instrument of FIG. 1;

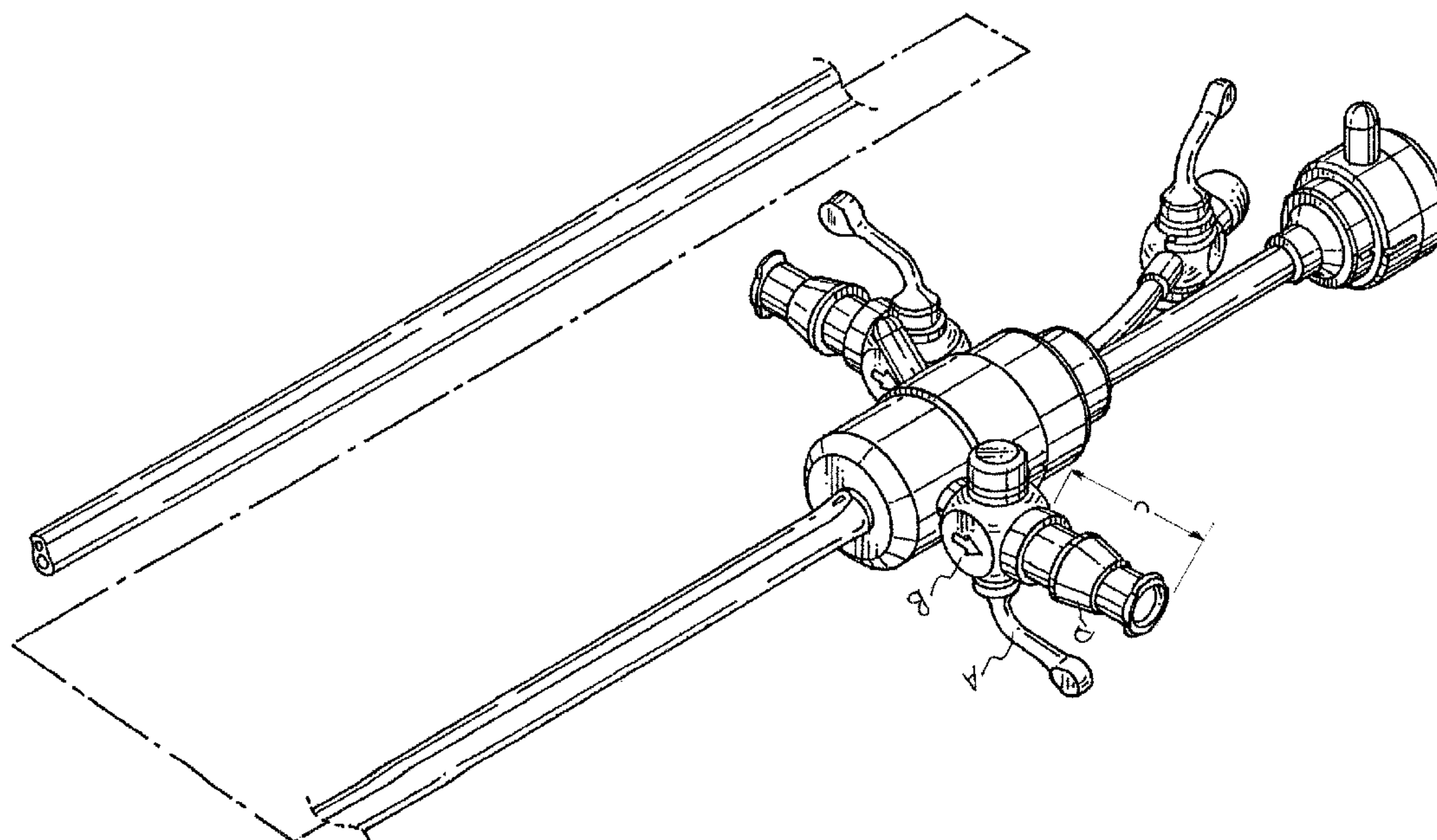
FIG. 3 is a top elevational view of a shaft for a medical
instrument of FIG. 1;

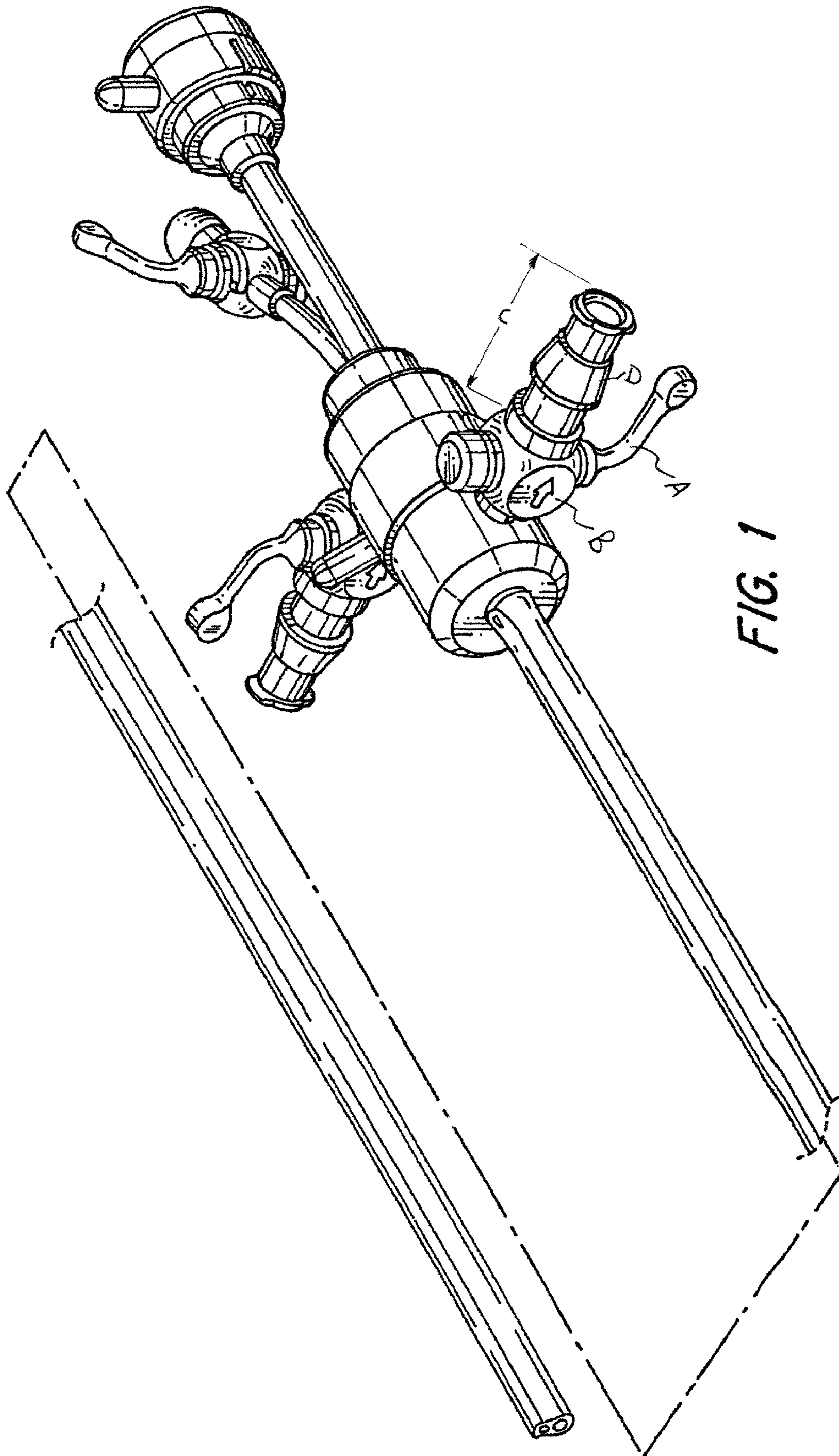
FIG. 4 is a bottom elevational view of a shaft for a medical

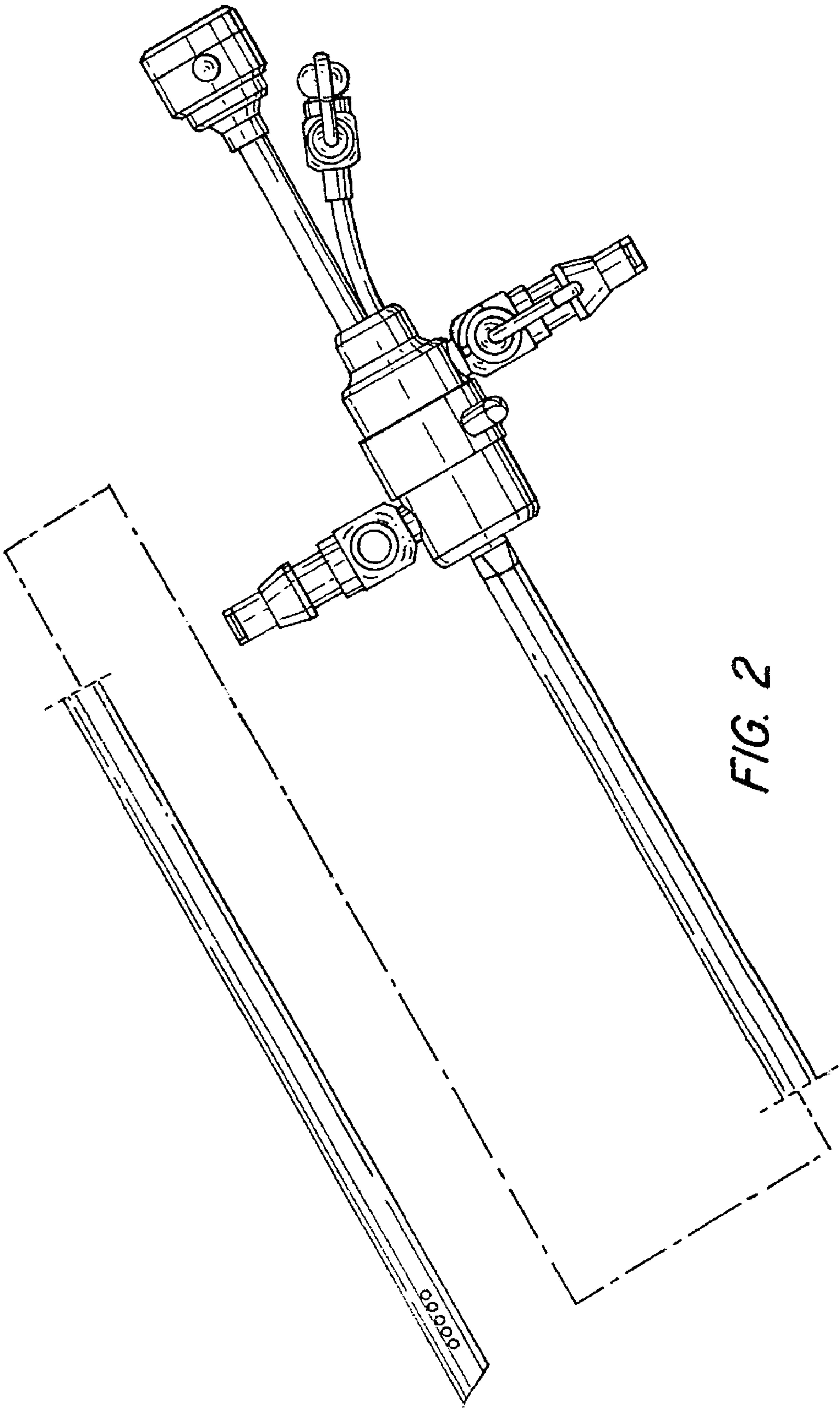

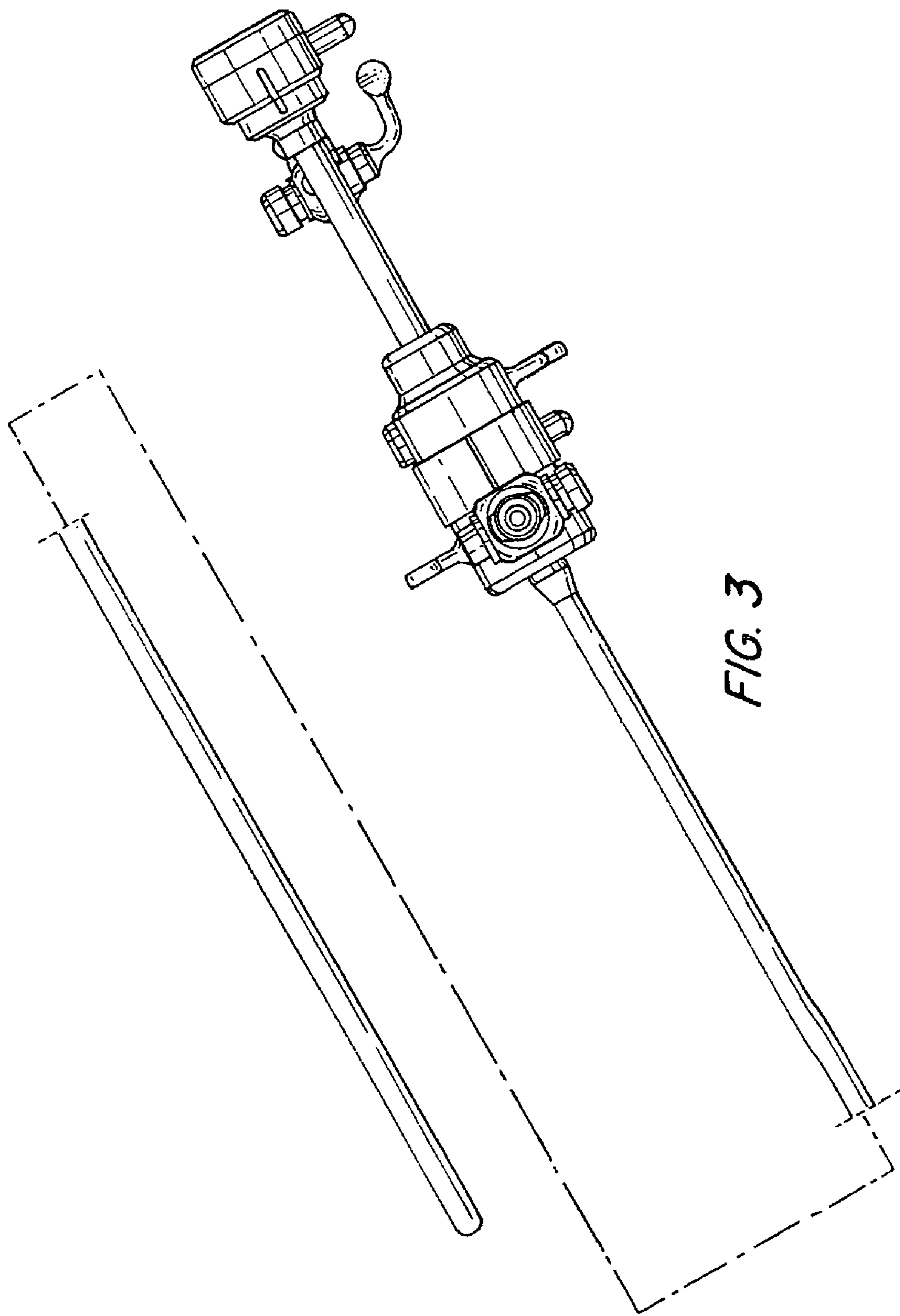

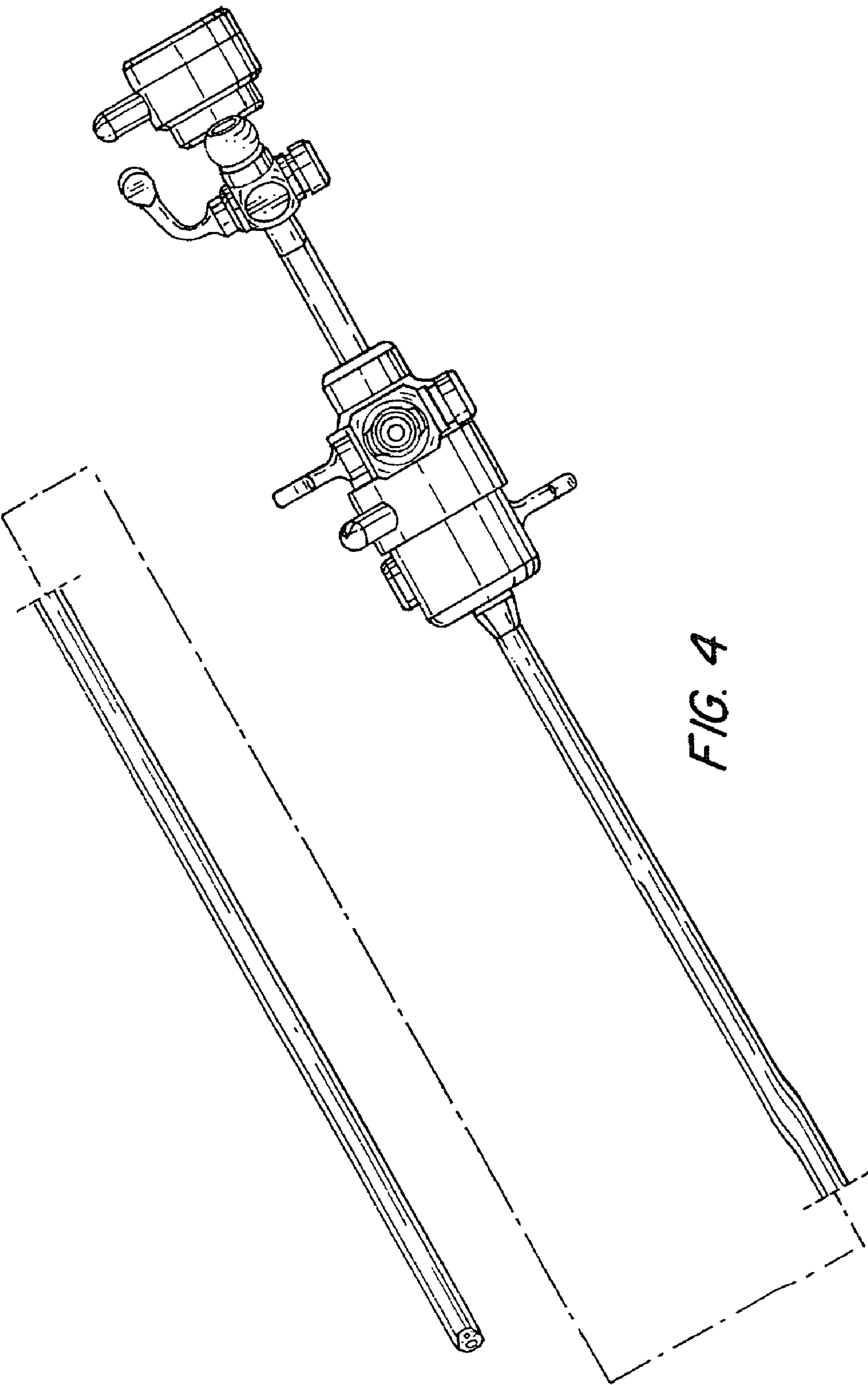

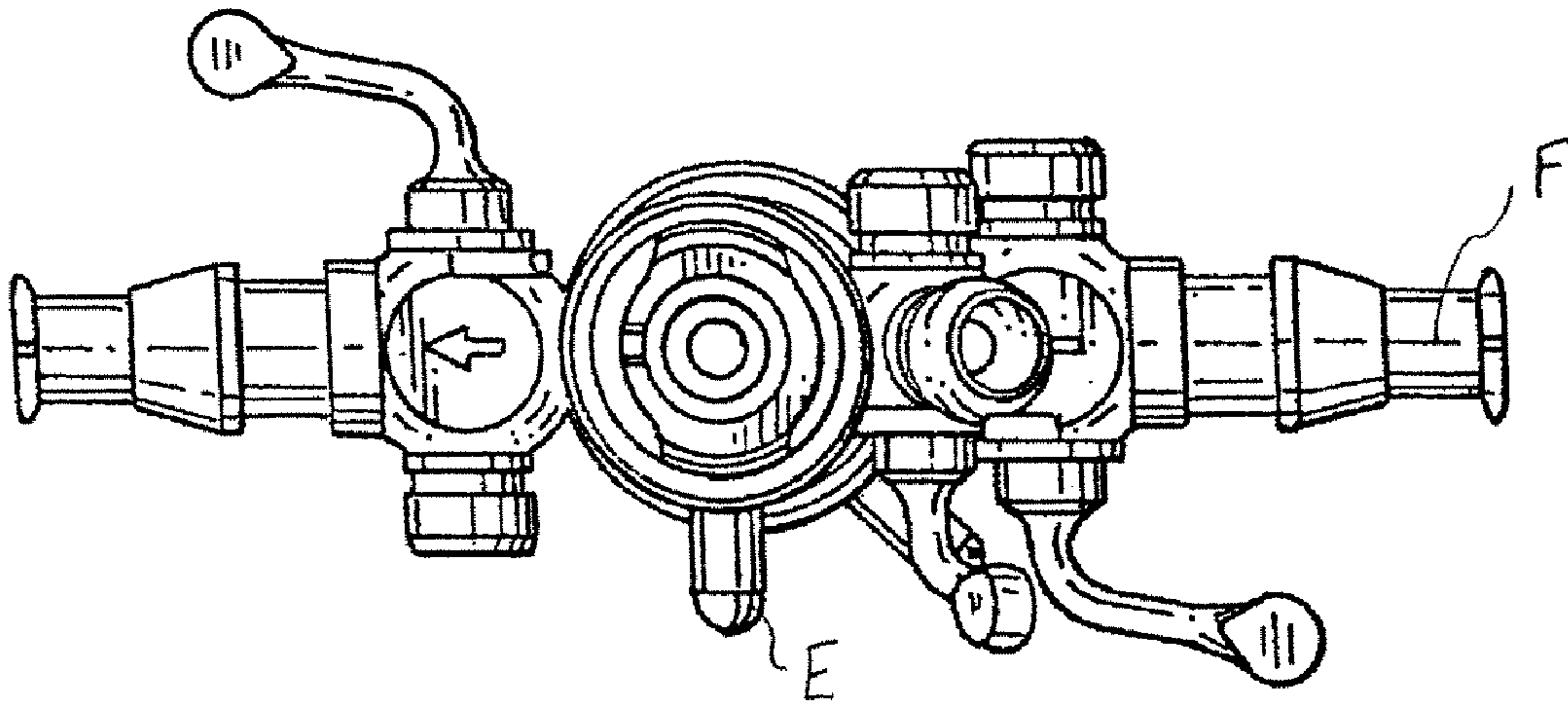

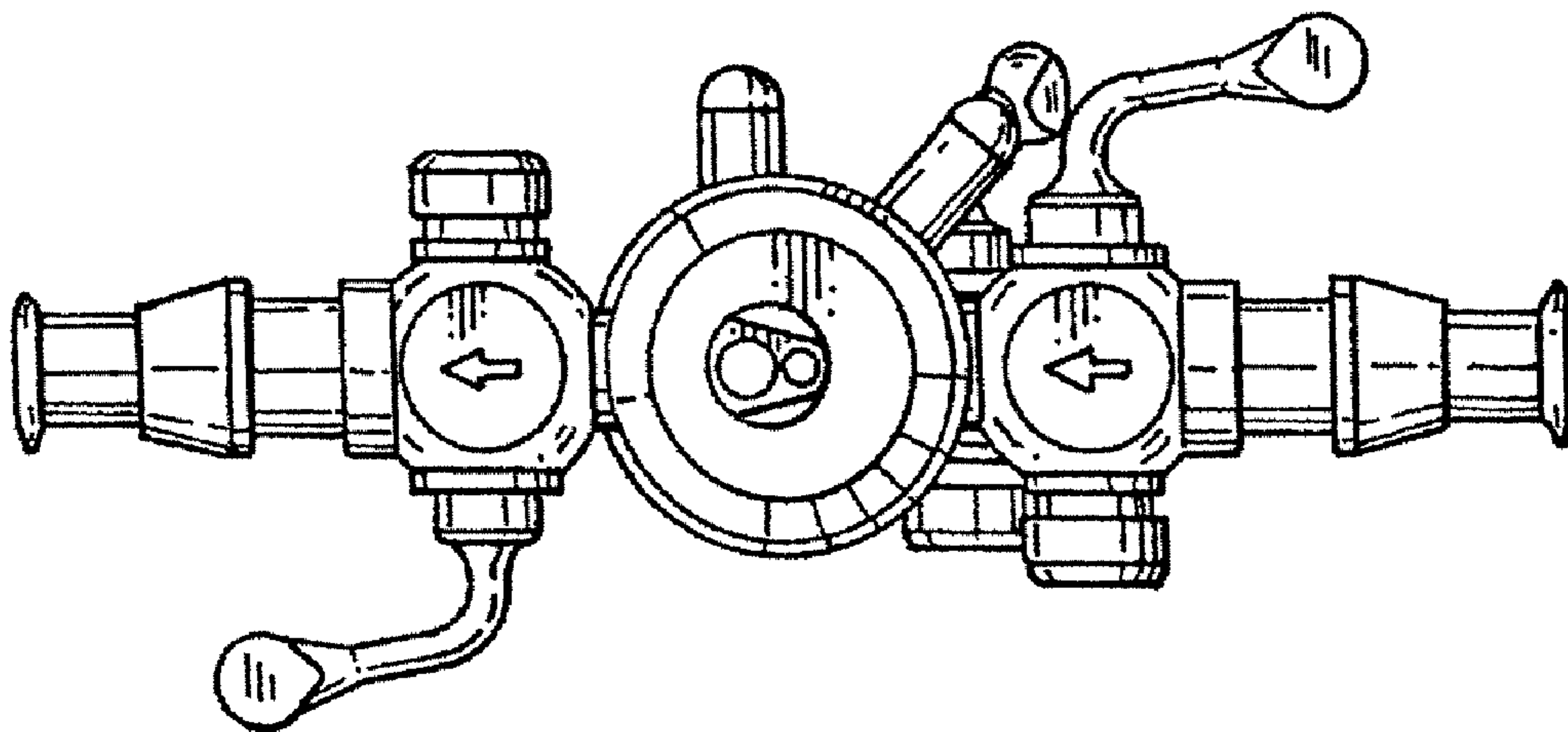
