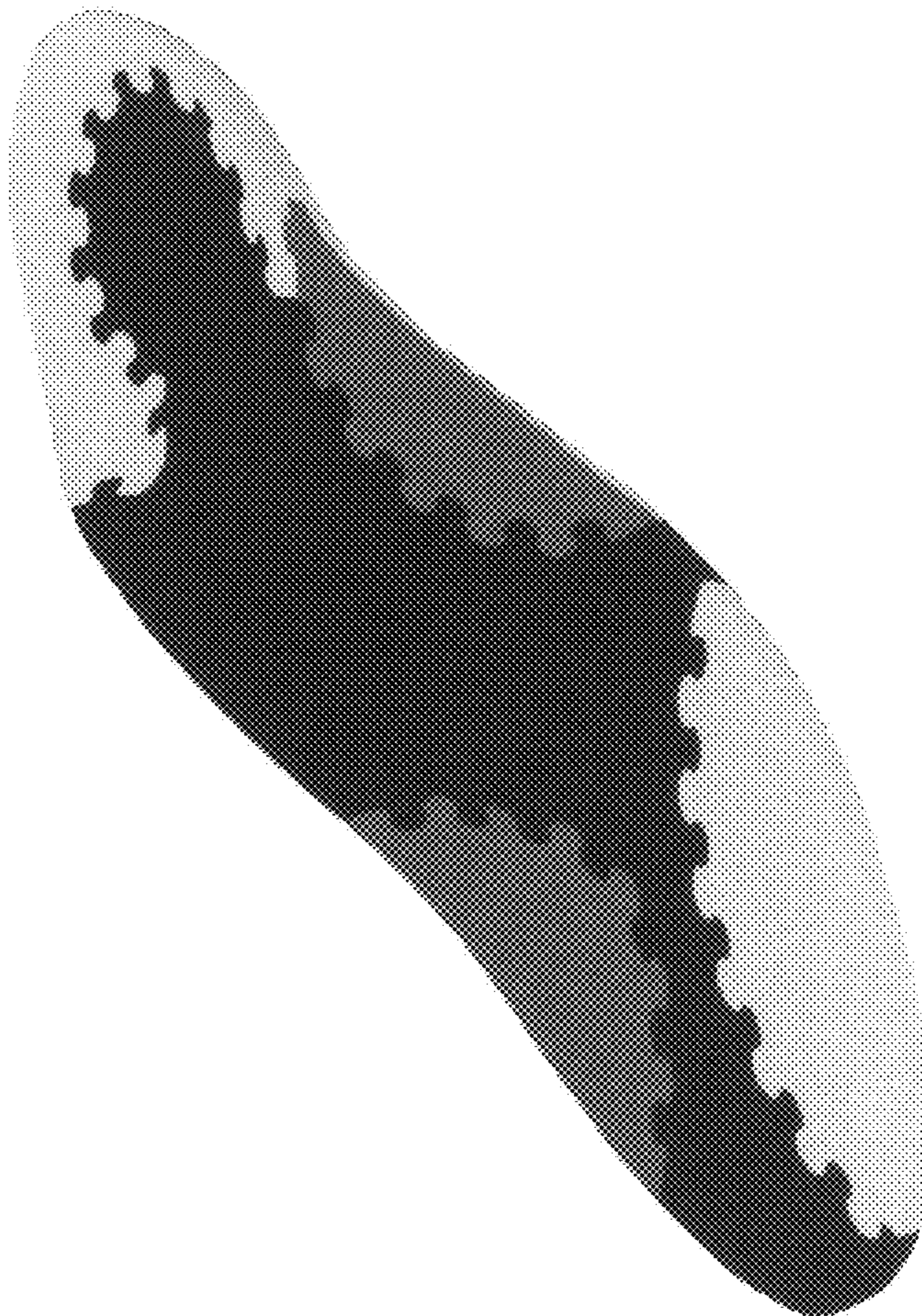
The sole FIGURE is a perspective view of an orthopedic insole showing our new design.

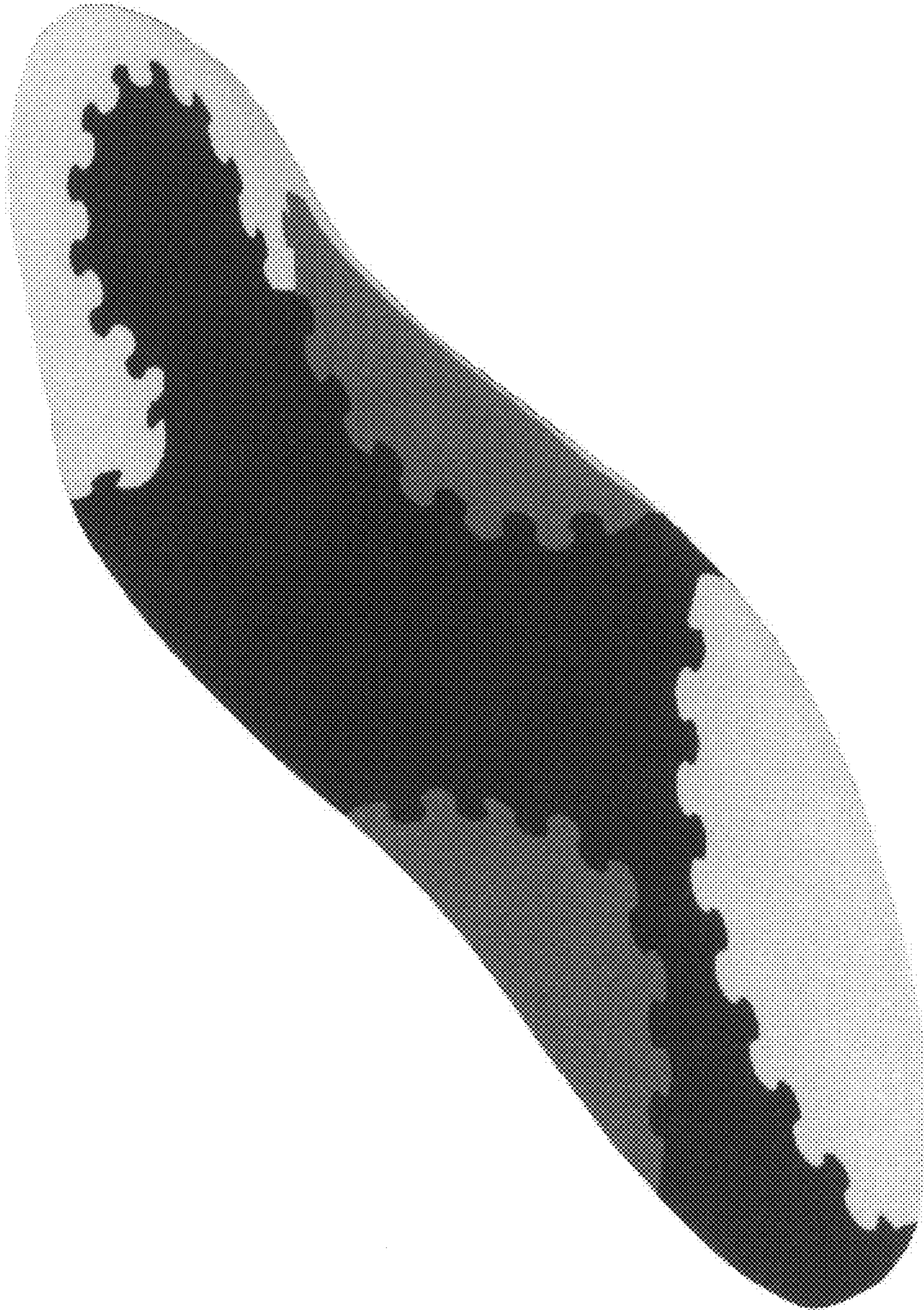
