FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the invention;

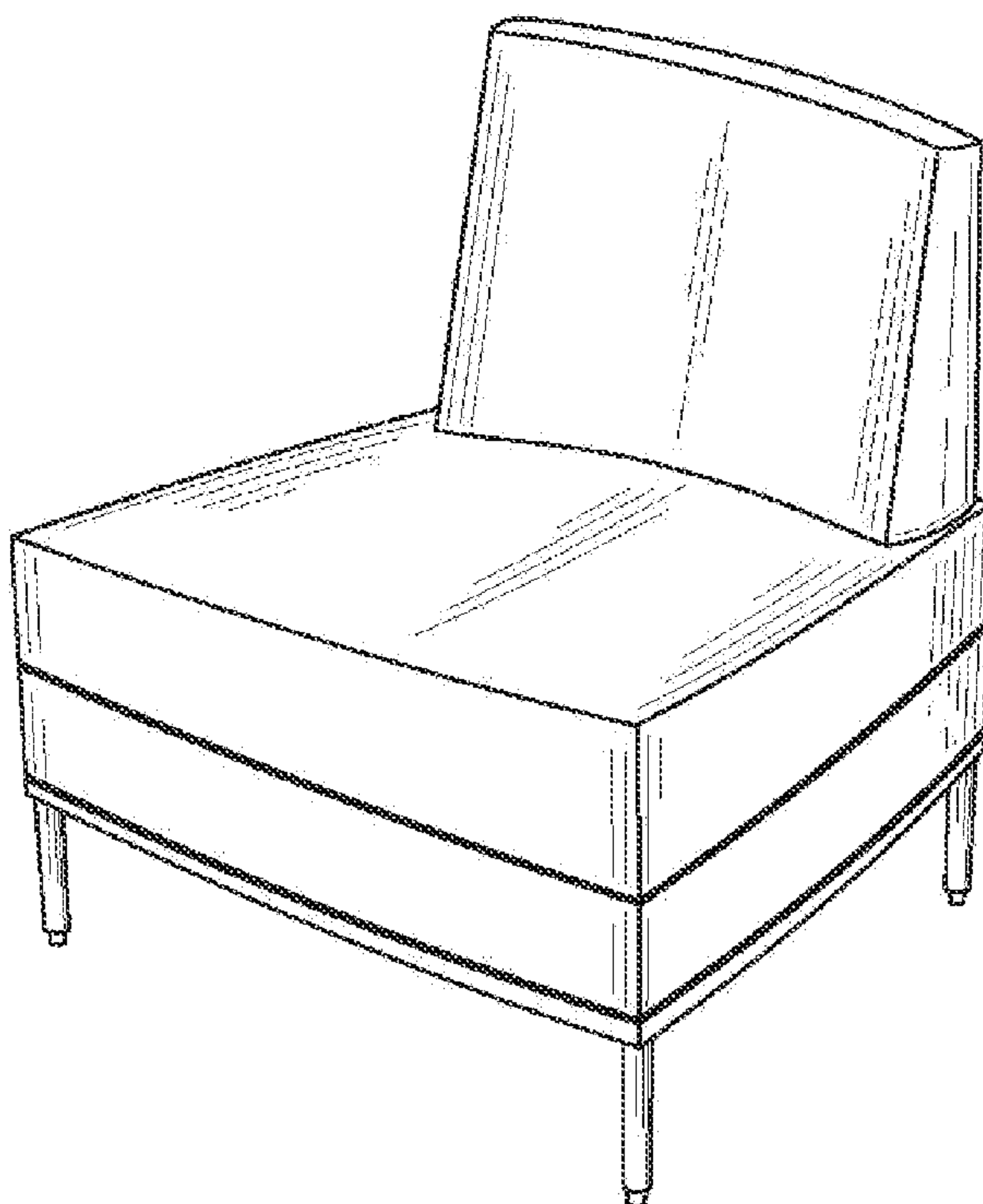
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the invention;

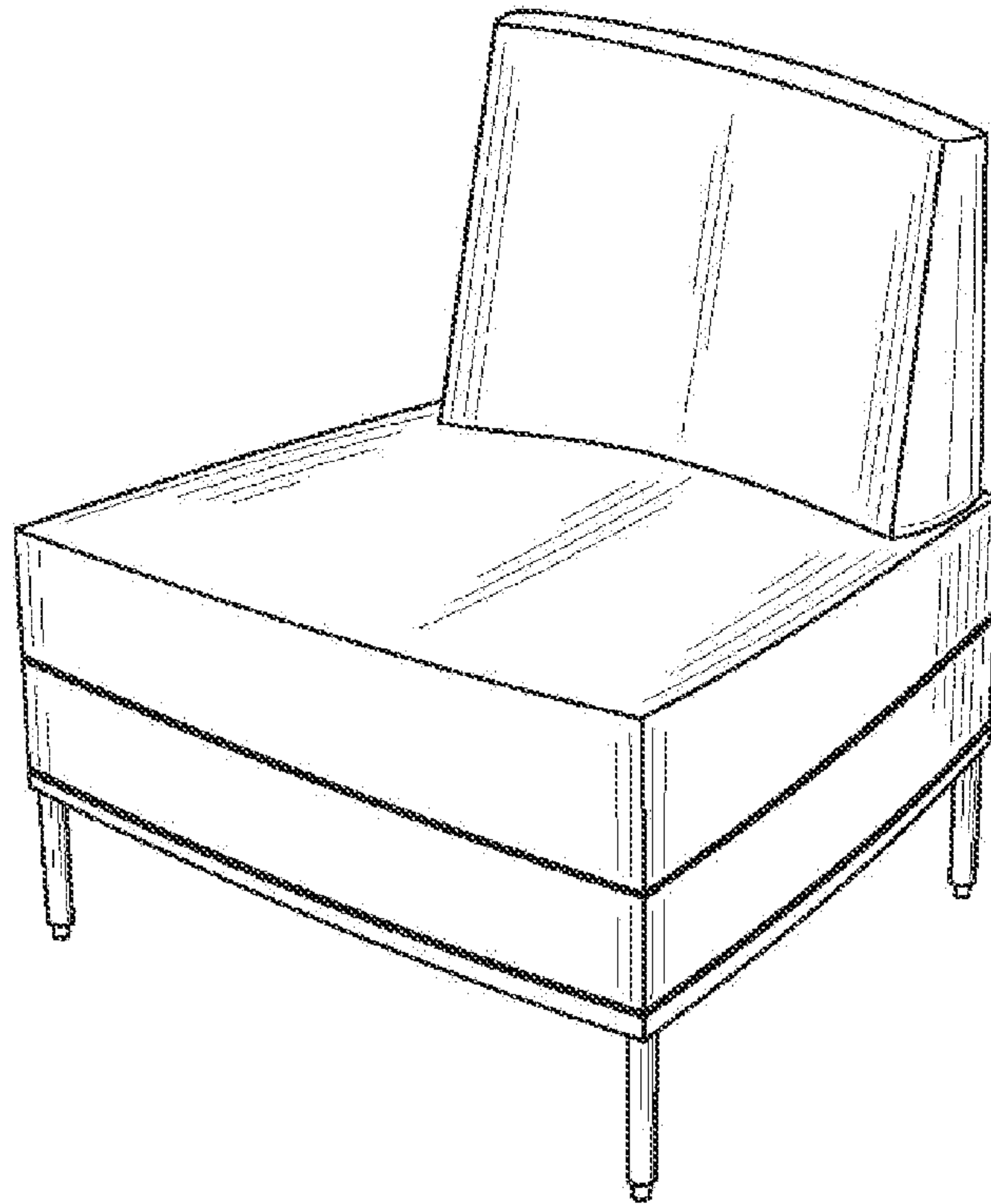

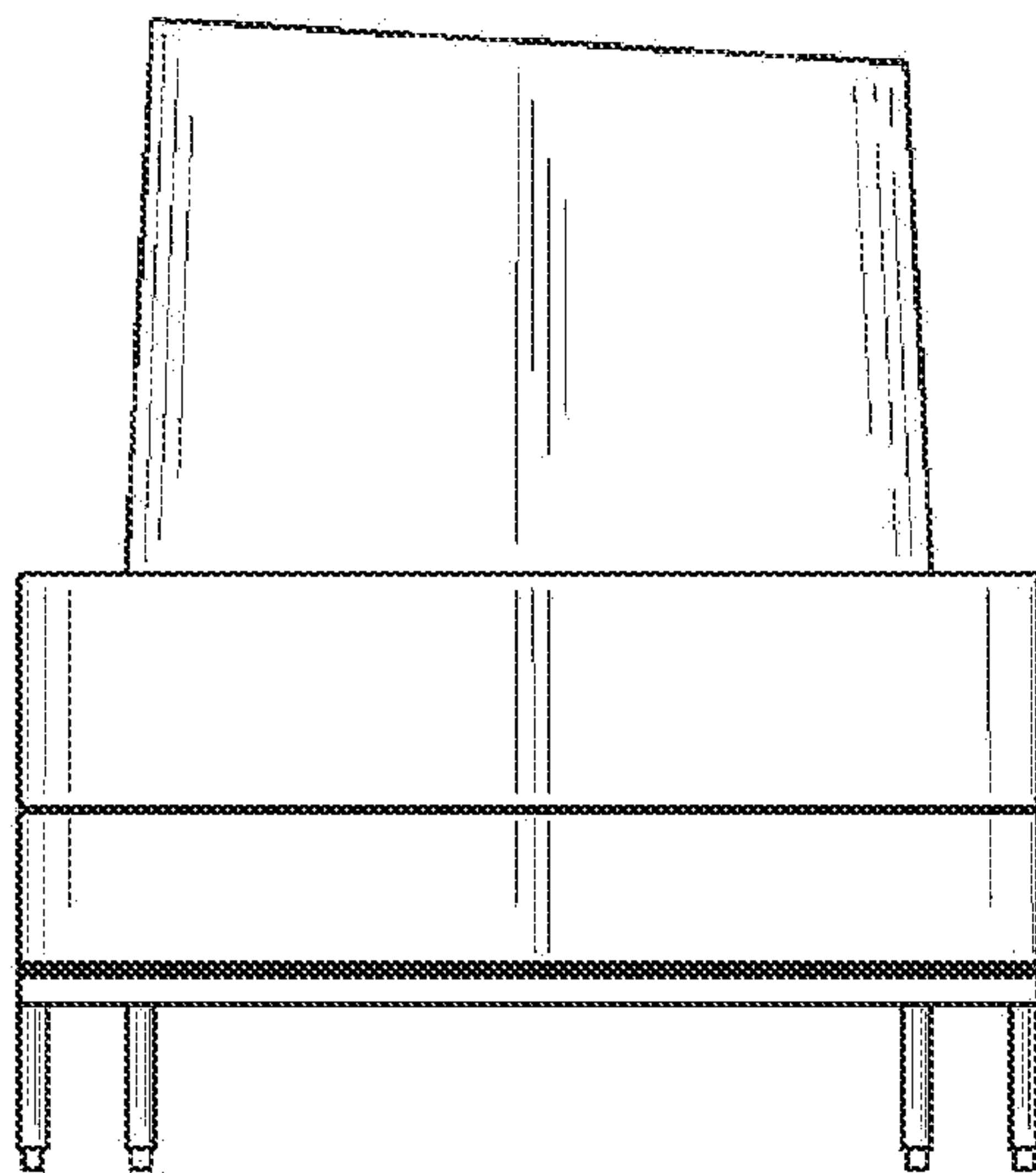

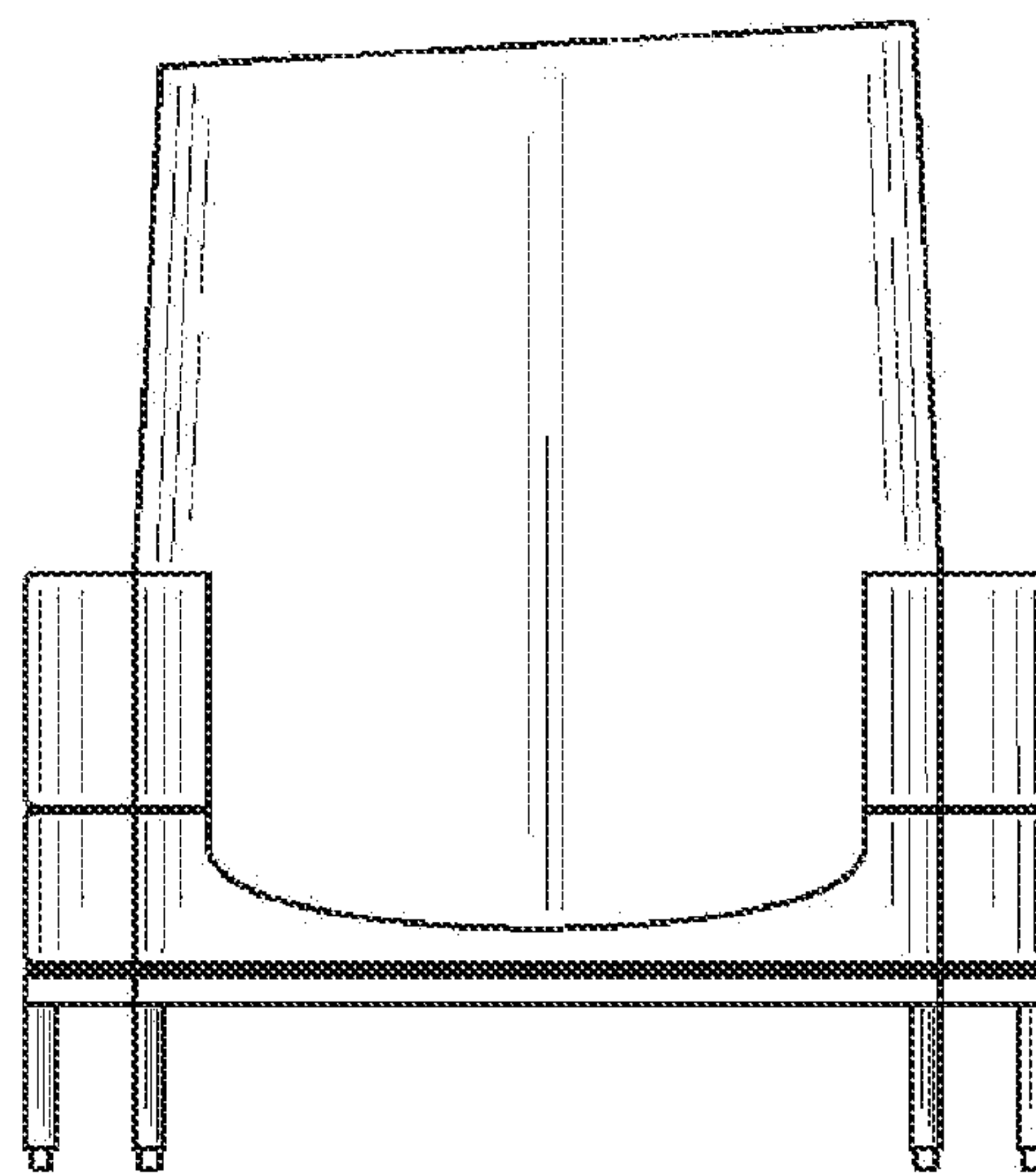

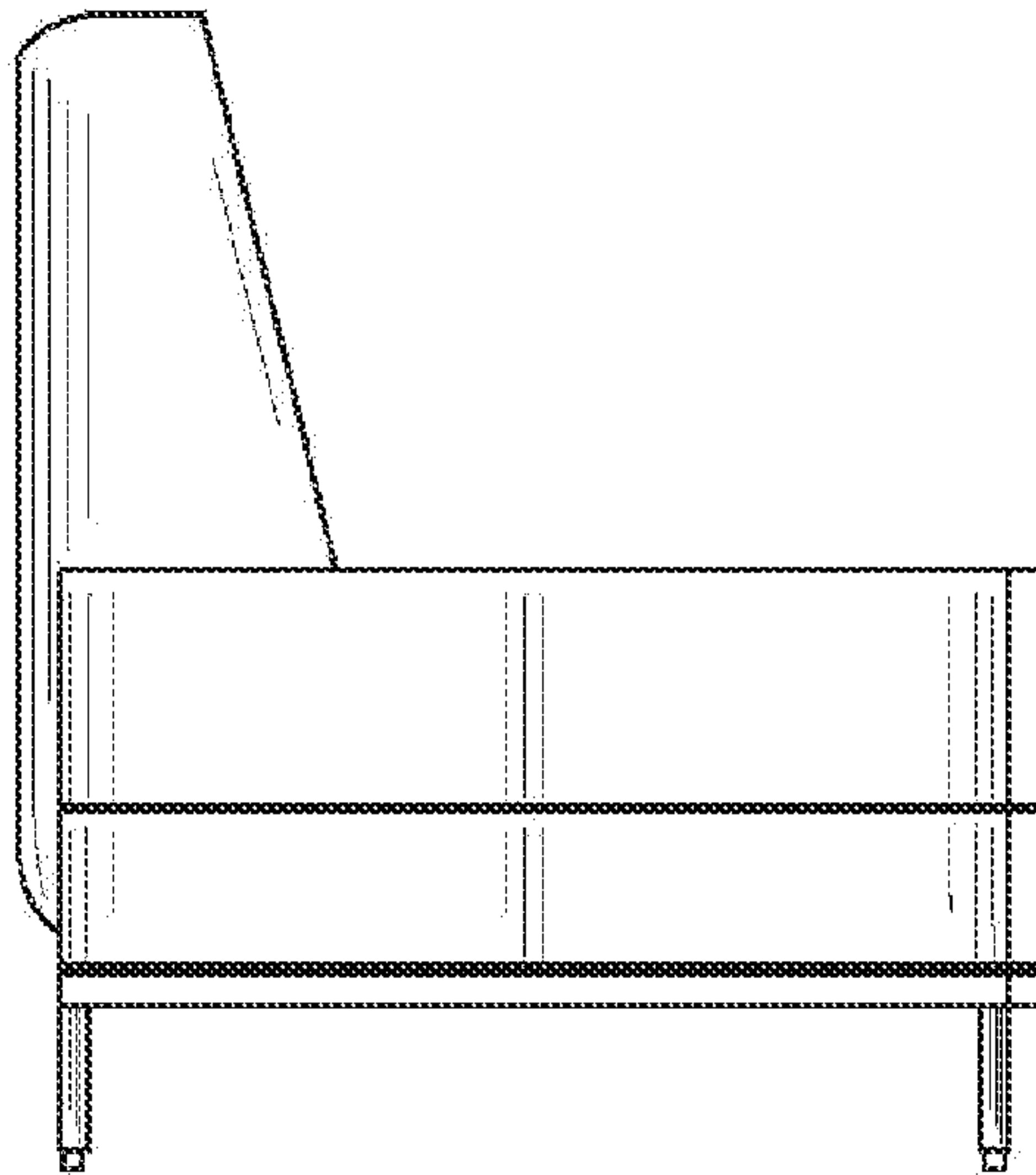

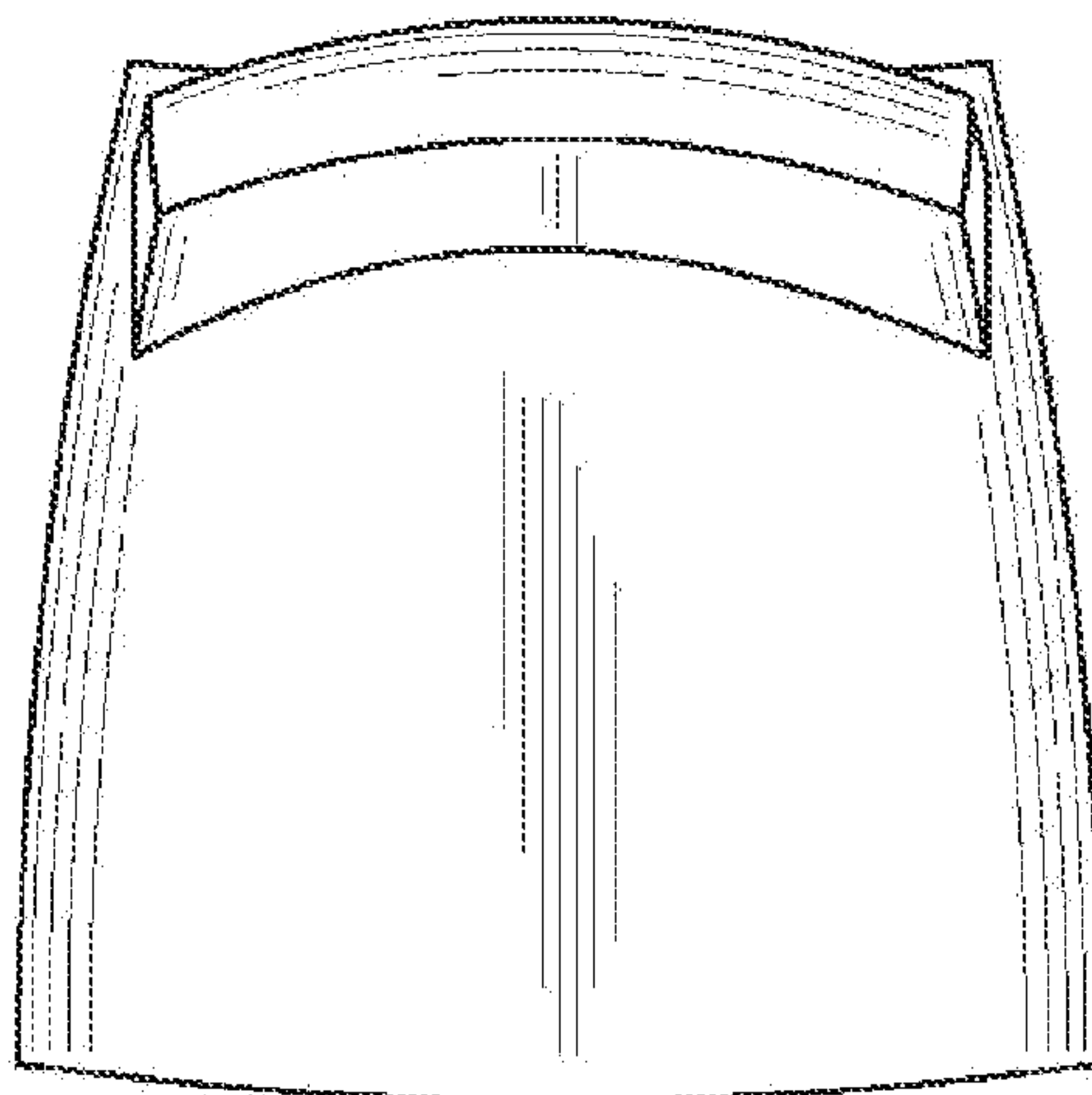

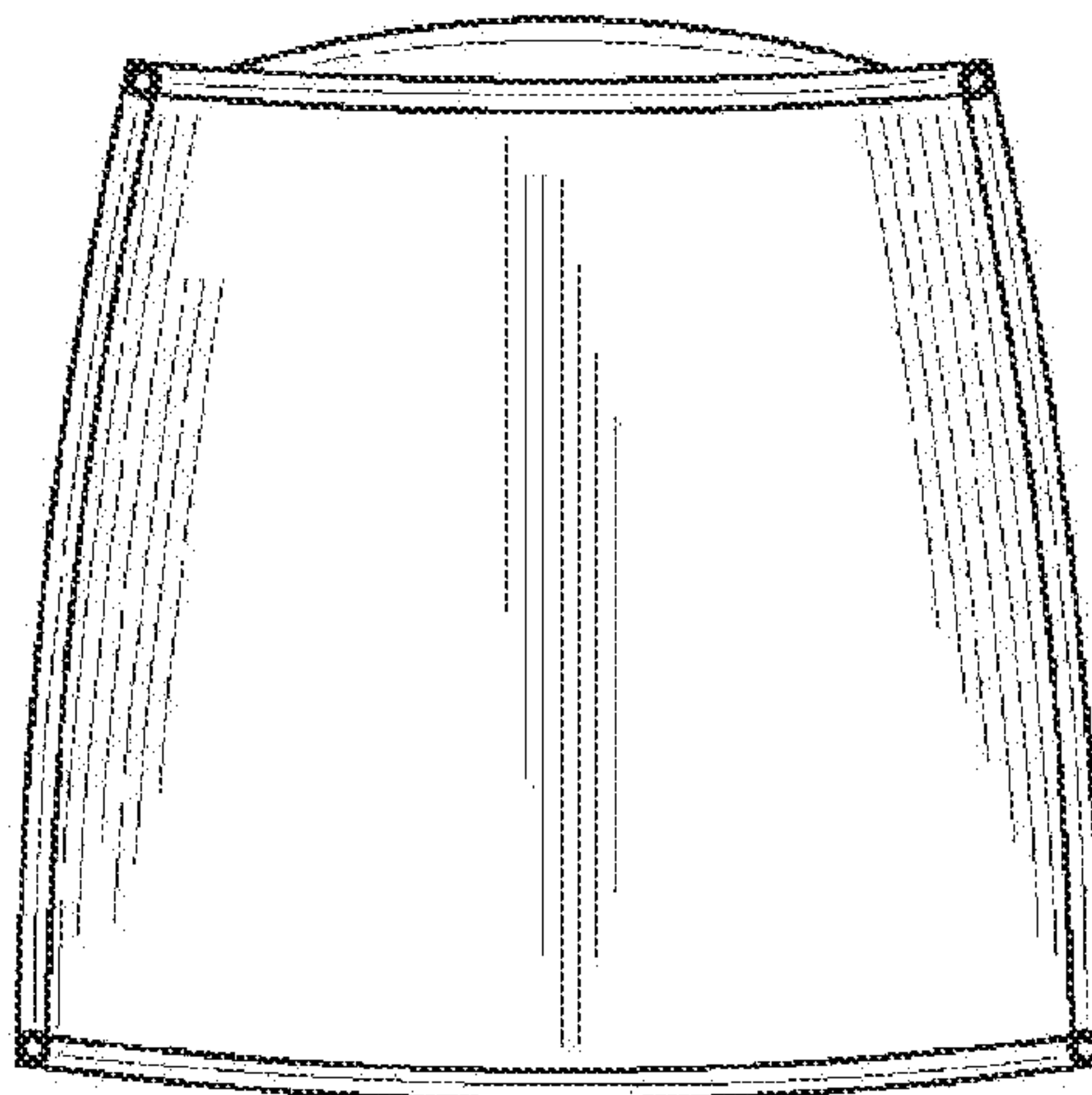
