FIG. 7 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

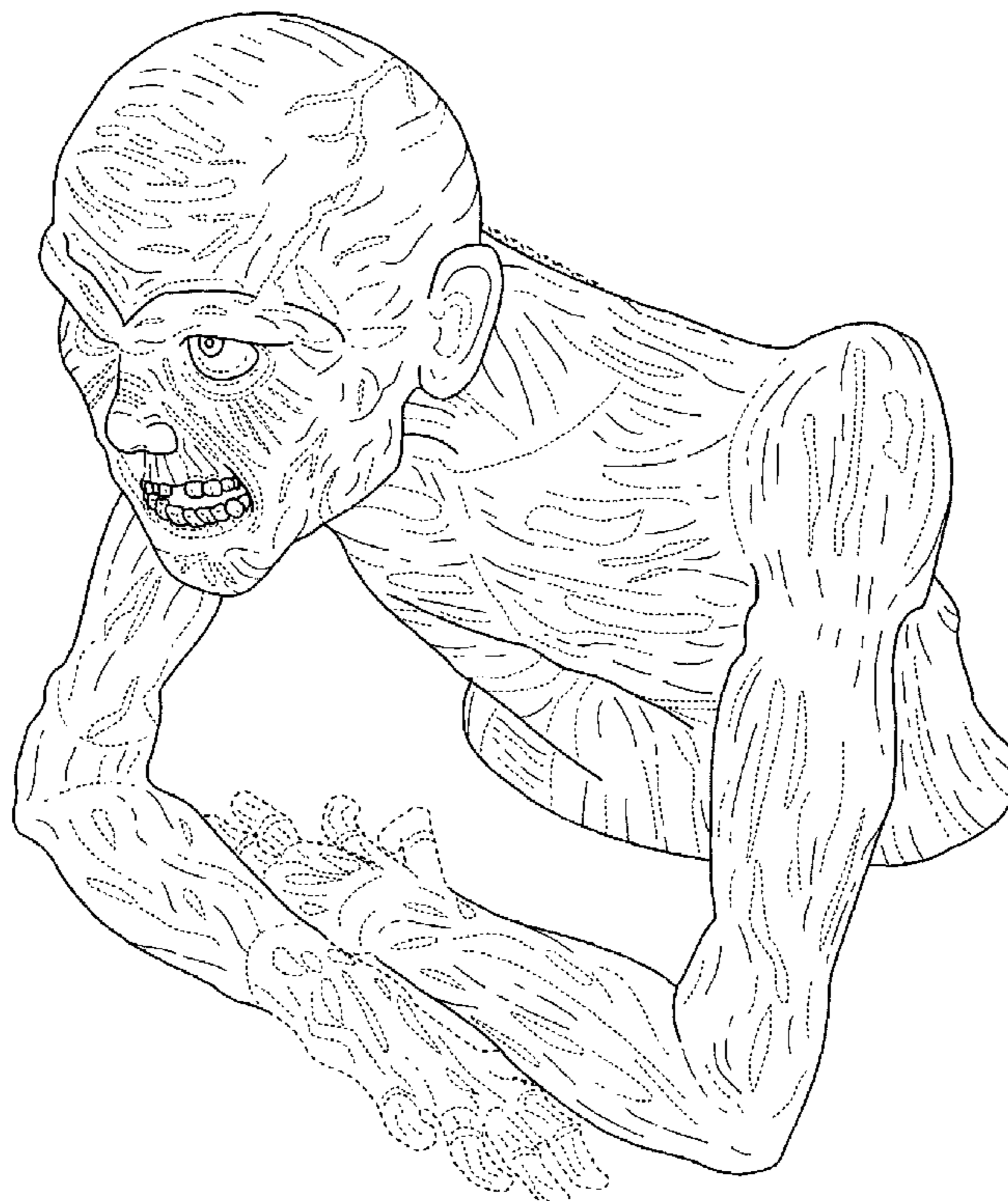

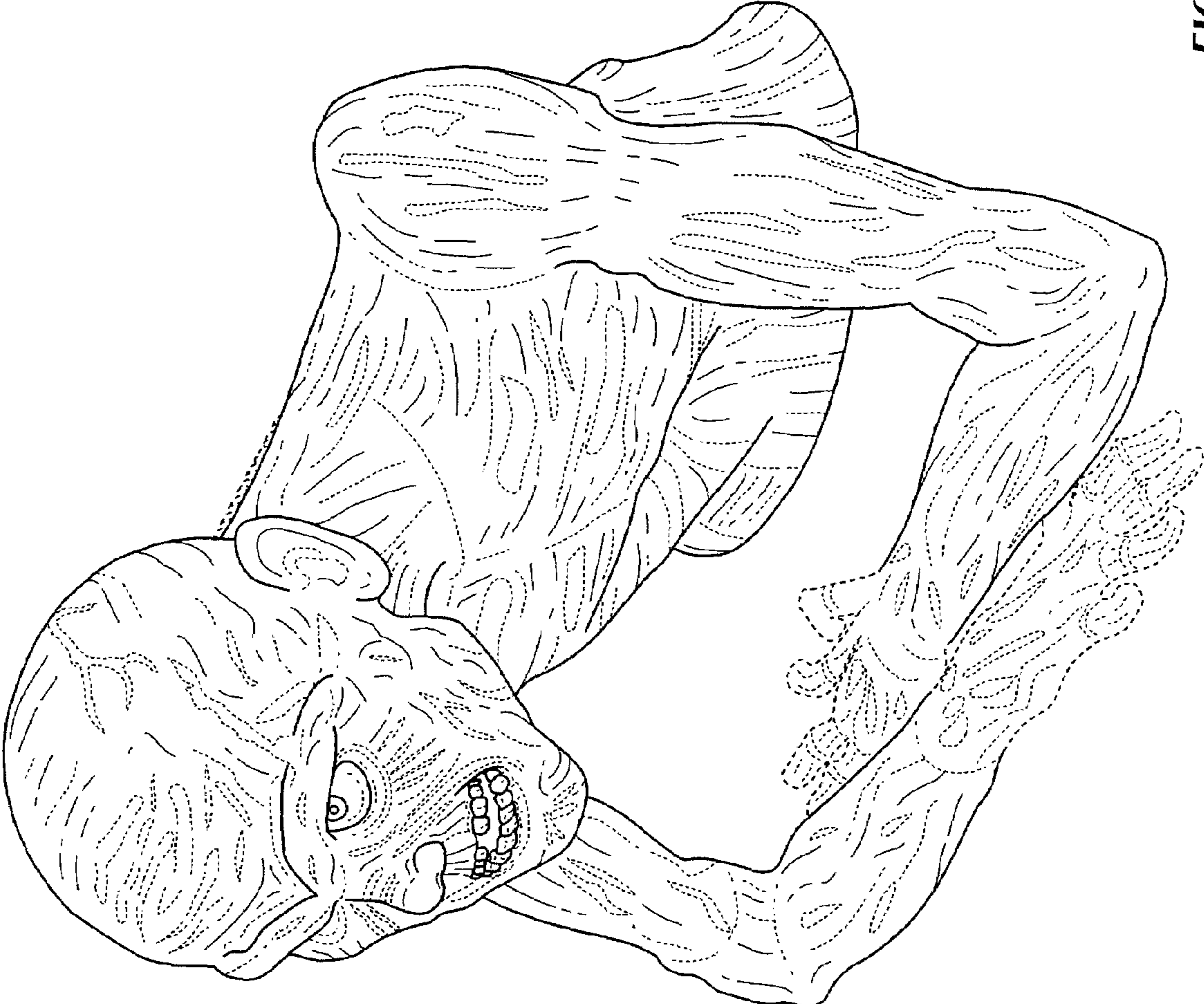

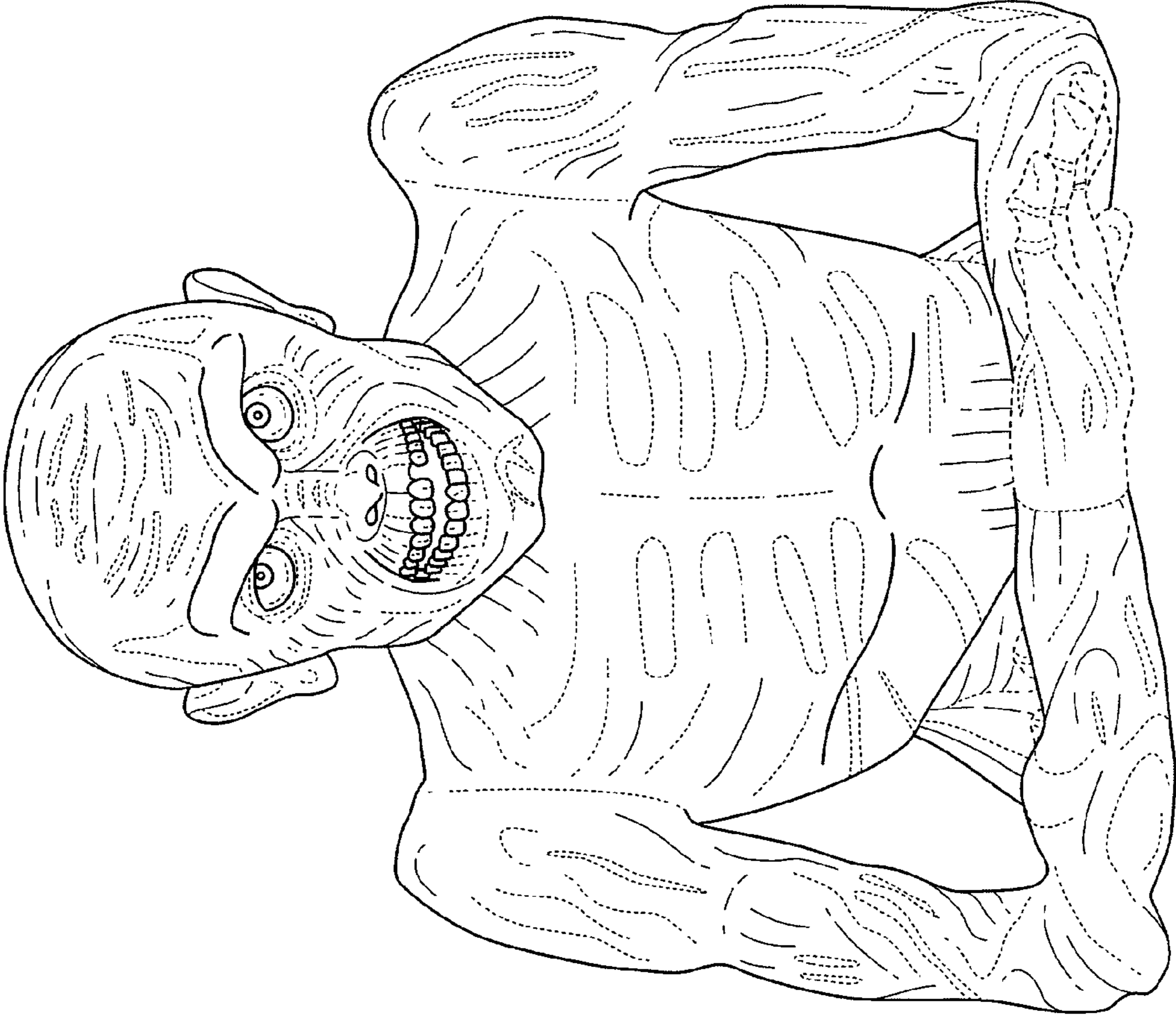

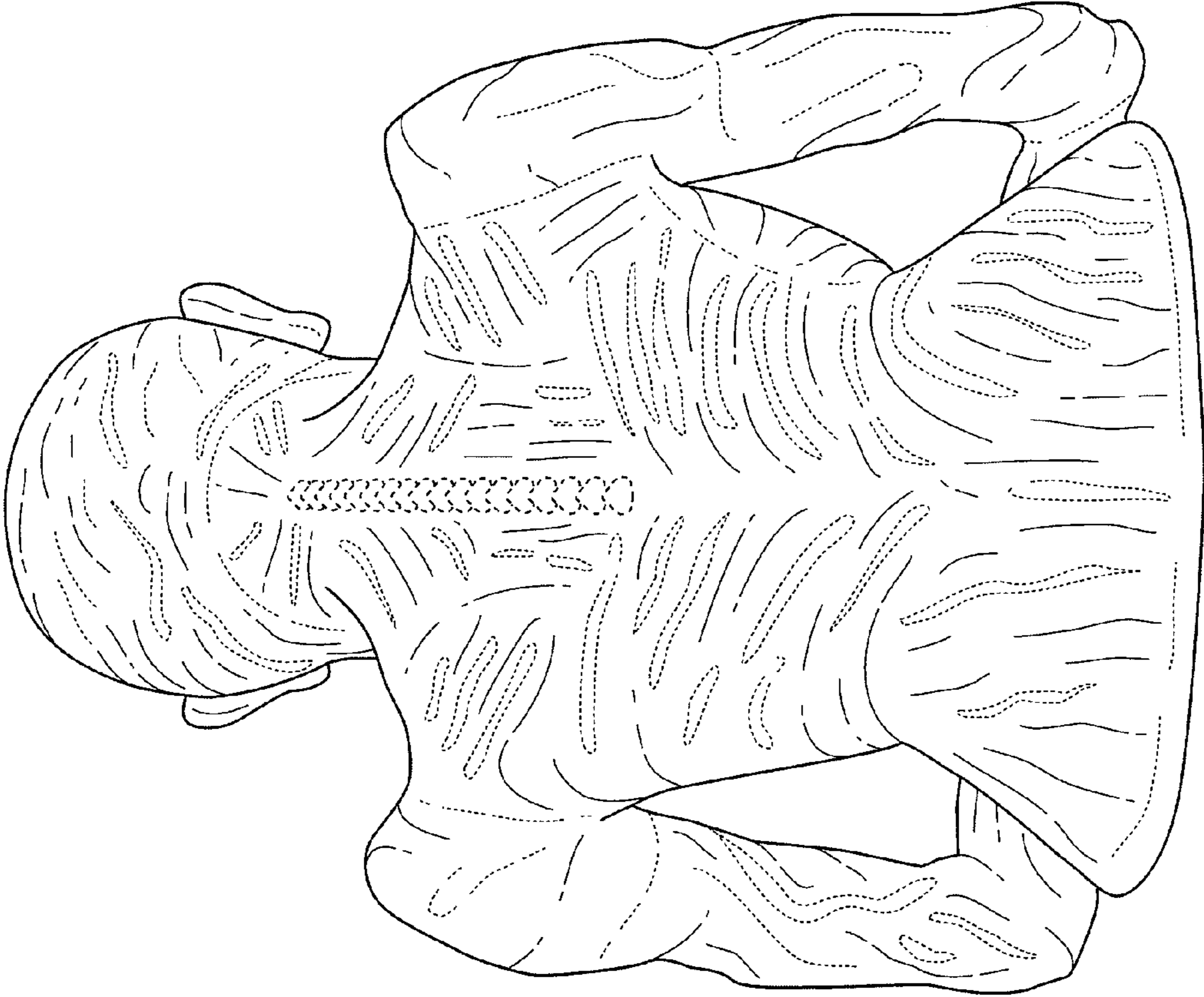

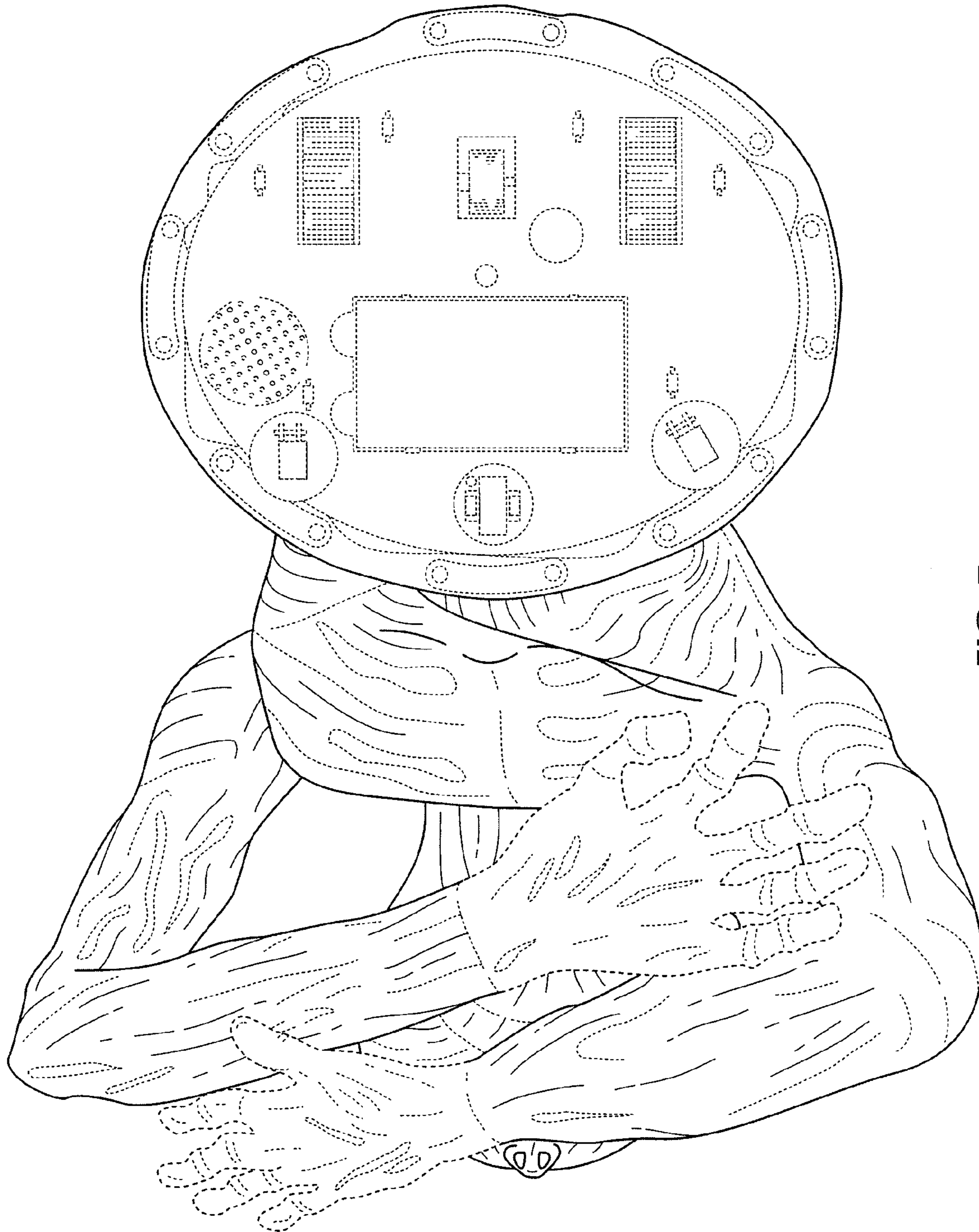
