FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a short scarf with Velcro fasteners, showing my new design, as worn by a person in one configuration;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the invention, illustrated without the person;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the invention, shown in a flat configuration;

FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view of the invention, shown in the flat configuration, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the invention, shown in the flat configuration;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the invention, shown in the flat configuration; and,

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the invention, shown as worn by a person in an alternate configuration.

The broken line showing a person in FIGS. 1 and 7 is included for the purpose of illustrating the invention in use, and forms no part of the claimed design.

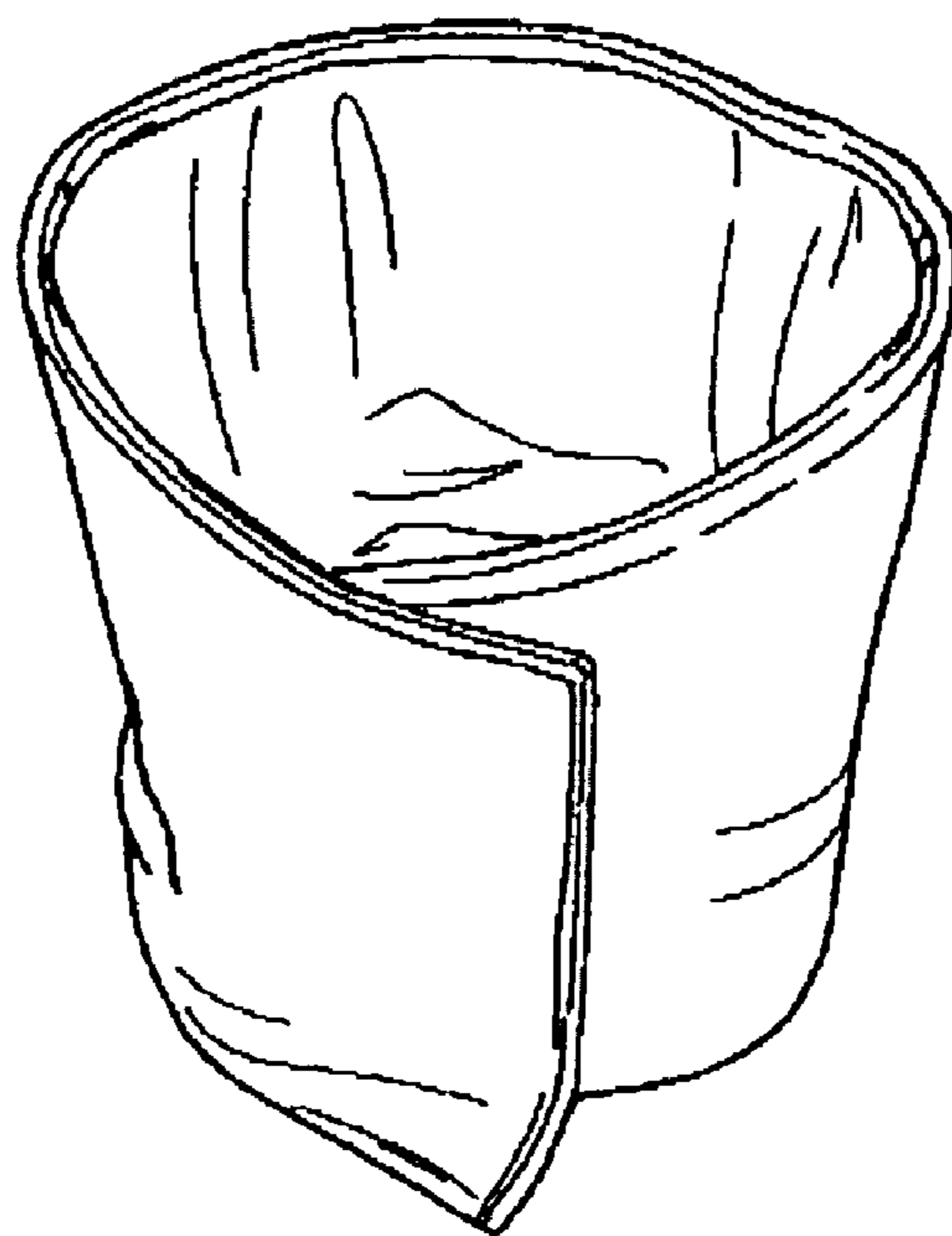

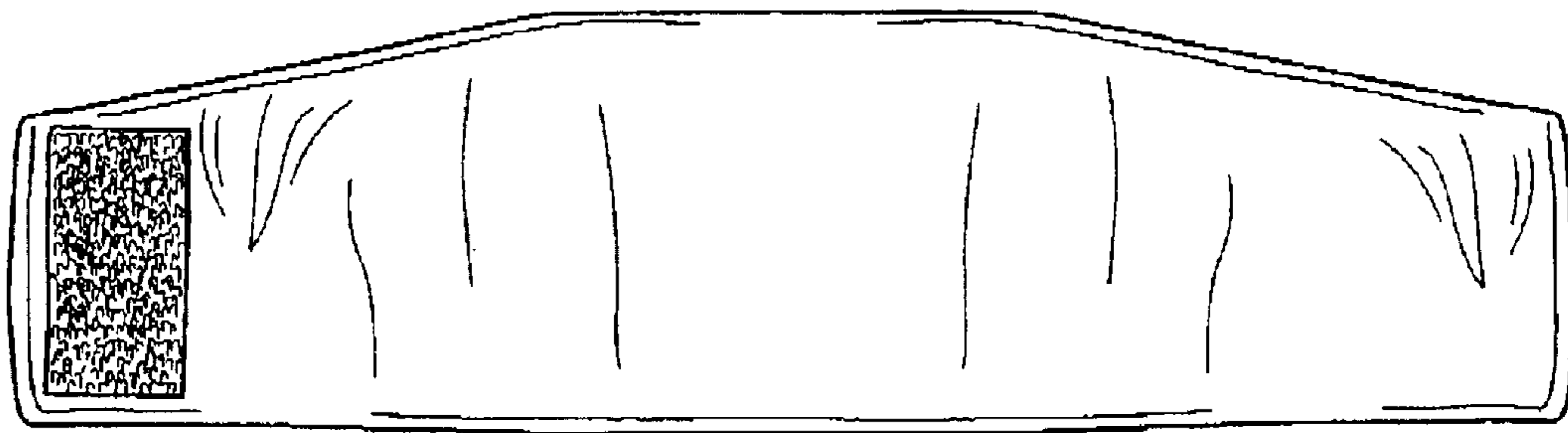

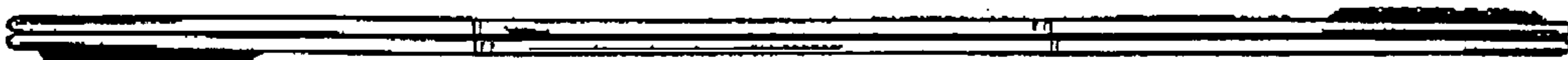

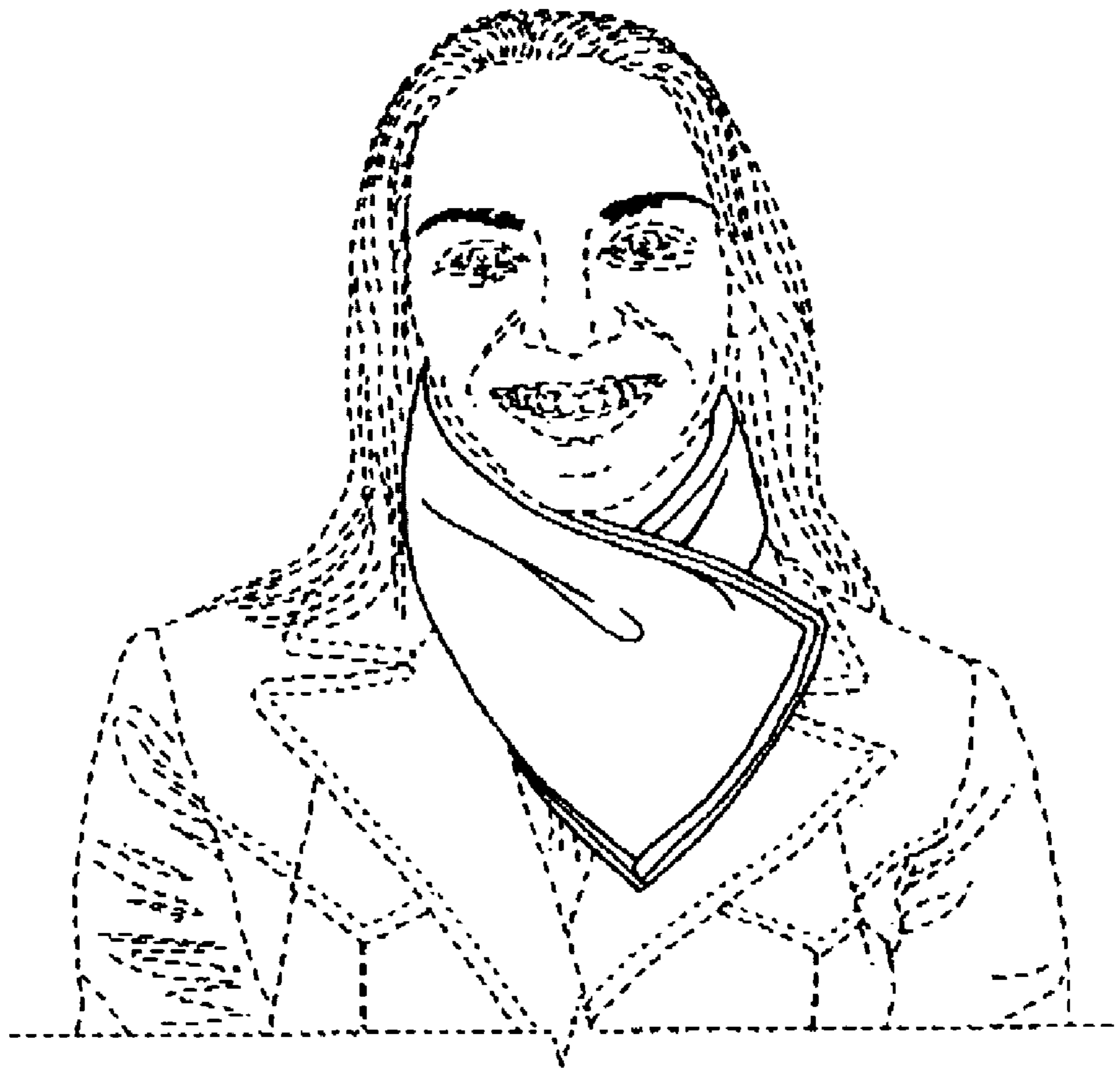
