DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoe sole in accordance
with my new design.

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right elevational view thereof;

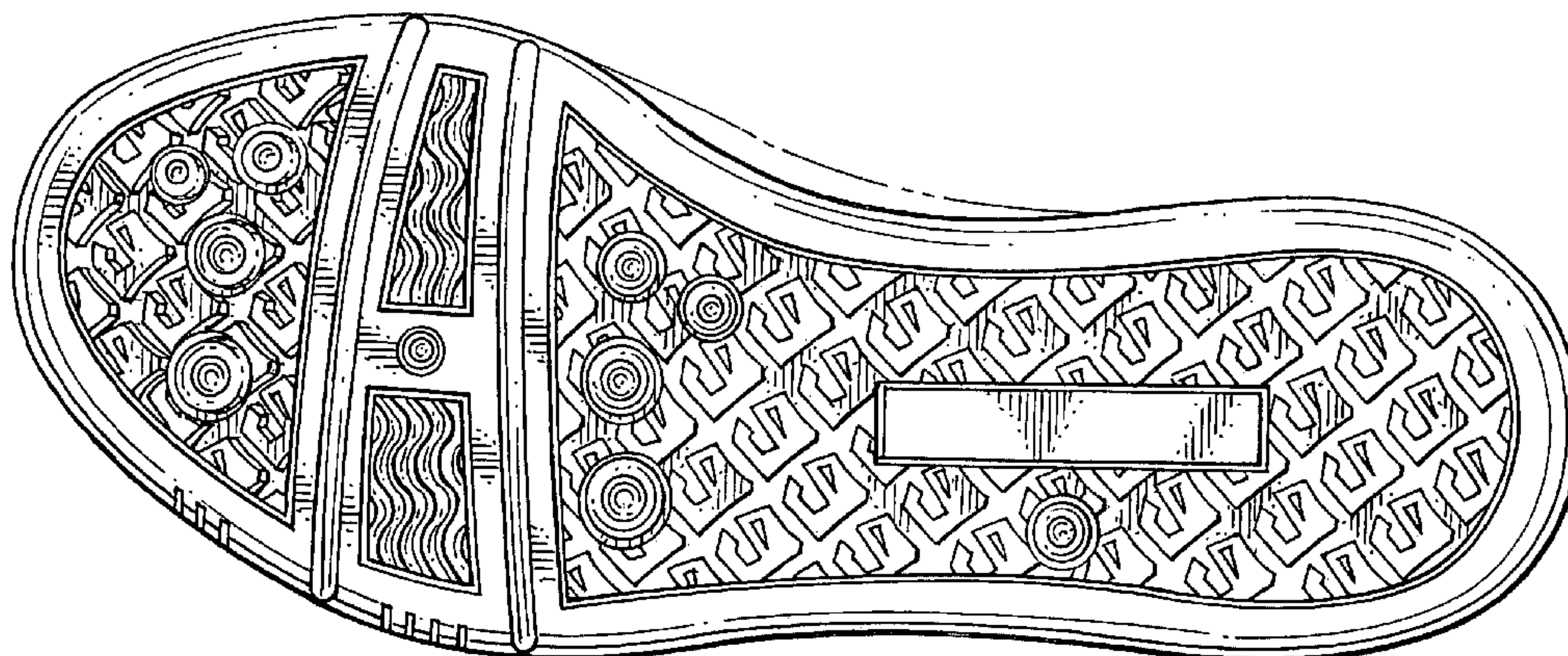
FIG. 4 is a left elevational view thereof;

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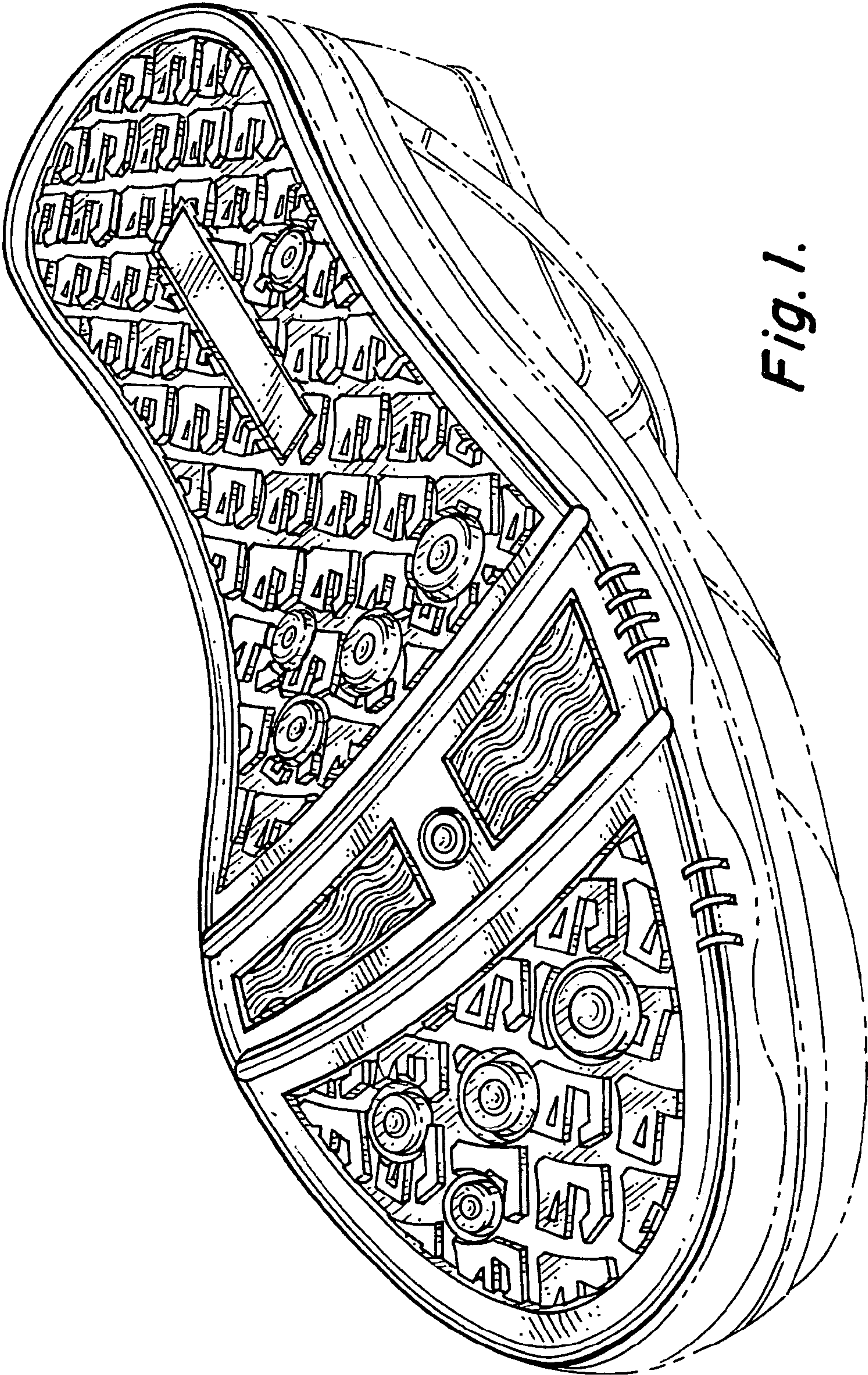

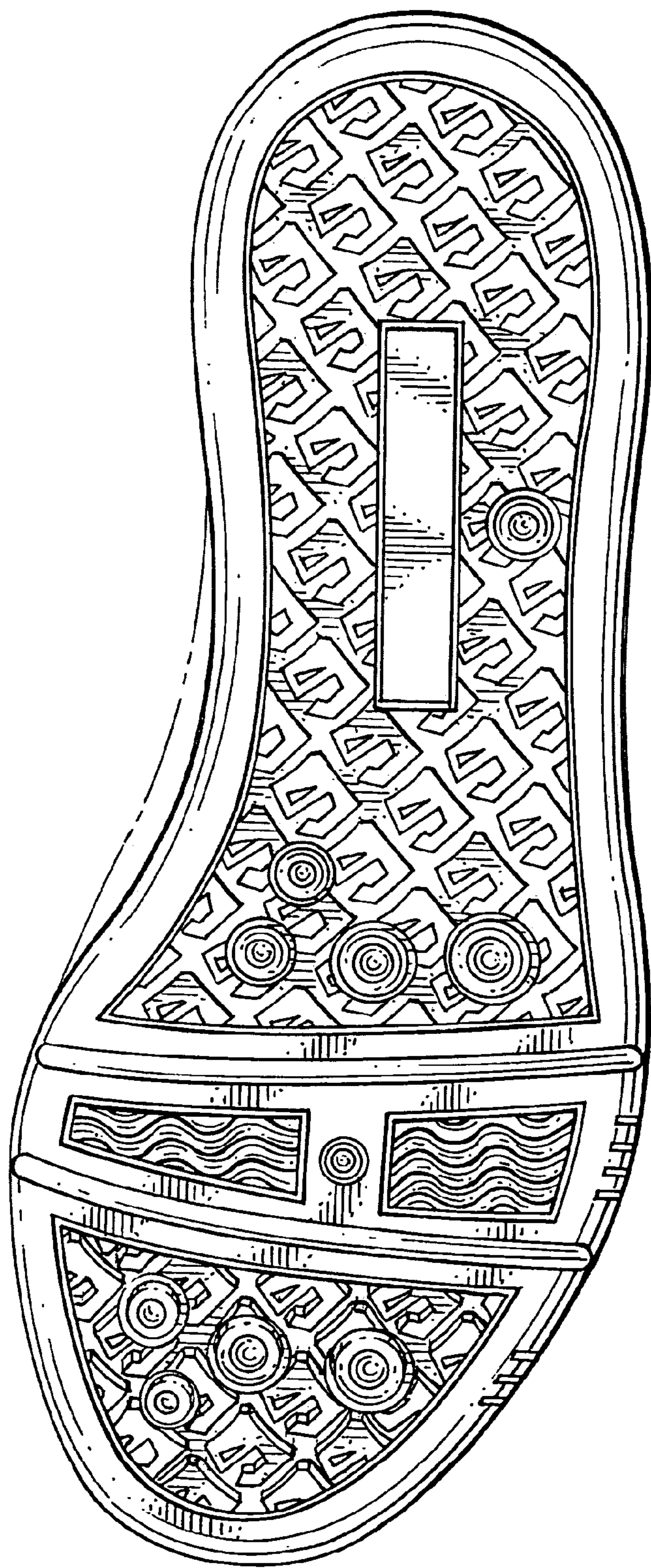

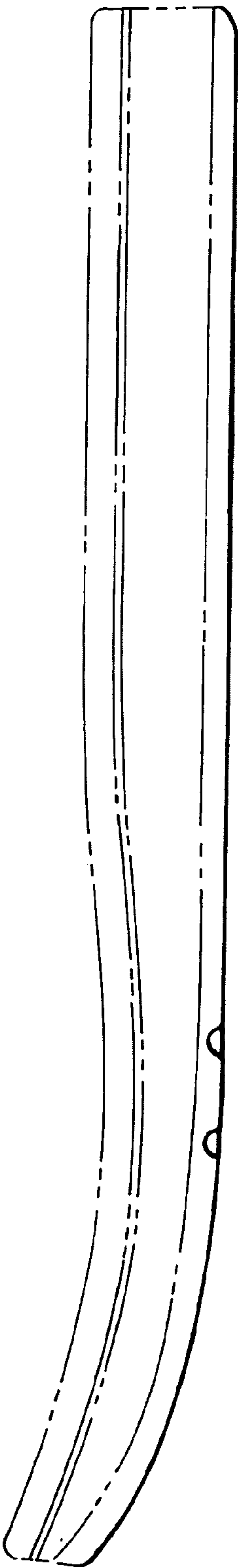

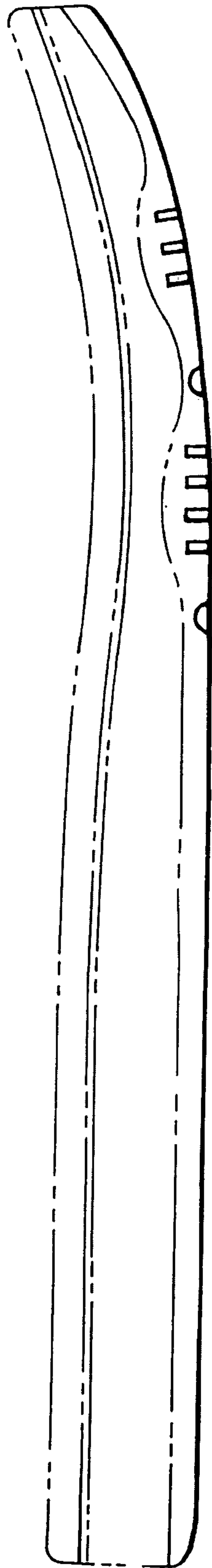

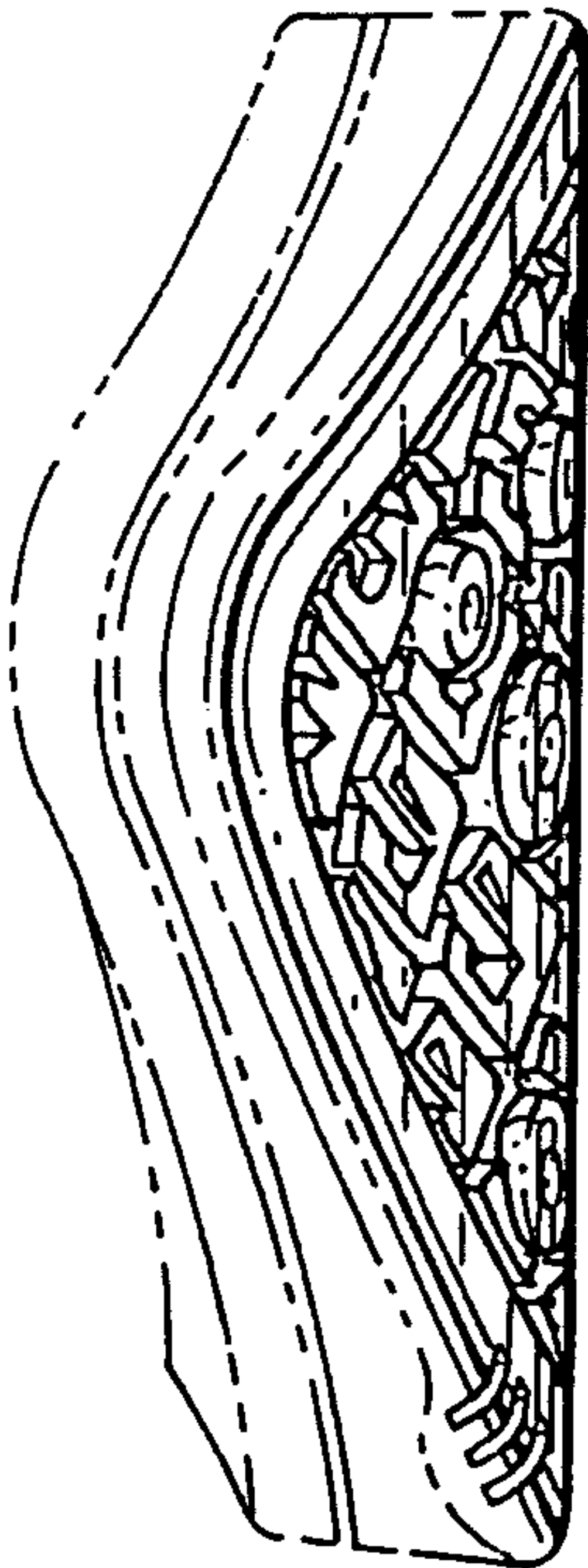

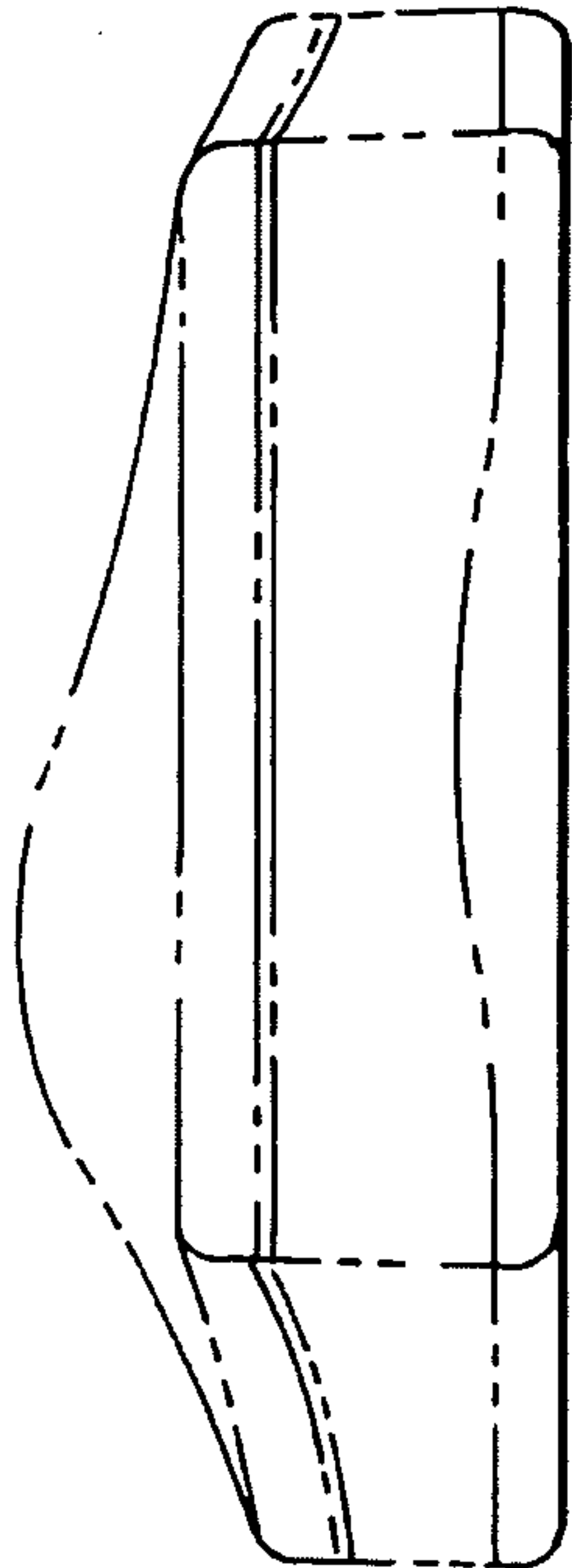
