**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 8 is a side elevation view thereof;

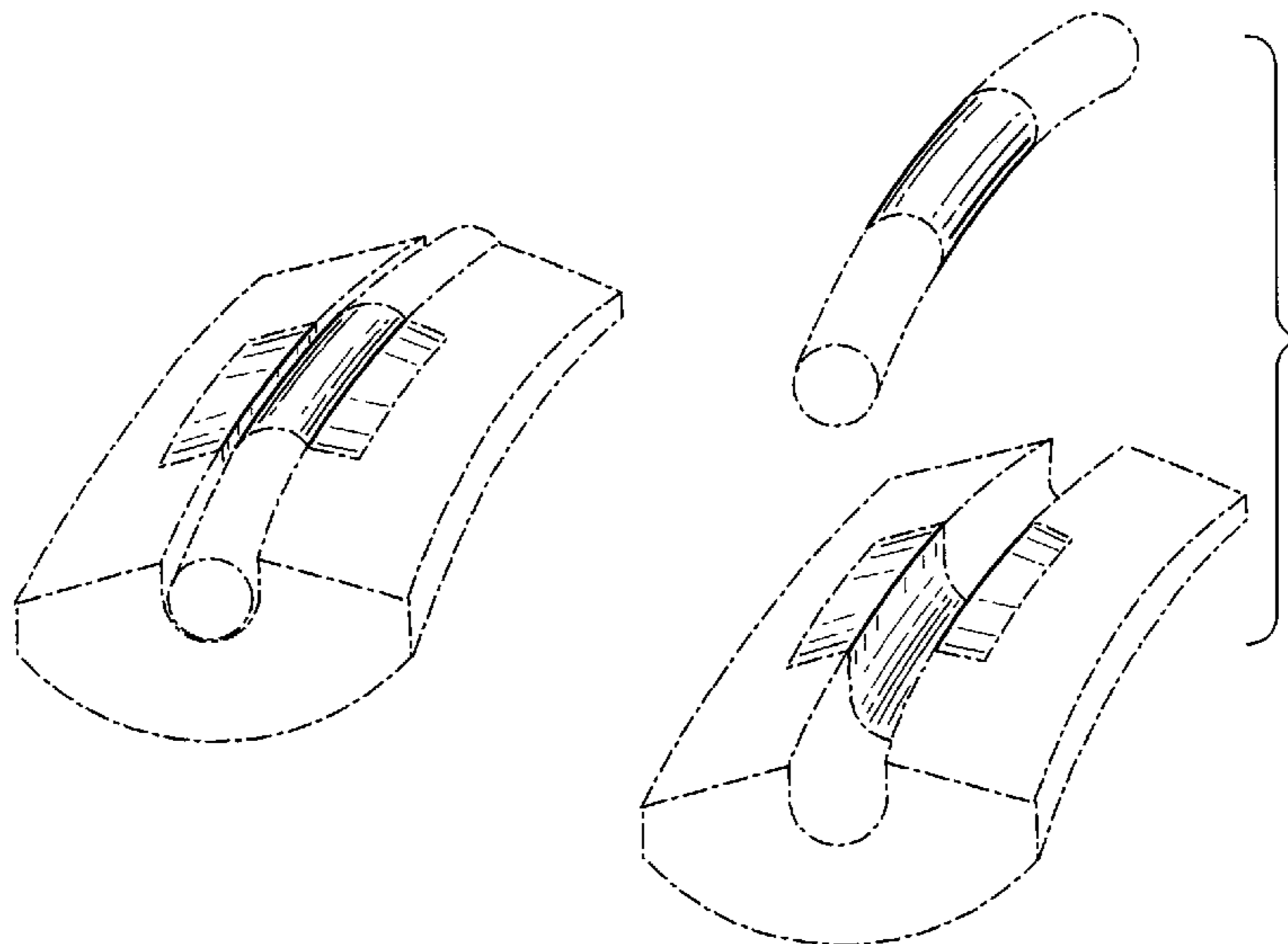
FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of the jewelry arrangement;

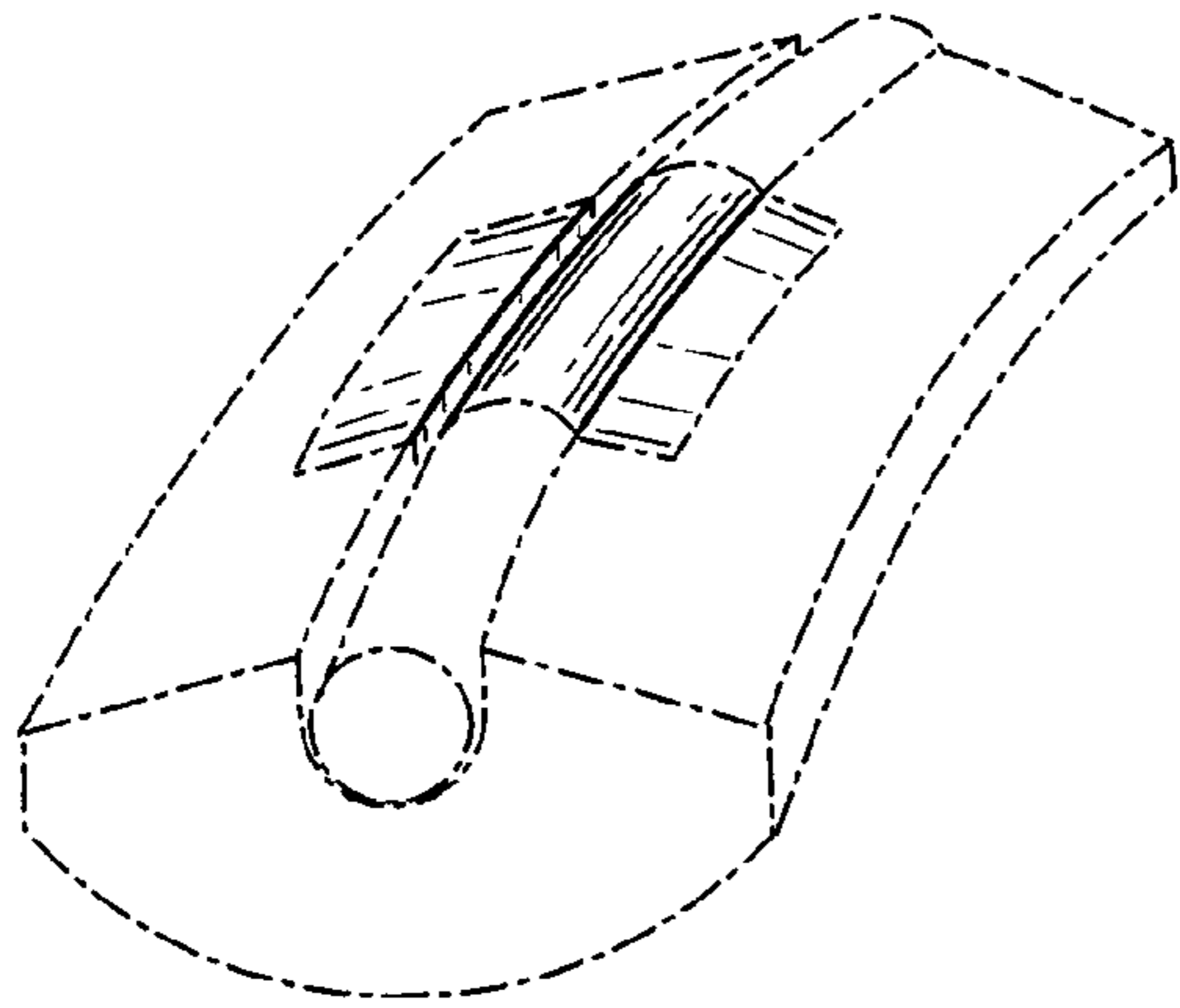

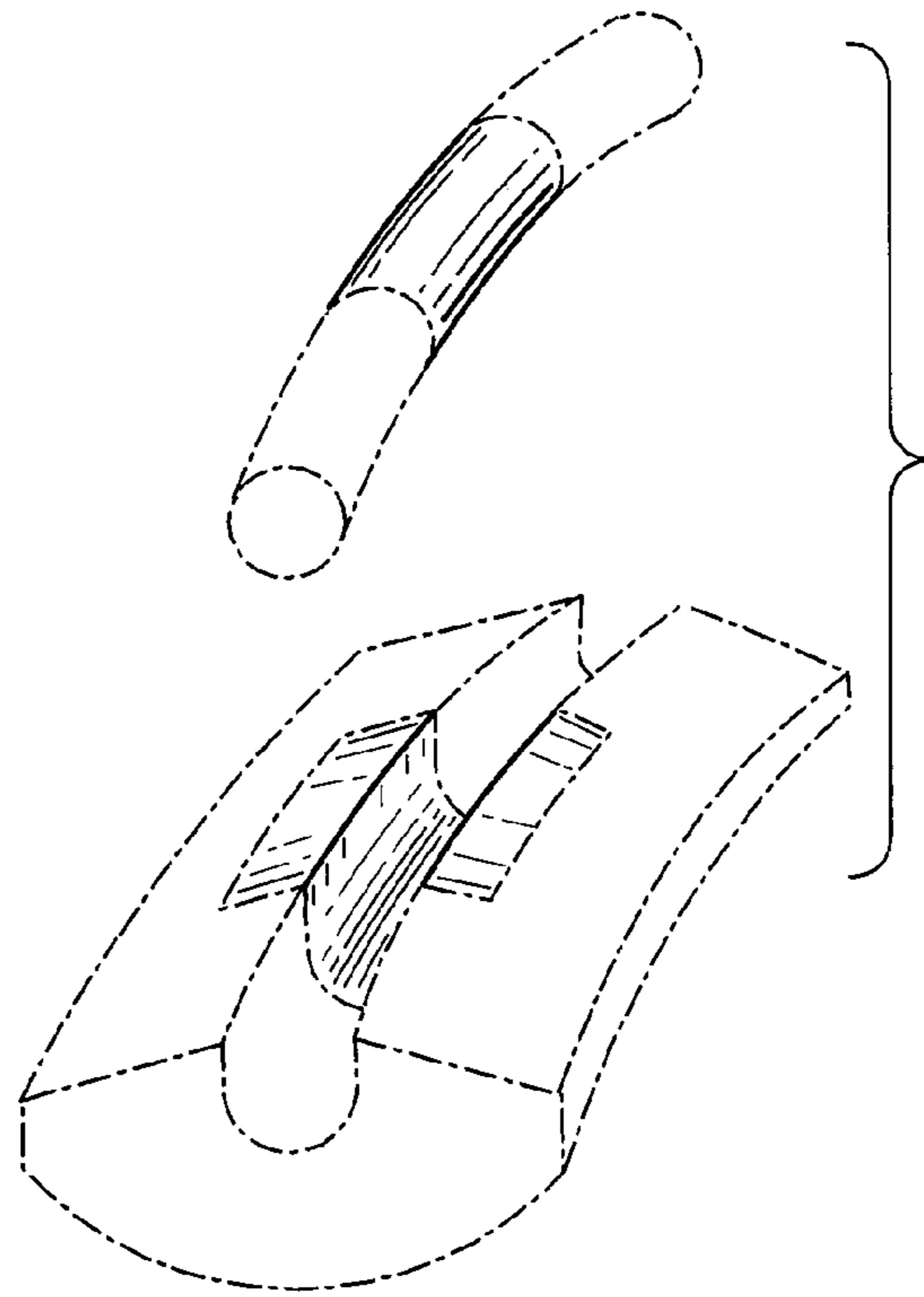

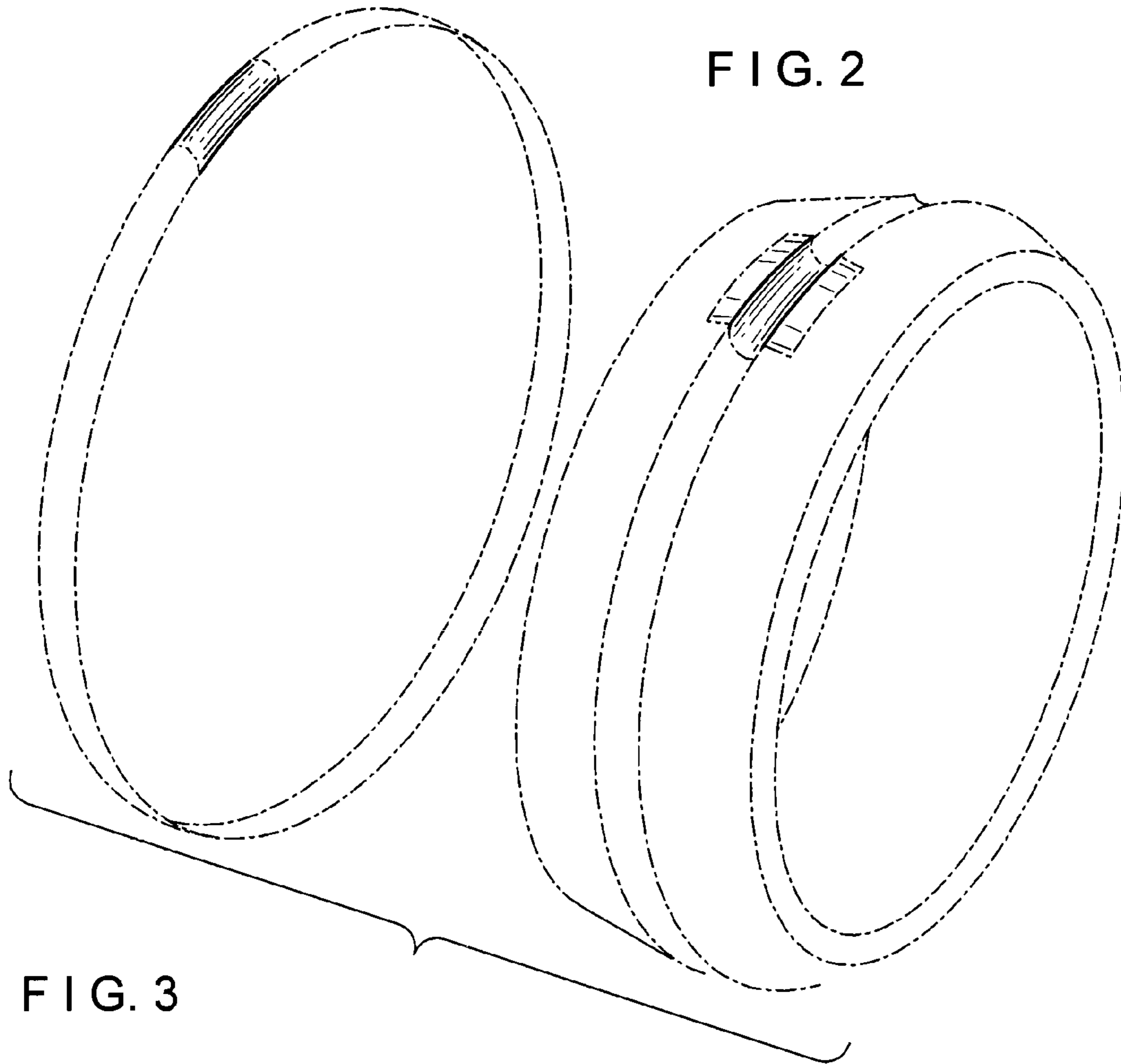

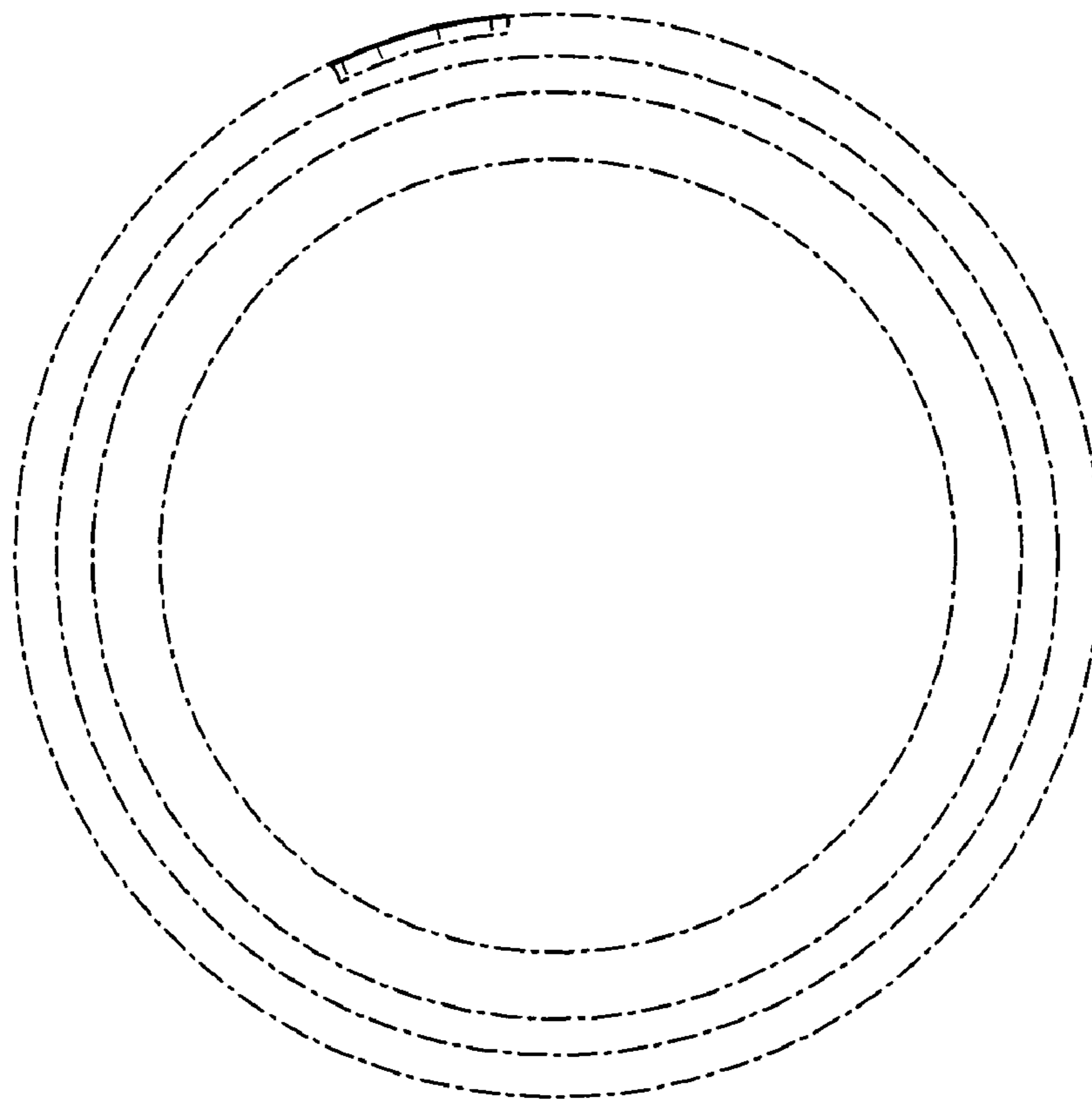

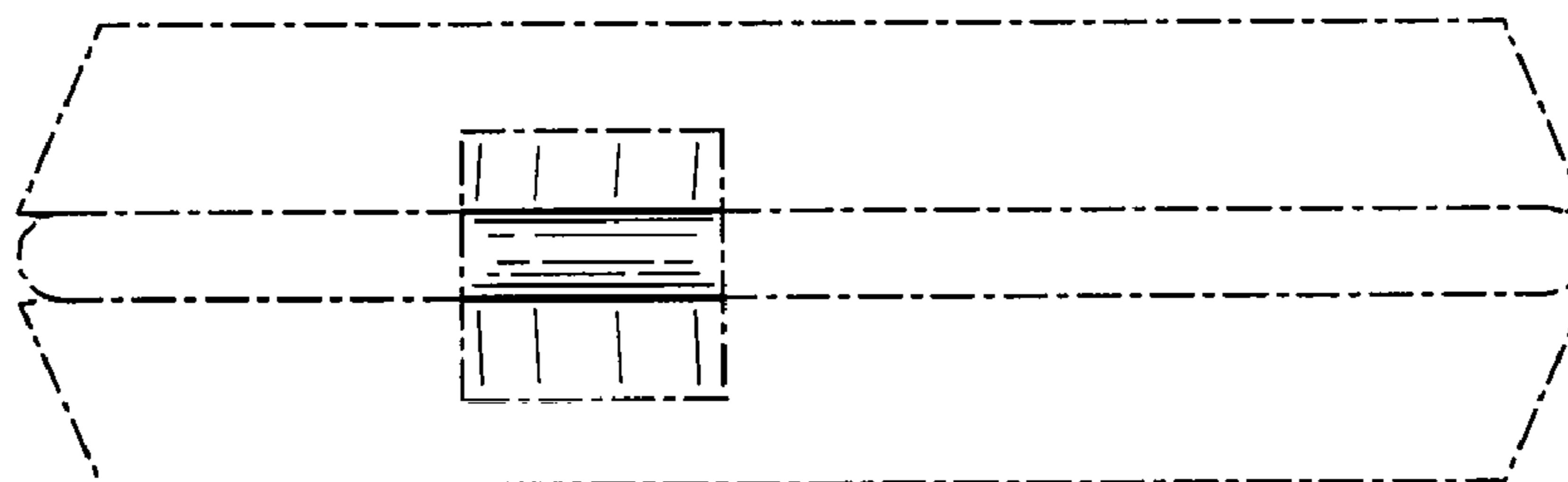

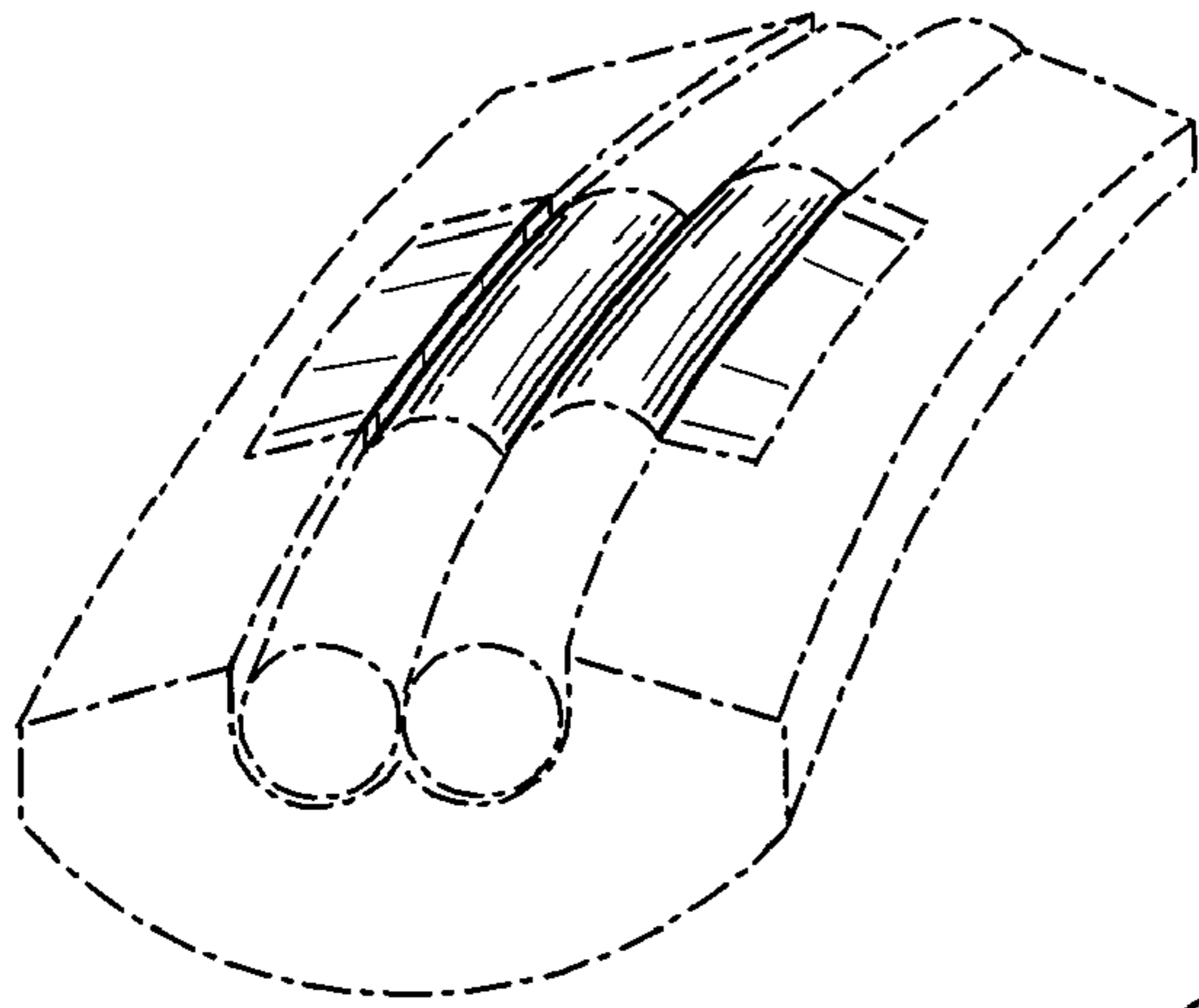

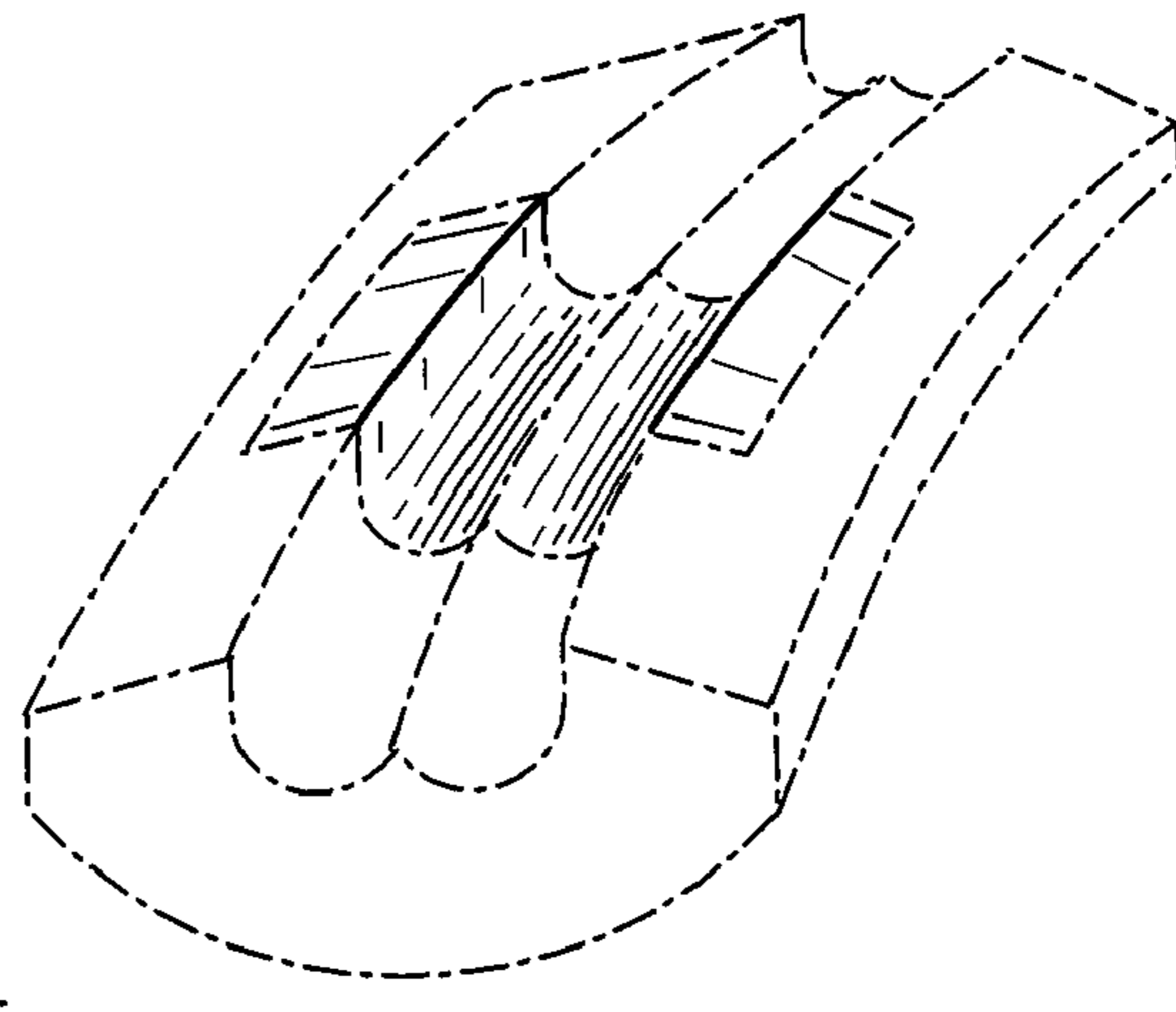
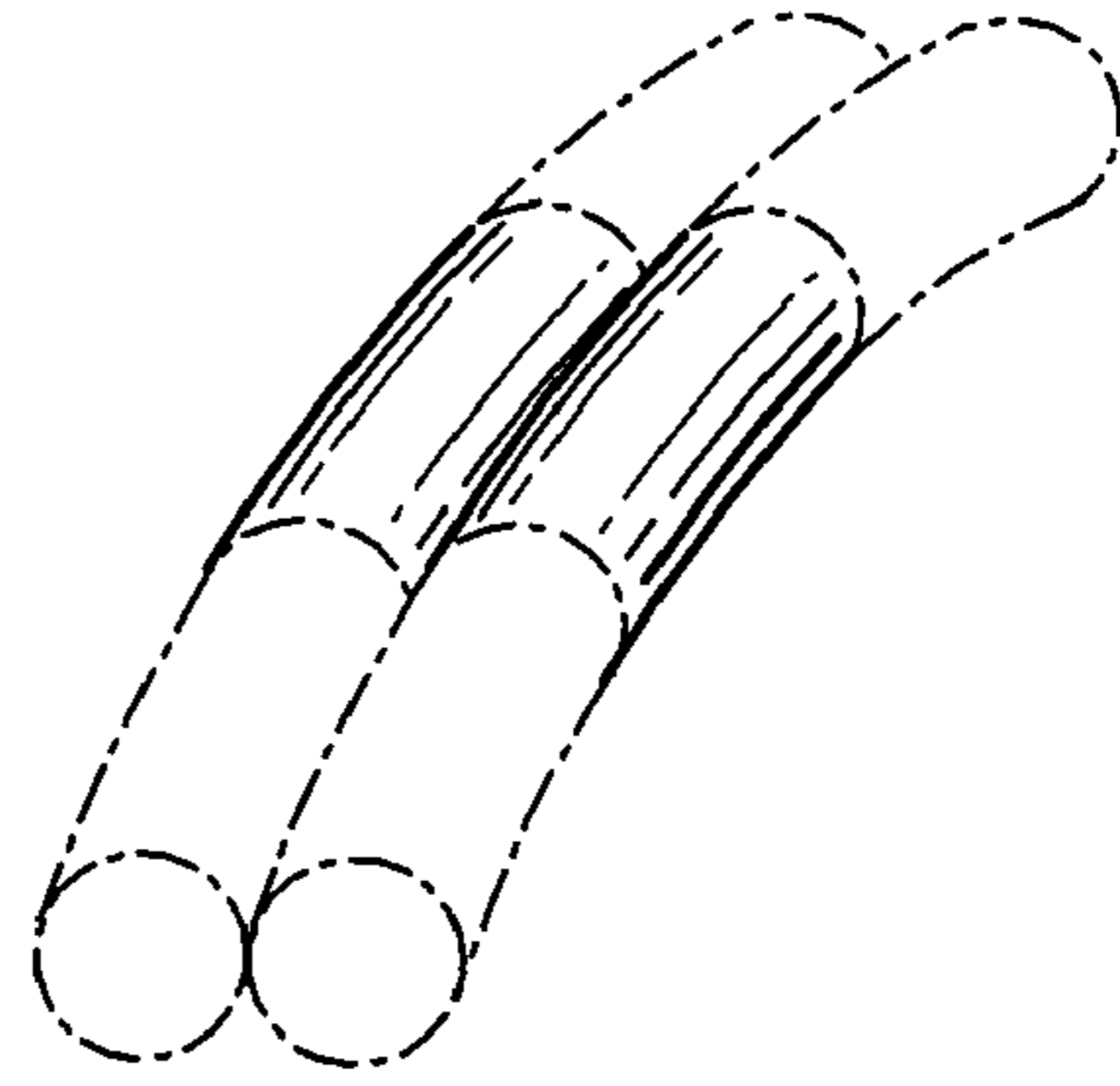

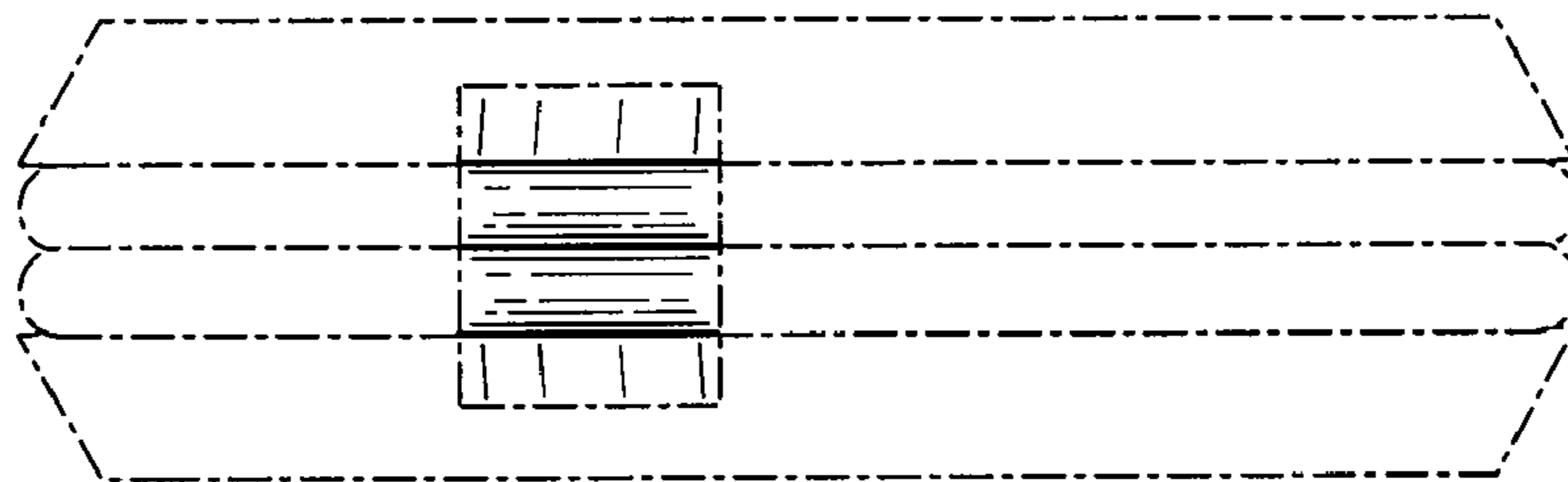

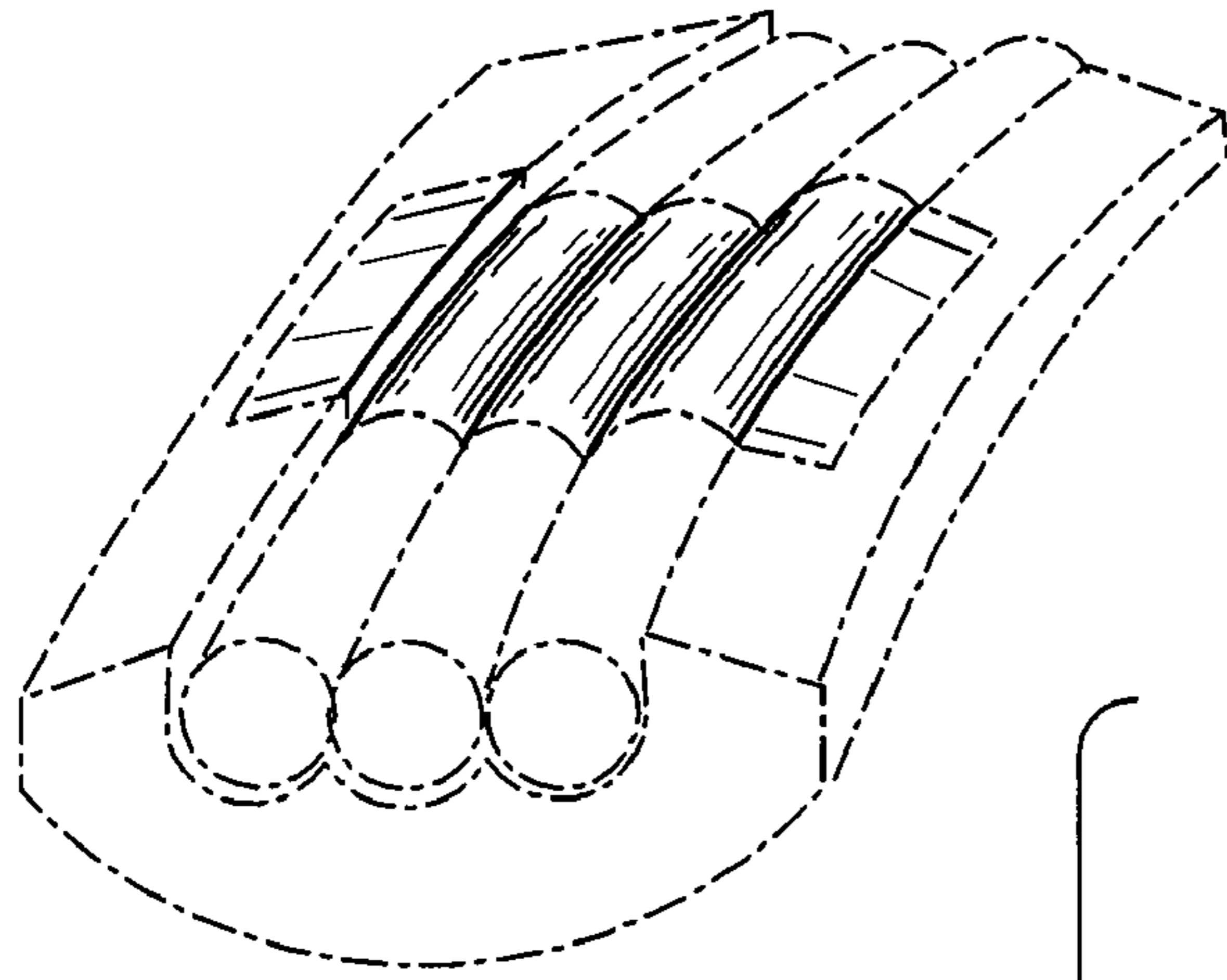

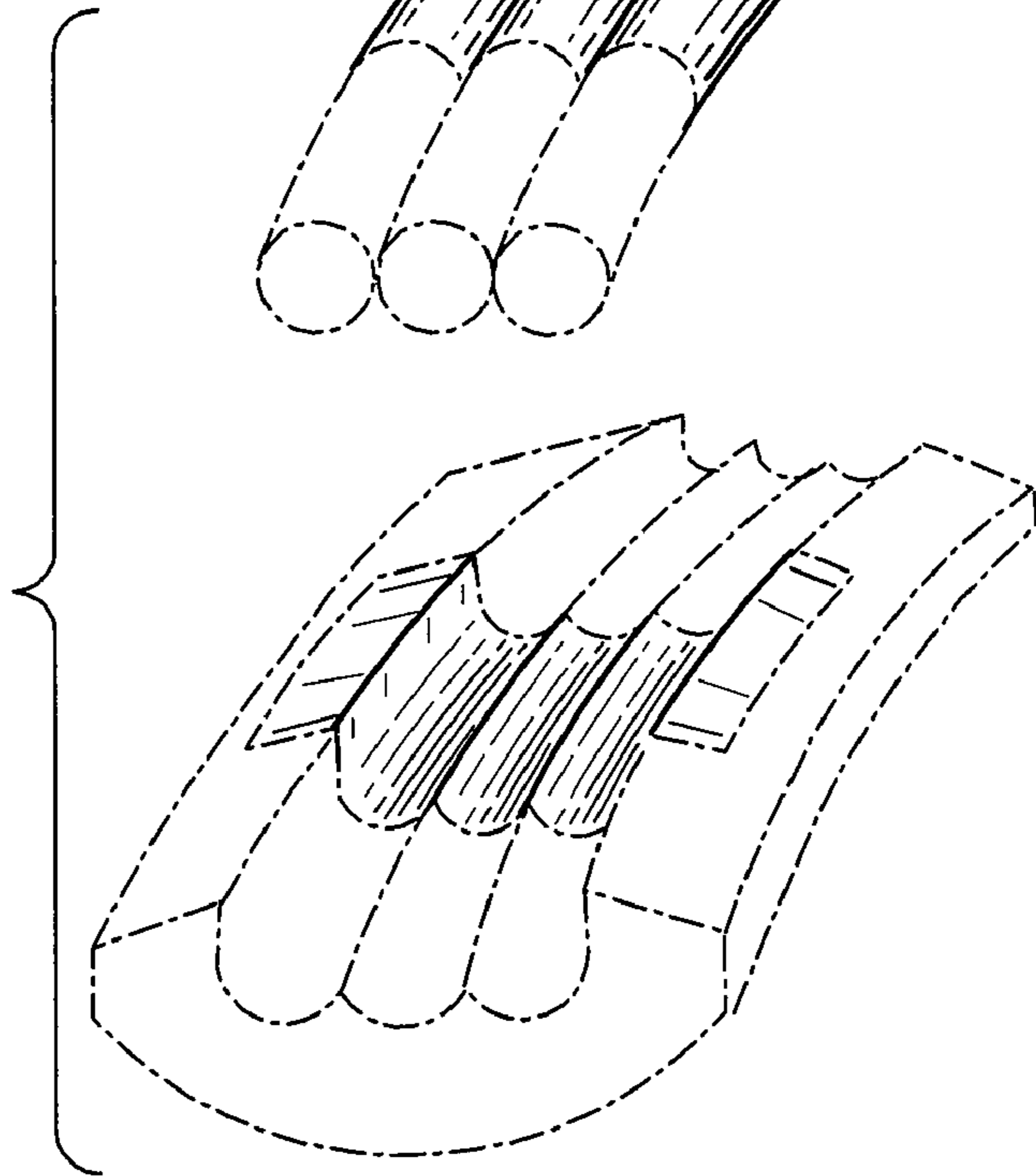
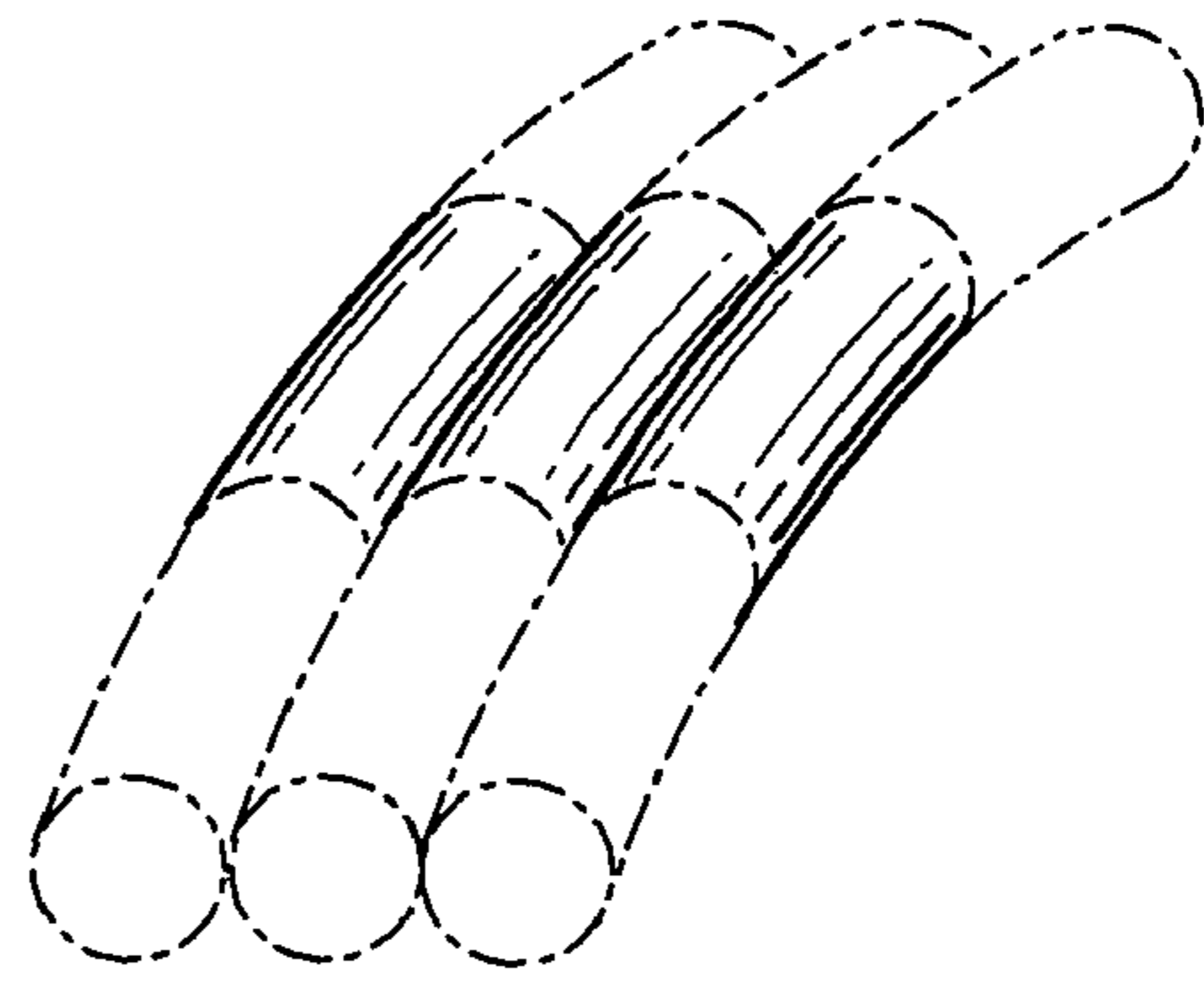

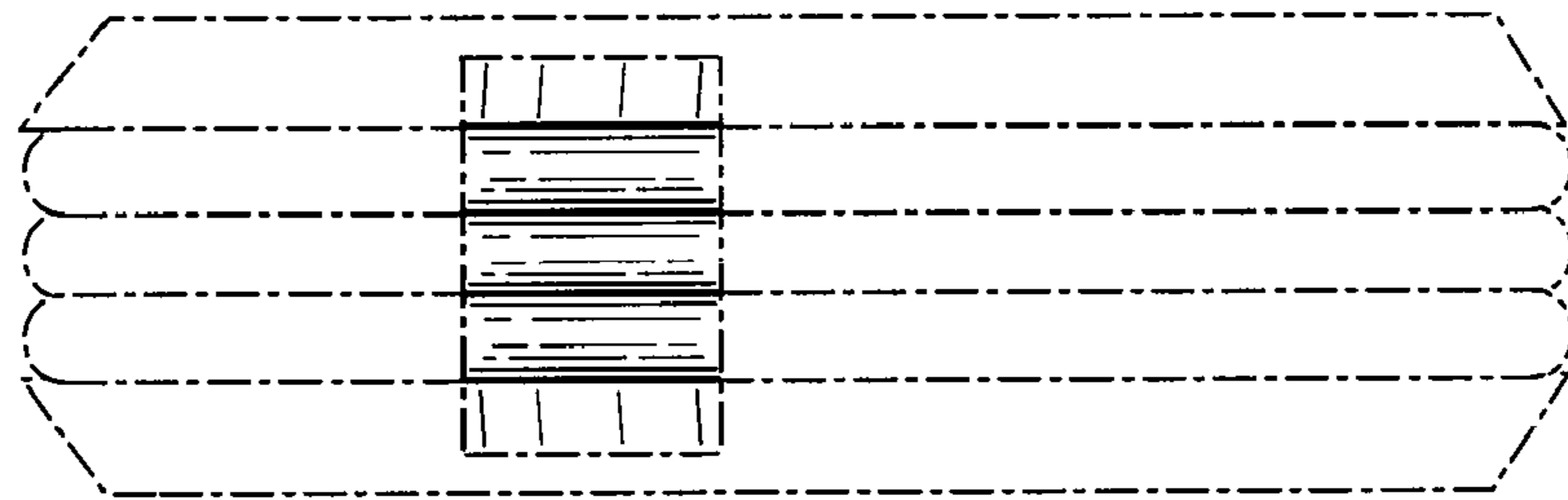
