(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a footwear outsole, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of aesthetic mid-sole design elements for a footwear outsole in accordance with an embodiment of the invention; and,

FIG. 2 is a top view thereof.

The broken lines immediately adjacent to the solid lines throughout the views, represent the boundaries of the design with the lines themselves and the areas within them forming no part of the claim.
