DESCRIPTION

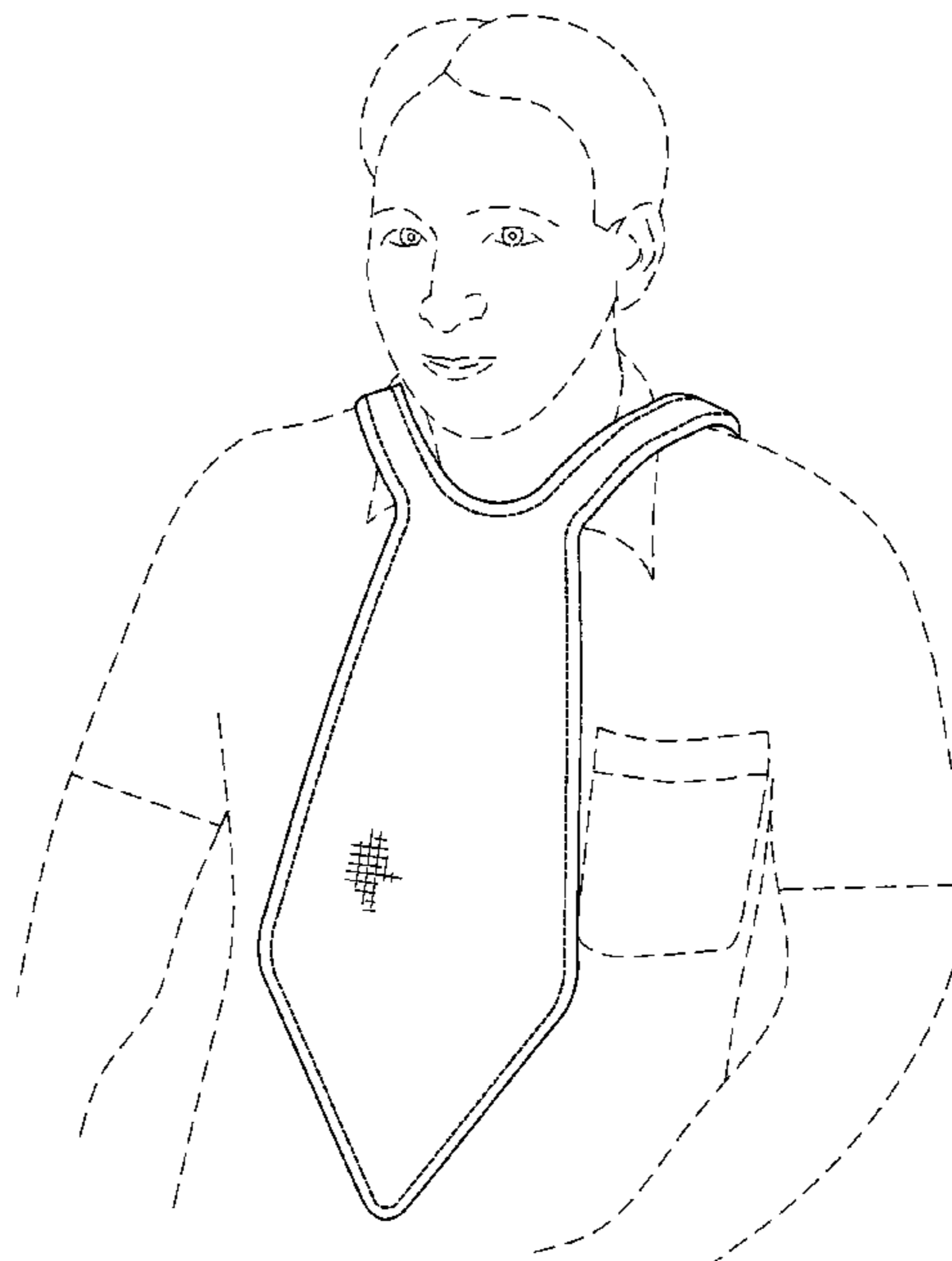
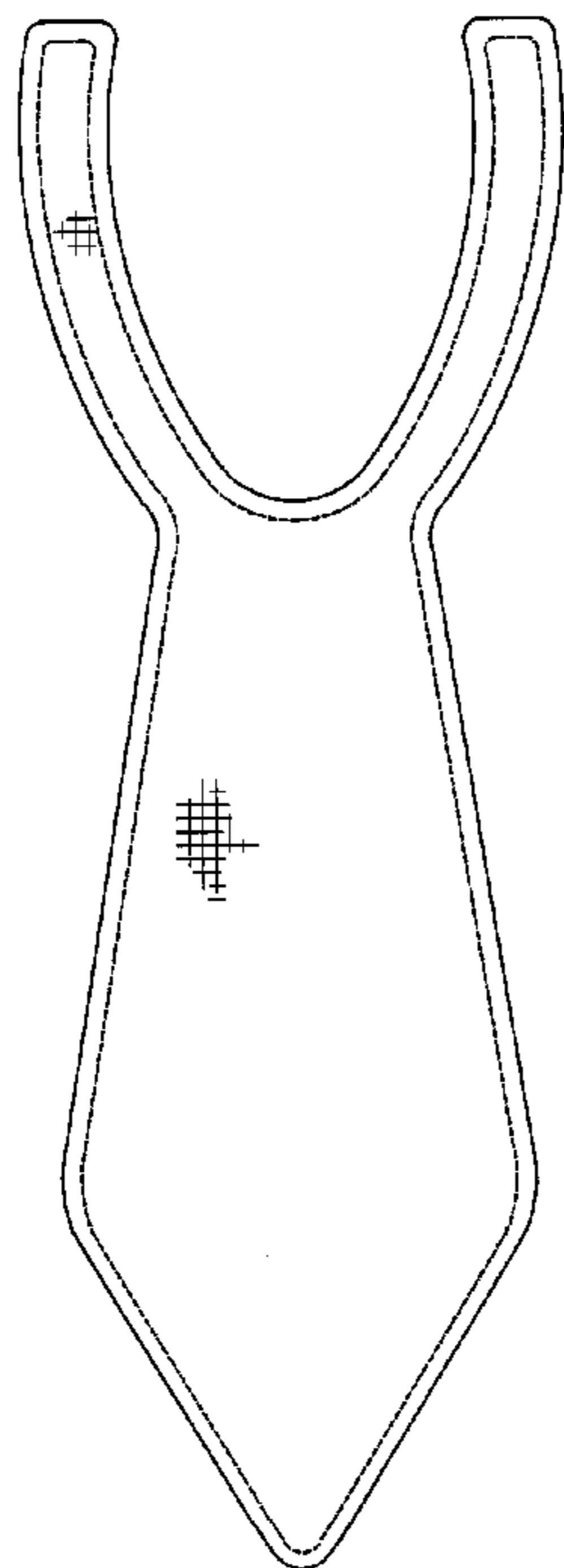
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bib that resembles a tie showing my new design;

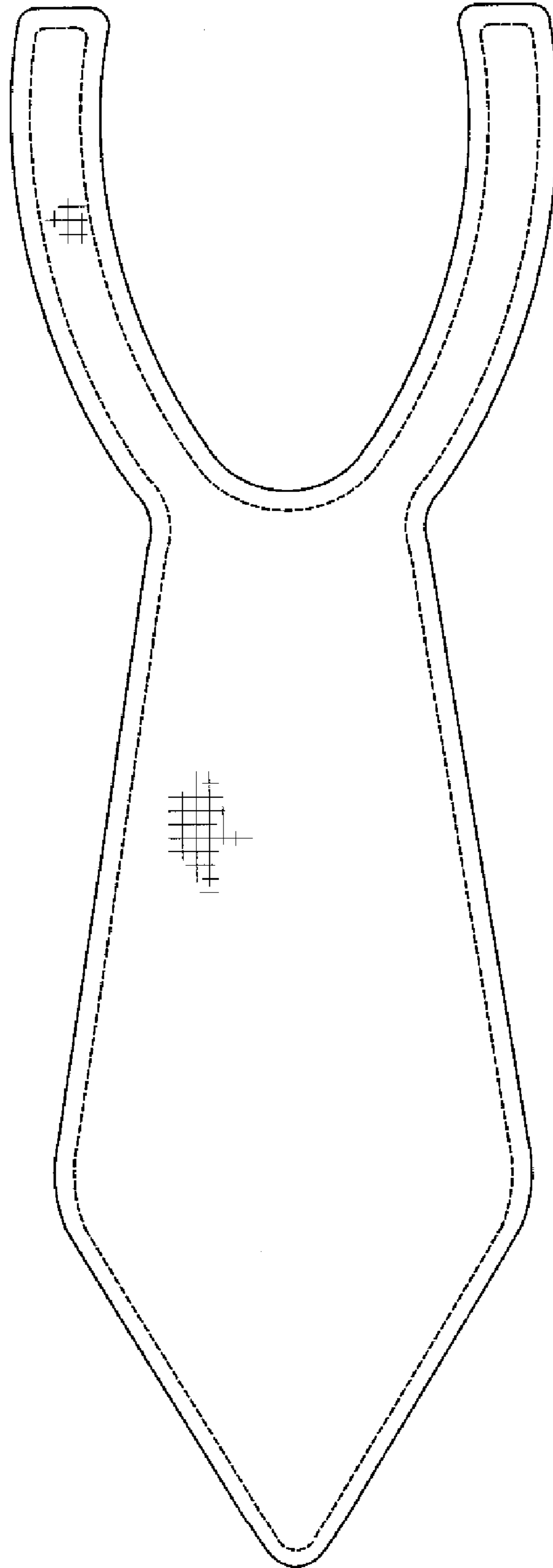

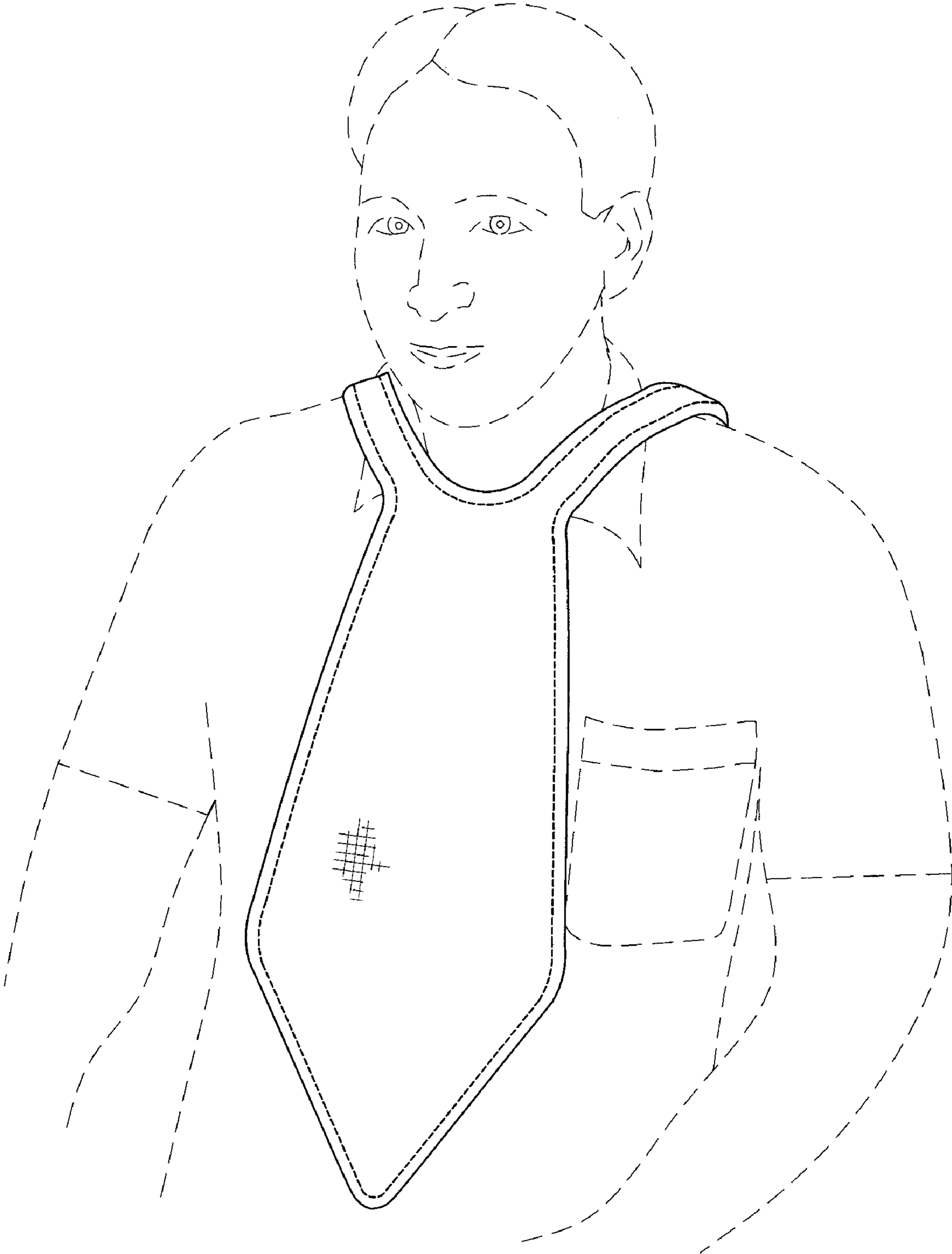

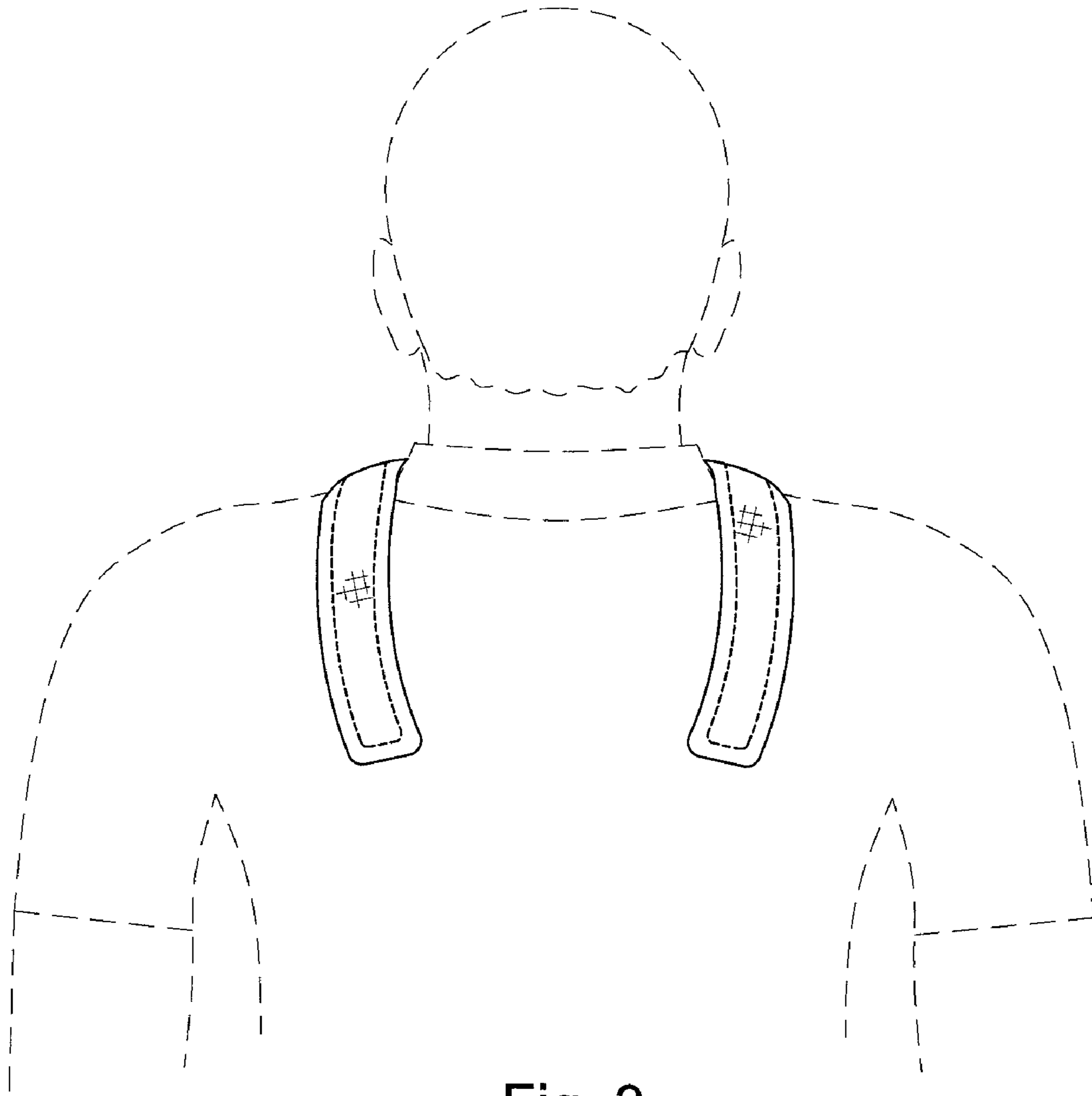
