(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design of a beverage-holding sweatshirt, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and right perspective view of a beverage-holding sweatshirt;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the beverage-holding sweatshirt of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear view of the beverage-holding sweatshirt of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side view of the beverage-holding sweatshirt of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a left side view of the beverage-holding sweatshirt of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top view of the beverage-holding sweatshirt of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the beverage-holding sweatshirt of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 8 is an enlarged fragmentary front view of the beverage-holding pocket detail of the beverage-holding sweatshirt of FIG. 1.

The broken lines forming drawstrings in the hood of the sweatshirt design and the outline of a beverage can are included for the purposes of illustrating environment and form no part of the claimed design. The remaining broken lines illustrate stitching in the material forming the design.

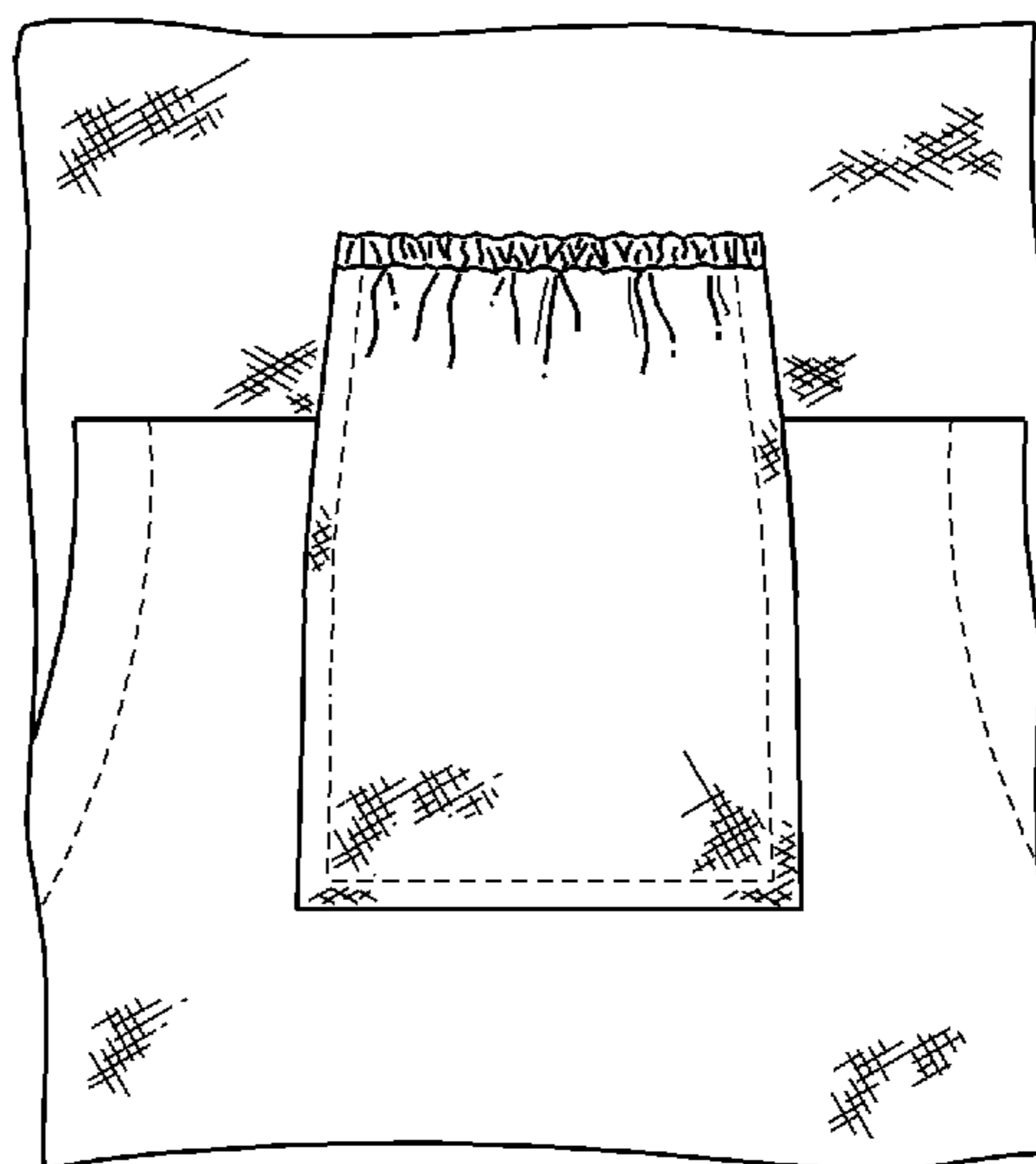

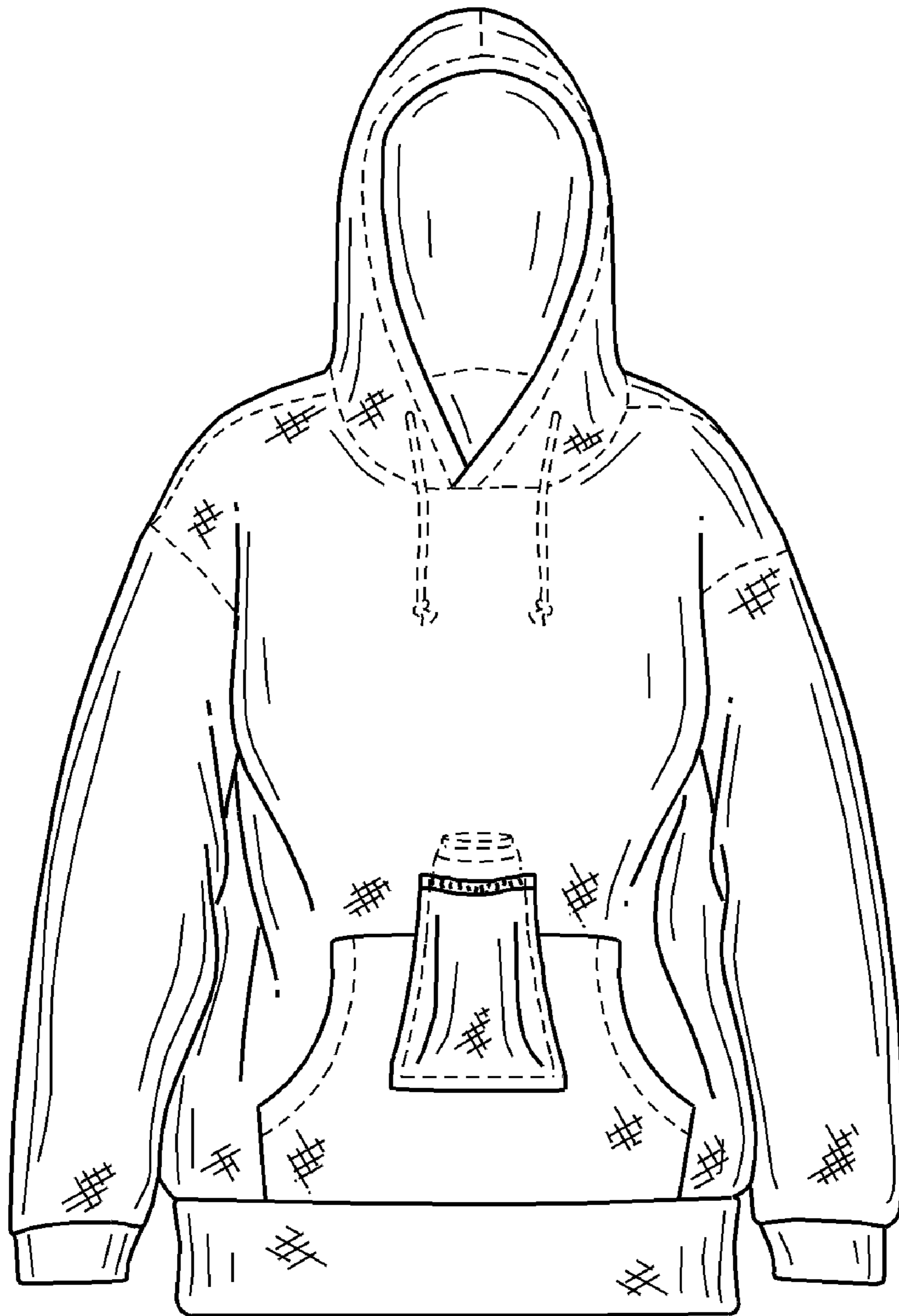

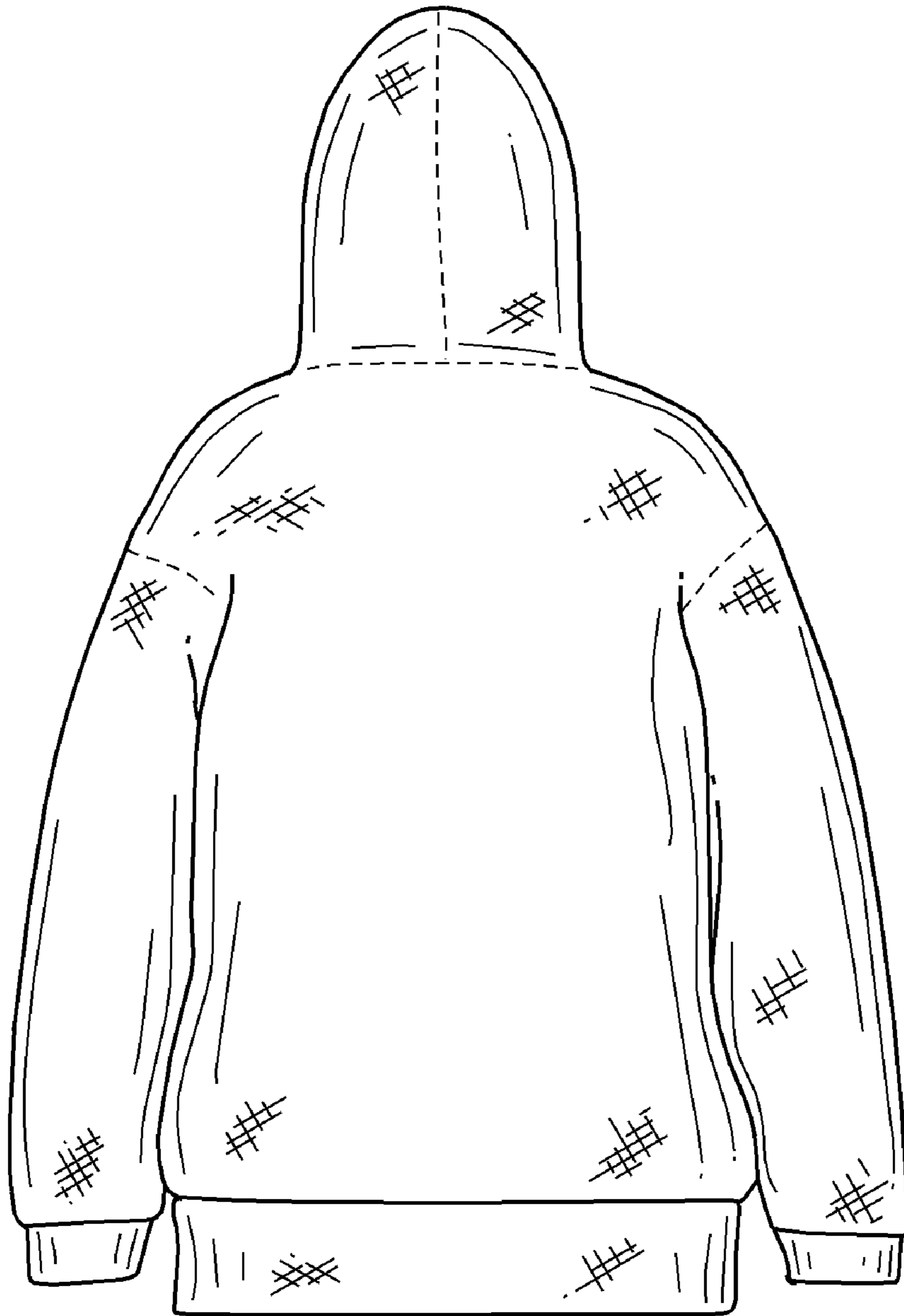

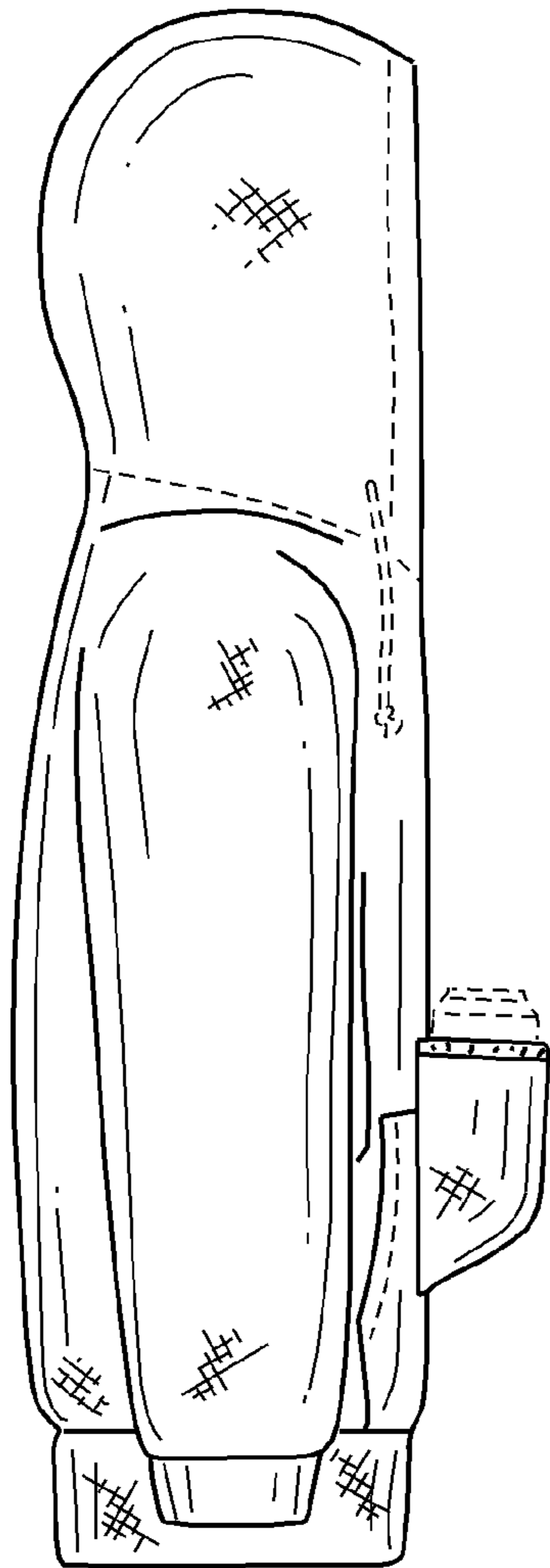

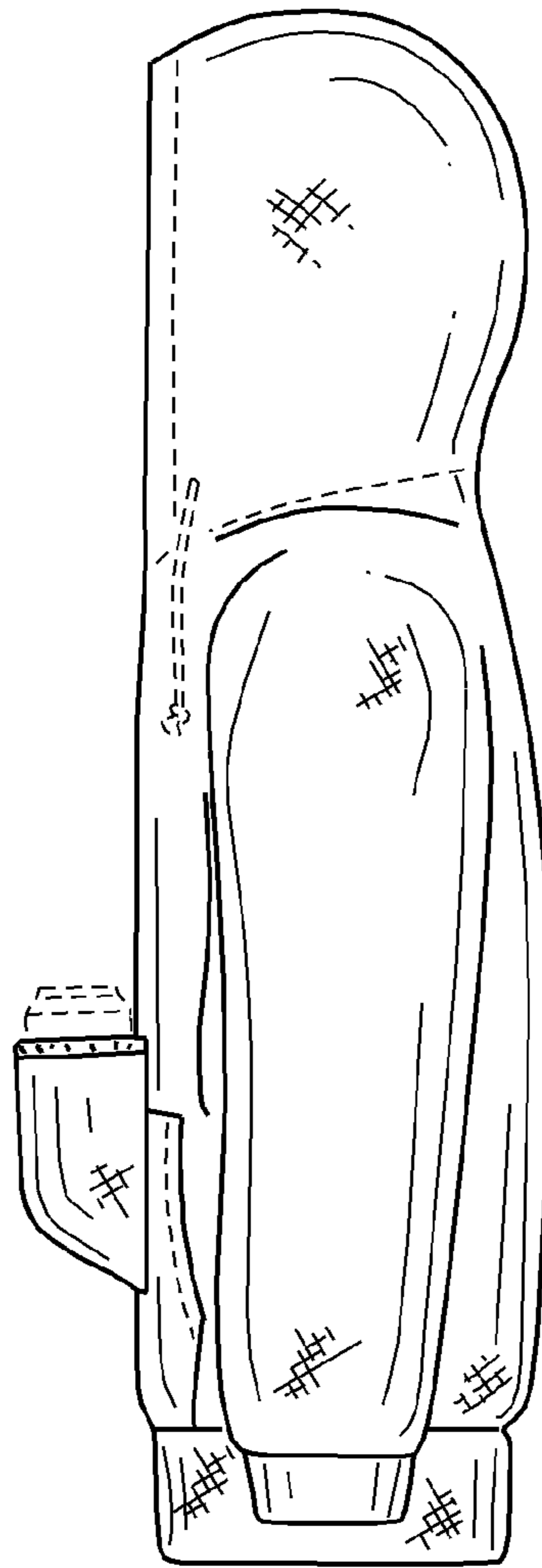

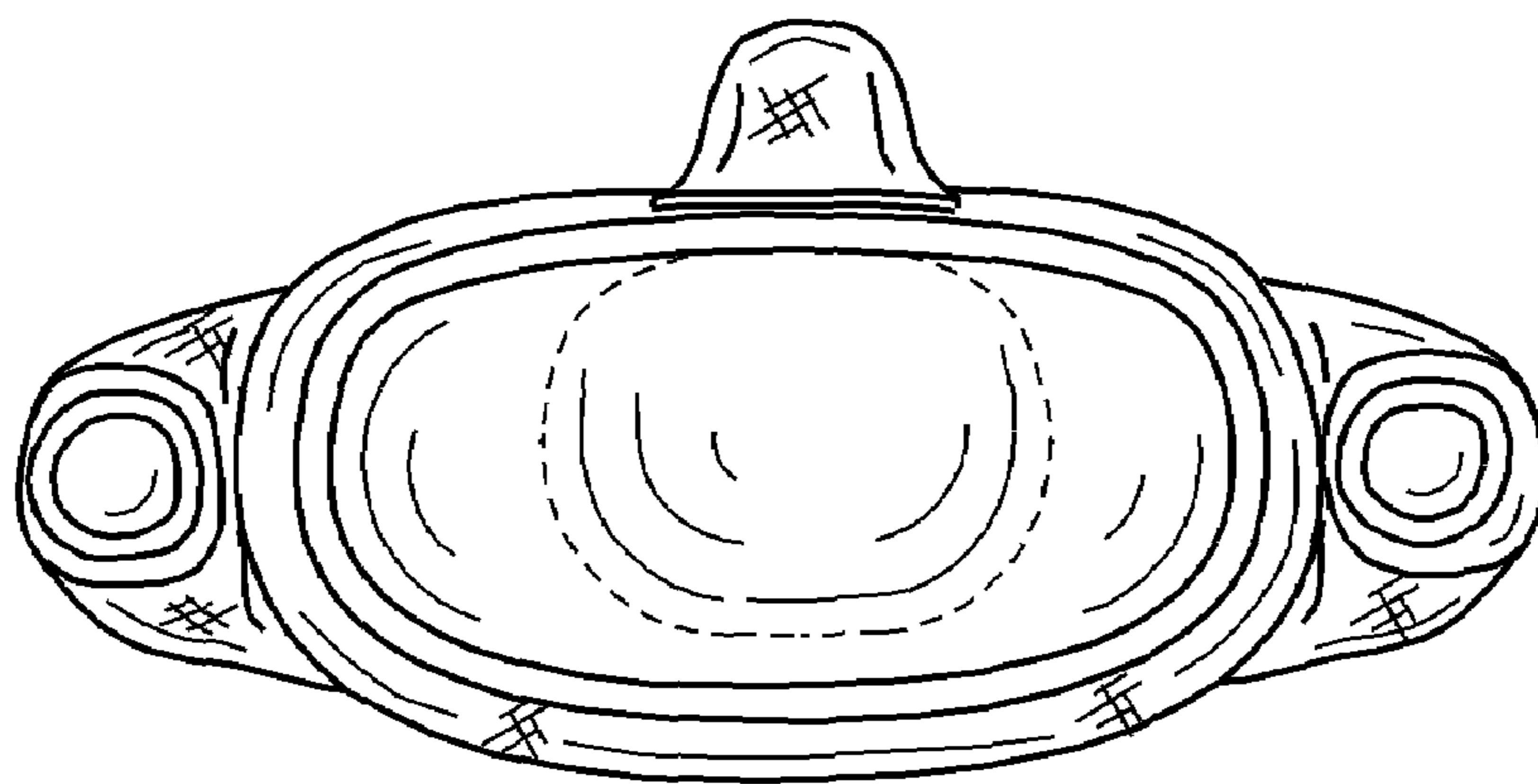
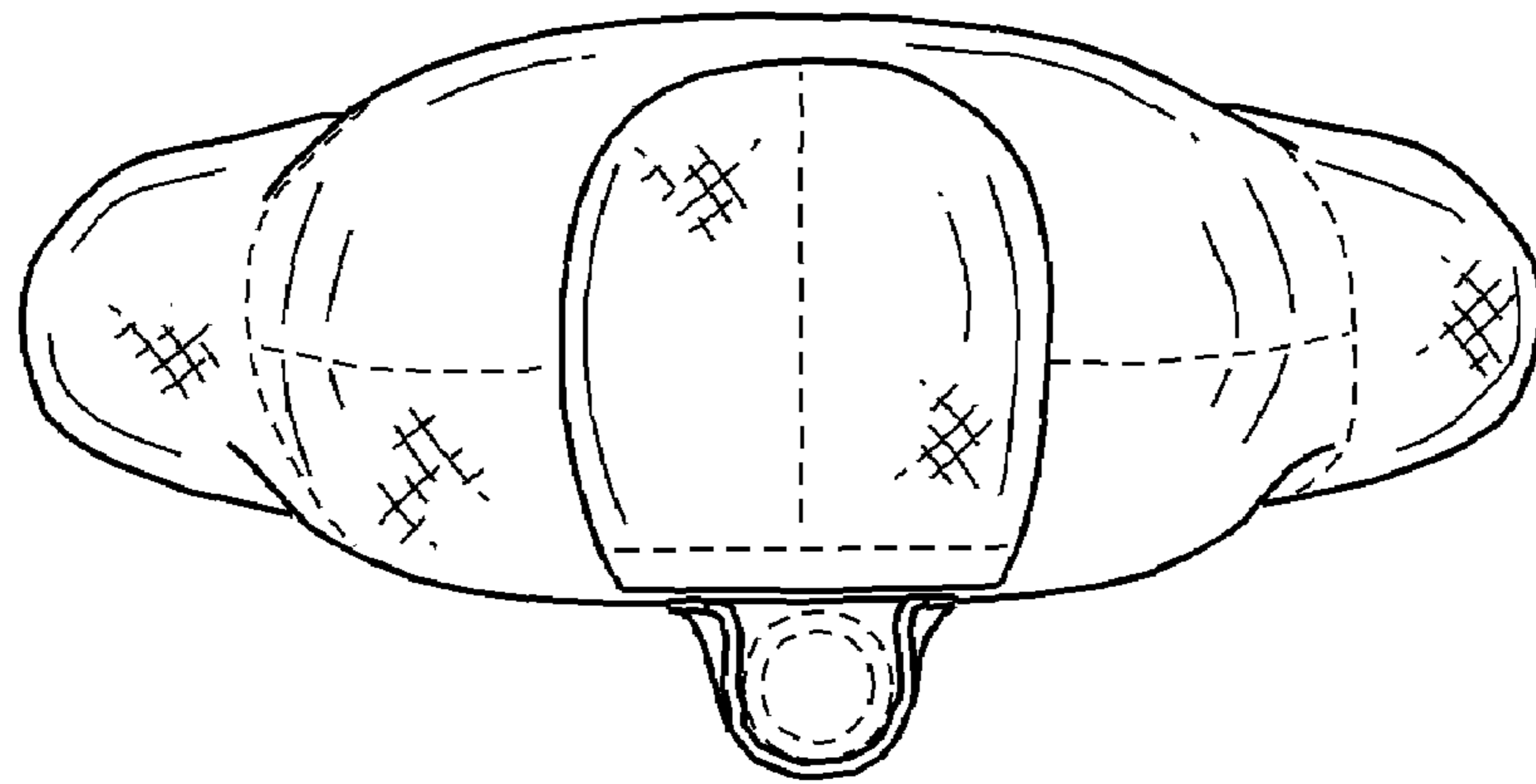

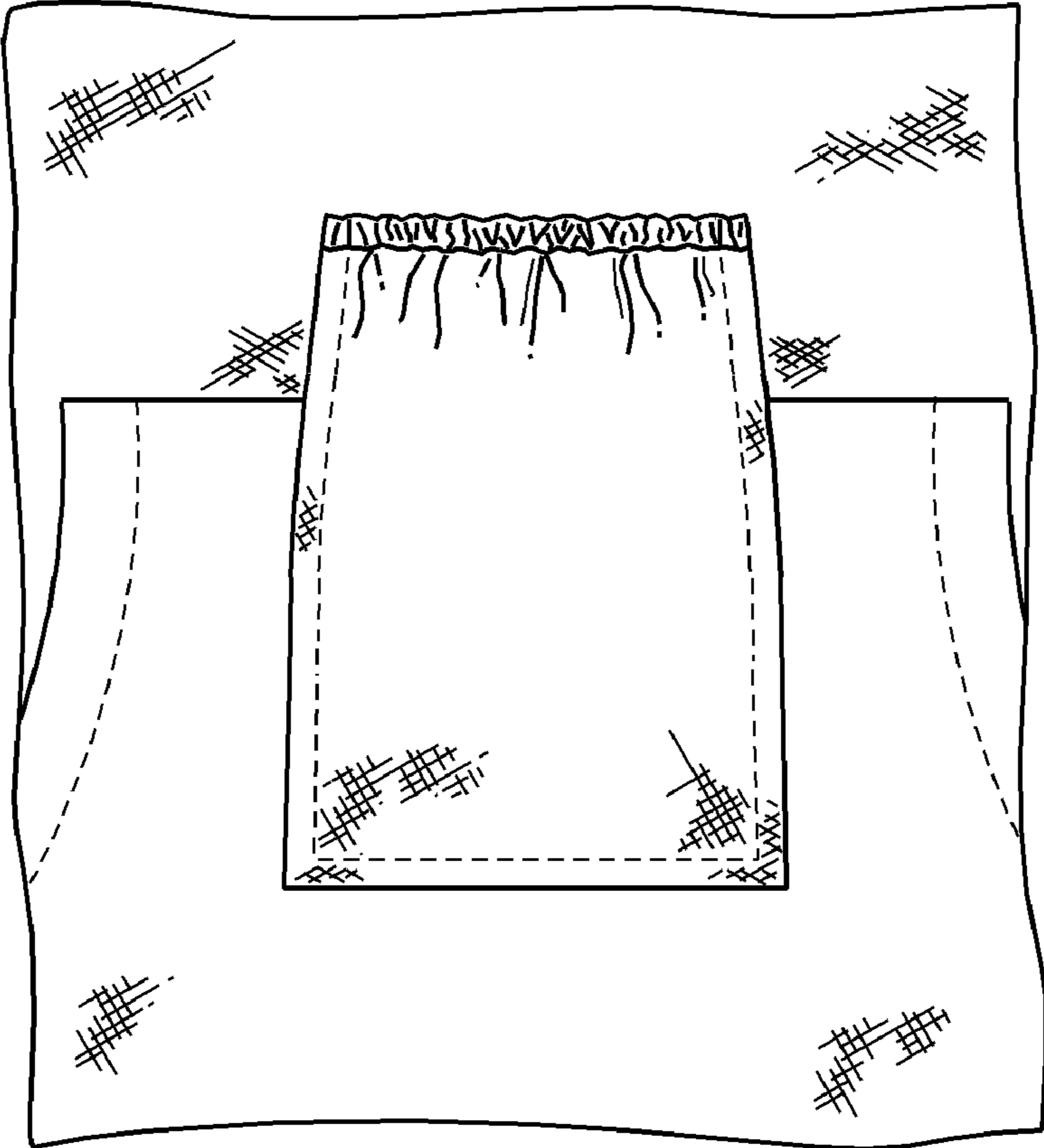
