(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a golf shaft, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a golf shaft on a driver, the enlarged fragmented section is shown for clarity of the 3 dimensional shape; and,

FIG. 2 is another perspective view of a golf shaft on a flag stick, the enlarged fragmented section is shown for clarity of the 3 dimensional shape.

The broken line showing of the club head and handle of FIG. 1 and the flag and ground of FIG. 2 are included for the purpose of illustrating and forms no part of the claimed design. The broken lines disclosed on the fragmented enlarged sections are shown for ease of illustration.

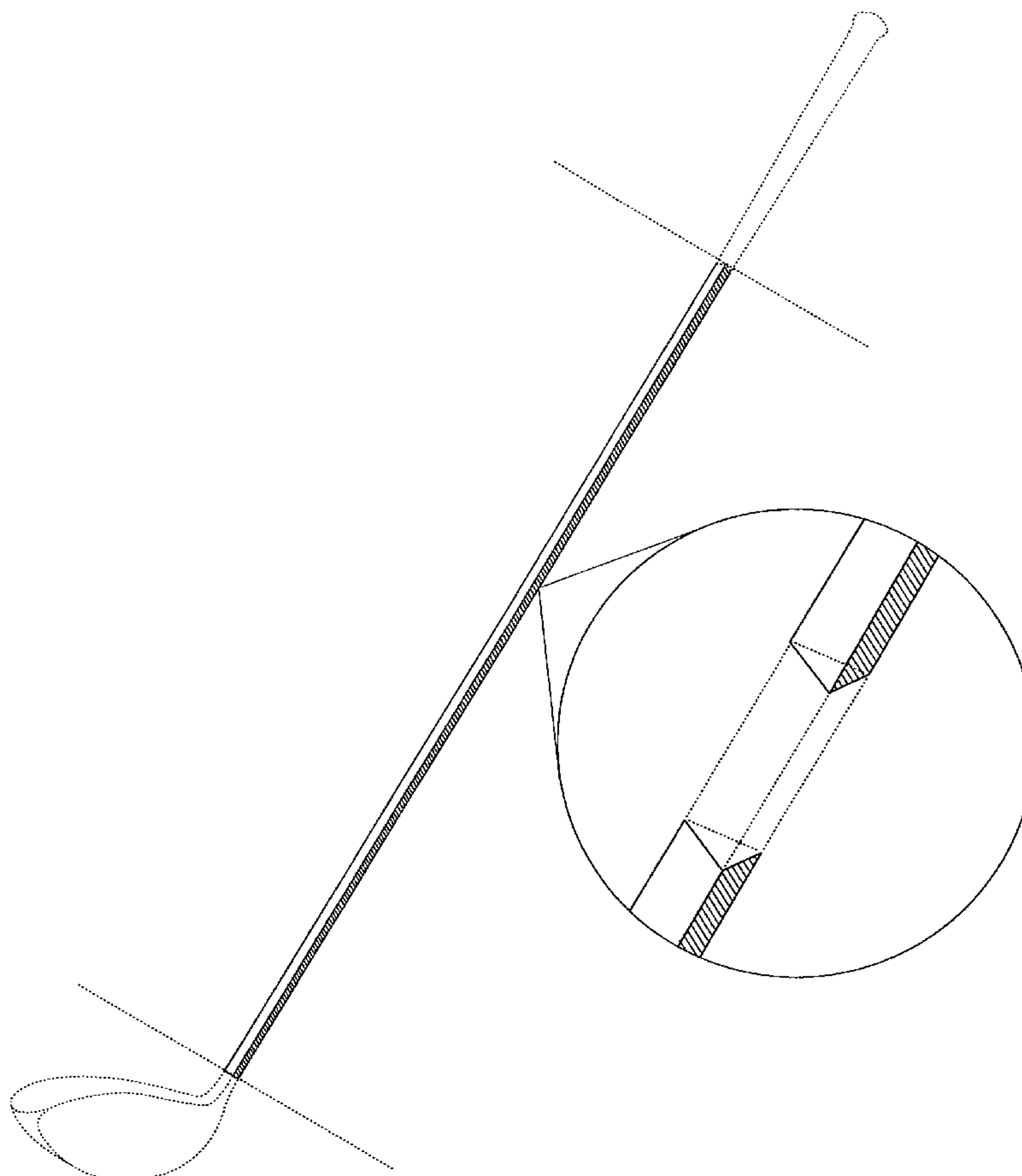

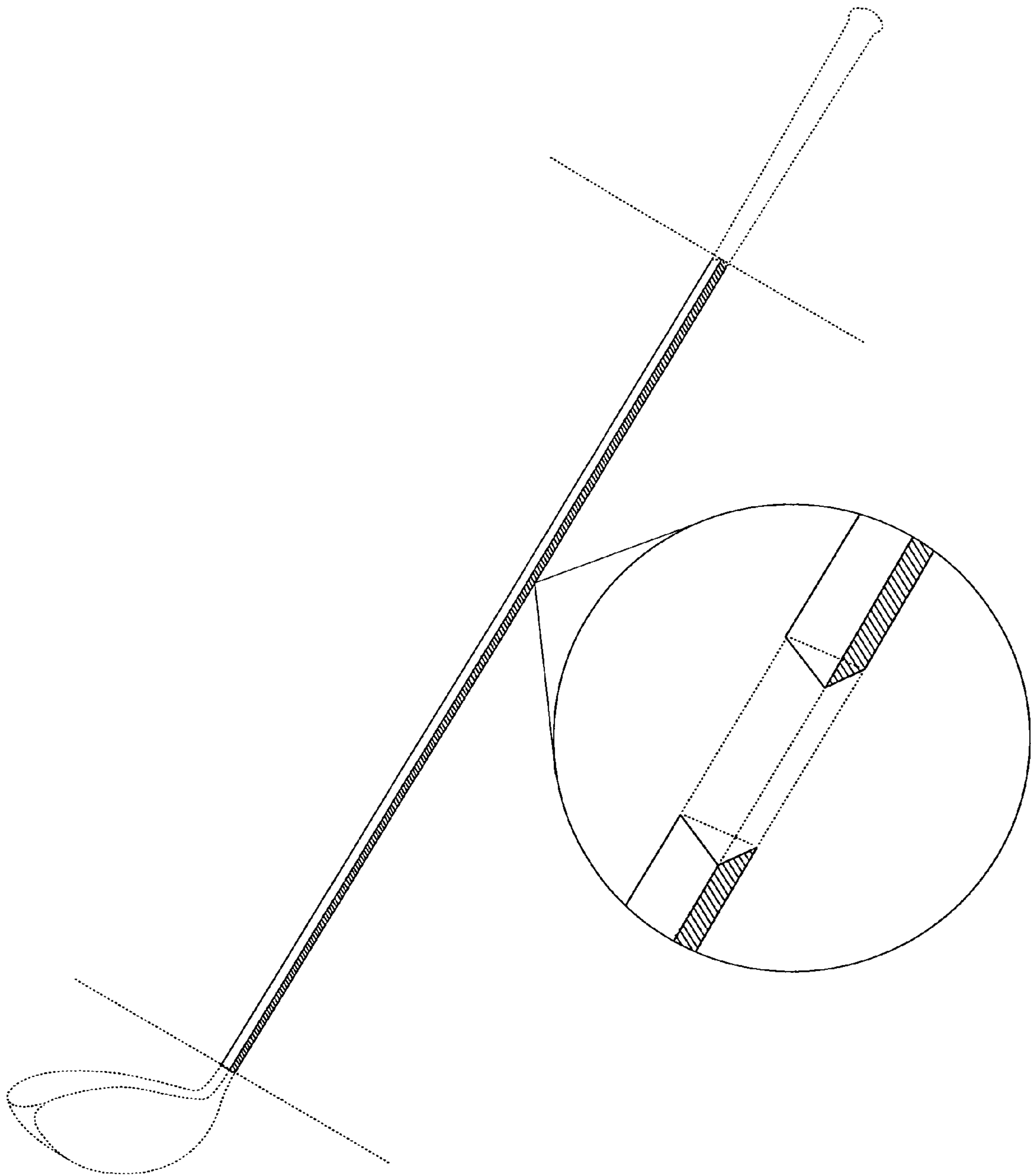
