The ornamental design for a goggles for preventing eye watering when cutting onions, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a pictorial view from the front of goggles for preventing eye watering when cutting onions according to the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a pictorial view from the rear of the inside of the goggles for preventing eye watering when cutting onions shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a top view of the goggles for preventing eye watering when cutting onions shown in FIGS. 1 and 2.

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the goggles for preventing eye watering when cutting onions shown in FIGS. 1–3.

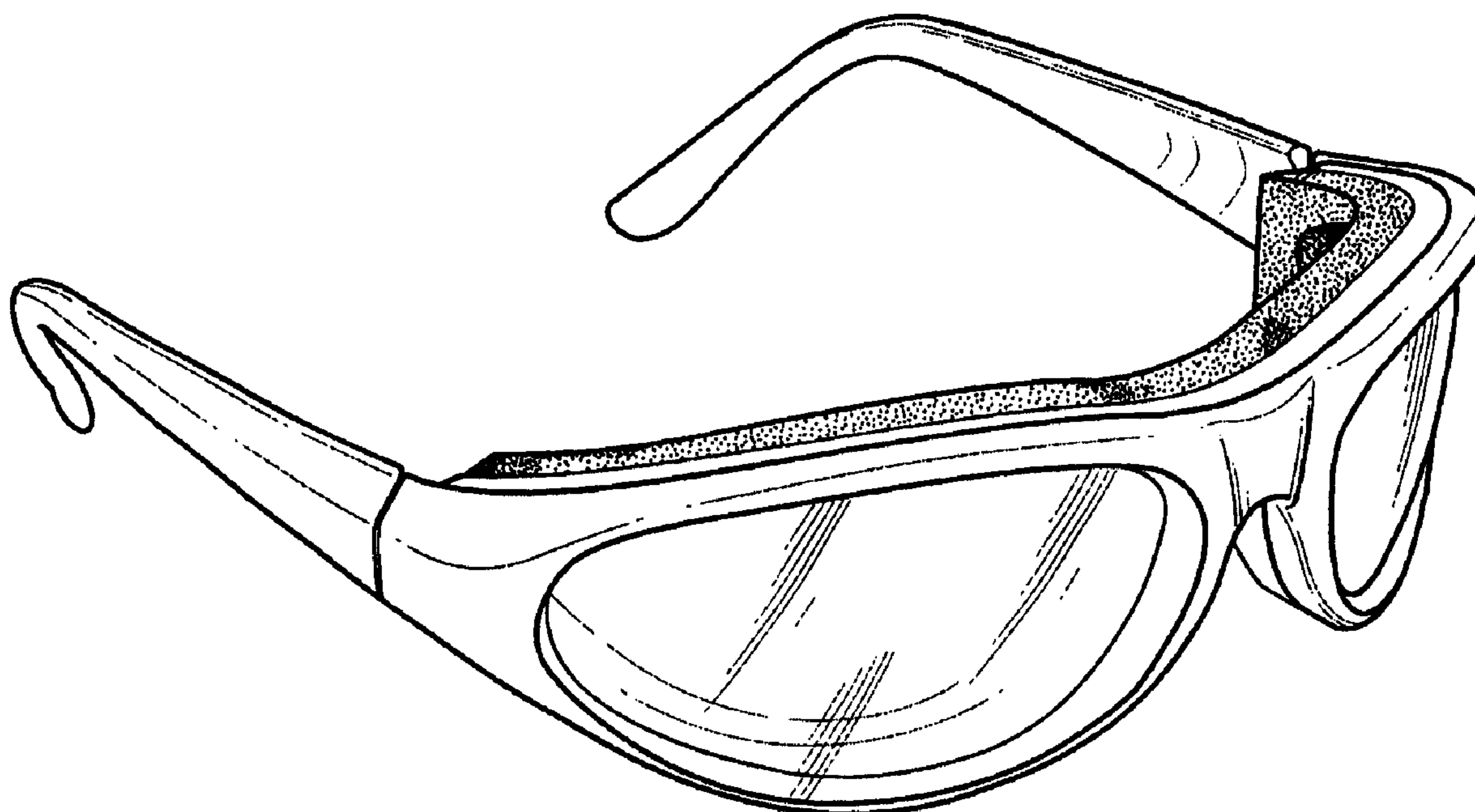

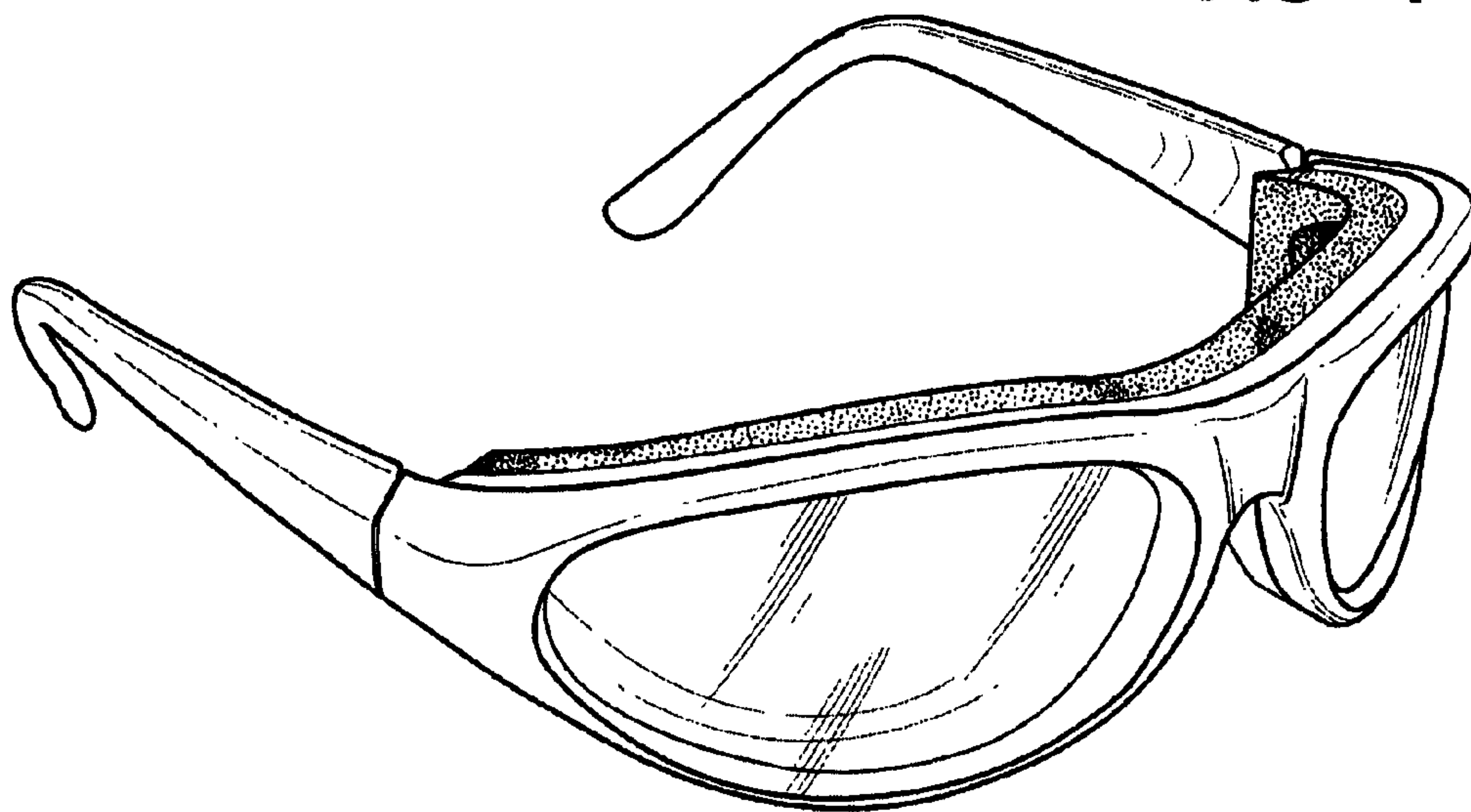

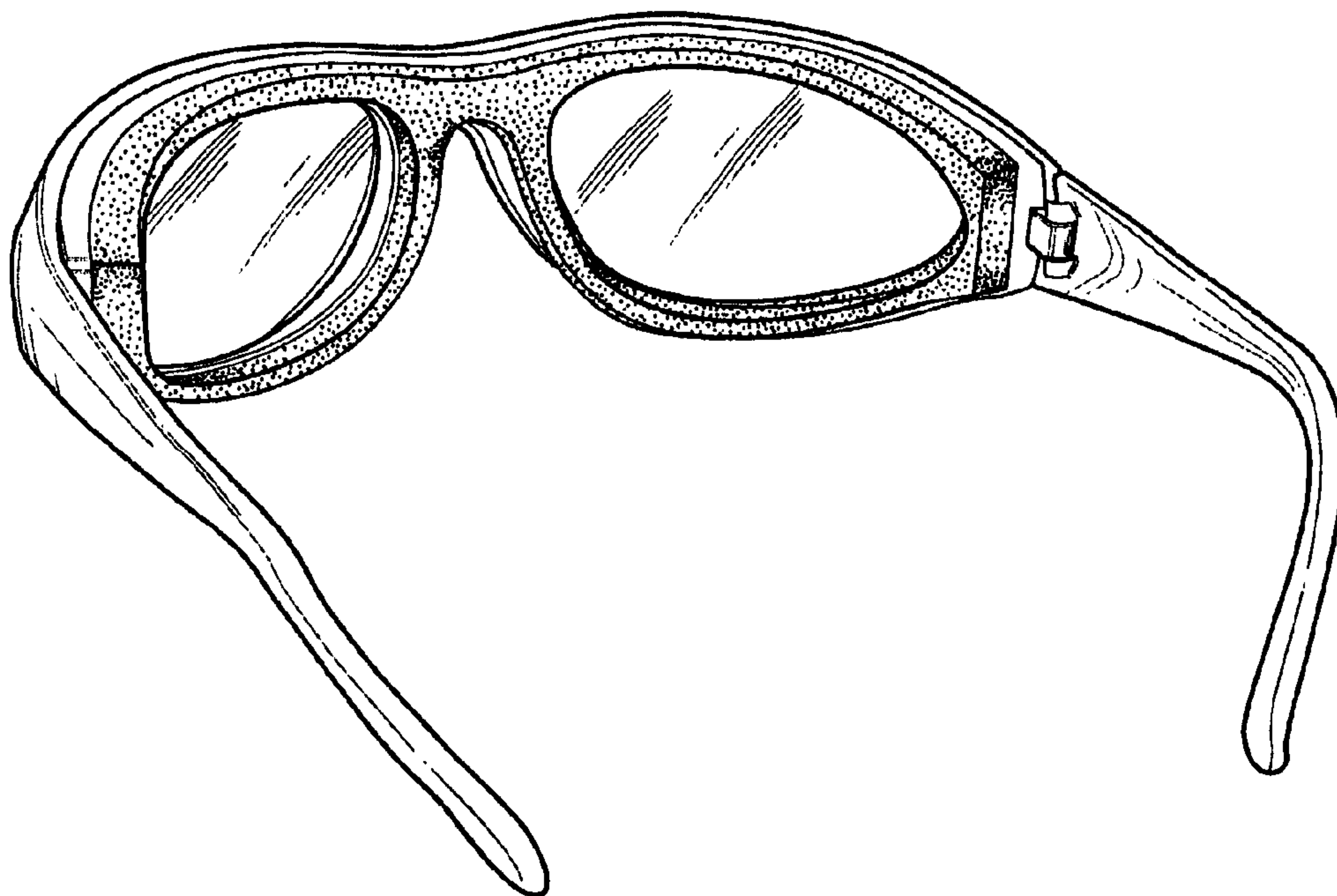

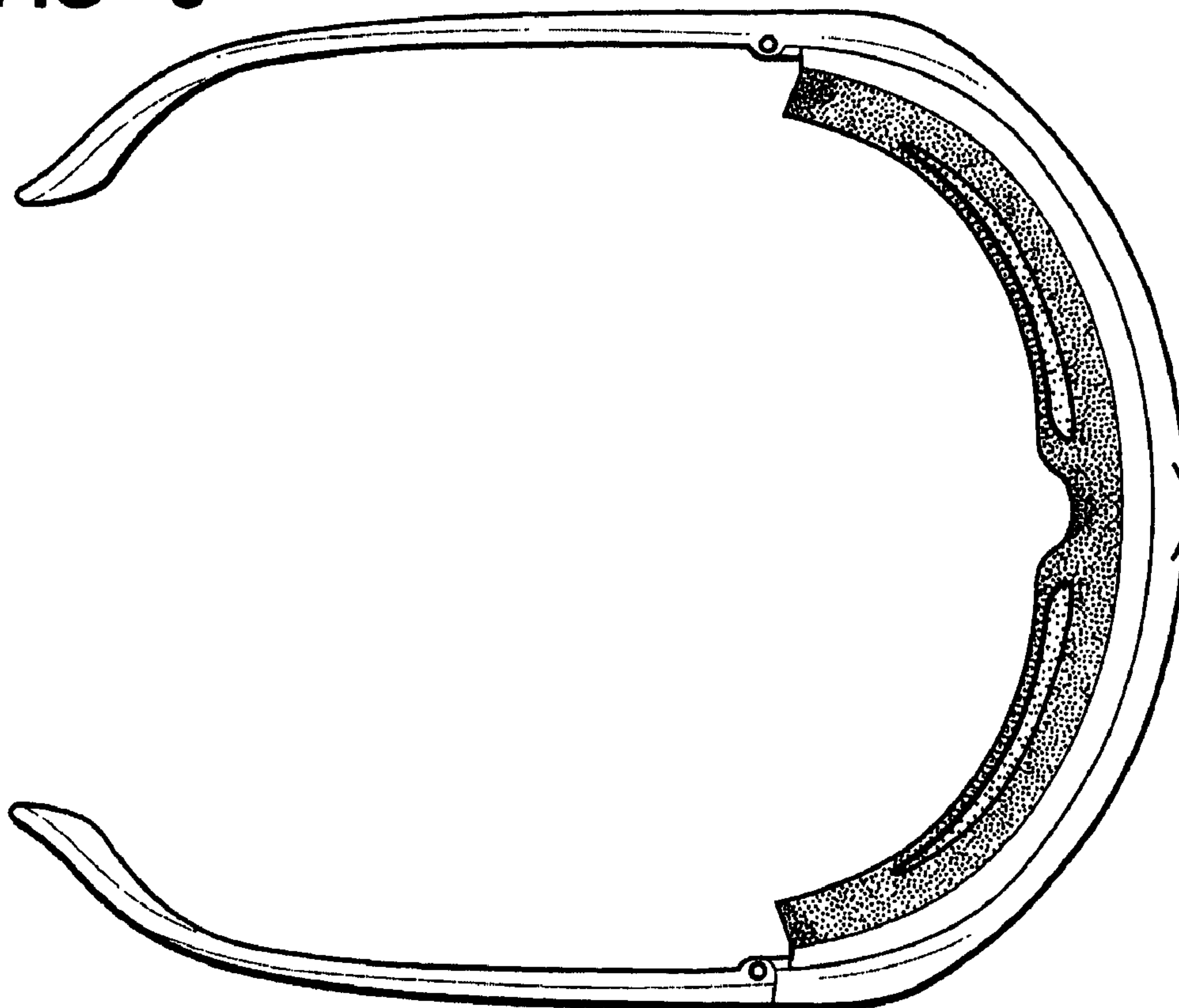

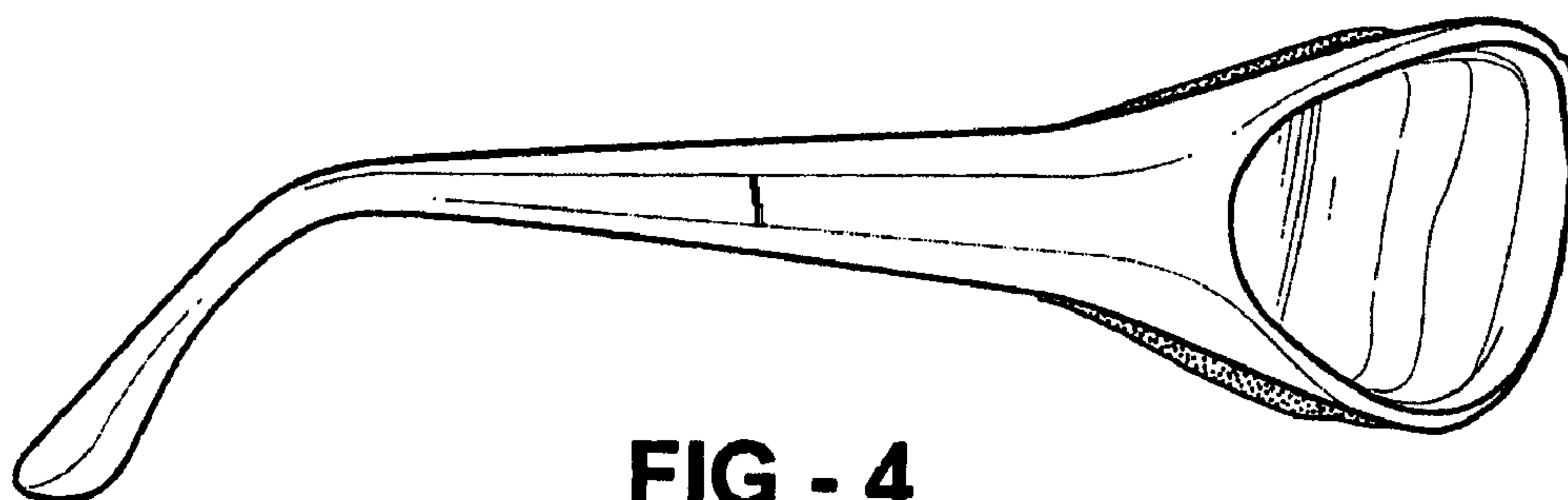

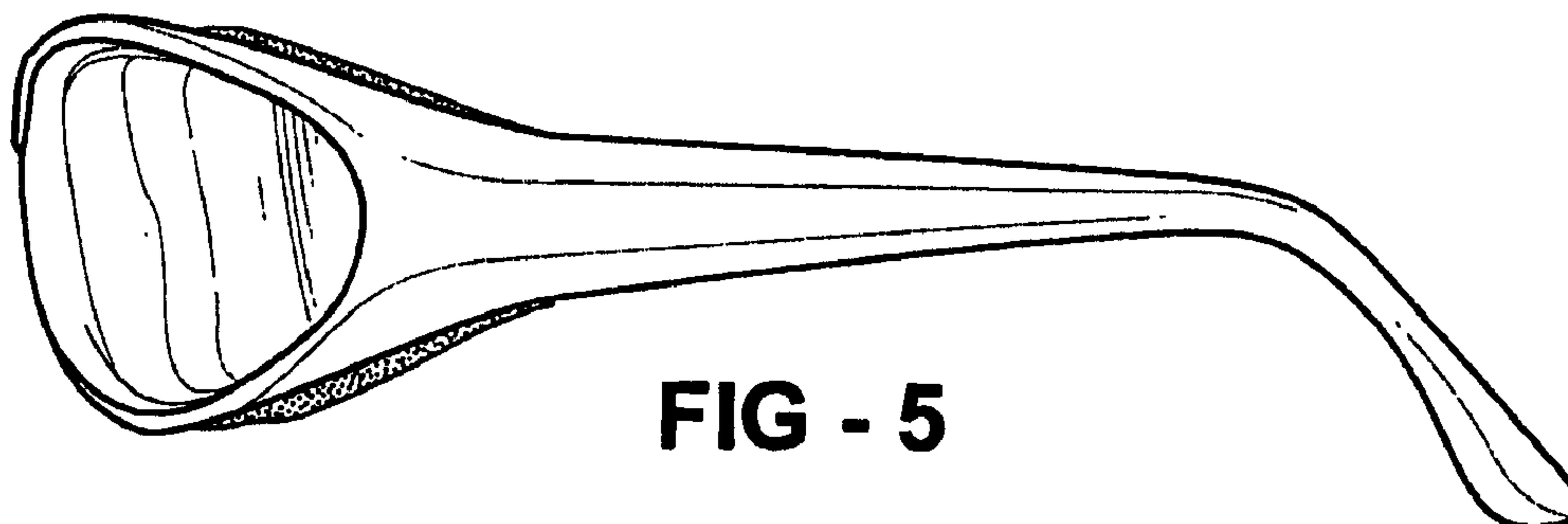

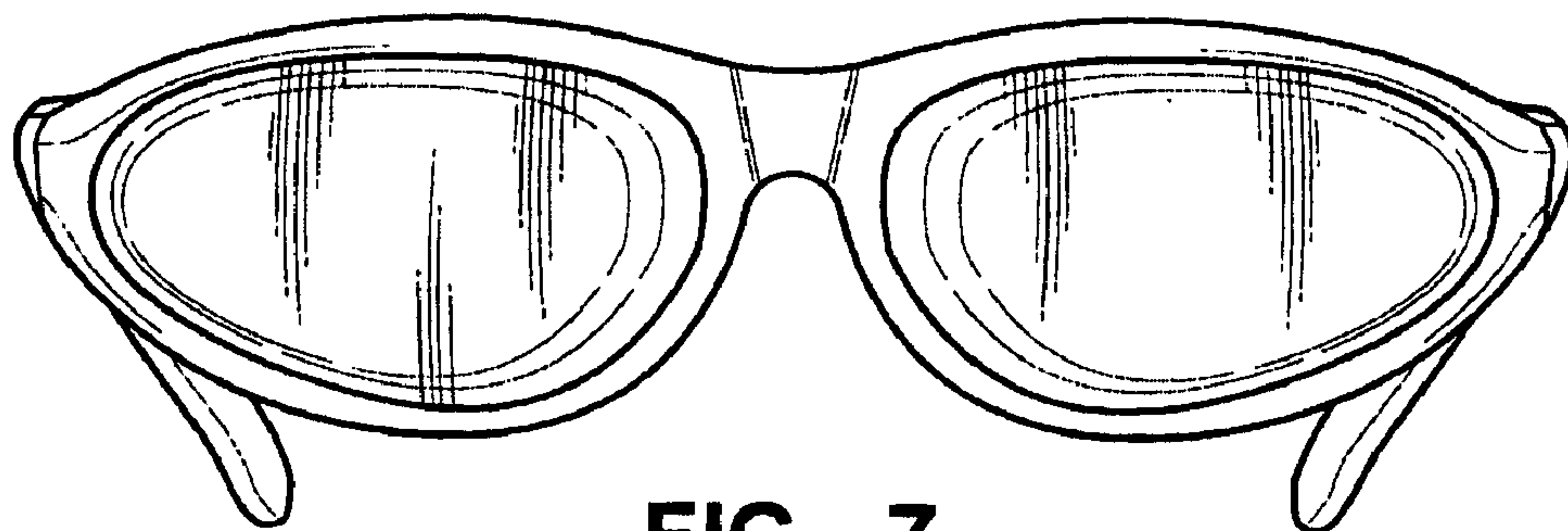
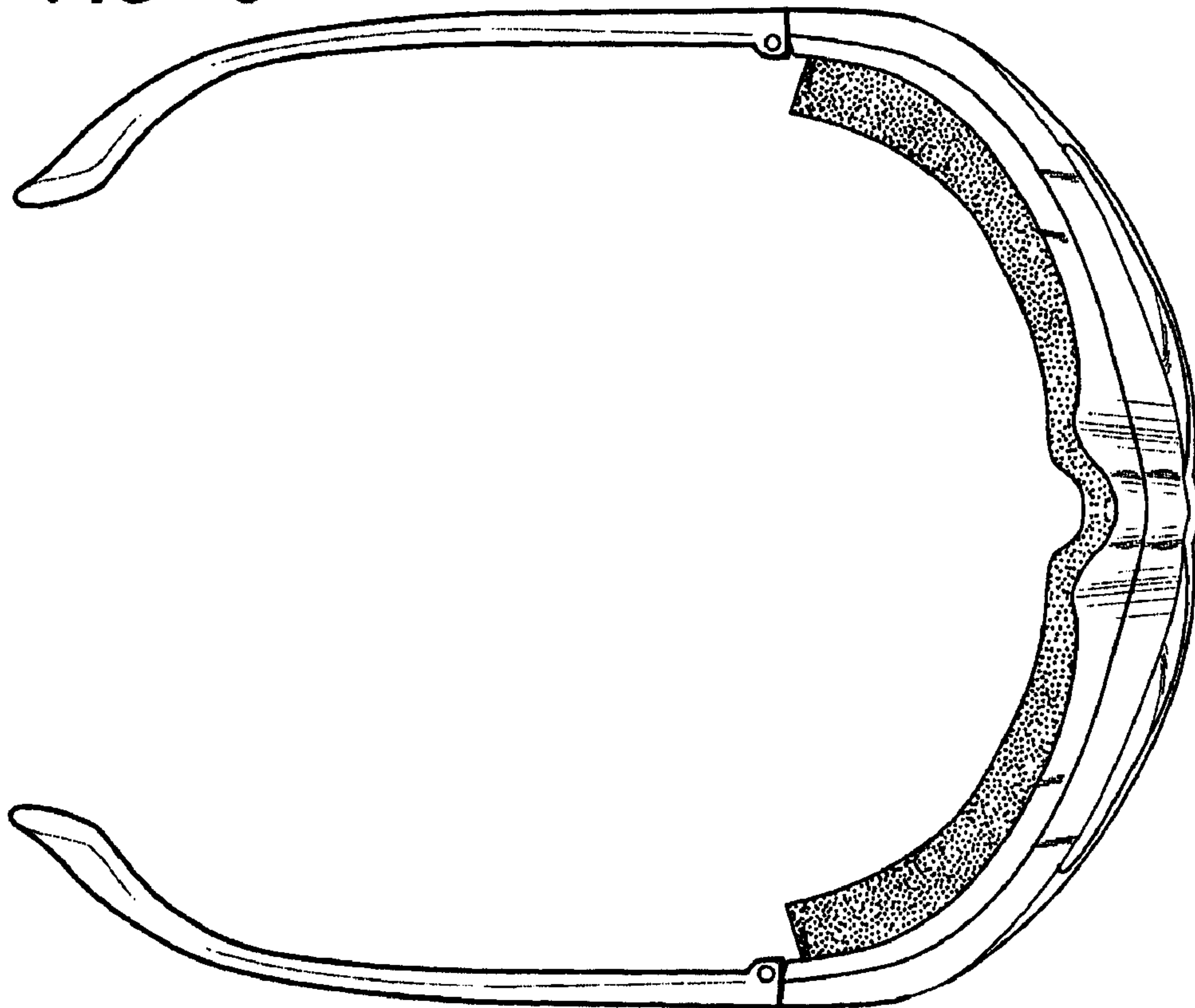

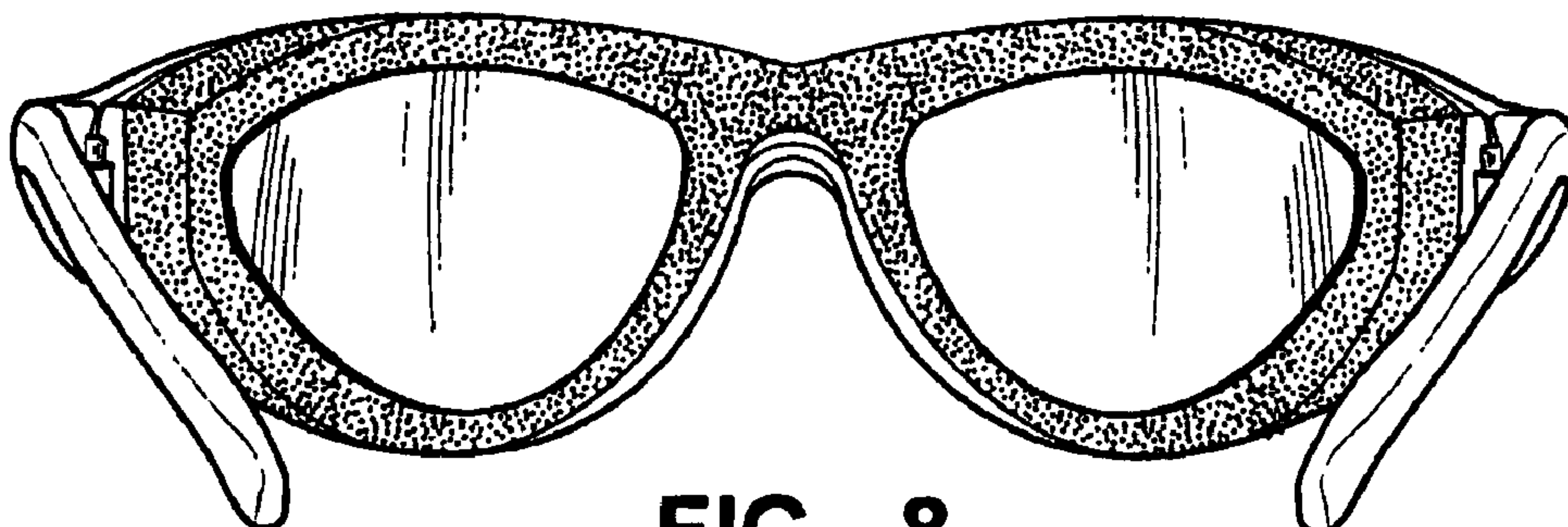
