(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a toothbrush with sports handle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a first embodiment of our design showing our toothbrush with sports handle;

FIG. 2 is front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top end elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom end elevational view thereof.

The broken lines showing bristles and elements of the handle are included for the purpose of illustrating portions of the article that form no part of the claimed design.

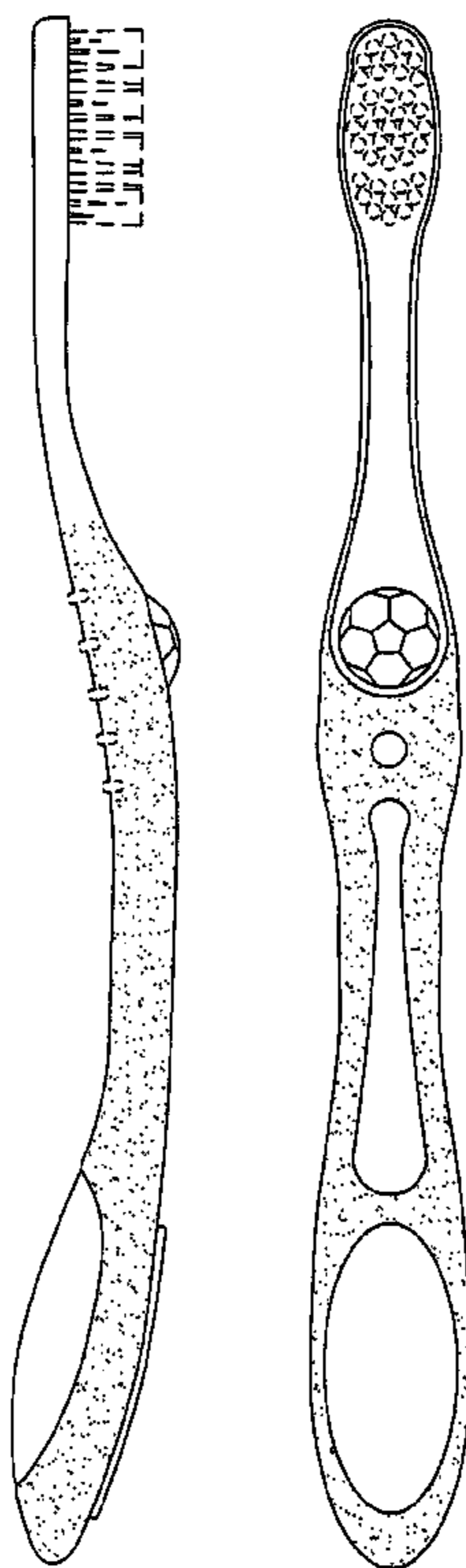

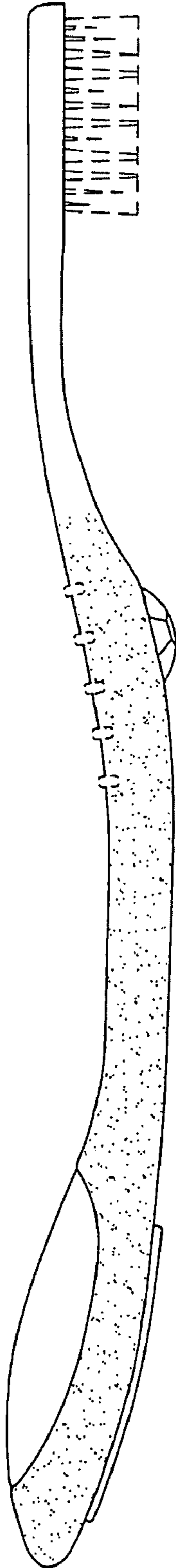

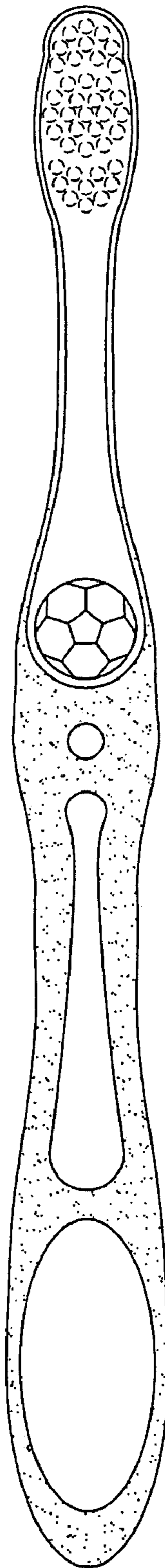
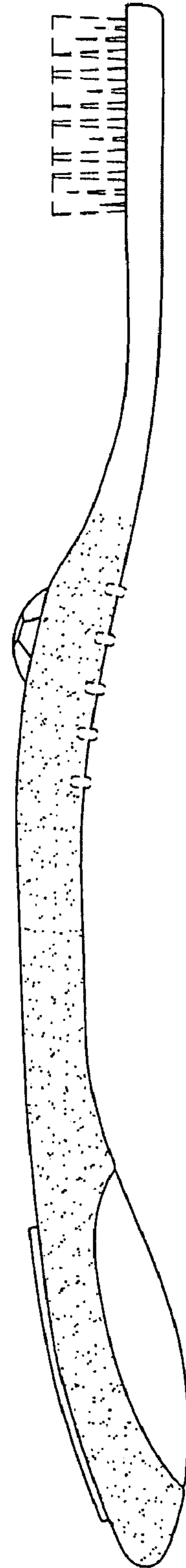
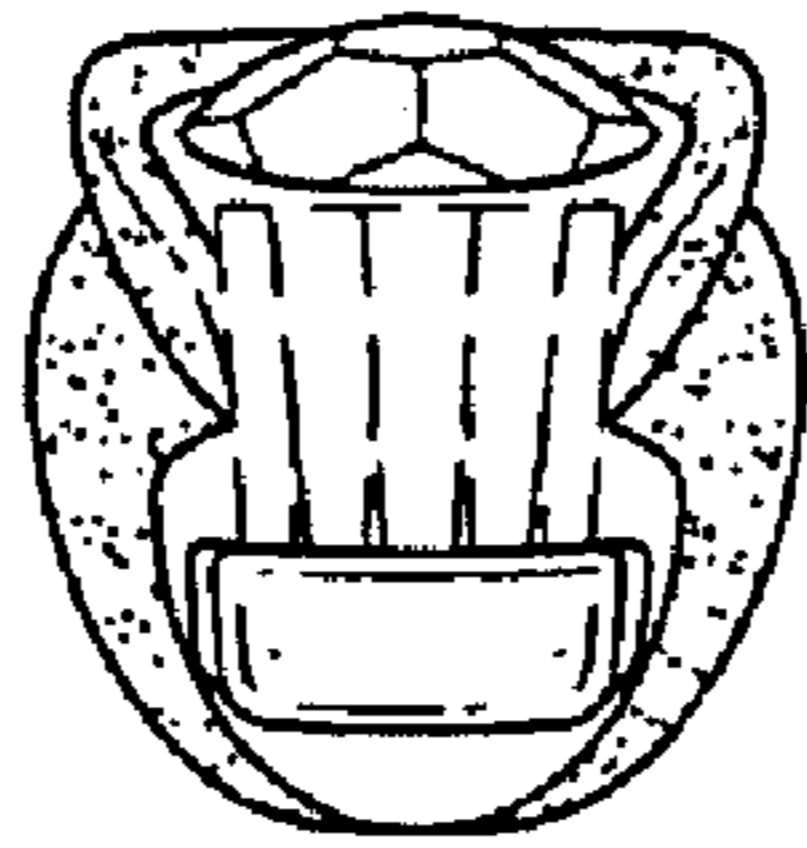
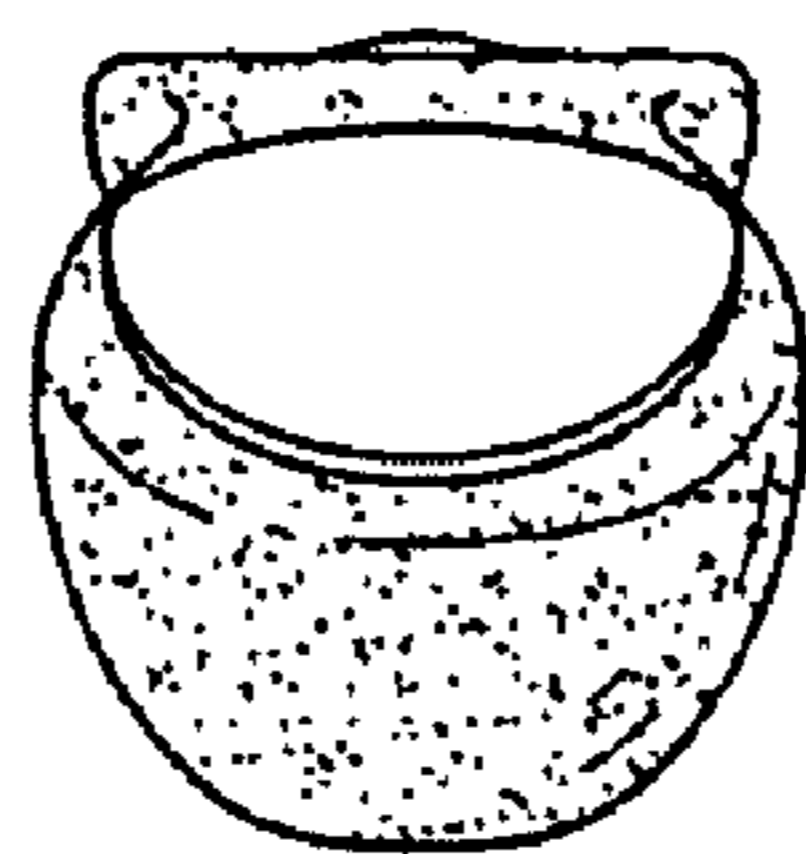
