FIG. 12 is a front elevational view thereof;

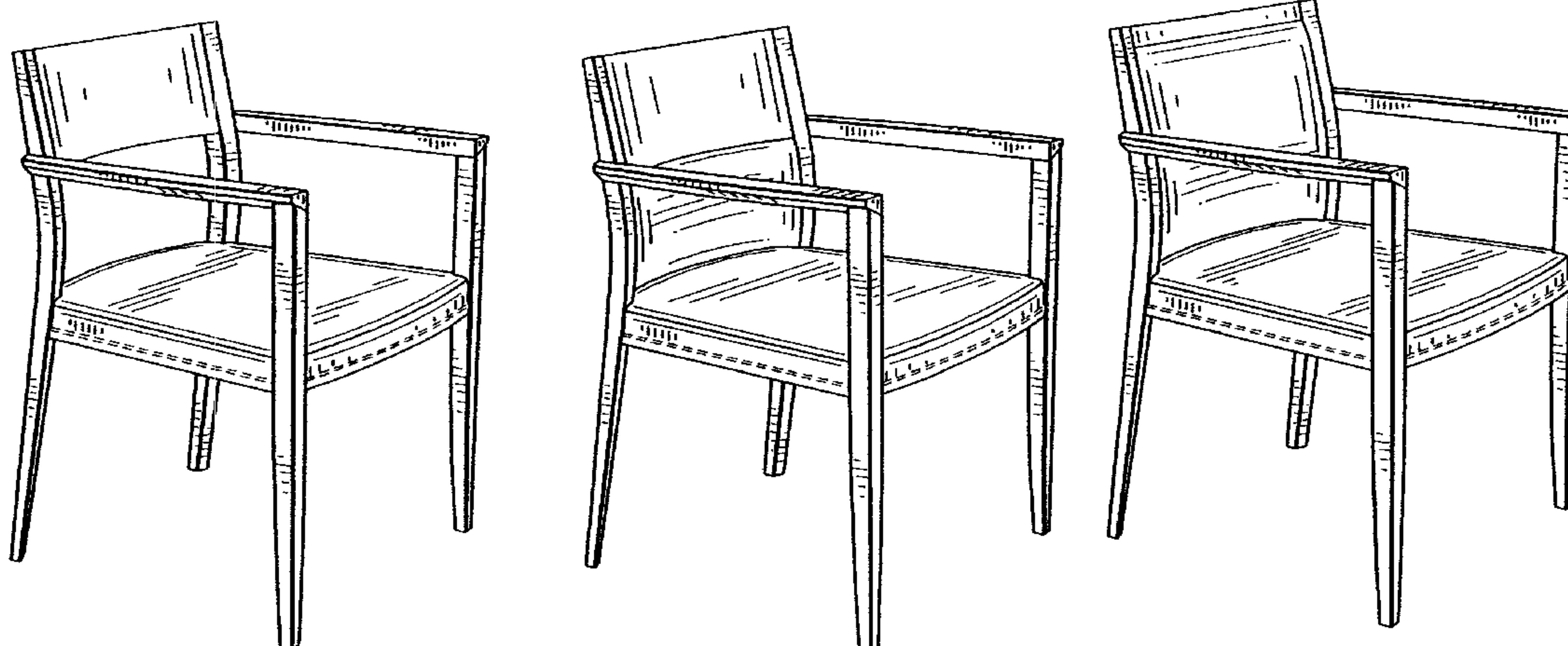
FIG. 13 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

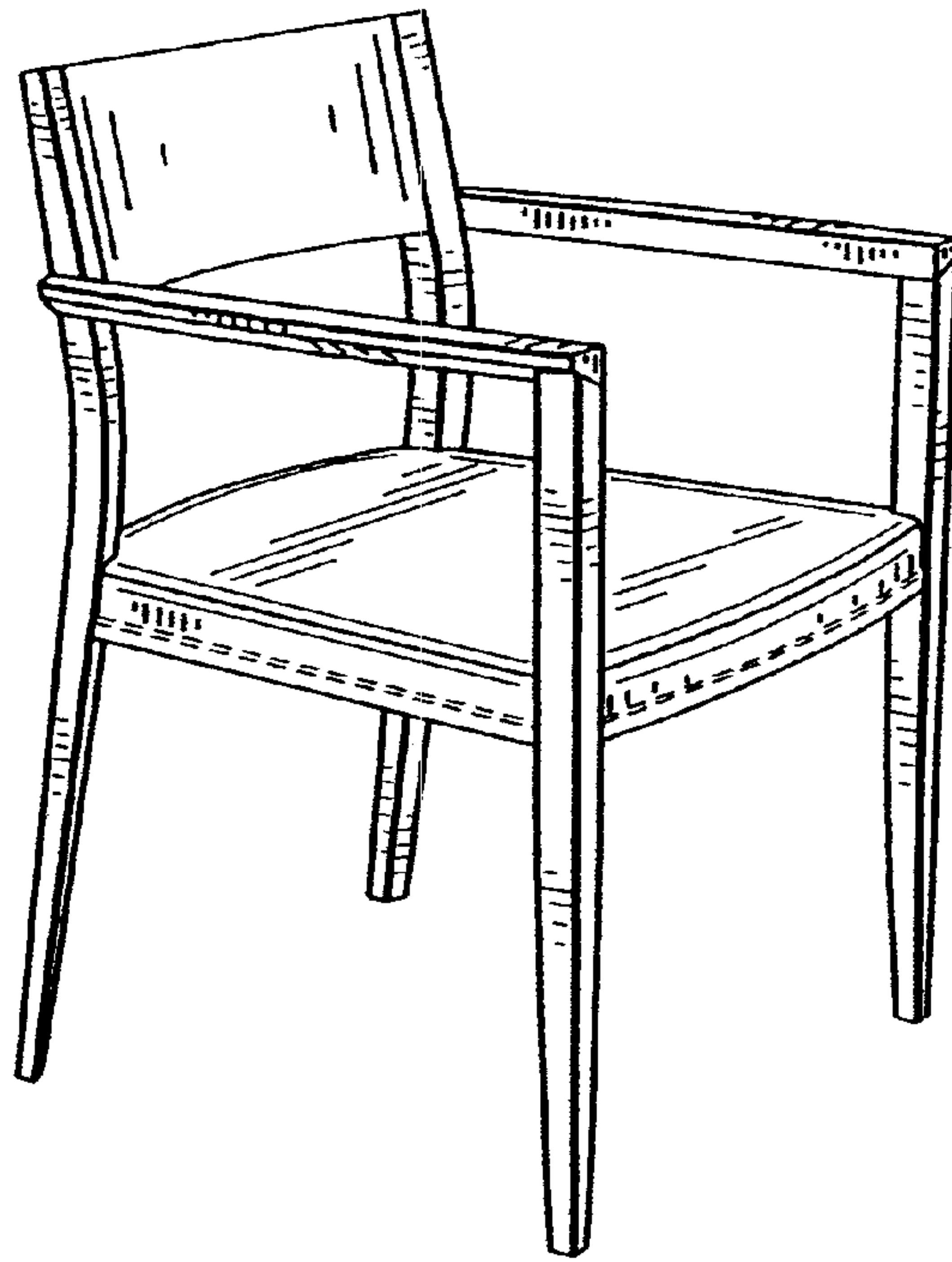

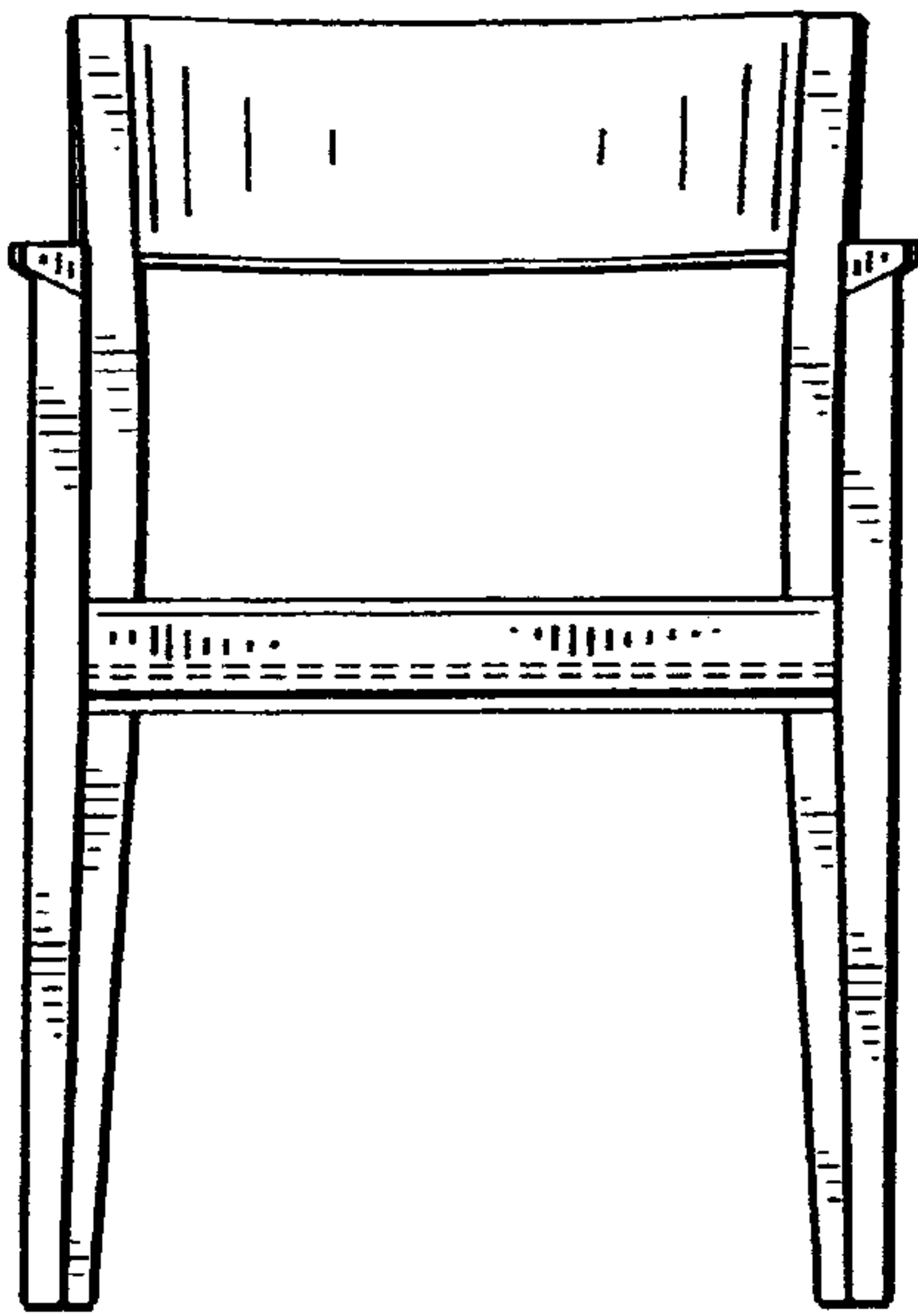
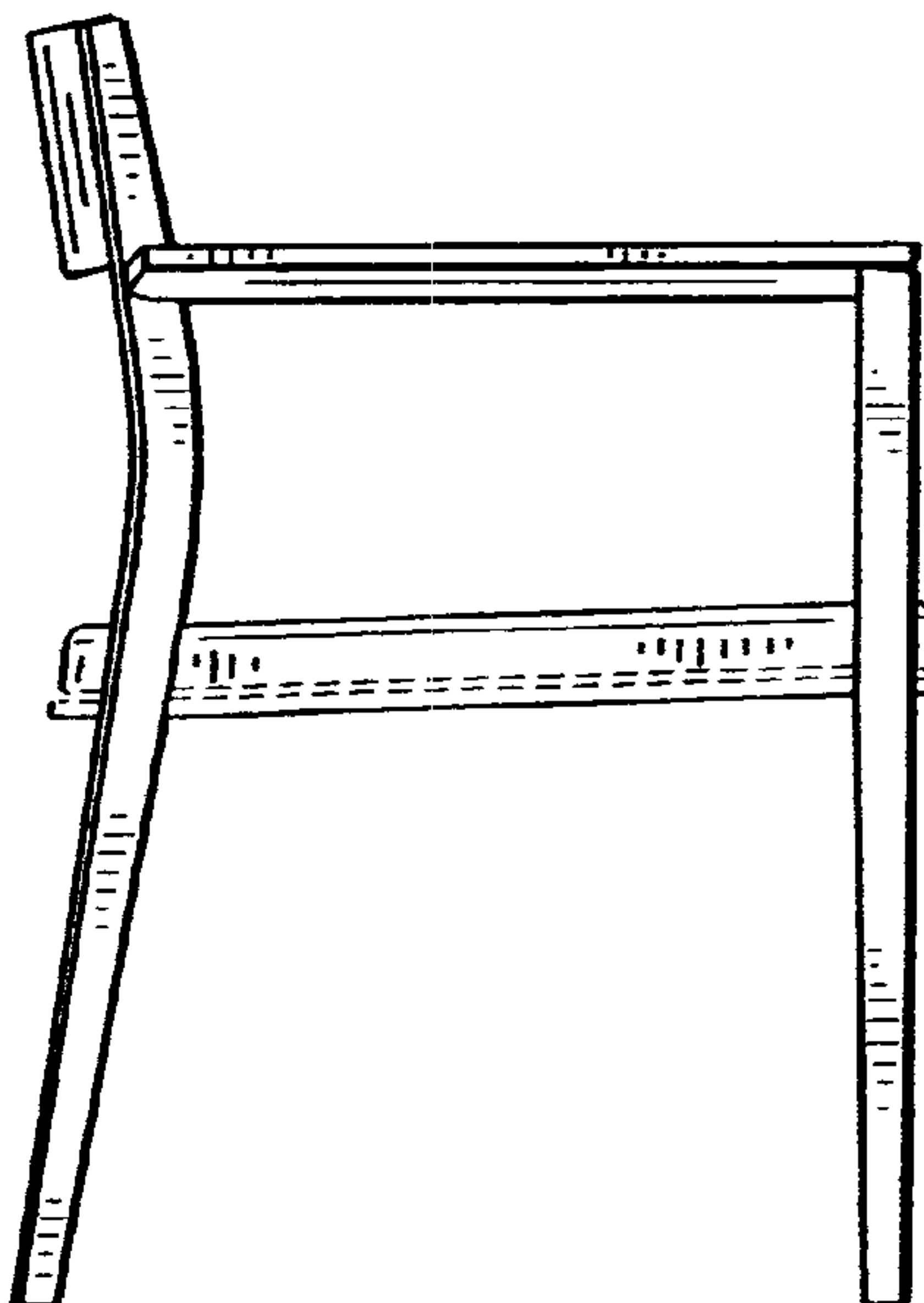

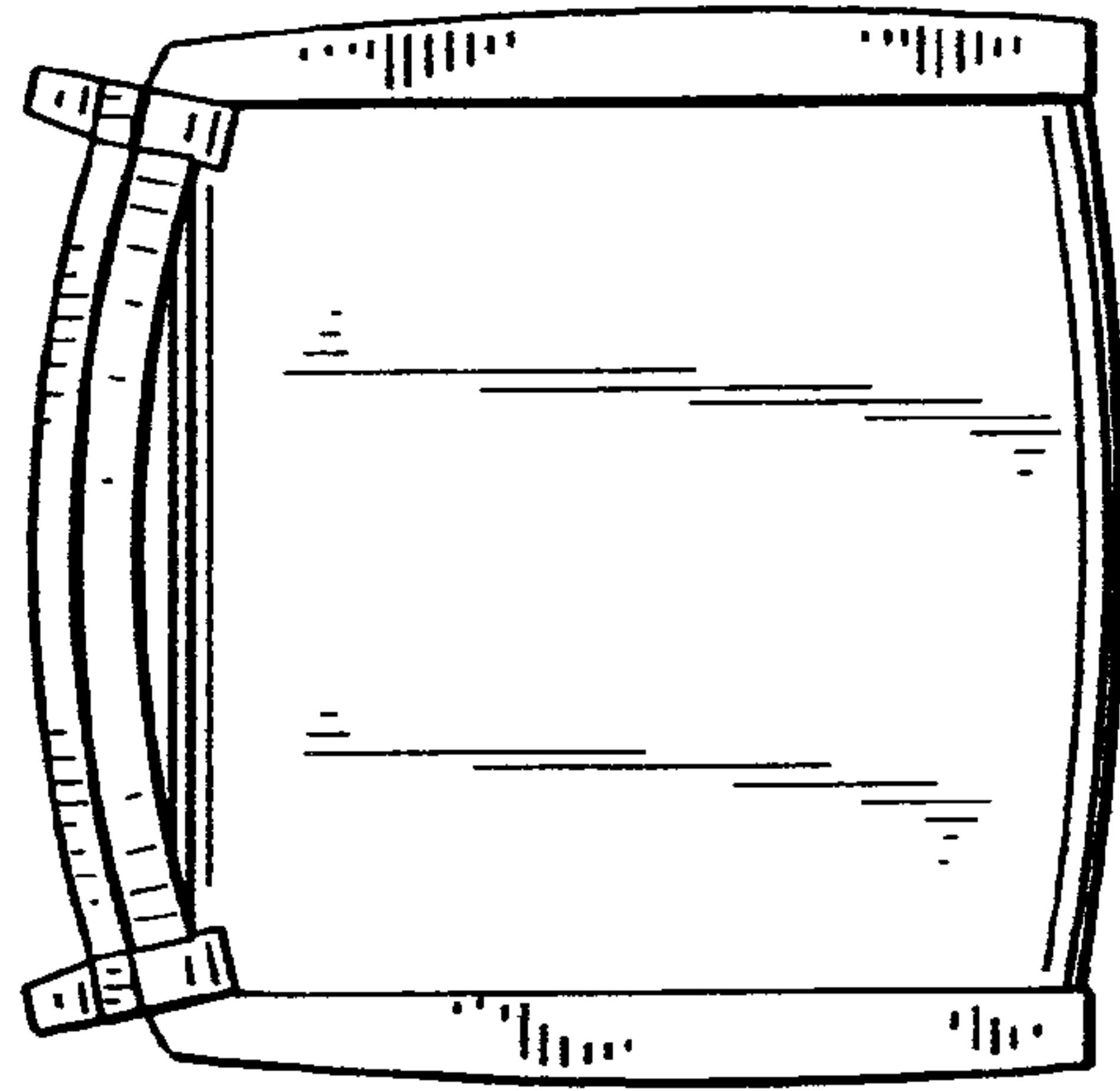

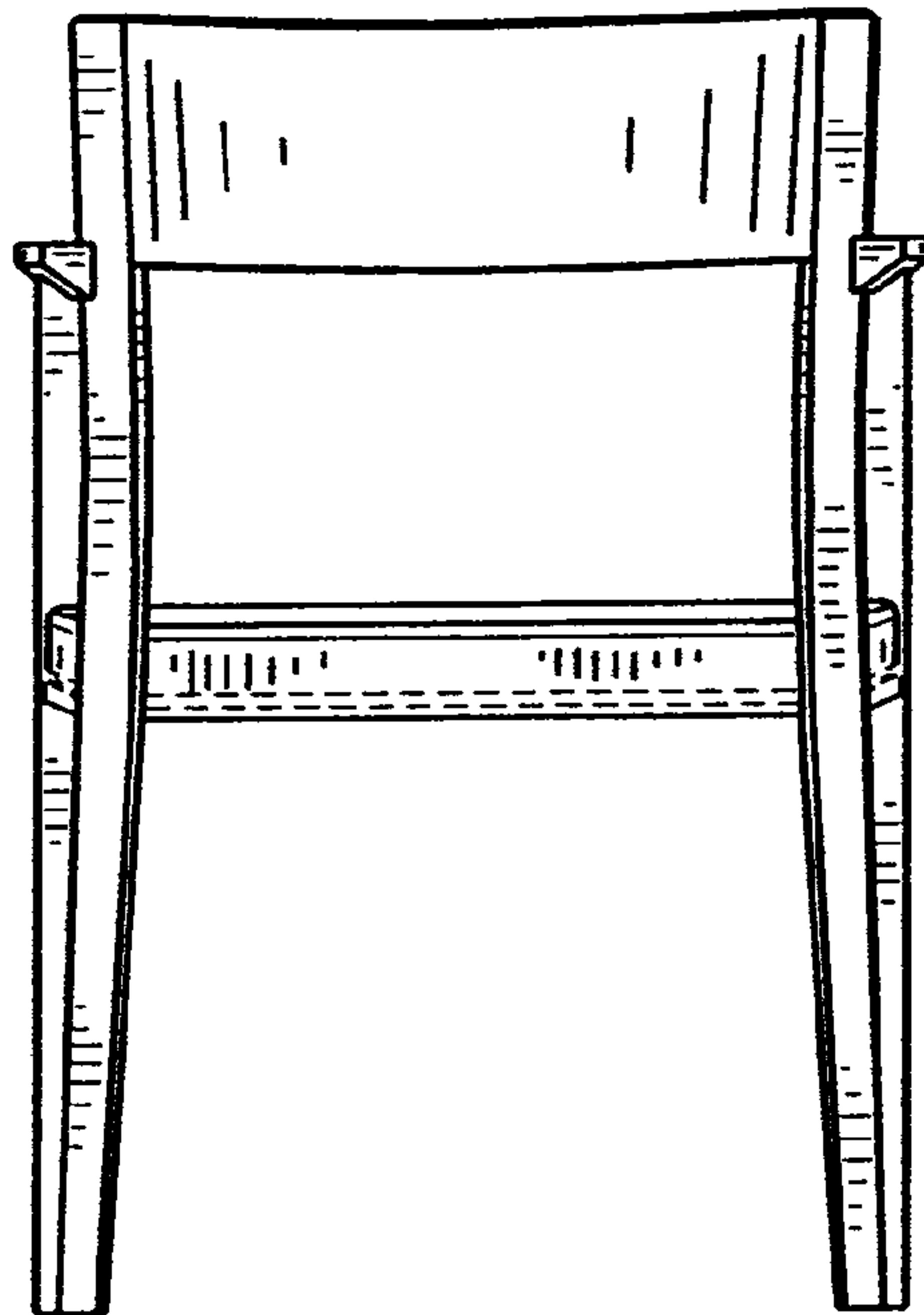

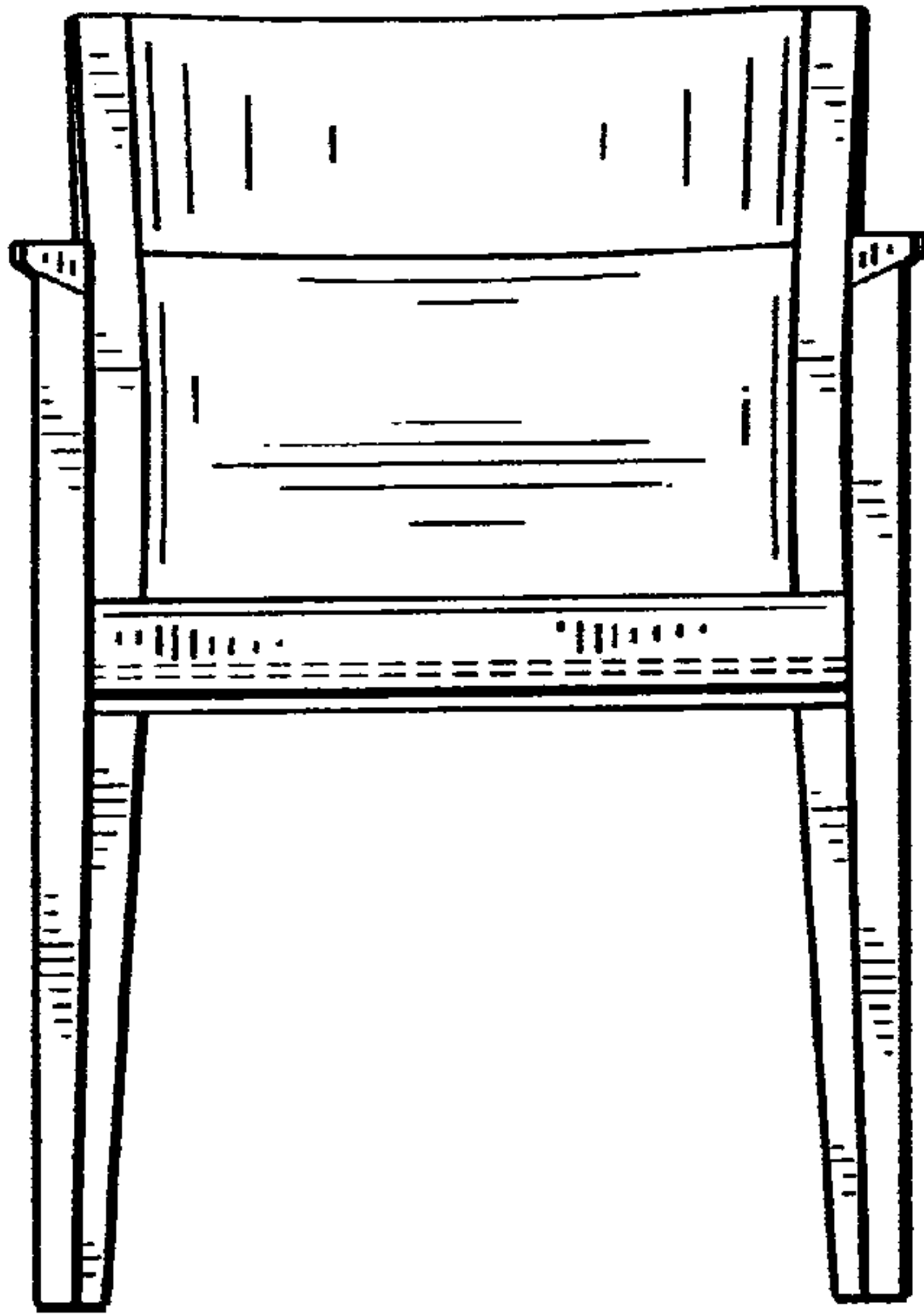
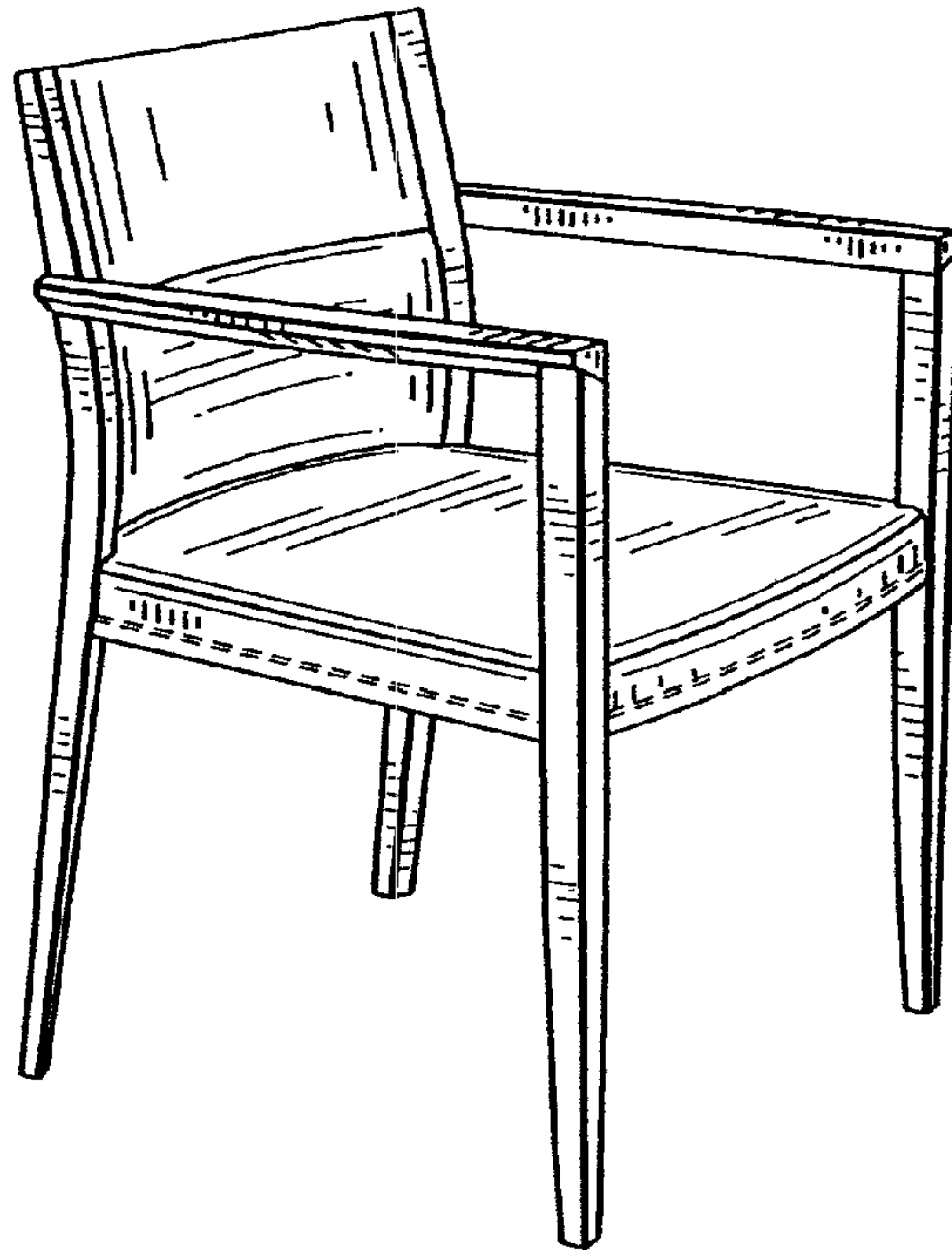

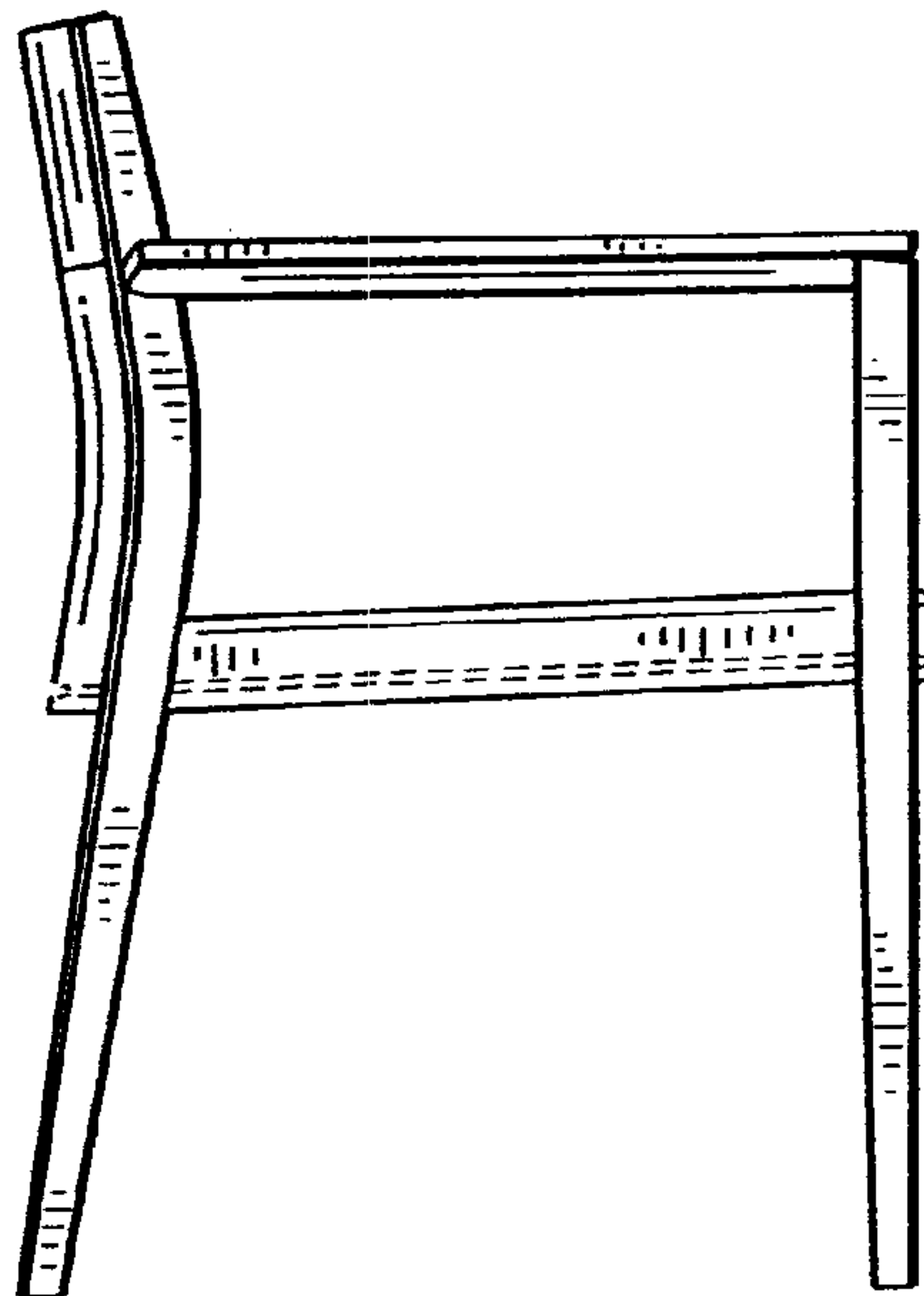

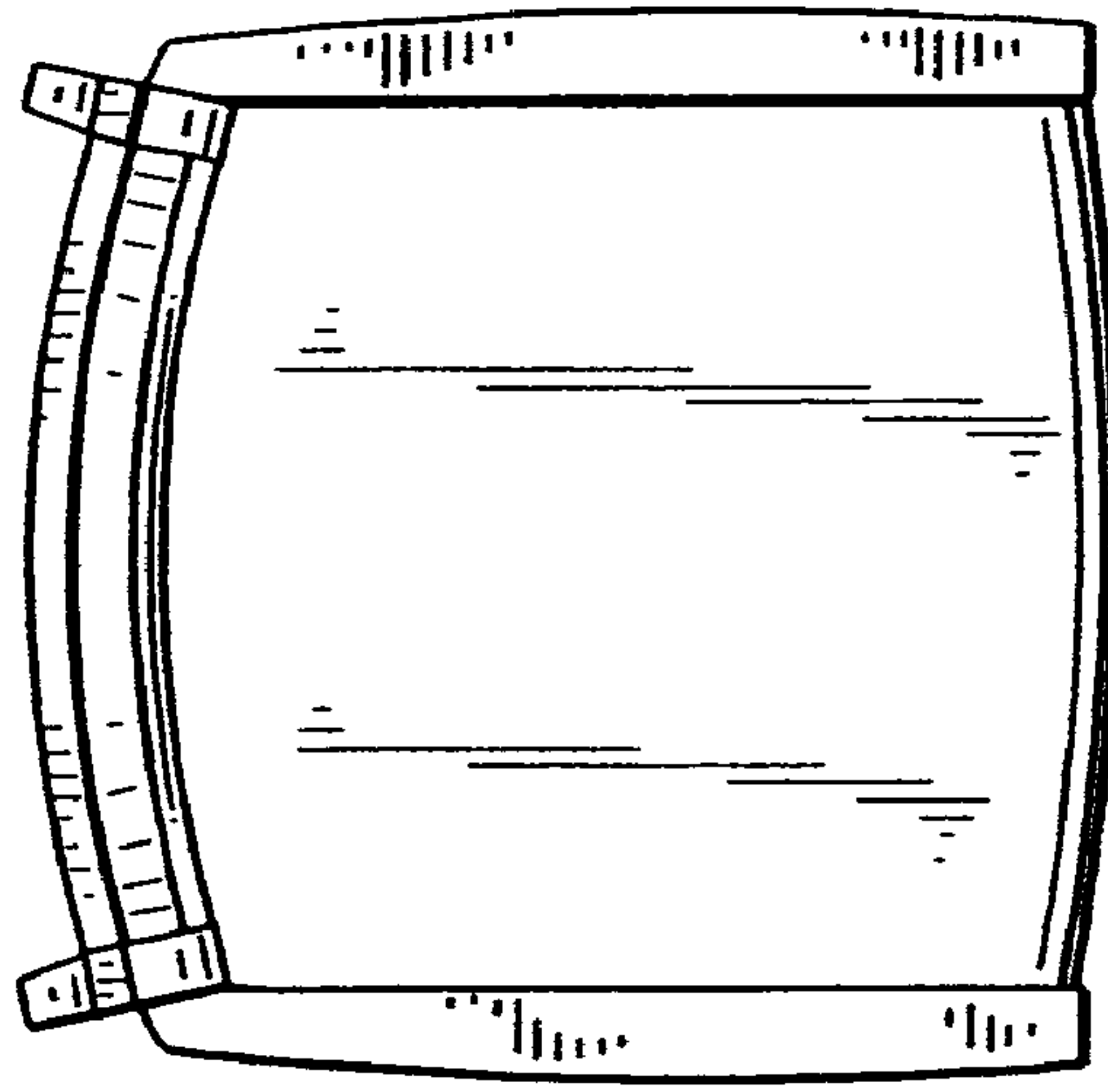

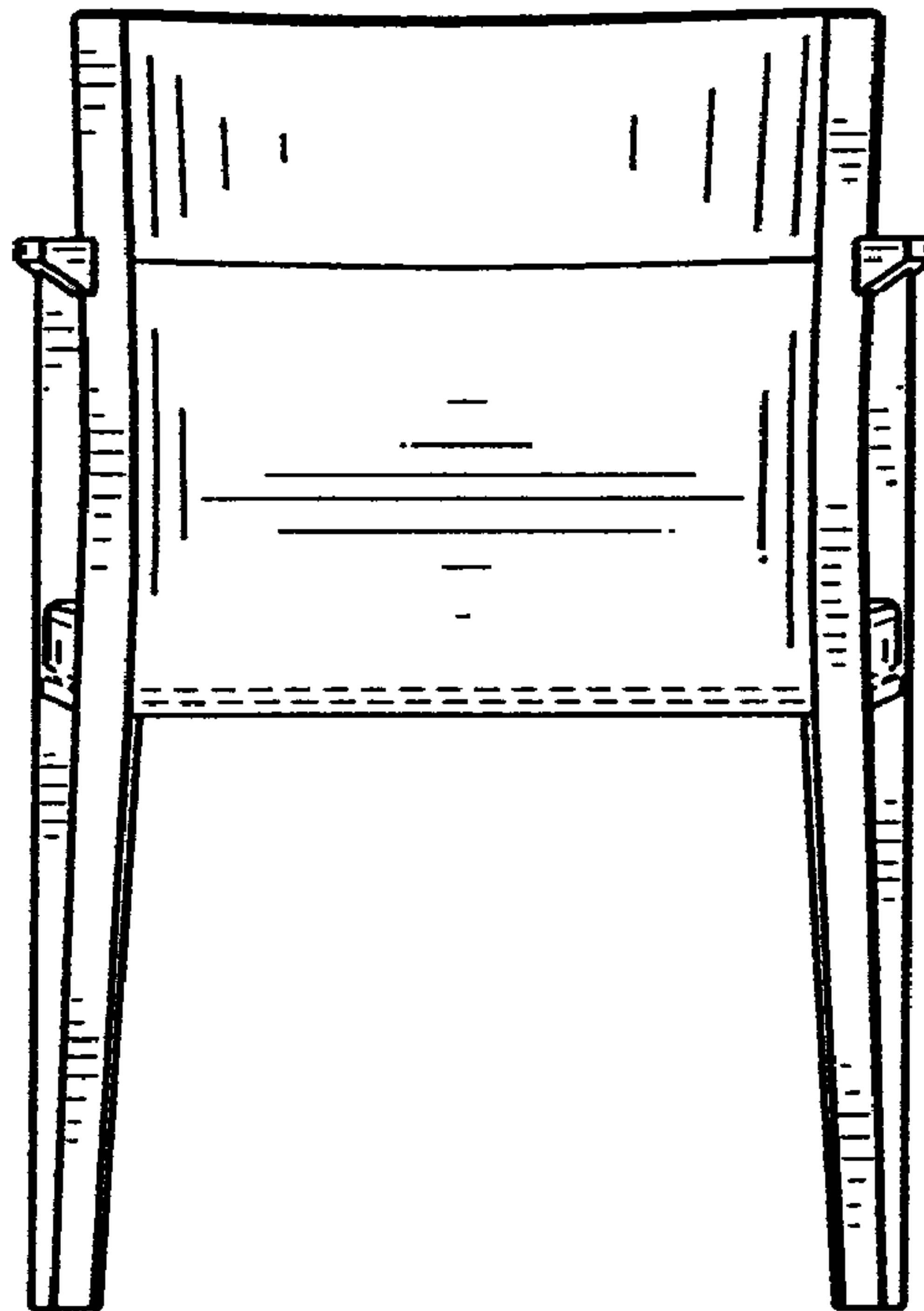

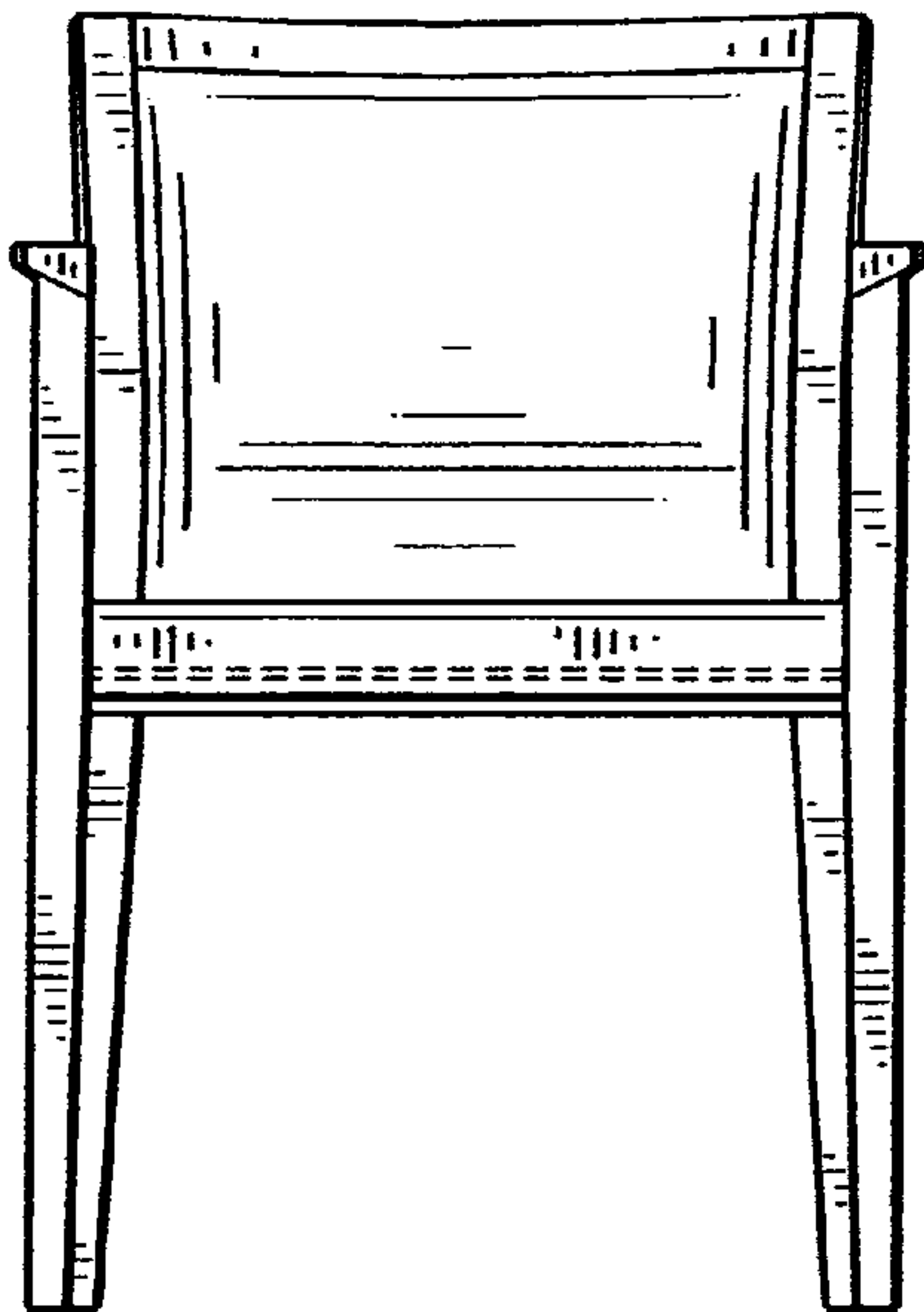
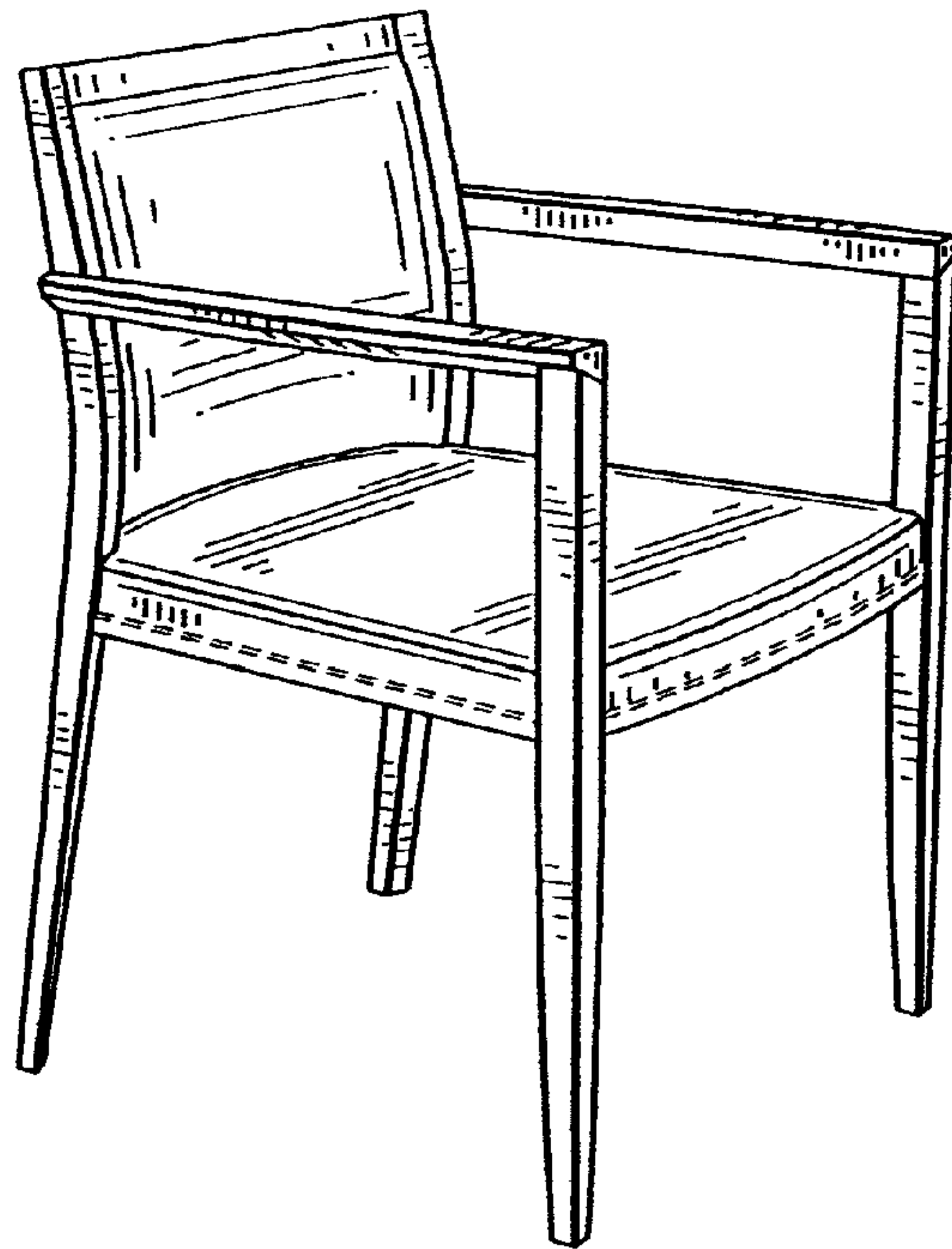

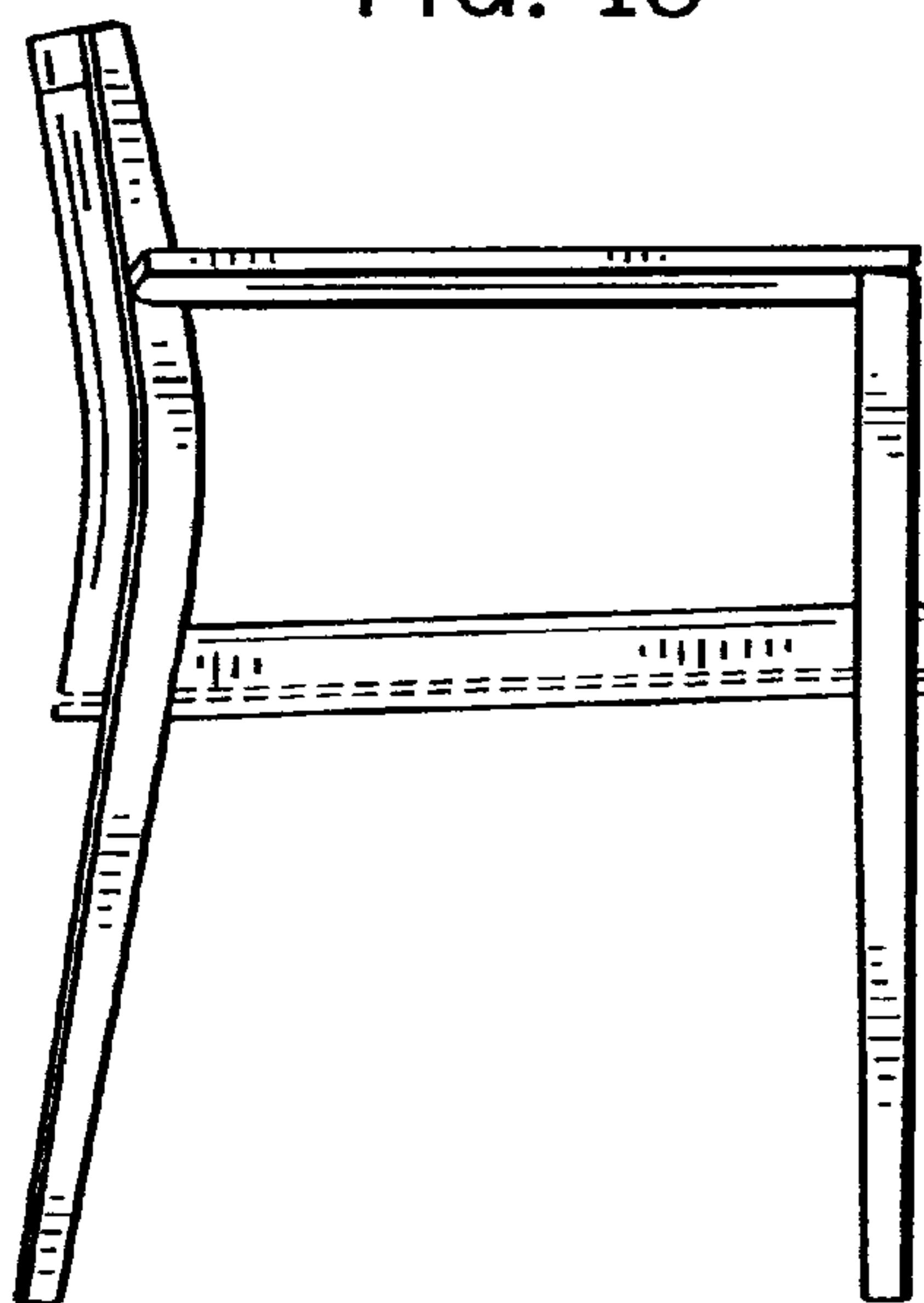

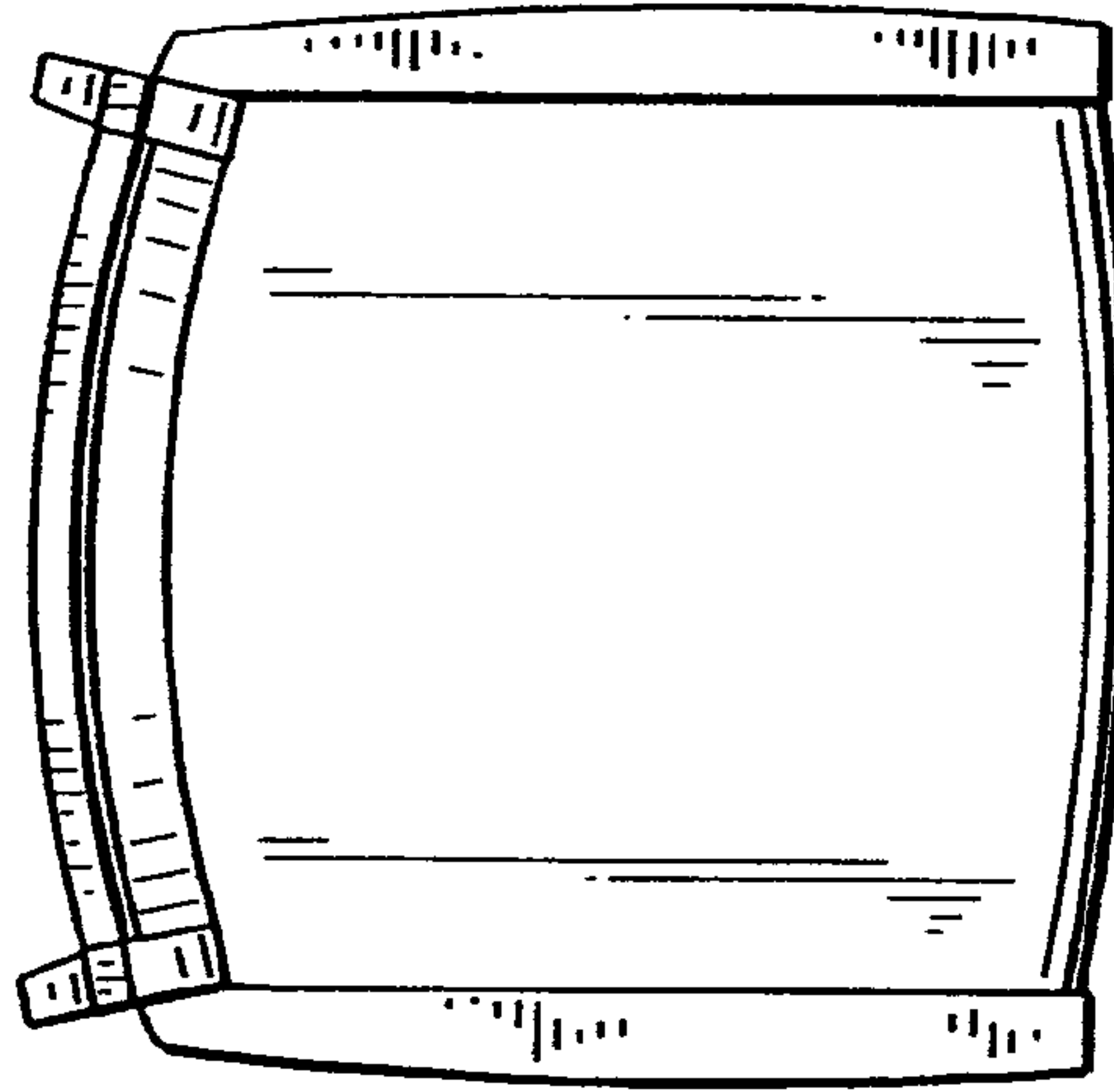
