DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the birdcage in accordance with the present invention, with a separate stand therefor being shown in broken lines;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a left side perspective view of the birdcage;












