The ornamental design for an arched cookware handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an enlarged perspective view from above the arched cookware handle showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is back elevation view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is an enlarged perspective view from below thereof.

The pair of circular rivet holes in the flange portion of the handle, which are visible at least partially in FIGS. 1–4 and 6–7, are functional elements and are not intended to be limiting the scope of the ornamental design, forming no part thereof as claimed.
