FIG. 3 is an elevated view of the right side thereof;

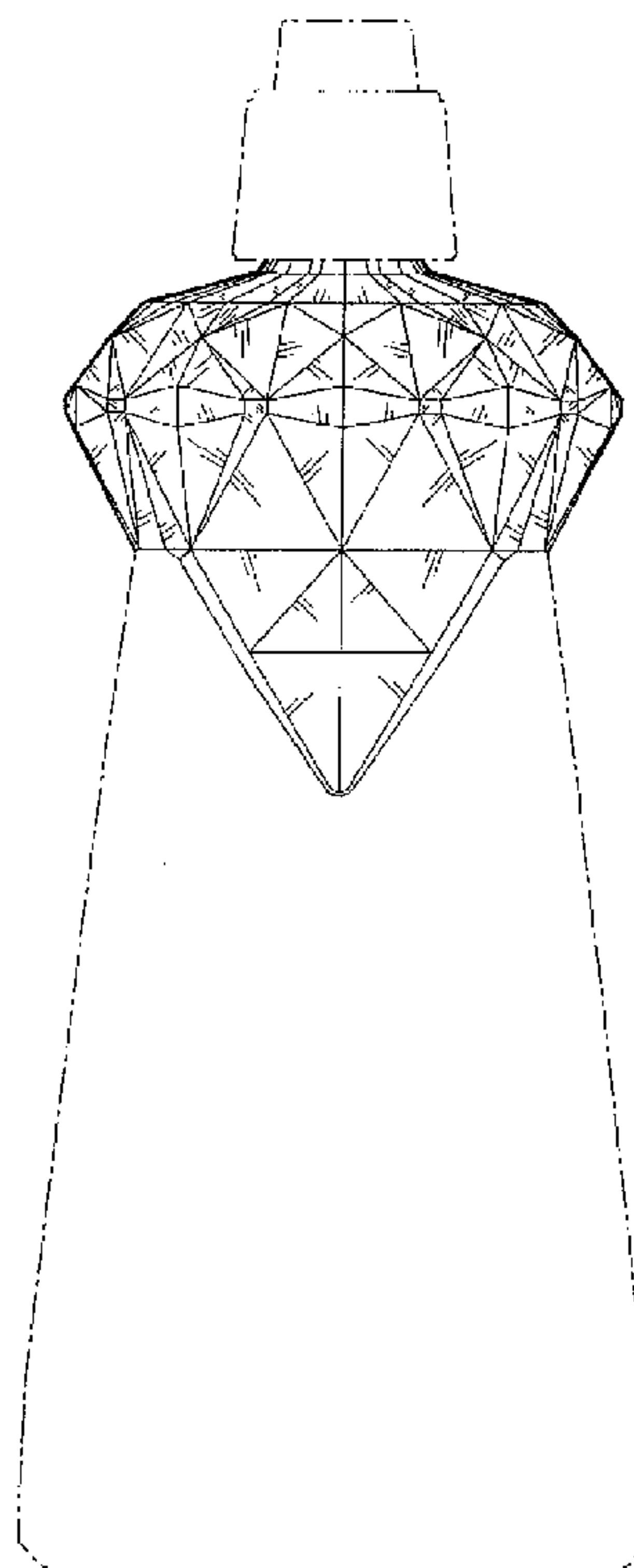
FIG. 4 is an elevated view of the left side thereof;

FIG. 5 is a plan view of the top thereof; and,

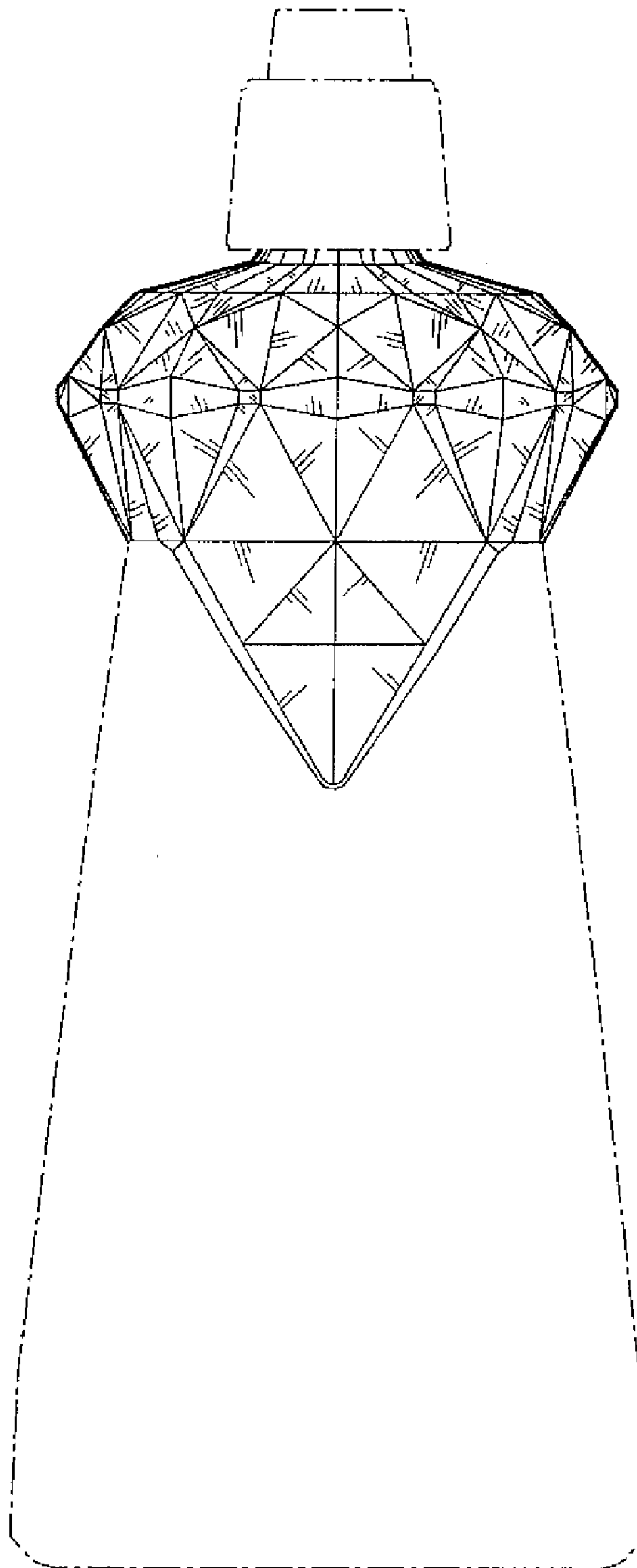
FIG. 6 is a plan view of the bottom thereof.

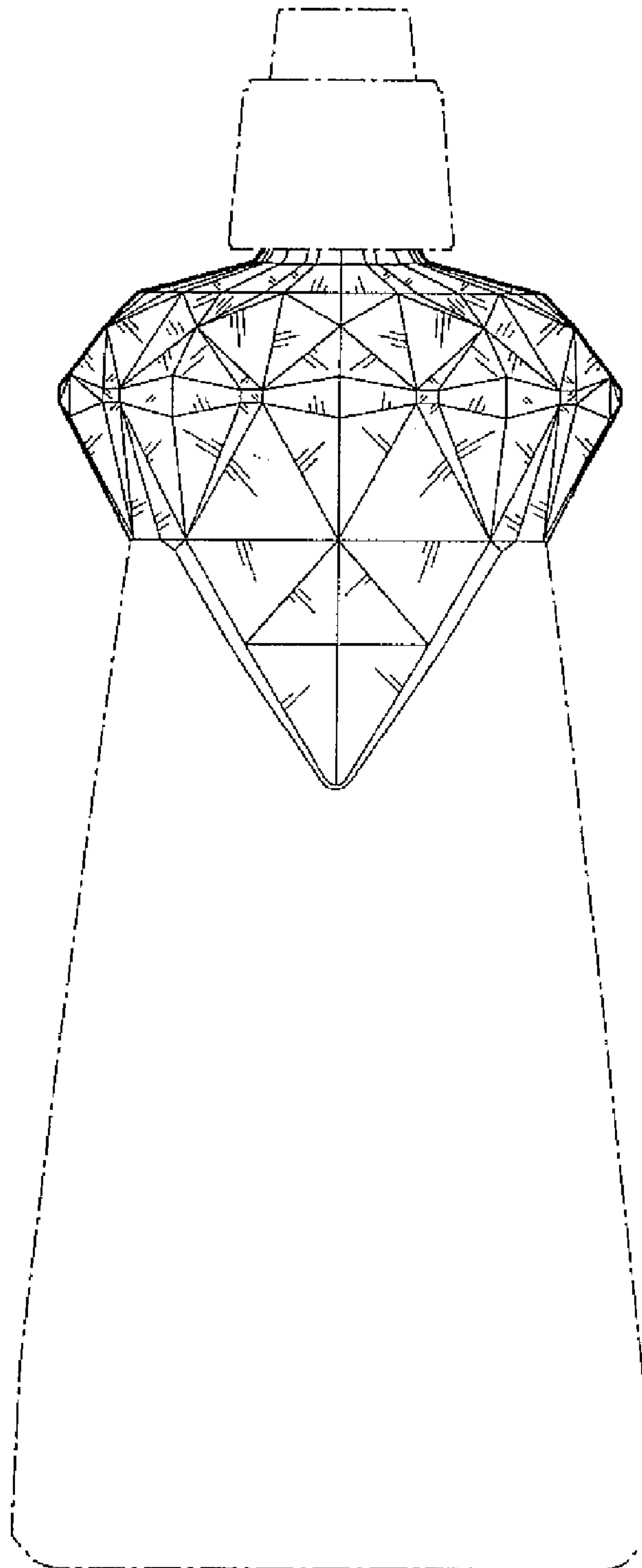

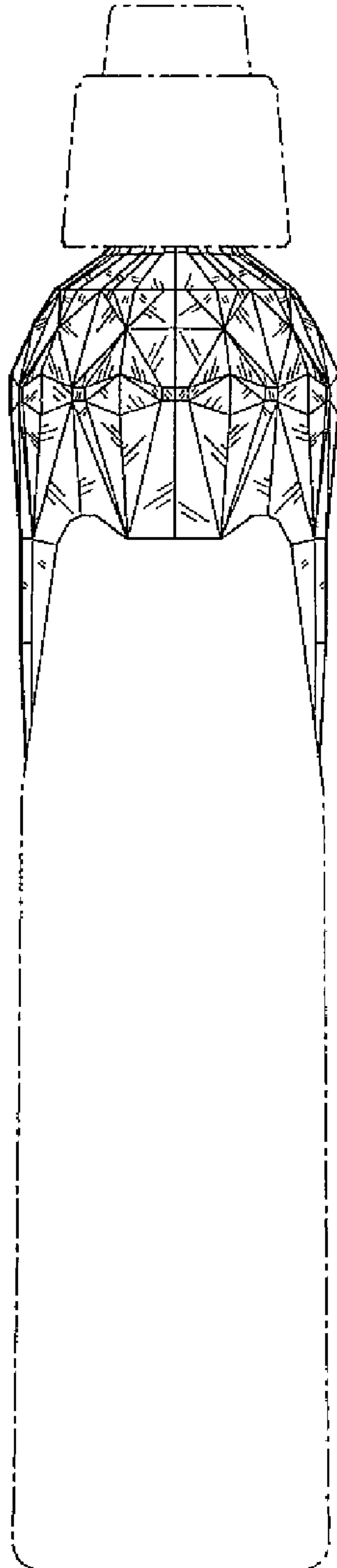

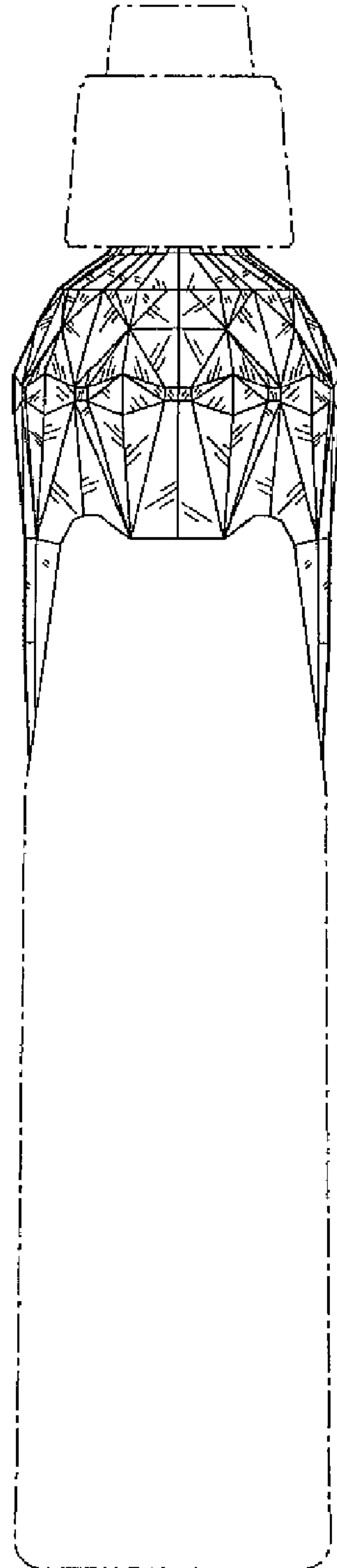

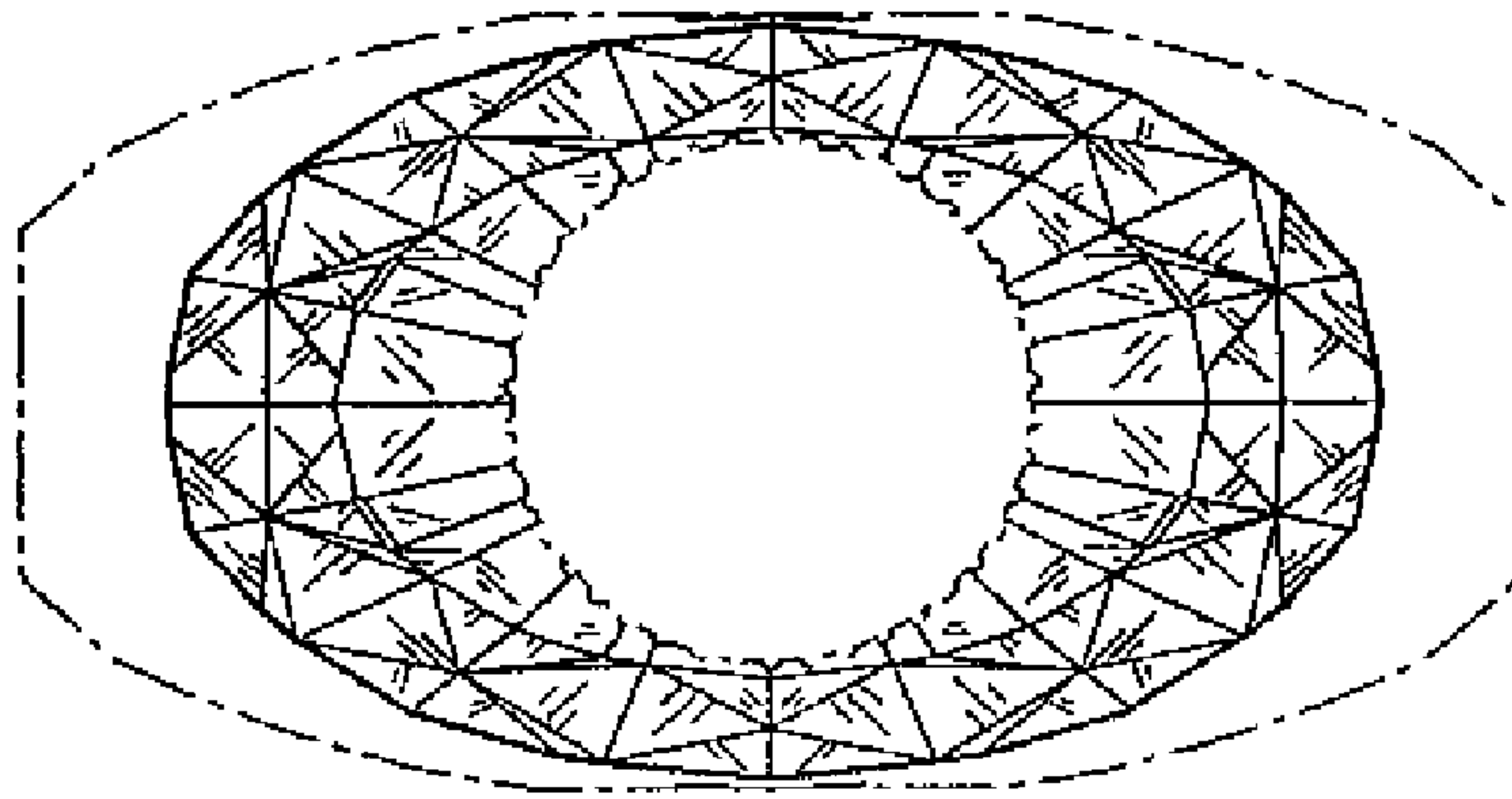
