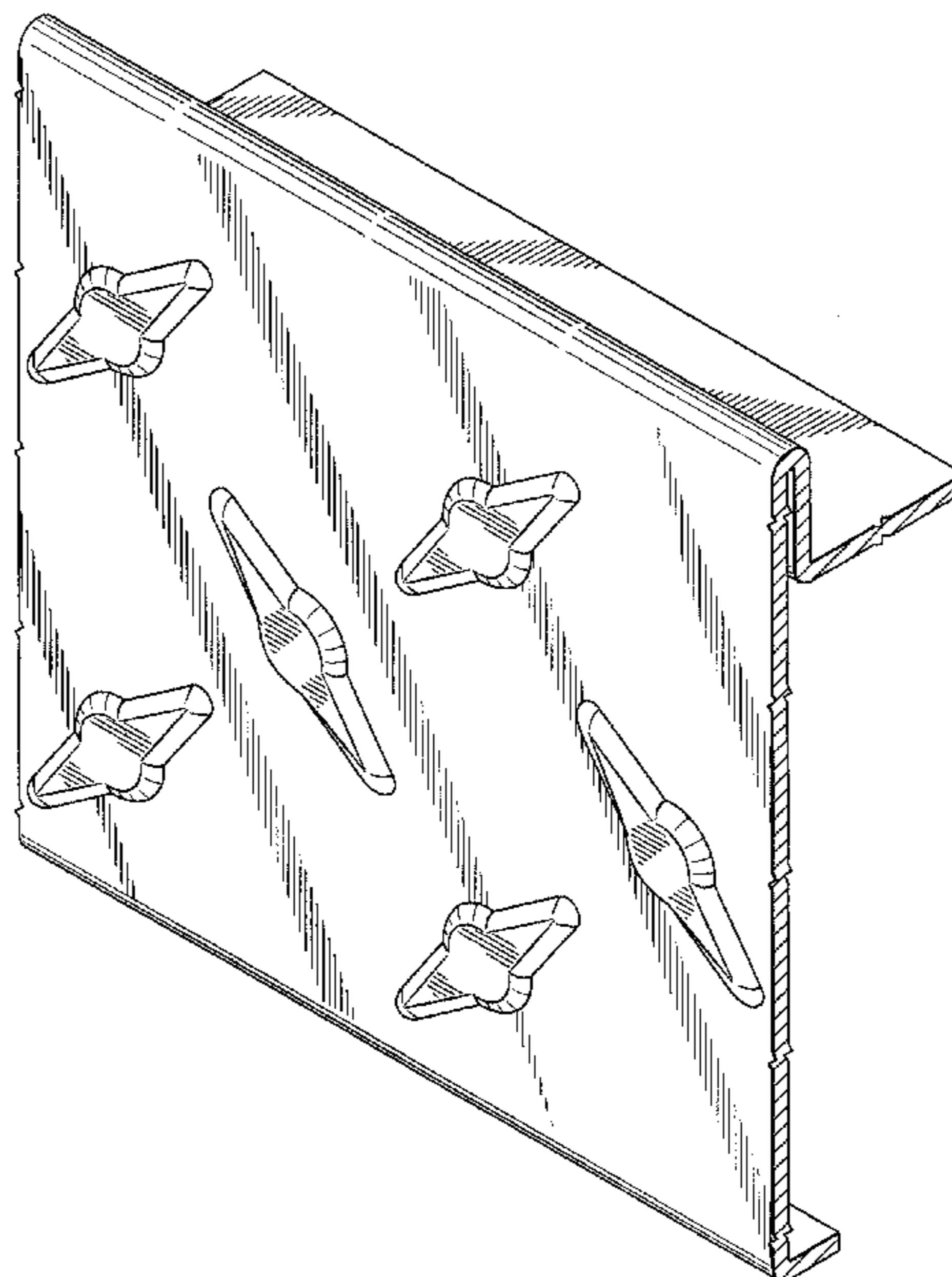
FIG. 7 is a top view of the design of FIG. 1; and,

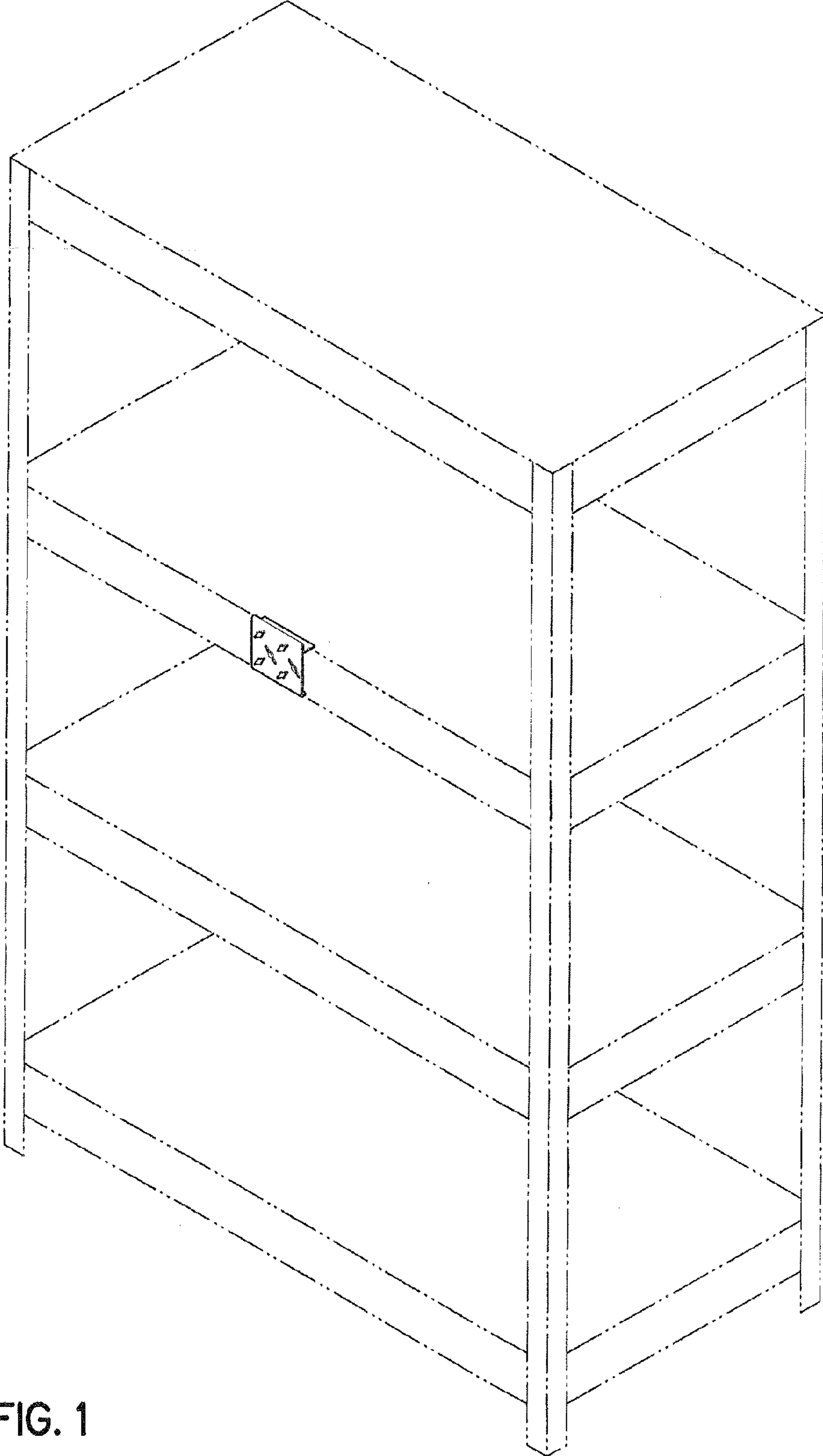

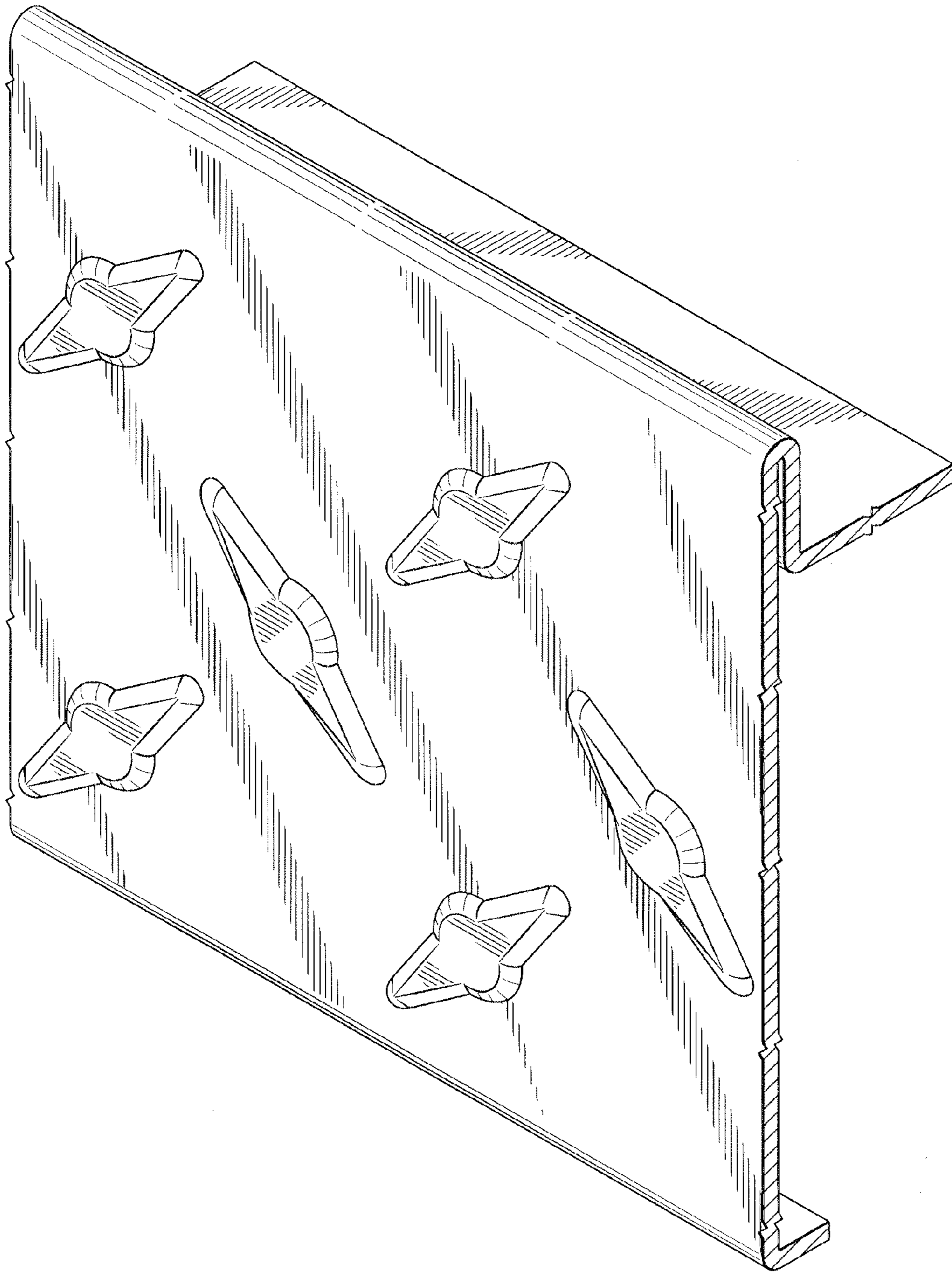

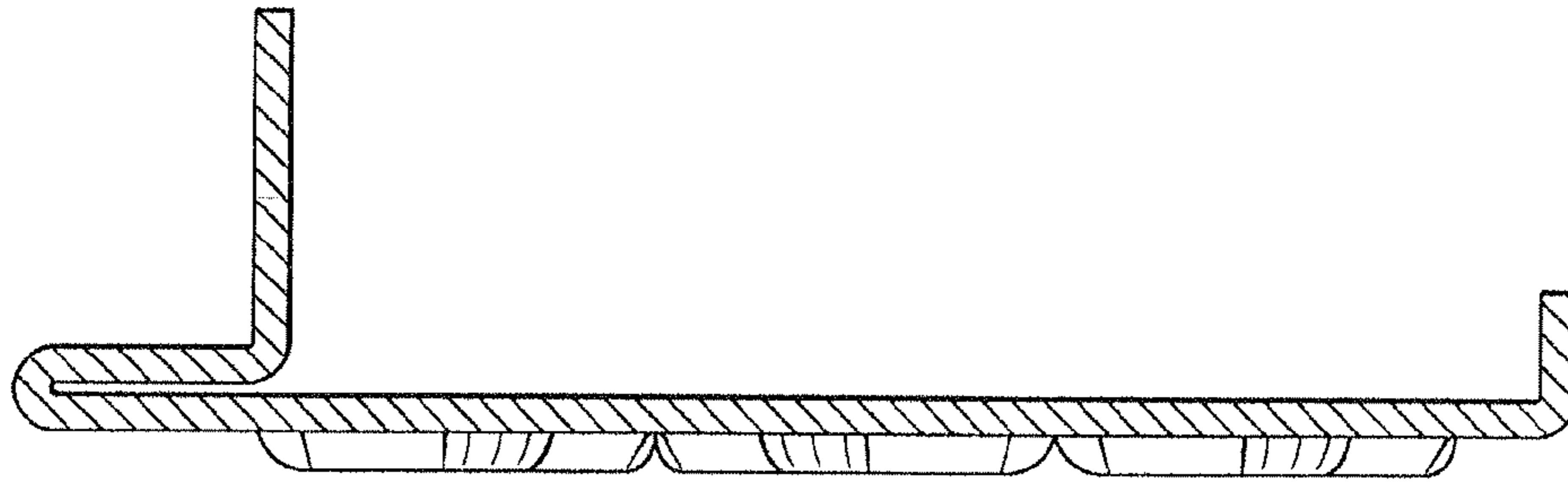

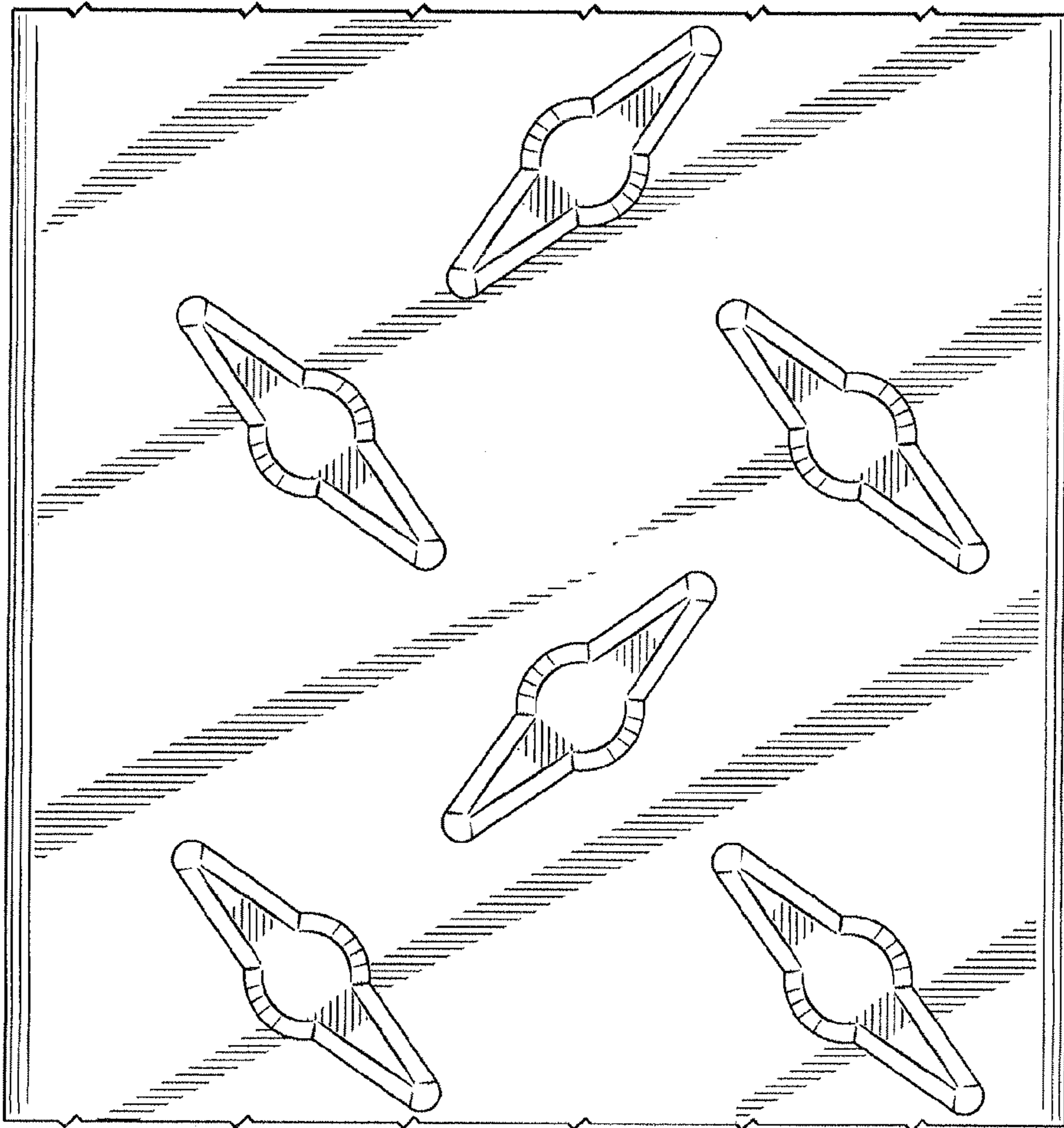

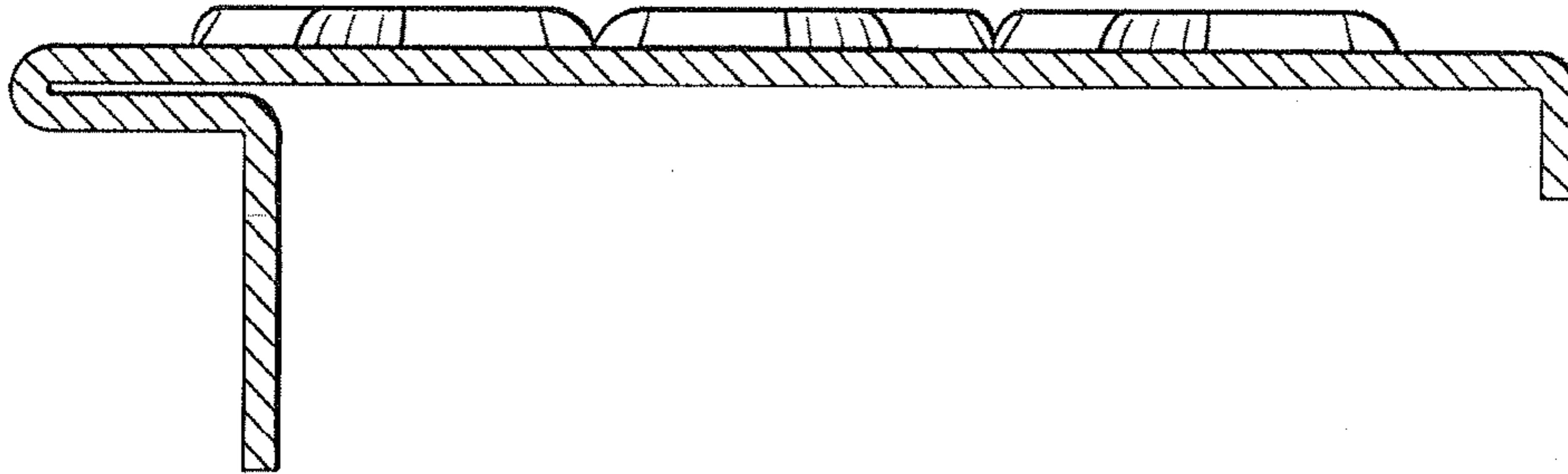

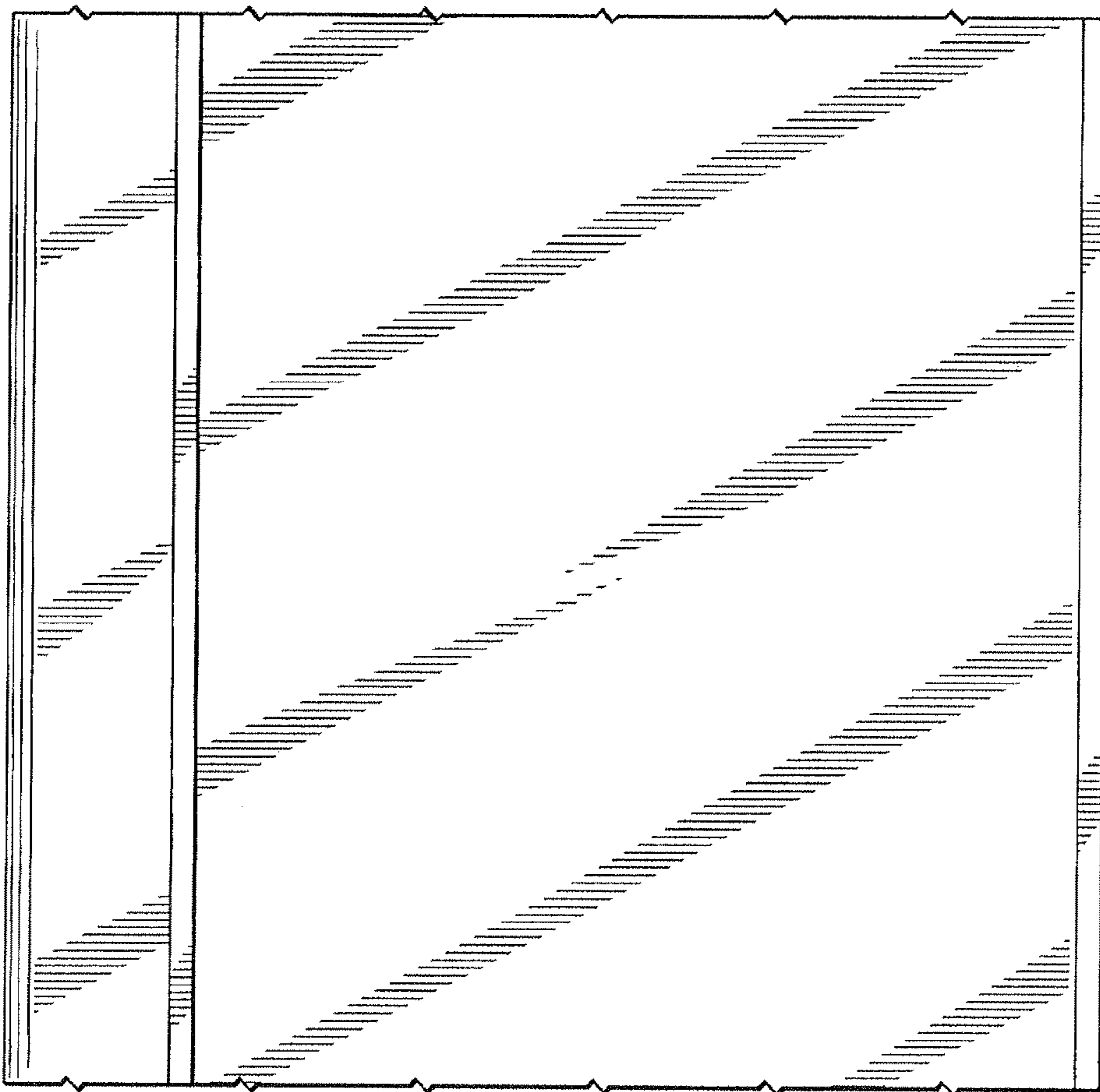

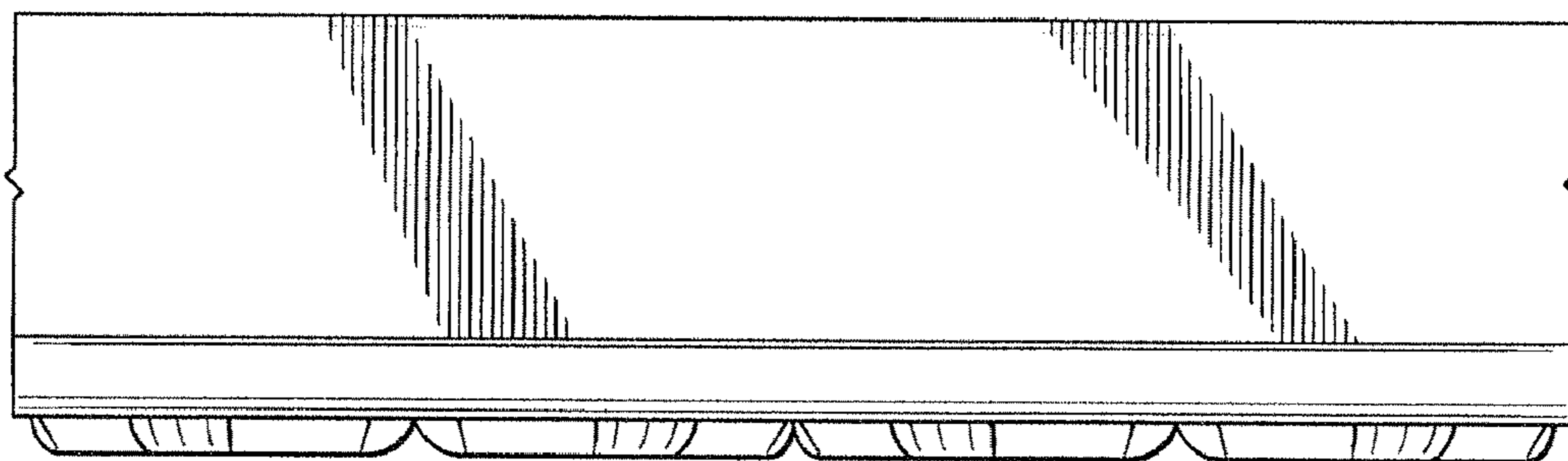

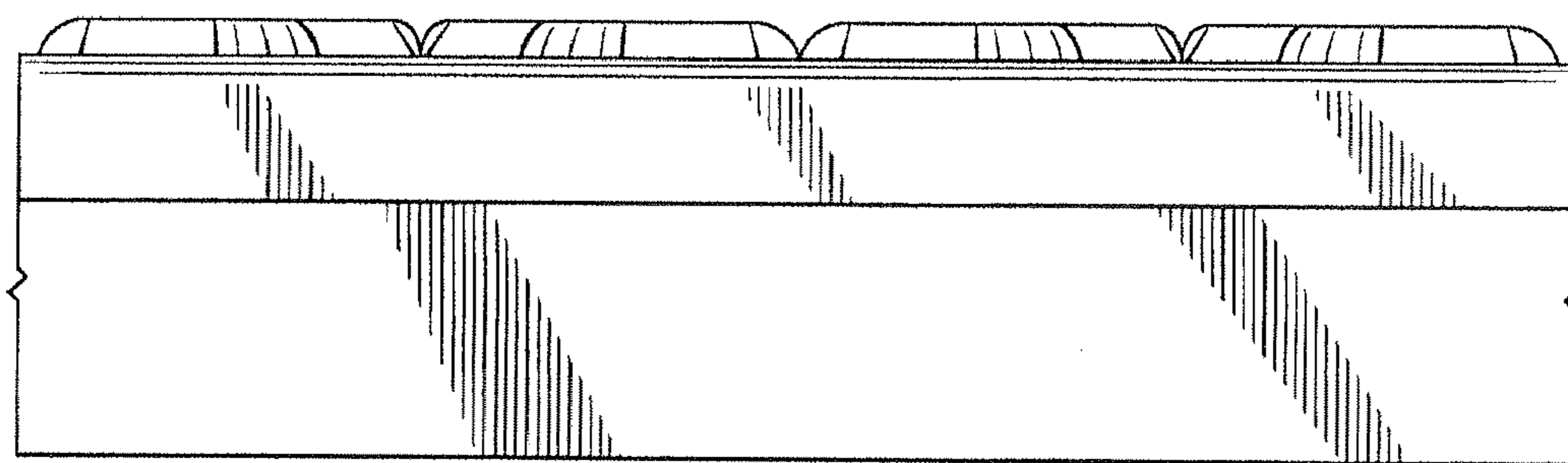
