FIG. 4 is a right end view thereof. A left end view thereof is an identical, mirror image of FIG. 3, and is omitted.

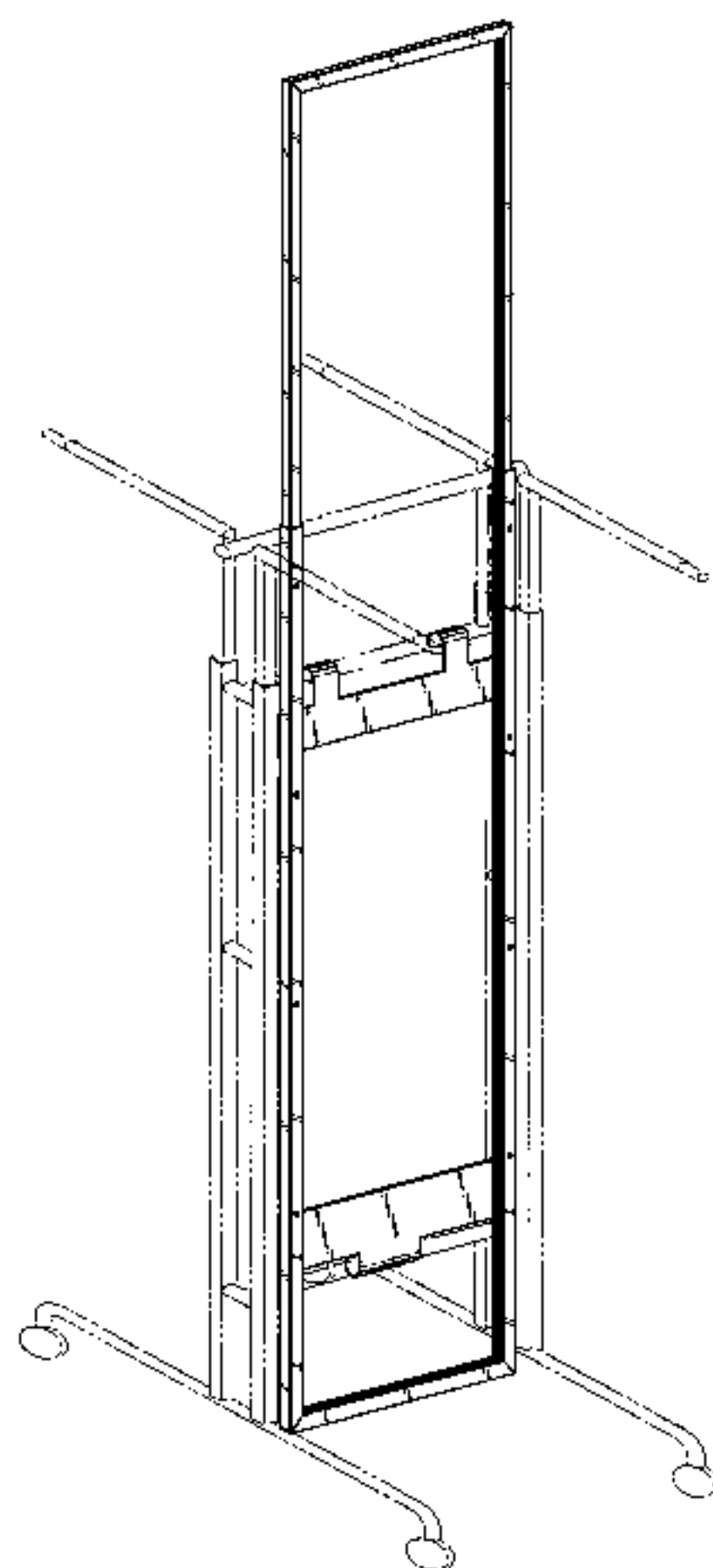
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof.

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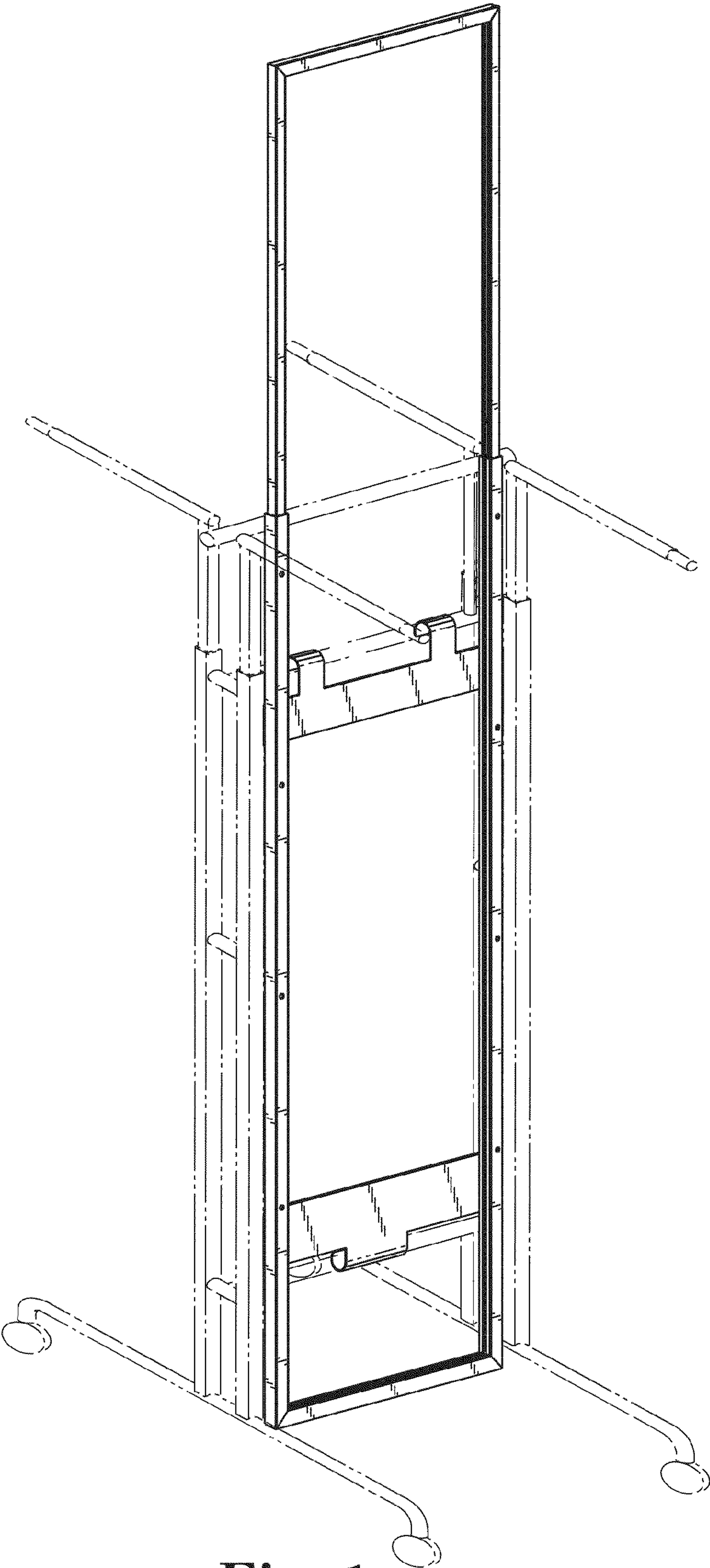

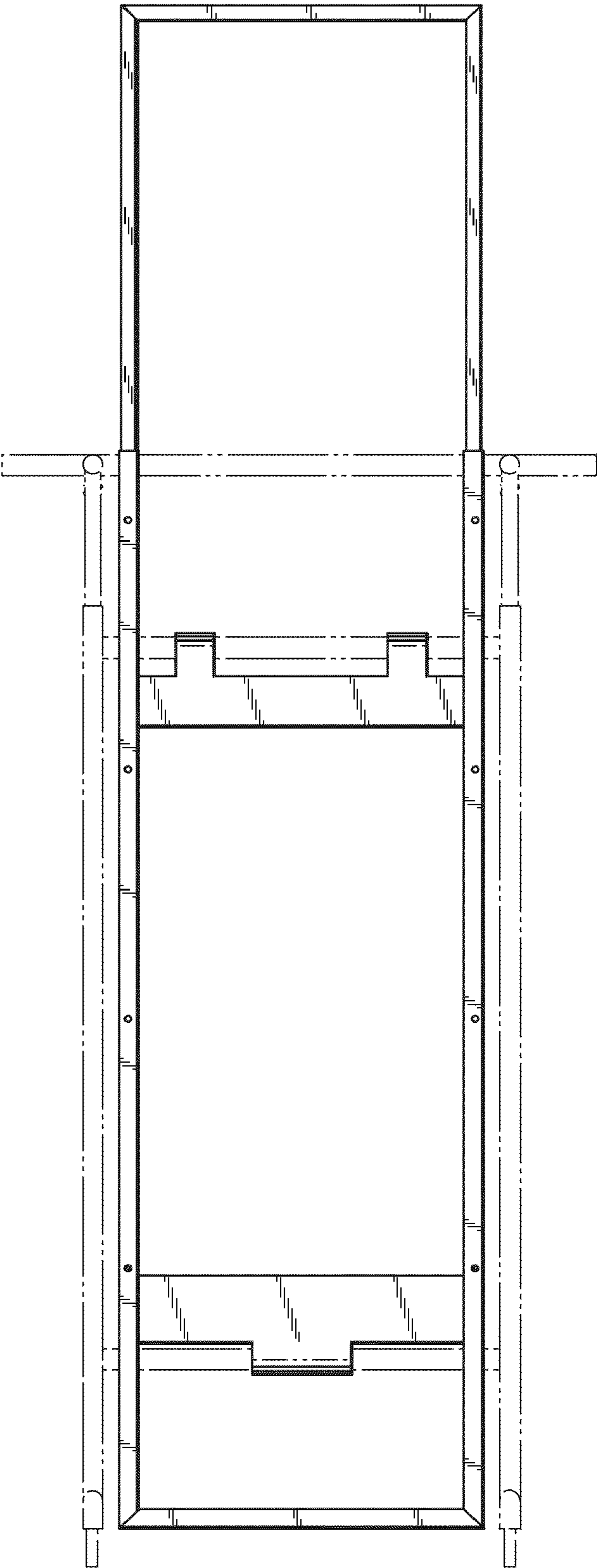

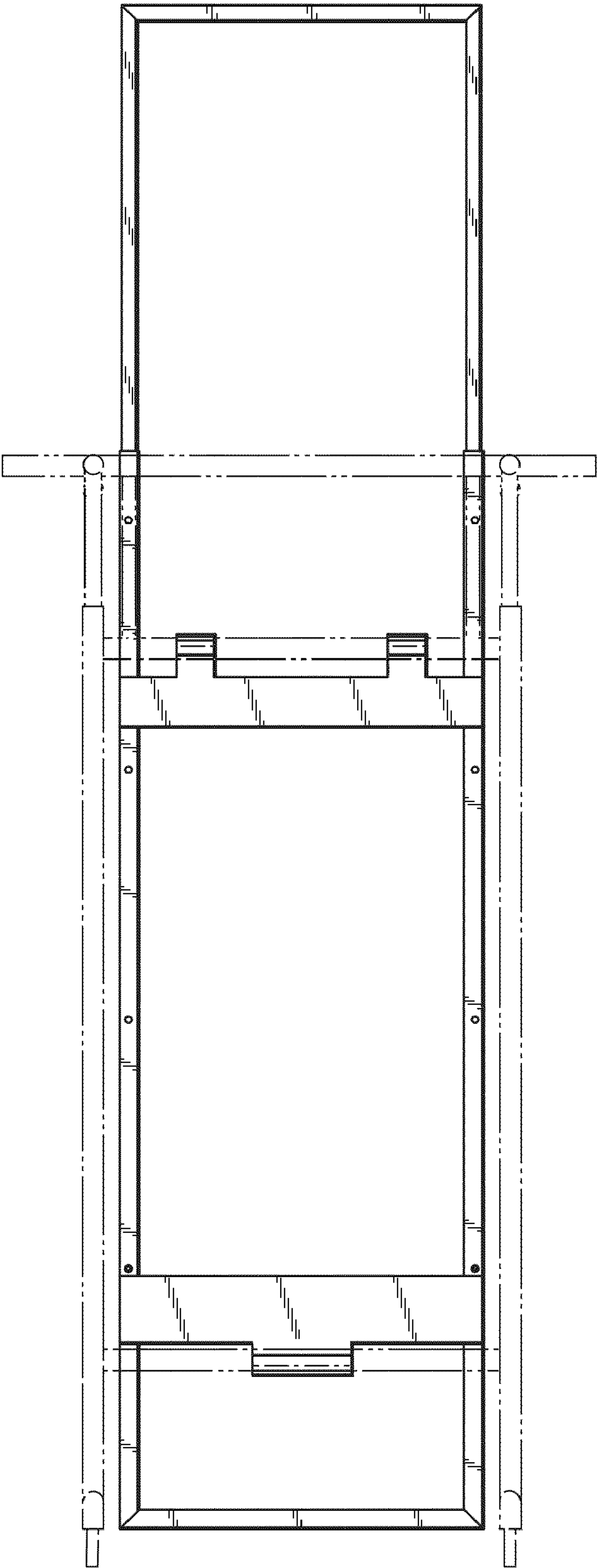

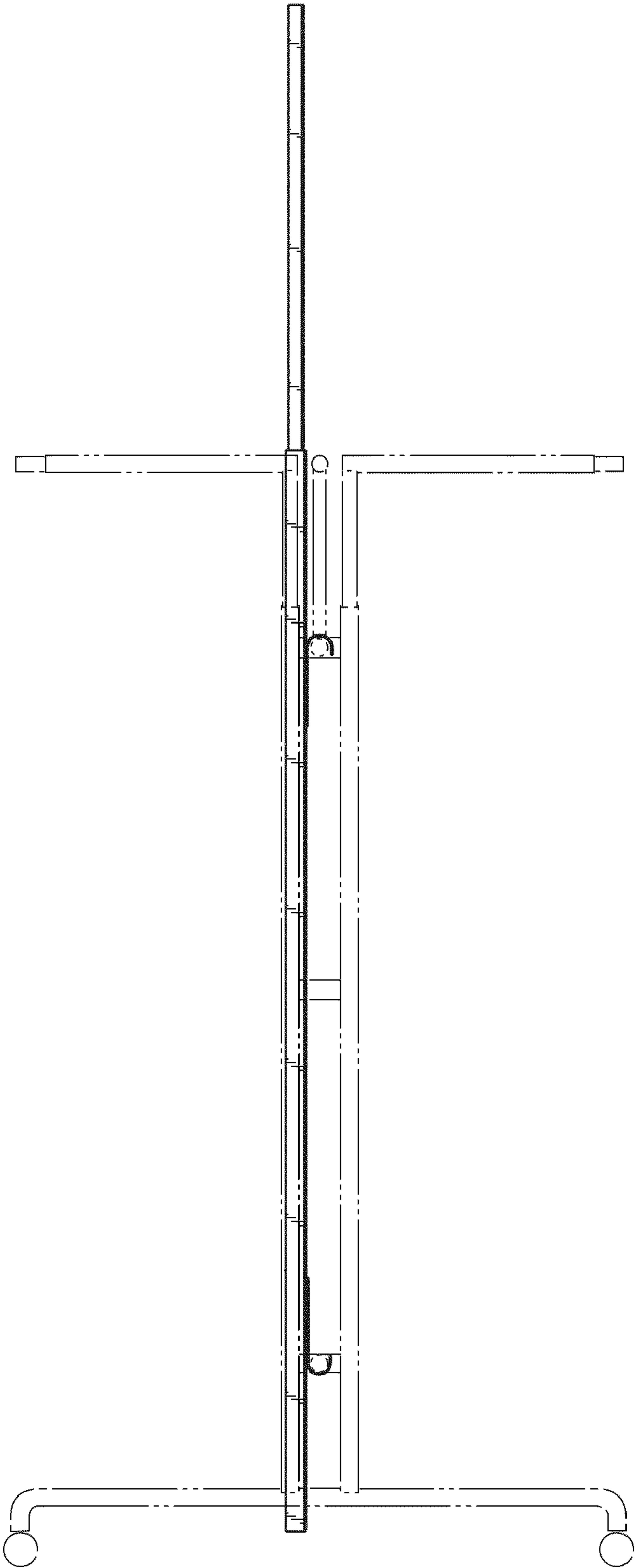

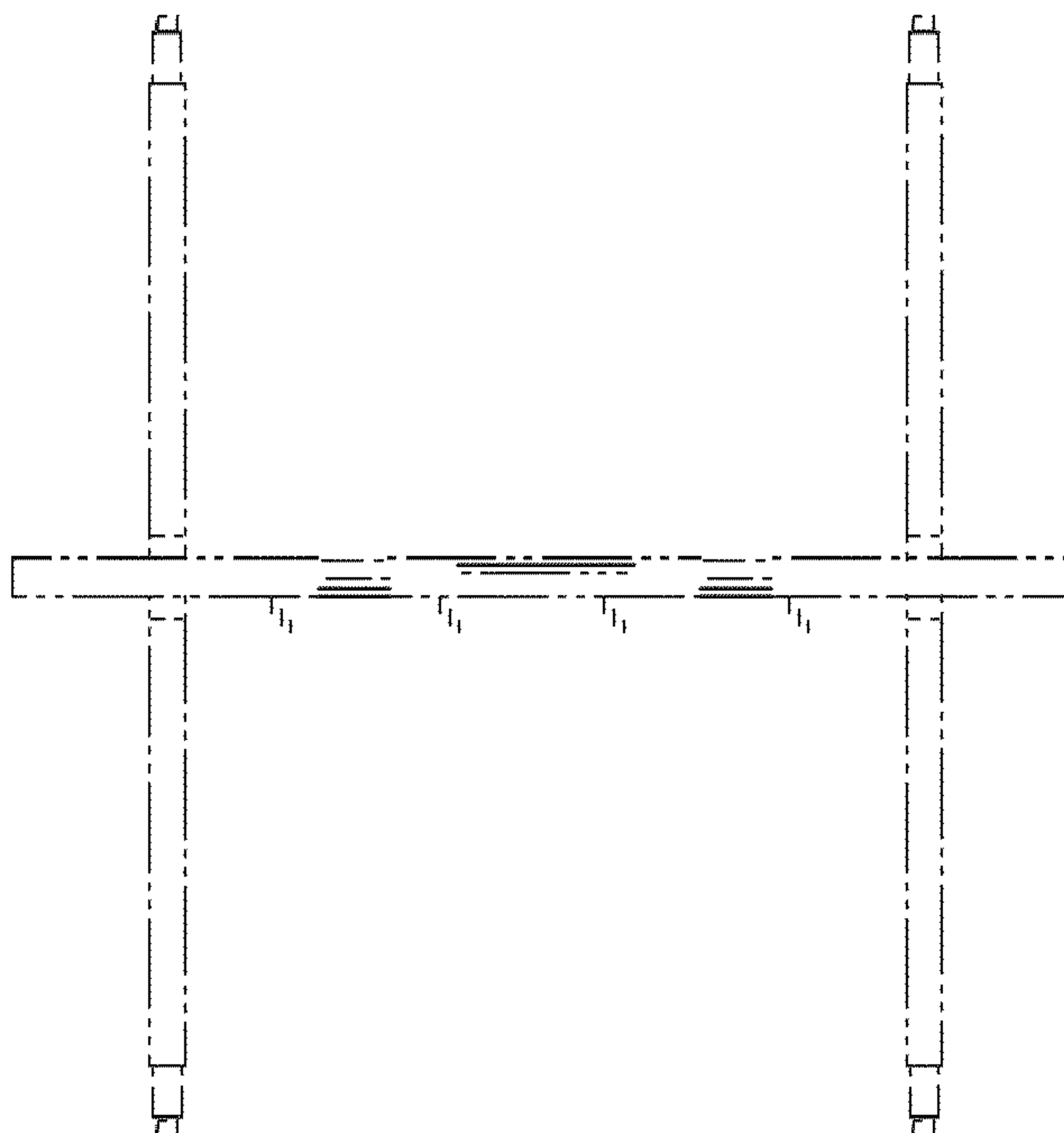

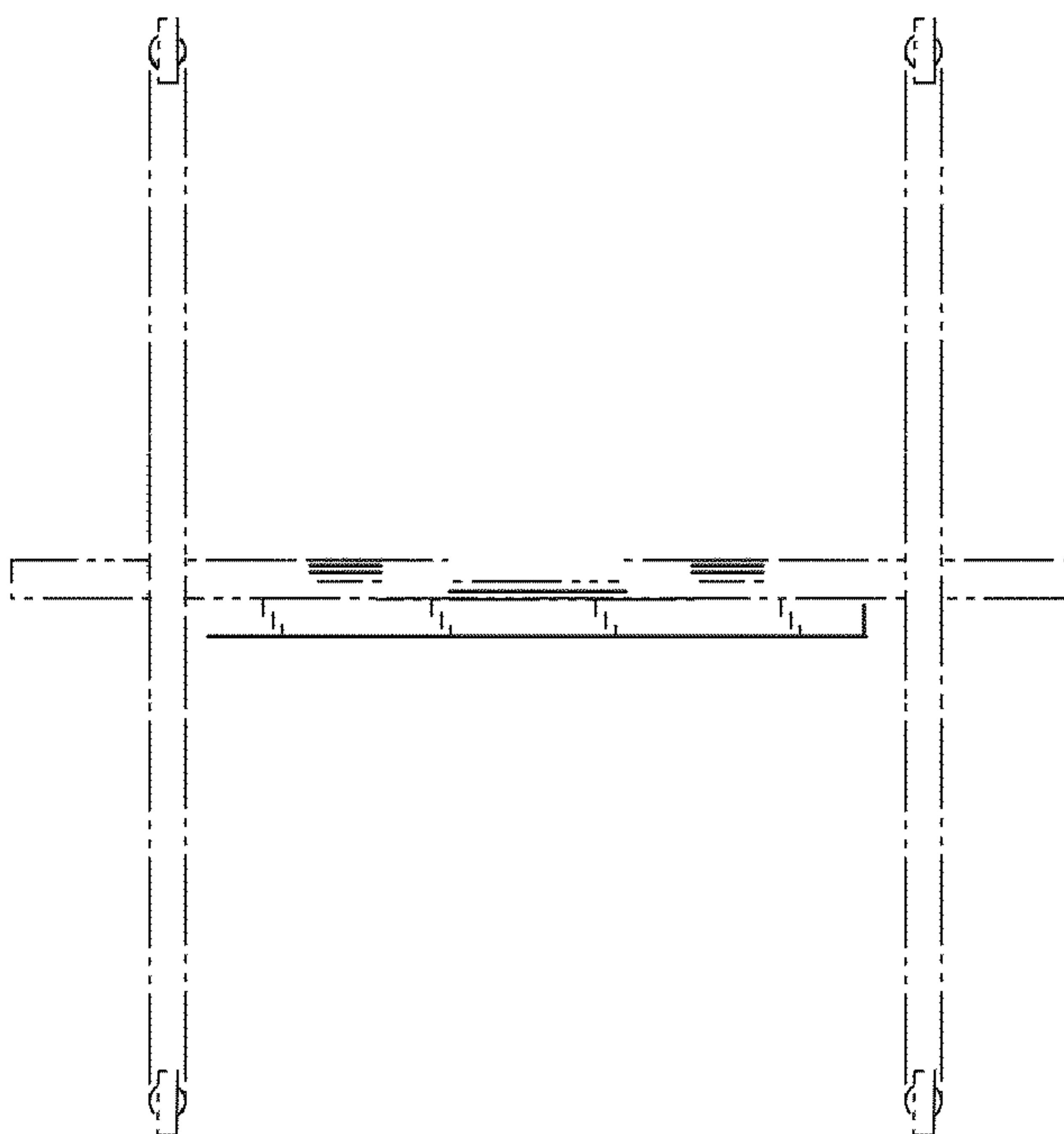

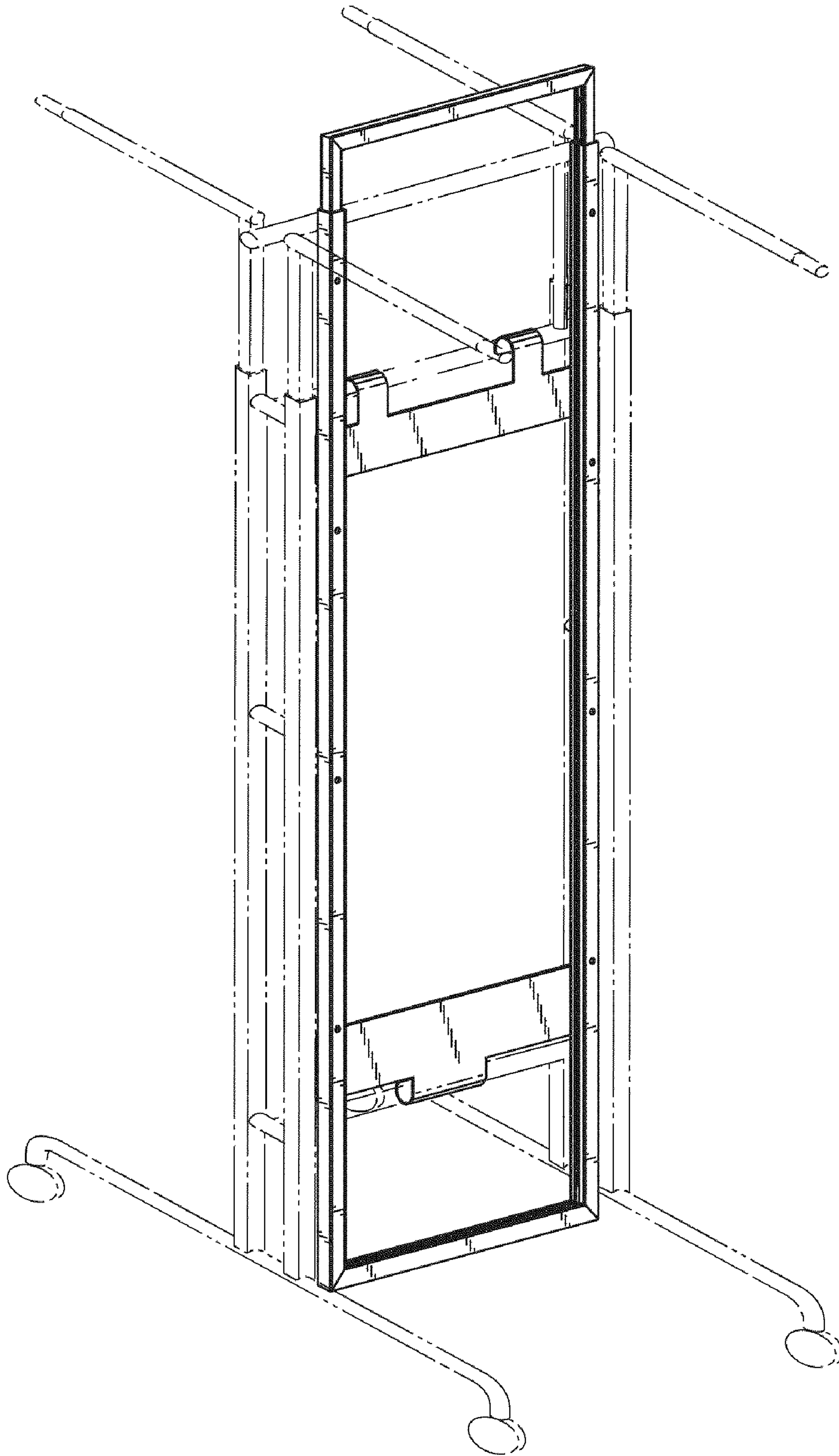
