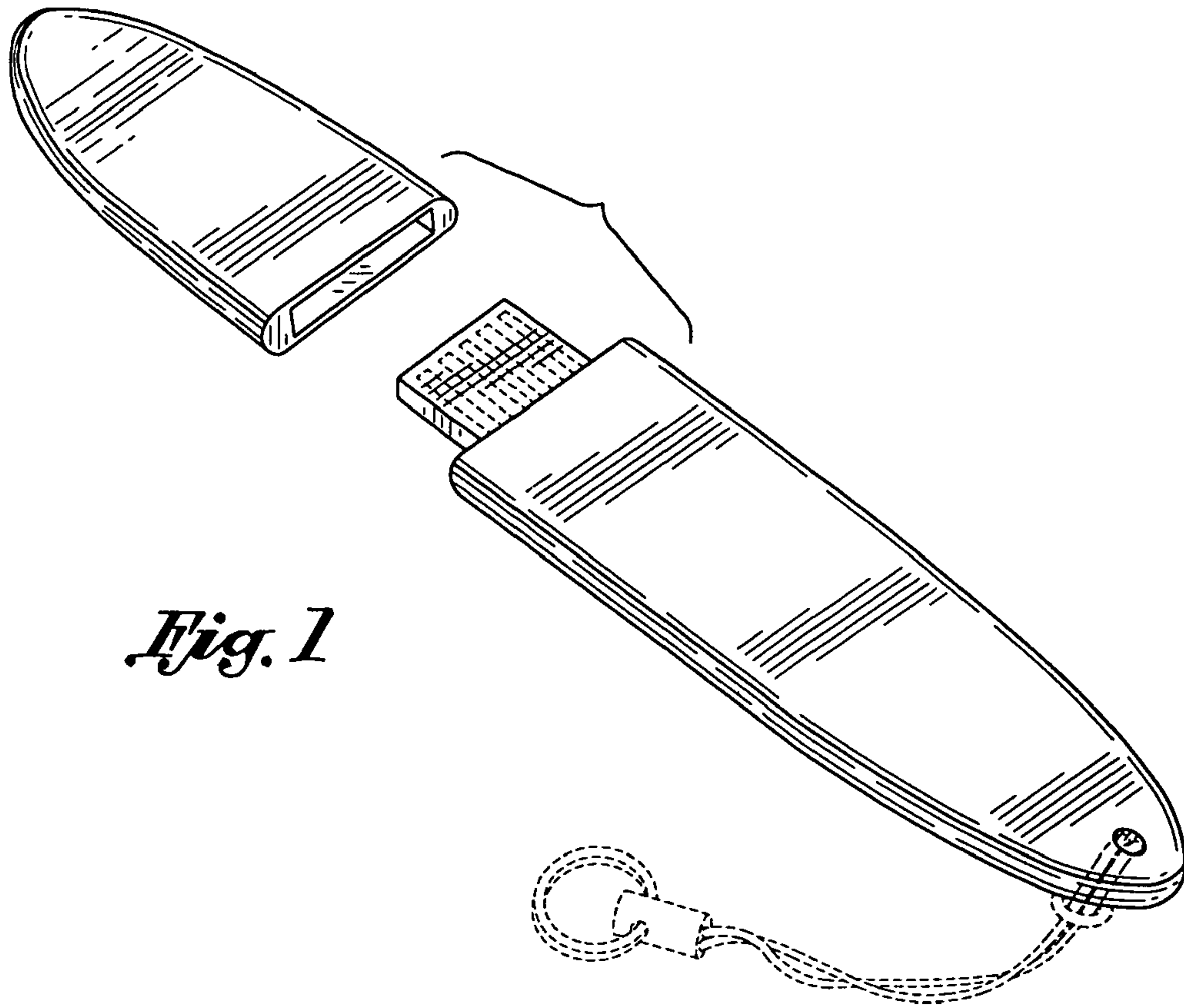
FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof.

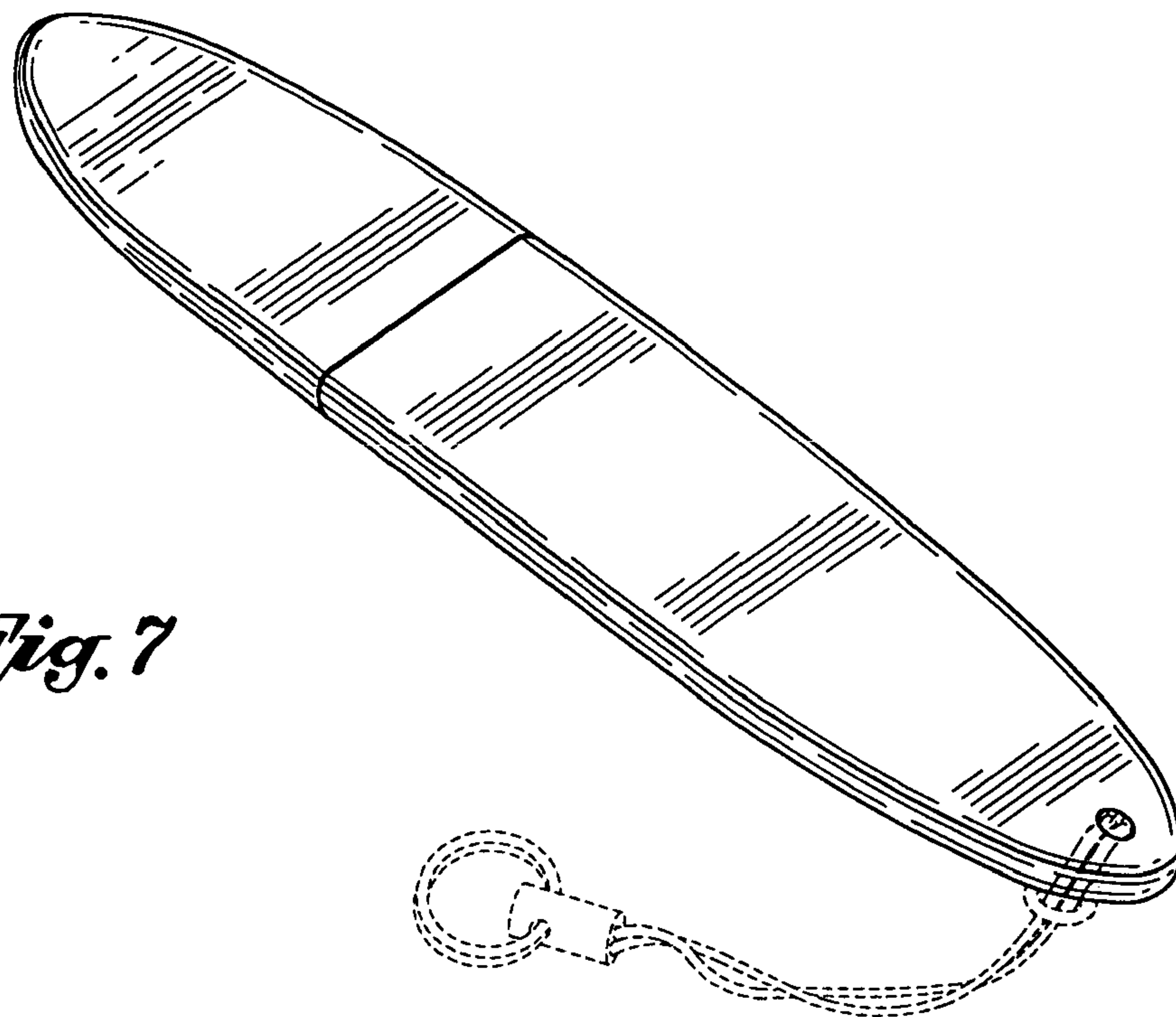

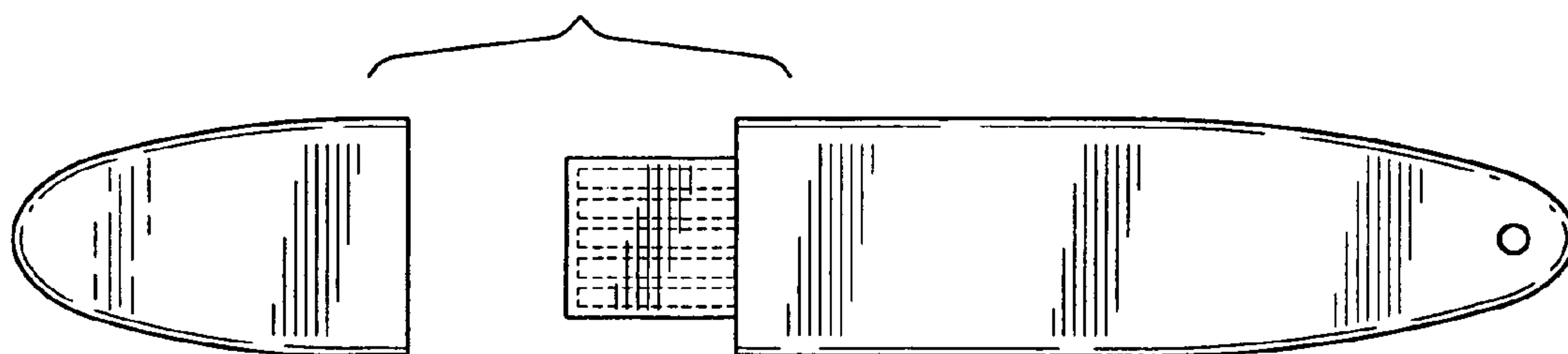




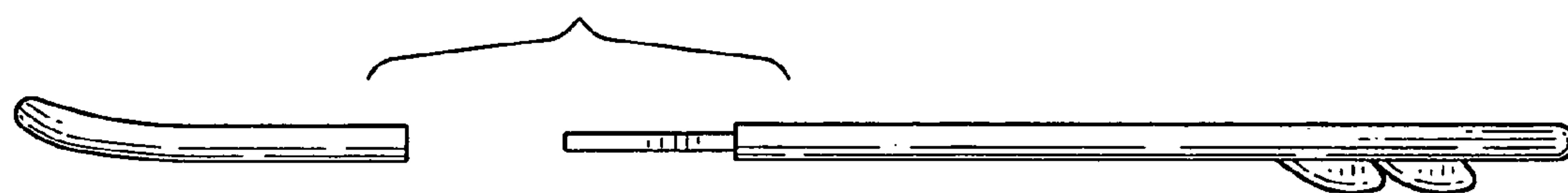

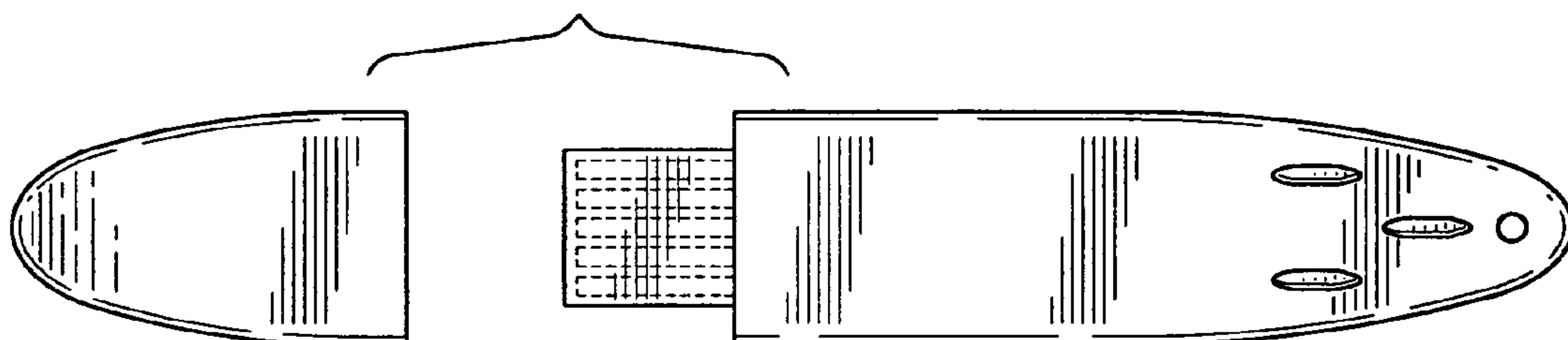
