FIG. 3 is a right side view of the transcranial magnetic stimulation system of the design that is depicted in FIGS. 1–2;

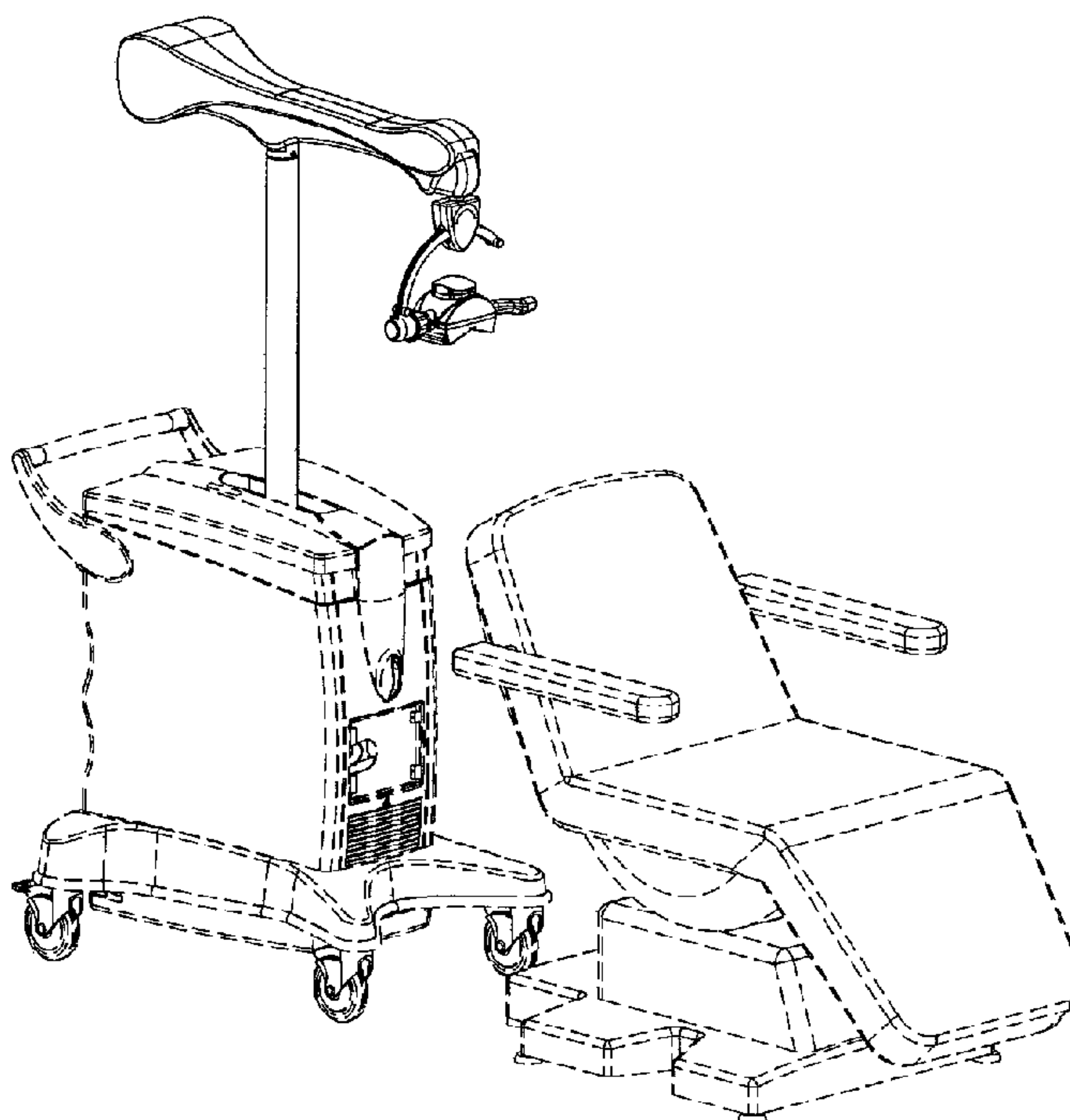
FIG. 4 is a left side view of the transcranial magnetic stimulation system of the design that is depicted in FIGS. 1–3;

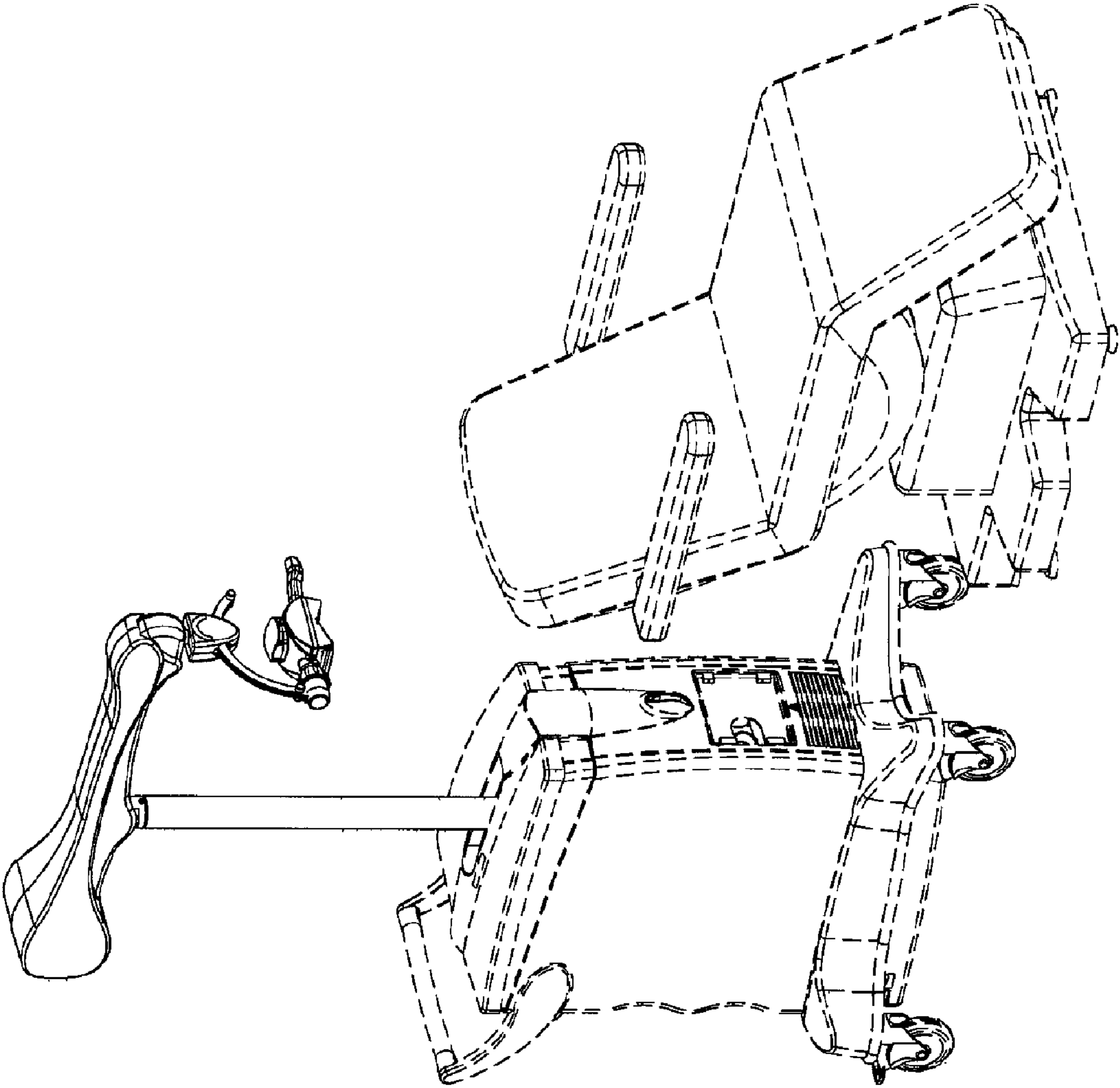

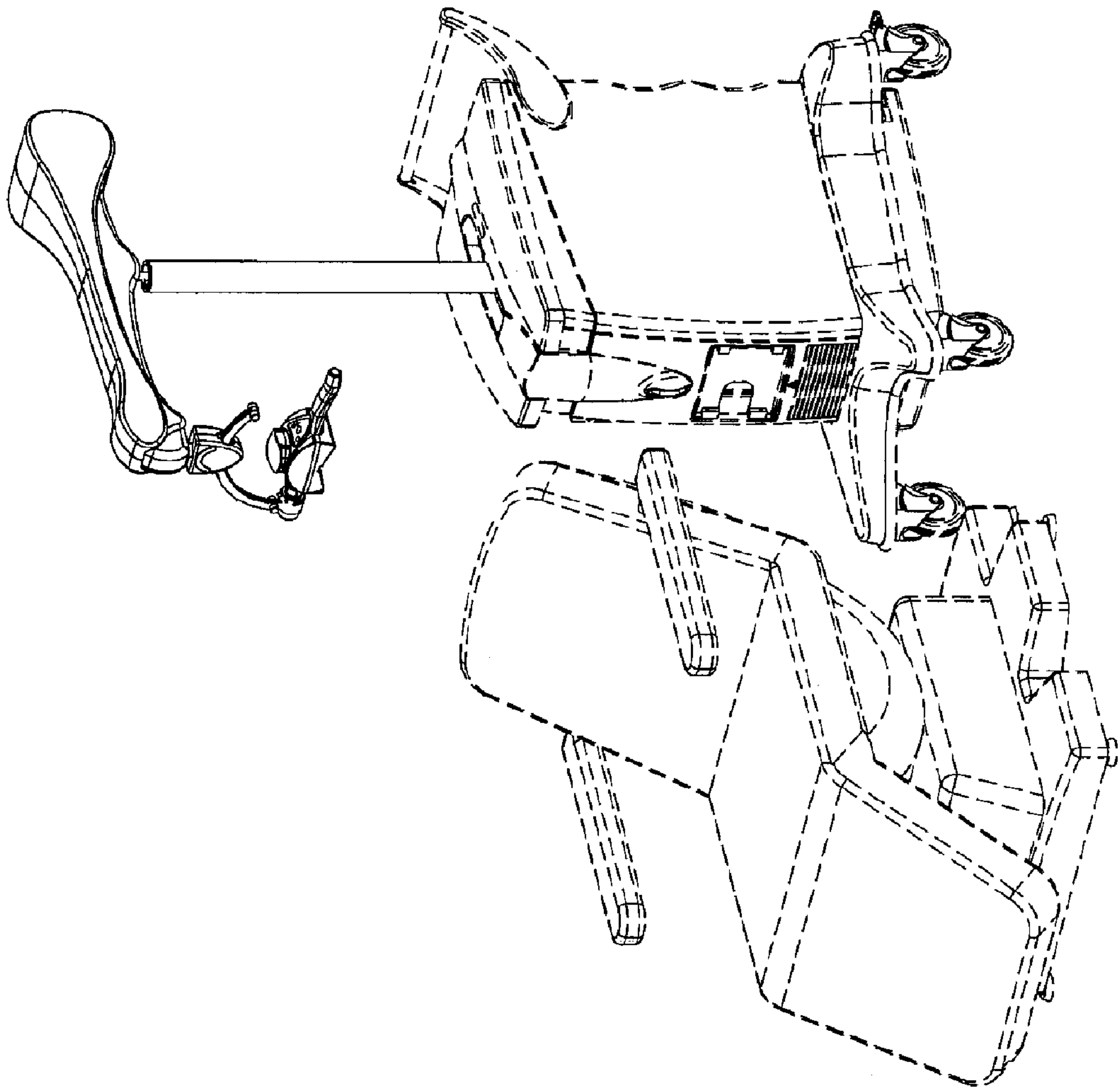

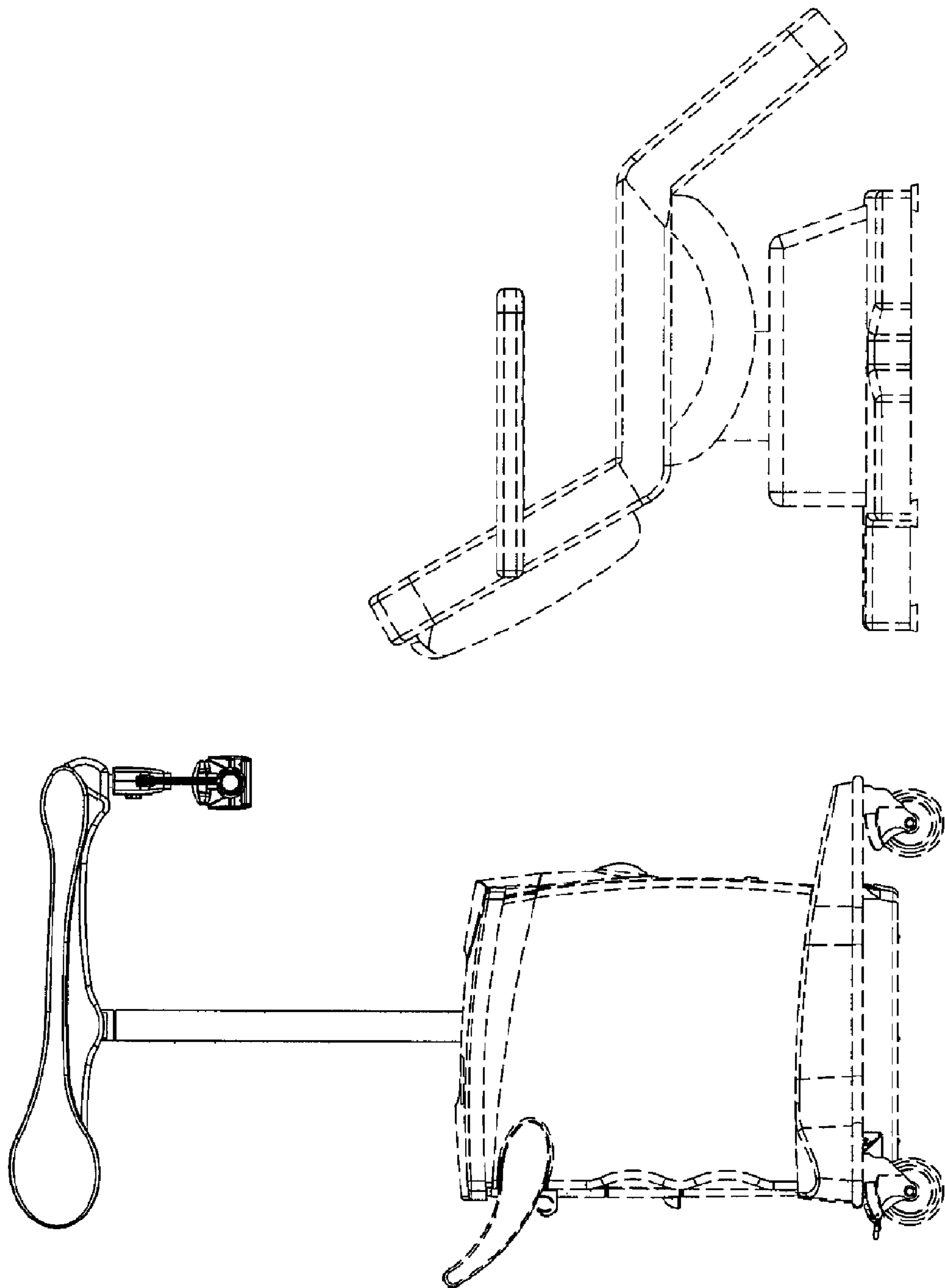

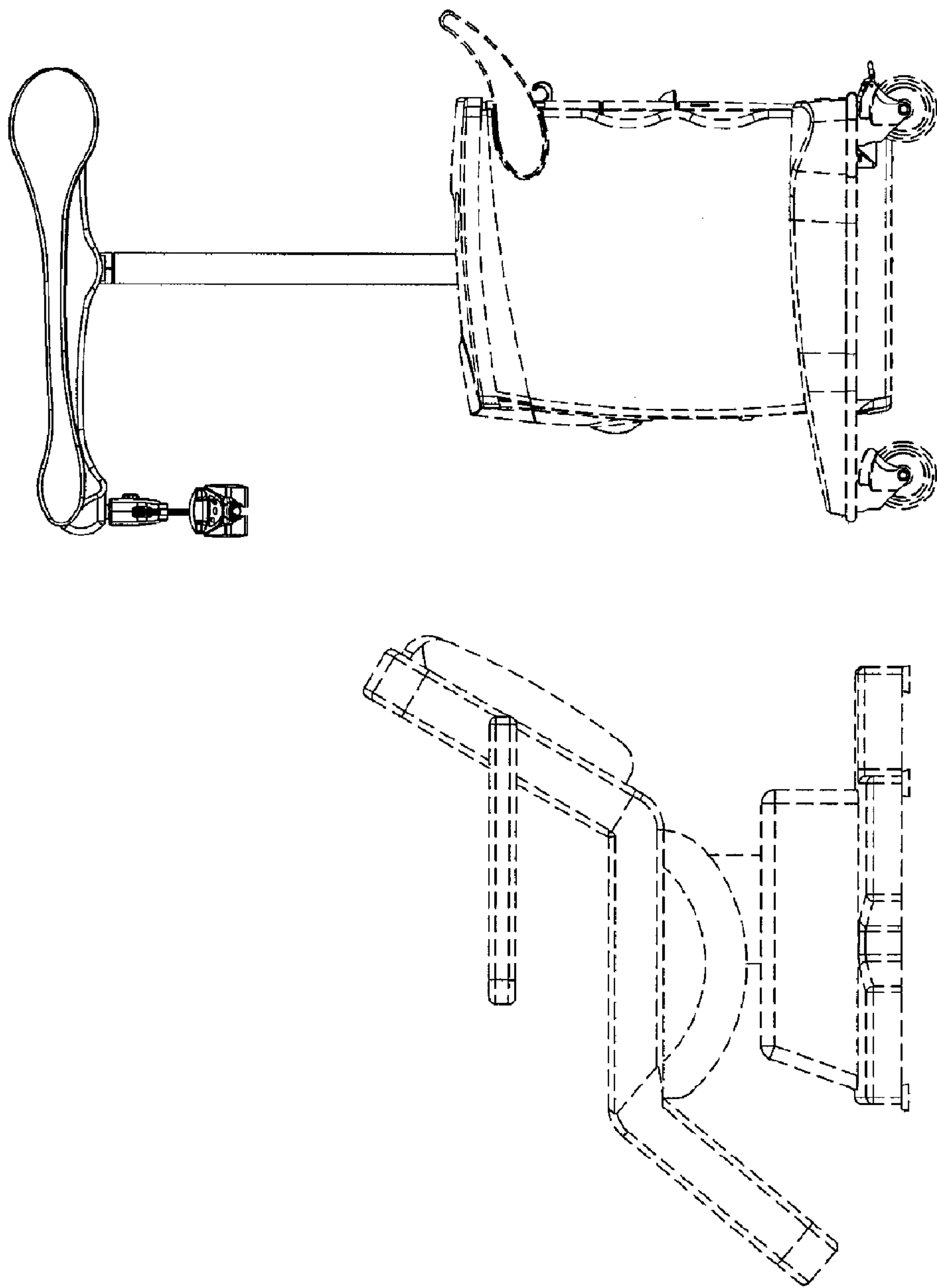

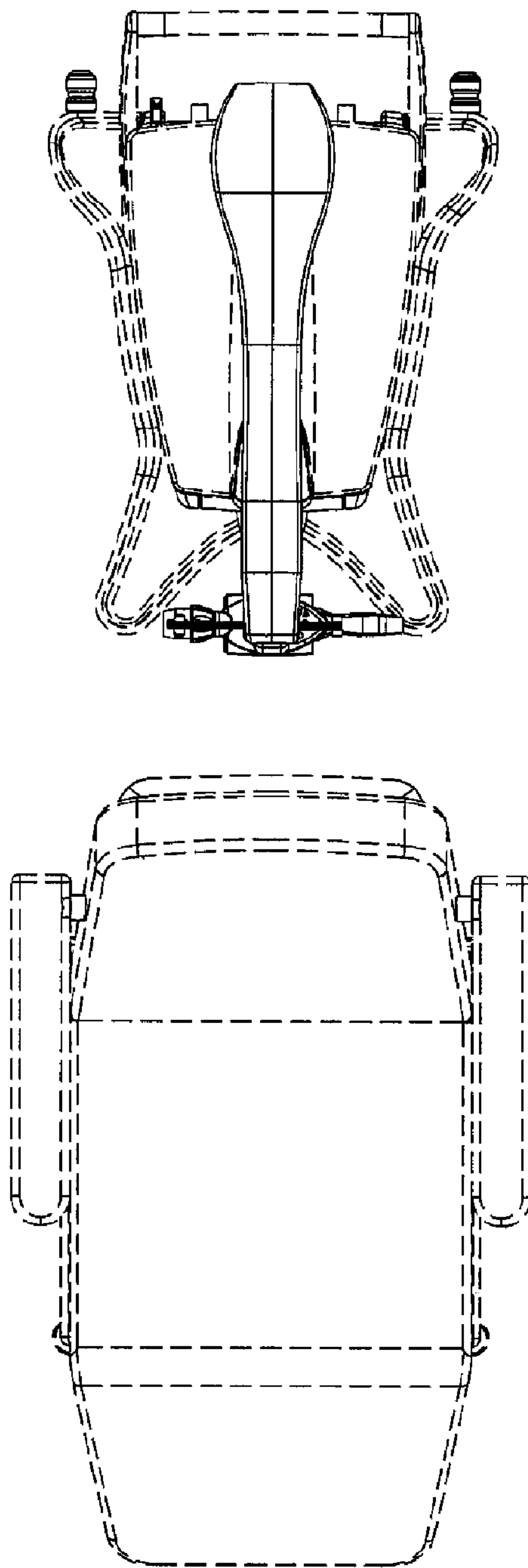

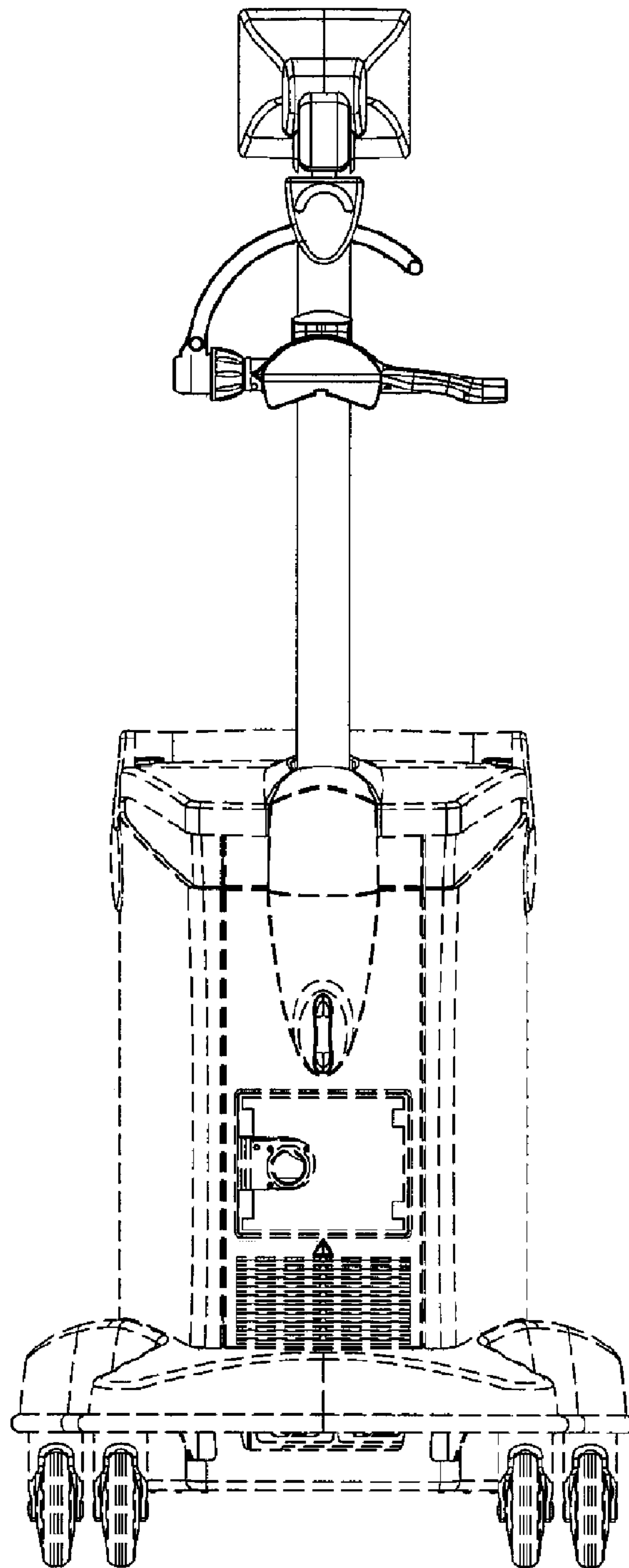
