FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 7.

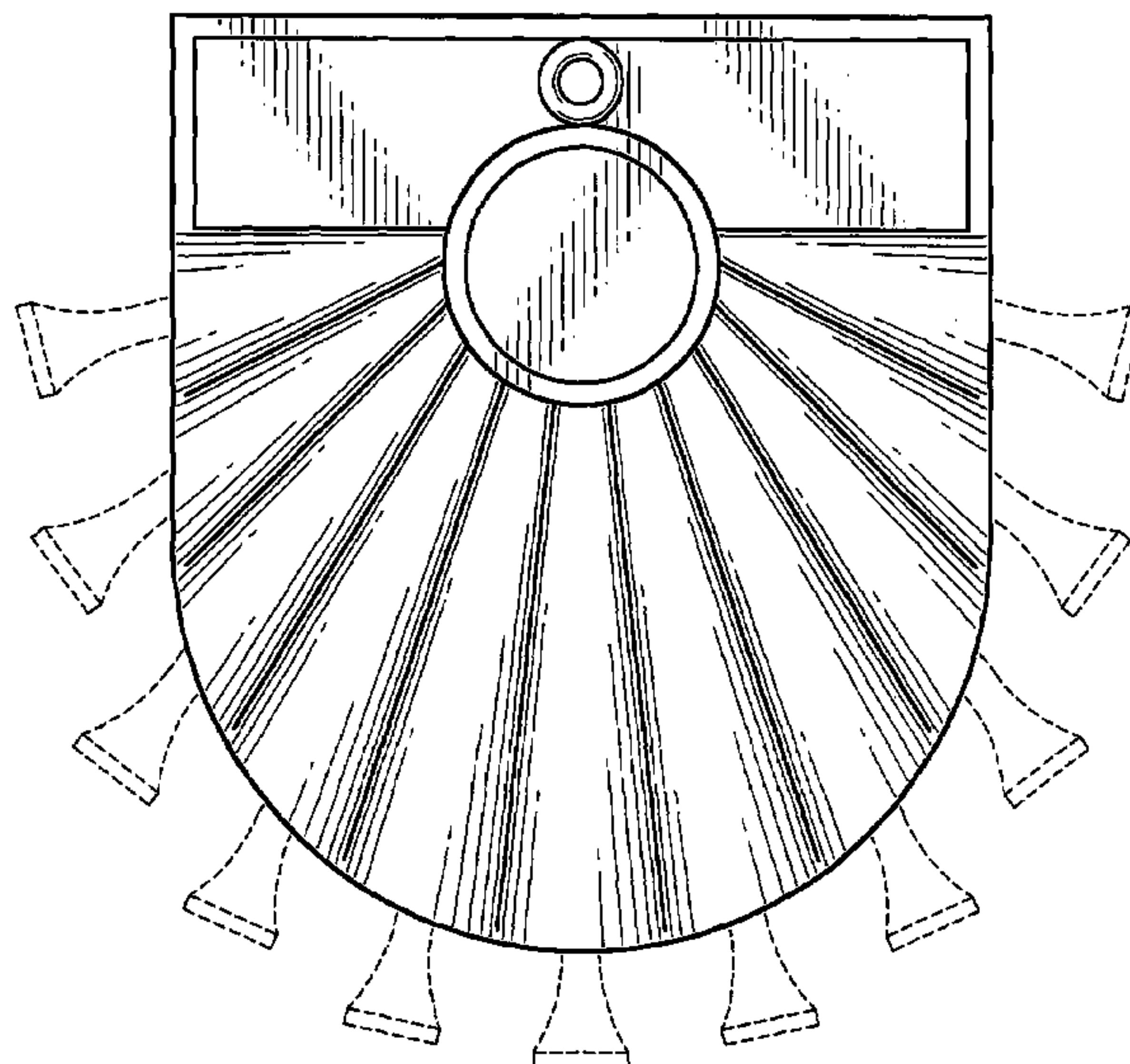
FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 7.

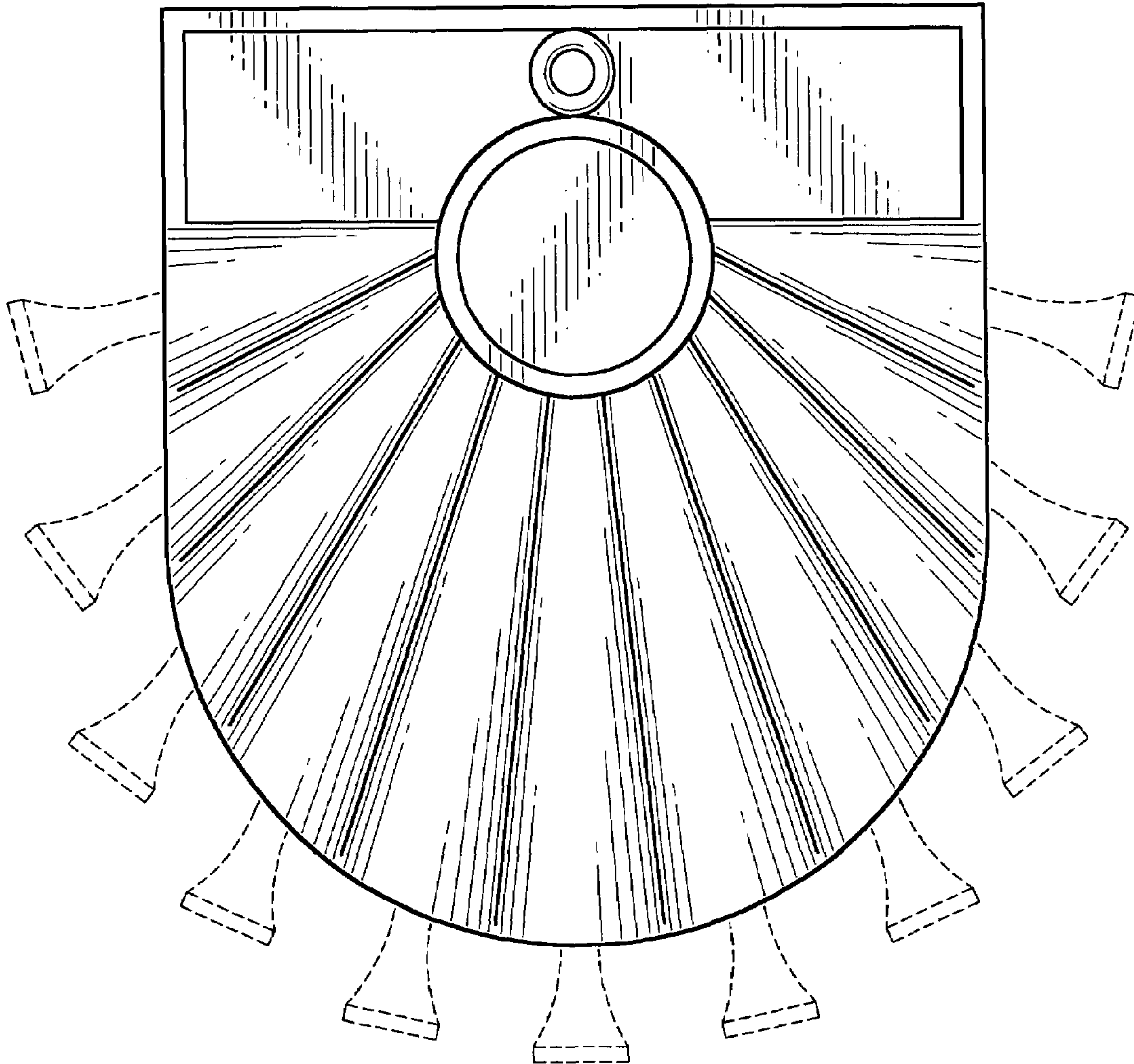

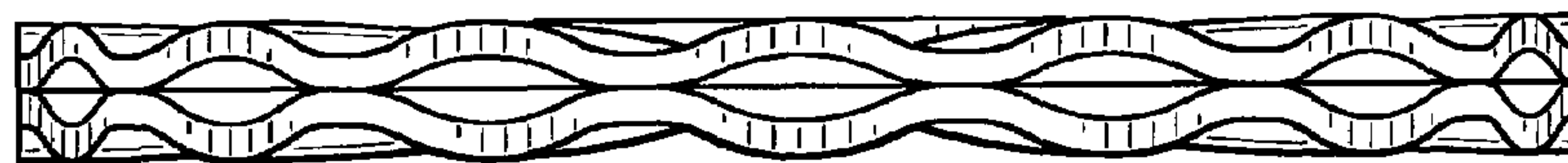

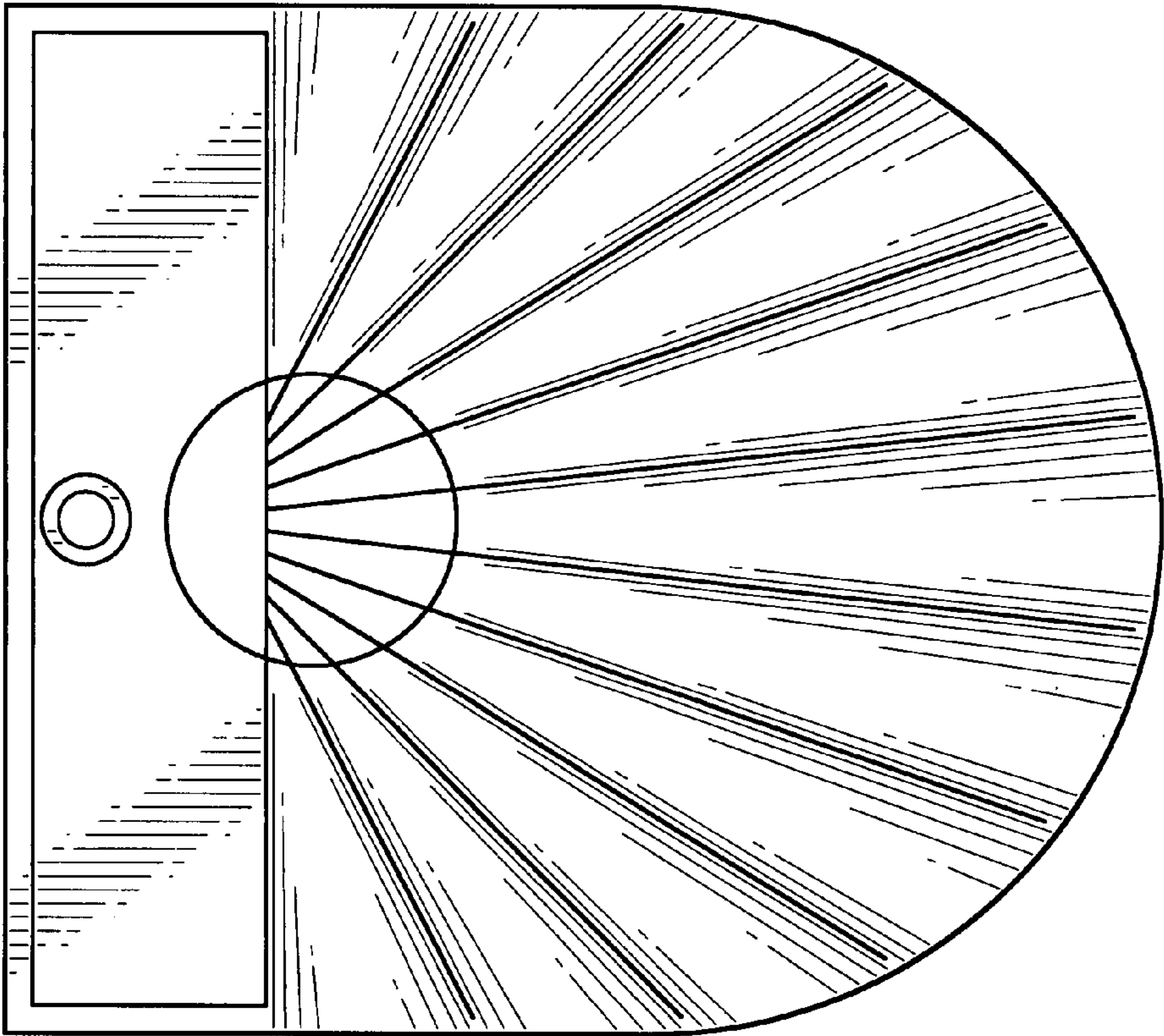

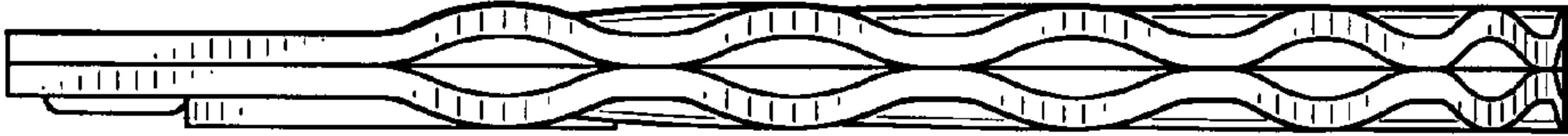

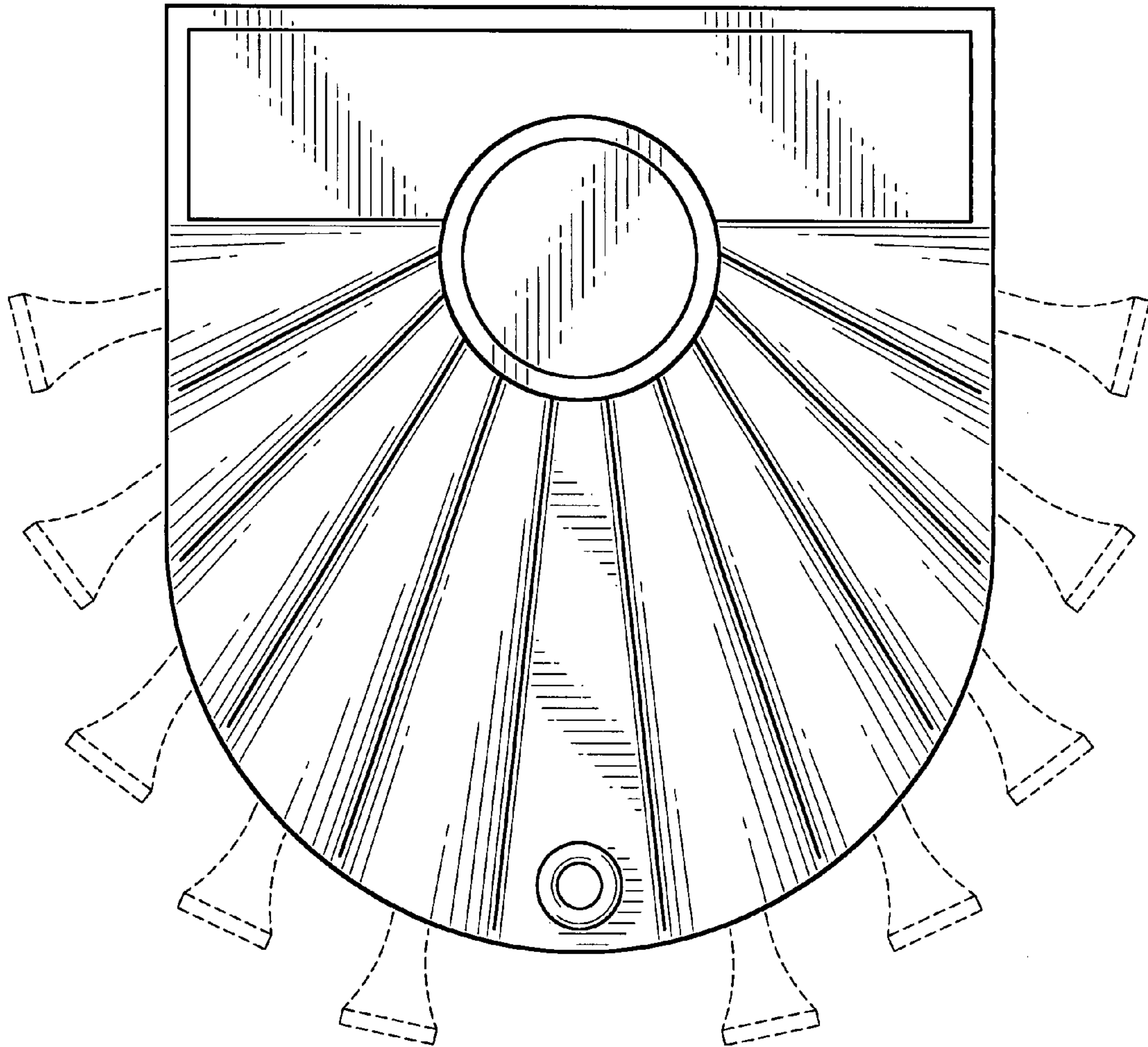

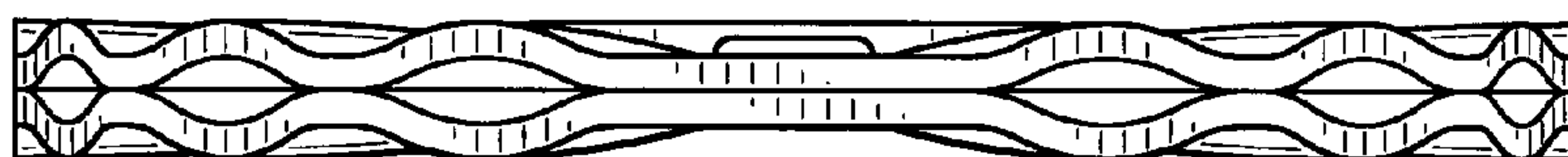

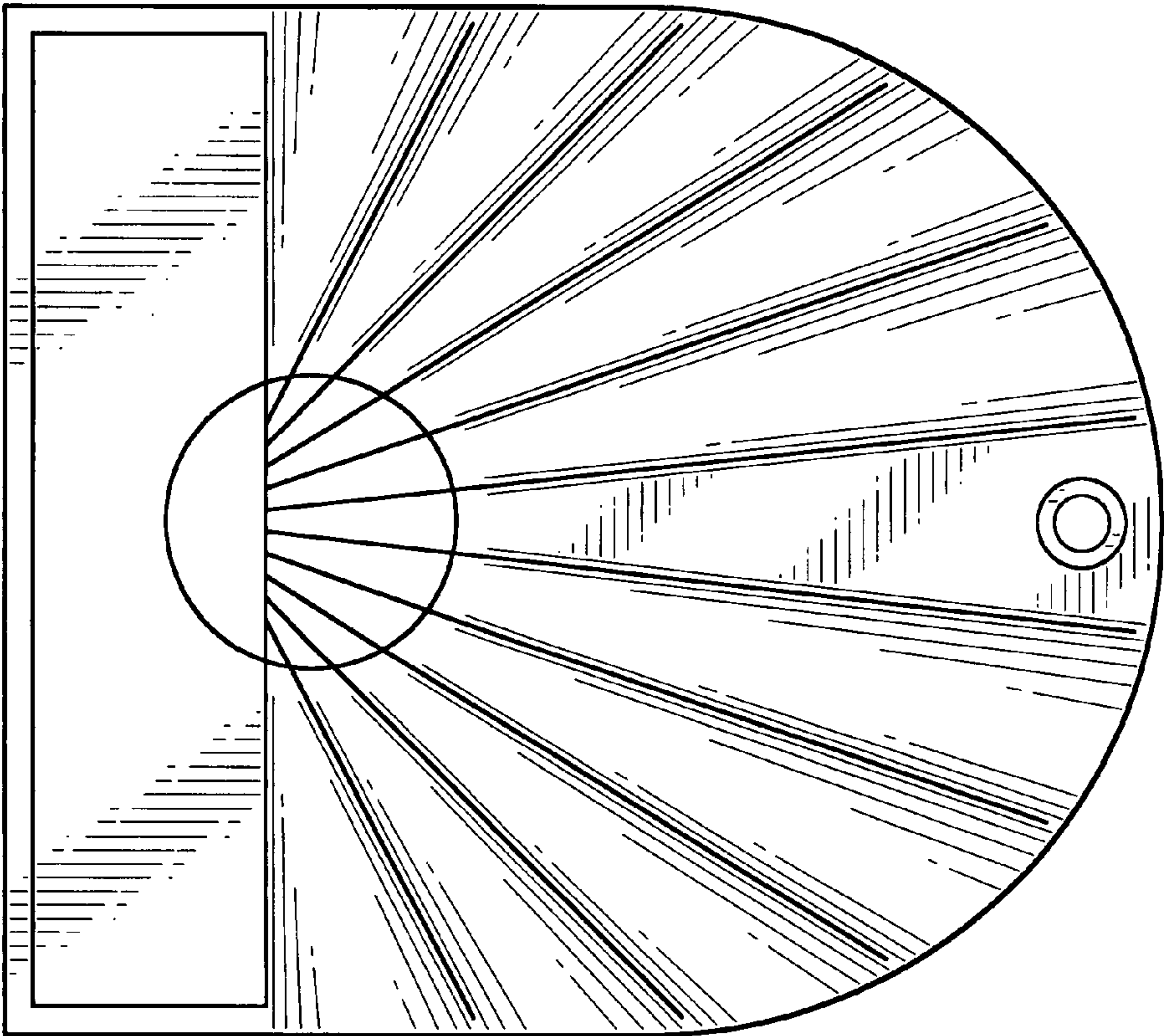

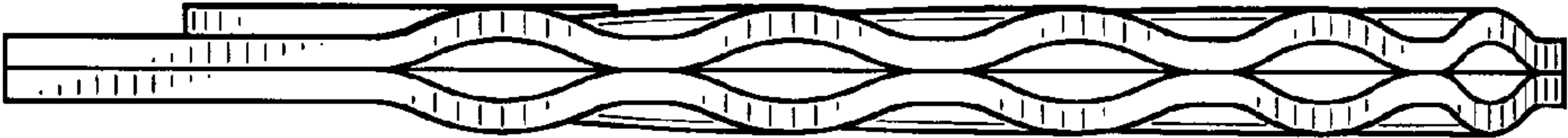
